RAIL-SKIMMING 'RAGS' UP IN BELMONT

It has been something of a tumultuous sophomore season thus far for Chadds Ford Stable's **Union Rags** (Dixie Union), but nothing about 150 seconds couldn't undo. Given a perfect ground-saving ride by John Velazquez, the handsome bay colt needed every inch of the stretch, but fought through an opening inside pacesetter **Paynter** (Awesome Again) for a neck victory in yesterday's GI Belmont S. *Cont. p3*

TACTICAL TAPITFLY LANDS JUST A GAME

Reverting to more positive tactics, similar to those that saw her win the 2009 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, Frank Jones's **Tapitsfly** (Tapit) made the running in Saturday's GI Longines Just a Game S. and showed European-like turn of foot to best favored **Winter Memories** (El Prado {Ire}) by 2 1/4 lengths. "Looking on paper, there was no speed," noted winning rider Ramon Dominguez. "I was pretty happy when I got to the paddock and [Trainer] Dale said to me 'Try to put her on the lead.' It worked out beautifully. She relaxed for me. Turning for home, she gave a great kick." *Cont. p4*

Coming Full Circle...

Fourteen months after their Big Brown (Boundary) was eased in the Belmont S., IEAH Stables signed the ticket on the Dixie Union colt out of Tempo (Gone West) for \$145,000 at Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga Selected Yearling Sale in the summer of 2010. They offered the bay at the same auction house's Florida Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale, and he attracted the eye of many a horse identifier, including his breeder, who either had seller's remorse or just wanted a Classic-looking racehorse. Phyllis Wyeth purchased the horse who would become Union Rags on a bid of \$390,000 and soon turned him over to Michael Matz, who conditioned Barbaro (Dynaformer) to a dominating victory in the 2006 GI Kentucky Derby. And her re-acquisition did little to disappoint early on.

Top of the Crop...

Union Rags rallied from seventh of nine to take his five-furlong debut over the Delaware main track July 12 before decimating the field by 7 1/4 lengths in a sloppy renewal of the GII Saratoga Special S. at Saratoga Aug. 15. He skipped the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. in September in favor of the GI Champagne S. the following month. Sent off the 6-5 chalk that afternoon, Union Rags was patiently ridden and was snookered at a crucial stage for about a quarter of a mile, but streaked away when the daylight came to hand Alpha (Bernardini) a 5 1/4-length defeat. Favored to complete an undefeated campaign in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he sat a disastrous four-wide trip as Hansen (Tapit) set the pace inside. He couldn't quite get to the pacesetter and settled for second, his Eclipse dreams dashed. He began 2012 with obviously high expectations and suggested he'd be the divisional heavy with an effortless four-length score in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 26. A somewhat disappointing third following a questionable ride in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 31, Union Rags was bounced around at the start of the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby, was taken up nearing the half-mile pole and did exceeding well to finish seventh, 7 1/2 lengths behind I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). Would there be a 'Rags-to-riches' story in the Belmont?

Hoping for a Cleaner Trip...

In an effort to change their luck, connections made a switch from Julien Leparoux to John Velazquez, who won his first Belmont astride the filly Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy) in 2007. Unmolested at the break this time around, Union Rags drifted back to about midfield as upstart and third wagering choice Paynter (Awesome Again) was ridden for speed by Mike Smith, already second aboard Bodemeister (Empire Maker) in the Derby and GI Preakness S. Following an opening quarter mile in a fairly quick :23.72, Paynter was then allowed to cover an internal half-mile in :51 as positions remained largely unchanged with another six furlongs still ahead of them. Velazquez took a look behind him shortly thereafter and asked Union Rags to get just a touch closer to Paynter, who picked up the tempo a bit and covered the mile in 1:38.85. Atigun and Leparoux moved in unison with Union Rags, though forced overland, but loomed a serious threat four wide at the quarter pole. Paynter, looking to give Ahmed Zayat his first Classic victory after several agonizing defeats, hit the eighth pole still going well, but Smith had vacated the fence and left an inviting opening for Union Rags and Velazquez to go through, if good enough. And that Union Rags proved, as he dug in tenaciously and grabbed the long-time leader in the final 40 yards for a hard-earned success. "We always thought this horse had Triple Crown potential," a clearly relieved Matz commented. "When we trained him, we gave him four races as a 2-year-old and gave him a rest and had a good plan. He never missed a beat. His first race couldn't have been any easier. He had trouble in his second race and his third race. I do really think that this horse, when he has a clean trip and can show himself, is one of the best 3-year-olds in this crop. Whether he could have done something against I'll Have Another, I don't know, but it sure would have been fun to see." Z Curse...

Pioneerofthe Nile, Nehro, Bodemeister and now Paynter. All have carried the silks of Zayat Stables to runner-up finishes--most of the excruciating variety--in Classics over the last few years. "Heartbreaking defeat. A heartbreaking defeat," said Zayat, whose Justin Phillip (First Samurai) was run down late in the GI True North H. earlier on the program. "He ran his guts out. It's just his [fifth] race. What do they call that race, the 'Test of the Champion?' To go a mile and a half the way he did, in only his [fifth] race, I am very lucky to have him."

Dullahan Struggles at Big Sandy...

Dullahan (Even the Score), third in the GI Kentucky Derby and the post-time favorite for the Belmont S., raced in the latter half of the field early on and never really kicked it in, finishing seventh. "I don't think he really liked the track today," commented jockey Javier Castellano, who was in the irons for the first time. "He's the type of horse who likes the turf or Polytrack more. The track was a little deep today and he kind of struggled a little bit." Added trainer Dale Romans, "The race unfolded like it looked on paper to me. Paynter ran a big race, they all ran big, Union Rags ran big; we just didn't have a finishing kick. This is a good horse, a very good horse. I was sure he was going to run a really big one. It's disappointing."

The Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf winner of 2009, Tapitsfly missed her entire 3-year-old season and found the winner's circle just once in nine starts in 2011. Third, beaten a head, in the GIII Marshuas River S. at Gulfstream Jan. 7, the homebred was along late to register a half-length victory in the GII Honey Fox S. Mar. 18. She tried in vain to make a run from midfield in a pacesetter renewal of the GI Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland Apr. 14 and could do no better than third and she was exiting a runner-up effort to Hungry Island in the GII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile May 5 in which she led into the final furlong before succumbing by a length. She was entered for last Saturday's GIII Mint Julep S. at Churchill, and the choice to scratch out of there proved a wise one. Using the inside draw to his advantage and capitalizing on a dearth of speed, Ramon Dominguez sent Tapitsfly to the front and covered the opening half-mile in a solid :46.44. She threw in a third quarter mile in :23.04, still holding firm to a two-length advantage, and went her final two panels in :22.86 to seal the deal. Winter Memories was kept in the clear, but couldn't outkick the winner and settled for second. "A mile is her best distance," said winning trainer Dale Romans in the midst of a career year. "She's proven that several times. We'll look around the country, but most likely Saratoga [for her next start]. She likes to run and she's just so sound and does things so right. She wants to win. She's competitive." He added, "Frank Jones, my father trained for him when I was born, so it's always good to win for him. Plus, I bought her mother for him as a race filly. It's been good. She's like a member of the family."

Desert Blanc took the first three starts of his career for Pascal Bary, following a Longchamp maiden win June 4 with a Deauville all-weather conditions success July 8. The bay validated favoritism in the Listed Prix de Tourgeville on the turf at Deauville July 31, then endured a tough trip when third beaten a length and a nose in the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange Sept. 17. The bay closed out the European portion of his career with a well-beaten eighth-place effort behind Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre) and Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Dollar Oct. 1 at Longchamp and made his Stateside debut in the Fort Marcy, leading past the furlong marker before getting run down by Boisterous by a length.

Whereas he was off slowly in the Fort Marcy, Desert Blanc was away without incident and held the rail into the first turn before allowing Hudson Steele (Johannesburg) to lead and took a sit just off his heels. Content to save ground beneath Ramon Dominguez, it was increasingly apparent that the British-bred was going to need some luck, as Papaw Bodie and Brilliant Speed (Dynaformer) stacked up to his outside and left him in jail. Still galloping just behind Hudson Steele turning for home, he came out to the two path and jumped onto his incorrect lead, but was able to bull his way through and outfought a game Papaw Bodie for a narrow victory. "I had a great trip," Dominguez stated. "I was fortunate enough to get in between horses turning for home and he was pretty determined to get up. I was concerned about the lack of early speed but I just trying to do my best to keep him cool and we prevailed at the end." Added Javier Castellano aboard the beaten favorite, "I had a beautiful trip. That's what I expected. There was no speed in the race. The way the fractions were, he was pretty comfortable on the lead. I didn't want to take away from the way he wanted to go. Nobody wanted to go the lead. It worked out great for me. The horse responded really well today."

Acclamation, the two-time defending titleist in this event, hadn't faced the starter since winning the GII Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship S. at Santa Anita Oct. 2. That capped a season that included victories in the GI Pacific Classic and GI Eddie Read H., and wound up earning him Eclipse Award honors as champion older horse. A foot bruise kept him from starting back earlier this season, but, reunited with troubled rider Pat Valenzuela, the 6-year-old started as the even-money choice. Acclamation jumped away well and assumed his usual spot on the front end. He was allowed to get away with six furlongs in 1:14 4/5, which pretty much spelled doom for the others. The champ drifted out in the lane and Slim Shadey did his best to cut the margin down, but Acclamation was never in serious danger late. "I've been working out a lot and doing my cardiovascular work," commented a rejuvenated Patrick Valenzuela. "I had plenty of horse the whole time. He relaxed on the lead and when they came to me on the last turn, I just asked him a little and he picked it up nice. Going that far, they were going to go :48 and change, :49 pace anyway. I'm glad [jockey] Eswan [Flores on Barney Rebel] didn't use his horse to try and make it a speed duel. But my horse would have put him away and kept running anyway. (Warren) has done a tremendous job bring him back to where he was at today. I feel that he's going to improve off this race. Coming back off an eight month layoff with a setback and a month in between, he did a great job. This is just a tremendous horse. I feel like Acclamation does, really good."

Trinniberg gave his connections some consolation for the injury suffered earlier by Giant Ryan (Freud) and cemented his status as the leading sprinter of his generation with a front-running victory in the Woody Stephens. Runner-up to Currency Swap in the GI Three Chimneys S. last September and in the GII Nashua S. the following month, the dark bay attended a blistering pace in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint and faded to seventh behind Secret Circle (Eddington). The Triple Crown nominee returned in style, taking the GIII Swale S. by a half-dozen lengths Mar. 10 at Gulfstream, then parlayed a soft trip into a three-length score over Hardened Wildcat (Hard Spun) in Aqueduct's GIII Bay Shore S. Apr. 7. When his connections decided to try Trinniberg in the GI Kentucky Derby, he was expected to take them as far as he could for as long as he could. He ran into a roadblock named Bodemeister (Empire Maker), who led through six furlongs in 1:09 4/5, and Trinniberg, as most expected, had run his race and was eased home for all intents and purposes. They even toyed with a run in the GI Preakness if Bodemeister didn't show up, but wisely backed down from that and returned to the one-turn game here. Quickly into stride, Trinniberg was joined--somewhat surprisingly--by his Hopeful conqueror and the duo raced through an opening fraction of :22.30, as Il Villano, restrained off the pace, held the fence from third. The front two began to sneak away a bit at the quarter pole, and Trinniberg asserted superiority in the final furlong to score handily. "There's nothing more that we can ask for," commented winning owner Shivananda Parbhoo. "I was expecting 44 [seconds], 1:08. I know this horse is capable of going fast. When they run this hard, you hope they come back good. \$400,000 [purse], this is the biggest win. I don't think any 3-year-old is going to be able to run with him."

Caixa Eletronica came from a seemingly impossible spot to grab Justin Phillip in the True North, a race marred by the breakdown of GI Vosburgh S. winner Giant Ryan (Freud) at the eighth pole. Claimed by these connections for \$62,500 in March 2011, the Repole runner was third to stable companion and fellow former claimer Calibrachoa (Southern Image) in the GIII Toboggan H. Feb. 4, then weakened to sixth in the GII General George H. 16 days later and got some time off. Caixa Electronica stretched out to a route of ground for the GIII Charles Town Classic Apr. 14, and that audacious decision paid serious dividends, as the chestnut strode home a three-length winner, but he came back down to earth with a fourth behind Shackelford (Forestry) in the GI Met Mile H. May 28. Back on just 12 days' rest, Caixa Electronica settled near the tail of the field as Pacific Ocean (Ghostzapper) and Giant Ryan set off at a breakneck pace. He began to find his best stride as the speed duel took its toll, knifed through a narrow gap between Hamazing Destiny (Salt Lake) and Smiling Tiger and was up in the waning strides. "I had a great trip and the race set up perfectly for me," said winning rider Javier Castellano. "The fractions were what I was hoping for, and when I asked him to run, he responded great. He never gave up down the stretch too." Giant Ryan fractured both left front sesamoids and sustained ligament damage in back of his left front ankle and was vanned off the track in a splint. He will undergo surgery at New Bolton Center to attempt to save him as a stallion.

MOOD MUSIC PLEASE

In racing who are the stars--horses or humans? It's a question from the ages and will never be truly reconciled, such is the competition for our hearts and minds between the legends of the turf.

Saturday, the two again vied for the headlines, as Peter Moody--a trainer at the height of his powers a month from his 43rd birthday and currently dominating a not-inconsiderable part of world racing--placed his big footprint over Brisbane's Eagle Farm racecourse claiming two Group 1's and a Group 2 in an historic winning spree under a rainless, but forbidding sky.

For Moody, a proud Queenslanders who has sought and found his fortune down south in Victoria, came back yesterday to claim the racing trifecta of his boyhood dreams and finally signal the return of the native who now has in his stable Black Caviar, arguably our greatest-ever sprinting mare.

For Moody to train the winners of a Stradbroke H., a Queensland Derby and a Brisbane Cup in the space of just 80 minutes is not only unprecedented, but must grab the headlines for the human half.

Racing is never that straightforward or obvious.

Look behind the trainer's latest million-dollar mare, Stradbroke heroine Mid Summer Music, and you find a story that will pull at your heart strings and for a moment dislodge the big black mare from our thoughts.

Mid Summer Music won the \$1-million Stradbroke H., Queensland's time-honored sprint over 1400 meters at an outsiders price of \$28.90, and was all but given up by Moody after her first start win at outback Warracknabeal as a 4-year-old in 2010. Despite the win, it is on the record that Moody wanted to sack her but was prevailed on by jockey and trackwork rider Linda Meech and co-breeder John Ivill to persevere. However the doubts lingered in Moody despite the fact that along the way, Mid Summer Music had accrued nearly \$500,000 before yesterday, including a victory in the G3 Bletchingly S.

'I was never that confident about her today,' Moody acknowledged. "Her win has me pinching myself to see that it's true. But again she has made a mug out of me and long may she do it."

Moody has high standards and this mare, certainly not born in the purple and described yesterday by stable staff on Twitter as 'a potty foal who didn't race until 4-years-old,' had a lot to prove.

By minor sire Oamaru Force (Geiger Counter), who this season would welcome any mare at a bargain service fee of \$3,000, Mid Summer Music was orphaned when her dam Samsara Lady (NZ) (Nassipour) didn't survive the ordeal of her birth. Hand-reared by her dedicated breeders at Noor Elaine Farm in north central Victoria, the young Mid Summer Music took a shine to an orphaned lamb and the two became inseparable. Maybe because of her early hardship the filly was a difficult horse to train and a brute to break in--a kicking, bucking nightmare was how one handler described her yesterday. But always there were people behind her who had faith, and yesterday, as in the great stories of the turf, the full circle was completed, and celebrations at Noor Elaine Farm went long into the night, drinking not only to the health of their once-troubled filly, but also to the fact that their stallion Oamaru Force had just sired his first Group I winner.

In the meantime Moody, who unlike most men can multi-task, had other thoughts in the back of his mind. Discussing the courageous front running win of his Brambles (NZ) (Savabeel {Aus}) in the Derby and Lights of Heaven (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) in the Cup, Moody seemed distracted. Looking at his watch he told Sky Channel, "The boys [his staff travelling with Black Caviar] will be just getting to the stables in the early morning at Newmarket."

It was an aside that gave evidence of his state of mind, anxious to know the latest on how the mare was coping not only with the new surrounds, but celebrity status in front of the world's media.

Make no mistake--Royal Ascot in a fortnight is Moody's Waterloo. Saturday may have reclaimed his Queensland birthright, but for the trainer with an Irish heritage to capture the Diamond Jubilee will seal the deal and remove any English doubters who have the temerity to question her or his right to do it.

Reduced Handle Means Reduced Purses at H'wood:

Betfair Hollywood Park yesterday announced reductions in purses beginning Thursday, citing "unanticipated declines in field size and, subsequently, all sources handle." Non-claiming and maiden allowance races will be cut \$2,000. Claiming races will be reduced \$1,000, but will remain higher or close to the same levels that were offered during the winter/spring meet at Santa Anita that concluded Apr. 22. Additionally, the purses of three upcoming stakes will be reduced. The July 14 GI American Oaks has been cut from \$400,000 to \$350,000. Both the Landaluce S. and the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship, which will also be part of the July 14 program, have dropped from \$200,000 to \$150,000. Even with the reductions, the purses for the American Oaks, Landaluce and Hollywood Juvenile are larger than what was offered in 2011. The purse for last year's American Oaks was \$250,000, while the Landaluce and Hollywood Juvenile Championship were \$100,000 races.

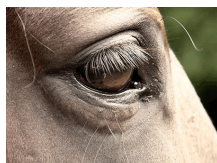
