MEANDERING TO GLORY

The Rothschild Family's **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) had promised much when annexing last year's G1 Grand Prix de Paris but, after a subsequent slump, turned his fortunes around in convincing style when causing an upset in yesterday's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. Sent off the outsider of the quartet remaining after **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) was a late withdrawal, the 6-1 shot tracked the steadily increasing pace carved out

by **Shareta (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) before being set alight by Maxime Guyon passing the quarter pole and surging to a 1 1/4-length success. "This horse is at his best during the summer and he needed his first two runs to reach his top level," commented trainer Andre Fabre, who is now just one short of the record of eight wins in this prize set by Francois Mathet. "He will not run in the [July 21 G1] King George, but we might take him to Berlin for the G1 Deutschland-Preis [at Hoppegarten July 22]." Cont. p3

'SORE' BLACK CAVIAR TO RACE ON

Trainer Peter Moody yesterday dismissed any retirement talk regarding **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}), who was found to have sustained soft tissue injuries during Saturday's G1 Diamond Jubilee S. success at Royal Ascot. Following the unbeaten mare's dramatic head success from Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the six-furlong feature, Moody had suggested it may have been her last race, but he seemed intent on moving ahead yesterday. "I have had my vets and chiropractors take some precautionary x-rays of Black Caviar this morning," Moody said from her Newmarket base of Abington Place Stables. "They have come back fine, but she has some soft tissue damage. I think it is called the quadricep muscle where the main problem is and she is quite sore behind. She'll now spend four weeks in quarantine and then when we get her home we will give her three months off and get her ready for the Spring Carnival in Melbourne in November. She will be prepared for another crack at the G1 Patinack Farm Classic at Flemington, which she has won for the past two years." Moody later told the *Telegraph*, "They are all injuries she has sustained before, so it is not unusual. She has torn her quad muscle before and it will not be the finish of her. She is very flat and will now have a couple of weeks' rest. It is the tightest I have seen her after a race, though she has never traveled this far before." Black Caviar entered quarantine yesterday morning and is likely to return to Australia in four weeks ahead of the spring carnival.

Meandre's four runs at two yielded a single placing and it took another three starts to get off the mark last term, but the grey quickly ascended through the ranks and two runs later was the impressive winner of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris on Longchamp's Bastille Day card. Runner-up to Reliable Man (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Niel back there in September, he closed off his 3-year-old campaign with a fair sixth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and returned to be fourth in the G2 Jockey Club S. over this trip at Newmarket May 5. Disappointing when a well-beaten second as the odds-on favorite for Longchamp's G3 La Coupe over 10 furlongs last time June 11, the homebred rebounded to upstage a trio of France's finest fillies here in a renewal diminished by the scratching of Cirrus des Aigles. Settled in third early as Shareta was left to cut out the pace, he always traveled comfortably and entered the home straight ready to tackle His Highness The Aga Khan's runner along with the 9-10 favorite **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). While that Arc heroine flattered to deceive near the rail, it was Meandre who cut loose with real purpose from 1 1/2 furlongs down. Danedream eventually lost third to the returning **Galikova (Fr)** (Anabaa), who never looked a danger under a patient ride from Olivier Peslier. Meandre earned an automatic berth into the GI Breeders' Cup Turf with his victory, but he would have to be nominated to compete in the event in November.

Danedream's trainer Peter Schiergen was at a loss to explain her flop. "I don't know what happened," he said. "She traveled well and then suddenly was finished, so we'll have to see how she is." Shareta's conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre said of the runner-up, "She ran her race and we have no excuses. She could run in the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 16], but we will also consider the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 21] in the interim."

Cirrus Suffers Setback...

Trainer Corine Barande-Barbe was forced to withdraw **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) from yesterday's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud after the 6-year-old suffered a late setback. The triple Group 1 winner was set to warm up for a tilt at the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. in yesterday's contest and his conditioner is still hopeful he will make that July 21 Ascot contest. "He is just a little bit lame," Barande-Barbe told *PA Sport*. "It is not serious. He just has a bit of an infection on his ankle and it impossible to run him in these conditions as it would hurt him, so we have to stay at home. We'll just have to see how he is this week. This happens to horses all the time."

American race fans were denied a chance to see a Triple Crown winner when I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) suffered the untimeliest of injuries on the eve of the GI Belmont S., but still might be able to lay eyes on a Triple Crown winner this fall. That, after last year's winner of the Japanese series--Orfevre--got back to his best form in the Takarazuka Kinen, a "Win and You're In" race for GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The brilliant chestnut swept through the G1 Satsuki Sho (2000 Guineas), G1 Tokyo Yushun (Derby) and G1 Kikuka Sho (St. Leger) over a five-month stretch last year, then replicated the feat of his champion full-brother Dream Journey (Jpn) by capturing the G1 Arima Kinen at Nakayama on Christmas Day facing elders. The 2012 season started off inauspiciously when Orfevre finished a half-length second as the 1-10 choice in the G2 Hanshin Daishoten S. Mar. 18, then took an even worse turn when he ran a well-beaten 11th at odds-on in the two-mile G1 Tenno Sho Apr. 29. Those who kept the faith were offered acceptable 2-1 odds here, and Orfevre rewarded them when a stylish return to form. Racing in midpack under regular rider Kenichi Ikezoe, he rallied into a striking position in upper stretch and strode clear impressively in the lane.

Dream Journey also had the Takarazuka Kinen on his resume, and they become the first brothers in JRA history to achieve the double. Trainer Yasutoshi Ikee, winning this race for the third time, had earlier said the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe was a probable target for Orfevre, but declined to comment on long-term plans after Sunday's win. Orfevre is not currently nominated to the Breeders' Cup program.

Strait of Dover began his career in his native British Columbia with two sub-par appearances over the dirt track at Hastings Park last summer, but found his stride when transferred to trainer Daniel Vella and Woodbine's Polytrack.

Disqualified from what would have been a maiden-breaking score last November, the dark bay colt made it official with a 1 1/2-length tally Nov. 26. He resurfaced with an allowance score Apr. 22 before earning his first stakes victory in the May 12 Marine S. He was sent off the second choice in the Queen's Plate, despite missing an expected prep run in the June 3 Plate Trial with a minor blood disorder.

The Canyon Farms homebred was quickest into stride and carved out honest fractions of :23 4/5 and :47 3/5. They began to turn up the heat after three-quarters in 1:12, but Strait of Dover found another gear in upper stretch and began to lengthen away. The lone horse in with a chance was the stalking filly Irish Mission, who gave game chase, but ultimately could get no closer than two lengths as Strait of Dover came home powerfully in track-record time to give Vella his second Queen's Plate victory.

A modest Vella gave all the credit to the horse. "Good horses do good things," he said. "We all like to take a little credit, but truthfully he's a great horse and that's what it's really about, the people that bred such a great horse and just being associated and being able to train these types of horses. It's what us guys in this industry, that's what we want to do."

Of his pre-race strategy, Vella added, "Well, we talked about it with [jockey] Justin [Stein] and we analyzed the race and we thought it was a possibility we would end up on the front end. We really didn't want that. You're doing the work for everyone else, but if you're there, you're there. Justin is just a great rider with a lot of confidence. He knew once he was out there he had to try and slow it down. He is just a great horse and it was a great ride."

Asked what it was like to win his first Queen's Plate, Stein said, "I can't say it right now because it would be a swear word, but it was something like 'Holy Foop!'"

The 32-year-old Stein, a native of British Columbia, added, "I loved this horse all along. He's shown me, and I have said it time and time again, that he is a racehorse. He wants to get out here and he wants to win. He calmed right down as soon as he saw that we were going into the gate and he just stood there and waited for his turn to be loaded. That's what he wants to do. I didn't have to be on the lead with him today, but no one else wanted to go and we were going pretty easy, so I just let him roll on up there. I have faith in this horse and he just galloped around there like a champ."

Strait of Dover, is a homebred for Wally and Terry Leong's Canyon Farms. The Leongs purchased his dam, Bahrain Star (Danzig), in foal to Smart Strike, for \$27,000 out of the 2002 Keeneland November sale. Her Smart Strike foal, named Starlite Strike, was a multiple stakes winner and graded stakes placed and earned \$210,341 running for Canyon Farms. The mare was bred to Yoonevano, who stood at the Kelowna farm, from 2003 to 2007 before producing Strait of Dover in 2009. She was bred to English Channel last spring. The Leong's only previous Queen's Plate runner was Illusive Force who finished last in 2003.

Smokey Fire, who captured the GII Play the King S. over the Woodbine turf course in 2010, had not been seen since running fifth in a main-track allowance that October. The gray gelding was allowed to settle near the back of the field as Essence Hit Man blitzed along on the lead through fractions of :21.93, :43.83 and :55.33. Angled to the outside for running room at midstretch, Smokey Fire reeled in the pacesetter and surged clear in the dying strides. "When he was so far back, I was worried," admitted winning trainer Sid Attard. "I didn't want to see him get stuck in traffic. He ran a great race." The 1:07.77 final time for the six furlongs was just a fraction off the course record of 1:07.39 set in 2008.

Smokey Fire was bred by the late Mel Lawson and runs in the Jim Dandy Stable now run by Lawson's son Jim, who is chairman of the Jockey Club of Canada. The 7-year-old's family has the elder Lawson's fingerprints all over it. He is out of Destroy, a mare bred by Mel Lawson out of his 1980 Canadian champion juvenile filly Eternal Search. Destroy, Canada's broodmare of the year in 2010, has an unnamed Smoke Glacken 2-year-old colt and a yearling colt by Arch. She was bred to Unbridled's Song this spring.

"We'll find a home for him for a stud career, although we were looking forward to running him the rest of the year," said Bradley. "[The Manhattan] was a very exciting race, and he showed how game and tough he was. It's the biggest hurt to lose a horse like this to an injury."

Desert Blanc was third in last year's G3 Prix du Prince D'orange. In two starts in the U.S. this year for trainer Chad Brown, the bay colt was second in the May 5 GIII Fort Marcy S. before his nose victory over Papaw Bodie (Strong Hope) in the Manhattan. On the board in six of seven starts, he won four times and earned \$428,093.

The dark bay colt, a \$230,000 Keeneland September yearling, worked five furlongs in 1:00.80, second fastest of 19 at the distance Sunday.



HYMN BOOK PREPS FOR SUBURBAN

GI Donn H. winner Hymn Book (Arch) worked four furlongs at Belmont Sunday in :48.05 in preparation for the July 7 GI Suburban H. The 6-year-old was fourth in the Apr. 14 GI Oaklawn H. and is coming off a fifth-place finish in the May 18 GI Pimlico Special. "I'm not a guy who says, 'I'm pointing to win a championship' or 'I'm pointing for the Breeders' Cup' in June," explained trainer Shug McGaughey. "These guys who are smarter than me start pointing for the Breeders' Cup in February. Hopefully he can be competitive in a race that will put him in [championship contention]. If he's competitive in the Suburban, we'll run in the GI Whitney H. or GI Woodward S. or something like that. If he needs to go down a notch, we'll do that, but hopefully he'll be competitive in those type of races. I'm not thinking year-end titles right now."

MOODY TOPS GROUP 1 LIST

Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus})'s narrow win in the Saturday's G1 Royal Jubilee S. in England was the crowning achievement on a momentous season for Australian trainer Peter Moody. The 43-year-old Victorian-based conditioner will end the nation's racing year on July 31 as the trainer with the most number of Group 1 wins during the season.

Moody claimed 10 Group 1 races in 2011/12, half of which were taken out by his champion mare Black Caviar. Moody's haul puts him two clear of rival Gai Waterhouse on 8, her tally helped along by the autumn heroics of **More Joyous (Aus)** (More Than Ready) and the Triple Crown-winning juvenile **Pierro (Aus)** (Lonhro {Aus}).

With five weeks still remaining in the season, Waterhouse holds a slender lead over Moody in prize money earned, with the Randwick trainer on A\$13,863,910 ahead of her Caulfield counterpart on \$13,854,956.

Australia's final Group 1 race in 2011/12, the BRC Tattersall's Tiara, run last Saturday in Brisbane, was taken out by 3-year-old filly, Pear Tart (Aus). A daughter of hugely successful shuttle sire Dehere, Pear Tart was bred by Tony Santic, owner of three-time Melbourne Cup winner Makybe Diva, and was sold to mining magnate Nathan Tinkler for \$45,000 at the 2010 Gold Magic Millions sale. -*Shayne O'Cass*
