Although unlikely to produce a starter for this year's GI Kentucky Derby, today's GIII Coolmore Lexington S. has still attracted a pretty solid field. Bourbon Lane

Stable's **Johannesbourbon** (Johannesburg), a dazzling 9 3/4-length debut winner going 6 1/2 furlongs at Turfway Park Mar. 25 ([video](#)), dives right into the deep end. "He ran a big Sheets number in his first race," trainer Kellyn Gorder said. "I know it was Turfway and we really didn't know what he beat." The runner-

up that day Potomac River (English Channel) stamped himself as one to watch with an impressive maiden victory over the Keeneland lawn earlier this week. "That validated the race a little bit," Gorder commented. "Mike McMahon and Jamie Hill had an idea of what they had. They thought they would have a shot at going into the Lexington if he ran as well as they thought he would."

Gorder also trains the unbeaten **"TDN Rising Star"** Bourbon Courage (Lion Heart) on behalf of McMahon and Hill's operation. Unbeaten **Summer Front** (War Front) makes his much-anticipated sophomore debut here. The Waterford Stable colorbearer won his first three starts on grass, including the \$100,000 Dania Beach S. at Gulfstream Park Dec. 18. "He is a very exciting prospect," trainer Christophe Clement told *Daily Racing Form*. "He has been impressive in every single race. He has been training brilliantly at Payson Park the last couple of months."

**UNION RAGS WORKS AT KEENELAND**

Chadds Ford Stable's **Union Rags** (Dixie Union) continued to tune up for the GI Kentucky Derby with a four-furlong move in :47.40 at Keeneland Friday. Under regular exercise rider Peter Brette, the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. hero posted fractions of :12, :24 and :35.80, and was out five furlongs in 1:00 ([video](#)). His previous four-furlong workout

took place at Palm Meadows Apr. 12. "I thought he went well," trainer Michael Matz said. "It was nothing spectacular, but he did it nice and galloped out fine. He was doing a two-minute lick before he got to the half-mile pole. It was a good work and we will ask more of him in his next work."

The handsome bay heads to the big one following a troubled third in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 31. Matz added that Union Rags would likely ship to Louisville in the middle of next week.

### BAFFERT SENDS PAIR FOR JEROME

Aqueduct main track. **Stirred Up** (Lemon Drop Kid) is favored at 2-1 on Eric Donovan's morning line. Favored when a distant third behind stablemate and **"TDN Rising Star"** Bodemeister (Empire Maker) going a mile for

the first time at Santa Anita Feb. 11, he held off a late run from Holy Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) to graduate Mar. 13 at the Arcadia oval. The \$420,000 KEESEP purchase gave a solid account of himself in his stakes debut last time out, finishing a clear third behind Daddy Nose Best (Scat Daddy) in the GIII Sunland Derby Mar. 25. Baffert's second string is **Brigand** (Flatter), the \$925,000 topper out of the 2011 OBS March sale who has been something of a disappointment for owner Kaleem Shah and remains eligible for a first-level allowance. **The Lumber Guy** (Grand Slam) cuts back to the one-turn mile off a pacesetting fifth in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7 and should be gunning for it from the inside post, but will have plenty of company up front. "It's back quicker than I'd like, but I'm anxious to run him in a one-turn mile," trainer Michael Hushion said. "I think that's the key, a one-turn mile. A rider can just come out there real quietly, wherever he wants to take him, and make them sort it out for a half mile down the backside."

### A GRIMM TALE

Britain's nasty weather and the prevalent soft ground at Newbury has already put paid to the chance of seeing **Top Offer (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and **Tales of Grimm** (Distorted Humor) in today's G3 Greenham S., but one who is not be dodging the testing footing is Michael Pescod's **Bronterre (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}). Successful on good-to-soft in the Listed Stardom S. in September, he was a place ahead of Thursday's impressive G3 Craven S. winner Trumpet Major (Ire) (Arakan) when fourth in a renewal of Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. that is working out well when last seen in October. "Bronterre looked to love the rain-softened ground when he won by five lengths at Goodwood last September, so he should be in his element in the conditions," commented Richard Hannon, who has won three of the last five renewals. "He was only beaten a length in the Dewhurst, finishing just behind Trumpet Major, who did the form no harm in the Craven, so we have to be hopeful. Bronterre worked well with Trumpet Major when they went to Newbury for an away day recently and he seems in very good form." **Caspar Netscher (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}) has already proven his liking for this track when successful in the G2 Mill Reef S. over six furlongs in September, but has stamina to prove after a last-out eighth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf over a mile at Churchill Downs. Andrew Balding puts forward Thurloe Thoroughbreds' **Spiritual Star (GB)** (Soviet Star), who tempted connections into a supplementary entry for the Dewhurst with a six-length success in a seven-furlong maiden at Newmarket in September. Despite coming up short on the big occasion when seventh, he was only beaten just over four lengths, and that race's also-rans Trumpet Major, Red Duke (Hard Spun) and Ektihaam (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) have all boosted the form this year. "I'm very happy with him and I think he's improved a lot since last year--he's a fine-looking, strong 3-year-old type," Balding said yesterday. "He's a high-quality horse at home and the question mark is the ground, but it's the same for all of them, and if he goes on it he'll go very well. He was too free in the Dewhurst and probably, in hindsight, it came too soon after his maiden win. He has a very bright future, and this might not be the best guide, as it will be run on soft ground, but I hope he handles it."

### UNFAVORABLE TERMS?

Robert Barnett's **Best Terms (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) is not a certain starter for today's G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury, with the soft ground causing connections some anxiety. Having coped with good-to-soft when winning the G2 Lowther S. at York in August, the diminutive homebred is not built for deep conditions, especially as this trip is an unknown. "Will Edmeades, racing manager to the Barnetts who own Best Terms, has always been for going straight for the Guineas, so if we are not happy with the ground we will wait for Newmarket," trainer Richard Hannon said of the homebred, who was a latest fifth in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in September. "Best Terms has not grown since last year, but she has been working very well up at Everleigh and she is fit enough. We think that she will stay the seven [furlongs] and she switches off at home, which is encouraging, but we won't know about the mile until we get to Newmarket." Mick Channon has done well with his 3-year-old fillies so far this term and **Fillionaire (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) is held in high regard at West Ilsley. Last seen finishing third in the Listed Radley S. over this track and trip in October, she is owned by Ann Black who is also a partner in the recent Kempton conditions scorer Laugh Out Loud (GB) (Clodovil {Ire}).

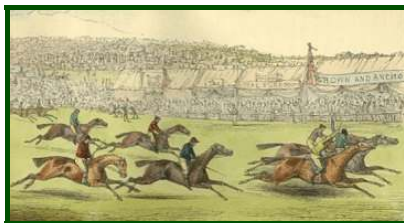

He's got to lift his game to run well in a Guineas, but I think he's a definite group horse."

## Fencing Confirmed for Guineas Test...

Trainer John Gosden yesterday announced that **Fencing** (Street Cry {Ire}) will run in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Due to prep in today's G3 Greenham S. at Newbury, George Strawbridge's G1 Racing Post Trophy third-place finisher suffered a late setback and will head straight to the May 5 Newmarket Classic. "He did a very nice piece of work, but a shoe came back and the clip went into his foot," his conditioner told *PA Sport*. "He's fit, but you can't run him and I didn't declare him for the Greenham. ## No Rush with 'Rain'...

"We found some chips in her joint after she came back from Japan," trainer William Haggas's wife Maureen explained. "She's at home recuperating now and, as rehabilitation for these sort of injuries is very important, there is no hurry with the races in the autumn and winter in mind."

## Igugu to Enter Quarantine for Dubai...

Trainer Mike de Kock revealed yesterday that reigning South African Horse of the Year **Igugu (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}) will be among those entering quarantine May 6 in order to compete in next year's Dubai Carnival. Due to protocol designed to control African Horse Sickness, Igugu, along with recent Sheikh Hamdan acquisition **The Apache (SAf)** (Mogok) and a number of other de Kock runners, will spend 19 days at the Kenilworth Quarantine Station, then 90 days in Mauritius and another month in the U.K. The Apache, a multiple Group 1 winner last year, will be sent to Hong Kong, rather than Dubai like the rest of his stablemates. "For Igugu and others to be able to compete internationally at the end of the year and next year in Dubai we have no choice but to make early arrangements to get them out of the country as soon as we can, which is about now," de Kock explained. "It's really ridiculous, but we cannot take the chance of waiting until after the [Durban] July, for example. We're following the export protocol as it stands right now."

## HUGHES APPEAL DISMISSED

Richard Hughes yesterday learned that his appeal against the decision of the British Horseracing Authority to uphold a lengthy ban handed out in India has failed. Despite attempts to lessen the 50-day suspension handed out in February for not following the instructions of the trainer of one of his mounts, the high-profile rider will have to wait until Apr. 29 to resume duties. Jamie Stier, Director of Raceday Operations and Regulation for the BHA, said in a statement, "The BHA stands behind the principle of reciprocity of penalties among recognised international racing bodies. Without reciprocity there is a risk of there being no effective measures to deter visiting participants from breaching the rules of the respective authority. However, we will be looking to see if there are any lessons to learn which may assist the handling of such matters in the future."

**BRUNETTI CHALLENGE TO MONMOUTH LEASE DISMISSED**

A complaint filed by John Brunetti, owner of Hialeah Park, seeking to re-open the bidding process on the lease to operate New Jersey's Monmouth Park has been dismissed. The Board of Commissioners of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority received a 37-page document Thursday afternoon from its hearing officer Mark Stefanacci saying that Brunetti's challenge was without merit, upholding the decision to give control of the track to the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association. The organization was granted the right to lease Monmouth Mar. 1, but soon afterwards, Brunetti, who operates Red Oak Stable with a string at Monmouth, challenged the decision, suggesting that the terms of that lease were dramatically different than those he had been offered in an initial request for proposals. On Monday, Brunetti also argued before the board that political contributions made by the NJTHA, a not-for-profit organization, precluded them from being awarded the lease under the state of New Jersey's pay-to-play restrictions. The NJTHA argued that, as a not-for-profit, is was not bound by the same rules as a business entity. Brunetti also acknowledged campaign contributions of his own. The NJSEA board met behind closed doors Thursday and accepted Stefanacci's recommendations at that time, but did not disclose their action until New Jersey Governor Chris Christie gave his approval. The governor signed off on the minutes Friday afternoon. Through his attorneys, Brunetti indicated that he might appeal the decision if the agreement was not overturned, but it was not clear Friday what other legal remedies he might seek, if any. Monmouth Park is scheduled to a 71-day meeting Saturday, May 12.


