A Rags to Riches Story...

All Squared Away couldn't get it squared away in lower-level maiden taggers at Hollywood last spring and summer, finishing a debut fourth for \$40,000 May 5, third May 26 and runner-up June 9. Away a little more than six months, the bargain-basement purchase missed by a head when third in his Dec. 17 comeback in Inglewood, then shipped to Northern California to graduate by a length going two turns at Golden Gate Jan. 22. Seventh after leading to the three-eighths point of the Gill El Camino Real Derby in Albany Feb. 18, he shed blinkers and was second in a Mar. 15 starter-allowance at Santa Anita ahead of his Turfway engagement, which came just nine days later. Past performance is not necessarily indicative of future results, but the tote read 70-1 at post time here.

Tough It Out...

Gill Southwest S. winner **Castaway** (Street Sense), a drifter in the market, was fractious in the stalls, but was ridden for speed once the gates were sprung and rushed up to join impressive Turfway maiden winner **Johannesbourbon** (Johannesburg) and **Hammers Terror** (Artie Schiller) in a three-pronged war on the front end. All Squared Away was trapped outside that trio and

four deep into the clubhouse turn before dropping in a bit to let the pacesetters break the wind. The longshot was still traveling comfortably just off the pace and edged back out to the four path, just beating favored **Summer Front** (War Front) to that spot and forcing that one a touch

wider into the far turn. Castaway dropped away tamely with about three furlongs to race, and Johannesbourbon and Hammers Terror boxed on gamely into the stretch. But, despite doing it tough most of the way, All Squared Away came off the heels of Hammers Terror at the sixteenth pole and staved off a late run from Summer Front for the upset.

"Since the horse got here--as most horses do when they get to Keeneland--this horse just flourished," Ward offered. "He just put a lot of weight on. He's eaten the bottom out of the feed tub. When we worked him, the last couple of works have been just outstanding. He's just thriving being here."

Jerome S. cont.

A couple of New York-breds, one produced at home and the other an expensive acquisition at the sales, came to settle Saturday's GII Jerome S. at Aqueduct, with The Lumber Guy outslugging California raider Brigand in the final graded event of the meet. The Lumber Guy, hailing from Barry K. Schwartz's formidable Stonewall operation, chopped down a field of state-bred maidens by 9 1/4 lengths in his six-furlong debut over the inner track Jan. 28 and promptly followed with a handy 4 1/4-length tally in Laurel's Miracle Wood S. over seven panels Feb. 25. No one could fault connections for taking a shot at the nine furlongs of the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7, and while he dropped back after a moderate six furlongs, he was far from disgraced in finishing fifth, beaten just over a half-dozen lengths.

The Jerome field was off to a level dispatch, and Brigand, the \$925,000 OBS March topper in 2011, led narrowly from The Lumber Guy as they hooked up with the course proper, and the two set sail through an opening quarter in :22.98, a smart opening split over the strip. The well-backed Adirondack King (Lawyer Ron) and favored Stirred Up were the back markers and had plenty of running to do, as the pacesetters got to the half-mile marker in a demanding :45.83. Still locked in battle as they reached the quarter pole, both The Lumber Guy and Brigand were beginning to show some fatigue, but nothing was coming to get them from behind, and the former was actually going further clear from the runner-up at the wire.

A maiden winner in three starts for Glen Hill Farm and trainer Tom Proctor, Capital Plan was fourth in her first go for this barn at Del Mar Sept. 1 before clearing her first allowance condition over this course and distance Oct. 21. The bay followed with a victory over the Hollywood Cushion Track Dec. 14, but could do no better than fifth in the Jan. 22 GII La Canada S. over this dirt course. Second at odds-on in a Tapeta allowance at Golden Gate Feb. 10, she entered this off a near-miss second going a grassy mile here Mar. 15. Settled in midfield down the hill and past the stands for the first time, Capital Plan pulled Brice Blanc up into second as Glowing Spirit (Brz) (Crimson Tide {Ire}) tried to drop anchor up front. She began to reel in the pacesetter leaving the half-mile pole and led midway on the turn, but was confronted by a trio of rivals to her outside. Capital Plan cut the corner beautifully into the stretch, pinched a bit of a break on her rivals and won the sprint to the judge. “[Trainer] Jerry [Hollendorfer] told me to play it by ear,” Blanc stated. “On paper, it looked like the one [Hard Seven] and the three [Glowing Spirit] were going to be the speed of the race. When everybody looked for cover on the front side I kind of just let my filly lope along and I just got a beautiful spot. I felt the momentum from there and I asked her to pick it up. She really responded and took off the last three-sixteenths.

The always-dangerous California Flag, currently in the twilight of his career, has now registered a black-type victory in his fifth straight season after a confident score here. The veteran broke a four-race winless skid when he won last year's GIII Monrovia S. over course and distance last October, but he could do no better than 12 of 14 in the GII Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Churchill in November. Sharp off the five-month break, the gray was up to lead and went unchallenged through :21.89 and :43.25 splits. He came into the lane with a roughly two-length lead and never let them closer. "He didn't spurt away quite as far as I thought he would, but he just kept on going today," said trainer Brian Koriner. "It was nice. [Jockry] Joe [Talamo] went ahead and let him show his class. He wasn't exactly flying today, because he's seen crazy fractions coming down the hill before. It was nice to see him back. I love the horse, and when I was being interviewed a couple days ago, I predicted that he would win this race. I just thought the horse would win because he's doing really good and is super sound. The horse just loves what he's doing."

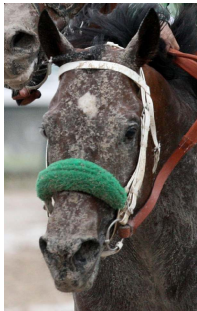

Greenham S. cont.

Like many who show their best form in the six-furlong contests as a juvenile, Caspar Netscher had stamina to prove in Newbury's G3 Greenham S. as connections dreamed about the 2000 Guineas. In a renewal which lost much intrigue with the defections of Top Offer (GB) (Dansili {GB}) and Tales of Grimm (Distorted Humor), Charles Wentworth's G2 Gimcrack S. and G2 Mill Reef S. winner stepped up to fill the void, and did little harm to his Classic prospects with a relatively impressive success. Settled in third of the five-strong field by Shane Kelly early, the 3-1 second choice showed a turn of acceleration rare on a day when testing ground had blunted speed to pick up Boomerang Bob a furlong out and win by a length. "He'd got the best form in the race," trainer Alan McCabe told *PA Sport*. "He didn't relish the ground, but he wanted to win."

Caspar Netscher began his career with a win over Beverley's stiff five-furlong trip in May and, despite some solid efforts in black-type company during a busy spell, began to emerge as a leading force when third in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood at the end of July. Building on that effort to win the G2 Gimcrack S. at York the following month, the bay defied a subsequent

penalty to add the G2 Mill Reef S. to his resume here in September and book a ticket to the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket the next month. Despite finishing fifth in that highlight, he emerged with great credit as he produced an impressive rally from too far off the pace

to be beaten just over a length. Although he had failed to shine at his first try over further than six when eighth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in November, the evidence of lacking staying power remained inconclusive as that run came at the end of a hectic campaign. Switched off early by Shane Kelly, he was held on to as Boomerang Bob and the 8-11 favorite Bronterre (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) engaged in battle ahead. That proved a smart move by his rider, as his late swoop was unable to be countered by the game runner-up and eventual third, who had damaged his chances of seeing out this test by pulling hard early. "He improved all of last year and he's still improving from what we have seen," Alan McCabe added. "He's got to go for the G1 2000 Guineas [at Newmarket May 5], and Charles [Wentworth] had an agreement that whoever rode him in the Greenham will ride him in the Guineas."

Moonstone Magic, who only appeared eight days ago when successful by eight lengths over this trip on soft ground at Leicester, was the darkest of dark horses entering this 1000 Guineas trial. Settled in rear early five lengths off the pace set by the over-exuberant favorite Best Terms (GB) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), the homebred made easy progress through the testing conditions as Radio Gaga took over before the quarter pole. That duo had the race between them from there, but it was Moonstone Magic who started to assert approaching the furlong marker, and she was able to draw clear under mainly hand riding for an emphatic win. Like Wednesday's G3 Nell Gwyn S. winner Esentepe (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}), Moonstone Magic is not entered in the May 6 Newmarket Classic, but the Irish equivalent three weeks later could be on the cards. Her jockey believes she will make her mark in better company. "We really liked her before she ran at Leicester and I fell in love with her there, as she ran like an old handicapper and never batted an eyelid," Jim Crowley said. "My only worry today was that the ground would dry out too much. There is a very strong headwind and she was in it for a long way when I pulled her out, but she has a very laid-back attitude and was idling in front. She wouldn't want fast ground, but she is definitely a filly going places and, hopefully, she can keep progressing, as she's a big bird and is just starting to fill her frame." Best Terms put a large dent in the 1000 Guineas hopes of her connections with a tame fifth after pulling too hard early.



I think we're the horse to beat in the race." **Dhaamer (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) looms an upset chance if he transfers his main-track form back to the turf. Winner of a couple of handicaps overseas when under the care of John Gosden, the chestnut made an auspicious U.S. debut, missing by a neck in the GIII Tokyo City S. going 12 furlongs on the dirt Mar. 24.

He was six lengths adrift of Excelebration when runner-up in the G3 Hungerford S. at Newbury in August, but he has put up some of his best performances when campaigned abroad and managed to beat Sahpresa (Sahm) in the G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly in June 2009.

He doesn't do too much in the morning, saving it all for the afternoon. It looks like he came back out of that race feeling good. Hammy has him peaking at the right time." Fourth, beaten just a length in the GII Remsen S. last November, Done Talking was a well-beaten 10th behind Hansen (Tapit) in the GIII Gotham S. in his seasonal debut Mar. 3 prior to his win at Hawthorne.

Went the Day Well Goes Well at Keeneland...

Team Valor International and Mark Ford's GIII Vinery Spiral S. hero **Went the Day Well** (Proud Citizen) worked six furlongs in the company of stablemate Crimson China (Giant's Causeway) Saturday morning at Keeneland, covering the distance in 1:14.45 over the Polytrack ([video](#)). Went the Day Well broke off about a half-length behind Crimson China, drew on even terms on the turn and was about a half-length ahead at the finish. “It was a very good work, he went really well,” commented jockey John Velazquez, who won the 2011 Derby aboard Team Valor’s Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). “I asked him to do a little more at the wire because he was content to stay with the other horse,” the rider added. “He worked well and very easy and I know the mile and a quarter [of the Kentucky Derby] won’t hurt him at all.” Unlike Animal Kingdom, Went the Day Well is a winner on the dirt going into the Derby, though trainer Graham Motion is not entirely certain what the colt’s best surface is. “I don’t know if he is not better on dirt. He’s a nice horse, an improving horse,” he explained. “I know he will be a longshot, but I feel good about running him in the Derby.”

Rousing Sermon Tunes Up at Hollywood...

Mr. and Mrs. Larry Williams’s **Rousing Sermon** (Lucky Pulpit), who only this week was confirmed a Derby participant, breezed seven furlongs Saturday morning over the Cushion Track at Hollywood Park in 1:27.60. Working alone with exercise rider Marco Ramirez, the homebred galloped out a mile in a strong 1:41, trainer Jerry Hollendorfer told *Daily Racing Form*. Hollywood clockers had the final three furlongs in :36.80. “He finished up really well,” Hollendorfer told the *Form*. “He did it real easily and it was a real nice work.” Out of the top three just once in his nine-race career, the Cal Cup Juvenile winner was a rallying second in last year’s GI CashCall Futurity and was last seen finishing an anti-bias third in the GII Louisiana Derby Apr. 1. Hollendorfer told *DRF* that he has yet to firm up a rider for the Derby and that he may turn in his next work over the Churchill main track.

Reveron Out of Derby Consideration...

The overachieving **Reveron** (Songandaprayer), runner-up to Take Charge Indy (A.P. Indy) in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 31, has been removed from Kentucky Derby consideration after a condylar fissure was diagnosed in his left fore following a Saturday morning breeze at Calder Race Course. “The horse worked great this morning,” trainer Agustin Bezara stated through an interpreter after Reveron went a mile in 1:46. “We brought him back to the barn and while we were giving him a bath, we noticed he was a bit off in the left front. We had him x-rayed and it came back showing a fissure near the ankle. The good news is that it isn’t a fracture, and that it’s not a career-ending injury,” the trainer continued. “But obviously the Derby is out.” Reveron has never been off the board in his seven career starts, including an 8-1 upset of the Gulfstream Park Derby New Year’s Day followed by a good third in the GIII Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 4. In the Florida Derby he finished a neck ahead of Union Rags (Dixie Union). Owned by Stipa Racing Stable, Reveron was 23rd on the graded-stakes earnings list, but was expected to gain a berth in the Derby due to recent defections. He will get about two months off before returning to training. He’s done so much for me, he deserves a rest and that’s what he’ll get now,” Bezara added.

Trinniberg on to the Big Dance...

One of the leading sprinters of his generation this season with impressive front-running victories in the GIII Swale S. and GIII Bay Shore S., Shivananda Racing’s **Trinniberg** (Teufflesberg) will try to stretch his speed a Classic distance, as *Daily Racing Form* confirms that connections will enter the colt in the Run for the Roses. It will be his first start beyond seven furlongs. What convinced owner Shivananda Parbhoo to run? “You want to know the reason,” Parbhoo asked lightheartedly. “Secret Circle (Eddington). When he came out of the race [due to a reported sesamoid injury], that’s what did it for me. With him out of the race, I know there isn’t another horse in the race with the kind of speed my horse has.” A debut maiden winner last summer at Calder, Trinniberg was runner-up in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. Sept. 5 and in the GII Nashua S. Oct. 2 before a seventh to Secret Circle in the inaugural Breeders’ Cup Juvenile Sprint Nov. 4. His two wins this year have come by a combined nine lengths.

but luckily he has developed into a relaxed traveller, and seems to enjoy clocking up his air miles." It will be Cityscape's second trip to Hong Kong, having finished a desperately unlucky second off a brutally wide trip in last year's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile Dec. 11. The Champions Mile could also attract G2 Godolphin Mile winner **African Story (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) and reigning Hong Kong Horse of the Year **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}).

Frankel Canters...

Khalid Abdullah's **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) is back cantering as he completes his recovery from last week's injury to his right foreleg. With a planned return in G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19 in the mind of Sir Henry Cecil, the unbeaten world highweight was back in action on the grass in Newmarket. "He's fine, he did two canters yesterday and two canters this morning," Cecil told *PA Sport*. "Hopefully, I will get him ready for the Lockinge. He is usually better for his first run, and I don't want him to go straight into the big races in the summer."

Amazombie to Return to Churchill...

California-bred **Amazombie** (Northern Fleet) will ship away from the Golden State and a date in the \$125,000 Tiznow S. Apr. 28 and will instead make his next appearance in the \$400,000 GII Churchill Downs S. May 5. Amazombie's last race beneath the Twin Spires resulted in a championship-clinching score in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint last November. "I talked to Tom Cruise," joked trainer Bill Spawr, who owns the 6-year-old California-bred with partner Tom Sanford, "and he said, 'Show me the money!' Seriously, Amazombie is doing great, he likes Churchill and the money was a major factor." Amazombie exits a score in Santa Anita's GII Potrero Grande S. Apr. 7.

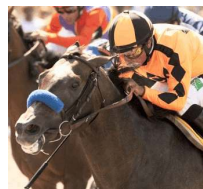
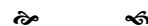
