OCTET SET FOR WOOD

A competitive group of eight sophomores has been entered for Saturday's \$1-million GI Resorts World Casino New York City Wood Memorial S., and WinStar Farm's **Gemologist** (Tiznow) has been installed as the 8-5 choice on the morning line. He will break from post six with Javier Castellano in the irons. **Alpha** (Bernardini), the second choice at 5-2, drew the rail.

On the far outside is unbeaten **The Lumber Guy** (Grand Slam), who is listed at 8-1. Barry K. Schwartz's homebred is coming off a sharp win in Laurel's Miracle Wood S. Feb. 25 ([video](#)). He will attempt to carry his speed two turns for the first time while maintaining a timber theme.

"I don't know if we're going to have much of a choice than to be on the lead," said trainer Michael

Hushion. "But I love the way he's been acting. I'm very happy with the way he's coming into the race. He got something out of his last work [1:01.83, Apr. 1], and it didn't knock him back at all. I might work him a little again on Friday."

Trainer Nick Zito, who has saddled a trio of Wood winners, has 20-1 **Casual Trick** (Bernardini) this time around. A narrow second in the Gulfstream Park Derby on New Year's Day, the regally bred bay underwent a throat operation following a pair of non-threatening efforts at the Hallandale oval.

"We're hoping he'll breathe better," said Zito, "and that he'll step up to the plate."

The son of G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Casual Look (Red Ransom) carries the colors of Robert LaPenta.

LOVE FIFTEEN

Last term's G1 Criterium International hero **French Fifteen** (Fr) (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) goes on trial for next month's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in today's G3 Prix Djebel at Maison-Laffitte and he will carry significant crowd support in this seasonal return.

Acquired by Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani after the Criterium International, he has been beaten just once in his last five starts--in October's G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud. His conqueror in that event, **Abtaal** (Rock Hard Ten), is one of two Jean-Claude Rouget entries who reopposes here in his first start since.

Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) used this as a stepping stone to Guineas glory two years ago and his trainer Mikel Delzangles is represented by the unbeaten **Hermival** (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), who comes here off a once-out win at Saint-Cloud in November. "We will know more about his programme after he has run, but Hermival has come through the winter in good shape," Delzangles told *Racing Post*. "He is also by Dubawi, so let's hope that he can go on and do the same thing [as Makfi] at Newmarket." **Cont. p3**

Hermival is joined by a pair of fellow unbeaten candidates. **Lord Sinclair** (Mizzen Mast) lines up off scores at Cagnes-sur-Mer in February and last month's Listed Prix Montenica at Deauville, whereas German raider **Al Malek (Fr)** (Anabaa) backed up an impressive debut triumph at Deauville with a 13-length demolition at his local Krefeld track on sophomore bow last month. Italian challenger **Salure (GB)** (Sakhee) boasts Group 1 form, having hit the board in October's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp, but comes back off a shock defeat at Milan last month. Richard Hannon trainee **Rockinante (Fr)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) enhances the international flavor and makes his seasonal debut coming back from a win in the G3 Autumn S. at Newmarket last October.

DO THE MASH

Since the Prix Imprudence was upgraded to Group 3 status in 2009, Jean-Claude Rouget has claimed two out of three renewals of the G1 1000 Guineas trial. Successful with subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine Elusive Wave (Ire) (Elusive City) in 2009, he also saddled Pouliches third Joanna (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) to success the following year. This time he relies on **Mashoora (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) and **Tribune (Fr)** (Grand Slam).

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's colorbearer Mashoora has made all three prior starts exclusively at Deauville and stepped up from an August maiden victory there to run second behind subsequent G1 Prix Marcel Boussac victress Elusive Kate (Elusive Quality) in the G3 Prix du Cavaldos that same month. She was caught close home when runner-up in October's G3 Prix des Reservoirs last time.

Ecurie des Monceaux homebred Tribune comes here off a neat score in last month's Listed Prix Ronde de Nuit at Deauville where **Nadeaud (Fr)** (Soave {Ger}) and **Belle de Lune (Fr)** (Ski Chief) finished in arrears. Guy Pariente's **Restiadargent (Fr)** (Kendargent {Fr}) was a close-up fourth to Elusive Kate in July's Listed Six Perfections at Deauville, but bagged the G3 Prix d'Arenberg in September going six furlongs before posting a personal best in the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte in the mud here again in November last time. **Cont. p4**

Last year's GI Jamaica H. winner **Western Aristocrat** (Mr. Greeley) sustained an injury when pulled up during Saturday's G2 Godolphin Mile at Meydan, trainer Jeremy Noseda revealed yesterday. Tom Ludt's 4-year-old disappeared from the action at halfway in the World Cup opener on Tapeta. "Unfortunately Western Aristocrat was injured on Saturday and we will not know his future situation for another week," Noseda tweeted. A track-record setter over the Kempton all-weather last season, Western Aristocrat posted a wire-to-wire victory in the GI Jamaica H. at Belmont Park and was a respectable third in the GI Hollywood Derby in November before his first-up run in the Godolphin Mile.

Coronation Option for Juddmonte Pair...

Khalid Abdullah's GI Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ World Domination** (Empire Maker)--who feature in a stellar entry of 30 for the June 2 G1 Diamond Jubilee Coronation Cup--are both pointing at Epsom's £300,000 contest, according to the owner's racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe. "The Diamond Jubilee Coronation Cup is on the radar for both Sea Moon and World Domination," he said. "In the case of Sea Moon, he is a proven Group 1 level horse so, although he hasn't run yet this year, you would like to think a race like that would be very much on his radar."

"[Trainer] Sir Michael [Stoute] has been very happy with how Sea Moon has done over the winter," added Grimthorpe. "We have always rated him very highly, so his progress towards the end of last season didn't surprise us. He was a nice 2-year-old and obviously took a while to come to himself last year, but he was very impressive in the Great Voltigeur at York. He probably didn't get the best of runs through in the St Leger, but he then ran very well in the Breeders' Cup Turf. I would imagine Sir Michael will want to give him a prep run beforehand, but I am yet to sit down and talk to him about that. Sea Moon was impressive over a 1 1/2 miles, so whether he will come back in trip or go a bit further remains to be seen, but I think a 1 1/2-miles seems to be the right trip for him."

World Domination, who earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status with an imperious debut performance at Newbury last April, was too keen for his own good when fourth in the May 12 G2 Dante S. at York and when last of 10 in the June 17 G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot, but retains connections' confidence. "World Domination hasn't run since Royal Ascot last year," continued Grimthorpe. "He was always highly rated, but obviously he has got to jump up to prove he's that level before he goes to Epsom. He has done very well over the winter. He was a very immature horse last year, but he has grown into a really nice-looking horse now and he showed glimpses of good ability last year. His tendency to pull in his races could have been down to a number of things, but he is certainly more relaxed now. The plan is for him to run in the [Apr. 28 G3] Gordon Richards S. at Sandown, when he will have to show himself as potentially Group 1 calibre, but I don't think he would be rushed. Obviously, he is a 4-year-old now, so the Coronation Cup would be an option as time is relatively limited, but we will have to play him by how he goes and what he does. However, we hope he can prove himself a legitimate contender."

Last year's winner St Nicholas Abbey heads Aidan O'Brien's team of nine, which also includes **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), **Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}). John Gosden is represented by G1 St Leger winners **Arctic Cosmos** (North Light {Ire}) and **Masked Marvel (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) while G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}), from the Andre Fabre stable, is France's second entry.

Defending Champ Back for Maker's 46...

Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) arrived at Keeneland Tuesday in anticipation of his start in the \$300,000 GI Maker's 46 Mile Apr. 13. The Sullimar Stable's runner, coming off a victory in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H., is looking to become the second horse to win consecutive runnings of the Maker's 46. Kip Deville took back-to-back renewals in 2007 and 2008. Trainer Tom Bush believes the "late-maturing horse" is "as good as he has ever been," noting that Get Stormy "has won graded stakes at three, four, five, and six, and there are not many that do that." Beyond the Maker's, Bush is looking towards the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 5 at Churchill and the GI Fourstardave Aug. 11 at Saratoga as possible future engagements.



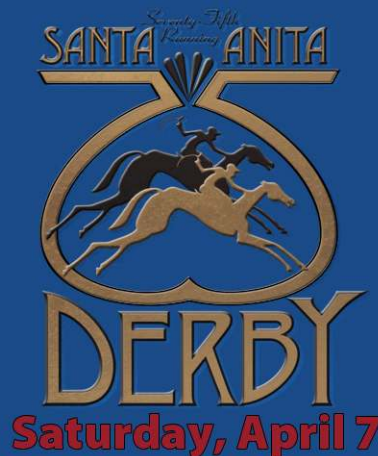

COPA BULLRICH CATALOGUE RELEASED

The catalogue for this year's Copa Bullrich Yearling sale is now available at www.abullrichsa.com. The three-day sale will be held from May 13 through May 15 in Buenos Aires.

During last year's auction, 64 horses sold for \$1,045,700 and the average, \$16,339, was up 29.2% from 2010. Antonio Bullrich, director of the sales company, is looking for an even stronger renewal of Argentina's premier yearling sale this year. "This year's sale is going to be even stronger than last year due to an increased amount of yearlings inspected and an improvement of the standard," Bullrich explained. "This increase in standard can be attributed to many facts, but mainly an increased understanding of foreign buyers' demands. There are more international consultants/managers being employed from overseas to advise the farm managers and owners on the larger

farms on how to improve their stock. Last year, Thomas Thornbury from Keeneland also gave advice to a few farms on improving their yearlings and this advice has very obviously been absorbed and put into practice."

There were 85 yearlings catalogued to last year's sale and that figure remains steady in 2012. The sales company is purposefully keeping numbers down in an effort to focus on quality over quantity.

Thornbury, Keeneland's Associate Director of Sales, is now in his third year of inspecting yearlings for the Copa Bullrich sale.

"You must remember that the 'selected' sale format is only in its third year with the Copa Bullrich," Thornbury commented. "Previously, all the major farms offered their crop at one time, at their own exclusive sales.

"The 'selected' Copa Bullrich Sale allows breeders, large or small, to be part of this exciting sale. It also allows international buyers the opportunity to buy from some of the best yearlings on offer in one, brief, high-quality sale."

Last year's sale was dominated by the first Argentinian crop of Giant's Causeway, who had nine yearlings sell for \$837,516. The Coolmore stallion will have 19 horses in the 2012 sale. Other international stallions represented in the catalogue include Hat Trick (Jpn), Exchange Rate, Tapit, Orpen, Aptitude, Roman Ruler, Johannesburg, Footstepsinthesand (GB), Mutakddim, Tiznow and El Corredor.

The Copa Bullrich sale has drawn an increasing number of foreign buyers, and Bullrich is expecting an even deeper international buying bench this year.

"We are anticipating a strong international presence this year and have already had a lot of interest and confirmations from foreign trainers and agents," Bullrich said. "We are hoping to double the international presence this year, with Tommy Inglis and John Foote from Australia, William de Burgh, Emmanuel de Seroux and Frankie O'Connor from Kildare Farm in Ireland, and many more expected."

Bullrich added that racing in Argentina has plenty of attractions for an international clientele.

"There are many attractions to buying horses in Argentina," he said. "Prize money would be one of the main attractions, with a good equation for training fees to prize money in Argentina's four officially recognized tracks, with a maiden 2-year-old race winning the equivalent of about 10 months training fees.

“As well as the high standard of racing and competitive prize money, there is also the desire to have a horse to follow down in Argentina, as it is such a brilliant holiday destination and many owners dovetail a holiday and racing,” Bullrich continued, “as well as trying to get a well-bred horse racing in Dubai or Hong Kong that is bought for a fraction of the price compared to the U.S., UK or Australasia and has relatively low training fees.”

Graduates of the Copa Bullrich sale are eligible for the auction’s race series, which has been expanded in 2012. Up until last year, the series consisted of just two races with prize money of 1.3 million pesos (\$297,000). This year, the series will consist of five races run at the Hipodromo in Palermo on both dirt and turf.

The Copa Bullrich catalogue is also available via an iPad app through The Jockey Club Information Systems.

F-T TEXAS JUVENILES SET TO SELL On the heels of a statistically successful Florida Sale, Fasig-Tipton hosts the Texas 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale today at Lone Star Park in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex beginning at 11 a.m. With a total of 19 horses having been withdrawn as of Wednesday afternoon, a total of 131 horses are set to go under the hammer, and sales officials are optimistic that they'll keep the ball rolling here. "We had a pretty good breeze show, and we had a lot of first-year sires step up and have their horses show good breezes," commented F-T Texas Director of Sales Tim Boyce. "This is a good place to highlight a precocious 2-year-old. It's safe to say that the market is on the mend and on the rebound, and we'll hope to mirror that here." Nationally prominent sires such as Awesome Again, Curlin, Empire Maker and Medaglia d'Oro give the Texas sale something other than a regional feel. "The Curlin is attracting a lot of attention," Boyce confirmed. "[Freshman sire] Salute the Sarge, he's had some nice horses and one worked well. It'll be interesting to see how they'll be received here." A filly by Into Mischief and colts by Latent Heat and City Place zipped an eighth of a mile in a bullet :10.1, while a Closing Argument filly earned the quarter-mile bullet, covering the distance in :21.3.



NJ RACETRACKS NOT PART OF INTERNET WAGERING BILL A New Jersey State Senate committee has approved a bill to authorize Internet wagering in the state, though the legislation contains no provision for the state's horse racing industry. A hearing was held Tuesday before the Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee and included arguments from the horse racing industry claiming that Internet gaming could very negatively impact the sport. The bill is a revised version of similar legislation already vetoed by Governor Chris Christie during the last legislative session, which proposed Internet wagering parlors outside of Atlantic City and included a subsidy for the state's tracks. Christie is opposed to gambling anywhere but Atlantic City, and is committed to helping to rebuild the struggling resort. State Senator Jennifer Beck, a Republican from Monmouth County, has explored ways for tracks to share from the revenue from Internet gaming, but told NJ.com that barring a constitutional amendment, it is not possible. The bill now advances to the Senate floor for a vote.

INVESTMENT INCENTIVES IN PLACE FOR 2012

Members of the Thoroughbred industry investing in their businesses in 2012 may be able to benefit from the two incentives described below. Each of these is the result of legislation from 2010 designed to stimulate the U.S. economy.

Section 179 Expense Allowance – allows taxpayers to write off the cost of new or used qualified depreciable property, up to \$125,000, if the property is purchased and placed in service before 1/1/2013. The expense allowance is reduced dollar for dollar once qualified investments exceed \$500,000. For 2013, the expense allowance drops to \$25,000 with a \$200,000 threshold.

Bonus Depreciation – allows taxpayers to write off 50 percent of the cost of new qualified depreciable property if the property is purchased and placed in service before 1/1/2013. Property is new if its original use commences with the taxpayer. ~~Bonus depreciation expires for 2013.~~

HASKELL ANCHORS MONMOUTH STAKES The \$1-million GI Haskell Invitational S. will once more be the centerpiece of a \$6-million stakes program this spring and summer at Monmouth Park in Oceanport, New Jersey. The total prize money on offer is down \$1 million from the 2011 meeting. While the Haskell retained its purse and will continue to be a mid-season focus for the nation's top sophomores, many other stakes were subject to cuts. The track's other Grade I event, the United Nations S. for older males on turf, was decreased from its previous level of \$750,000 to \$500,000, while the Monmouth S., though promoted to Grade II status for the first time, saw its purse slashed from \$250,000 to \$200,000. For the 2012 meeting, the Salvator Mile, Lady's Secret S. and Jersey Derby have been eliminated. They are to be replaced by the Monmouth S., the Gill Eatontown S. and Gill Red Bank S. Monmouth will open its doors May 12. The meet is being run for the first time by the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association under a long-term lease agreement with the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority.

UK Club Discussion to Feature Racing Industry Heavies:

Jockeys’ Guild Launches Injury Database:

Officials at The Jockeys’ Guild have announced that information on injuries suffered by jockeys at the racetrack will be collected and entered into a database for future analysis. The database will include where, when and how injuries occurred, what type of equipment was being worn by the riders, and the nature and severity of the injuries. In the event of an incident, information will be collected confidentially by medical personnel at the track and also by Guild representatives. Jockeys will not be named nor will the track at which the injury happened. “We constantly work with tracks and the industry to ensure the safety of jockeys,” said Terry Meyocks, National Manager of the Jockeys’ Guild. “This program was first conceived at the Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit and it has been in the works for several years. We are thrilled to see it come to fruition. Its goal is to find ways to reduce racing injuries and create a safer racing environment.” Keeneland will be the first track to collect data and will begin doing so coinciding with the beginning of the spring meeting tomorrow. The NTRA Safety and Integrity Alliance will advocate participation in the database when it seeks track accreditation. “Anything we can learn from accidents that happen on the racetrack to help improve the safety for our human and equine athletes is a plus for the sport,” said Mike Ziegler, executive director of the NTRA Safety and Integrity Alliance.

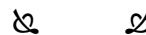

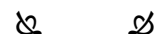
