A THIN 'BLACK' LINE

It was far tighter than expected, but **Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus})** clung on after her jockey Luke

Nolen caused a few minor heart attacks to win Royal Ascot's G1 Diamond Jubilee S. Connections of her opponents may have appeared to be clutching at straws beforehand in the belief that she could be

beaten, but in another stride **Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire})** would have done the unthinkable. Sent to the front with a quarter mile remaining, the 1-6 pick looked to have it in safe keeping before being eased down prematurely near the line, which came in time as she held on to win by a diminishing head margin from the French raider. Luke Nolen was in humble mood afterwards. "I probably underestimated the testing track of Ascot," he said. "She'd had enough and that big engine throttled right down. It's quite unfortunate, because we're going to talk more about my brain fade than the horse's fantastic effort. We got away with it." **Cont. p3**

UPSET EXACTA IN MOTHER GOOSE

Belmont's GI Mother Goose S. was expected by many to be a match race between GI Acorn S. heroine **Contested** (Ghostzapper) and GI Kentucky Oaks victress **Believe You Can** (Proud Citizen), but when those two fillies failed to show up with their best, Live Oak

Plantation's **Zo Impressive** (Hard Spun) was there to pick up the pieces and garner a top-level success. The Acorn runner-up sat perched off Contested's pace in third as that one seemed to be getting loose as she had last time. Scrubbed on to challenge her foe at the head of the lane,

Zo Impressive went right on by the frontrunner with little resistance, but was immediately confronted by fellow grey **Disposablepleasure** (Giacomo). That pair dueled gamely down to the line, bumping slightly at one point, but Zo Impressive pulled away late to ultimately prove 3/4-of-a-length best and become the first Grade I winner for her second-crop sire (by Danzig). The Oaks winner checked in third, 8 1/2 lengths back of the runner-up, while Contested finished last in the five-horse field. "It wasn't a big [field] but it was probably the four best fillies you've got in the country right now, so that's what made the race pretty special," said winning conditioner Tom Albertrani. "We always had confidence in our filly, and she was just very sharp today." **Cont. p5**

The Weight of a Nation...

Black Caviar's momentous popularity can be measured by the fact that her narrow defeat of the Euro brigade was watched live by a crowd of 10,000 in a closed-off Federation Square in Melbourne, as well as by the largest contingent of visiting Australians in the Berkshire venue's history. Everywhere she goes now, she generates a wave of salmon-and-black memorabilia, and Ascot was relatively benign yesterday when compared to the scenes at Adelaide's Morphettville racetrack or at the likes of Flemington, Caulfield and Moonee Valley. Nevertheless, the welterweight of goodwill and support from the British people was clear to see and, despite not producing her usual visual feast at Ascot, she was met with a tumultuous welcome as she returned to the winner's spot. There was no Hay List (Aus) (Statue of Liberty) in the line-up here and very few that seemed able to push her to the kind of performance witnessed in the last two renewals of the G1 Lightning S. or last year's G1 T J Smith or G1 Newmarket H., but the outcome was far too close for comfort. Having come out of the stalls with her usual gusto, the dark bay was settled in third early traveling smoothly as Frankie Dettori cut out the running on Soul (Aus) (Commands {Aus}). Moving up to lead passing the quarter pole, her effort looked more labored than usual, but she soon had two lengths to spare out in front. Luke Nolen waved the stick, but never used it and put it down with 125 yards remaining as the French contenders Moonlight Cloud and Restiadargent started to wear her down. As Black Caviar began to tread water, her rider eased off the gas, and the final yards were as dramatic as any finish in the Royal meeting's history. Nolen gave her one more push as he realised his error with the French fillies bearing down, and luckily the post came in the nick of time. This was her first photo finish and shortest winning margin since her 3/4-length defeat of Wanted (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) in Flemington's G2 Danehill S. 18 runs ago. **Cont. p4**

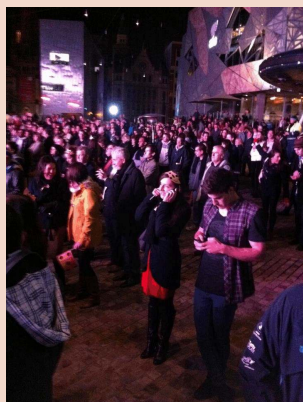

Trainer Peter Moody stood up for his rider afterwards. "You've only got to win by a quarter of an inch--that was what we were prepared to win by and we've got the job done," he commented. "We never expect dominance and we've never asked her for dominance. We are extremely proud of her--she's 22-for-22. I'm an extremely proud Aussie and words can't describe it. It's very fitting that it's with a horse like this." Freddie Head was delighted by the effort of Moonlight Cloud. "One more stride and we would have won," the trainer told *PA Sport*. "I think we will now head for the [Aug. 5] G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville and I don't think we will return here for the G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 14]. I love this filly, she is a darling and she will make a lovely broodmare one day." Fellow French trainer Henri-Alex Pantall told *PA Sport*, "I am so happy with [Restidargent], because I would have settled for coming fourth or fifth, so this is a bonus. She is still very green and was a 3-year-old against older horses, which makes the run even more commendable. She is only a baby, but I would not be frightened of taking on Moonlight Cloud again in the Maurice de Gheest."

Black Caviar's younger brother All Too Hard (Aus) (Casino Prince {Aus}) topped the 2011 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale at A\$1.025 million, and captured a pair of Group 2 events before finishing second in the G1 Inglis Sires Produce S. in his first season on the racecourse. Her Redoute's Choice (Aus) half-sister sold for A\$2.6 million at this year's Inglis Easter Sale ([click here](#) for TDN coverage).

Homeward Bound...

Reflecting on the performance by the "Queen of Speed" and looking beyond this adventure, trainer Peter Moody said, "It's not sunk in yet and I'm very proud. She's come a long way and got the job done nicely. We're accustomed to her winning comfortably and dominating races, but she wasn't in that dominating fashion today. You saw her a long way off her top, and anyone who'd seen her races at home might have had concerns three or four furlongs from home..."

I was concerned that she didn't travel like she does at home, and I was concerned that she was off her top a fair way out. Grit and determination got her home. She'll be in quarantine at 10 a.m. Sunday morning, and back in Melbourne in 28 days. We won't have any discussion over retirement unless any injury comes to light, and I've not seen anything, but if she's as tired and as worn out when she arrives home in Australia, you may have seen her grace the track for the last time. Hopefully, that's not the case, and she'll resume work in preparation for the Spring Carnival at Melbourne. We'll let her guide us. It's been a great ride and I'm very grateful to have been a small part of that. She's done great things for racing." **Cont. p5**

Two Hearts Beat as One...

Despite the heart-stopping moment when the whole of Australia skipped a beat as Luke Nolen engaged autopilot mode prematurely, the jockey admitted his near-disastrous blip and explained, "The first emotion when this mare wins is relief. She wasn't the same horse and you don't find out until you race. Her work on Tuesday was as good as ever, but you don't find out until you put them under race pressure how taxing the trip actually was. It's 36 hours to get to Newmarket, but the real story is she is still 22 for 22. I underestimated the grueling nature of the straight six-furlong track here. I coasted late and I thought that she'd done enough, but because it was such a test for her, she pulled up very quickly on me and took me by surprise. It was a rookie mistake and one I'm glad I came out the right side of. She wins by 3/4 of a length if I kept at her, but I was looking after her late. I wasn't easing her, I let her coast. She was out on her feet, she was stuffed and it took me by surprise. When I let her coast, she stopped under me, but she's still the victor. I won't get to ride another one like her and I probably won't live long enough to see another one as good." Racecourse vets examined Black Caviar after the Diamond Jubilee and gave the unbeaten mare the all-clear.

Zo Impressive immediately tipped her quality with a 6 1/4-length first-out romp at Gulfstream Jan. 22, and handled the stretch out to a mile with ease when besting eventual GII Black-Eyed Susan S. heroine In Lingerie (Empire Maker) by 4 1/2 lengths back in Hallandale Feb. 25. She was a distant second to Grace Hall (Empire Maker) after a rough beginning in the Mar. 31 GII Gulfstream Park Oaks, and couldn't make up for a distinct tactical disadvantage when trying to emulate big sis Zaftig (Gone West) in the Acorn here May 28.


"Maybe the biggest difference was the Acorn had a very speed-favoring track, and Contested got an uncontested lead," postulated rider Rajiv Maragh. "[Today], several horses gave her more respect and put on pressure, and that help me beat her. The pace was a little hot [in the Acorn] and they got away from me more than I wanted. I had too much ground to make up. We wanted more of a tracking position today."

As far as future plans for Zo Impressive, Albertrani said, "I don't think [more distance] should hurt her any--we'll see when we get to Saratoga with two turns again, try to stretch her out to a mile and an eighth [in the GI TVG Coaching Club American Oaks July 21]. We're just happy to get the Grade I--that's important--and as long as she comes out of the race healthy, that's really what we want."

Grade I winner Zoftig (Cozzene), who was bred and campaigned by Disposablepleasure's owner Glencrest Farm, was carrying Zo Impressive when she was purchased by Charlotte Weber's operation for \$1.5 million at Fasig-Tipton November in 2008 following Zoftig's victory in the Acorn earlier that year. She has an unraced 2-year-old colt by Distorted Humor named Souper Funny (Distorted Humor) and an unnamed yearling filly by Street Cry (Ire).

SAY WHAT?

Larry Jones, trainer of Believe You Can:

It's my Mother Goose jinx--I've never had any luck in this race. I was second with [favorite] Joyful Victory last year, Proud Spell didn't win (DQ'ed from 2nd to 3rd in 2008) and neither did Island Sand (third in 2004). I think maybe next time we'll skip the Mother Goose and go straight to the Coaching Club American Oaks.

Jim Barnes, assistant trainer of Contested:

I think the track she ran on in the Acorn was just a much different track. This was kind of wet down deep inside and kind of a dead track, didn't look like it had life to where they were bouncing over it. She looked to be running fairly easy early, but I knew at the top of the stretch, or even before then, that we were in serious trouble.

Sea Moon was always held in high regard by the Stoute stable, but he took a while to find his stride, and it was only when winning York's G2 Great Voltigeur S. by eight lengths in August that he emerged as a leading player. He suffered a troubled trip when third as favorite for the G1 St Leger at Doncaster the following month before running into a revived St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf in November. He looked beaten in the Listed Tapster S. last time, but rallied to deny the solid, but below top-class performer Dandino (GB) (Dansili {GB}) to stay on course for this vital stepping stone. Held up early here despite the far-from-testing tempo, the flashy bay settled kindly for Ryan Moore in mid-division, and had the forward move of Aiken (GB) (Selkirk) covered on the turn into the straight. Taking a few strides to reach top gear, he was soon in command and was able to be geared down late as the Melbourne Cup one-two Dunaden--who met trouble in running late on--and Red Cadeaux chased at a respectable distance.

"I thought we might have his work cut out today, but I was delighted with him," Moore commented. "He traveled really smoothly and picked up really well, and I couldn't have been more pleased with the horse today. All the horses this week have ran very well." Dunaden may meet the winner again in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. here July 21 after trainer Mikel Delzangles told *PA Sport*, "He ran a very good race. He was a bit unlucky, because he was stuck when the horses slowed up. He quickened very well and the King George is a possibility." Ed Dunlop said of Red Cadeaux, "He ran a very good race. Dunaden has now beaten us three times, and I think he's proved he's the better horse. Hopefully, we won't have to bump into him too often. We'll freshen him up and give him one more run before going back to Melbourne."

"It was all the horse today," said winning pilot Joe Talamo. "Eden's Moon is a real nice filly so I knew I was going to need a lot of horse to get by. That's why I waited longer than I wanted to. I figured it would pay off the last part, which it did. We just got up. She's unbelievable. [Trainer] Mike [Mitchell] has done an unbelievable job with her. That was her third career start and she just beat a Grade I winner. When they can get headed and come back like that, that's a real nice horse. I really think the sky's the limit with her."

Mitchell advised owners Anthony Fanticola and Joe Scardino to purchase the filly privately before she debuted last year. "I told the owners, 'I heard that this filly is a runner' and they stood at the gate and bought her," he recalled. "Tony and Joe are just great, great guys. I had these owners years ago and I asked them about this horse and they said, 'Where do we send her?' She's a gigantic filly, but very easy to train. She's not a gorilla, she's not hard on herself and she's so professional in everything she does--a fun horse to train. I thought Joe [Talamo] gave her a million dollar ride."

Conditioner Bob Baffert said of the runner-up, "She ran pretty well. She made that little surge, but that other filly is a nice filly because she came right back at her. Those are two nice fillies."

There had always been a bit of a buzz surrounding Blueeyesintherein, and that chatter proved for good reason as the dark bay gave trainer Gary Simms and co-owner Barry King back-to-back renewals of this early season juvenile event. The duo teamed up last year with Flashy Lassie (Flashy Bull), but there was no way backers were getting the 17-1 they got on last year's winner, as Blueeyesintherein was pounded early and often in the wagering here off a measured 3 3/4-length debut success going 4 1/2 panels May 31. Away from the blocks in good order, the favorite settled in the pocket behind a contested opening quarter in :22.16. She edged out into the four path at the top of the lane for clear sailing, was ridden in earnest in midstretch and kicked for home a convincing winner. Longshot Quiet Success held for second over maiden Shesakitty, who was compromised again by a slow start. Blueeyesintherein, who was the first winner for her freshman sire (by Honor Grades), also becomes his first black-type winner. The MGSW winner of more than \$2.5 million stands at Darby Dan Farm. "We came into this race with a lot of confidence," said Simms. "I thought we were the best on paper, but it's a horse race and anything can happen. She really showed a lot of class and heart today and looked a lot like her sire, Magna Graduate, who I trained at the beginning of his career. I had deja vu watching her run." The conditioner, who has been battling cancer for the last two years, added, "I've been through a lot, but a lot of people have it a lot worse than I do. Today's win is a blessing from above and I'm really happy for my owners and my team." Blueeyesintherein could return in either the GIII Schuylerville S. at Saratoga July 20 or the Mountaineer Juvenile Fillies S. Aug. 4.

Ryan Moore Takes Leading Rider Honors...

A final-day double saw Ryan Moore take the title of leading jockey at this year's Royal Ascot with five wins following a ding-dong tussle with William Buick that ebbed and flowed throughout the final day. Moore drew level with Buick on four wins when comfortably winning the G2 Hardwicke S. on Sea Moon (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}), but Buick, who was riding high after booting home a treble Friday, put his nose back in front with a confident ride aboard Camborne (GB) (Doyen {Ire}) in the Duke of Edinburgh H., the meet's penultimate test. However, Moore was not done with, and took the finale--the marathon Queen Alexandra S.--with willing partner Simenon (Ire) (Marju {Ire}), who had annexed the Ascot H. earlier in the week. This put both jockeys on five wins apiece atop the standings, but Moore gained the golden armband on countback, thanks to two third-place finishes. Buick's five winners were all supplied by the red-hot John Gosden stable, who was the week's leading trainer. "You realise how hard it is to ride winners here and I am really pleased with how the week has gone," Moore told *PA Sport*. "Simenon has given me two winners, and Sea Moon was very impressive. I was very pleased to see him put in another performance like he did in the Great Voltigeur [S. at York last year]. Any winner here is good, and the one for The Queen [Estimate] was extra special, even though I'd rather it had been Carlton House."

He came here off a ninth in this year's GP Republica Argentina at Palermo May 1. Unhurried in the early stages, Calidoscopio was roused when they turned in front of the stands for the final time and finished determinedly up the center of the course to book a spot in the GII Breeders' Cup Marathon at Santa Anita by virtue of this race's "Win and You're In" status. He is not currently nominated to the Breeders' Cup program.

A WEAKNESS FOR THE LADIES?

This small but highly select renewal of the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud sees some heavyweight fillies take on the French favorite **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}), who, if he can be deemed guilty of any shortcoming, has shown some vulnerability against the distaffers in recent times. While Corine Barande-Barbe's darling seems to have no issues with brushing aside the likes of So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), three of his last six defeats have come against the females. In his defence, they were the incomparable Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa), who lowered his colors in the 2011 G1 Prix d'Ispahan; and the less talented but ultimately high-class pair of Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) and Golden Lilac (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who overshadowed him in this race 12 months ago and in the latest renewal of the d'Ispahan May 27. "We thought about Ascot, but I just felt it would be better to run him over a mile and a half before he goes for the King George," Barande-Barbe said. "There was also no rain around Ascot earlier this week, and we would rather stay home and run him on the softer ground on Sunday. I'm not sure it will be very soft, but it will be soft, and the heavier it is, the more it will trouble the others. It won't bother him. All has gone well since his last run, so hopefully he runs well, and then we can look forward to the King George." In last year's Arc first and second **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) and **Shareta (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}), as well as Goldikova's half-sister **Galikova (Fr)** (Galileo {Ire}), he has to contend with a formidable trio, and the former has already flaunted her wares this term when capturing the 11-furlong G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmer at Baden-Baden May 20. "She is in very good form and, hopefully, she will run a very good race," trainer Peter Schiergen told *PA Sport*. "She has won on soft ground and good ground, so I don't think it matters to her too much. There are only five horses in the race on Sunday, but they are five good horses, so it will be an interesting contest. We take it race by race. We will see how she runs on Sunday, but the options afterwards are either a race in Germany or the King George at Ascot." There does not appear any obvious reason why Gestut Burg Eberstein and Teruya Yoshida's ground-breaking German raider should be upstaged by His Highness The Aga Khan's Shareta, who she had five lengths behind her in the Longchamp feature in October, but ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆** Galikova remains of intense interest. Only ninth in the Arc, the Wertheimers' homebred had looked a work in progress last season despite finishing runner-up to Golden Lilac in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly in June and winning the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September, where Shareta was back in third.

FULL FIELD FOR QUEEN'S PLATE

A full field of 14 line up today in Etobicoke for the 153rd running of the Queen's Plate, the first leg of Canada's Triple Crown. Canyon Farms's **Strait of Dover** (English Channel) gets a narrow morning line nod as he enters this event off four straight trips past the post in front since joining the Daniel Vella barn. Disqualified from a maiden heat for interference here last November, the homebred secured his diploma later that month. He returned to clear another condition going seven panels Apr. 22, and proved a route was of no concern when romping home by 6 1/2 lengths in the 8 1/2-furlong Marine S. May 12. Of the four draw, Vella told *Daily Racing Form*, "My best choices were eight or four. I've been thinking there's not a lot of speed in the race, and I think we're going to be in the first five going into the turn, so we're better off inside." **River Rush** (Orientate) is just a one-time winner, but that ;one victory came in a pretty key spot--the Plate Trial S. here three weeks ago. Let go at 21-1 off a runner-up effort locally in maiden allowance company Apr. 29, the Stronach Stables colorbearer rallied from last to first to report home a convincing 5 1/4-length winner over four of today's rivals, earning the field's best last-out Beyer Speed Figure of 89.

"I just want to save as much ground as he can," trainer Reade Baker told *DRF*. "He doesn't have a lot of natural speed." Inglorious (Hennessy) took this event for the fairer sex last year, and John Oxley's **Dixie Strike** (Smart Strike) will look to start a trend. The Gill Selene S. winner was a dull fifth last time at odds-on in the Woodbine Oaks, but she adds blinkers for this and is more than capable at her best. She shares the Mark Casse barn with Melnyk Racing Stables impressive recent graduate **Golden Ridge** (Distorted Humor) and seeming outsider **Making Amends** (Repent).

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Plans Set for Top Sophomores...

Grade I winners **Dullahan** (Even the Score) and **Hansen** (Tapit), both on the Churchill Downs worktab Saturday, have been confirmed for upcoming starts this summer, connections revealed. Donegal Racing's GI Kentucky Derby third Dullahan will seek to make amends for a disappointing seventh as the 5-2 favorite in the GI Belmont S. in Monmouth Park's GI Haskell Invitational July 29. "We haven't given up thinking he can run on dirt," trainer Dale Romans said. "If we want to try him on the turf after that, we can always wheel him back in the [GI] Secretariat [at Arlington Aug. 18]." The handsome chestnut, hero of the GI Toyota Bluegrass S. over the Keeneland Polytrack Apr. 14, worked five furlongs in 1:00.60 beneath the Twin Spires yesterday. He was clocked in fractions of :12.60, :24.40, :36, :47.80, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.20. "He worked well," Romans added. "We wanted him to get out there and stretch his legs."

Hansen, off since a ninth-place finish in the Derby, covered five furlongs in 1:01.20 at the nearby Trackside training center. The juvenile champion has his sights set on the GIII Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows June 30 after missing an intended engagement in the GII Woody Stephens S. on the Belmont S. undercard. "It was just a maintenance work," trainer Mike Maker told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm real happy with him." Maker also told the publication that the Dr. Kendall Hansen and Skychai Racing colorbearer's long-term objectives include the GII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Aug. 4 and the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 25.

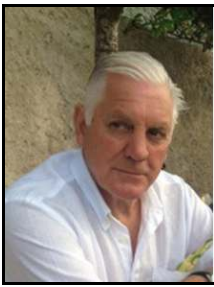

AN ENTREE TO BLACK CAVIAR

Thirty-something billionaires who buy, breed and race horses are a rare and blessed kind. Generally those who amass that sort of money at a tender age are consumed by the chase and don't have the time for the careless rapture of a passion like racehorses.

That comes later--at a certain age.

But not Nathan Tinkler, 36, a bush electrician working down the mines out of Sydney eight years ago --and today peering down the shaft as owner. It's been a rise that has dazzled even the most jaded stockbrokers and one of the stories of Australia's mineral/mining boom that has included the making of the world's richest woman, Gina Rinehart.

Tinkler has ridden the boom cycle to become our richest person under 40 and emerged as a breeding and racing colossus with over \$400 million splurged on farms and bloodstock. His extravagant forays into Thoroughbreds has generated a mixed reaction, his unorthodox crash-through style a matter of conjecture, but always the sort of cash Tinkler splashes is welcome, his largesse a fillip for breeders and farm purchases a boost for rural real estate.

Tinkler arrived when the game needed him and the GFC hovered. He raided the auctions from 2008 with purchases of over A\$2 million for yearlings and much more for stallion prospects off the track. Often he was paying overs. Tinkler heard that the industry was laughing at him and he took umbrage, suing Anthony Cummings, the son of legendary Bart Cummings, for millions he alleged had been taken from him in illegal commissions.

Tinkler finally settled on the court steps after being persuaded by people like Magic Millions owner Gerry Harvey that his actions were embarking on a no-win situation. Tinkler withdrew the action a year ago and generally since then has been a low-profile player at the sales and rarely seen on the track as he prepares to live in Singapore where the media scrutiny of his private life will be, like the tax rate, much lower.

His racing business and breeding empire keeps churning out horses with mixed fortune, the general consensus being that payback time is still light years away. Yesterday some of that perception changed when Tinkler found a Group 1 filly that will repay him richly, and just maybe had joined the other two outstanding fillies of her generation Mosheen and Atlantic Jewel.

Pearl Tart strode away over 1400 meters with Australia's last Group 1 of the season when she overcame a competitive weight-for-age field of fillies and mares at Eagle Farm to bring down the curtain on Queensland's winter carnival.

It was Tinkler's first Group 1 win for a filly he bought from Makybe Diva's breeder Tony Santic and, more importantly, the third winner at the highest level for his young trainer John Thomson. The win was greeted by Thomson, manfully trying to hold back the emotion of the moment and defending his filly as not just good on wet ground, as stoically as it is possible in the glare of a TV camera when your life has just been run before you.

Pearl Tart had showed her class a couple of weeks ago in the G2 Queensland Guineas, but that had been an undervalued win because it was on a bottomless track and she had been typecast as a mere 'wet tracker' which undersold her true worth.

Now she has a genuine Group 1 on her CV, raced on a fair, dry track that has added considerably to her value, which began when Tinkler paid just A\$45,000 for her at the Gold Coast Magic Millions Sale of 2010. Why he paid only that amount, one of his cheapest buys that year, is explained by the fact that Pearl Tart is by Dehere, who has ben sold to Turkey, and is out of Tangerine Dream (Fr), a Sadler's Wells mare that had not thrown a stakes winner.

The miner who has dug as deep as anyone to find it has found gold.

THERE IS NO PERFECT HORSE

On a bleak, wet Thursday last week I found myself on Adam Sangster's Swettenham Stud an hour out of Melbourne where Black Caviar was prepared for the Melbourne yearling sale at which Peter Moody famously paid A\$210,000 for her. The workers at the farm recalled the black filly and agreed she wasn't the 'perfect package by any means' and 'would be lucky to make the same money' in today's financially challenged sales environment. "The buying bench today is so picky and hypercritical," one said.

I didn't press for details of the so-called faults feeling this a fruitless and depressing exercise--rather like measuring perfection and finding it comes up short.

KZN IS THE PLACE TO BE THIS YEAR

In what has been described as the comprehensive validation of the immense talent in Natal, the KZN Breeders Club has introduced a new revamped Million Rand race for graduates of the Yearling Sales. Originally called the KZN Breeders 1600 and boasting stakes of R250 000, the race's purse has increased ten fold to the present amount of R1 million. It will be run July 1 as part of the build-up to the Durban July weekend, and is open to horses with a merit rating of more than 80, ensuring that the cream of the crop, the most talented and promising get to represent KZN on the racing stage.

Subject to terms and conditions, any horse that passes through the Suncoast KZN Yearling Sale this year, and whose dam was registered in Kwa Zulu Natal as part of the innovative Breeders Premium Scheme offered by the province, will be eligible to compete in the KZN Breeders' Cup to be held on Vodacom Durban July Day in 2013, for stakes of R1 million. What is even more incredible, is that the horse will also be eligible to run in 2014 and 2015, which means potentially that a horse and its owner, could earn up to R3 million in winnings.

Past alumni of the race include: The Mousketeer, who went on to win the G3 August S. a few months later, following that up with a victory in Africa's richest sand race, the G2 Emerald Cup in November; Nhlavini, the three-time Equus Champion and leading older male sprinter of his generation, who went onto win at Group 1 and 2 level; To And Fro, listed winner; and Goat, runner-up to champion filly Dancewiththedevel in the G3 Acacia H.

Many of this year's potential entrants come not only with impressive racing credentials, but they have either full- or half-siblings on the KZN Yearling Sale, which follows July 4-5. KZN-based stallion King of Kings, who leads the sires log as a sire of 2-year-old winners, has several entries in the race, including the six-time winner King's Entourage, who has R380,000 in earnings already. The "on fire" stallion, Miesque's Approval has two very promising entrants in the race in the talented Sugar Rush and two-time winner Rocky Bay. Perennial top 10 sire Kahal has a strong hand in the race, with the likes of The Mousketeer (hoping to make it a double), Black Wing, Checcetti, Acapella, Top Talent and Silent Call. Checcetti has really hit a purple patch of late. A former R323,000 graduate from the 2009 Summerhill Ready To Run draft, this talented daughter of Kahal has raked up nearly R400,000 in earnings from her four wins, which included the G3 Jacaranda H. in March this year.

What makes this race so special and unique is that it is a breeding ground for future champions at all levels. Even the runners-up have gone onto achieve group and international fame. Names such as Art of War, Surfin USA, Pick Six, Galant Gagnant are all well known in the annals of local and international corridors. Last year's runner-up Ice Axe, a 4-year-old son of Summerhill Stud stallion Solskjaer, is a six-time winner for Charles Laird.

One things for sure, no matter who wins the race, there are bound to be many other winners on the day, and Kwa Zulu Natal racing has much to look forward to in the future as these emerging stars light up the tracks.
