TURNING HEADS

Sent off at 7-10 for yesterday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches after her easy prep success in the Apr. 15 G3 Prix de la Grotte, Ecurie Wildenstein's unbeaten **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ Beauty Parlour (GB)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) duly delivered with another commanding performance in front of the Longchamp faithful. Taking over from stable rabbit **Regatta (Fr)** (Layman) passing the quarter pole, the bay required no more than two slaps with Christophe Soumillon's whip to seal a comfortable length victory over Ballydoyle's **Up (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). "We all knew she was good, but to win today is a great relief," trainer Elie Lellouche commented. "She is now a Group 1 winner and that is all that matters." **Cont. p4**

LUC ON HIS SIDE

Ahmed Mouknass and Pandora Stud's **Lucayan (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) entered yesterday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains under the radar, but had his head in front

when it mattered at the end of a messy and dramatic renewal of the French Classic.

The race was marred by the fatal injury sustained by third-place

finisher **Furner's Green (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). Despite showing quality when winning the Listed Prix Aymeri de Mauleon at Toulouse Apr. 27, Lucayan lacked form of any real weight and was largely ignored by the Parisians at 27-1. Needing all of the straight to get to the freewheeling pacemaker **Veneto (Fr)** (Panis), the bay finally managed to get in front yards from the post and had a short neck to spare over that 92-1 shot, with the late-closing Furner's Green the same distance away in third. After the line, that Ballydoyle raider suffered a catastrophic fracture of his right-fore and had to be euthanized. "I believed in him today and he is improving all the time," the winning trainer Francois Rohaut explained. "He is very brave, tough and genuine like his sire, who I also trained."



Lucayan started his racing late and was making an unusually low-key debut for a future Guineas winner when winning over 7 1/2 furlongs on Pau's fibresand in December. Nosed out of a first Polytrack score in a mile conditions event at Saint-Cloud Mar. 3, he continued his education when returning there to be second again behind Coup de Theatre (Fr) (Gold Away {Ire}) 24 days later in the Listed Prix Omnium II on his first turf start. Taken to Toulouse for the Apr. 27 Listed Prix Aymeri de Mauleon, he bested his stable companion Azeville (Ger) (Shamardal) in that mile heat and the latter had given a boost to the form minutes earlier when finishing a creditable sixth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches.

Kept away from the rail and out of trouble by Stephane Pasquier early, the bay, who sports cheekpieces, was in sixth as Veneto established a clear lead carrying out pacemaking duties for the 4-5 favorite Dabirsim (Fr) (Hat Trick {Jpn}). As Lucayan was beginning to wind up at the top of the straight, Christophe Soumillon found a dead end on Dabirsim up the fence, but there appeared no excuses for the market leader afterwards. Veneto was continuing to give Thierry Thulliez everything up front and, despite matters getting tight on the bunched run to the line, Lucayan stayed straight and true to inch ahead, as the ill-fated Furner's Green made up significant ground to make the frame.

For Lucayan's conditioner Francois Rohaut, the subsequent inquiry brought back unhappy memories of losing the Pouliches in the stewards' room two years ago with Liliside (Fr) (American Post {GB}). "The fact that we lost the fillies' race makes this one special," he said. "He only had his first run in December, so this gives me great pride. I could see when he was in contention at the top of the straight that he would go close. He is in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [at Chantilly June 3], but we also have Hard Dream (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) for that, so I think we'll pass with this horse. He could be supplemented for the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 19], but we'll take our time to think about it as there is also the G1 Prix Jean Prat [at Chantilly July 1]."

Aidan O'Brien was on hand to give the details of Furner's Green's injury. "He broke his off-fore and he had to be put down," he told *PA Sport*. "Joseph [O'Brien] is okay--when a horse goes down at that speed, it could have been much worse."

Trainer Christophe Ferland was not too downcast over the eclipse of eventual sixth Dabirsim, and pointed to a drop back to sprinting with the colt. "He was slightly unlucky early in the straight, but still had every chance, and so now it is obvious that he doesn't stay," he said. "He is in the G1 July Cup [Newmarket July 12], but we could wait for the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest [at Deauville Aug. 5]."

Familiarity Breeds Redemption...

Lucayan's owners Ahmed Mouknass and Anthony Forde's Pandora Stud have campaigned horses in Spain, and were plenty familiar with Karluv Most (Fr) (Della Francesca), named the country's champion stayer in 2010. So when the group was shopping for juveniles last year, it was logical to take a look at his half-brother by Turtle Bowl (Ire) at Arqana's Breeze-Up Sale. Bloodstock agent Marc Antoine Berghgracht, acting on their behalf, had his own connection with the family, having bought Turtle Bowl's dam Clara Bow (Fr) (Top Ville {Fr}) as a yearling way back in 1991, and liked what he saw from the youngster, already named Lucayan. "He had a good breeze but nothing fast, which personally I do not clock, and feel it's more important to see his action during the work and his attitude after," said Berghgracht, who was able to secure him for €85,000.

Fast forward almost exactly one year, and Lucayan was giving his connections the sweetest kind of redemption. That, after Mouknass and Forde saw their filly Liliside (Fr) (American Post {GB}) cross the wire first in the 2010 renewal of the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, only to be DQ'd to sixth for interference. To add a touch of insult to injury, it looked like the duo's filly Lily America, a full-sister to Liliside, would give them another shot at the Pouliches this year after winning her third straight in the Listed Prix La Camargo at Saint-Cloud Mar. 27, but she was scratched in the days leading up to the race with an abscess. "They really deserve such a fabulous day!" enthused Berghgracht. "They have been in the game for only five years, but they had the sad experience of being disqualified with Liliside and then having Lily America declared a non-runner. It is fantastic for this great team."

What could make the day even sweeter for Mouknass and Forde? The breeder of Lucayan, Jean-Pierre Colombo, is reportedly the steward who was responsible for disqualifying Liliside. Mouknass, who is from Mauritania, and the Moroccan-born Forde are in the fishery business together. That have horses split between trainers Francois Rohaut, Rodolphe Collet and Yann Durepaire in France.

Intriguingly, Beauty Parlour followed the same route to this Classic as last year's Pouliches heroine Golen Lilac (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), winning twice as a juvenile over a mile in conditions races at Saint-Cloud. Leaving no one in any doubt as to her class when winning those stepping stones by a total margin of 11 1/2 lengths, the Wildenstein homebred returned to show that she had substance as well as style when easily annexing this race's course-and-distance trial, the G3 Prix de la Grotte. Connections feared that this mile might prove on the sharp side for her by now, but after her pacemaker Regatta eventually forged her way to the head of affairs, she had a suitable pace to bring her stamina into play. Professional despite being forced to race three-wide for the major part of the contest, Soumillon asked her to make an early move at the end of Longchamp's renowned "false straight" and she was in front and there to be shot at with just under a quarter mile remaining. Given a couple of cracks soon after to keep her up to her work, she was hand ridden throughout the final yards, as Up closed strongly to lead home Topeka and fellow Ballydoyle raider After (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) to further demonstrate the strength in depth among Aidan O'Brien's current crop of sophomores.

Whale Capture earned a well-deserved first Group 1 success here after a trio of narrow top-level defeats in the past two seasons. A close-up second in the G1 Hanshin Juvenile Fillies in December of her 2-year-old year, Whale Capture came back to be beaten just 3/4 lengths when second again to Marcellina in the G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) at Hanshin last April. Classic success further eluded her in the G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) in May, when a neck separated her from winner Erin Court (Jpn) (Durandal {Jpn}) and runner-up Pure Brise (Jpn) (Monsun {Ger}). After a break, Whale Capture bounced back to win the G2 Kansai Tele Corp Sho Rose S. at Hanshin in September, but had to settle for a Group 1 placing once again when third by 2 1/2 lengths in the G1 Shuka Sho at Kyoto Oct. 16. Fourth behind the world-class Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Kyoto Nov. 13, she looked in need of the run when fifth in the G3 Nakayama Himba S. in her 4-year-old bow Mar. 11, and was primed for a big effort here in her first start at less than nine furlongs since the Oka Sho. Breaking from stall 12, the gray filly was away alertly and soon maneuvered into the slipstream of the pacesetter Queen's Barn (Jpn) (Special Week {Jpn}). From there she just bided her time, waiting patiently as they made the left-hand turn into the stretch before angling out into the two path with the majority of the field bunching up just behind her. Jockey Norihiro Yokoyama asked Whale Capture in earnest a furlong out, and she quickly lengthened away to a daylight lead before gamely accounting for the late thrust of Donau Blue. The winner is likely to stay at the metric mile for the time being and is being pointed toward next month's 1600-meter G1 Yasuda Kinen. The heroine of last year's Victoria Mile, Apapane (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), was the 3-1 choice to get her first win since that event, but could do no better than fifth.

Settled in rear early despite the pace proving only moderate, the grey who was last seen warming up with a win in a 10-furlong conditions event at the San Siro Apr. 8, made his move as Afsare was committed in early stretch. After a prolonged tussle with the British raider, he gained the edge approaching the furlong marker and drew clear late to confirm his status as Italy's leading performer.

"Kieren Fallon was very strong on the second and took the race by the scruff of the neck, so this was a real test for Crackerjack King and he really is a champion," his conditioner Stefano Botti told the *Racing Post*. "I'm very emotional because he's going to leave soon--I am broken-hearted."

He needed plentiful courage to subdue the ill-fated Furner's Green (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) in a mile conditions at this track Mar. 28 and looked thoroughly straightforward when returning here to add the G3 Ballysax S. over this trip last time Apr. 15. Allowed to drift in the market with all the support coming for Wrote, the Bolger homebred stuck close to that favorite's enterprisingly ridden stable companion Tower Rock early. Joining battle in the straight, the chestnut got the better of the Ballydoyle second-string with 150 yards remaining and asserted as Wrote proved a major disappointment, finishing well adrift in third. "He didn't like the ground and is not the same on it, but he's a top horse with a will to win and lots of ability," Jim Bolger said. "He's going for the G1 Irish Derby [at The Curragh June 30]."

Brought along stealthily by Francois Doumen, Top Trip made his debut over 10 furlongs on Deauville's Boxing Day fixture and followed a promising second with a defeat of the smart Brillant Chichi (Fr) (Chichicastenango {Fr}) back over the same track and

trip also on the fibresand Jan. 7. Switched to the turf for another conditions event over that trip Mar. 10, the bay continued his march forward to score again before finishing two-lengths runner-up to the leading domestic Derby hope Kesampour (Fr) (King's Best) in the Listed Prix Francois Mathet over 1 5/16 miles back at the latter venue last time Apr. 1. Anchored at the tail of the field early by Thomas Huet in this staging post for the leading French middle-distance colts, he was helped by the genuine pace set by the Ballydoyle raider Athens (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) and his rider was happy to be the last to play his hand in the straight. Sir Jade took over approaching the final quarter and immediately veered left, leaving a hole for Masterstroke and Top Trip and it was the latter who proved strongest in the final 50 yards. "He was slightly dismissed here, but he can't be faulted as he has not been out of the first two in his career," commented Doumen, who also bred the winner in partnership with Joerg Vasicek at his Haras d'Ecouvès. "He has a great turn of foot and uses his stride very well for a small horse. All being well, he'll be at Chantilly for the [June 3] G1 Prix du Jockey Club."

Blasting from her wide stall to take a clear early lead once more, the Newmarket raider was asked to stretch at the quarter pole and was beyond reach as Monsieur Joe closed late. "Last year in the Abbaye, she missed the break and things got very complicated as early speed if her forte," trainer Roger Varian commented. "She is very fast and had the benefit of a run. Five furlongs is best for her and she goes on any ground, so I would imagine we will come back to France with her and run in the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene [at Chantilly June 3]."

A runaway winner in the restricted Dec. 3 Ontario Lassie S., the chestnut was given some time off before resurfacing with a narrow score in Tampa's grassy Florida Oaks Feb. 4. Stretched out to nine panels for the Mar. 11 GIII Herecomesthebride S. over the Gulfstream sod, she crossed the wire in fourth, but was promoted to third. Most recently, Dixie Strike was given a tall task when returning to the Poly for the Apr. 7 GI Ashland S. at Keeneland and could only manage a fifth, beaten 7 1/4 lengths. Facing slightly easier company here, the John Oxley runner still had to face the likes of **"TDN Rising Star"** Tu Endie Wei, undefeated in four starts over the local strip. A step slow off the mark, the Mark Casse trainee was content to trail the field through Tu Endie Wei's modest splits of :24.1 and :49.1. Scraping the paint turning heading into the far turn, the Canadian bred rolled up to the heavy favorite midstretch and easily strode by en route to a comfortable win.

Tiger Walk & Zetterholm Work...

Sagamore Farm's **Tiger Walk** (Tale of the Cat), who arrived at Pimlico Sunday morning, worked a half-mile in advance of Saturday's GI Preakness S. The dark bay covered four furlongs in :47.60 seconds under Horacio Karamanos.

"He was awesome. It was a little bit faster than I wanted, but it was still good," trainer Ignacio Correas said. Tiger Walk, who was equipped with "cheater" blinkers for the work, will wear them for the first time in the second jewel of the Triple Crown.

"Especially on the turns, he's been losing ground," said Correas. "It's like coming into the turn he's three lengths behind the pace and coming home, it's like seven or eight lengths, and then he's closing ground. So we're trying to avoid that and, hopefully, we'll accomplish that."

Tiger Walk was third in the Feb. 4 GIII Withers S. before finishing fourth in both the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 3 and GI Wood Memorial Apr. 7.

"Even though he's been competitive, he still needs to step up," Correas said. "It's a tough race, but you cannot win unless you're in. So, we're going to try our best and he's going to try his best too."

Kent Desormeaux will be aboard Tiger Walk for the first time Saturday.

Also at Pimlico Sunday morning, **Zetterholm** (Silver Train) made his first visit to the track at 6:50 a.m. for a leisurely turn before returning at 8:30 a.m. for a five-furlong work in 1:01.40. Exercise rider Mario Madrid was aboard for the move.

"It was all very basic," said assistant Blake Dutrow, the 20-year-old nephew of trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. "Everything went well."

Zetterholm, who shipped from Aqueduct to Pimlico Saturday, was bedded down in Stall 40, the space usually reserved in the Pimlico Stakes Barn for the GI Kentucky Derby winner. The stall became available after trainer Doug O'Neill opted to use Barn D instead for I'll Have Another, which would keep all of his runners and stable pony Lava Man together.

"We just got him out and jogged him, so he could see the track and know what he was going to be facing when he came out," Dutrow added. "He loved it. He went out, came back to the barn and knew he was going to breeze. He came out and did his thing the right way."

CIRRUS TO ASCOT

Trainer Corine Barande-Barbe has opted not to send the 6-year-old to contest Sunday's Singapore Airlines International Cup and focus on the June 20 feature of the Royal meeting. A report from the Singapore Turf Club read, "Trainer Corine Barande-Barbe made the decision to withdraw him after it was felt travel plans to Singapore and return were too difficult, putting in jeopardy his assault on next month's Royal Ascot meeting in England."

The juvenile sales season enters the homestretch this evening at Barretts, which holds one of the final major juvenile auctions of the year with its May Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. Action gets underway at 6:30



PDT at the Hinds Pavilion at Fairplex Park in Pomona, California. A total of 116 horses have been catalogued for the event, down from 123 last year and roughly 30% off the 2010 figure of 166. The 2011 auction was topped by Civility Pledge (Hard Spun), an as-yet unraced half-brother to GISW Sinister Minister who was purchased by George Bolton for \$220,000. The colt was consigned by Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stable. Another horse Bolton purchased at the sale, the

\$150,000 Gun Boat (Congrats), finished third in Saturday's GIII Laz Barrera S. at Betfair Hollywood Park, while Bolton and Fog City's The Factor (War Front), a \$250,000 May grad in 2010, is the catalogue's coverboy. Figures from last year's sale remained consistent with 2010. The \$36,466 average was down a scant 1.3%, while the median of \$20,000 was down 2.4%. Overall, 73 horses sold for \$2,662,000. Seven horses made \$100,000 or better, and the sale enjoyed a strong RNA rate of 19.7%, based on the 18 horses who didn't sell in the ring. Workers for tonight's auction were led by [hip 122](#), a Sky Mesa filly from Wavertree's consignment who drilled an eighth in [:9 4/5](#).
