



### SEVEN UP AT CHANTILLY

His Highness The Aga Khan's tally of winners in the G1 Prix de Diane stood at a record-equaling six prior to yesterday's renewal, and the supplemented **Valyra (GB)** (Azamour {Ire}) came up trumps to help her owner-breeder to new heights. Sent off the 28-1 outsider of the trio racing in the emerald green, the unbeaten bay, who came into this on the back of a 10-furlong course conditions event victory, was steadied from the outset before being settled in rear by Johnny Murtagh. As the even-money favorite **Beauty Parlour (GB)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) was committed by Christophe Soumillon at the top of the straight, Valyra was the sole

challenger, and after subduing that rival with a furlong remaining, drew away to score by 3/4 of a length. "It is always great to win the Diane, as I love this racecourse and everything involved around Chantilly," The Aga Khan said. "I must congratulate the whole team, as everyone is doing a remarkable job." **Cont. p3**

### FRANKEL FACES TEN IN OPENER

Khalid Abdullah's **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) will be tackled by 10 rivals in tomorrow's G1 Queen Anne S., which is set to provide the ultimate opening salvo to the 2012 Royal Ascot meeting. Lord Grimthorpe, racing manager to his owner-breeder, is taking nothing for granted despite Frankel's cramped odds of 1-6. "I don't know of a Group 1 race that is a penalty kick--even for Frankel. We were impressed with his win in the Lockinge in every way, and I think from the Prince's point of view, he wants to let Henry make him as good as he can be. If he is remembered as one of the greatest milers of all time, that would be pretty good for us." The ground at Ascot has dried and is now "good" on the straight course and "good-to-soft, good" in places on the round track, with further rain forecast.



All of The Aga Khan's previous winners of this Classic were trained by Alain de Royer-Dupre, and that conditioner's duo of **Sagawara (GB)** (Shamardal) and **Dalkala** (Giant's Causeway) understandably occupied far more prominent spots in the betting. What Valyra had in her favor was the fact that she had been supplemented by Jean-Claude Rouget despite the presence of that stakes-winning pair. Stable confidence must have been strong, as her debut win in a 9 1/2-furlong contest at Bordeaux-le-Bouscat Apr. 14 and subsequent score, albeit impressive in nature, in a 10-furlong conditions event here last time May 18, left her some way short of the required standard on paper. Any suggestion she would be used as a pacemaker, as her half-sister Valasyra (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire}) was in this two years ago, was settled instantly as Murtagh steadied her out of the gate to race with only two behind. Traveling strongly as 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 Beauty Parlour was taken past the front-running **Kissed (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) with three furlongs remaining, she needed only to be shaken up to reel in the market leader and show determination to belie her inexperience. Her victory saw her owner-breeder surpass Auguste Lupin's six renewals and join an elite club of homebred Diane heroines including the great Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar), and the Aga Khan was clearly delighted with the achievement afterwards. "We had three fillies in here, each with their own qualities and good chances," he said. "Each jockey had different instructions, and they carried them out to the letter, with Valyra proving best. She is a filly who needs to find her rhythm in a race, and that's what Johnny [Murtagh] let her do here. He had flown to Pau to ride her in a piece of work on Monday and was delighted with what he saw, and was very keen to ride her."

Rouget added, "She was very immature last year, but had made tremendous progress and improvement in the spring, and when they come to hand so quickly, it is always a good sign. When the filly won last time, I thought she could be one for the Diane, as she was so impressive and confirmed that day all that she had been showing us at home. It wasn't until Monday, when Johnny worked her, that we decided to supplement, as she was brilliant that morning. I am very proud to win this for His Highness, as it is rare to see major owners putting their trust in provincial trainers. We will take our time to decide where she goes next, as we have nothing in mind." Beauty Parlour's trainer Elie Lellouche said of the runner-up, "I think I should take the blame for that defeat, as I did not choose the right pacemaker for the filly, and she was forced to come too early in the race. She had already done too much when she was challenged, so it was not a bad performance, and we'll take our time to see how she comes out of the race before we decide what to do next." Francois Rohaut added of the third **Rjwa (Ire)** (Muhtathir {GB}), "I am delighted with that--she always runs her race whereas [her unplaced stable companion] **Trois Lunes (Fr)** (Manduro {Ger}) showed bad temperament, and we will have to try and correct that now. **Cont. p4**

Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's 900,000gns TATOCT half-sister to Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) made most of the running before fading out of contention in the Chantilly Classic and it was later revealed that she had sustained a fracture. Annemarie O'Brien tweeted the news, "Kissed sustained a fracture of the sesamoid bones of her left fore at Chantilly today. She is comfortable and will now be retired to stud." Kissed was unbeaten in two starts prior to yesterday, having won the Listed Salsabil S. by 8 1/2 lengths at Navan Apr. 29.

Sapphire was runner-up in the G2 Blandford S. over 10 furlongs at The Curragh Sept. 11 before returning there to easily win the Listed Finale S. over 12 furlongs the following month. Always traveling strongly towards the front end, the bay homebred struck with a quarter mile remaining and settled the result in a matter of strides. "She did it very easily, and we hope she could be a Group 1 filly," jockey Pat Smullen said. "She has improved a lot over the winter, and the ground is the key to her, as she handles that soft very well. She definitely does need ease in the ground."

Remus de la Tour came into this on the back of an initial black-type win in the Listed Coupe des Trois Ans at Lyon-Parilly May 16, having finished fifth two starts previously behind the subsequent G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero Saonois (Fr) (Chichicastenango {Fr}) in the Listed Prix Policeman on the fibresand at Cagnes-sur-Mer Feb. 25. Sent to the lead by Davy Bonilla, the bay had no hiding place in the straight and proved a game and genuine mount for his tactically astute rider to ward off the one-paced Masterstroke. "I thought he had improved a lot over the winter, and that he would stay a mile and a half, so we decided to come here to see if we could make the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14]," conditioner Keven Borgel said. "He will need to be supplemented for that. I have to pay tribute to the owner, as this was the only horse he would buy at Arqana October and, despite me writing him off because he was very incorrect, he stuck to his opinion, so all credit to him."

Vagabond Shoes continued the sequence of shock results at Chantilly with a game effort on his return from racing in Meydan. Runner-up to Byword (GB) (Peintre Celebre) in this 12 months ago, he went on to capture the G3 Prix Messidor at Maisons-Laffitte in July before finishing off the board in four of his next five starts. Settled behind the leading trio throughout the early stages, the chestnut was driven to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and had done enough as Moonwalk In Paris emerged with his late flourish. "We got close in this last year and we gelded him at the end of the season, which he took a while to come back from," trainer Yan Durepaire said. "He is also quite immature, and the plan today was to warm up for the Messidor, so it worked out better than we expected. We have nothing special in mind for him now."

Le Bernardin was fourth when unveiled sprinting on the Big A inner in January, but resurfaced to don cap and gown with a 91 Beyer Speed Figure over the same track and trip Mar. 10. He had no trouble facing winners and going a route of ground on the Aqueduct main track, and nearly paired up his graduation figure to clear his first-level condition with a 90 Beyer on the GI Wood Memorial S. undercard Apr. 7. The dark bay was beaten nearly 40 lengths when last in Belmont's nine-furlong GII Peter Pan S. May 12, but erased all memories of that effort here.

Chasing the stretching-out Innocent Man (Henny Hughes) through splits of :23.53 and :47.73, Le Bernardin took the overland route when confronting the pacesetter on the home turn as favored Good Morning Diva snuck up the fence. That trio came into the lane on even terms, but Le Bernardin made relatively quick work of his two foes. The race wasn't over, however, as a fast-closing Easter Gift made it close at the line while filling out the exacta for Darley stallions.

"It was a great win and an excellent ride by Mike Luzzi, said winning conditioner Kieran McLaughlin. "The horse seemed to be lugging in for much of the race, but Mike did a great job. I've never noticed that he's been a tough horse to ride in the past, but Mike knows him well and did a great job today. The [GI] Haskell [Invitational S. here July 29] is obviously a race we'll look at after we see how he comes out of this."

The gray, winner of the GII Demoiselle S. at two, enters off a runner-up performance to In Lingerie (Empire Maker) in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 18. Another Pletcher runner under consideration for the Mother Goose, GI Kentucky Oaks second **Broadway's Alibi** (Vindication), did not breeze as planned on Sunday.

**THIS DATE IN HISTORY...**

**June 18, 1936...Omaha**, the 1935 North American Triple Crown winner, finished second by a nose in the Ascot Gold Cup.

**June 19, 1867...**The inaugural **Belmont S.** was run at Jerome Park in the Bronx and was won the filly Ruthless, who defeated colts and earned \$1,850 for her victory. Ruthless was one of a group of fillies known as the "Barbarous Battalion," daughters of the mare Barbarity owned by Francis Morris. The other "battalion" members--all full sisters by \*Eclipse--were Remorseless, Relentless, Regardless and Merciless.

**June 20, 1908...**With his final victory in the Tidal Stakes at Sheepshead Bay, **Colin** retired undefeated after 15 starts. No major American racehorse approached this record until 1988, when Personal Ensign retired with a perfect 13-for-13 career.

**June 20, 1996...**Emerald Downs in Auburn, Washington opened for its inaugural Thoroughbred meeting.

**June 21, 1924...****Exterminator** finished third in his 100th and final start, the Queen's Hotel H. at Dorval Park in Quebec. The 1918 Kentucky Derby winner won 50 races in his career.
