



IRELAND FORMS LINK TO CHINESE RACING

Irish racing will receive a much-needed boost to its economy as a result of the announcement yesterday that a multi-million euro deal has been signed with China to launch the country's Thoroughbred industry. Coolmore is at the forefront of the initiative to build a \$2-billion equine centre over 3.3-million square meters in Tianjin, China's fourth largest city, as early as next year. The Irish bloodstock industry will ship over 100 broodmares and a selection of stallions over the next three years to lay the foundations, while Coolmore has offered training for a group of agriculture graduates from Chinese universities who will eventually run the breeding operation. **Cont. p3**

ENTER THE DRAGON


All eyes were on France's returning Horse of the Year **Dabirsim (Fr)** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) in yesterday's G3 Prix de Fontainebleau, but the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere hero had to give up his perfect tally when missing out to **Dragon Pulse (Ire)** (Kyllachy {GB}) in a dramatic finish. Let go at a generous 7-1 on his debut for the Mikel Delzangles barn, the chestnut was restrained in rear early in the slipstream of the keen-going Dabirsim, as **Sofast (Fr)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) failed to live up to his name while settling into a moderate tempo. The 3-5 favorite coasted to the front with 300 meters remaining, but Christophe Soumillon was soon taking several lingering looks behind, while Gregory Benoist was searching for Dragon Pulse's top gear. Soumillon went from showboating to panic in a matter of strides, as Benoist's labors began to pay off on Dragon Pulse and the finishing surge of the eventual winner took him past the previously unbeaten champion and his embarrassed Belgian rider in the shade of the post for a short-head success. For Delzangles, the result was not the surprise the betting indicated. "I got him two months ago and he acclimatized very quickly to his new surroundings," the trainer with the ever-growing reputation explained. "He is very easy to train and his record last year spoke for itself. They didn't go very quick, so the jockey did well to ride such a fine waiting race and I was very impressed with the way he quickened up. He is definitely a good one and will be back for the [May 13] G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains." **Cont. p7**

'ROBIN' FLIES TO VICTORY IN BEAUMONT

Gypsy Robin (Daaher), one of only three representatives by her sire to hit the track, made up for the lack of numbers to provide the Grade I winner with his first graded score as a sire in Sunday's GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland. Sent off the 2-1 second choice, the bay led the field through fractions of :24.15 for the first quarter-mile and :49.10 for the half. Comfortably in front after three-quarters in 1:13.06, the \$27,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase proved best to hand even-money choice **Sacristy (Pulpit)** a three-length defeat. The win gave jockey Jeffrey Sanchez his first Keeneland stakes victory and trainer Wesley Ward his third. The filly is owned by a partnership which includes King 9 Stables, nom-de-course for New England Patriots wide receiver Wes Welker. Gypsy Robin broke her maiden at first asking at Keeneland last spring, romping by 7 1/2 lengths, before a respectable seventh-beaten 3 1/2 lengths--in the G2 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot June 15. Fourth in a quick turnaround for the July 22 GIII Schuylerville S. at the Spa, she concluded the season with a score in Monmouth's Sorority S. Sept. 5. **Cont. p7**





Horse Racing Ireland's Director of Marketing and Communication Michael O'Rourke said, "HRI has an international marketing wing and we've been entertaining delegations from China for some years.

They've been seeing our stud farms and coming to our sales. What is particularly exciting about this is that this is the first deal of its kind done by the Chinese government. That is a big plus. They have been saying very nice things about us, that we are a world leader. The HRI message would be that Ireland is the best country in which to breed racehorses. Realistically, domestic demand has been quite flat since 2008. We have been conscious that, if we are going to get growth, it would be overseas. And this has great potential. A few years ago, our

export of Thoroughbreds were worth €200 million a year. They are talking about this project alone delivering €50 million in about three years' time, so that shows the scale of it."

Trainer Dermot Weld is in China at present as part of a delegation to help in the creation of the Tianjin Equine Culture City, which will encompass two racecourses, five training tracks, 150 training bases, 4,000 horse stalls, a horse clinic, international equestrian college and an auction house. It is expected that around 40 race days will take place next year.

Coolmore's J.P. Magnier commented, "We are delighted to be one of the first Irish companies to kick-start this partnership and represent Ireland's hugely successful horse breeding and racing industries. Today's announcement marks the culmination of huge efforts by the Irish Government and department of agriculture, led by Minister [Simon] Coveney, who have been trying to develop new Irish trade links with China.

The sector plays a huge part in the Irish economy, currently generating €1.1 billion annually. This industry is something we are good at, and today one of the biggest markets in the world has recognised that and has chosen to partner with Ireland." Coveney added, "Today's announcement of a partnership involving Ireland to develop a major racing and breeding operation in China arises from the preeminent position that Ireland holds in the Thoroughbred breeding world. This initiative should facilitate the development of a major export market for horses from Ireland and has the potential to provide a range of business opportunities for companies and individuals in Ireland who can bring a wide range of expertise to the project. Coolmore Stud is recognised as a world leader in Thoroughbred breeding and is to be commended for their involvement in this major project."

A TRUE BEAUTY

Kept to non-stakes events at two, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Beauty Parlour (GB)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) had something to prove in Sunday's G3 Prix de la Grotte, but backers at 6-4 hardly had a worry as she wowed the Longchamp crowds to remain unbeaten. Having made an indelible impression last term with two wins at Saint-Cloud by a cumulative margin of 11 1/2 lengths, the Wildenstein homebred's reputation saw her a warm order for this vital trial for the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches despite facing rivals with proven Pattern-race form and some intriguing prospects. Settled in fifth off the even early pace set by the free-running **Zantenda (GB)** (Zamindar), the imposing bay was angled wide as **Woven Lace (GB)** (Hard Spun) took the lead with a quarter mile remaining. Swamping that rival 100 meters later, she required only nudging along by Christophe Soumillon to score by 4 1/2 lengths. "I am relieved, as I always thought she was top-class and, although she had shown that already, you never know until they make that transition from two to three," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "She was brilliant today and is not yet 100%, so she will definitely come back for the Pouliches, and we'll take it race-by-race after that."

Toyota Blue Grass Top Three to Derby...

The top three finishers from Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. hit the road soon after the race. Heading the exodus was **Dullahan** (Even the Score), who shipped to Churchill Downs, while respective second- and third-place finishers, **Hansen** (Tapit) and **Gung Ho** (Kitten's Joy), returned to trainer Mike Maker's barn at the Trackside Training Center in Louisville. "He looks great this morning, like he hadn't run at all," trainer Dale Romans said of Dullahan, a half-brother to 2009 GI Kentucky Derby winner Mine That Bird (Birdstone). A winner of two of eight career starts--including last fall's GI Breeders' Futurity--the chestnut has recorded both wins on the Polytrack. "I think he will run well on dirt," said Romans. "He ran a big race [fourth] in the [GI] Breeders' Cup Juvenile [at Churchill] last fall and he is better this year. He should handle the surface." Maker confirmed Sunday morning that both Hansen and Gung Ho were doing well following their respective efforts. "Both of them got back safe and sound and are fine this morning," Maker said. "We are just going to soak it all in for now. I'm not sure where [Gung Ho] will run next, but the [May 4 GIII] American Turf [at Churchill] is among the possibilities."

Kentucky Derby Unlikely...

According to Whit Beckman, assistant to Todd Pletcher, **Heavy Breathing** (Giant's Causeway) exited a seventh-place effort in Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. in good order, but will likely skip the Kentucky Derby. "I think they are going to back off and give him a little time," said Beckman. Heavy Breathing, winner of a nine-panel \$75,000 optional claimer at Gulfstream Mar. 3, finished third in the Mar. 24 GIII Spiral S. prior to his Keeneland effort. "They had the Derby dream." **Ever So Lucky** (Indian Charlie) reportedly returned from his 10th-place Blue Grass effort fine, according to trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "We are going to regroup," Sheppard said. "We will get our heads together and come up with something." Trainer Gennadi Dorochenko confirmed that **Russian Greek** (Giant's Casueway)--11th in the Blue Grass and **Hero of Order** (Sharp Humor)--13th--were doing well and likely had an excuse for their poor performances. "They didn't like the Polytrack," said Dorochenko, who plans to race at Arlington Park, which also has Polytrack, this summer. "There are plenty of other racetracks. We will give it a couple of days and see [what's next]."

Following an impressive showing at Oaklawn Park Saturday afternoon, a quartet of Bob Baffert trainees appeared poised to push on to Louisville for their next engagements.

GI Kentucky Derby-bound **Bodemeister** (Empire Maker), runaway winner of the GI Arkansas Derby, and runner-up

Secret Circle (Eddington) are scheduled to join Wednesday's GII Fantasy S. heroine **Mamma Kimbo** (Discreet Cat) and

third-place finisher **Jemima's Pearl** (Distorted Humor) on a flight to Churchill Downs this morning. The fillies are slated to contest the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4.

In related news, Jim Barnes, long-time assistant to Baffert, accompanied GI Apple Blossom H. winner **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) and Northern Spur S. runner-up **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) on a flight back to California. Baffert shipped six horses to this year's Racing Festival of the South and came away with three graded stakes victories (including two Grade I's), two runner-up finishes and a third-place result.

"We took some really nice horses there," Baffert said Saturday. "They all ran well and had been training well."

Sabercat Kentucky Derby Bound...

Winchell Thoroughbreds' **Sabercat** (Bluegrass Cat), who bounced back from an eighth in the GII Rebel S. last month to finish third in the GI Arkansas Derby, is also expected to ship to Churchill Downs today. Trained by Steve Asmussen, the winner of last year's GIII Delta Jackpot S. had already secured enough graded stakes earnings to make it into the Kentucky Derby field, but needed to justify his presence there with a good showing in the nine-furlong prep.

"I was very pleased with it," confirmed Asmussen Saturday. "It was encouraging. It was the step in the right direction we were expecting and looking for--the move forward we needed. It looked like a very good experience for him. We needed to see improvement and at this time of year, that's the important thing in each start." Asmussen, who teamed up with jockey Corey Nakatani for five wins on Saturday's card, rounded out the meet with his fourth training title.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

It's Tricky to Phipps...

It's Tricky (Mineshaft), winner of Saturday's GII Distaff H., came out of her exertions no worse for wear, according to Art Magnuson, assistant to Kieran McLaughlin. "She really came out of it well," he said. "She wintered very well in Florida and it's nice to be able to stay home [and run]. She's already won two Grade 1s, so we didn't have to go chasing it. Let them come to us." As for what's next for the 4-year-old, Magnuson added, "It's Tricky's doing great; she came out of the race very well, ate well, she's happy. Simon Crisford and Jimmy Bell [of Godolphin] will make the final decision on what's next, but logically it looks like the Phipps [GI Ogden Phipps H. May 28 at Belmont Park]."

Daisy Devine to Distaff Turf Mile...

Daisy Devine (Kafwain), winner of Saturday's GI Jenny Wiley S., may make her next start in the May 5 GII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile, according to trainer Andrew McKeever. The filly is undefeated in four starts on the grass, including the GIII Pin Oak Valley View last fall. On Saturday's card, McKeever also saddled Street Serenade (Street Sense), who broke his maiden in the sixth race at Keeneland. Saturday's double gave McKeever four victories from six starters this meet, a total that leads all trainers. "It has been a great meet so far," McKeever said. "I also have two thirds, including **Ariana D** (Rock Slide), who was third in the GI Vinery Madison S." McKeever said the GIII Arlington Matron S. May 26 would be the likely next start for Ariana D.

That form had been given weight earlier in the afternoon when the runner-up annexed the G3 2000 Guineas Trial on this card and Light Heavy continued the momentum to book an early Derby ticket here. Settled in third early as Athens (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) set an honest pace, the chestnut worked his way to the front with a furlong remaining and had the race in safe keeping by the time Call To Battle emerged from the pack. Last year's G2 Beresford S. winner David Livingston (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) was sent off the 7-4 favorite despite his five-pound penalty, but looked rusty on his comeback and never threatened in fifth. "He'll come back here for the [May 13] G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial, all being well, and then he'll go for the G1 Irish Derby [at The Curragh June 30]."




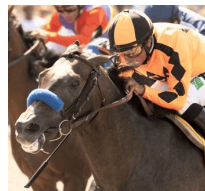
