off with 3-5 favorite **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker), who shrugged off the dust from Dubai and ran off and hid from the opposition in the \$150,000 Gil Fleur de Lis H. A half hour later, it was 9-1 shot **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate) who snuck through on the inside to deny 4-5 **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) in the \$400,000 GI Stephen Foster H. "She ran good in Dubai, but had a bad trip," said owner Ben Leon, who secured Royal Delta for a lofty \$8.5 million in November. "Today, I don't think Mike had to hit her a single time. He have her a great ride and the filly did her job. I'm very happy."

Ron the Greek captured the GI Santa Anita H. in March, and secured an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic via the "Win and You're In" Challenge. **Cont. p5**

Odds-on **Include Me Out** (Include) looked home free in the GI Vanity H. at Betfair Hollywood Park, but, when she began to idle on the front end, longshot **Love Theway Youare** (Arch) ran by her late to post the upset. FRENCH KISS

Coolmore's hand in today's G1 Prix de Diane Longines at Chantilly appears strong despite the presence of **Beauty Parlour** (GB) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), with **"TDN Rising Star"** **Kissed** (Ire) looking the pick of a smart trio of Galileo (Ire) fillies to race in Derrick Smith's silks, alongside **Up** (Ire) and **Petite Noblesse** (Fr). So impressive when dealing out an 8 1/2-length beating to Aaraas (GB) (Haafhd GB) in the Listed Salsabil S. over 10 furlongs at Navan Apr. 29, Kissed was denied a chance to show her true potential when she was a late withdrawal from the Epsom Oaks due to the fast surface. Aaraas went on to fill the same place behind Princess Highway (Street Cry {Ire}) in the May 16 G3 Blue Wind S. at Naas, where Kissed's stable companion and subsequent Oaks heroine Was (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) was back in third. "Kissed likes ease in the ground and that's why she missed Epsom, as conditions were a bit quick for her," Aidan O'Brien said. "She's in good form and the more cut there is in the ground, the better it will be for her. We were delighted with Up when she ran second in the French 1000 Guineas. We've been very happy with her since. She's stepping up in trip and, hopefully, she will stay the distance." **Cont. p3**

Kissed may have more to offer than her barnmate **Up**, who attempts to reverse a length defeat by Beauty Parlour in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 13. She looked as if this step up to middle distances would suit on that evidence, and it may be a mistake to view her as exposed, with some of Ballydoyle's better fillies in recent times only finding their full stride several runs into their career.

Andre Fabre, who has captured this Classic four times, saddles **Petite Noblesse**, who completes the Smith triumvirate. She did not enjoy the rub of the green when eighth in the Pouliches, having looked a very smart performer in the making previously when winning a mile conditions event at Longchamp Apr. 23.

Francois Rohaut puts forward Haras de Saint Pair's **Trois Lunes (Fr)** (Manduro {Ger}), an intriguing contender on the basis of her neck defeat of **Sagawara (GB)** (Shamardal) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp last time Apr. 29. She bids to become the first to complete the Vanteaux-Diane double since Lattice (Ire) (Inchinar {GB}) in 2004. Owner Gerard Augustin-Normand is represented by the May 27 G1 Prix Saint-Alary third **Forces of Darkness (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) and the supplemented **Leupartie (Ire)** (Stormy River {Fr}), who earned her ticket with an authoritative win against the de Royer-Dupre-trained Verema (Fr) (Barathea {Ire}) in a conditions race over this trip at Saint-Cloud May 25.

Love Theway Youare had faced off against Include Me Out several times this year at level weights and had come up short each time, finishing fourth to the favorite in the GII La Canada S. and second in the GI Santa Margarita S. at Santa Anita Jan. 22 and Mar. 17, respectively. She tried her luck in Churchill's GII La Troienne S. May 4 to no avail, running seventh throughout, and made an ignominious return in the GII Marjorie L. Everett S. (ex Milady) at this track two weeks later, when she lost her rider at the start. Content to settle well off the pace set by 5-2 Rock and Glory (Rock Hard Ten), the Myung Kwon Cho colorbearer looked to be running for second when Include Me Out swept to the lead on the far turn. However, the 122-pound highweight didn't really drop the hammer in the stretch, and jockey Garrett Gomez went to work aboard Love Theway Youare, who kept on coming down the center of the track to post the upset. "This filly just keeps staying and she did so again today," said Gomez. "She kept coming and coming. She doesn't have any kind of gear, she's just one-paced the whole time." Jockey Joe Talamo took the blame for the favorite's defeat. "She has a kind of tendency to pull herself up," he admitted. "You know, when I passed [Caelis and Atlantic Swing], I really thought the race was over. We've always beat [Love Theway You are] so far, so many times. In hindsight, I wish I would have waited a little longer. Every time I've ridden her I've always tried to steal the race at the quarter pole. That's a brutal way to get beat in a Grade I."

'RON' BEATS 'DAN' AT THE WIRE

Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) looks like he'll be heading back to Arcadia later this year as a serious contender for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The Florida-bred kicked off 2012 with a second to Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Jan. 28, then shipped cross-country to annex the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 3. He did his best to complete the exacta behind **Alternation** (Distorted Humor) in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 14, but, having been off since, was dismissed as the 9-1 fourth choice here.

There was more than a little jockeying for position when the gates opened, but Nates Mineshaft jumped out in front, with Wise Dan and Fort Larned (E Dubai) in hot pursuit. Jockey Jose Lezcano allowed Ron the Greek to lope along near the back of the pack in the early stages, and committed to the rail in the stretch. Though Wise Dan wandered about under the lights, he was finally getting by Nates Mineshaft late. But he never saw Ron the Greek sticking to his guns on the fence, and the shipper took home the big prize. Rogue Romance (Smarty Jones) was forced to take up a bit behind the meandering Wise Dan, but a claim of foul was disallowed.

"We fell pretty good after he won the race out there [at Santa Anita], but it's good to see him come back and run two good races since the Santa Anita H.," said Mott. "He seems like he's an improving horse, and you'd have to say he's one of the top handicap horses in the country. It was a very good field tonight, and I feel proud of our horse that he was able to beat such a good field. We started on him pretty early, so we'll probably give him a break now and point for the Jockey Club Gold Cup and then the Classic. He might have a race before the Gold Cup, but I'm not sure where it would be."

Royal Delta, an imposing winner of the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga last summer, made her first appearance under the Twin Spires a memorable one when she sealed her Eclipse Award credentials with an authoritative score in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Nov. 4. A few days later, the regally bred filly made even more headlines at Keeneland November when Ben Leon prevailed in a bidding battle with Frank Stronach to take her home for \$8.5 million. She made her first start in the Besilu colors in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Mar. 31, but ran into traffic and wound up ninth. Trainer Bill Mott brought her home, regrouped, and sent her to Louisville along with GI Santa Anita H. hero Ron the Greek. With Mike Smith in the irons for the first time, Royal Delta was surprisingly hand in third as Sterling Madame and Afleeting Lady set the pace. The big filly zoomed to the lead on the far turn and galloped home the easiest of winners.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Coronation Attracts 20

Trainer Mick Channon looks set to be doubly represented in Friday's G1 Coronation S. after 20 sophomore distaffers were left in the one-mile contest at yesterday's confirmation and supplementary stage. **Samitar (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who became the former England soccer international's first Classic winner in last month's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, is slated to be partnered by Martin Harley, who was in the plate at the Curragh, and the West Ilsley conditioner has been quick off the mark to book Frankie Dettori for **Laugh Out Loud (GB)** (Clodovil {Ire}), who annexed Chantilly's G2 Prix de Sandringham two weeks ago. Susan Magnier colorbearer and G1 1000 Guineas victress **Homecoming Queen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), who ran fourth to Samitar when attempting a Classic double, leads a Ballydoyle team of six currently engaged. It also includes G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up **Up (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Rowley Mile third **Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who ran fifth in the G1 Epsom Oaks last time. John Gosden's trio includes G1 1000 Guineas second **Starscope (GB)** (Selkirk) and last term's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality), who has not been out since running eighth in November's GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Churchill Downs. Godolphin increased its representation to three when adding Mahmood Al Zarooni trainee **Irish History (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) to the field at a supplemental cost of £25,000. Final declarations for the £250,000 test will be made Wednesday.

'Caviar' July Cup Bid in Doubt

Trainer Peter Moody yesterday cast doubt over the participation of **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) in the G1 July Cup, suggesting that the unbeaten star could be seen only at Royal Ascot during her stint in Britain. While not entirely ruling out a tilt at the six-furlong July 14 feature at Newmarket, her conditioner was cool about the prospects of a second public outing for the Australian legend after Saturday's G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot. "The July Cup is certainly an option, but the Diamond Jubilee is her sole target," Moody said. "There is plenty of racing back home for her, and I've got a little feeling that if she goes to Ascot and gets the job done, it is exactly that, job done. The July Cup is a time-honoured race and one I'd dearly like to have on my resume and hers, but I think it's a massive ask, as she has had eight runs in this campaign, unlike the European horses, who are just on the way up. The other thing is the July course is a really undulating one, and as she's a filly that has suffered with issues throughout her career, I just wonder how she'd be suited racing on that course. I must say, at this point in time, I'm thinking the Diamond Jubilee would be it, but I'm not ruling the July Cup out."

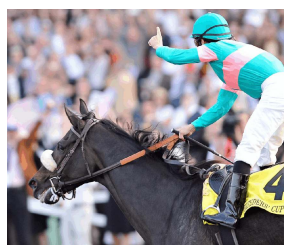
