ON THE BOURBON TRAIL

Churchill Downs kicks off its spring meet with a strong renewal of the \$200,000 Gill Cliff's Edge Derby Trial, which will be run under the lights tonight. **TDN Rising Star** **Kentucky Bourbon** (Lion Heart) looked like he might be any kind with a pair of easy wins going six furlongs at Fair Grounds. He earned respective Beyer Speed Figures of 103 and 101 for those efforts, and stretches out to a one-turn mile following a

Mar. 24 optional claiming victory in the Big Easy. "We're going to lead him over there with quite a bit of confidence," trainer Kellyn Gorder told *Daily Racing Form*. "The outside post is just fine. I think it's better than getting one down on the inside." Trainer Bob Baffert has shipped **Paynter** (Awesome Again) in from California. After earning **TDN Rising Star** status in his career debut going 5 1/2 panels at Santa Anita Feb. 18, the Zayat colorbearer gave an honest account of himself when fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 7. "He's a good colt," Baffert told *DRF*. "We've just kind of taken our time with him, let him tell us when to run him."

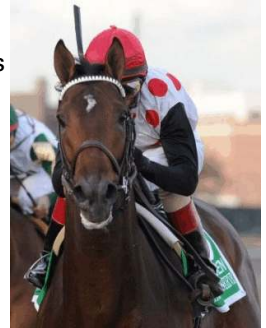

BACK AT BELMONT

New York racing makes its long-awaited shift to Belmont this afternoon, and a trio of Grade I winners face off in the meet's traditional opener, the Gill Westchester H. at a flat mile. The morning-line favorite is Live Oak's **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini), who capped his sophomore season with a win in the GI Cigar Mile H. at the end of November at Aqueduct. Trainer Bill Mott indicated that the colt's first major target this season is the GI Metropolitan H. on Memorial Day, but the 4-year-old has been training strongly for his return. "He put on a lot of weight, filled out, and matured a lot," said Mott. "He definitely needs a race to get going, I am sure. Our early goal for this part of the season would be the Met Mile. You always have to have something to shoot for, and that's what we're shooting for at first." Also in the field are the 2010 Cigar Mile victor **Jersey Town** (Speightstown), who is coming off a good second in an overnight stakes at Gulfstream Mar. 31 in his seasonal bow; and **Boys At Tosconova** (Officer), the 2010 GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. hero who is working his way back up the class ladder. Sidelined following a second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the dark bay was third to Tapizar (Tapit) in his Oct. 8 comeback at Belmont. He has since rattled off three straight, including a narrow score over subsequent Grade I-winning filly Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) in a one-mile optional claimer at Gulfstream Jan. 27.

GRADED/GROUP PREVIEWS

SECOND CHANCE

Beaten but unbowed on his seasonal return, **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) is back at the helm nine days after that reversal in today's G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown. Khalid Abdullah's four-time Group 1 winner may have needed his reintroduction when a head second to Questioning (Ire) (Elusive Quality)--second in yesterday's G2 Sandown Mile--in Newmarket's G3 Earl of Sefton S., and returns to the track and trip over which he won the 2010 G1 Eclipse S. He is joined by stable companion **World Domination** (Empire Maker), who earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status on his debut at Newbury last April before finishing fourth in the G2 Dante S. at York the following month and sustaining an injury in Royal Ascot's G2 King Edward VII S. He has been the subject of rave reviews from the Newmarket gallop watchers this spring, and has always been held in the highest regard by trainer Sir Henry Cecil. Juddmonte Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "Twice Over was a bit rusty at Newmarket in the Earl of Sefton. On the gallops at home, he seems to retain all his old enthusiasm and, in him and Famous Name (GB) (Dansili {GB}), we've been blessed with two incredibly tough and consistent horses who have held their form for years. He won't mind the cut in the ground, I don't think, but this will be ground for specialists, some will go on it and some won't. World Domination was impressive in his maiden at Newbury and we all got a bit excited, what with his name and everything. Ground-wise, we'll have to have a look at it and I'll talk to Henry. There is a small chance he might not run. He's beautifully bred, out of [MG1SW] Reams of Verse (Nurevey), and she won an Oaks in soft ground, but he's by Empire Maker and his progeny tend to want good ground. He's done well over the winter and he's a gorgeous horse." Godolphin saddle two headed by **Hunter's Light (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who looked a colt who was progressing last term when signing off with wins in the Listed Foundation S. at Goodwood in September and Listed Churchill S. on Lingfield's Polytrack in November. "Hunter's Light looks to be in good form at the moment and his latest piece of work went well," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "He won a couple of Listed races over this distance last season and I am hopeful of another good run."

READY TO RULE

Ballydoyle's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) makes his return in today's G3 Sandown Classic Trial which has lost some luster as a Derby prep in recent times. Once used as a warm-up by subsequent Classic heroes Troy (GB), Henbit, Shergar (Ire), Shahrastani and Old Vic (GB), it still has the propensity to produce future stars such as Pentire (GB), Fantastic Light and Sakhee. Imperial Monarch proved his ability to handle testing conditions on debut over a mile at The Curragh in September, but faces his first acid test against proven rivals here. Julie Wood's **Rougemont (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) beat some smart types in Newmarket's Apr. 19 £250,000 Tattersalls Millions 3-Y-O Trophy over this trip, while Khalid Abdullah's **Stipulate (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) had also shone at the Craven meeting a day earlier when stamping his authority on the nine-furlong Listed Feilden S. The former's trainer Richard Hannon said, "He did well physically through the winter and has matured, as you would expect of a son of Montjeu, and we know that he stays and acts in the soft, so he ought to have a decent chance."

Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Lord Grimthorpe is worried about the ground conditions for Stipulate. "He's by Dansili, who does have winners on heavy ground, but Dansili has winners on any ground really," he told *PA Sport*. "We'll have to check the ground on Friday and see how it is. I think this is ground for specialists. Stipulate has a 10-furlong pedigree, he doesn't have a pedigree which suggests he'll be going over a mile and a half, so at this moment in time we are not looking at him as a Derby horse." John Gosden has won this a record six times and relies on George Strawbridge's **Thought Worthy** (Dynaformer), a full-brother to the 2007 G1 St Leger hero Lucarno and winner of a mile Newcastle maiden on his sole outing in October.

'THINK' OUT OF GANAY PICTURE

Tomorrow's G1 Prix Ganay was robbed of much interest yesterday after Aidan O'Brien scratched **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) and his two supporting entries for the Longchamp highlight. With the ground set to ride extremely testing, the eight-time Group 1 winner will be kept at home, leaving a field of six and featuring just the one overseas challenger in **Wigmore Hall (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}). Mark Hawtin's 5-year-old has raced away from his native Britain on nine of the last 10 occasions, and those travels have yielded a win in the G2 Jebel Hatta and G1 Northern Dancer Turf S. and a third in the G1 Dubai Duty Free last year. Finishing strongly in customary fashion when a las-outt fourth in this year's renewal of the Duty Free at Meydan Mar. 31, he will be ridden by Hayley Turner. "I saw So You Think was in the entries, but he's not running now, which is a shame in a way, as he would have had a pacemaker, which would have really helped Wigmore Hall," she commented. "Those familiar with the horse will know he doesn't break from the stalls that well, so has to be dropped in and needs a strong pace to make his challenge. He ran a solid race to come fourth behind Cityscape (GB) (Selkirk) in Dubai, especially when you consider he was drawn widest of all the runners. He was a little unlucky in that respect, although I don't think anyone would have got close to the winner that day."

Apr. 11, will not contest the GI Kentucky Oaks next Friday. “We’re going to give her an extra two weeks,” said trainer Bob Baffert. “She ran really hard in that race and it was only her second start. It’s taken her a little bit longer to bounce out. She’s doing well.” The Peachtree colorbearer will now target the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 18.

On Fire Baby (Smoke Glacken) continued her preparations for the GI Kentucky Oaks by working seven furlongs in 1:27 early yesterday morning at Churchill. BASS GOES FISHING FOR TWO TOP LOTS

Trainer Mike Bass held sway on the opening session of the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale, when he picked up two of a trio of R1.25-million (US\$161,621) lots. The first through the ring, Lot 133, an impressive full-brother to G3 Al Rashidiya S. hero Silver Mist (SAf) (Western Winter), drew some heavy hitters to the ring and before long, bidding passed the half-million rand mark. Bloodstock agent John Freeman capitulated at R750,000, and in the end, it became a duel between Michael Azzie and Bass, ending with the latter's winning bid.

Bass was acting on behalf of Marsh Shirtliff, the owner of former stable legend Pocket Power (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}). "He's a full-brother to a really good horse who finished just a head behind Pocket Power in the 2006 G1 Queen's Plate," Shirtliff commented. "I will probably race him in a syndicate."

Shirtliff is also owns the colt's year-younger half-brother Ze Kaizer (Ger) (Silvano {Ger}), which topped the 2011 Equimark Vintage sale at R700,000. "We're very happy with him, he appears to have considerable ability," he added.

Consigned by Wilgerbosdrift, the colt is the seventh foal out of Palace Bride (Aus) (Palace Music), also the dam also of this season's G2 Merchants S. hero Shades Of Indigo (SAf) (Indigo Magic {GB}). Palace Bride died after producing a Tiger Ridge filly in 2011.

Towards the end of the session, Bass again emerged triumphant, this time for lot 242, a son of G1 Vosburgh S. hero Trippi, whose impact as a freshman sire in South Africa can only be described as sensational. Drakenstein Stud offered a September-foaled bay out of G1 Empress Club S. victress Stratos (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}), whose first foal Abercrombie (SAf), also by Trippi, sold for R1.8-

million as a yearling and recently broke his maiden second time out for the Bass stable.

Also weighing in at R1.25-million was lot 196, a grey son of champion juvenile sire Captain Al (SAf).

Consigned by Klawervlei Stud as agent, the cracking colt will eventually find his way to Hong Kong, specifically to the stables of former South African champion trainer Tony Millard, who is now firmly part of the Hong Kong training establishment. He outduelled Mike de Kock for the full-brother to juvenile filly All Is Secret (SAf), an impressive debut winner.

The colt is the third foal of multiple Group 2 winner Secret Of Victoria (SAf) (Goldkeeper), whose five winning siblings include ill-fated classic winner Rabiya (SAf) (Jallad) and his stakes-winning sister Rafiya (SAf), as well as G3 Fillies Nursery victress Spring Lilac (SAf) (Joshua Dancer). They are out of the fine matron Mystic Spring (Ire) (Royal Academy), who hails from the family of English 2000 Guineas hero Mystiko.

The Beginnings of Dynasty...

Former Horse of the Year Dynasty (SAf) was responsible for the day's only other seven-figure lot and, fittingly, it was Karoo breeder David Southey who hit pay dirt for lot 190, an as-yet unnamed half-brother to the six-time winner The White Horse (SAf) (Grey Eminence {Ire}). The classy colt, knocked down for an even R1 million, was the subject of a spirited bidding battle, and he was eventually knocked down to trainer Sean Tarry, who was bidding on behalf of new owner Michael Javett. Southey was quick to congratulate the purchaser. "He has never had a day's illness; in fact, this is a colt that when you see him first thing in the morning, he puts a smile on your face," he explained.

Contrary to many who held that Trippi fillies would be all the rage, having already sired three stakes-winning fillies in his first local crop, it was a colt who became the stallion's highest-priced youngster of the session. Consigned by Roski Stud, hip 165 was knocked down to Form Bloodstock at R900,000. The colt's dam, G3 Debutante S. victress Rambo's Love (SAf) (Rambo Dancer), hails from the extended family of European champion juvenile Embassy (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who emulated her dam Pass the Peace (Ire) by claiming victory in the G1 Cheveley Park S.

The session's most expensive filly proved to be lot [235](#), a daughter of Black Minnaloushe, the sire of U.S. Grade I winners Black Mamba (NZ) and Dancing In Silks. She fetched R800,000 and had the obvious attraction of being a half-sister to a pair of Oaks winners, Arcola (SAf) (Caesour) and Princess Of Light (SAf) (Var). She was also a granddaughter of another Oaks winner, the Argentine import Arcola (Mariache).


Not Always Smooth Sailing...

In what proved to be a tough, grin-and-bear-it start to the day, the sale did strengthen as the session progressed. Nevertheless, when the shutters came down on the day's trading, final figures revealed a 12% drop in aggregate from R48,675,000 to R42,975,000, while the average for the 179 lots sold had declined marginally from R249,615 to R240,084.


Jan Naude, Bloodstock SA's CEO, had the final say. "Although I was somewhat disappointed with the day's returns, we look forward to [Sunday], as there are still a number of outstanding lots waiting to be sold," he said.
