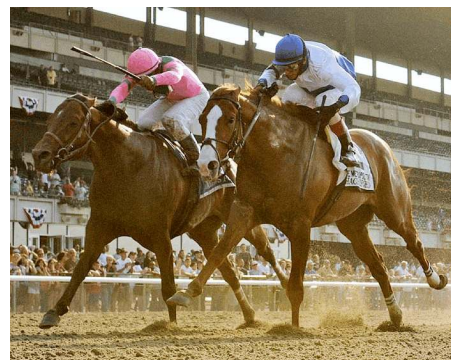

SHACKLEFORD HOLDS ON IN MET MILE

Shackleford (Forestry) set all the pace in Monday's GI Metropolitan H. and just held on for a gritty nose victory over the furious late rally of **Caleb's Posse** (Posse). "I knew he was going to finish," said winning trainer Dale Romans. "It was just a matter of whether they could get by him or not. He's gutsy as they come. Hopefully, he'll get the credit he deserves. He's a spectacular horse."

Sent off at 3-1, Shackleford broke alertly and was soon at the head of affairs. He was hounded by

Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil) through fractions of :22.77 and :44.73, with favored **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini) a close-up third along the rail as Caleb's Posse dropped some 10 lengths off the pace. Shackleford began to open up on his rivals after three-quarters in 1:08.52, but Caleb's Posse was

finding his best stride in the middle of the track to give the Belmont faithful a Met Mile finish to remember.

Romans is already looking forward to the continuing rivalry between the two 4-year-olds.

"These two have had a good rivalry," Romans commented. "It's their fourth time against each other, and they're 2-2. Caleb's Posse is a great horse, and it's a good rivalry. Let's see each other again. It was the race of the year, and it's exciting to have been part of it, win, lose, or draw, with all of those good horses. And it lived up to its billing. To be a nose apart at the wire, I think it lived up to the hype."

IT'S TRICKY ON TOP IN OGDEN PHIPPS

Godolphin's **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft) made a strong case for the title of divisional leader in yesterday's GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont, a mid-season event that nonetheless could have championship implications. Godolphin's star 4-year-old registered her third graded win in three starts this season after fighting past **Cash for Clunkers** (Tiznow) for the 3/4-length win, with odds-on **Awesome Maria** (Maria's Mon) finishing a no-excuse third. "She's a special filly," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "Eddie [Castro] rode her very well. [Trainer] Rick Violette's filly [Cash for Clunkers] was tough... wow! We just did get there." **Cont. p5**

UN-CONTESTED IN THE ACORN

The main question put to Natalie Baffert's **Contested** (Ghostzapper) before Monday's GI Acorn S. at Belmont was whether she could stretch her considerable speed to a mile. The former **TDN Rising Star** answered the question authoritatively, sprinting clear from the start and cruising unmolested to a five-length victory. "That's just what we wanted to see," said Jim Barnes, assistant to trainer Bob Baffert. "It all depends on how you break. She basically caught a flyer, and they stayed off of her. She went :22 and :45, so they didn't just give it to her. She was rolling right along. Javier [Castellano, jockey] said she reminded him of [Horse of the Year] Ghostzapper." **Cont. p7**

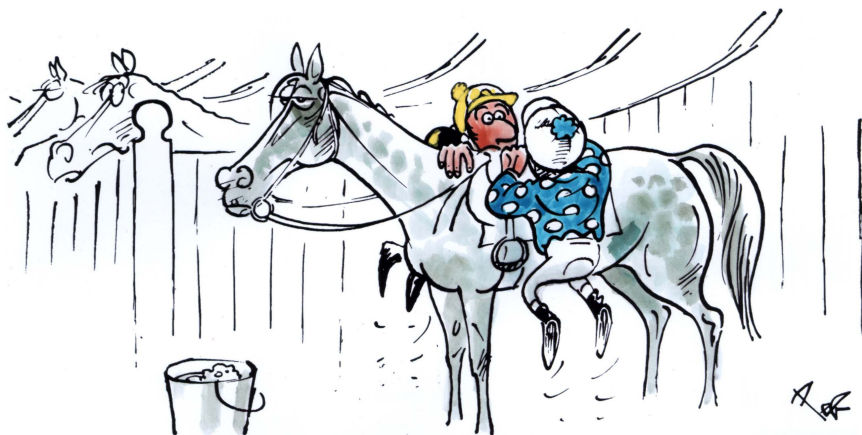

Shackleford Holds on in Met Mile (cont. from p1)

"He broke so good, I didn't have to do much, and he was doing it easy," John Velazquez said of his trip aboard Shackleford. "Even as they were chasing him, he was in hand the whole way and that's what I liked about him. Because he was doing it so easy, I didn't have to rush him. I saw the shadow [of Caleb's Posse] coming, so I had to go real far out to get him. I was wondering if somebody was in between and was thinking, if nobody was there, I was going to go straight out, and that's what made me win, because when I came out, he put up a fight. [He dug back in] big time."

Shackleford earned an automatic berth to this year's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile with the victory and co-owner Michael Lauffer is ready to book his hotel. "Our two main goals for this year were to win the Met Mile and the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile," Lauffer said. "We've accomplished the first one and now we'll go after the second. The "Win and You're In" is a great incentive."

Shackleford went winless for nearly a year after his victory in the 2011 GI Preakness S., but got back on track with a game victory over sprint champion Amazombie in the May 5 GI Churchills Downs S.

He wasted no time in making it back-to-back wins Monday and, according to trainer Dale Romans, he is a horse who thrives on activity. "The more work [Shackleford] does, the better he is," the trainer said. "I brought him out a little too soft early in the year. I was too easy on him. We started cranking it up, and it's paid off. The more I do with him, the more he likes it and the better he gets."

For Caleb's Posse, winner of last year's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, it was a third straight heartbreaking defeat. The 4-year-old missed by a neck in the Mar. 3 GIII Tom Fool H. and by a nose in the Apr. 7 GI Carter H. "We'll get over this," said trainer Donnie Von Hemel. "For him to overcome the track bias and run like that, we're very proud of him."

INCREASES FOR MET MILE DAY

Met Mil Day at Belmont Park saw double-digit increases in on-track and all-sources handle, according to figures released by the New York Racing Association yesterday. On-track handle was \$2,296,972, up 13% from last year's total of \$2,031,127. All-sources handle on NYRA races was \$14,444,665--up 10.7% from 2011. This year's holiday attendance of 10,577 was up 15.7% from a year ago.

It's Tricky was one of the best of a very deep sophomore filly bench last year. She won the one-mile GI Acorn S. in the slop on the Belmont S. undercard in June before stretching out to add the nine-furlong GI CCA Oaks at Saratoga in July. She ran second in her final three starts of the year: to Royal Delta (Empire Maker) in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga in August, to Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GII Cotillion S. at Parx in October and to Royal Delta once again in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic in November. She got back to business relatively early at Aqueduct this past spring, winning the 1 1/16-mile GII Top Flight H. in the mud Mar. 3 before scaling back to annex the seven-furlong GII Distaff H. Apr. 14.

Off as the second choice as the crowd hammered Awesome Maria down to 3-4 favoritism, It's Tricky was up from post four to hound Cash for Clunkers through fast splits of :22 3/5 and :45 3/5. John Velazquez guided Awesome Maria into the clear on the outside just off that pair, and looked poised for a big run as It's Tricky moved to near even terms in upper stretch. Cash for Clunkers wasn't through yet, though, battling back on the inside and leading most of the stretch, but It's Tricky wouldn't relent and surged late to win as Awesome Marie continued one-paced in third. "From the three-sixteenths pole to the eighth pole, I was worried--she wasn't there yet," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "She ran great. We're not sure what's next for her." Trainer Rick Violette Jr. was thrilled with the effort of Cash for Clunkers. "We had to start running on the middle of the turn and it was a long, hard drive," he said. "For a filly that hasn't really been pressed to the wire, she just really ran her eyeballs out. I am really, really proud of her. We found out today that she is a real filly." Trainer Todd Pletcher, meanwhile, shouldered the blame for the finish of Awesome Maria, who saw her six-race winning streak snapped. "I think I did a really poor job preparing her for this race," he said. "We stayed in Florida too long, got rained on a lot, missed a couple of works down there. Then I tried to make up for it here and breezed her on a sloppy track. It wasn't her fault. I'll take the blame for it. We'll go to Saratoga."

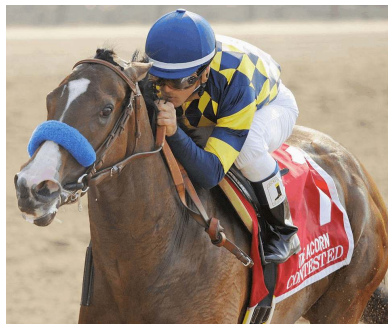

He's ended up in front a bit soon, but Shane said he just took him there and I can't believe how well it went." Looking ahead, trainer Alan McCabe revealed, "Caspar Netscher is in the [June 20 G3] Jersey S. [at Royal Ascot], but we might also have a look at the [July 1 G1] Prix Jean Prat [at Chantilly] in France for him. We'll take him home and then make a plan from there."

MG1SW KICKS OFF MM NATIONAL IN STYLE

Dual Group 1-winning mare **Melito (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) launched Monday's opening session of the Magic Millions National Broodmare sale at the Gold Coast the right way, heading the day's affairs with a A\$1.65 million (US\$1,624,673) final bid from Coolmore Stud's Tom Magnier. A late entry, the 6-year-old mare-- who is out of listed winner Cloister (Aus) (Marauding {Aus})-- was offered as the very last lot in the supplementary catalogue, however, it was clear that the big guns stuck around until the very end, as no less than four different parties slugged it out for the Reavill Farm offering. The price represents the fourth highest paid at Magic Millions and the second most expensive for a mare in foal.

"Mares like her don't come up for sale very often and we're delighted to be able to buy her," said Magnier.

In foal to champion sire Encosta de Lago (Aus), the mare garnered the title of top 3-year-old filly on the 2009-10 Australasian classifications following wins in the G1 AJC TJ Smith S. and G1 Qld Tatts RC Winter S., G2 Silver Slipper S. and G2 Furious S.

"Obviously she is a serious mare," Magnier said. "She's a lovely looking individual with a great pedigree. She had great speed and a great deal of quality and all of the lads were keen to buy her."

As for a future date for the champion, Magnier added, "She will be served this spring by [Coolmore campaigned] So You Think ({NZ} High Chaparral {Ire}) and I can't wait to see the resultant progeny."

At the day's conclusion, Team Coolmore ruled the roost as the session's leading buyer, securing four of the top five offerings of the afternoon. Magnier also purchased **More Valour (Aus)** (More Than Ready) for A\$400,000, **Sevruga (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) for A\$360,000 and **Graceful Anna (Aus)** (Canny Lad {Aus}) for A\$250,000.

The operation rounded out the day with a total of five purchases and gross expenditures of A\$2,707,500.

Other top sellers Monday included Miss Keepsake (NZ) (Keeper {Aus}), sold to Ireland's Dermot Farrington for A\$400,000 and Born to Rock (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), who brought A\$300,000 from Queensland's Bowcock Bloodstock.

At the conclusion of the first day of selling, the gross closed at A\$8,078,750 for 144 lots sold, with an average price of A\$56,102, up 30% from 2011.

"It was a very selective market today," said Magic Millions Managing Director Vin Cox. "Buyers were prepared to pay for the right product."

Addressing the RNA rate for the first session, Cox admitted, "The disappointing aspect to the sale was that some vendors haven't come to terms with the reality of the market. The 68.3% clearance rate is disappointing, but we expect [Tuesday] to be a better days' selling, with some extremely high-profile mares.

He may be joined by stable companions **Astrology (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), winners of the G3 Dee S. at Chester May 11 and the Apr. 28 G3 Sandown Classic Trial, respectively, in addition to the May 13 G2 Derrinstown Derby Trial runner-up **Tower Rock (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) and Chester maiden

winner **Father of Science (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}).

Andrew Balding also has a duo in Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's May 17 G2 Dante S. winner **Bonfire (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}) and Fitri Hay's **Minimise Risk (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who was last of five in the May 10 G3 Chester Vase. The Niarchos silks will be carried by the unbeaten David Lanigan trainee **Main Sequence** (Aldebaran), who booked his ticket with success in the May 12 G3 Lingfield Derby Trial, while another important trial winner set to line up is Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum's **Mickdaam (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}). Paul Hanagan is set to ride the Chester Vase scorer, who had been troubled with a hock infection subsequently, after he pleased trainer Richard Fahey in a spin at the weekend. "Mickdaam worked well on Saturday," his conditioner told *sportinglife.com*. "We'll monitor him through the week, but if everything goes well he'll run in the Derby and Paul will ride." Ground conditions at Epsom are currently described as "good-to-firm" and "good" in the home straight, and Clerk of the Course Andrew Cooper is contemplating a watering policy. "There is a lot of uncertainty in the forecast, particularly regarding what we might get in terms of rain," he said yesterday. "One thing we are fairly sure of is that from tomorrow onwards, things are going to get cooler, and we think temperatures will be down to around 18 degrees by Thursday, from the mid to late 20s we've had the last few days. I think the rain is meant to be showery in nature. We're going to put some water on the downhill section of the course this afternoon, which I would describe as good-to-firm at this stage, and it will benefit from some watering. I think all we can do is keep on top of things, and we can make decisions about watering on a daily basis."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

No Sussex Showdown for Caviar...

Connections of **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) yesterday ruled out a clash with Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 QIPCO Sussex S. at Goodwood. Despite some suggestions that the unbeaten mare could stay in Britain long enough to tackle the Juddmonte star in the Aug. 1 mile contest, which would have seen its purse increase to £1 million if both lined up, a statement issued by Peter Moody Racing ended all speculation yesterday.

"Moody Racing does not intend running Black Caviar at a mile in the QIPCO Sussex S., Frankel or no Frankel, as we are looking at getting her back to Melbourne for racing later in the year if she comes through Ascot as well as she can," the organisation's Jeff O'Connor explained. "Therefore, we are not planning to nominate her for the QIPCO Sussex S. at [the] nomination stage, as we feel it would not be the right thing by the racing industry worldwide, giving false hope that the race may happen. We understand it would have been a great selling point for Glorious Goodwood and we appreciate the more than generous offer from QIPCO in getting the conditions of the race to where they are, but we will have to decline on this occasion."

Black Caviar's British campaign will take in the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 23 and G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 14 before she enters quarantine for her return ahead of Melbourne's Spring Carnival.

Adam Waterworth, managing director of Goodwood Racecourse, commented, "We are obviously disappointed that Black Caviar will not be entered in the QIPCO Sussex S., but fully understand her connections' viewpoint. It was always going to be a long shot to have world's top two horses race against each other because of their different distance requirements, but we wanted to make sure we did everything we could to facilitate such a contest. Therefore, we are very grateful to QIPCO for increasing the prize money so much if Black Caviar and Frankel had met."

Rod Street, chief executive officer of the British Champions Series and Racing for Change, added, "We cannot underestimate the efforts it took to entice Black Caviar's connections to travel across the globe to race in the UK in the first place. We should celebrate the fact that she is coming, and adding another dimension to what could be the most memorable of flat seasons. It's natural that racing fans wanted to see a clash between Black Caviar and Frankel, and it had all the makings of something very special. Nonetheless, it was always going to be difficult to find the right conditions for a sprinter to meet a miler, who has learned to settle and is likely to step up to beyond a mile."

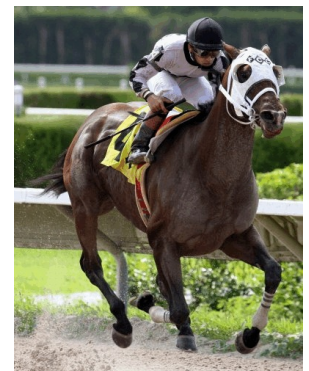

Darley yesterday announced plans for its Australian standout **Sepoy (Aus)** (Elusive Quality--Watchful {Aus}, by Danehill), who is set to start once more before being retired to stud at the operation's Kelvinside Stud in the Hunter Valley for the Southern Hemisphere's 2012 season. The 3-year-old Sheikh Mohammed homebred, currently trained by Mahmood Al Zarooni, will line up in the G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket July 14 in his career finale, where he could meet fellow Aussie star Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}). "We hope that he shows the Northern Hemisphere what a special horse he is...before embarking on a stallion career he so richly deserves," said Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford. Sepoy was named Australia's champion juvenile in the 2010-11 season with wins including the G1 Golden Slipper S. and G1 Blue Diamond S. At three last spring, Sepoy recorded his third Group 1 over More Joyous (Aus) (More Than Ready) in the Manikato S., later added the G1 Coolmore S., and was honored as the highest-rated 3-year-old sprinter in the world. Overall, he's won 10 of 13 starts and earned nearly A\$4 million. "Sepoy is simply extraordinary," said Oliver Tait, Darley's chief operating officer. "There hasn't been a racehorse with these credentials retire to stud in Australia since Vain (Aus). His performances in the Golden Slipper and Blue Diamond were breathtaking, and to come back in the spring as a 3-year-old to win five from five, including a victory over More Joyous, is truly unique.
