A WELCOME OUTCOME

Worries about The Curragh's testing ground aside, the superiority of **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) on all known form was unquestionable prior to yesterday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby, and the brilliant colt overcame the conditions to maintain his perfect sequence. Sent off the 1-5 favorite, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Investec Derby hero traveled like those odds suggested he would for much of

the contest, but, when committed at the quarter pole, instantly had **Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) to contend with. Shaking him off soon after as the whip was applied, the bay stretched away to a two-length success. In doing so, he became the first since Nijinsky to win this trio of Classics, and John Magnier confirmed that they want to emulate that great with Triple Crown glory in the G1 St Leger. "I said to Aidan when he came to Ballydoyle that there was room for another of those statues," Coolmore's owner said, referring to the monument to Dr Vincent O'Brien's champion that stands at Rosegreen. "That's Derrick and Michael's dream, to have a Triple Crown winner, and we will try to make him one." **Cont. p3**

The Curragh's decision to stage their feature race on a Saturday evening acted as a relaunch of sorts of this Classic, but much of the build-up to the most recent renewal was focused on whether Camelot would actually show. Heavy rain hit most of Britain and Ireland this week, and connections were in no doubt as to the testing nature of the track, which led to the withdrawal of Moyglare Stud's Speaking of Which (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). His absence, along with Camelot's stable companion Imperial Monarch (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), undermined the opposition to the pride of Ballydoyle, who had become the necessary ingredient to determine whether the new recipe was one for success. Despite the excitement of seeing him again, the prospect of defeat due to the unusual conditions hung like a spectre over the occasion.

With the die cast and Camelot committed, Joseph O'Brien took his usual languid approach and settled him well off the pace set by Astrology (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) with only Born To Sea and Johnny Murtagh behind. Apparently sitting pretty on the home turn as Akeed Mofeed (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) took over with Light Heavy pressing him on the lead, Camelot was moved to the fore with a quarter mile remaining and he jinked left there. Straightened for the final drive, he was able to handle more than a furlong of harrying from the Tsui homebred with his jockey reverting to hands and heels in the final yards.

"It's incredible--he hasn't set foot on grass at home since Epsom, as we've been flooded," trainer Aidan O'Brien commented after greeting his 10th winner of the race and seventh in succession. "He's passed every test all the way along, but I thought today would be too much for him, as we were asking him to swim against the tide. It was a massive call and I thought it was impossible, but John [Magnier] was very adamant that he wanted to support the race, and all the people and sponsors. Joseph [O'Brien] always said he didn't like soft ground and his wheels were spinning the whole way. He's been working on all-weather for the last month, so it was an incredible performance in the circumstances."

Aidan O'Brien continued, "I definitely would have wilted under the pressure and not had the courage to run him, so fair play to the lads. I think it's a testimony to the horse, as our horses had been running very ordinary all week, but he's very special and Joseph only wanted to nurse him and get him over the line. He's so calm after the race and doesn't blow--I've never seen a horse like him after a race and we are privileged to have anything to do with him. The plan was to give him a break after today and look to the autumn with him. Every morning going in, we salute Nijinsky and we never thought we would have one that could pass all the same tests. Today was so special."

Joseph O'Brien, who became the first to claim to victory for a father-son partnership in this race, added, "Camelot has done extremely well to win today on ground he struggled on all the way."



He continued, "There is a patch down the back which the horses cross for the gallops and he stumbled and lost his footing there, so I was worried turning in. He showed the heart that he has from there. He relaxed well and everything went to plan apart from the fact that he hated the ground."

John Magnier left nobody in any doubt as to the regard he holds Camelot.

"We are looking for the next Sadler's Wells," the Coolmore supremo said. "This horse has been tested all the way through and has shown the two-year-old form, the Guineas form, the hard, the soft and the

battling and that's what you want--you have to have all those qualities, so that's my commercial. Sadler's Wells ran in the bog here when winning the Beresford and did all those things, too."

As far as the decision to let him take his chance, Magnier added, "It is like winter ground, but we had to run. Given a choice, we probably wouldn't have done, but that would have been like the tail wagging the dog. We didn't do the right thing, but we just got away with it."

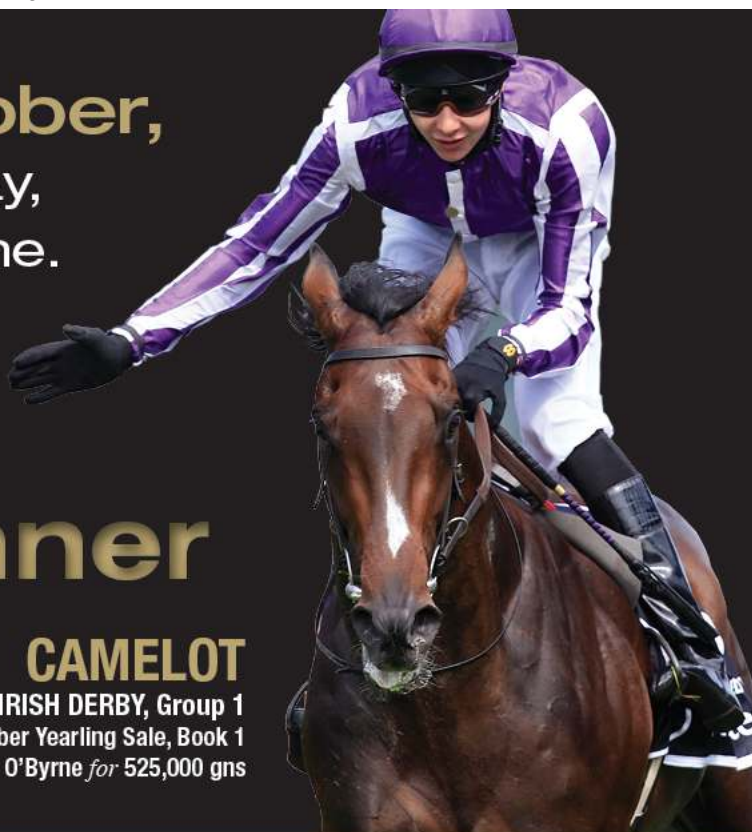

Overlooked a bit at the windows this time, Jeranimo was content to trail the field of eight as East Coast invader Little Mike and jockey Joe Bravo attempted to take the field wire-to-wire while pressed through fractions of :23.59 and :46.40. Jeranimo began to come alive when wheeled out for his run at the top of the stretch, and came flying home on the outside to post an impressive tally. "We have the home field

advantage now," owner B.J. Wright revealed. "This is a 'Win and You're In,' and the Breeders' Cup is going to be held at Santa Anita. I like that home field advantage. He's just a great racehorse. He's had some rides where the jockey didn't know him well, but Garrett [Gomez] seems to ride him really well. We're really happy with this jockey." Gomez added, "This is a hard-trying horse. He and I get along pretty well. We had a good trip today. We just wound him up and made one little run with him. It was the right kind of race to do that. He's been training really well. The guys have been doing a really good job with him." Suggestive Boy, a multiple Group 1 winner in his native country, ran well while making his first start in the U.S. "This is a serious horse," jockey Joe Talamo said. "He definitely needed the race, coming off an [Oct. 15] layoff. But to do that in a Grade I like that, he's going to be a real nice horse. Distance wise, he can run all day. If he moves forward off this, we could have some fun with him."

Camp Victory provided the perfect get-well-soon present to his trainer as Mike Mitchell continues to recover after having a brain tumor removed Friday. Claimed off West Point Thoroughbreds and John Sadler out of a winning effort for \$40,000 last February, Camp Victory finished second and was placed first via disqualification over subsequent champion Amazombie (Northern Afleet) in the GIII Los Angeles H. at Hollywood last May. He also collected second-place finishes in the 2011 renewal of this race and the GI Pat O'Brien S. at Del Mar.

Seventh in the GII Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Churchill Downs, Camp Victory kicked off his 5-year-old campaign with a good third in the GII Potrero Grande S. at Santa Anita Apr. 7, and repeated that effort in the GIII Los Angeles H. most recently May 28. Camp Victory stayed within striking distance here as favored The Factor was pressed through fractions of :22.49 and

:44.82 with defending Triple Bend winner Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger) a stalking third. Smiling Tiger moved to challenge The Factor turning for home, but Camp Victory took up the challenge as well, revving up three wide as Joe Talamo took a quick look back in the rear view mirror. Camp Victory blew right by The Factor in the stretch, and increased the margin to the wire.

"There was a tear or two coming down," assistant trainer Phil D'Amato admitted. "Mike [Mitchell] did all the work--I just had him in maintenance mode. Mike's always loved this horse and picked him out to claim. It was, like, a six-way shake the day we got him. I've

been with Mike seven years now. He's like my father. He took me under his wing and taught me everything." Mrs. Denise Mitchell watched the race alongside her husband via the internet in the hospital. "We were ready to move to a new room from the ICU, but they let us sneak a laptop in there to watch the race," she revealed. "Both [daughters McCall and Shea] were there and we were all huddled around the laptop. Mike came out of the surgery fine and he's doing very well. In fact, he's sitting in a chair right now and isn't in any pain. Mike knew he was in tough today, but after the race he said, '10-1? Man.'"

Maarek took two of his first three starts in 2012, which were competitive six-furlong handicaps at Naas Apr. 21 and Newmarket May 6, and was not disgraced when sixth in the prestigious Wokingham H. over that same trip at Royal Ascot on Saturday. Sum of the Parts, an impressive debut winner at Churchill Downs last May, was runner-up in Remington's Kip Deville S. Oct. 7 before concluding his juvenile season with a well-beaten sixth-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 4. The dark bay has caught fire since turning three, kicking off the term with a runaway Keeneland allowance win Apr. 20, and entered off a narrow victory in Presque Isle's Tom Ridge S. May 15. Hustled to the front through fractions of :22.37 and :45.64 here, Sum of the Parts was doing it comfortably, and easily turned back the challenge of Gill Woody Stephens third Il Villano to win for fun. "He gave me a ton," winning jockey Leandro Goncalves said. "I just waited on this horse. I rode him very confident. I could have waited even longer on this horse, but then Il Villano came to us and I let him go."



BLACK-TYPE PREVIEW

THE NOVEL APPROACH

Monsun (Ger) is one of the main reasons for the emergence of Germany as a force on the international arena in recent times, and his son **Novellist (Ire)** can become his fourth winner of the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg today. Unbeaten and unchallenged thus far, Dr Christoph Berglar's prized homebred has won his three starts by a cumulative margin of 19 lengths, and his dispatch of the re-opposing **Munic Boy** (Bernardini) in the June 10 G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen over 11 furlongs at Cologne sets a clear standard. He bids to follow where recent winners **Next Desert (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}), **Dai Jin (GB)** (Peintre Celebre) and **Wiener Walzer (Ger)** (Dynaformer) led and complete the double here. Stable companion **Black Arrow (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) may be best placed to take advantage of any slip-ups, despite being turned over at 1-5 when runner-up in Munich's G3 Bavarian Classic--where **Salon Soldier (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) was back in third--over 10 furlongs when last seen May 28. Previously, Stall 24's talented bay had beaten Stall Eivissa's subsequent G2 Derby Italiano hero **Feuerblitz (Ger)** (Big Shuffle) by a decisive 3 1/2-length margin in the Listed Derby Trial at Hanover Apr. 29. One with genes on his side is the winner of Bremen's June 17 Listed Derby Trial **Baltic Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), and it may be significant that Gestut Ammerland have supplemented this grandson of the 1997 heroine Borgia (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}).

FIFTEEN LOVE

Traditionally, the G1 Prix Jean Prat has been a poor cousin of the major mile contests, but stars who stopped off for a spin around Chantilly's chateau in recent times include Bago (Fr) (Nashwan), Lawman (Fr) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and Tamayuz (GB) (Nayef). Successful in the 2005 version, Turtle Bowl (Ire) has a strong chance of siring a winner of the race from his first crop courtesy of Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani's **French Fifteen (Fr)**. His neck defeat by Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the May 5 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket was another step forward after wins in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in October and the G3 Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte on his sophomore bow Apr. 5, and he was one of the chief sufferers of the melee in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club here last time. Still beaten less than five lengths in that June 3 Classic despite being held up in the bottleneck more than once, he appears to have the beating of these rivals with a clear run. "[Last time] was a nightmare of a race," trainer Nicolas Clement told *PA Sport*. "He came back with some cuts and bruises, but he seems fine now. You only have to look at Brian Meehan's horse Most Improved; he had a similar run in the race and won the [G1] St James's Palace S. last week. I've been very happy with his last two pieces of work, and we decided this was the right race for him." Princess Haya of Jordan's **Gregorian (Ire)** (Clodovil {Ire}) added to the comedy of errors in the Jockey Club when running wide off the final bend and throwing away any chance. That forgettable effort was sandwiched between two creditable displays over this trip when fifth in the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp and third in Royal Ascot's G1 St James's Palace S. 12 days ago. Fellow British challenger **Caspar Netscher (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}) had already proven himself a force to be reckoned with at sprint trips last year, but looked a dubious stayer when fading to ninth in the 2000 Guineas. Unbowed, Charles Wentworth's bargain-buy rebounded in typically game fashion to win Cologne's G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (the German version of the Newmarket Classic) 22 days later, and that form was boosted by the Royal Ascot win of the fourth Energizer (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}). "He's very fresh and well because we bypassed Ascot," trainer Alan McCabe told *PA Sport*. "Last year, he was a horse that took a lot of racing and probably needs a lot of racing. Everything we've thrown at him, he's done it for us." One unexposed type who is going forward at a rate of knots is Daniel-Yves Treves' **Xanadou (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre), and the form of the G3 Prix Paul de Moussac that he won over this track and trip June 9 was boosted yesterday by the G3 Prix Daphnis success of the fourth So Beautiful (Fr) (Zamindar).

Seamus Heffernan remains in the irons. "She's a Classic winner and I'm really looking forward to riding her again," Heffernan told *PA Sport*. "I got a good trip round Epsom. I knew where I wanted to be the whole way and she got the job done well. Hopefully, she can improve from that, and it will be interesting to see how she handles conditions, as the ground is going to be very different to what she raced on in Epsom. She's coming back to 10 furlongs, but I don't think that will be too much of a hindrance. The ground is probably more of a worry than the trip, but it's the same for all of them and, hopefully, my filly is on a going day again and we get a bit of luck." Joseph O'Brien maintain his partnership with ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who may have been in need of the outing when third as the 13-8 favorite in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6, and looked not to stay when fifth in the Oaks. Her unbeaten 2-year-old campaign that earned her champion status has to be viewed in a less favorable light now that the form has had the chance to unravel, but Michael Tabor's colorbearer always suggested she would improve at three. Leading the English invasion is the Meon Valley homebred **Izzi Top (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who is on a roll after a trio of Pattern-race successes.

Positive tactics have seen her annex the G3 Prix de Flore over 1 5/16 miles at Saint-Cloud in October, G3 Dahlia S. over nine furlongs at Newmarket May 6 and York's G2 Middleton S. 11 days later. Emulating her dam Zee Zee Top (GB) (Zafonic) in winning the latter contest--which was a listed contest nine years ago--she will bid to better her again here, as that former Sir Michael Stoute trainee could only manage second in this before being demoted to third also in 2003. One of the potential improvers is Moyglare Stud's **Sapphire (Ire)** (Medicean {GB}), who dealt with Was and Maybe's stable companion Betterbetterbetter (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) with ease in Cork's G3 Noblesse S. over 12 furlongs last time June 17. "She is a lovely mare and she's entitled to have a crack at this," trainer Dermot Weld said of the homebred, who would be a fitting winner in the week the world lost Moyglare founder Walter Haefner. "We're bringing her back two furlongs and, although she's a really good mile-and-a-half mare, the forecast rain should help us. It is an excellent renewal of the race, with the champion two-year-old of Europe in Maybe and the best mile-and-a-quarter filly in England in Izzi Top, so it has the makings of an outstanding race, but I wouldn't swap Sapphire."

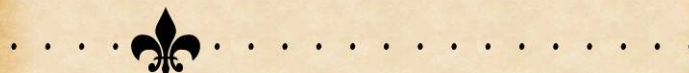
