## CAUSE FOR HOPE

There will be a few new shooters in this afternoon's GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita, but **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway), already a Grade I winner over the track and distance, should prove the one to beat in the final local prep for the GI Santa Anita Derby. The

GI Norfolk S. hero was a more-than-respectable third to Hansen (Tapit) and Union Rags (Dixie Union) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in November, and his comeback third to Drill (Lawyer Ron) and **American Act** (Quiet American) in the GII San Vicente S. over seven panels Feb. 19 shouldn't be judged

too harshly. The **"TDN Rising Star"** found the wire generously, shading 12 seconds for his final furlong, and should improve for the return effort. **Bodemeister** (Empire Maker) has a chance to complete-or top--the "Rising Star" exacta. A debut second to American Act over 5 1/2 furlongs Jan. 16, he turned in a freakish performance in a one-mile maiden Feb. 11, covering his final quarter-mile in :23.73 en route to a 9 1/4-length score. **Liaison** (Indian Charlie), the GI CashCall Futurity winner, had run his race and was destined to be off the board in the GII R. B. Lewis S. Feb. 4 when he clipped heels and lost his rider. He needs to show much more today. **Field p5**

**WIDE OPEN TEST IN TAMPA**

A case can be made for about half of the runners in today's GII Tampa Bay Derby, and John Oxley's **Prospective** (Malibu Moon) looms a value play from an advantageous post. Last year's winner of Woodbine's GIII Grey S., the \$250,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga graduate was last of 13 in the GI Breeders' Cup

Juvenile Nov. 4, but returned to action with a game half-length victory in this track's Pasco S. over seven-eighths of a mile Jan. 14. Drawn in the parking lot for the GIII Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 4, the dark bay covered ground on both turns, but stayed

on extremely well to finish 1 1/4-lengths second to the maiden **Battle Hardened** (Giant's Causeway). Many will be happy to take a crack against **Spring Hill Farm** (Smart Strike), who brings a two-for-two mark into the Derby. Owned in partnership by George Bolton and Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Stables, the dark bay aired by over a half-dozen lengths in his seven-furlong debut at Gulfstream Jan. 14 and followed up with a front-running allowance victory going a mile Feb. 11. "We always thought he had a lot of talent," trainer Todd Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "He started behind some of our other 3-year-olds, but he's made up a lot of ground." The race will lose some of its luster, as morning-line second favorite **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy) will not take part. "He's doing so well here (in South Florida) that we're just not crazy about the idea of shipping him to Tampa," trainer Patrick Byrne said. Take Charge Indy is expected to make his next start in the GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park Mar. 31. "We love the idea of racing him there for \$1 million."

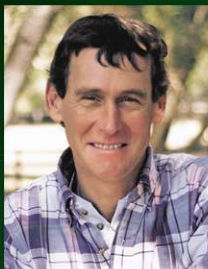

**FLORIDA-BRED FULL HOUSE**

Today's GII Gulfstream Park H. isn't restricted to Florida-breds, but each of the six runners was remarkably foaled in the Sunshine State. **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil), who has certainly done his best to fly the flag for horses with the 'FL' suffix, races at arguably his pet distance. Victorious in last year's GI Forego S. going seven furlongs in September, he stretched out to this distance and posted a 112 Beyer, good for only second behind Uncle Mo

(Indian Charlie) in the GII Kelso H. Oct. 1. Despite that defeat, he had an Eclipse Award within reach, but could do no better than a rallying third to Amazombie (Northern Afleet) in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 5. Jackson Bend entered the Jan. 14 GIII Hal's Hope S. winless in four tries at this venue, but overcame a bobble at the start to rally for a one-length success. The last time **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) raced at this one-mile distance, he turned in a sparkling front-

running performance, scoring by 5 3/4 lengths at Aqueduct Nov. 9. His last-out victory in the nine-furlong Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 28 looks that much better in light of Ron the Greek (Full Mandate)'s win in last week's GI Santa Anita H. The turnback in distance is the only question mark.

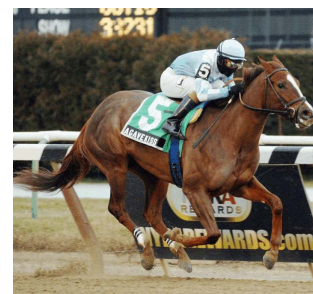

Having said that, he worked nicely last Monday and I'm hoping he maintains that kind of progress physically." Fellow globetrotter and defending champ Wigmore Hall earned a career high when annexing last term's G1 Northern Dancer Turf S. at Woodbine, and he makes his seasonal bow coming back from a ninth in the Oct. 15 G1 Champion S. at Ascot. "Wigmore Hall is very relaxed and seems in great form having had virtually the identical preparation as last year," commented trainer Michael Bell. Last term's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish {Ire} stretches out to nine furlongs for the first time here. Successful in Goodwood's G2 Celebration Mile, he subsequently ran fourth in the G1 Prix du Moulin, the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. and the G1 Hong Kong Mile last time. "It looks a massively competitive race, but the idea of running in the nine-furlong race is to get a little bit of a feel about where we are heading with him," owner Andrew Tinkler's racing manager Tim Jones told *PA Sport*. "He has the option of the Dubai Duty Free on World Cup night, but if he sees it out well on Saturday there is the option of stepping up again and going for the 10-furlong Dubai World Cup itself. Equally if he doesn't stay, we could drop back down for the Godolphin Mile. Saturday's race is on turf, as is the Dubai Duty Free, while the World Cup is on Tapeta, but as he's a listed winner on the Polytrack the surface would hold no fears for us." Godolphin's team of three is headed by **Rio de La Plata** (Rahy), who is set to be partnered by Frankie Dettori. The 7-year-old added the 2010 G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua and G1 Premio Roma to his portfolio, and ran with distinction without winning in six starts last term. He lines up off a below-par seventh in the Feb. 16 G2 Al Fahidi Fort. He worked really well at home, and when we got him here he prepped well. But you don't really ever ask him for their fastest until show day. I thought he could work in :21 1/5 or :21 flat. If everything went 110% perfect, maybe :20 4/5, which is what he did."

It was very gratifying to see her win those Grade I's last year, but she was always a very good filly, and was a very good 2-year-old." -Note: De Meric sold Ask the Moon to trainer Ned Allard and owner Cheval Corporation and Millicent Johnsen. She won the 2007 Maryland Juvenile Filly Championship for the group. Last year, she was claimed for \$75,000 by Farnsworth Stable, and subsequently won the GI Ruffian H. and Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga.

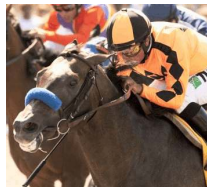
