It wasn't exactly a walk in the park, but **Dayatthespa** (City Zip) had something left in the tank late to fend off **Regalo Mia** (Sligo Bay {Ire}) by a neck at the end of the GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream. Camped out

in the outside post for the break, Dayatthespa rushed up to press **Frolic's Revenge** (Vindication) through an opening quarter in :24.00. With the front-runner squarely in her sights through a half in :48.60, the chestnut began to cut into her rival's narrow

advantage and reached even terms with her as they rounded the home turn. Ready to be cut loose in the stretch, Dayatthespa had to pull out extra in the final sixteenth, but she had enough left to hold off Regalo Mia at the wire. **Cont. p5**

RULING THE LAS FLORES

Izzy Rules (Peace Rules) once again lived up to her name with a authoritative front-running score in Sunday's GIII Las Flores S. at Santa Anita. Installed the 6-5 choice for her first attempt at graded company, the

bay quickly bounded to front, reeling off an opening quarter in a crisp :21.73. In front by two lengths through a half mile in :43.31, the 5-year-old was given a couple of cracks of the whip by jockey Edwin Maldonado turning for home, but the mare quickly proved that was unnecessary as she powered home an easy

4 1/4-length winner over the game yet vain challenge of **Spectacular Sky** (Sky Mesa). "This win feels great, and it's a dream come true," said Maldonado, who was earning his first stakes win at the Arcadia oval. "I was hoping to win a stakes race here at Santa Anita, and I finally did. This filly is so nice going and is just easy to ride. My main concern during the race was to try and get to the quarter pole alone, because I knew she would do the rest of the work for me." **Cont. p3**

AND HOWE

Team Valor International's **Howe Great** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) certainly had the credentials to be backed down to 3-5 favoritism for his graded stakes debut in Sunday's GIII Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream. That

support appeared to be fully justified as the dark bay--appropriately named after hockey icon Gordie Howe--strode home a length clear of the highly-regarded **Dullahan** (Even the Score), who was making his seasonal debut. Content to let **Scorcher** (Kitten's Joy) show the way through an opening quarter in :23.87, the handsome sophomore settled along the rail as GI Breeders' Futurity winner Dullahan settled in an easy fifth down the backstretch. Following a half in :47.52 and three quarters in 1:11.53, Howe Great inched to the front along the inside as Dullahan swept to reach the leading pack from the four path. As the leg-weary pacesetter wilted, Howe Great spurred to a slight advantage at the head of the lane as **Csaba** (Kitten's Joy) and Dullahan mounted their challenges. But despite Dullahan's best effort, Howe Great was able to hold his rival at bay by a length at the wire. **Cont. p4**

Offered for a \$20,000 as recently as Dec. 4, Izzy Rules kicked off her winning skein with a stylish 4 1/2-length victory over Hollywood's CushionTrack on that occasion. Bumped up to \$40,000 optional claiming company on the Santa Anita dirt Jan. 14, she once again dominated on the front end, powering home a 6 1/2-length winner. Favored in her latest in a \$62,000 optional claiming test over this track and trip, the 5-year-old did as she has grown accustomed to doing of late, and that is winning with ridiculous ease. On the front end once more, she rolled home a 6 1/4-length winner and made it four straight with Sunday's victory.

"[Jockey] Edwin [Maldonado] knows how to ride her," said Miguel Carranza, assistant to Jeff Bonde, who was in Ocala, Florida, Sunday afternoon ahead of this week's OBS March sale. "He knows her well. I just wished him good luck and told him to get the job done." Despite making a gallant attempt to narrow the gap between herself and the free-running front-runner, Spectacular Sky had to settle for second. "We ran into a buzzsaw today," said trainer Marty Jones of the runner-up. "The winner really likes this track and she's getting good. My filly tried so hard and I'm proud of her. She's a real solid, honest filly. She's been running pretty hard lately, so we'll see how she comes out of this race before we decide what's next."

Howe Great, runner-up in his career debut going seven panels over the main track at Parx Sept. 20, quickly got off the duck with a 1 1/4-length score in a 6 1/2-furlong test at the Philly-area oval Oct. 31. A front-running winner while trying the turf for the first time in an 8 1/2-panel allowance at Gulfstream Dec. 15, the dark bay added some black-type to his resume with a score in the Hallandale track's Jan. 21 Kittens Joy S. "He hasn't done too much wrong in his life," said winning trainer Graham Motion following Howe Great's victory. "He's a very classy, straightforward horse. The more he races, the more relaxed he has become. He's been in front in some of his races, but as you saw today, he's very tractable and relaxed, and doesn't need the lead." As for the colt's next race, Motion added, "We talked about it before the race and decided the logical spot for him, if he did well today, would be to go to the [GI] Blue Grass [S. at Keeneland Apr. 14] and see where we go from there." According to Dale Romans, the runner-up is also slated for the Blue Grass. "I'm very pleased," said Romans. "I thought that was a perfect race for him in his comeback. He finished good; we just wanted to see him finish good at the end. [Howe Great] is a quality race horse. This sets us up good, so we'll go from here to the Blue Grass."

(First Samurai) in the one-mile Gill Natalma S. at Woodbine Sept. 17. She tired to ninth in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf in her first start for a partnership consisting of newcomers Jerry and Ronald Frankel, but she soon made amends with a nifty score most recently in the Sweet Chant S. going a mile over the Hallandale oval's turf course Jan. 22. "She was acting up a little bit before the race, but as soon as she got by the starting gate she completely calmed down and went about her business," said Javier Castellano. "It was her first time going a mile-and-an-eighth and she did it beautifully. In the stretch she saw the other horse coming and just ran on that much more."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Musical Romance Likely For Inside Information...

Pinnacle Racing and Bill Kaplan's **Musical Romance** (Concorde's Tune), the Eclipse Award-winning sprint mare of 2011, hopes to improve off a fourth-place effort in the Jan. 28 Sunshine Millions Filly & Mare Sprint when she heads postward Saturday for the GII Inside Information S. at Gulfstream. Victorious in last fall's GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Churchill, the Florida-bred's 2012 debut was marred by an awkward start, a rough run to the turn, and a shoe malfunction. "Right now she's probable for the race," said Kaplan, who also trains the filly. "She grabbed herself pretty good coming out of the gate. A horse outside of her acted up just as the gate opened. She also bent a shoe and took a piece of a quarter off. There was actually a small puncture wound [in her foot], but she's fine now and ready to go." Also possible for the Inside Information is Grade II winner **Pomeroy's Pistol** (Pomeroy), who came home fifth in the Sunshine Millions. "I'm still feeling a little guilty about running her in that race," said the 4-year-old's owner/breeder/trainer Amy Tarrant. "I think I made a mistake running her back too quickly after her last race. I'm probably not going to decide until entry day [Wednesday]." According to Tarrant, another option for the filly is Keeneland's GI Vinery Madison S. Apr. 12.

COVERBOY NEARING RETURN *By Steve Sherack*

Klaravich Stables Inc. and William H. Lawrence's unbeaten **Currency Swap** (High Cotton), pictured winning the prestigious 2011 GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. ([video](#)) on this year's OBS March catalogue cover, continues to train forwardly toward his sophomore debut.

The handsome bay was placed on the sidelines after having a small ankle chip removed last fall. He was being aimed at the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile when the flake was detected.

"He's doing good," trainer Terri Pompay said of Currency Swap, who zipped through a six-furlong bullet from the gate in 1:11.40 at Gulfstream Park Mar. 10.

"He knows his job, I'm just getting him fit. He was always a well-built horse, but you could still see the little bit of boy in him last year. Now, he's all man."



Currency Swap returned to the worktab with a three-furlong breeze in :36.60 Jan. 28. He was rehabbed at Nick de Meric's farm in Ocala.

"Before he was just doing his job because it was fun to do," Pompay said. "Now he knows what his job is, and he goes out there with a purpose. He came in a little bit heavy from his time on the farm, but he's getting down to fighting weight now."

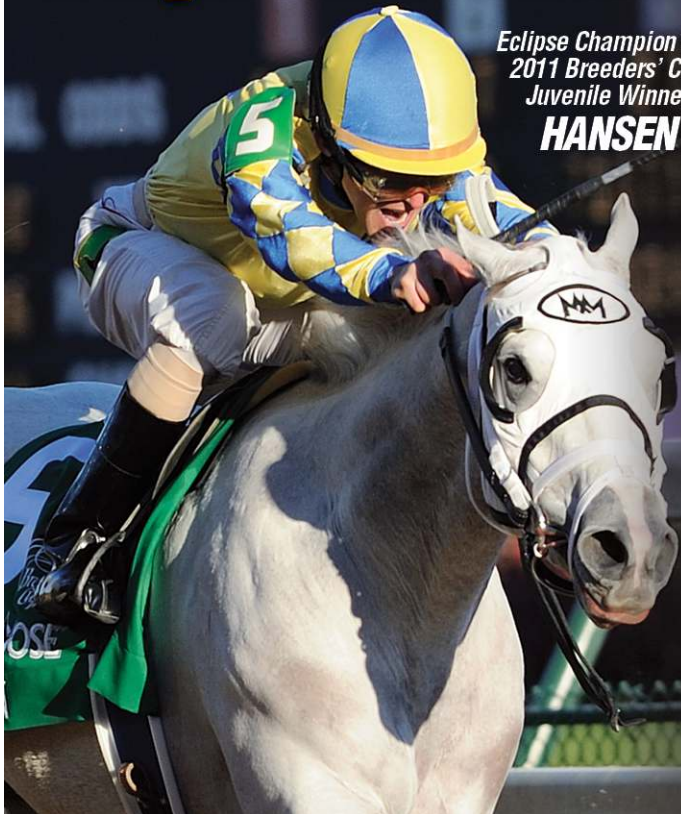
A flashy six-length debut winner going 6 1/2 furlongs at Saratoga Aug. 6 ([video](#)), Currency Swap kept his perfect record intact at the Spa with a hard-fought 3/4-length tally over Saturday's GI Swale S. winner Trinniberg (Teuflesberg) when adding an additional half-furlong over a sloppy oval in the Hopeful. Pompay is confident that the son of the unraced Pine Bluff mare Echo Bluff will be able to successfully stretch out to two turns this term.

"When he gallops and breezes, it seems like he just starts to get rolling when it's over," she said. "We always thought that of him, even as a baby, and I think so even more now."

Currency Swap was nominated to various upcoming stakes events--including this weekend's GI Rebel S. at Oaklawn and the \$75,000 Private Terms S. at Laurel--but will instead return to action in a Gulfstream allowance Friday.

The unbeaten Gemologist (Tiznow), off since a win in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 26, has also been entered in the salty five-horse affair at a mile.

"I don't want to throw him to the wolves the first time [off a layoff]," Pompay revealed. "I just want to get a good starting race into him."

Is Currency Swap running out of time to get on the Triple Crown trail?

"Obviously, we'd love to do the Derby or the Preakness, but it's going to be like they tell me, 'Push 'em or don't push 'em,'" Pompay explained. "They want a nice 3-year-old, but they don't want me to push him too hard in the beginning when we're not ready."

Based on his sharp move Saturday, it sure looks like he's sitting on go.

"Honestly, we always loved the horse," said de Meric, who made the trip from his Florida base to root on Currency Swap in the main event for 2-year-olds at Saratoga last summer. "One of his most endearing qualities is that he has a wonderful disposition--he's very laid back, but also very confident and aggressive, but not overly aggressive. Aggressive in a good way, and very forward and easy to get along with."

Currency Swap, bred in the Sunshine State by Stonecliff Farm, also had the looks to go along with his good demeanor, according to the native of England.


"He's a lovely physical," de Meric continued. "He's a big, rugged, robust-looking horse--a lot of bone, nice short cannonbones, a good strong hindquarter and a lovely shoulder. I was just looking back through my notes on him and my updates to the owner, and they were all positive. Of

course, [2011 freshman sire] High Cotton was a wildcard to some degree."

Was de Meric surprised that Currency Swap didn't prove a bit more popular in the ring after breezing a quarter in :21 3/5 ([video](#)) at last year's breeze show?

“Good question--yes and no,” he replied. “Yes because I always loved him so much and recommended him to quite a few people. And no because he didn’t actually love the synthetic surface over here [at OBS]. His breeze, while it was solid, wasn’t quite what I felt he was capable of from what he had been doing on dirt at home.”

De Meric added, “[Trainer] George Weaver tried to buy him privately after the sale, but at that point, we had already decided that everyone had their chance and that we were going to put him in the racing stable because we really liked him.”

Bidders who took a pass on Currency Swap at last year’s sale will have another chance to buy into the family when his full-sister goes under the hammer during Wednesday’s session. The bay filly, also bred in Florida by Stonecliff, has been consigned by de Meric Sales as [hip 304](#). She stopped the timer in :10 3/5 at the breeze show ([video](#)).

“We like her a lot,” de Meric commented. “She’s very like her brother in *many* ways. She may be a little bit less husky than he was, but they have a lot of similar physical characteristics.”

Thomas Looks to Build Off Big 2011...

Sequel Bloodstock's Becky Thomas has long been one of the business's most respected yearling-to-juvenile pinhookers. And members of her 2011 draft are showing why. Thomas, who in the past has sold Grade I winners like Officer (Bertrando), Rightly So (Read the Footnotes) and Habibt (Tabasco Cat) has enjoyed an especially strong run of late, led by Grade I winner **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway). The gray reaffirmed his status as California's top Derby hope Saturday with an impressive score over Bodemeister (Empire Maker) in the GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita. It was the third graded win for the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆, who also captured the GI Norfolk S. and GII Best Pal S. last year and ran a close-up third to Hansen (Tapit) and Union Rags (Dixie Union) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Thomas purchased Creative Cause for \$135,000 as a KEESEP yearling and, after scratching him from the Fasig-Tipton Florida Sale with a minor suspensory issue, sold him privately to trainer Mike Harrington and owner Heinz Steinmann last spring.

Creative Cause wasn't Thomas's only former pupil to perform well Saturday. At Gulfstream, another ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆, **Ever So Lucky** (Indian Charlie) ran third in the GIII Swale S. It was his first start since finishing second to Gemologist (Tiznow) in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in November. A \$95,000 KEESEP yearling, Ever So Lucky was Thomas's top-priced juvenile in 2011, topping Fasig-Tipton's May sale with a \$600,000 bid. EQB bought the horse, now trained by Jonathan Sheppard, for George Strawbridge.

At the same May sale, Thomas also offered a leggy colt named **Speightscity** (Speightstown). A \$65,000 KEESEP yearling, he was bought back for \$49,000, but was sold soon after privately to clients of trainer Gary Contessa. Three months later, he broke his maiden at Saratoga by an 11 1/2-length margin, was unplaced in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and has recently rounded back into form with a solid

second to Alpha (Bernardini) in the GIII Withers S. at Aqueduct Feb. 4. cont. p12

Sequel's 2011 OBS March consignment produced the \$75,000 grad **Pretension** (Bluegrass Cat), winner of the Sweet Envoy S. for New York-breds at Aqueduct Feb. 11, and more recently fifth to Hansen (Tapit) in the Gill Gotham S. Mar. 3.

Thomas's \$125,000 OBSAPR grad **Closerwalk** (Street Sense) recently broke through in his third career start with a victory in a seven-furlong maiden special at Gulfstream Mar. 3, just as **Teeth of the Dog** (Bluegrass Cat), another who sold privately, broke through in his third career try going nine panels in a salty Gulfstream special weight Feb. 4.

On the same day as Closerwalk's win nine days ago, the filly **Undeterred** (More Than Ready), a \$105,000 FTFFEB grad, became another horse of note from Thomas's 2011 group, winning a six-furlong maiden in Japan by six lengths. That puts the official record for Thomas's 2011 horses at one Grade I winner, another stakes winner, a pair of graded horses and at least three smart-looking maiden special weight winners.

"We don't sell that many horses, so it's been a great run," Thomas said from the OBS sales grounds, where she's been preparing what she hopes will be her next round of stars.

She has reason to be optimistic, in part because, as a yearling shopper last year, she made a concerted effort to avoid horses that might become "weak links" in her operation. As part of her refined buying strategy, she targeted only better-quality yearlings, on the page and by conformation. Thomas knew she'd have to pay more for them, but reasoned she'd be a happier horsewoman. And, hopefully, a more successful seller.

"When I walked down the shedrow and saw a marginal horse, I just had a hard time liking them at all," she admitted. "I hated myself for buying them, I didn't like them, and they were not the horses that showed up for me. I couldn't promote them at the sale, because they were just *horses*, and I bet I lost money on those horses every time."

Thomas continued, "So I went out and just got the horses I really, really liked, and spent more on them. I don't know that it will turn into a better *profit* year for us, but I do have some really nice horses. I was really happy with my Barretts horses, I'm really happy with my horses here, and I have a nice group for Palm Meadows."

The early returns have been positive. At last week's Barretts March Sale, Thomas was the second-leading consignor by gross, with four sold for \$635,000. They included a Bernstein--Clouds of Gold colt who sold to North Hills for \$200,000, a Pure Prize--Gatherindy filly who went to West Point Thoroughbreds for \$195,000, and a Malibu Moon--Ever Hopeful filly who sold to Kristin Mullhall for \$160,000. The Pure Prize filly didn't sell as a yearling, while the Bernstein and Malibu Moon brought \$70,000 and \$125,000 as yearlings, respectively.

Thomas admits that paying over six figures for a pinhooking prospect can be a little unnerving, particularly for the type of horse she says she shops for.

"The worrisome thing for me is that a lot of my better horses are two-turn horses," she said. "They're not little, short sprinter horses. Those horses don't work as fast, and I have lot of money in them. What everybody wants to see is a big two-turn horse work in :10 1/5, and that sometimes doesn't happen."

As a general rule, Thomas agrees that buyers have gotten more sophisticated over the past decade, relying less on the time of an under-tack breeze and more on how the style in which the horse works. "I think they're more forgiving and able to assess times that aren't as fast," said Thomas. "It's not all about speed."

She added, "It also helps if you've been around a long time like I have. I really don't promote anything I don't like, and I think that makes a difference."

(Evidence of the truth in that? Mike Harrington purchased Creative Cause, site unseen, based on Thomas's recommendation. The trainer later told the *DRF's* Gleyne Cain Oakford that it was until after the Best Pal that Harrington admitted it.)

Thomas has 12 catalogued at OBS March. Standouts include [hip 168](#), a filly by Medaglia d'Oro--Tango Prospect (Allen's Prospect) who sells tomorrow. From the family of GI King's Bishop S. winner Visionaire (Grand Slam), the filly, a \$120,000 KEESSEP yearling, worked in [:10 3/5](#) at the under-tack show.

"She's very much a two-turn filly," said Thomas. "She's always been a really hard-training horse--she really wants to go out and train."

"She's a real pretty mover, and while she didn't work super fast, there's something about this filly. She is also an Ontario-bred."

Also in Thomas's shedrow is [hip 297](#), a New York-bred filly from the first crop of GISW Majestic Warrior (A.P. Indy) out of Dixie Lyrics (Dixie Union). She worked an eighth in [:10 2/5](#) and was purchased last year for \$75,000 as an FTNAUG yearling. "I bought three Majestic Warriors in total--I have a colt in this sale that I also like a lot [[hip 37](#)]-and she's just a really nice filly," said Thomas. "She's always been a very elegant filly."

[Hip 318](#) is a Thomas homebred and another potential notable after a [:10 2/5](#) breeze. A New York-bred by Read the Footnotes out of Fit Right In (Out of Place), the filly is a full-sister to the aforementioned GISW Rightly So.

"She's very different than Rightly So, in that she's a chestnut with a lot of white on her, while Rightly So was a bay. The Out of Place came out in her," said Thomas. "She's a very powerful-looking filly who I don't think is just going to be a sprinter. I think she's going to be a seven-furlong or a mile horse. She's got a huge body on her."



The 2012 juvenile season got off to a positive start at Barretts March last week, where average was up 8.7% and median was up 21.4%. Thomas is optimistic that OBS will carry the momentum forward. "I thought Barretts was a very good sale, and I think there's an awful lot of nice horses here," she said. "I know a lot of my friends here have nice horses, and I think it's going to be very solid in the middle of the market. Like always, you're going to have horses who don't find homes, and they're not all going to be good horses. It's still early in the year, too, and it just may be too early for some of them. But I expect it to be a strong, solid sale." -LM

He went missing thereafter, and returned with a fourth-place effort to Spring Hill Farm (Smart Strike) in a one-mile optional claimer in the slop at Gulfstream Feb. 11. **Burn the Mortgage**, runner-up in a pair of Tampa optional claimers on the grass Dec. 30 and Jan. 20, got through to win at that level Feb. 4. **Patrioticandproud** could hold the class edge. Third in the Display S. at Woodbine last fall, he tries to get back on track after a dull eighth in a grassy optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 5. **Hello Prince** ran second in Saturday's GIII Swale S. and is a likely scratch.

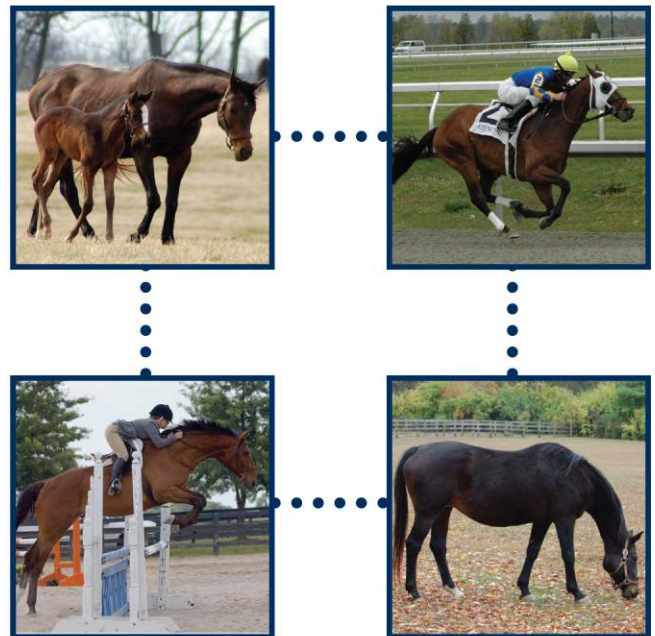
