AN UNFOLDING LEGEND

Derrick Smith's **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and Joseph O'Brien had a weight of expectation on their shoulders entering yesterday's G1 Investec Derby, but the 8-13 favorite and his 19-year-old rider proved impervious to the pressure when surging to an emphatic five-length success. In doing so, the much-lauded bay completed the 2000 Guineas-

EK-CITING PROSPECT

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum and his team have placed great faith in **Ektihaam (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and that could be repaid in today's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly. Disappointing in the G1 Dewhurst S. on his major juvenile test, the **"TDN Rising Star"** followed a smooth win in testing ground in a 10-furlong conditions event at Newbury Apr. 20 with a second to **Bonfire (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}) in the G2 Dante S. at York last time May 17. Trainer Roger Varian was assistant to the Late Michael Jarvis when he saddled **Holding Court (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) to win this in the millennium year and he is hoping the imposing colt can follow suit. "I have been very pleased with him since his good run in the Dante," Varian said. "He has taken his races extremely well and looks in very good condition. He blew out beautifully the other morning and we are very hopeful that he can run a good race." Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani's **French Fifteen (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) ran into a top-class performer himself when a neck second to **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5 and he should be considered France's leading 3-year-old colt at present. Versatile in terms of trip at two, he opened his account over five furlongs and rounded off that campaign with a win in the G1 Criterium International over a mile at Saint-Cloud in October. Cont. p5

Settled with only one behind by his supremely confident rider early, Camelot had his positively ridden stable companion **Astrology (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) to aim at in the straight and, after powering past with a furlong remaining, carried on into the clear, with **Main Sequence** (Aldebaran) denying a Ballydoyle one-two in the final stride. "He must be right up there with the best," John Magnier commented. "It is there for everybody to see, and we are fortunate to have

anything to do with him, particularly in the year that his father died, which makes it more important." When asked whether he would like to attempt the Triple Crown, the Coolmore supremo answered, "Wouldn't anybody? We are going to have to take it race-by-race and give it a lot of thought. These things get to mean more as you get older. If you had asked me the same question 20 years ago, I would have looked the other way, but we'll have to see what Derrick [Smith] and Michael [Tabor] think about it. We are going through a good patch at the moment, so we just have to savor the moment."

Those looking for alternatives to Camelot approaching this test were keen to focus on the relative inexperience of his jockey, but that argument was beginning to wear thin after yet another impressive piece of piloting by Joseph O'Brien on Power (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas. Just a day later, the famed Ballydoyle operation was being denied a British or Irish Classic for the first time this year, but an Oaks success courtesy of Was (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) on Friday continued to strengthen the portents for the stable star. Camelot had created his own aura on the track without any need for hyperbole, and his scintillating performance in the G1 Racing Post Trophy on the back of heavy market support at Doncaster in October rightly earned him champion 2-year-old status. Allowed to take his chance in the May 5 Newmarket Classic on the back of impressive home spins, the son of the sadly deceased Montjeu showed a different, but no less important side to his character when winning a fist fight with the accomplished miler French Fifteen (Fr) (Turtle Bowl {Ire}). Just over an hour after Joseph O'Brien had delivered a masterclass of cool on another of Montjeu's long list of stellar runners St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the Coronation Cup, he set out in the same unhurried manner belying the magnitude of the occasion.

If there was any panic rising as he guided Camelot down the hill still several lengths adrift of Ryan Moore and Astrology, it was not apparent until he asked the crowd's choice to chase hard from the three-furlong pole. Hanging down the camber as he closed down his barnmate, Camelot's acceleration had carried him into a winning position by the furlong pole and his subsequent tour de force allowed connections and

favorite-backers time to bask in the moment. "I was a bit worried, as he didn't come down the hill at all and didn't handle the track that well," Joseph O'Brien explained. "He's a very special horse and I'm just very fortunate to be on his back." Derrick Smith, who was celebrating an apt 100th winner Group 1 winner, added, "It's not a dream, because I could never have dreamt I would do it. This is the one everybody wants in racing and what a horse and what a ride. I suppose the Triple Crown must be on the agenda and we may get pressured into it, but we'll sit down and talk about it and make the final decision."

Aidan O'Brien paid his own tribute to the sport's new talent. "He always looked special, but this is something you can't really dream about," he commented. "He's one of those unusual horses who seems to be always finishing no matter what trip you run him over. He's magical and that's the only way I can describe him--he couldn't be better named. He has a great constitution and the way he came back and stood relaxed in the winner's enclosure afterwards, he's very much in control. That he's in such a place in his head with that ability, it is very unusual. We really fancied Ryan [Moore]'s horse [Astrology] and an awful lot of things could have happened, but Joseph wanted to come with a long sustained run. When a horse can give distance away and go up into those gears and still mow horses down like that, it's incredible. I think he was only going away at the line and he has an awful lot of different options now."

Sequence Settles For Second-Best...

Main Sequence's rider Ted Durcan had no excuses afterwards and told *PA Sport*, "I got a good smooth run around with the winner behind me all the way. I got first run on him, but I ran into a better horse on the day." **Bonfire (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}), who was sent off the 9-2 second choice, raced freely early on and made no impression in the straight before finishing sixth. "Jimmy [Fortune] felt he wasn't in any way suited by the track, which was obvious watching it," trainer Andrew Balding said. "He was rolling in and getting disorganised. That is what Epsom is about--I thought he would handle it, but he didn't. Having said that, if he had he probably wouldn't have beaten the winner as Camelot must be exceptional. He's still a decent horse, so we'll re-group and look for something else."

French Fifteen had the pace to take Maisons-Laffitte's G3 Prix Djebel over seven furlongs on his seasonal reappearance Apr. 5 and the stamina to make Camelot work on a rain-softened surface at Newmarket. "Everything has gone well since Newmarket," trainer Nicolas Clement told *PA Sport*. "The horse has had a very good preparation, he looks great and is working great. He is drawn in stall 13 of 20, which I am happy with and we have Christophe Soumillon booked to ride, which is great. He is riding well and rode the horse in a piece of work on the racecourse 10 days ago and everything went well. He will be riding a patient race and we'll see what happens. It is his first time over the distance, so that is a question mark, but the way he ran over a mile at Newmarket on soft ground gives you hope he will stay." One important colt who was missing from the 2000 Guineas line-up was Iraj Parvizi's **Most Improved (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) and the sounds emerging from Manton this spring suggest that Classic was missing a key element. Third on only his third start in Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. in October, he will have to be every bit as smart as connections believe if he is to win this on his seasonal bow. "He is back in very good form now and working well," trainer Brian Meehan explained. "His chance, based on a close Dewhurst S. third to Parish Hall (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) and subsequent Irish 2,000 Guineas winner Power (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), is as good as any, while his middle draw in this 20-strong field should be no problem." Germany is represented by Gestut Winterhauch's Apr. 22 G3 Dr Busch-Memorial winner **Amaron (GB)** (Shamardal), who was a short neck ahead of the re-opposing **Gregorian (Ire)** (Clodovil {Ire}) when fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 13, while the Irish contingent is made up solely of Susan Magnier's unbeaten **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). The **TDN Rising Star** ⚡ overcame heavy ground and a wide trip to beat Thought Worthy (Dynaformer) in the Apr. 28 G3 Sandown Classic Trial and may have been a leading player in yesterday's Epsom Derby had he not been re-routed here.

Hard at work to shake off Middyay (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) at the finish of this race 12 months ago, St Nicholas Abbey made the whole process seem a lot easier when recording back-to-back successes in this race re-named in honor of the Diamond Jubilee. There had been much talk about his reversal at 2-5 in the G3 Mooresbridge S. at The Curragh May 7, but the one-time hot Derby favorite was only half-asleep in that contest used as a prep for this repeat bid. Wide awake back on the big stage, the livewire was reserved with only one behind by a confident Joseph O'Brien as the stable rabbit Robin Hood (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) set off in clear isolation to provide the favorite with a marker. Freewheeling into contention on the outer running downhill, the reigning BC Turf hero swept past Masked Marvel and to the front with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining and although his jockey dropped his whip a furlong out, St Nicholas Abbey needed no encouragement to slam overmatched rivals. "When he goes to sleep early in his races, he's a very special horse," his rider commented. "He has always shown a lot of ability and he's really coming back to his old form. I got to the front too soon, but he picked the bit up going past the four and I didn't want to disappoint him. When he relaxes and quickens up like that, it takes a very good one to go by."

This win means that St Nicholas Abbey continues his excellent record going left-handed, with only been defeat that way at the hands of the crack French performer Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan.

Nevertheless, Aidan O'Brien is looking at the major prizes on right-handed tracks for his immediate campaign. "He has the option of the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [at Royal Ascot June 20], the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 21] and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 7] at the end of the year," the Ballydoyle conditioner explained, while Derrick Smith added after welcoming back his 99th top-level scorer. "He has vindicated everything we thought of him and it was a procession--he was very impressive." Connections of the second and third are looking at stepping back up in trip, with the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh Sept. 15 mentioned as a long-term target for both.

Marketing Mix kicked off her 4-year-old campaign with an Apr. 11 Keeneland allowance win over Inglorious (Hennessy) and Hungry Island (More Than Ready), and reported home fourth behind the latter as the 3-2 chalk in Churchill's GII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile S. last time May 5.

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Moonlight Cloud was off the mark when her Classic credentials were tested in last year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, but she bounced back from a seventh in the Rowley Mile feature to run second in last year's renewal of this contest. Returning to the same seven-furlong chute to bag July's G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot back here next time, she earned a career high in the Aug. 7 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville before closing her sophomore campaign with a fifth in the Oct. 15 G2 British Champions Sprint at Ascot. Moonlight Cloud enjoyed considerable support at the tills for this reappearance, despite a hefty weight penalty incurred for the Maurice de Gheest score, and was restrained in mid division after an alert break. Making smooth progress once turning for home, the favorite was last off the bridle in the straight and swamped her rivals with an impressive turn of foot inside the final quarter mile to earn a fourth pattern-race score in dominant fashion. She won it last year and that will be her main objective once again. She's also in the [June 23 G1] Diamond Jubilee [S. at Royal Ascot] and it would be great to take on Black Caviar, but we'll see."

A REGAL ASSEMBLY

Fittingly on Britain's Diamond Jubilee weekend, Chantilly stages the G2 Prix de Sandringham today which is named after The Queen's Royal Stud in England. Formerly a prep for the G1 Prix de Diane, it is now used as a potential stepping stone to the G1 Coronation S. and this renewal features some exciting prospects for that Royal Ascot contest. Setting the form standard are Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Mashoorah (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) and Gerry Oldham's **Topeka (Ire)** (Whipper), who were first and fifth, respectively, in the G3 Prix Imprudence over seven furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 5 before taking separate Classic routes. While Mashoorah appeared not to stay this trip when down the field in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6, Topeka looked to relish the extra furlong when finishing strongly to be third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp a week later. Pandora Stud and Ahmed Mouknass's Mar. 27 Listed Prix la Camargo scorer **Lily America (Fr)** (American Post {GB}) and Haras de Saint Pair's **Bugie d'Amore (GB)** (Rail Link {GB}) add further weight to the line-up. The latter races for the Alain de Royer-Dupre barn for the first time, having been the only rival to beat subsequent G3 Premio Regina Elena and G2 Oaks d'Italia heroine Cherry Collect (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) in the G3 Premio Dormello at the San Siro in October. British interests rest with the May 18 Listed Michael Seely Memorial S. scorer **Laugh Out Loud (GB)** (Clodovil {Ire}), while Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's May 15 Listed Prix Volterra winner **Dark Orchid** (Dansili {GB}) hails from the Andre Fabre stable, which has been successful eight times, most recently with Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill) in 2001, and could be anything at this stage.

May 12. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Maxios (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}) has been given two confidence boosting 10-furlong conditions wins at Longchamp Apr. 8 and at Fontainebleau May 8 and the half-brother to the Niarchos Family's Bago (Fr) (Nashwan) still has time to reach his early potential.

Chantilly's five-furlong test of the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene offers no hiding place for the European sprinting brigade and potential opponents to Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) and her compatriots face a true sharpener ahead of Royal Ascot. Last year, Maeve Mahony's **Wizz Kid (Ire)** (Whipper) beat **Prohibit (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) by a head on weight-for-age terms and the pair square off against each other once again. Wizz Kid was subsequently second in Ascot's G1 British Champions Sprint S. in October and returned with a solid fifth under a penalty to the trail-blazing **Beyond Desire (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges over this trip at Longchamp May 13. Prohibit is being geared towards a repeat bid in the June 19 G1 King's Stand S. and trainer Robert Cowell told *PA Sport*, "If he can bounce back to form, he would be right in the shake-up and that would be his prep race for the King's Stand." Steve Parkin's Beyond Desire will be hard to pass if able to reproduce her Prix de Saint-Georges performance and conditioner Roger Varian commented, "She doesn't need much work at home, so she has just been ticking over nicely since her win at Longchamp. She seems in as good a form as ever and I'm very hopeful that she'll run another solid race at that level."

Today's G2 German 1000 Guineas at Dusseldorf has an open feel to it, with very little separating a clutch of domestic hopefuls and a solid contender from Britain in **Electrelane (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}). She was a length second to today's G2 Prix de Sandringham protagonist Laugh Out Loud (GB) (Clodovil {Ire}) in York's Listed Michael Seely Memorial S. when last seen May 18 and it may be significant that the first two drew 10 lengths clear of smart fillies there. Eckhard Sauren's **Survey (Ger)** (Big Shuffle), who appears to be the best of the German hopes, beat **Ilena (Ger)** (Areion {Ger}) by 3/4 of a length, with the re-opposing **Paraisa (GB)** (Red Ransom) a nose away in third, in the G3 Schwarzgold/Rennen over this trip at Cologne May 13. Gestut Rottgen's **Dessau (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) was second behind subsequent G2 Diana-Trial winner Monami (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}) in the G3 Preis der Winterkonigin at Baden-Baden in October, where Paraisa was again third. She returned to give **Cherry Danon (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) two pounds when nosing her out of the Listed Henkel-Stutenpreis over this track and trip last time Dusseldorf May 1. On that occasion, Gestut Brummerhof's **Waldtraut (Ger)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) proved a disappointment when three lengths away in third as the even-money favorite, but there is a feeling that the Andreas Wohler trainee has more to offer.

SOPHOMORE SEASON, ACT TWO

A solid group of seven 3-year-old colts, many of whom had Classic aspirations dashed for one reason or another, face off in today's GIII Affirmed H. over 1 1/16 miles at Betfair Hollywood Park. Headlining the show is the Bob Baffert-trained **Liaison** (Indian Charlie), the lone runner in the field who lined up on the first Saturday in May, and who ran a credible sixth in the GI Kentucky Derby, seven lengths behind I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). Liaison ensured himself a spot in Churchill's starting gate back in December when

he posted the slight upset in the GI CashCall Futurity S. over today's course and distance, but entered the Derby as a rank 56-1 outsider after a disappointing spring that saw him lose his jock in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. in February, followed by unplaced efforts in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 10 and GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 7. Baffert also saddles the GIII Laz Barerra S. third **Gun Boat** (Congrats). Trainer John Sadler was always high on the ability of **Holy Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}), even though it took the gray four attempts to break his maiden. He did so impressively at Santa Anita Mar. 23 in an effort that earned him ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status, and Holy Candy far from shamed himself when a late-closing fourth in the GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 14. The John Shirreffs-trained **Blingo** (Artie Schiller) is another who gives the impression that we've only scratched the surface of his innate talent. A first-out winner on the grass, he ran sixth in both the CashCall and in the San Felipe on the main track, before returning to the sod to win the La Puente S. at Santa Anita Apr. 20. It's an open question whether he's strictly a turf horse, but his connections' faith is encouraging.

CASSE FIELDS TRIO IN WOODBINE OAKS

Trainer Mark Casse holds a hot hand entering today's \$500,000 Woodbine Oaks in Toronto, with a trio of sophomore fillies in with a chance in the 1 1/8-mile Classic. Two of those--**Northern Passion** (First Samurai) and **Dixie Strike** (Dixie Union)--are owned by John Oxley. The uncoupled pair is led by the 6-5 morning-line choice Dixie Strike, who made an eye-catching return to Woodbine when easily defeating Tu Endie Wei (Johar) in the GIII Selene S. going a half-furlong shorter May 13. Winner of the Ontario Lassie S. here last December, the bay miss opened her season with a tally in the grassy Florida Oaks at Tampa Feb. 4 before running fourth (placed third via DQ) in the GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream Mar. 11. Back on synthetics, she was fifth in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 7 before heading north once again. Dixie Strike is a half-sister to last year's Oaks winner--and later Queen's Plate heroine--Inglorious (Hennessy). Northern Passion, the 5-2 second choice, took a near identical path here this year. Winner of the GIII Natalma S. on the turf at Woodbine last September, she was a close-up fourth in the Florida Oaks, then finished sixth (placed fifth) in the Herecomesthebride. In her own return to Canada, she rallied to victory in the seven-furlong Fury S. over the main track Apr. 29. The last of the trio is the longshot **Black Bird Rock** (Flower Alley), who overcame trouble to break her maiden impressively going two turns here Apr. 28 and, despite her inexperience, wouldn't be a shock.

WRITERS UP

THE OAKS TEST - A GUIDE TO BREEDING

By Richard Zachariah

The late Jim Fleming, an astute grocer with an eye for a horse, always said his preferred choice was to breed from Oaks winners. Luckily, Jim made millions from selling Australian's their staple diet and he could afford to buy the expensive staying fillies off the track.

And Fleming's maxim worked--from his boutique Tyreel Stud outside Sydney he bred many Goup 1 winners and regularly topped yearling sales with sparkling colts and luminous fillies from Oaks-winning mums.

Jim would have liked the look of Saturday's Queensland Oaks winner Quintessential, whose dour run through driving rain in the Eagle Farm mud would have delighted any stud master looking to breed toughness and durability into their horses.

Although bred in that brilliant nursery of stayers, New Zealand, Quintessential is not of the Classic mould. She is by Australian-bred sprinter Fast 'n' Famous, an unheralded son of Danehill's champion sire Redoute's Choice, shipped to New Zealand in 2007 without remorse from Australian breeders. However, like his breed-shaping grandfather Danehill, he may be on the road to get sons and daughters who race and win over all distances.

Quintessential was favored Friday, but eased slightly on track with bookmakers as his trainer, John Sargent, the owner of an impressive and most un-trainer like bushy moustache, told anyone who would listen that he thought the heavy rain had washed away his chances.

Yes the filly had run third in very heavy going in New Zealand, but he feared the Eagle Farm track--diced up by horses in six previous races--would not be to the filly's liking and spell the end of his dreams of winning his first Group 1 in Australia.

And the Queensland Oaks is not just any Group 1, it is a 'major' to anyone who has even the most cursory interest in pedigree pages or the genetic make up of Australian Thoroughbreds.

There are good reasons. The Queensland Oaks is run over the Classic mile and a half in the last months of the 3-year-old season and is a true test of mature fillies held in the winter in the north where the law of averages say the weather is lengths better than that in the frosty southern states.

Like Florida, the famed Queensland sunshine attracts trainers who are only human when it comes to early morning comfort and so you have the time-honored Oaks providing fillies who go on to greater things like the Caulfield and Melbourne Cups in November and later to the breeding barn.



Australia's best female line stems from a Queensland Oaks winner, Denise's Joy (Aus) (Seventh Hussar {Fr}), whose own daughter Joie Denise (Aus) (Danehill) also won the race. They have gone on to give us 'blue hen' and Oaks winner Sunday Joy (Aus) (Sunday Silence), her daughter Tuesday Joy (NZ) (Carnegie {Ire}), and current standout More Joyous (NZ) (More Than Ready), a candidate for Horse of the Year in any other season that didn't include Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}).

Ethereal (NZ) (Rhythm), dashed from last to win the 2001 renewal of the Oaks before becoming the first horse trained by a woman to win the Melbourne Cup in the spring.

This year's edition was seen as an even race without a standout although the New Zealanders who had won the two previous years were leading betting markets. Given the deteriorating conditions it became a guessing game with trainers totally at a loss as to which of the 17 starters, including the three New Zealand-trained fillies, would enjoy the wintry track.

In the murky light Quintessential shone from gate one and, aided by the local knowledge of Brisbane horseman Damien Brown, used no extra effort until asked 600 meters from home to go around tiring horses.

From that point on Quintessential made it her race-beating home fellow Kiwi-bred and Australian-trained Eliza Blues and Vittoria--bringing joy to the syndicate of owners who forked out NZ\$70,000 for her at the 2010 NZ bloodstock sales.

As Quintessential completed this real staying test in style I tried to fathom the inexact science of how a daughter of an Australian sprinter could win a slogging saga like this, which must have felt like two miles at the finish.

Bloodhorses will always bemuse and confuse.

Quintessential's mother is an unraced American-bred mare called Florette by Del Mar Grade II winner Sword Dancer (Ire).

Nothing remarkable there until you look deeper.

There is Nijinsky as sire of Sword Dancer and Florette's dam is by Roberto.

So two of the greats came together to make this Oaks winner, yet finally the answer to the puzzle lies in Fast 'n' Famous.

His dam is by Zabeel (NZ)--the son of Sir Tristram and grandson of Sir Ivor--now as famous as his father as an Australasian staying influence.

Breeding is really simple after all.

EXCHANGE WAGERING TABLED IN CA

Proponents of exchange wagering in California were dealt a blow Friday after the board of the Thoroughbred Owners of California (TOC) tabled a vote on the controversial form of betting for a year. The betting and broadcasting conglomerate Betfair TVG had hoped to launch exchange wagering in California this year. "The concept of exchange wagering has been a polarizing issue among the stakeholders in California racing, and this action will give us additional time to study this betting alternative and consider if it is in the best interests of the industry in our state," said TOC Chairman Mike Pegram.

At the same meeting, the TOC said it "achieved one of its major goals of recent years" by approving a proposal from Stronach Group Racing (SGR) that would allow TVG to broadcast racing from Santa Anita Park and Golden Gate Fields in return for the Stronach-controlled HRTV to be able to broadcast Del Mar and Hollywood Park.

"The lack of uniform distribution of the California product both in the Golden State and nationwide has been a primary concern for the TOC as it seeks to increase revenue for purses, especially in Northern California, where the horsemen race for considerably less money than in the south," added Pegram.

Officials at Betfair TVG, however, said that they had little knowledge of the proposal, and harshly criticized the TOC's actions in a situation that once again highlighted the labyrinth of overlapping interests both in California and nationally. SGR owns both Santa Anita and Golden Gate, as well as Xpressbet.com, the advance deposit wagering company. In March, Betfair, which owns TVG and is a potential rival to Xpressbet, acquired the naming rights for Hollywood Park, now called Betfair Hollywood Park.

On Saturday, Betfair issued a strongly worded response, calling it, "a bleak day for California horse racing," and adding, "Not only has the TOC turned down millions of dollars of guaranteed revenue in 2012, it has aligned itself to a track ownership group with a long record of broken promises. We look forward to a fuller explanation of their motives because, presently, any rational observer who takes time to examine the full facts behind this decision will struggle to comprehend it. We are bemused by the TOC's release, announcing its 'approval' to a proposal from the Stronach Group for which TVG, Del Mar and Hollywood Park must be party. Astonishingly, none of TVG, Del Mar, or Hollywood Park had any prior knowledge of and have not indicated any interest in, the television rights proposal."

Betfair went on to say, "From what little we know about the way this deal would be structured, it benefits no one except tracks owned by the Stronach Group, their Xpressbet ADW provider and their HRTV network. The current complex pricing structure of TV rights means millions of dollars in wagering revenue would flow to the Stronach Group if this agreement were adopted, and it delivers nothing for Del Mar, Hollywood Park or TVG. We will work with racing interests in other states and for other breeds within California to implement exchange wagering to help their businesses grow while the TOC further considers its position on exchange wagering, the statute for which has been on the books in California already for two years."

Betfair operates a financially successful exchange wagering operation in the UK and is trying to break into the U.S. market, but has come up against stiff opposition. John Sadler, president of the California Thoroughbred Trainers Association, has repeatedly said that exchange wagering threatens the sport's integrity, while others have worried that tracks and horsemen might not get an adequate share of the revenue.

"We will continue to seek alternative-revenue sources and have not slammed the door closed on the concept of exchange wagering," said TOC President Lou Raffetto. "We are simply putting this contentious issue on the back burner until we can analyze it further and, hopefully, build a consensus within the industry."

The TOC noted that both Del Mar and Hollywood Park are currently under exclusive broadcasting agreements with TVG and that none of the parties has agreed to the proposal.

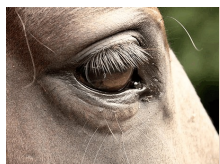
