Union Rags Doing Well; Eyes Summer Campaign...

Saturday's GI Belmont S. hero **Union Rags** (Dixie Union) was doing well Sunday while settling back in at his Fair Hill Training Center home base. "He was

looking out the door, waiting to get outside," said trainer Michael Matz. "He got out [to the paddock], had a little roll, started to eat some grass and watched the other horses walk to the track and training."

Matz continued his high praise for Jockey John Velazquez yesterday, commending the pilot for his bravery in guiding the bulky Phyllis Wyeth homebred through an opening on the rail to get by Paynter (Awesome Again) in the waning moments of the "Test of the Champion." "It was an awfully small hole for such a big horse to fit through," he said. "I have to give him and Johnny credit. They got it done."

Unsurprisingly, Matz has an eye on the major summer 3-year-old races for Union Rags. "At this point right now I think what we'll do is look at some of those, whether it's the [GI] Haskell [Invitational S. at Monmouth Park July 29], the [GII] Jim Dandy [S. at Saratoga July 28], the [GI] Travers [S. at Saratoga Aug. 25]--whatever--one of those races down the line with a little time in between."

When asked about end-of-the-year championship honors, Matz conceded that I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) currently stands atop the Eclipse standings, but said that he and his colt weren't "throwing in the towel by any means." Matz continued, "It all depends on how we finish the season," he said. "They ran one time against each other and that was it. He was very impressive in those two races he ran with Bodemeister (Empire Maker). Again, I was so confused with the voting last year as a 2-year-old [when Union Rags was second to Hansen (Tapit)], who knows what can go on?" **Belmont wrap-up cont. p3**

DATA LINK 'GETS' BY THEM

Under a well-timed ride from GI Belmont S.-winning jockey John Velazquez, Stuart S. Janney III's **Data Link** (War Front) mowed down multiple Grade I-winner **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic) to annex Sunday's GII Monmouth S. on the Jersey Shore. Backed all the way down to 3-5 from a 5-2 morning line, the GI Maker's 46 Mile winner bided his time in last early before taking slightly closer order down the backstretch as the speedy **Presious Passion** (Royal Anthem) doled out swift splits. **Get Serious** (City Zip) and Get Stormy inherited a joint lead as the frontrunner backed out on the turn, and while the latter was able to put away the former in midstretch, the favorite swooped up on the outside in the waning moments to score a decisive one-length blow. Get Serious, a winner of this event in 2010, held well to be third. "It was perfect," said Velazquez. "There was a lot of speed in the race and he likes to come from behind. It just worked out perfect for us. All the speed held up pretty well and when I pulled him outside at the quarter-pole, he responded right away. It's easy when you ride this kind of horse." **Cont. p4**

Belmont Wrap-up cont.

Paynter Pointing to Travers...

Zayat Stable's GI Belmont S. runner-up **Paynter** (Awesome Again) was scheduled to return to California today, where he will regroup before coming back East. "He'll go back home, freshen up, and we'll look to bring him back somewhere on the East Coast," said trainer Bob Baffert, who also finished second in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Belmont S. with fellow Zayat colorbearer Bodemeister (Empire Maker). "Maybe the Jim Dandy--we're shooting for the Travers with him. We have [Derby and Preakness runner-up] Bodemeister for the Haskell." The Hall of Famer said Paynter suffered a nick on his left hind leg and also lost a shoe during the running of the Belmont, but was in good shape overall. "He lost his left hind shoe in the race," he said. "I don't know when it happened, but it must have been near the end."

Giant Ryan Awaiting Surgery...

Giant Ryan (Freud), who fractured both left front sesamoids during Saturday's GII True North H., remained at trainer Bisnath Parbhoo's Belmont barn Sunday. "He's OK this morning, not good, but OK," said owner Shivananda Parbhoo. "He ate his food last night, and drank a lot of water, which is a good sign." The 6-year-old is expected to have surgery, but Parbhoo said nothing is definite. "We're waiting on a call from the doctor and then we'll ship to the hospital, most likely New Bolton [at the University of Pennsylvania]. I'm hoping for today, but waiting for their call."

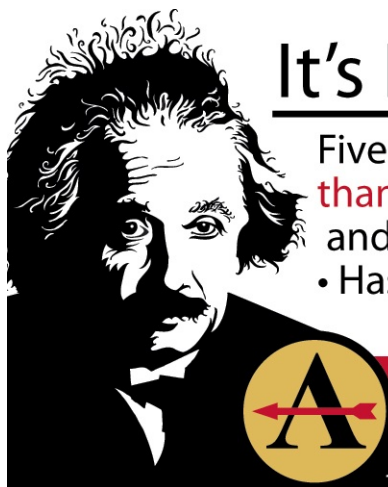
Parbhoo said that **Trinniberg** (Teuflesberg) was doing well a day after his victory in Saturday's GII Woody Stephens S. "He's doing very nice," Parbhoo reported. "He's happy, he ate all his food, everything is good on his side." As for what is next for the speedy sophomore, Parbhoo added, "I was thinking about running him at Calder, but he's done a lot of work this year so far. I'm going to give him two weeks off and we'll train him for the [Aug. 25 Foxwoods GI] King's Bishop."

Belmont Business Booming...

Despite the late defection of Triple Crown aspirant I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) from Saturday's GI Belmont S., Belmont Park saw record attendance in a non-Triple Crown attempt year and nearly eclipsed its record for on-track handle on a Belmont day. A total of 85,811 patrons were on track to see Union Rags (Dixie Union) best Paynter (Awesome Again), surpassing the previous non-Triple Crown attendance record of 73,857 set in 2001. Attendance was up 53.8% from last year (55,779) and came in sixth for all-time attendance at the Elmont, NY oval. On-track attendees wagered \$13,777,920, third all-time at Belmont behind the 2004 Belmont day in which Smarty Jones was denied the Triple Crown (\$14,461,402) and the 2005 Breeders' Cup (\$14,742,521). All-sources handle was \$96,485,985, the third-most ever wagered on a Belmont S. card, and the most ever for a non-Triple Crown year, surpassing the \$89,705,885 mark set in 2009. All-sources handle was up 18.8% over last year's mark of \$81,245,326.

"What a great day of racing with five tremendous graded stakes, including the ultimate Test of the Champion," said Ellen McClain, President and COO of The New York Racing Association (NYRA). "Congratulations to [owner] Phyllis Wyeth, [trainer] Michael Matz, and [jockey] John Velazquez on a thrilling victory by Union Rags." McClain added Saturday, "This has been another outstanding day of Thoroughbred racing for New York, and NYRA thanks all of the connections who raced at Belmont today and our countless fans who visited Belmont Park and watched coverage on NBC and at simulcast facilities across the country."

Television ratings for NBC's coverage of the Belmont S. also soared. With a 5.4 overnight rating and a 13 share for the portion of coverage covering the race, Saturday's Belmont earned the highest rating for a non-Triple Crown try on NBC since 2005, according to data from Nielsen, and was up 13% over last year.

Patiently handled like most Shug McGaughey runners, Data Link broke through in his fourth career start over the Aqueduct sod at the end of 2010 before resurfacing with a pair of victories down at Gulfstream the following winter. He struggled with soft turf in a stakes try at Belmont from off the bench that October, but returned to winning ways back in Florida in December. The homebred was a promising late-on-the-scene third in the GIII Canadian Turf S. in Hallandale Mar. 3, and upended Keeneland's Maker's 46 at 12-1 over GI Woodbine Mile winner and GI Breeders' Cup Mile runner-up Turrature (Wando) Apr. 13. He endured some traffic trouble last time when fifth in Churchill Downs's GI Turf Classic S. on the GI Kentucky Derby undercard May 5. "He's a pretty good horse," McGaughey said. "We got a little bit of a pace set up and Johnny was patient with him and got him to relax good for him. When he wheeled him out, it was 'here we come.'" Velazquez, who was also getting on Union Rags for the first time in the Belmont, hadn't previously ridden Data Link. Hailing from the same family as Janney's 2012 GI Donn H. Hymn Book (Arch), Data Link has a 2-year-old full-sister named Decoder and a yearling full-sister named Guard The Lines. Database, who was also raced by Janney, produced an Afleet Alex colt earlier this year.

Earl of Tinsdal claimed his spot as one of Germany's leading sophomores when runner-up in last July's G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg, and enhanced his reputation by garnering the G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne the following month. He continued in good form when hitting the board in the Sept. 25 G1 Preis von Europa back there in his season closer next time, and prepped for this with a close fourth in the Apr. 29 G2 Gerling-Preis there once more last time. The bay was swiftly into stride and led at a moderate tempo from the outset of this first international foray. Shaken up approaching the three-furlong marker, he stayed on strongly under a drive inside the final 300 meters to easily register a second top-level triumph.

Novellist, who registered wide-margin wins at Dusseldorf Aug. 7 and at Baden-Baden Apr. 8, became Germany's foremost candidate for the July 1 G1 Deutsches Derby when registering a six-length win in the May 6 G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen at Frankfurt last time. He cemented that berth with another daylight success in this premier trial for that Classic and took his aggregate superiority to 24 lengths with a victory here. The dark bay was keen under restraint until settling off the pace along the backstraight. Set alight at the top of the stretch run, he quickened to the fore approaching the final furlong and surged clear in hand thereafter to take his unbeaten tally to four. "Novellist will now have to bear the burden of favoritism in the [July 1 G1] Deutsches Derby," admitted trainer Andreas Wohler, who also claimed Italy's G1 Gran Premio di Milano earlier in the afternoon. "He coped well with that pressure today and all we have to do now is to keep him in today's shape until Hamburg." GOING FORWARD

Trainer Andre Fabre will be hoping that today's G3 La Coupe at Longchamp will serve as the springboard back to the big time for **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) after a spell out of the spotlight. So impressive when winning the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at this venue last July, the Rothschild Family's homebred had an interrupted preparation for the G2 Prix Niel back here in September where he booked his ticket to the Arc when a game second. His troubled training program prior to that race may have had a knock-on effect in the main event itself on the first Sunday in October, but he still fared much the best of the 3-year-old colts in sixth behind Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}). Back with a fourth in Newmarket's G2 Jockey Club S. that Fabre has used as the seasonal reintroduction for his better older horses in recent years, he was too fresh for that May 5 12-furlong contest and was eight lengths adrift of the soft-ground lover Al Kazeem (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) at the line. Another mudlark is in opposition here in Sheikh Sultan bin Khalifa Al Nahyan's **Poet (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), but he will need to show more than when second in the G3 Gordon Richards S. on heavy ground at Sandown last time Apr. 28.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Pletcher Looking for Productive Fall with Soph Team

Four months ago, trainer Todd Pletcher was armed with one of the strongest sophomore benches around the country. **Algorithms** (Bernardini), the star of the stable early in the year, kicked off his career with three straight victories, including the Jan. 29 GIII Holy Bull S. He was an early favorite for the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. and appeared to be one of the early choices for the GI Kentucky Derby. Fate would intervene, however, and the Starlight Racing runner was derailed by a fractured splint bone. Currently layed up at JJ Pletcher's farm in Ocala, Florida, the colt has recently returned to light training and is expected to resurface after Saratoga. According to Pletcher, he will be targeted at Aqueduct's GI Cigar Mile H. in November or Santa Anita's GI Malibu S. in December. "There are limited opportunities in the fall here for straight 3-year-olds, especially one that is just coming back," explained Pletcher. "We are more focused on his 4-year-old year, but he might have one start this year."

Another Pletcher runner, WinStar's **Gemologist** (Tiznow), showed plenty of class in his own right, accounting for five straight wins, including the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. last fall before adding a narrow tally over Alpha (Bernardini) in the Apr. 7 GI Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct. "He's always had a tendency to run to his competition," said Pletcher, explaining the handsome chestnut's short margin of victory. "I felt there was a lot more in the tank. It looked like Alpha had dead aim on him, and once he kind of saw him, he re-engaged. I thought it was a very impressive race." Sent off at 8-1 in Kentucky, the colt could only muster a 16th-place finish, beaten 30 lengths by winner I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). "He was fine the day after the Derby, but the second day after the race he had a really bad foot bruise, so he ended up missing a couple weeks of training," explained Pletcher. **Cont. p8**

As for what lies ahead for Gemologist, Pletcher added, "He is [at Belmont] and training well and we'll probably start breezing him next weekend. We're thinking probably [Saratoga's] GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S. or maybe the GI Haskell S. [at Monmouth]."

Rounding out Pletcher's triumvirate of early Derby hopefuls, **El Padrino** (Pulpit) launched his sophomore campaign with a pair of wins, including a nose score in the Feb. 25 GII Risen Star S. In the money in all five of his initial starts, the Let's Go Stable representative had to settle for fourth in the in the Mar. 31 GI Florida Derby. "Like everyone else, we were so aware of where Union Rags (Dixie Union) was," offered Pletcher.

"Javier [Castellano, aboard El Padrino] had Union Rags in a difficult spot, so he tried to keep Union Rags there. I think if he had forgotten about Union Rags he would have been more aggressive with him and he would have got him going sooner. I think it might have taken him out of his running style a bit." Pletcher continued, "He is a grinding type horse, and you would never want to take away what he is volunteering. If he had ridden him with that in mind, he would have been in second, right off the flank of [winner] Take Charge Indy (A.P. Indy), instead of five lengths back and trying to hold Union Rags in. He was put in a position where he had to sprint home and that is really not his game." The chestnut, who subsequently finished 13th in the Kentucky Derby, was sent to WinStar Farm in Lexington for 10 days following the race and has been given 45-60 days off. The \$210,000 KESEP yearling is expected to rejoin Pletcher and resume training sometime between July 1-15. "I think he will probably make it back sometime in the fall, after Saratoga," confirmed Pletcher.

Also given a brief respite since the first weekend in May, **Broadway's Alibi** (Vindication), winner of the Jan. 29 GII Forward Gal S. and GIII Comely S. Apr. 7, was second behind Believe You Can (Proud Citizen) in her latest start in the May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks. "She ran so hard in the Kentucky Oaks that it's taken her a little while to get over it," admitted Pletcher. Campaigned by E Robsham Stables, the dark bay worked Sunday morning, completing four panels in :47 3/5. "I think she is back on her 'A' game," said Pletcher, who indicated the filly will be pointed to the June 23 GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont before a tilt at the GI Test S. at Saratoga.

Another of Pletcher's ladies expected to run at Saratoga is **In Lingerie** (Empire Maker), winner of the May 18 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. last time out. The filly exited her 1 1/4-length win with a free-bleeding cut on her right foot. "The cut on her pastern wasn't as bad as it looked," confirmed Pletcher. "It might have just hit a vessel and looked worse than it was. It's fine." The Robsham homebred is expected to go straight to the July 21 GI Coaching Club American Oaks. --CBoss

E.J. PERRODIN DIES

Longtime jockey E.J. Perrodin, who retired from the saddle in February, passed away Sunday morning at his home in Haughton, Louisiana, according to *Daily Racing Form*. He was 55 and had been battling cancer. Perrodin won 3,083 races and more than 200 stakes races during his career. He was diagnosed with lung cancer not long after announcing his retirement this past winter. Perrodin is survived by his wife Lisa and son Devin. Services will be held Wednesday at Hill Crest Memorial Funeral Home in Haughton. A visitation will be held from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., followed by a funeral service.
