**Drill** (Lawyer Ron) had lost some of his luster since winning last year's GI Del Mar Futurity, failing to hit the board in four starts since a runner-up effort in the Oct. 1 GI Norfolk S., but the Bob Baffert trainee buffed up his image with a determined victory in yesterday's GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita. The win gave Baffert, who is enjoying an embarrassment of sophomore riches early in this Triple Crown trail season, his seventh San Vicente victory. ## TESTA MATTA ON TOP IN FEBRUARY

**Testa Matta** (Tapit) came with a stinging stretch rally under an energetic Yasunari Iwata to land yesterday's G1 February S. at Tokyo Racecourse, as odds-on **Transcend** (Jpn) (Wild Rush), last year's G1 Dubai World Cup runner-up, flopped in seventh. Taken back off a strong tempo after breaking from the widest barrier, Testa Matta unleashed a furious bid from the middle of the track to seize control with 200 meters to run and powered clear to defeat **Silk Fortune** (Jpn) (Gold Allure {Jpn}) by two lengths. Transcend had to be ridden to keep pace early, dropped back leaving the quarter pole, and was beaten about eight lengths in the finish. **cont. p3**

**Drill Wins San Vicente (cont. from p1)**

The pre-race talk before yesterday's GII San Vicente S. focused squarely on the **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway), and while the GI Norfolk S. winner, returning off a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, was sent off the 1-2 favorite, **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) was allowed to go off at 7-2 in the short field of four. **American Act** (Quiet American) jumped out to the early lead with Drill chasing through an opening quarter in :22.78 and Creative Cause taken back off the pace to avoid traffic. Drill took closer order after a half in :45.88 and stuck a head in front of the pacesetter at midstretch, as Creative Cause tried to make up ground from the middle of the track. It looked like Drill would come home an easy winner, but American Act fought back gamely to just miss by a nose as Creative Cause came home an even third. "I don't know what made the difference today, I guess he just wanted to run," admitted winning rider Martin Garcia. "He's a really good horse so I don't know what happened in his last races, but he put everything together today. The finish was close, but I was confident I got the win."

Since running second behind Creative Cause in the Norfolk S., Drill, a \$300,000 Keeneland September yearling, was 10th in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, seventh in the Nov. 19 GIII Delta Downs Jackpot S. and ninth in the Dec. 17 GI CashCall Futurity. He returned to a sprint for the first time since his victory in the seven-furlong Del Mar Futurity when making his sophomore debut in the Jan. 22 San Pedro S., but came home only fifth as the 8-5 favorite that day. *Cont. p4*

“We actually thought he was going to run really well last time,” Baffert said. “Last time he broke a little slow and was behind, then he took him to the outside and then he flattened out.” Of his charge’s effort in the San Vicente, Baffert added, “It worked out today with a shorter field. He got to the outside where he was clear. Martin did a great job of slowing the pace down. He fired his race and it’s nice to see him back. We just got the jump on everybody, so that really helped. Today he was more relaxed in the race and he got an easy trip, that helped too.”

**No Cause to Be Discouraged**

Connections of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Creative Cause were far from discouraged by the gray colt’s third-place effort. “We got what we wanted out of the race,” confirmed trainer Mike Harrington. “He’s a route horse, not a seven-furlong horse. We hope he moves forward off of this. Did you see him gallop out? He’ll definitely move forward.”

Jockey Joel Rosario added, “Everything set up perfect, but the other horse [Drill] was much the best today. The last two times my horse ran, he was going a longer distance, but he shortened up to seven furlongs today, and I think that had something to do with it. He’ll have a little time off after this, so the main thing is that he comes back good.”

Harrington said either Creative Cause or stablemate Empire Way (Empire Maker) would likely start next in the [Mar. 10 GII, 1 1/16-mile] San Felipe S.

R Holiday Mood, a two-time stakes winner last term, returned from seven months on the sidelines to dead-heat for a gritty victory in the one-mile Ocala S. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 8. Shortening up and trying graded company for the second time in her career, the bay filly broke sharply and took the early lead. She was hounded by Funny Sunny through fractions of :22.67 and :45.14 with a tightly bunched chasing pack. Funny Sunny inched past the pacesetter at midstretch, but R Holiday Mood battled back on the inside for a narrow victory. "The speed didn't really develop, so I went ahead and took the initiative," explained winning rider John Velazquez. Victorious trainer Todd Pletcher wasn't surprised by R Holiday Mood's effort. "I felt reasonably confident that she would run well today coming off the mile race," Pletcher said. "That was a demanding race and the mile is about her limit, but she's a big strong filly and came out of it well. I'd say if she comes out of this okay we'll look at the next one, the [Mar. 17 GII] Inside Information. The seven-eighths is just right for her."

**UNION RAGS TUNES UP FOR FOY**

Chadds Ford Stable's **Union Rags** (Dixie Union) tuned up for his sophomore debut in next Sunday's GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. with a four-furlong drill at Palm Meadows Sunday. The GI Champagne S. winner breezed from the starting gate and covered the distance in :48 3/5. "He did it easy and galloped out fine," reported trainer Michael Matz. "He's ready to go. Other than running in a race, he's as ready as he could possibly be." Of the decision to have Union Rags work

from the gate, Matz added, "We've stood him a couple of times in the gate. We wanted him to pop out today, and and we'll stand him in the gate again on Thursday, and then he should be ready to go. He's going to be running against horses that have been racing and he hasn't raced since November. He's a big, quiet horse, so I thought a little reminder wouldn't hurt." Union Rags, off since running second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, will face an unbeaten duo from the Todd Pletcher barn in the Fountain of Youth in GIII Holy Bull S. winner **Algorithms** (Bernardini) and **Discreet Dancer** (Discreet Cat).

**A #** will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a **@** will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a **▲** will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a **+** will indicate first-time starters.

### Casual Trick Looks to Rebound in Fountain of Youth

Robert LaPenta's **Casual Trick** (Bernadini), second in the inaugural Gulfstream Park Derby, will look to rebound off a lackluster eighth-place effort over a track labeled good in a Jan. 29 Gulfstream allowance in Sunday's GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. The bay tuned up for the 1 1/16-mile race with a five furlongs move in 1:00 2/5 Saturday at Palm Meadows. "He worked good and we're going to give him a chance," explained trainer Nick Zito. "I want to think he just didn't like the off track the last time and just throw that race out. He had shown enough to be favored, so we'll take a shot. We know it's a tough spot."

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### ANIMAL KINGDOM COMEBACK RATES A '10'

Trainer Graham Motion confirmed GI Kentucky Derby winner **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) will now target the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup after the 4-year-old's sparkling comeback at Gulfstream Park on Sunday. "He's a very hard horse to read because he always acts kind of tired," Motion said. "But he certainly didn't seem knocked out by it. I think we couldn't ask for a better prep, really." Motion wasn't the only one giving the Team Valor runner rave reviews for his two-length win in the 1 1/16-mile turf allowance. "He made the ESPN Top 10 Plays of the Day," the conditioner reported. "I thought that was pretty cool."

Team Valor's **Lucky Chappy (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) may also be headed to Dubai after his narrow runner-up effort in the GIII El Camino Real Derby. "The horse is so tiny, I think if he was a little bigger, he would have won that race," Motion said. "He's never going to win a photo-finish, that horse. He's a very honest horse, though. As for a possible tilt at the Mar. 31 G3 UAE Derby, Motion said, "We're going to talk about it. That's been our plan. We're going to try to figure out what caliber of 3-year-olds they have other there. It's a long way to go and there are so many options here, but it's something we're talking about. The distance [1 3/16 miles] would be good for him." Lucky Chappy, a stakes winner in Italy last year, was fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. He was runner-up behind Howe Great (Hat Trick {Jpn}) in the Jan. 21 Kitten's Joy S. The El Camino Real was the the bay colt's first non-turf start and was over the same Tapeta surface he will face at Meydan.

### CALEB'S POSSE READIES FOR RETURN

**Caleb's Posse** (Posse) continued preparation for his expected seasonal return in the Mar. 3 GIII Tom Fool S. at Aqueduct with a four-furlong drill at Oaklawn Park yesterday in :48.00. It was the third fastest of 31 at the distance. "I was very pleased with him," said trainer Donnie Von Hemel. "I had him out in about a minute and he came down the lane very nicely."

## CAVIAR NOT YET OUT OF FUTURITY

After initially and immediately ruling out undefeated **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) from next Saturday's G1 Futurity S., trainer Peter Moody has backtracked a bit and will at least leave her in the discussion, for the time being. "I was probably a little bit quick on the draw to declare that," Moody told *Australian Associated Press*. "I've got to say once again, she's pulled up unbelievably well. "I looked at the clock [after the Lightning] and said in my own mind, 'Futurity off.' But looking at the horse again [Sunday] morning, she'll certainly be nommed [this] morning and we might let it play out for a few days like we did last week." Should she go postward, it would mark the supermare's third race in 14 days, having won the G2 Australia S. Feb. 11 ahead of her victory in this past Saturday's G1 Coolmore Lightning S.

## RICHARD HILLS TO RETIRE

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's long-standing retained rider Richard Hills will retire at the close of the current Dubai World Cup Carnival, he announced yesterday. Following a report in the UAE-based newspaper *Khaleej Times* claiming that the 49-year-old would quit the saddle, he issued the following statement through his agent John Robertson yesterday. "It has been my privilege to ride for Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum as first jockey for the last 15 years and previously as second jockey to Willie Carson for two years," it read. "No jockey could have ridden for a more loyal and supportive owner. I was very fortunate to have started my career with a truly great man in Mr. Tom Jones and without him, much of what I have achieved would not have been possible. I now want to use the experience and knowledge gained through my career to date to further contribute to Sheikh Hamdan and the Shadwell team, including the Derrinstown and Shadwell farms. After closing one great chapter, a new one begins." Hills, son of the legendary trainer Barry, who retired last year, has partnered five British Classic winners including a trio of 1000 Guineas heroines in the Shadwell silks in Harayir (Gulch), Lahan (GB) (Unfuwain) and Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway). In total, he rode the winners of 29 Group 1 races during a 33-year career which featured the 1999 Dubai World Cup hero Almutawakel (GB) (Machiavellian) and champion Nayef (Gulch). Appointed second jockey for Sheikh Hamdan in 1995 and promoted to the top spot following the retirement of Willie Carson two years later, Hills also enjoyed several high-profile wins for the Godolphin operation including in the 1999 G1 St Leger with Mutafaweq (Silver Hawk).

Son Patrick has begun to make his name as a jockey in his own right, while his twin brother Michael and brothers John and Charles both train in Lambourn. John Dunlop, another trainer who enjoyed a lengthy partnership with the jockey, paid tribute yesterday. "He rode primarily for Tom Jones when he first started riding for Sheikh Hamdan, but subsequent to that, and after Willie Carson's retirement, he rode as number one jockey for Sheikh Hamdan and has been the most marvellous, reliable, most consistent stable jockey that you could possibly have," the famed Arundel conditioner told *PA Sport*. "And a very nice young man, too. I'm glad to hear he's going to take some sort of role in Sheikh Hamdan's operation in future. I think the best he rode for me, as sadly all the Classic winners we had were in Willie's reign, was probably Elnadim. He won the July Cup and was a top, top horse. Richard has done us very well over these years and I do wish him well in the future."

## CAMBINA LOOKS TO START YEAR OFF RIGHT

**Cambina (Ire)** (Hawk Wing), winner of last year's GI American Oaks, looks to kick off her 2012 campaign in style in today's GII Buena Vista H. at Santa Anita.

The 4-year-old filly is making her first start since a solid eighth-place effort in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. She has won three of five starts over the Santa Anita turf course, including wins in last year's GIII La Habra S. and GII Providencia S. **Strawberrydaiqri (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) won the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot in 2010, but failed to find the winner's circle in five 2011 outings. Seventh in the G1 Dubai Duty Free last spring, the 6-year-old mare was third in the G1 Sun Chariot S. but managed only a 10th-place finish in her North American debut in the GI E

P Taylor S. last October. She makes her first start for trainer Ben Cecil today. Cecil also saddles **Andina (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and **So Belle (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) in the Buena Vista and, asked what instructions he will give his three riders, said, "Stay out of each other's way. Just get in everyone else's way." **Vamo a Galupiar (Chi)** (Proud Citizen), a Group 1 winner in her native Chile, made her stateside debut off a seven-month layoff and ran a dull seventh in the GIII Wilshire H. That was her lone 2011 start, but the 5-year-old bounded home first in her return in the Jan. 21 Megahertz S. over today's course and trip.

### TOBY'S CORNER RESURFACES IN GEORGE

Diane and Julian Cotter's **Toby's Corner** (Bellamy Road) makes his first trip to the post since injury knocked him out of last year's GI Kentucky Derby in today's GII General George H. at Laurel Park. The GI Wood Memorial winner broke his maiden by a romping 10 3/4 lengths at Laurel in November 2010 and made it a perfect two-for-two over the Baltimore oval with a victory in an optional claimer last January. He officially announced his arrival on the Triple Crown trail with a win in the Feb. 5 Whirlaway S. and a third-place effort in the Mar. 5 GIII Gotham S. He tuned up for his return with a five-furlong move in 1:01 3/5 at Palm Meadows last Tuesday. The hard-knocking **Caixa Eletronica** (Arromanches), third in last year's GI Metropolitan H., GI Vosburgh H. and GIII Bold Ruler S., opened his campaign with an easy win in the Jan. 8 Rise Jim S. and is coming off a third-place finish in the Feb. 4 GIII Toboggan S. **Eighttofasttocatch** (Not For Love), a four-time stakes winner over the Laurel oval last year, took the Maryland Million Classic before a fourth-place effort in the Oct. 29 GII Fayette S. and has been off since a front-running 4 3/4-length victory in the Dec. 3 Jennings H.

### MILLIGAN PLANS SOUTHWEST ASSAULT

Oaklawn Park's leading trainer Allen Milligan will saddle a runner in each of today's two divisions of the GIII Southwest S. Milligan will send out **Jake Mo** (Giacomo) in the first division of the one-mile event. The Stephen Brown colorbearer, a stakes winner at Prairie Meadows last July and fifth in the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint, produced a much-improved effort to be fourth in the Jan. 16 Smarty Jones S. and Milligan thinks he has his charge ready for an even better performance today. "I've trained him a little harder this time," said Milligan. "I left him a little bit short for his last race, so we've been pushing him harder to make sure that doesn't happen again. He's training super. He's the best he's ever been."

The trainer admitted there were some distance questions surrounding Jake Mo, whose two victories have come on the front end. "We're just going to let Cliffy [Berry] send him away from there and see who wants to go with us," he said. "If they don't want to go with us, we'll try and slow it down. If they do, we will take our chances and see how far we can go." In the second division of the Southwest, Milligan will saddle **King Coral** (Limehouse), ninth in the Smarty Jones last time out. "We're going to try and put him in the race a little earlier," Milligan said of King Coral. "I think he's just getting too far out of it and he's just getting discouraged. We will try and get him into the race, although I wish he was in the side Jake got. The pace might fit him a little better in there, but that's just the way it goes, I guess."

The John Oxley runner closed out the season with a pair of seconds, the latest of which was recorded in the six-panel Dream Supreme S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 9.

Dancinginherdreams broke smoothly and was allowed to settle in an easy fourth early as Rihanna (Per) (Apprentice) carved out modest opening splits. Eagerly inching her way closer to the lead, the grey launched her bid nearing the far turn. Three wide around Rihanna and Majestic Maria turning for home, Dancinginherdreams poked her head in front at the head of the lane and proved best of this bunch, including a closing Go Unbridled. Rihanna tired to fourth. "It's great to have her back," said Ward.

"Actually, she was ready to run about six weeks ago and then she bruised a foot and we had to wait, but sometimes things like that work out for the best. We had great expectations for her last year that just didn't work out. I liked the way she got to use that big, long stride of hers to pull away in the stretch today.
