## HANSEN TO MISS WOODY STEPHENS

Last year's juvenile champion **Hansen** (Tapit) will be forced to miss Saturday's GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont Park after a routine blood test revealed a depleted red blood cell count. "On him, we routinely do [blood tests], and when we did it this morning, that's what we discovered," trainer Mike Maker explained. "He's got a little low red blood cell count, and we didn't want to risk, with the ship and the race and everything, to knock him down even further. So, we elected to pass the race." Hansen has not raced since finishing ninth in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby. "It would have been a nice race to compete in, being a big day and all, but it's not the end of the world," Maker said. "It's a minor issue, so we'll get it handled and get him back in the entries before too long."

## MADCAP ESCAPADE DIES

Grade I winner and producer **Madcap Escapade** (Hennessy--Sassy Pants, by Saratoga Six) died Saturday after complications from colic. Owned by Bruce Lunsford and Hill 'n' Dale Farms, the 11-year-old mare won the 2004 GI Ashland S., as well as the GII Princess Rooney H., GII Forward Gal S. and GII Shirley Jones H. She was third in the GI Kentucky Oaks. On the board in eight of nine starts, the bay won seven times and earned \$1,052,852.

Madcap Escapade, carrying her first foal, sold to Hill 'n' Dale for \$6 million at the 2006 Keeneland November sale. That first foal was **Mi Sueno** (Pulpit), a \$1.7-million Keeneland November weanling purchased by Southern Equine in 2007. The filly went on to win the 2009 GI Darley Debutante S. The mare's 2008 foal, **California** (A.P. Indy), sold for \$1 million to the bid of Demi O'Byrne at the 2009 Keeneland September sale. She has a yearling filly by Unbridled's Song and produced a colt by Malibu Moon this spring.

"We have retained an A.P. Indy filly out of Madcap Escapade [Divine Escapade] who is unraced and in foal to War Front and will race her 2-year-old colt by Unbridled's Song," said John G. Sikura, President of Hill 'n' Dale Farms. "Madcap Escapade was a fantastic race mare and well on her way to becoming a great broodmare. We are terribly saddened by the loss. She will be buried on the farm next to Hill 'n' Dale foundation mare Daijin."

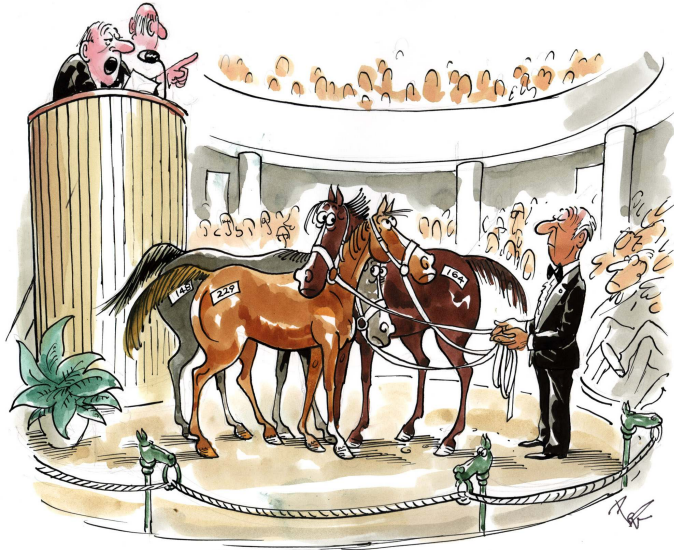

### I'll Have Another Relocates Today (cont. from p1)

O'Neill thinks the Belmont Stakes barn may help educate critics of the sport. "Just the transparency that our game probably lacks is key," he said. "You get a lot of commentary from people who don't know the horses, who don't know the horsemen, and don't know how they're cared for. This way you have everyone in an isolated vicinity and everyone who wants to come and kind of watch what's going on there and make a judgment from what's really happening and not guessing what's going on in that guy's locker room or that guy's locker room. I think it's a good thing. The obvious negative thing is a lot of horses do get distracted when they change stalls. It sounds silly, but it happens. Hopefully I'll Have Another won't get distracted, that none of the other horses get distracted, they all settle in good, they all present themselves well, and it's a nice, clean-run race, and at the end of the day people can say, 'Wow, they were all looked after and they all ran great.'"

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners.

Jockey Mario Gutierrez is scheduled to arrive in New York today. He is expected to take a tour of the Belmont oval with former rider Richard Migliore and he is named to ride O'Neill's **Boxeur des Rues** (Smart Strike) in the 1 1/2-mile GII Brooklyn H. at Belmont Friday.

### Guyana Star Dweej Works

**Guyana Star Dweej** (Eddington) turned in a half-mile work over Belmont's main track Monday in :49.06. He galloped out five furlongs in 1:02.39. After the work, trainer Doodnauth Shvimgal confirmed the colt would start in Saturday's GI Belmont S. Kent Desormeaux was aboard for Monday's work and has the call in the Belmont.

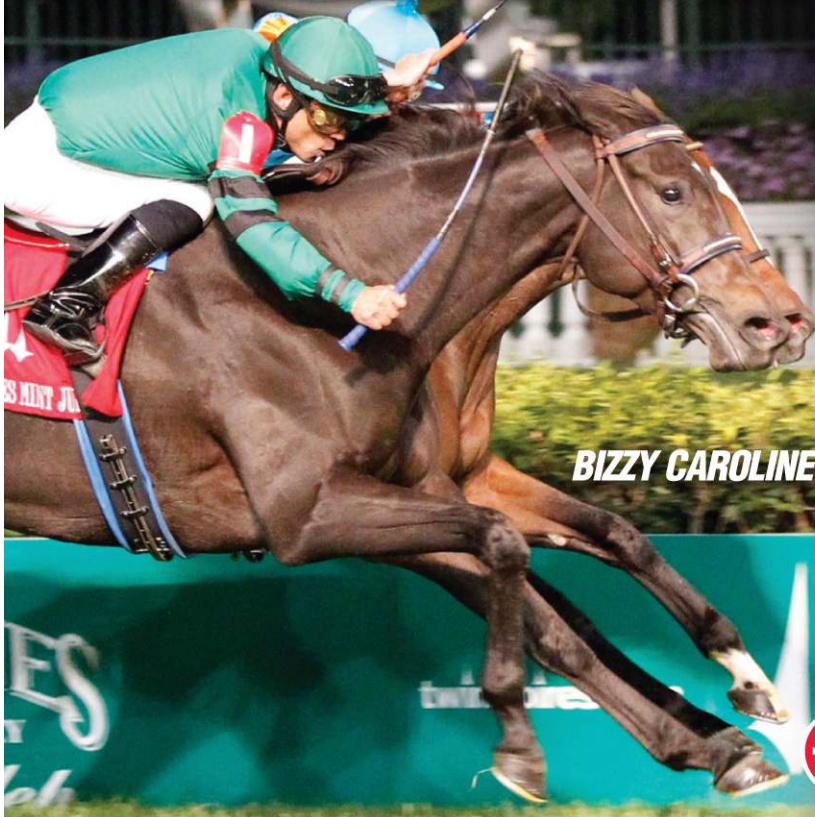
### "War Horse" Cast Members Visit Belmont

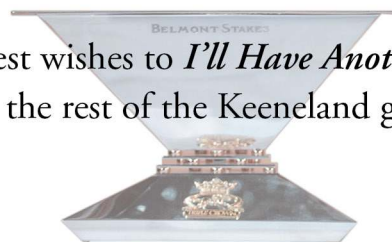

### NATIONAL YEARLING SALE STARTS TODAY

The Magic Millions National Yearling Sale begins today at 11 a.m. at the Gold Coast Sales Complex. The three-day auction features siblings to five Group 1 winners, 15 Group 2 winners and 14 Group 3 winners. Group 1-winning mares with yearlings in the catalogue include champion **Bramble Rose (NZ)** (Shinko King {Ire}), whose colt by Sebring (Aus) is [hip 1320](#); and **Ellicorsam (Aus)** (Fimiston {Aus}), whose Redoute's Choice (Aus) colt is [hip 1377](#). **Sydney's Dream (Aus)** (Bletchingly {Aus}), dam of Group 1 winner Charge Forward (Aus) (Red Ransom), has a Redoute's Choice (Aus) colt catalogued as [hip 1255](#). During last year's select portion of the National Yearling Sale, 276 horses sold for A\$8,719,500. The average was A\$31,592.

### OBS JUNE SUPPLEMENT ON-LINE

The supplemental catalogue to the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's June Sale of Two-Year-Olds and Horses of Racing Age is now available on-line at [www.obssales.com](http://www.obssales.com). The 43 supplemented horses will sell after the older horses section as hips 681 through 723 on the second day of the two-day auction and will breeze during the sale's third under tack session June 17.

The sale's under tack show has been divided into three sessions, June 15-17. Each session begins at 7:30 a.m. Hips 1-240 breeze Friday, followed by 231-480 on Saturday and 481-723 on Sunday. The sale gets underway at 10:30 a.m. on June 19 and 20.

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### FLY LEXIS FLY POINTED TO SWAPS

Peruvian dual classic winner **Fly Lexis Fly** (Badge of Silver), who has not started since scoring a dominating 10 3/4-length victory against older Southern Hemisphere foes in the G1 Derby National (Peruvian Derby) to cap off his 2011 campaign on Nov. 13, has returned to training and will most likely make his North American debut in the GIII Swaps S. at Betfair Hollywood Park July 4. "I am very happy with his improvement, he just worked a very smooth four furlongs at Betfair Hollywood Park this morning," trainer Neil Drysdale said of his colt's second workout since resuming training. Drysdale clocked the Badge of Silver colt galloping out a very easy four furlongs in :50.80 handily on the cushion track. Fly Lexis Fly, last year's champion 3-year-old colt in Peru, arrived at Drysdale's barn in Southern California in the winter after winning three of five starts in Peru for owner Oscar Peña's Stud Doña Licha and trainer Arturo Morales.

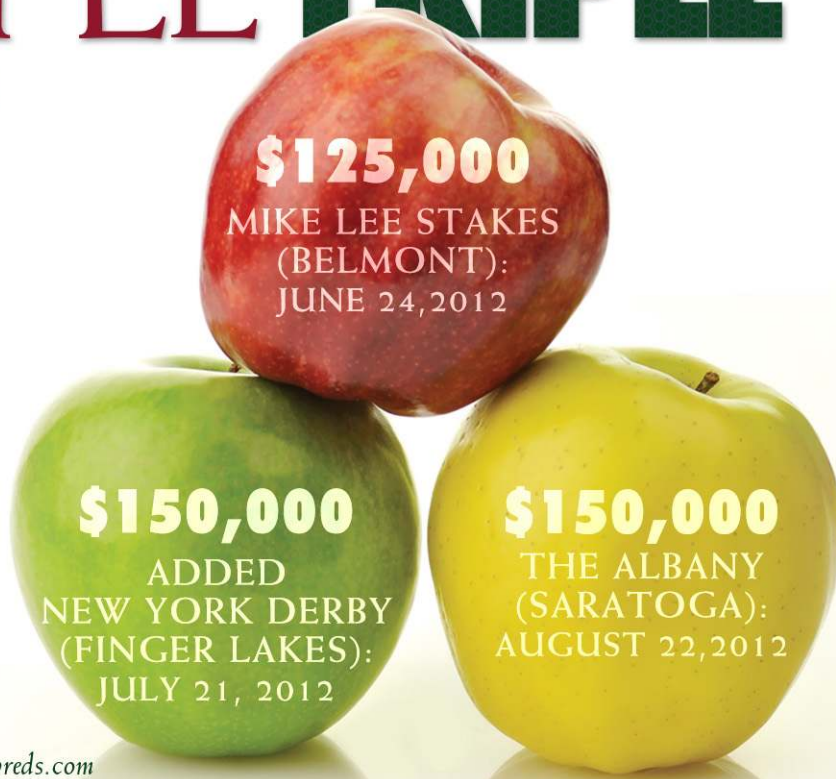

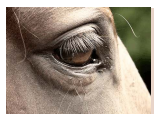

Any notable achievement needs putting into perspective, so how exceptional is Montjeu's feat of siring a fourth Epsom Derby winner in the space of eight years? The quick answer is that it stamps him as one of the most important stallions in the Derby's 233-year history, and the most successful of the modern era.

No stallion has ever succeeded in siring more than four winners of the Epsom Classic, and Montjeu is only the fifth to reach that arduous milestone. He is preceded by the 1787 Derby winner Sir Peter Teazle (whose quartet scored during the nine years between 1798 and 1806); the 1793 Derby hero Waxy (sire of four winners in seven years in the early 1800s); Cyllene (four in eight years in the early 1900s, before being sold to Argentina as a 13-year-old); and Blandford (four in seven years between 1929 and 1935, before dying--like Montjeu--at the age of 16). **Cont. p7**

## ANOTHER NEW STAKES WINNER

Six days after AQUAPAZZA won the Opelousas S., AMERICAN LADY, a \$230,000 yearling purchase, became Stormy Atlantic's **69th Stakes Winner** with her victory in the Reminiscing S. Owned by Kaleem Shah, Inc., she has finished first or second in 5 of 6 career starts.

Bearing in mind how much the Thoroughbred population has grown over the centuries, I would be happy to accept that Montjeu's achievement is even more meritorious than those of his predecessors. Although he enjoyed a considerable numerical advantage over the stallions of yore, racing is now more competitive and specialized. Multiple Classic winners are far less frequent than in the eras when the likes of Cyllene and Blandford operated. For example, as many as seven colts landed the Triple Crown in the 18 years between 1886 and 1903, and it was in 1902 that the legendary filly Sceptre won the 2000 Guineas, 1000 Guineas, Oaks and St Leger. Even in Blandford's era, it wasn't unusual for a colt to win more than one Classic, as three of his Derby winners showed. Trigo and Windsor Lad also won the St Leger, while Bahram won the Triple Crown in 1935.

It is relevant to Camelot that only one colt--the majestic Nijinsky in 1970--has managed to win the Triple Crown since Bahram, and it is wonderful news that the magnetism of the Triple Crown seems to be gripping Camelot's connections.

Incidentally, Nijinsky was one of the few modern stallions to have been responsible for as many as three Epsom Derby winners, the other being his peerless sire Northern Dancer. Between them Camelot's sire, grandsire and great-grandsire sired the magnificent total of nine Derby winners in the space of little more than 40 years. The Northern Dancer male line has also provided nine other winners during that period.

Of course, Montjeu's Classic success hasn't been limited to the Derby. In addition to Motivator, Authorized, Pour Moi and Camelot, Montjeu was also responsible for the Irish Derby winners Hurricane Run, Frozen Fire and Fame And Glory, plus the St Leger winners Scorpion and Masked Marvel. Another son, Montmartre, won the Grand Prix de Paris, a race which is nowadays a nearer equivalent to the Derby than the Prix du Jockey-Club. For good measure, Montjeu's four visits to New Zealand early in his stallion career yielded two winners of the Australian Derby.

In assessing Montjeu, I believe it is essential to remember that he wasn't able to cover nearly as many mares in recent years as Galileo, his arch rival and stud companion. The figures for the five years from 2007 to 2011 stand at 98, 96, 101, 115 and 92 mares for Montjeu, compared to 190, 206, 189, 175 and 214 for Galileo. Pour Moi and Camelot both come from crops numbering "only" 77, and there are only around 80 Montjeu 2-year-olds this year. *Cont. p8*

Now that Montjeu is no longer with us (he succumbed to septicaemia in late-March), his colts from his last two full crops will be like gold dust at the 2012 and 2013 yearling sales.

It is surely encouraging to Camelot's connections that Montjeu has sired two winners of the St Leger, as well as winners of the all-aged St Leger equivalents in Ireland (Jukebox Jury) and France (Montare). This record reflects the sizeable amount of stamina which can be found in the bottom half of Montjeu's pedigree. Group races over 1 15/16 miles at Longchamp feature strongly on his relative's resumes. His dam Floripedes stayed well enough to finish second in the French St Leger (Prix Royal-Oak), while Floripedes' broodmare sire Tennyson won the Grand Prix de Paris in the days when it was contested over that same distance. Floripedes' half-brother Dadarissime was a Group 2 winner over that same demanding trip, and her dam Toute Cy was a sister to Le Mamamouchi, a Group 3 winner over 1 7/8 miles as a 3-year-old.

Stamina, or lack of it, is often dictated by a horse's temperament. Although Montjeu's progeny have a reputation for being high-mettled, it clearly hasn't been a significant obstacle for many of them, and Camelot has shown himself very amenable to restraint. No one can say for sure that the St Leger distance will pose no problems for a colt whose first two dams were sired by the miler Kingmambo and the sprinter-miler Danehill, but there are grounds for optimism. Kingmambo sired the 2004 St Leger winner Rule of Law from a speedy mare, whereas Danehill is the grandsire of the 2010 winner Arctic Cosmos. Then there's the fact that Montjeu ranks alongside Saddlers' Hall and Galileo as one of three sons of Sadler's Wells to have sired a St Leger winner--a feat Sadler's Wells himself achieved in 2001 and 2003, thanks to Milan and Brian Boru.

It is also encouraging that Camelot's female line was never short of stamina (hence the desire to try to add speed via the likes of Kingmambo and Danehill). His fourth dam One Over Parr thrived over a mile and a half, winning the Cheshire Oaks and Lancashire Oaks, without showing as much ability as her Oaks-winning sister Polygamy. The next dam, Seventh Bride, was a very useful performer at up to a mile and a half--a distance which brought out the best in her talented dam Little Miss Muffet. For the record, this female line traces all the way back to the legendary Kincsem. Bred in Hungary in 1874, Kincsem remained unbeaten in 54 starts, including the Goodwood Cup on her only visit to England.

If Camelot triumphs at Doncaster in September, he too will be talked about long after he has gone.

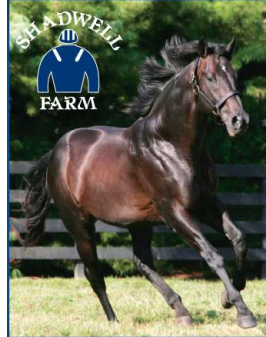
