A maiden winner and Grade II-placed at two, I'll Have Another swept his four starts this season, including impressive victories over Bodemeister (Empire Maker) in the G1 Kentucky Derby and G1 Preakness S. Financial details were not released.

## BLACK SATURDAY IS HERE

Despite the Berkshire rain and damp, Royal Ascot will shine out across the globe today as racing fans from both hemispheres celebrate the esteemed presence of the seemingly untouchable **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) in the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. Few believe neither the change of scenery nor her 14 opponents can upset her incredible sequence, and even the rain-softened ground appears to hold few fears for her confident trainer and guardian Peter Moody. Following Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire})'s performance Tuesday in the G1 Queen Anne S. would be a tall order for any horse, but Black Caviar is not used to being put in the shade, and is poised to provide the ultimate reply. Reportedly more fine-tuned than when strolling through her most recent tests in the Apr. 28 G1 Robert Sangster S. and May 12 G1 Goodwood S. in front of the Adelaide faithful, the record-setter is set to start the shortest-priced overseas raider in this meeting's history. Moody carries the weight of expectation well and is not showing the pressure outwardly, even if he feels it. **Diamond Jubilee S. cont. p3**

"Like any horse, little things can go wrong, and you probably worry a little bit more with her, especially because we're so far from home, but it's all gone to plan thus far," Moody said. "It's probably pretty important for the Australian racing industry as a whole, and it's the first time we've had a horse rated this high on the world stage. I'd be lying if I didn't think I had some obligation to the Australian racing industry to make sure this works. We don't want to be belittled if our horse gets rolled by a horse rated quite inferior." Moody continued, "Certainly my reputation and my ability to travel a horse is on the line. I said to my wife 'I hope I don't stuff up.' She said 'You haven't in 21 times yet, just don't change too much.' I think she's exactly where I want her." He added, "Fitness levels are good and everything seems right. Watching Frankel on Tuesday was something to behold, I'll remember it for the rest of my career. There's a line of thought that we should put them to the sword and do a Frankel, but it's never been about that--we won't let the hype get into us. We're out there to win, a quarter of an inch will do me, get the cheque and get home."

Black Caviar aside, this renewal has a fascinating subtext, with George Strawbridge's homebred **Moonlight Cloud (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) bidding to make up for a luckless fifth in the G1 British Champions

Sprint S. over this track and trip on Champions' Day. That was the only reversal for the **TDN Rising Star** in her last four starts, which include a four-length defeat of last year's Golden Jubilee winner **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in Deauville's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over

6 1/2 furlongs in August and a latest impressive success under a penalty in the G3 Prix du Palais-Royal over seven furlongs at Longchamp June 2.

"I think six furlongs on softish ground should be fine for her, and I like her very much," trainer Freddy Head commented. "She's a tiny filly with a big heart who always runs well and has never disappointed me. She was very impressive last time when she won on her comeback, and I expect her to run very well." Head continued, "Black Caviar is going to be a big challenge, but that's what racing is for, and you have to compete against the best. I think she wasn't at her best at Ascot in October, and I think I've got her right on song now--she's in the best form I've ever had her in, so we'll see what we do. The soft ground will bring her stamina into play, and I wouldn't like it too soft. I never duck any challenge with my horses and we are trying once again. Black Caviar will need to be at her best to beat her." Bahrain-based owner-trainer Fawzi Nass sends over **Krypton Factor (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), who was a revelation on Meydan's Tapeta when winning the Mar. 10 G3 Mahab Al Shimaal and G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen three weeks later. On the latter occasion, he had some strong international presences in arrears, but came unstuck on soft ground when fifth in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint at Kranji last time May 20. **Diamond Jubilee S. cont. p4**

"We were confident of a good run in Dubai, but to win in such a fashion was a bit of a surprise," Nass admitted. "We didn't see the best of Krypton Factor in Singapore, and I put that down to two things. Firstly, he didn't travel over there so well, and secondly the ground turned very soft on the raceday which he didn't enjoy. He did well on grass as a 2-year-old when trained here by Sir Mark Prescott and also scored on it in Dubai, but not at this level. Unfortunately, we have Black Caviar in our race--I keep being reminded we are running for second spot, and it will certainly take a hell of a horse to beat her."

Simon Gibson's Society Rock had no Black Caviar to contend with last year, but he shaped well on his comeback when third in the May 16 G2 Duke of York S. Jockey Johnny Murtagh is looking for positives. "He's very good at Ascot and seems to like it there," he said. "I'm drawn beside Black Caviar, so I should see plenty of her and who knows. With all this rain around, he's one that can run well if she doesn't perform to her best. It's been a great meeting and everyone's very excited to see her--she's a big mare, but she'll probably look a lot smaller when she's going into the distance."

Fallen For You's reputation preceded her to Newmarket's July Course 11 months ago and she did not disappoint, producing a smart spell of acceleration from rear to open her account over seven furlongs. Sent off the 2-1 favorite in the G2 May Hill S. over a mile at Doncaster in September, she lost out to **Lyric of Light (GB) (Street Cry {Ire})**, but was only a neck down at the line despite being carried right, with **Samitar (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire})** 3 1/4 lengths behind in third. Too keen and possibly still weak when only fifth behind that winner again in Newmarket's G1 Fillies' Mile a fortnight later, she was left alone for the year and returned to make virtually all in a mile conditions event on Kempton's Polytrack May 2.

Dropped to seven furlongs and taking on older fillies and mares in Lingfield's G3 Chartwell Fillies' S. again on the Polytrack 10 days later, she was hemmed in on the fence as **Chachamaidee (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB})** swooped and finished full of run while dead-heating for sixth. While her reputation was mainly intact after that, she had become something of a forgotten horse and some questioned William Buick's election to ride her over the G1 1000 Guineas S. runner-up **Starscope**. Reserved with only one behind early as her rivals opted to stick close to the pace set by the runaway 1000 Guineas heroine **Homecoming Queen (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire})**, **Fallen For You** had a strong tempo to settle into and was traveling notably well as the long-time leader attempted to turn the screw in early stretch. Angled into the clear on the outside, she had dead aim on the green **Irish History (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire})** as that rival rolled to the front passing the quarter pole and swamped her in a matter of strides. Veering right towards the far rail, she had decisive forward momentum on the tiring ground with her barnmate plugging on to complete a memorable exacta for **Clarehaven Stables**. "I always felt that things had conspired against her, but today everything went for her," Buick explained. "There was a good gallop, she got cover from the wind and was in a good rhythm. She finished her race very well and won easily and, like John said, this is not a fluke and this is how good she is. Hopefully, from now on it's onwards and upwards, as she's beaten the best of her generation." Gosden added, "I gave the wrong instructions in the Fillies' Mile, as when she was second in the May Hill. She had run a bit green, so I said to be up there because the ground was riding fast and the speed was holding at Newmarket, so that was riding her back to front. Then she had a holiday and came back and I think she still had that in her mind, as she was always too keen. Ryan [Moore] won on her at Kempton, but she wasn't where we wanted to be, and got in trouble and learnt a lot last time."

## CHIPPENDALE JOINS ASCOT FURNITURE

Stepping up from a Newmarket handicap win two weeks ago and making his black-type bow in the G2 King Edward VII S., **Thomas Chippendale (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) belied his lack of stakes nous to bravely prevail in a thrilling three-way battle for Royal Ascot's "Derby." Patiently ridden in fourth for most of the

12-furlong test, the 9-2 chance made ominous headway off the home turn to challenge in the straight, but required hard love from tutor Johnny Murtagh to deny Frankel's full-brother and stablemate **Noble Mission (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) by a half-length.

Epsom Derby fourth **Thought Worthy** (Dynaformer) was equally game in a thrilling stretch fight and finished a neck away in third. "Noble Mission came there to get me, but my lad is still a little bit green and was only just getting organised," Murtagh explained. "He's still a little bit raw, and when I put my stick down and changed my hands, he accelerated again to the line and won going away. He is still learning and is still a bit of a baby. It's a pleasure to ride a Royal Ascot winner for Sir Henry Cecil."

Thomas Chippendale finished off the radar in York's renowned Convivial Maiden S. Aug. 19 before edging subsequent G1 Kentucky Derby fourth Went the Day Well (Proud Citizen) when closing his juvenile campaign with a win in an Oct. 11 Leicester maiden. Fifth in Newbury's London Gold Cup H. on sophomore return May 19, he remained in handicap company and registered an impressive score in a soft-ground test going 10 furlongs at Newmarket last time. He was positioned within range in fourth for most of this pattern-race debut, but enjoyed a brief moment racing third at halfway. Making ominous headway in tandem with Noble Mission off the home turn as Thought Worthy overhauled the pacesetter G1 Epsom Derby third Astrology (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), the eventual winner challenged widest of all passing the quarter-mile marker. He exchanged fleeting bumps with Noble Mission as Thought Worthy made a slight drift left entering the final eighth, and was driven out to deny those game adversaries in a thrilling three-way go. "I am delighted for [owner] Sir Robert [Ogden]," Cecil commented. "He is improving; he looks as if he stays well, and he could even be a St Leger horse. I thought both deserved to run, as they both had a chance. The Derby third [Astrology] is a good horse, but I thought he had a hard race in the Derby. My horses are owned by two different owners, and I hate one beating the other, but they both ran very well. Noble Mission has run a very good race and he is improving as well." Doncaster's Sept. 15 G1 St Leger might also be on the agenda for Thought Worthy, according to conditioner John Gosden. "He ran a great race and was just done for a bit of toe," he said. "We shall give him a bit of a break and he will have one more race before the [St] Leger. We can pick and choose which one." Aidan O'Brien considered Sir Henry Cecil's opinion that Epsom may have left its mark on Astrology, who faded to fourth. "Maybe Ascot came a bit quick after Epsom for Astrology, I don't know," O'Brien said. "He seems to be fine."

Newfangled was sent off at 10-1 in the face of strong support for the well-regarded Fleeting Smile (Distorted Humor) over this trip on Newmarket's July Course June 8, but relished the testing ground to put that Shadwell representative firmly in her place and score by 4 1/2 lengths. Making light of this quick return, the dark bay produced a tour de force from the front to score with real authority with most of her rivals floundering a long way from home. The race was diminished slightly after Irish challenger Sendmylovetorose (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) panicked in the stalls and was scratched, while Godolphin's Kosika (Hard Spun) never looked like loading and was also withdrawn.

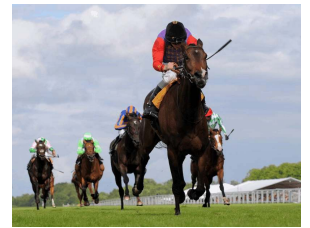
"It wasn't the plan to make the running, as there was a strong headwind and I had made up my mind to sit in behind one or two, but she jumped first and nothing was in front of me and she ran in my hands," Buick explained. "For the moment, six is her trip, but she might strengthen into a miler by next year." Trainer John Gosden added, "She's been very athletic from day one and at home she has looked like she will do any trip because she settles. Today, with all the razzmatazz she decided to go, so it's my job to settle her down. We'll go quietly now and have a holiday before the G2 Lowther S. [at York Aug. 23] and the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Sept. 29]" The success had special resonance for Princess Haya of Jordan, whose colors were sported by the sire. "It's such an honor to see your horses win here and she is really special," she said. "Machiavellian is very evident in her also, so it's lovely for His Highness."

Both the hard-headed punters and romantics combined to send the sole filly in the line-up off as the warm favorite, despite some smart colts in opposition, and they were pleased to see her settle into fifth after initially racing keenly when trapped wide in the early stages. Wound up by Ryan Moore on the turn into the straight, both Athens (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) and Ed de Gas (GB) (Peintre Celebre) traveled with elan in behind, and she looked a sitting duck as she ground her way to the head of affairs passing the quarter pole. That initiative meant that her ample stamina was employed to the maximum and she dragged the chasing duo out of their comfort zone as she powered clear for an emphatic success. In the process, she was providing her owner with a 21st Royal Ascot winner and Sir Michael Stoute summed up the feeling. "It's a great thing," Stoute said. "We had hoped to do it with Carlton House, but we've done it here and I think the whole country would have appreciated this victory." Estimate's stamina-packed effort led some to question whether she could eventually be a contender for the G1 St Leger, which the Queen won in her Silver Jubilee year in 1977 with Dunfermline (GB). Stoute was pouring cold water on such thoughts, however. "I wouldn't have thought so at this stage," he said. "We will just have to see how she progresses. She's bred to stay, being out of a real Aga Khan staying family with a Gold Cup winner in it. I felt after Salisbury that she could just be a Vase filly. She's improved in her work of late and she's come and done it nicely." The Queen was presented with the trophy by her husband, the Duke of Edinburgh, who had been hospitalised for part of the Jubilee celebrations due to a bladder infection.

"It has been great today and we fancied him to finish in the first three here," Gosden revealed. "They went pretty strong again and he could come down the outside to do it, but the trainer has been running him over the wrong trip. He should go a mile-and-a-half, and I think I've got him a bit short [on trip]. The [July 12 G2] Princess of Wales's S. [at Newmarket] is a possibility, but you savor the moment when you win at Royal Ascot. The owner bred him and he's the last of the great American owners to have horses here, so it's fantastic to have him. He's done everything right. He likes to come with one big run down the outside, and William had him in the right place to pull out when he wanted to go." Buick added, "This is what jockeys dream of, and just to have a horse run well here is good. One winner is fantastic, but three in one day is amazing. I knew I had good rides coming into the week, but a lot of other people had good chances as well. So far everything has gone my way and all the horses are in top shape. I wanted to have him close to the pace, but they were going so quick and I wanted to keep him on an even keel. He's better than that winning margin, especially over further. He's a nice progressive horse who's going places."

**Royal Ascot: Pedigree Points**

Juddmonte stallion Dansili (GB) (Danehill) had a big afternoon at Royal Ascot Friday, with **Thomas Chippendale (Ire)** (*see below*) taking the G2 King Edward VII S. just a little while before **Fallen For You (GB)** defeated all comers in the G1 Coronation S. Fallen for You is a homebred from Nicholas and Phillipa Cooper's Normandie Stud, whose colors were also carried in recent years by the good staying siblings Duncan (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Samuel (GB) (Sakhee). The Coronation heroine hails distantly from the Highlight (GB) family of Height of Fashion (Fr), et al, and Nicholas Cooper raced Fallen for You's Fallen Star (GB) (Brief Truce), a half-sister to Group 1 winner Fly to the Stars (GB) (Bluebird). A 140,000gns Tattersalls yearling, Fallen Star was a listed winner at three in 2001 and notched a pair of placings at the Group 3 level. She also finished fourth in the 2002 G1 Nassau S. won by Islington (Ire). Fallen Star's third foal Fallen In Love (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) was runner-up in the G2 Lancashire Oaks, and she was followed by Fallen Idol (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), a listed winner for Normandie before selling for 250,000gns at Tattersalls Autumn in 2011. Barren in 2010, Fallen Star has a yearling Pivotal colt named Fallen In Line (Ire), and produced a Sea the Stars (Ire) colt Mar. 5 that has been dubbed Fallen For A Star (GB).

Thomas Chippendale, who hails from the illustrious Alruccaba (GB) family, was the highest-priced colt among Dansili's yearlings in 2010, when he brought 375,000gns at Tattersalls October from Sir Robert Ogden. He is the first foal from All My Loving (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), runner-up in the 2007 G2 Ribblesdale S. during her Royal Ascot appearance. A full-sister to Group 1 winners Yesterday (Ire) and Quarter Moon (Ire), All My Loving has two subsequent foals by Danehill Dancer (Ire), a 2-year-old colt and a yearling filly, and was bred to Lookin At Lucky last season. Thomas Chippendale is the seventh stakes winner that Dansili has sired from a Sadler's Wells mare.

A few days after 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) continued his progression by capturing Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S., **Newfangled**, a Kentucky-bred filly from the Galileo (Ire) stallion's first crop, ran away from her rivals in the G3 Albany S. Newfangled's granddam Flagbird (Nureyev), bred in the Bluegrass State by W.S. Farish, captured the 1995 G1 Gran Premio Presidente della Repubblica for Godolphin, and later placed in a pair of Grade I events in California. Though she failed to produce a black-type winner, Flagbird has been represented by the Grade III-placed Anasheed (A.P. Indy) and two additional listed-placed runners, including Dubai Belle (Mr. Prospector), whose A.P. Indy filly Little Belle annexed the 2008 G1 Ashland S. Newfangled's dam Scarlet Ibis (GB) (Machiavellian), a winner at three in France, has a yearling Bernardini filly, and produced another filly by the Darley stallion Apr. 24.

The Queen missed out on a Royal Ascot winner when gift horse Carlton House (Street Cry {Ire}) was second-best in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. Wednesday, but Her Majesty received a trophy yesterday when **Estimate (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) stepped up from a maiden win in May to defeat a host of colts in the G3 Queen's Vase S. over two miles. Bred by the Aga Khan from stakes winner Ebaziya (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), Estimate is a half-sister to Enzeli (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), who captured the 1999 G1 Gold Cup at this venue. Ebaziya is also the dam of Ebadiyla (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Prix Royal Oak in 1997; and Edabiya (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), the 1998 G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine. Estimate is the second Royal Ascot winner in as many days for top German sire Monsun following Energizer (Ger), and his daughter Give Me Five (Fr) also produced G1 Gold Cup winner Colour Vision (Fr) (Rainbow Quest).

## THE WHOLE OF THE MOON

Today's G2 Hardwicke S. features some of Europe's leading middle-distance performers, headed by Khalid Abdullah's **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}), who bids to book a ticket to the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. Having put up a monstrous performance when winning the G2 Voltigeur S. at a rain-affected York in August, the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up should relish similar conditions here. Not

impressive when scraping home at by a head at 2-7 in Goodwood's Listed Tapster S. over this trip on his return May 26, Sea Moon should improve by leaps and bounds as many from Sir Michael Stoute's stable do.

"He would have needed his first run, and hopefully he would have come on a bit," jockey Ryan Moore said. "He ran a great race in America in the Breeders' Cup--St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) is a very good horse and he beat us well that day. This horse, as last year showed, will improve as the year goes on I think." Last year's G1 Melbourne Cup first and second **Dunaden (Fr)** (Nicobar {GB}) and **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) also feature in a strong edition, and it is hard to say which has improved the most subsequently. Separated by a pixel that day, the former has since garnered the G1 Hong Kong Cup and put up two encouraging efforts under a subsequent penalty when third in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 5 and June 3 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly. Pearl Bloodstock's 6-year-old is partnered by Christophe Patrice-Lemaire. "It was a very slow pace at Chantilly, and he is a horse who likes to wait, so it was hard to come from behind and I didn't have many options," he said. "Hopefully, he'll get the pace he likes; he has a lot of class and ability and stays this trip very well. I am very confident." Red Cadeaux has gone on to finish runner-up to Thursday's G1 Gold Cup hero Colour Vision (Fr) (Rainbow Quest) in the G3 Sagaro S. over two miles on Kempton's Polytrack May 2, annexed the May 18 G2 Yorkshire Cup and finished second to St Nicholas Abbey in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 2.

Alongside Ronnie Arculli's colorbearer, trainer Ed Dunlop also saddles his new recruit **Testosterone (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}), who took the G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly and G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud last June before finishing second to Galikova (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September. "She is a big, scopey type who should be capable of building on her already impressive resume," her conditioner said of Nurlan Bizakov's acquisition.

John Gosden relies solely on George Strawbridge's **Aiken (GB)** (Selkirk), having withdrawn last year's G1 St Leger hero Masked Marvel (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) due to the ever-softening conditions. Aiken came to the fore when winning the aforementioned Grand Prix de Chantilly last time, and jockey William Buick had opted for him over his stable companion before the rain arrived. "Aiken is a lovely horse who is improving, but is stepping up again," Buick said. "The ground shouldn't be an issue for him and the fact that I'd picked him over a good horse like Masked Marvel shows I've got a lot of faith in him."

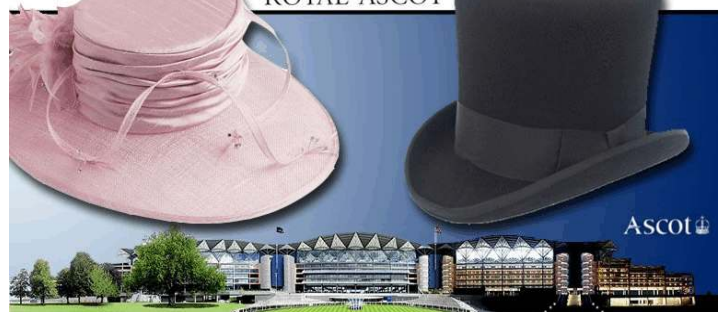

One of the reasons Tuesday's G2 Coventry S. winner Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) was re-routed from this race was to make way for his stable companion **Move To Strike**, who was so impressive when opening his account by nine lengths over six furlongs at The Curragh last time May 7. The runner-up on that occasion, Slope (GB) (Acclamation {GB}), has since upheld the form with a smart effort in a decent fillies' maiden at Fairyhouse. The Bolger camp will be disappointed if he does not offer a bold showing. In one of the strongest renewals in this race's history, Godolphin put forward a duo headed by the authoritative Ripon maiden winner **Tha'lr**, who beat the subsequent winner Bircham (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) by 4 1/2 lengths in that June 6 six-furlong contest, and the filly **Lovely Pass**. Her debut win over six furlongs at Lingfield May 26 had to be seen to be believed and she must possess a large share of talent to have overcome such a disastrous break and still win with plenty in hand. Richard Hannon saddles another intriguing type in Shadwell's **Jalaa**, who looked a colt with a future when scoring on debut over six at Leicester June 5.

## BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

### THE 'MOTHER' LODE

There is a lot of racing left in the year, but the winner of today's GI Mother Goose S. over 1 1/16 miles at Belmont could gain an early advantage in divisional championships honors. Brereton Jones's homebred **Believe You Can** (Proud Citizen), winner of the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 31, is arguably in the catbird seat after she rallied past Broadway's Alibi (Vindication) in the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill May 4. She'll be reunited with jockey Rosie Napravnik as she kicks off the second half of her season.

"She worked well the other day [five furlongs in :55.77 at Belmont last Monday], Rosie was happy with her, and she [has been] feeling really good," said trainer Larry Jones. "She's put on weight since the Oaks, and I'm very, very pleased with the way she's continued to grow." Despite her Oaks win, Believe You Can, at 8-5, isn't the morning-line favorite. That designation belongs to the 7-5 pick and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Contested** (Ghostzapper), who goes out for trainer Bob Baffert. Undefeated in her last four, Contested also raced May 4 at Churchill. But instead of the Oaks, she tackled--and easily won--the seven-furlong GIII Eight Belles S. The added furlong wasn't a problem in the one-mile GI Acorn S. at Belmont May 28, which she won by five over **Zo Impressive** (Hard Spun), and now she tacks on a bit more ground. "We've been moving her up in increments to see how far she wants to go," said Baffert, who trains the filly for his wife, Jill.

## Agave Kiss Works for Victory Ride...

**Agave Kiss** (Lion Heart) worked a bullet five furlongs in 1:00.43 yesterday at Aqueduct as she readies for a tilt in the GIII Victory Ride S. at Belmont July 7. "We're very happy with the way she's been doing," said Rudy Rodriguez, who trains the New York-bred for Flying Zee Stables. "The Victory Ride is the next spot for her, and after that, we'll keep our fingers crossed and point for the [Grade 1, \$300,000] Prioress at Saratoga [Aug. 4]." Agave Kiss has

won all six of her starts in front-running fashion by a combined margin of 30 lengths, most recently winning the Miss Preakness S. at Pimlico by 5 1/2 lengths May 18. The six-furlong race was contested at Saratoga for the past eight years, but was moved to share the card with the GII Suburban H.

## Unstoppable U to Dwyer...

Susan McPeek and Mojallali Stables's **Unstoppable U** (Exchange Rate), who lost his unbeaten record when sixth beaten 11 lengths in the GI Belmont S. June 9, will likely make his return in next Saturday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont. "He's been doing great since the Belmont," said Ken McPeek's assistant, Lars Becdelamotte. "He was more mad than anything else. He missed the break and got tangled up with another horse, and it was the first time he'd ever been behind horses, first time around two turns, 1 1/2 miles...I thought he ran a pretty good race, considering everything." Unstoppable U broke his maiden on debut over a sloppy six furlongs at Aqueduct Mar. 31, and returned to take a one-mile optional claimer by over six lengths at Belmont Apr. 27. "We'll see how he does in the Dwyer," added Becdelamotte. "If he runs well, then he can take the next step to other stakes races." Unstoppable U is expected to face Teeth of the Dog (Bluegrass Cat), a sharp winner of the Easy Goer S. on the Belmont undercard, as well as GI Preakness S. fourth **Zetterholm** (Silver Train). **Monarchic** (Forestry) and **Morgan's Guerilla** (Ghostzapper) are also probable, while **Done Talking** (Broken Vow) is questionable.
