## ON TO PREAKNESS FOR DERBY HERO

**I'll Have Another** (Flower Alley) came out of his win in Saturday's G1 Kentucky Derby in fine shape and is expected to ship to Baltimore this afternoon to prepare for the May 19 G1 Preakness S. "He looks great this morning and a key thing is he ate up last night after the race," said trainer Doug O'Neill, who added Sunday the Derby victory represented "the highest of the highs."

O'Neill is confident his charge has what it takes to make it through the grueling Triple Crown series in top form. "I think he is the kind of horse who can maintain his form and keep it going," he explained.

Of his early arrival at Pimlico, O'Neill commented, "I want to do whatever is in the best interest of the horse. On paper, getting there early made sense. As long as the track is open and they let us train on it, we're in. We're looking forward to getting to Baltimore."

Also making the trip to Pimlico will be I'll Have Another's stable pony, multi-millionaire Lava Man. "He has taken three horses to the post," O'Neill said of Lava Man. "They won the G1 Santa Anita Derby, the G1 Kentucky Derby and a horse I ran here Friday, Unex Dali (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), who ran second on Friday, but thinks he won. Lava Man makes a pretty good caddie." **Cont. p9**

**Homecoming Queen Rules the Guineas (cont. from p1)**

Warming up for this by taking the seven-furlong G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial Apr. 15, Susan Magnier's Homecoming Queen, a 3/4-sister to Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill), led from the outset and kept surging clear to record the second-longest winning distance in the race's history. Starscope (GB) (Selkirk) emerged best from the chasing pack to be second, with the 13-8 favorite Maybe a further length back in third.

Much like the stable's multiple top-level scorer of 2007 Peeping Fawn (Danehill), Homecoming Queen did all her learning on the track during the formative stage of her career and took eight starts to get off the mark. When doing so, in a modest seven-furlong Fairyhouse nursery in mid-September, she showed what she was capable of when asked to stretch from an early part of the race and those tactics almost earned her a black-type success in the G3 C L Weld Park S. over that trip at The Curragh a week later. Second to Coral Wave (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) on that occasion, she returned to that venue to win the Listed Lanwades & Staffordstown Studs S. over a mile the next month and was last to finish on the Churchill dirt in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' in November. Only ninth on her comeback in the G3 Park Express S. over a mile back at The Curragh Mar. 25, the bay upset Fire Lily (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) in the G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial and was underestimated once again by the crowds who assumed she would merely set the pace for Maybe.

Like quicksilver from the gates after the lengthy hold-up, she had established more than a two-length lead by halfway and had already inflicted major damage by the time she reached the quarter pole safely clear. Her sectional splits from over the third, fourth and fifth furlongs of :11.57, :12.01 and :12.13 showed that she had already killed off all opposition if she could maintain her momentum to the line. Despite rolling right onto the far rail running downhill, she never looked like giving up any ground and stayed well beyond the reach of the staying-on Starscope and one-paced Maybe.

"She's a hardy, tough filly with a great pedigree who has progressed and, in the last couple of weeks, she has gone into a different zone," commented Aidan O'Brien. "When Seamus [Heffernan] won on her last year, he didn't know what to make of her, but said she could be very smart and Joseph [O'Brien] won a listed race on her at the Curragh and said she had a massive engine. We went to the Breeders' Cup with her after that, but she was entitled to run a little bit disappointing there and she got a bit tired first time up at the Curragh this year before winning nicely at Leopardstown last time. When a filly has a pedigree like that and they start progressing, they can really go on--Dylan Thomas and Holy Roman Emperor were progressive like that as well. It was an incredible performance--Joseph said she was the filly he was most worried about, as she would be going off in front and it was Maybe's first run. I was delighted with Maybe, too, as fitness came into it when the ground got slow. They have a lot of options, so we'll see how they are. Homecoming Queen is really strong-minded and can plough her own furrow and she could go for the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 27], but we'll talk about it. Maybe is more like a colt, so racing will help her." **Cont. p4**

**Gosden Looks To the Future...**

Trainer John Gosden, whose Starscope and **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) were second and fourth, respectively, behind Homecoming Queen, was delighted with their efforts but had negative news on the latter. "I was thrilled with both my fillies, who will go further in time and will want a longer trip," he told *PA Sport*. "They've run great but, unfortunately, The Fugue has been struck into on her hind leg and I hope she'll be okay. Starscope has run well and is a nice prospect."

Rod Street, Chief Executive of British Champions Series Ltd, was another taken by the winner's scintillating performance and said, "Aidan O'Brien and Coolmore have well and truly laid down the gauntlet for the 2012 QIPCO British Champions Series this weekend, witnessed on both days by bigger crowds than last year despite the poor weather. Just like Frankel a year ago, I don't think there's any doubting that we had another superstar to launch the Series with Camelot's QIPCO 2000 Guineas victory yesterday. He may have won by a much smaller margin than Frankel, but his class was there for all to see over a trip that was always likely to be his bare minimum this year. Homecoming Queen, meanwhile, put up a Frankel-like performance in the QIPCO 1000 Guineas this afternoon, running her rivals ragged with an amazing piece of front-running to seal the Coolmore double with a nine-length victory." Speaking of the death of Gray Pearl, Street added, "It was extremely sad that Gray Pearl suffered an injury in the starting stalls prior to the race and had to be put down. That kind of accident is fortunately very rare and everyone involved with the QIPCO British Champions Series extends their sympathies to the filly's connections."

**Gray Pearl Euthanized...**

Raymond Mould's **Gray Pearl (GB)** (Excellent Art {GB}) was euthanized after suffering a spinal chord injury in the stalls before Newmarket's G1 QIPCO 1000 Guineas. Trapped under the apparatus for several minutes prior to the mile Classic, last year's G2 Rockfel S. third was unable to be saved by the on-course vets. Chris Hammond, the attending British Horseracing Authority veterinary officer, explained, "Gray Pearl went down in the stalls and incurred an injury in the process. On examination by the racecourse vet, it became evident that she had lost the use of her hind legs and was suffering from an apparent spinal chord injury. To minimise distress to the filly, a decision was made to have her put down on welfare grounds." Her trainer Charlie Hills later told *PA Sport*, "We think maybe she hit her back in the stalls. She moved beautifully down to the start but then, suddenly, she went down under Michael [Hills]. It's a terrible shame and very sad."

With New Zealand phenom James McDonald in the irons, Xtension came charging to take a blanket finish and successfully defend his title in the Champions Mile, while 6-5 Cityscape (GB) (Selkirk) could do no better than 10th. The G2 Vintage S. winner and runner-up in the 2009

G1 Dewhurst S., Xtension was third in the G1 Prix Jean Prat before being acquired with a Hong Kong Derby campaign in mind. He had the misfortune of running into **Ambitious Dragon** (NZ) (Pins {Aus}) and was

second to the subsequent Horse of the Year in the domestic centerpiece over 2000 meters before defeating Lucky Nine by a half-length in this feature 12 months back. Third to Able One (NZ) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G1 Hong Kong Mile in December, he couldn't quite get to Ambitious Dragon in the Stewards' Cup the following month and chased that one home in the Hong Kong Gold Cup over 10 panels in February. He was exiting a fifth to Cityscape in the G1 Dubai Duty Free, the best result of the three Hong Kong runners in that event. **Cont. p6**

Alertly away, Xtension got the perfect spot as Able One dropped his head and took them along on the front end. Lucky Nine, the G1 Hong Kong Sprint hero stretching out off a third in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, got over from his wide draw to force the pace from second, while Cityscape, a bit slow to start, lingered in the latter half of the field. Able One led into the stretch, with Lucky Nine peeled to his outside, and McDonald looked for a way through between those rivals before switching off the heels of Lucky Nine. Ambitious Dragon, ground-saving throughout, made a menacing bid up the inside, but Xtension found the acceleration he needed and charged home four paths off the inside to score. "The way James rode him was the best ride you've ever seen!" said John Moore, who was winning his fourth renewal of this race in its 11-year history. "He got him across, right behind Able One, and got the gun run. At the 200 meters he had to extricate himself from a pocket but he got out, and the horse showed true courage because he wasn't at his best weight after the Dubai trip--there were a few shortcomings there and a few doubts after the trip, but he got to the line really strongly today. We were living in hope--with that great ride, we got home." Moore said Xtension could return in Singapore's G1 SIA Cup May 20, after which he will be considered for the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot.

**NHK MILE CUP-G1 result cont.**

Curren Black Hill remained unbeaten in his brief career with a decisive success in Tokyo Sunday, but the Takashi Suzuki colorbearer could soon get a major class test if his connections opt to ship to Royal Ascot for the G1 St James's Palace S. in June. A three-length debut winner at Kyoto in January, the dark bay came closest to defeat when he annexed the Kobushi Sho by a half-length back at that venue a month later. He garnered favoritism off a 2 1/2-length victory in Nakayama's G2 New Zealand Trophy S. Apr. 7. Quickly in front, Curren Black Hill bottomed out the field with a burst of acceleration two furlongs from home and held sway over 2011 champion 2-year-old Alfredo to justify his odds. This is the first time a horse who was unraced at two has won this event. Last year's NHK Mile Cup winner Grand Prix Boss (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}) finished eighth behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the 2011 St James's Palace.

The heavy favorite broke sharply and was soon on the lead with Signature Red (Bernstein) pressing through an opening quarter in :22.2, but Essence Hit Man soon shrugged off that rival and opened a clear lead. Canada's reigning sprint champion was two lengths in front after a half in :45.0 and three lengths in front at the top of the lane after three-quarters in 1:08.4, but tired noticeably in the final yards to just hold off the late-closing Big Band Sand. "He was better loading, he was better in the gate and he was able to get off to a better start," said winning rider Jesse Campbell, who has now ridden Essence Hit Man to three straight wins, beginning with last year's GIII Kennedy Road S. "He's a tired boy today. He knows where that wire is at. He ran hard."

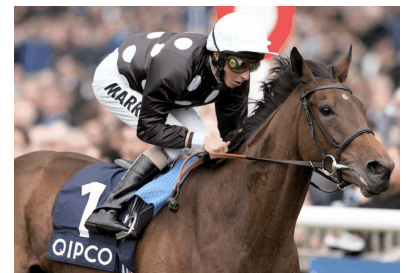

Nurtured by John Gosden last term, Izzi Top showed the benefit of that patience here when defying a penalty as a result of her success in the G3 Prix de Flore at Saint-Cloud in October. Third at this meeting 12 months ago in the 10-furlong Listed Pretty Polly S., the homebred beat Dancing Rain (Ire) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) in the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. over that trip at Newbury just 12 days later, but trailed her when third in the G1 Epsom Oaks on her next start. Given a break, she responded to positive tactics to capture the Prix de Flore over 1 5/16 miles and was dropping in trip for this re-introduction. Keen early racing prominently as Primevere set moderate fractions, the bay gained the edge approaching the furlong marker and kept digging in as Captivator threatened out wide. "She was a bit fresh, but they didn't go quick enough early on, so we got no cover which was not ideal," jockey William Buick commented. "It's a great start to the season, especially with her being fresh as she still got home. There is lots of improvement to come." Connections are looking at the G2 Middleton S. at York May 17.

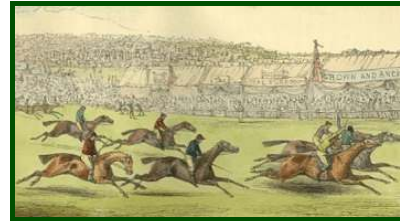

Following Derrick Smith's unbeaten colt's neck defeat of French Fifteen (Fr) (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) at Newmarket, the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby looks to be on the agenda, although the Ballydoyle conditioner was holding fire yesterday. "He seemed to be fine this morning and the Derby looks a lovely race for him, but it won't be discussed until this week," he said. "If he is well, that is what we'd be thinking of at the moment."

**Murtagh Keeps Faith in 'Sea'...**

Johnny Murtagh yesterday reflected on the flop of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Only 12th in the mile Classic after racing freely early and fading in the last quarter mile, Christopher Tsui's homebred 3/4-brother to Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) never looked likely to emulate that esteemed performer, but his rider was not blaming the trip for his disappointing effort. "He is fast, but I don't think he's a sprinter," Murtagh explained. "He was first to leave the gates yesterday and didn't get much cover, so after two furlongs I knew my fate. He never really got cover and ran a bit fresh, so we can put a line through it. I left him alone when his chance had gone and he came down the hill a little bit unbalanced. I didn't knock him about and there is a lot more to come. I believe he's a good horse and I think he'll show his true worth later in the season. He's a typical miler, but needs good-to-firm ground and to learn to settle a bit better."

**Preakness Possible for Bodemeister**

Bob Baffert reported that GI Kentucky Derby runner-up **Bodemeister** (Empire Maker) exited the race well, but the trainer will wait to make a decision on the May 19 GI Preakness. "I will let him tell me if he's ready, like I did with [2010 Preakness winner] Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike)," Baffert said. "With Lookin At Lucky, the day after the Derby I told them, 'We're not going to run.' The next Monday I said, 'Not only are we going, we're going to win this.' I've got to wait and see if he shows me a spark." Baffert's GIII Derby Trial S. runner-up and fellow Zayat Stables colorbearer **Paynter** (Awesome Again), who worked five furlongs in 1:00.20 yesterday at Churchill, is also possible for the Preakness, as is Derby sixth-place finisher **Liaison** (Indian Charlie).

**Take Charge Indy Injured**

GI Florida Derby winner **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy), 19th in the Kentucky Derby, will undergo surgery this week to remove a chip from his left front ankle. "Dr. Bill Baker just did the x-rays and in the ankle we have a P-1 chip fracture," trainer Pat Byrne said. "We've got an excellent prognosis." The surgery will be performed at the Woodford Equine Hospital in Versailles. "They will take that little chip out of the ankle, the rest of the leg is fine," Byrne said. "We're looking at 60 days of down time. If everything works out, we will make the Breeders' Cup Classic with a prep race beforehand."

**Police Investigate Possible Churchill Homicide**

Louisville police have opened a homicide investigation into the death of a man found Sunday morning in barn 8 at Churchill Downs. "We found evidence of injuries that lead us to believe he was involved in an altercation and that foul play was involved," Louisville Metro Police spokeswoman Alicia Smiley told *ABCNews.com*. "We are still trying to determine what led to the incident. At this point we don't have anything pointing to the fact that this had any association with Churchill Downs or the Derby itself."

**Derby Day Sets Records**

The 138th Kentucky Derby attracted an all-time record crowd of 165,307 to Churchill Downs Saturday, according to figures released by the track yesterday. The previous record of 164,858 was set last year, breaking a record which had been set in 1974. Wagering from all-sources on the card also set a record, with the \$187 million breaking the 2006 mark of \$175.1 million. All-sources wagering on the Derby itself was a record \$133.1 million.

Also setting a new mark, on-track wagering on the Derby was \$12.3 million. On-track wagering on the whole card was \$23.7 million--up 1.3% from the 2011 figure. Churchill Downs returned \$153.3 million, or 82% of the total wagers, to bettors and generated almost \$1 million in taxes to be paid to the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

"This Kentucky Derby Day was remarkable from start to finish, and the wagering and attendance records and the tremendous renewal of the great race won by I'll Have Another made it a day we'll likely be talking about for years to come," said Kevin Flanery, president of Churchill Downs Racetrack. "We deeply appreciate the support of our on-track fans; those across North America who watched and wagered online through TwinSpires.com and other advance deposit wagering outlets and those who watched the NBC Sports television coverage of the Kentucky Derby and Derby Day races throughout the United States and the world. After this year's marvelous renewals of the Kentucky Derby and the Kentucky Oaks, it appears that these great events are, after 138 years, just hitting their stride."

### THE PATIENCE OF A SAINT

In the aftermath of Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas, Aidan O'Brien accused himself of "destroying" **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in that Classic two years ago, but that looks an exaggeration of the facts now that Derrick Smith's turbo-charged 5-year-old has hit his stride again. Coaxed back to the top by Team Ballydoyle, he rewarded that steady approach with an emphatic win in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf in November and looked to have retained all his ability when second to the subsequent G1 Prix Ganay winner Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. Back at 10 furlongs for today's G3 Mooresbridge S., he could be ready to reinvent himself again. "He ran a blinder in Dubai on his first run of the year and the form has been franked since," rider Joseph O'Brien said. "He's had a little break, so hopefully he can run well, but the ground is very soft and it won't be ideal for him. He's on his way back and I think he's still improving. Hopefully he can come back to that very high level." John Oxx could be responsible for the main threat in His Highness The Aga Khan's **Sharestan (Ire)** (Shamardal). He may have been unlucky on his black-type debut when second to Famous Name (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in Leopardstown's Listed Heritage S. last time Apr. 15. "It will be very interesting to see how he gets on against a high-class horse like St Nicholas Abbey," The Aga Khan's Racing Manager Pat Downes told *PA Sport*. "It will certainly tell us more about him. I think the extra two furlongs should really be in his favour. He finished really strongly over a mile last time out at Leopardstown. He still looked a bit green and ran a bit free that day, too. He ran well though, it's very hard to beat Famous Name at Leopardstown in those conditions."
