Pegram, Watson and Weitman's **Secret Circle** (Eddington) answered that final question emphatically Saturday, coming with a determined stretch rally to reel in pace-pressing **Scatman** (Scat Daddy), then holding off a wrong-lead finish from **Optimizer** (English Channel) to take the GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn.

THAT'S WHY THE LADY IS A CHAMP

The New Orleans Ladies S. appeared on the Fair Grounds calendar for the first time in 2010 to attract reigning Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro). Things didn't go so well for the HOY on that occasion, but there were no such hiccups yesterday, as Fox Hill Farms's **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam), always confidently handled by Ramon Dominguez, rated in third, swept to the front 2 1/2 furlongs from the wire and was on cruise control late for a 4 1/2-length victory. "We had a great trip. My main purpose was to try to keep her out of trouble," Dominguez explained. "She was ready to run, as [is] usual with all Larry Jones' horses coming off of the layoff. She seems like she was definitely much the best on paper and she proved to be so today. I thought it was 'mission accomplished' first race back and she did great." Winner of the GI Woodward S. last September, Havre de Grace sewed up champion older mare honors by taking the GI Beldame S. the following month. Connections swung for the fences in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and, despite a solid fourth, she was rewarded with the Horse of the Year. She is likely to defend her title in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Apr. 13. **Chart p7**

The Edd-ucation Continues...

Despite a pedigree that said long and maybe not so early, Secret Circle overwhelmed a field of Del Mar maidens at first asking by over seven lengths, earning the **TDN Rising Star** designation. The attractive bay resurfaced for a popular score in Santa Anita's Jack Goodman S. Oct. 10, but, despite the win, trainer Bob Baffert opted to add blinkers for the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint Nov. 4. Though he held off the charging Shumoos (Distorted Humor), the evidence was inconclusive as to whether the shades made any sort of material difference, and he raced without the equipment in the Gill Sham S. Jan. 7. Keen early in that two-turn bow, Secret Circle held the advantage into the stretch before yielding late to be second. Baffert elected to keep his charge at the mile distance and opted to send him here for the Gill Southwest S. Feb. 20. He was able to switch off just enough to sit off the pacesetter Scatman before pouncing on that rival late to score by a half-length. The plot would read very much the same in the Rebel.

Clever Maneuver Seals the Deal...

Longshot **Unbridled's Note** (Unbridled's Song) took advantage of the inside stall and led under the line the first time, pressed by Scatman with Secret Circle not far away in third. Scatman pressed past Unbridled's Note at the midway point of the backstretch, and Rafael Bejarano had Secret Circle in good striking position in fourth, but soon made the decision which ultimately won him the race. **Cyber Secret** (Broken Vow) began to drift out a bit entering the turn, and Bejarano opted to go inside of that one and follow the move of Scatman up front. Tipped out in upper

stretch, Secret Circle looked to have his work cut out as the pacemaker set his sights on the wire, but he dug down with determination and proved best. **Optimizer** (English Channel) came wide into the stretch and flew home the final eighth to just miss while racing on his left lead. "I'm glad they made the decision to bring him back here," Bejarano commented. "It was the right decision. He was really ready today. The key was getting him to relax. It took a while for connections to stretch Include Me Out to two turns, but the Jay Em Ess colorbearer has found a home. Winner of a six-furlong optional claimer at Santa Anita in early November, she ran on for second in a similar test at Hollywood Nov. 25, coming up a half-length short to Teddy's Promise (Salt Lake). She was fifth to that rival in the seven-furlong GI La Brea S. in her sophomore finale at Santa Anita Dec. 31, and was an 8-1 chance in the 1 1/16-mile GII La Canada S. Jan. 22. She won off by 4 1/4 lengths under Joe Talamo that day for her first black-type score, and was sent off the crowd's second choice here as the streaking Ellfitz (Tiznow) was sent off odds-on. **Cont. p4**

Talamo, up once again, kept his mount in touch from the start as Ellafitz took her customary place at the head of affairs, where she set sensible fractions of :23.88, :47.16 and 1:10.62. Just as they hit the three-eighths pole, Include Me Out made a strong move to the lead that went unchallenged by Ellafitz, who soon fell back, and from there Talamo just had to stay aboard as Include Me Out skimmed the rail to victory. Love Theway Youare, well back early, made up good ground to claim place honors. "I think my horse handled the track really well today," Talamo said of the off-

going. "She's by Include, who I think liked the mud. I figured, like daughter, like father, hopefully." *(Talamo was just 11 when Include beat Sir Bear and Broken Vow in a sloppy renewal of the GII Mass Cap at Suffolk in 2001, one of only two starts he made on an off track.)* Trainer Ron Ellis said he had plenty of confidence in his filly, given the way she was

training. "She was improving in leaps and bounds," he said. "I just knew my filly was going to run huge. That's all I knew. I wasn't worried about the favorite. I knew my filly would run a big race and she did. I was just worried about the race track. She's got a lot of heart, and I know the way she was loping along back there she was going to give it a run at the three-eighths. That's where she likes to make her move, and it turned out to be the winning move." Martin Garcia, aboard the chalk, surmised Ellafitz didn't take to the rain-soaked surface. "I don't know what happened," he said. "I guess she just didn't like the track, because she is better than she ran today. It wasn't her day. She did not fire like she normally does. She was good until the three-eighths pole, and when I asked her to go she didn't respond like she usually does. I just don't think she liked the mud."

Musical Romance was racing's iron filly last season, making 14 trips postward for five wins, including an overlaid 20-1 upset of the field in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint Nov. 4. Kept in training this year at age five, the Florida-bred resumed her career in the Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint Jan. 28, but she was away awkwardly, found trouble on the turn and lumbered home fourth. She'd trained brilliantly of late at Calder, but was still relatively lightly regarded to get back to winning ways here. Funny Sunny (Sharp Humor) pushed through at the fence to lead from Hot Summer in the middle and R Holiday Mood (Trippi), as Musical Romance showed good tactical foot to sit just behind in fourth. Positions were largely unchanged as they reached the quarter pole, but Musical Romance was blocked with an unsure future for a few strides. Funny Sunny began to retreat in the final furlong, and that gave the Eclipse Award winner the gap she needed. She knifed through between the tiring pacesetter and R Holiday Mood before outfinishing Hot Summer to the wire.

The bettors had the Azeri down to a battle between Absinthe Minded (Quiet American) and Joyful Victory, but Tiz Miz Sue had other ideas and posted a mild upset. Winless in eight tries in Hot Springs coming into this, the homebred filly had her number taken down from third to fourth in the GI Ruffian Invitational H. at Saratoga last July before finishing third in that track's GI Personal Ensign S. Sept. 3. A disappointing fourth at odds-on in the GIII Turnback the Alarm H. at Aqueduct Nov. 4, she hadn't been able to solve Absinthe Minded in two local starts this term, finishing runner-up in the Jan. 21 Pippin S. and in the Feb. 18 Bayakoa S. She picked a fine time to turn the tables. Settled off the pace and able to tuck in and save some ground down the backside, she angled out around Joyful Victory in upper stretch, had the reins shaken at her and she blew past her foes for a convincing success. "It's a huge victory for her today," said owner and breeder Ran Leonard. "She is now a graded stakes winner, which is huge for a small breeding operation. This is a great victory for the whole family. To get lucky and win is a huge accomplishment for us. I'm going to let Steve decide our next move with her. We will probably nominate to the [Apr. 13 GI] Apple Blossom, but we will wait and see."

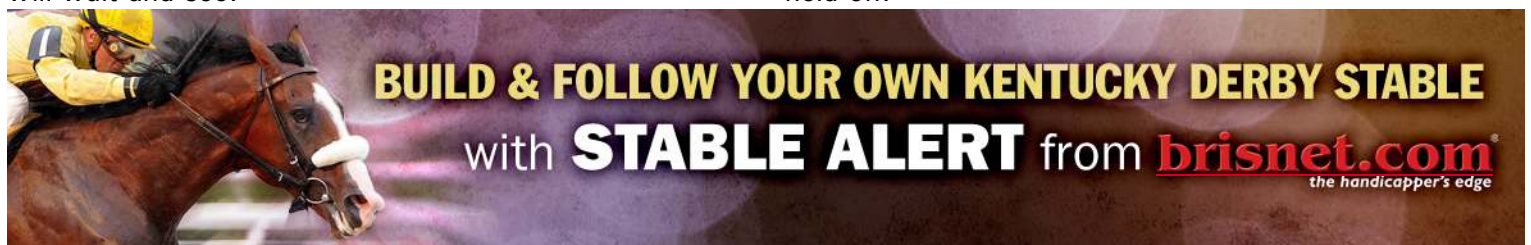

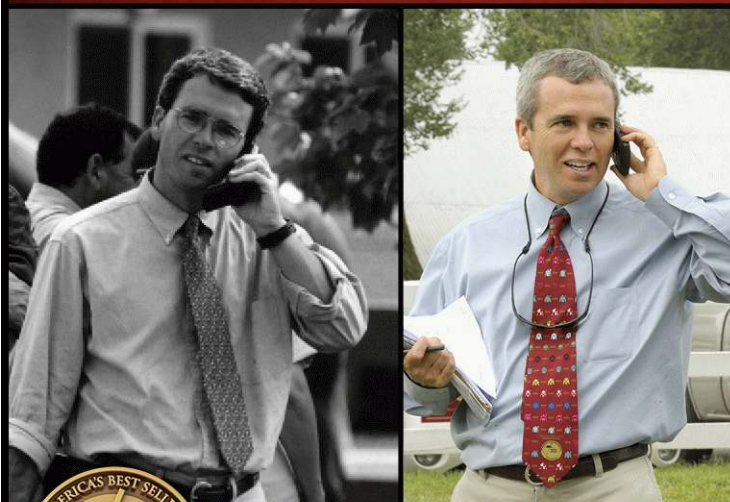
Marilyn's Guy took his batting average over the inner track to .800. holding off a resurgent San Pablo in the Excelsior. A six-length winner on this winterized surface last Jan. 23, the grey was risked for \$50,000 by trainer Kiaran McLaughlin in a similar spot Mar. 2 and was halted by these connections. A big-figure and hard-trying runner-up in the 2011 H. E. Johnson Memorial S. at Laurel, he was sidelined and returned from an 11-month hiatus to decision San Pablo by a nose in this track's As Indicated S. Feb. 18. The two rivals--San Pablo on the inside and Marilyn's Guy his grey shadow--had the best early speed in this heat and took the field up the backstretch through a half in :48.81 as favored Redding Colliery (Mineshaft) sat a perfect trip from third. Marilyn's Guy rolled up to take control of the race at the three-eighths marker and looked on his way to a comfortable win, as San Pablo was heavy pressure. He came into the final furlong with a clear advantage, but shortened stride noticeably late, allowing San Pablo to make a race of it at the finish. "Today he got off good, for a change, and I was making my man [Cornelio Velasquez aboard San Pablo] as uncomfortable as I could going down the backside," said winning rider C. C. Lopez. "When I got to the three-eighths pole, I'd already put [San Pablo] away and from there he just held on."

Chinchon, third in this race in 2009, won it a year later and used it as a springboard to a career-high victory in that season's GI United Nations at Monmouth. Last seen splitting Teaks North (Northern Afleet) and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) when runner-up in his repeat bid in that July highlight, the bay showed no sign of rustiness despite an injury-enforced spell on the sidelines as he warmed up for a visit to the Far East. Settled with one behind early by Olivier Peslier, the veteran was last at the top of the stretch where he was being prepared for his customary wide run. Picking up the long-time leader War Is War with 100 meters to race, he was soon in command and appeared to be idling as he crossed the line. Trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias revealed that tilts at the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 29 and G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 20 are in the cards. "He was hurt nine months ago [suffered a fracture] and had to be box-rested, and with the bad weather we've had in the last month, he was not as sharp as I would have liked and was certainly not 100%," he revealed. "I asked Olivier to wait and let him finish, and he's passed the test conclusively, so we'll do what we did last year and campaign him internationally. We have had no news from Dubai, so he'll probably pass that up and go to Hong Kong and Singapore now."

THE FUTURE IS NOW

George Bolton and Peter Leidel's **Future Generation (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) made a splash in her U.S. debut last time out and looks to make an equally smooth transition into American graded-stakes competition in today's GII Honey Fox S. at Gulfstream. A consistent performer in Ireland last season for trainer Ger Lyons, the bay filly was runner-up in the G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh prior to a 3/4-length success in Leopardstown's G3 Desmond S. going this trip Aug. 11. A narrowly beaten fourth under 133 pounds in the valuable Cambridgeshire H. back at The Curragh Aug. 28, Future Generation was a handy 1 1/2-length winner of a Feb. 15 optional claimer over the course and distance. One-time claimer **La Reine Lionne** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) took a Dec. 16 starter-allowance by a length and nearly got the job done in this track's GIII Marshua's River S. Jan. 7, missing by a nose while finishing a head in front of the re-opposing **Tapitsfly** (Tapit). **Entrustment** (Forestry) was scratched from a Saturday allowance and is interesting here at a minimum. Fourth by a neck in the GI American Oaks last season, she may want further than this, but horses making their first start for the Wolfson barn are always dangerous.

SONS OF FASTNET ROCK DOMINATE HKIS

Capitalizing on the popularity and success of Coolmore's Fastnet Rock (Aus), Saturday's Hong Kong International Sale showcased a pair of the stallion's sons that achieved record-setting pricetags. The 26 ready-to-run 2- and 3-year-olds, acquired at auction houses from the Gold Coast in Australia to Keeneland, sold for a record aggregate of HK\$114.4 million (US\$14,738,469), easily surpassing the previous record of HK\$94.1 million (US\$12,121,212) set just last year. Fully 16 of the

26 youngsters to go under the hammer sold in excess of HK\$4 million (US\$515,248), which was also the sale's median price. The first of the Fastnet Rock's to come into the makeshift sales pavilion in the Sha Tin walking ring was [lot 11](#).

The November foal, an A\$250,000 purchase out of last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, is a son of Verdict Declared (Aus) (Mr Henrysee {Aus}), making him a half-brother to Australian Group 3 winner A Country Girl (Aus) (Singspiel {Ire}). He eclipsed the previous sales record of HK\$7.5 million, falling to the bid of Guoxing Liang for HK\$8 million (US\$1,030,662). Liang is an executive with the Silver Base Group Holdings, involved with the sales and distribution of liquor and cigarettes throughout China. That record pricetag stood for all of about 10 minutes, as [lot 14](#), a son of Undercover (Aus) (Covetous {Aus}) from the family of G1 Golden Slipper S. winner Polar Success (Aus) (Success Express), was knocked down to Yung Chiu for HK\$9 million (US\$1,159,495). The Australian-bred gelding was acquired for NZ\$300,000 out of New Zealand Bloodstock's Premier Yearling Sale in Karaka in 2011. Of the four American-bred offerings in the catalogue, [lot 10](#) proved most popular. A son of the late Indian Charlie out of the stakes-winning Lottacosta (Cat Thief), the bay was purchased by John Yuen for HK\$5 million (US\$644,164). He was a \$220,000 acquisition by Cash Asmussen and his team at Keeneland September in 2010. [Lot 23](#), the full brother to champion Finsceal Beo (Ire) (Mr. Greeley), one of the priciest yearlings in the sale at 320,000gns, realized a final bid of HK\$5.5 million (US\$708,580) from owner Siu Pak Kwan. "It is truly a very unique sale," said William Nader, The Hong Kong Jockey Club's Executive Director of Racing. "When you look at a sale like this, it is always so impressive to experience the kind of atmosphere and enthusiasm we had today. In many ways, it was a replica of what Hong Kong racing is--a collection of talent from all over the world, whether people or horses, all coming together to create a great product."

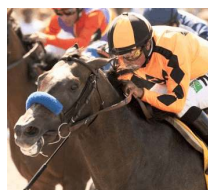
