**SIX FACE CAMELOT**

Just a sextet will take up the challenge of facing Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in tomorrow's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh and that number could be diminished further if there is additional rainfall in Kildare. One of those anxious about the current soft conditions is trainer Dermot Weld, who is hoping that the ground dries out for Moyglare Stud's May 27 G3 Gallinule S. winner **Speaking of Which (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). "The ground has become very testing and, if there is any more rain, then Speaking of Which would have to be considered a very doubtful runner," the Rosewell House-based conditioner told the *Racing Post* after the going was described as "heavy in places," the result of 20 millimeters of rain on Wednesday night. "He's a top-of-the-ground horse and earned his place in the race when winning the Gallinule S. by nine lengths last month. That was over a mile and a quarter on fast ground. It is nobody's fault that conditions have changed overnight, but I want to let the public know the situation." **Cont. p3**

## IRISH DERBY

### Born to Sea Stretches Out...

John Oxx has left in a duo, with **Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) sporting first-time blinkers and Jaber Abdullah's **Akeed Mofeed (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) now to be ridden by William Buick after Niall McCullagh was passed over. "It's fantastic to get such a good ride and I'm looking forward to it," Buick said. "He was a high-profile horse last year and it's always a pleasure to get these call-ups for such a good firm and such a nice horse." That colt's troubled spring has been well-documented and it will be a tall order for him to win on his first outing since finishing runner-up to David Livingston (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) on extremely testing ground in the G2 Beresford S. here in September. "He was a promising 2-year-old last year and we had high hopes for him," Oxx

told the *Post*. "He went through the winter fine, but took a lame step 10 days before the G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial and it took him a while to overcome that. Then we were aiming for the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial and he pulled a muscle that week, so although they were fairly minor things, it was seriously bad timing. So out of the last 12 weeks, he's had almost six of those walking and trotting and it's not a great preparation. The last month has gone well and he is working and moving very well, but he's not match-fit. He's fit enough to run a good race and start off for the year and, hopefully, we'll learn something."

**Bodemeister to WinStar cont from p1**

Accorded TDN Rising Star status off a 9 1/4-length maiden win in his two-turn debut at Santa Anita Feb. 11, Bodemeister ran Creative Cause (Giant's Causeway) to 3/4 of a length when second in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 10, then earned his role as Kentucky Derby favorite with a powerhouse 9 1/2-length victory in the Arkansas Derby. Owner Ahmed Zayat sold a minority interest in the colt to businessman Mike Moreno in late April, and Bodemeister led the Kentucky Derby through fast fractions and carried a three-length advantage into the final furlong before being run down by I'll Have Another. He repeated that performance in the Preakness, yielding grudgingly in the final yards to drop a neck decision. Those last three races produced Beyer Speed Figures of 108-109-108.

"Bodemeister is a brilliant horse, and this industry needs more sires that can carry their speed a mile-and-a-quarter," said his Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert.

Added Walden, "Bodemeister will be in an advantageous situation when he retires to stud. Mr. Zayat and Mr. Moreno have built quality

broodmare bands and are very active in the marketplace. I think breeders will love the fact they start off with three potential bidders on his babies. We are excited about the possibilities and the relationship."

Bodemeister, who skipped the GI Belmont S., had his first workout since the Preakness at Santa Anita June 24, going a leisurely half-mile in :50.60. He is tentatively scheduled to resume his campaign in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park July 29.

## WRITERS UP

### LONGTIME BREEDERS SCORE DESERVED

#### 'PLATE' WIN *By Lucas Marquardt*

Last Friday, owner/breeders Wally and Terry Leong met trainer Danny Vella for the first time in person. Two days later, the trio teamed to win the 153rd edition of the C\$1 million Queen's Plate with Strait of Dover (English Channel). For the Leongs at least, unfamiliarity breeds success.

The road that led the British Columbia-based couple to Vella began last fall--when they chose him based on a computer search--to take over the training of their homebred colt, then an unknown Hastings Park runner who was beaten a combined 31 lengths in his first two starts. But the road that led them to Plate glory began much earlier than that, as the Leongs have worked hard through several decades in the business, sometimes with success, and at other times struggling. Theirs is a story that, with little hyperbole, represents a hope that keeps many small breeders in the business: stay at it long enough, and you might just reach the top of the sport.

The Leongs, who operate under the banner Canyon Farms, first got involved in Thoroughbreds back in the mid-1960s, when Wally bought into a racehorse with a few college buddies from his alma mater, the University of British Columbia. A decade later, they were so immersed that they opened a breeding and stallion operation in Kelowna, a small city in British Columbia four hours northeast of Vancouver. Called Mission Creek, the farm stood, among others, the Sir Ivor stallion Golden Reserve, who for years remained atop the leading sires list in the province. Bloodstock agent Rollin Baugh advised on some of those initial purchases, and was among those who called the Leongs this week to congratulate them.

By the early '80s, however, Mission Creek, like many other farms in the area and beyond, began to struggle. The economy was stagnant, and interest rates were punishingly high. Mission Creek was forced into a bankruptcy, threatening the Leongs' involvement in the business. But the couple wasn't about to give up on their dreams. After reorganizing, they reopened as Canyon Farms, whose orange silks still have the old Mission Creek logo on them.

One of the stallions the Leongs stood at Canyon Farms, a son of Seattle Slew named Yoonevano indirectly led to Strait of Dover. The Leongs purchased Yoonevano as a stallion prospect for just \$4,000 at the 1998 Keeneland November Sale. The horse was small and, as Wally describes him, very "thick," but he had pedigree behind him. He was a half to Grade I winners Pine Bluff (Danzig) and Demons Begone (Elocutionist), and another sibling, Angel Fever (Danzig), would later become the dam of GI Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector).

The success of Danzig blood in the family led the Leongs to search out mares by the Claiborne great for Yoonevano. "I always look for blood," said Wally. "We can't afford to buy a young Danzig or Storm Cat mare of anything like that, so we have to buy the older ones, which is usually someone else's cull."

He was able to acquire the 13-year-old Danzig mare Subtle Blend for \$12,500 at the 1997 Keeneland November Sale, and from her bred Yoonevano's good son Illusive Force, a homebred earner of over \$500,000. Illusive Force gave the Leongs' their first Queen's Plate starter, but after suffering heat stroke, he walked across the line in 2003, the year Wando won. He is now a retiree at Canyon Farms. *Cont. p9*

A few years later, the Leongs added another daughter of Danzig: Bahrain Star. They purchased her, in foal to Smart Strike, for \$27,000 at the 2002 Keeneland November Sale. The resulting foal, Starlite Strike, could run. She won two stakes and earned over \$200,000. But four subsequent matings to Yoonevano proved wildly unsuccessful. All four horses made it to the races, but none won, and combined earned a little more than \$3,400. "They all came out to be plow horses," laughed Wally. "They were really thick, and couldn't run worth a damn."

The Leongs hadn't lost faith in Bahrain Star, though, and began searching out a more suitable mate. Smart Strike, Starlite Strike's sire, was now out of their price range, but one of his sons caught their eye. "We were in Kentucky, and English Channel was just coming off the racetrack," said Wally. "He'd just won the [2007] GI Breeders' Cup Turf. We went to see him at Ben Walden's Hurricane Hall, where he was at the time. He was smallish, but we were looking for a finer stallion, and we liked what we saw. We asked if they'd accept our mare, and they did, and that was Strait of Dover."

Wally said when Strait of Dover was born, he was, thankfully, more like his sister Starlite Strike than Bahrain Star's produce by Yoonevano. "He's not clunky," he said.

That Strait of Dover is not clunky is an understatement. Unplaced in his first two starts at Hastings as a 2-year-old last summer, he has now crossed the line first in his last five starts, all over Woodbine's Polytrack, including powerful wins in the Marine S. May 12 and in the Queen's Plate. He would probably be heavily favored to win the second leg of the Triple Crown, the Prince of Wales S. at Fort Erie July 15, regardless of his 0-for-2 record on dirt. Wally isn't sold on a tilt in the Prince of Wales, but believes Strait of Dover has some excuses for those Hastings efforts, when he was trained by Cindy Krasner.

"In that first start, he broke really bad, and that was it," said Wally. "In his second, there was a big gap after you come out of the starting gate--kind of like at Woodbine in the Plate--and he ducked in toward that opening. He was shuffled back and left so far behind he didn't have a chance. And then the meet ended."

At that point, the Leongs decided to take a chance on Strait of Dover's grassy pedigree, and made plans to ship him to Woodbine. In need of a trainer, Wally hopped on Google and started researching. "I read a few bios, and I liked what I read about Dan Vella," he said. "I just met him for the first time last week, when we came to the track on Friday morning. He's a good man--I couldn't have picked a better trainer, and his crew is great. They're just so nice. We really owe all this to Danny and his team--they're the ones who do all the work."

Leong said that when he departed Woodbine after the Queen's Plate, he gave Vella the nominating papers for the Prince of Wales and said, "you decide."

By Wednesday, the Leongs were back to Kelowna and catching up on farm business. Sadly, Bahrain Star ran into complications last year carrying a full-sibling to Strait of Dover, and the farm lost both the mare and the foal. But Canyon Farms does have three other mares currently in foal to English Channel, who now stands at Lane's End, and also has an English Channel yearling on the ground from the stakes-producing mare Fabulous Babs, yet another daughter of Danzig. Starlite Strike, meanwhile, is in foal to another Lane's End stallion in Stephen Got Even.

"Lane's End has looked after us very well," said Wally. "I got good-luck notes from them before the race, and right after the race got a congratulations from them. The gal I deal with is Gemma Freeman. She's been great."

The Leongs have scaled Canyon Farms down a bit in recent years. At its height, the farm was home to about 20 foals each spring. Now, that number's around four or five. Wally said he might add another mare or two next season, and not surprisingly mentioned English Channel as a possible mate for them. While they mull those decisions, the Leongs will just continue to bask in the glow of Strait of Dover's Queen's Plate win, which has struck a chord of provincial pride in British Columbia.

"We had 22 friends and family come with us to Toronto," Wally said. "We stayed up to 3:30 in the morning, watching the CBC [broadcast of the Queen's Plate]. It still hasn't totally sunk in. It was unreal. I've never felt like that before."

**My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike) capped a perfect four-for-four championship season with a three-length tour-de-force on the big stage in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Churchill Downs Nov. 4 ([video](#)).

Sideline thereafter with a sore shin, the Stonestreet Stables and George Bolton colorbearer is currently on the comeback trail, most recently turning in a trio of moves at Churchill Downs since rejoining the Steve Asmussen barn. The \$550,000 KEESOP yearling worked three furlongs in :39.20 June 15, four furlongs in :52 June 20, and four furlongs in :51 June 25. The

GI Frizette S. heroine also had a pair of three-furlong breezes under her belt during a previous stay at Vinery in May.

"My Miss Aurelia has grown taller, longer and has filled out a lot," co-owner George Bolton revealed, adding that the bay joined Asmussen's Saratoga string earlier this week, the site of her debut maiden win and GI Adirondack S. score. "She seems to be *very* happy to be back in full training. Physically, she seems to have gone the right way from two to three; the time off allowed her to fill out even better than she would've if she'd been hammered on all spring."

The Maryland native continued, "It's nice to hear that she's at Saratoga already--she's been to the track there twice and is doing great. It took her a little while to heal [following the Breeders' Cup], but there was no operation or screws--she just needed time to get right. We weren't in a rush to bring her back until she was *really* right."

Bolton, who has also been represented by top-shelf runners such as two-time Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart Strike), MGISW The Factor (War Front), and GII Dwyer S. winner Dominus (Smart Strike), has a deep appreciation for My Miss Aurelia's accomplishments in 2011.

"I'm so glad that I had 20 years in the sport to know how rare it is," he said of her unblemished record. "If she was my first horse, I'd be ruined. I own her with a great lady, who loves the sport, and we have a great time. We have the same agent in John Moynihan, she's named after my mother, and she went out there and won four races impressively, including the Breeders' Cup."

Bolton concluded, "It's once in your *lifetime* if you could have something this fun at this level. You just have to thank God that I had the 20 years of ups and downs to know how special it is. In a month we'll know if we got her right for the Test, which is always a tough race up there, but we all know that she's pretty tough, too."

## FIRE ON ICE

☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Fire On Ice (Unbridled's Song), a dazzling double-digit debut winner as a juvenile on the loaded GI Travers S. undercard last summer ([video](#)), is gearing up for a much-anticipated return to

the races with an eye on the upcoming Saratoga meeting.

Sidelined with a condylar fracture to his left hind ankle while preparing for the GI Champagne S. last fall, the flashy gray has since resurfaced on the worktab with a pair of easy three-furlong moves in :39 flat over the Belmont training track June 17 and 24, respectively.

"So far, so good," reported trainer and co-owner John Kimmel, adding that Fire On Ice's injury required a small, one-screw repair.

"We're bringing him back in a slow, progressive fashion. He's had a couple of what we called, 'two-minute licks,' but he's actually gone down there and worked in :39 and was out in :54 [for four furlongs]."

Out of an unraced half-sister to champion sprinter Squirtle Squirt (Marquetry), Fire On Ice was purchased by Kimmel and Eli Gindi for \$160,000 at the FTKJUL yearling sale with the intention of pinhooking as a juvenile. After failing to impress over Keeneland's Polytrack during the April Sale breeze show, bidding stalled out at \$170,000, and the duo took Fire On Ice home as a racing prospect.

"I thought he was a horse that had a lot of pedigree and had a very positive physical presence to him even back then," Kimmel recalled of his charge's appeal as a yearling. "He acted like he knew where he was going-- he's been a tough customer that way. He's got some of that Storm Cat demeanor in him; he could be tough around the barn at the times. I thought he had a great walk on him when he was a yearling, and as soon as I put him on the track at Belmont [after the KEEAPR sale], he was outworking every horse I put him with, including a horse that went on to win a Grade II stakes."

Not much of a secret at 5-2 in his Aug. 27 unveiling at the Spa, Fire On Ice broke on top, rattled off fractions of :22.29 and :45.07 while racing under pressure, and dropped the hammer under a busy David Cohen in the stretch, streaking home 10 3/4 lengths clear of Our Entourage (Street Cry {Ire}). Geared down a bit late, he stopped the clock for six furlongs in 1:09.67, good for an 88 Beyer Speed Figure. The eye-catching effort prompted Frank Stronach to purchase an 80% controlling interest.

"If his fitness level continues to improve, we'll ask him to do a little bit more each time," Kimmel concluded. "I'll have a better line on him once we get a couple of half-mile works into him. Right now, he's handling everything we've been doing quite well."

We're proud to be the winter home for some of the nation's finest horses, and believe it's just a matter of time until Fair Grounds is rewarded with a Grade I race."

The funds will be used to study gene- and blood-doping substances, as well as snake toxins and protein-based drugs. "I know of no better way to protect those interests than by supporting our drug testing program and providing our labs with the resources needed to keep illegal medications out of New York racing."

### TBA ANNOUNCE NEW BONUS SCHEME

The Thoroughbred Breeders' Association yesterday revealed that it will launch a new bonus scheme worth £5 million per year in an attempt to boost poor levels of British prize money. Unveiling the initiative at the organisation's annual general meeting in Newmarket, departing Chairman Kirsten Rausing gave the details of the British Owners and Breeders Incentive Scheme (BOBIS). "BOBIS is a simple scheme designed to be transparent and easy for breeders and owners to understand its benefits," she said. "Importantly, it also recognises and rewards the contribution of owner/breeders and encourages the retention of fillies, with the aim that we see an increase of domestic broodmares over the next five years." Designed by TBA Vice-Chairman Julian Richmond-Watson, Paul Greeves, Grant Pritchard-Gordon and Louise Kemble, the scheme's aim is to boost prize money by 25%, with the extra prize fund split 70/30 between owners and breeders, respectively. Richmond-Watson added, "This is unashamedly a scheme to support owners of mares based in the UK. It's a 'self-help' scheme for every single Flat and National Hunt race and would be phased in over three years. We'd be looking to the Levy Board to match the funds raised by owners and breeders. By the time it's up and running it should be generating an extra £5 million."

### NEWCASTLE HIT BY STORM

Newcastle look set to lose their feature Northumberland Plate meeting after an electrical storm hit the track Thursday. Yesterday's meeting was abandoned after the fourth race when over an inch of rain fell in minutes, while today's fixture which would have centered around the Listed Hoppings S. is already off. "Thanks to the support of vendors we were able to offer 11% more weanlings this year than in 2012, and buyers flocked to the sale with the aggregate up 29%," said Inglis Managing Director Mark Webster. "The top nine weanlings [Thursday] were all sold to interstate or overseas clients, a great indication of the spread of buying bench assembled here in Sydney."
