IZZI ON TOP

Sunday's renewal of The Curragh's G1 Pretty Polly S. was considerably diminished by the withdrawals of the star Ballydoyle pair of **Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Was (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), and to a lesser extent of **Bible Belt (Ire)** (Big Bad Bob {Ire}), due to the well-documented testing ground, but in **Izzi Top (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) it was saved by a genuinely impressive winner.

Succeeding where her dam Zee Zee Top (GB) (Zafonic) failed--she was demoted from second to third in this in 2003--the Meon Valley homebred made light of the heavy going to collect a vital first Group 1 victory and earn an automatic berth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. "She was very progressive last year and put up very good performances at Newmarket and York, so I always thought she was a Group 1 filly," jockey William Buick said. "The ground was not ideal for her, but she won nicely." **Cont. p3**

SAME OLD STORY FOR FABRE AT CHANTILLY

Godolphin homebred **Aesop's Fables** (Distorted Humor) came into yesterday's G1 Prix Jean Prat as a decided outsider with **French Fifteen (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) hogging the spotlight, but it should have come as no surprise that trainer Andre Fabre would have a say in the outcome and secure a fourth victory in this contest since it was upgraded to top-level status. With a strong pace to run at here courtesy of the early travails of **Arnold Lane (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) and **Coup de Theatre (Fr)** (Gold Away {Ire}), Aesop's Fables had precious energy remaining as he was wound up for his challenge by Maxime Guyon in midstretch. **Gregorian (Ire)** (Clodovil {Ire}) was committed passing the quarter pole, but was a sitting duck as Aesop's Fables swooped on him with 100 meters en route to a comfortable success. French Fifteen was never a factor and only passed one rival under exaggerated waiting tactics. "He was a nice 2-year-old, but like many of my horses, got sick in the second half of the season and I had to keep him quiet," Fabre said of the winner. "He ran a very good race last time behind Moonlight Cloud, but more than anything, he is a good-ground horse and hasn't had the chance to run on it so far this year. He had a sound surface today and that was a nice result, so we'll see where we go now." **Cont. p5**

At three, Izzi Top's form was tied in with Dancing Rain (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), as she beat that rival in the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. over 10 furlongs at Newbury in May before finishing third behind her in the G1 Epsom Oaks the following month. Next seen winning the G3 Prix de Flore over 1 5/16 miles at Saint-Cloud in October, the bay showed she had made further progression during the off-season when garnering the G3 Dahlia S. over nine furlongs at Newmarket May 6 and York's G2 Middleton S. over an extended 10-furlong trip just 11 days later. Stalking the favorite Sapphire, who was looking to provide the greatest honor for the memory of her stud's founder Walter Haefner in the week he passed away, Izzi Top was going clear-best of that duo inside the final quarter and the writing was soon on the wall. Cruising through the gears quickly as soon as she was set alight by William Buick, she was in front approaching the furlong pole and received just a couple of light flicks with the whip as she recorded one of her easiest wins.

"Pat [Smullen] wanted to bowl along in front and keep it simple, but on this ground you don't want to give away too much rope so I wanted to have him in my sights," Buick said of the trip. "At the same time, I didn't want to challenge too early, as she has a lot of speed and is really a fast-ground filly because she can use it properly on that surface." Trainer John Gosden added, "She didn't like that ground, but not many do and this is her trip. We'll look at the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 4] and [Oct. 7] G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp and the Breeders' Cup, too."

Last year's G3 Herzog Von Ratibor-Rennen winner Pastorius entered this Classic under the radar, with all the focus on the unbeaten Novellist, but he blindsided that 7-10 favorite to cause a 31-1 shock. Runner-up on his first black-type test behind Black Arrow (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in the Listed Winterfavorit-Trial over a mile at Cologne in September, he reversed that form in decisive fashion in Krefeld's Herzog Von Ratibor-Rennen over a half-furlong further in November. Back over that same track and trip for the Apr. 22 G3 Dr Busch-Memorial on his sophomore bow, the bay was fourth behind the subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains fourth Amaron (GB) (Shamardal) and G3 Tercentenary S. winner Energizer (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) and owed his starting odds here to a lackluster effort afterwards when only seventh in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas), at Cologne last time May 28. Held up in rear early following the tracks of Novellist, he started to veer left towards the rail in early stretch as the market leader made hard work of getting past Black Arrow and Girolamo and to the front. While he managed to do so yards from the line and give the Hamburg faithful hope that he would fill pockets, it was Pastorius whose wide charge out of sight of most of the bunch proved decisive in a tight finish.

Trainer Mario Hofer, who was winning his first Derby, commented, "Before the race, I said that Novellist was not to be beaten, but I was sure Pastorius would be able to finish in the frame." Jockey Terry Hellier, who was also enjoying an initial taste of glory in this prestigious affair, added, "I have always believed in this horse and I was sure that he would stay the trip." From the first crop of last year's leading first-season sire Soldier Hollow, who is now based at Gestut Auenquelle, Pastorius is another footnote in the story of Monsun (Ger), who is his damsire and also the sire of the much-vaunted runner-up.

Aesop's Fables started out with a promising second over six furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte last June and stayed at that trip to open his account later that month at this track. Only second as the favorite for the G3 Prix Roland de Chambure over seven at Longchamp on Bastille Day, the bay dropped to fifth next time in Deauville's Listed Prix Francois Boutin, again over that trip, in August. Returning with a third in a six-furlong conditions race back at Maisons-Laffitte May 10, he showed he was ready for a mile on his latest start when overwhelmed late on and finishing third behind the top-class Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the seven-furlong G3 Prix du Palais-Royal at Longchamp June 2.

The lightly raced but very consistent Hunters Bay has proven a force to be reckoned with over Woodbine's Polytrack, and the Adena Springs homebred continued his dominance of this venue's handicap division here. Two-for-three for trainer Todd Pletcher as a sophomore, the bay was handed over to Reade Baker last term, finishing close seconds in a pair of salty Gulfstream optional claimers in February and March, while breaking the 100 Beyer Speed Figure mark both times. He got his first win for the new conditioner two starts later when romping by 6 1/4 lengths in a seven-furlong heat here last May. He resurfaced at Gulfstream to finish second again Mar. 3 behind MGSW Pants On Fire (Jump Start). Hunters Bay returned to take another seven-furlong optional seller here Apr. 28 by a convincing four-length margin, and was last seen earning what seemed like inevitable black-type when he annexed the 8 1/2-furlong GIII Eclipse S. here May 26 by three lengths.

Dominion Day S. cont.

Guided to the outside as Straight Story (Giant's Causeway) provided the compact field with what little pace there was, the odds-on choice confronted Pender Harbour as that one took over turning for home. Last year's Canadian champion 3-year-old wasn't going down without a fight and dug in as Hunter's Bay struggled to keep a straight path while cocking his head towards the stands, but the favorite ultimately leveled off in the waning moments to pull clear. "He's so easy to handle," pilot Emma-Jayne Wilson said of the winner. "If you ask him to sit, he sits. If you ask him to move on up, he moves on up. Having that tactical ability makes it easier to ride these kinds of races." Baker revealed that Hunters Bay could be taking his show on the road and stepping into the deep end next time. "We'll probably go to the [Aug. 4 GI] Whitney H. at Saratoga or possibly the [Aug. 26 GI] Pacific Classic at Del Mar."

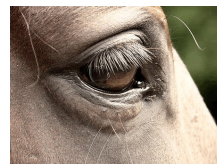

The first light of dawn last Thursday saw racing enthusiasts flocking to Greyville racecourse to watch the contenders for South Africa's headline race, the G1 Vodacom Durban July, go through their paces at the official gallops. The traditional coffee and sticky buns kept the morning chill away as they waited to see their fancies in action.

Top weight **Pierre Jourdan (SAf)** (Parade Leader) was first out and the people's horse did not disappoint, putting in an eye-catching gallop under race rider Robbie Fradd. With the two reserve runners withdrawn, Pierre Jourdan now jumps from barrier 13.

English Garden (SAf)

(Camden Park) from the Mike Bass stable put in a strong gallop in the early dawn. Bernard Fayd'Herbe partnered the gelding, who jumps midfield from barrier nine.

The Mike De Kock duo of **Vettel (Arg)** (Know Heights {Ire}) and the filly **Ilha Bela (SAf)** (Fort Wood) galloped together, with Anton Marcus on Vettel and stable jockey Anthony Delpech doing the honours on Ilha Bela. Ilha Bela is the second favourite in the antepost betting, with a light weight of 53kg, while Vettel is third favourite with 53.5kg. The draw, however, is not in Ilha Bela's favour with barrier 19.

Last out on the course on Thursday was the Brett Crawford-trained pair of **Jackson (SAf)** (Dynasty {SAf}), the current Vodacom Durban July favourite, and **Polar Bound (SAf)** (Western Winter).

Karis Teetan, Jackson's regular rider, was impressed by the performance of the burly colt. Teetan commented that the gallop will bring him on and that he will be spot on for the Vodacom Durban July.

With the Vodacom Durban July gallops being a condition of entry, **Smanjemanje (SAf)** (Kahal {GB}) and **Eton Square (SAf)** (Miesque's Approval), who have not yet departed from their Johannesburg base, galloped on Wednesday, with their efforts being recorded and shown on course. **Cont. p14**

The recent G1 Prince of Wales's S. scorer **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) is set for Saturday's G1 Eclipse at Sandown, while ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who was scratched from the Irish Derby, is being aimed at the [July] 14 G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp.

Oxx Looks to Champion with Sea...

☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) has the G1 Irish Champion S. as his main target following his Irish Derby heroics, trainer John Oxx announced yesterday. Beaten two lengths by Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the 12-furlong Classic on Saturday, the Tsui homebred has opened up a series of options at middle-distances and connections are thinking of the Sept. 8 10-furlong contest at Leopardstown.

"I'm delighted with him and every time he runs, he runs better than the previous time so is finding his way now," Oxx said. "I thought he had Camelot for a while and so did Johnny [Murtagh], but in the last 50 to 100 yards the ground just bottomed him out. He gets a mile and a half on normal, but was just flagging a little bit at the end on that and has run a great race. He is beginning to make his own mark and is very tough, genuine and very adaptable. He takes his races very well and improves race to race, so he's heading in the right direction and a mile and a quarter to a mile and a half is ideal. Maybe the Irish Champion S. would be his next objective and whether he runs or not beforehand, I don't know."

Oxx also expressed satisfaction with the effort of Jaber Abdullah's **Akeed Mofeed (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who was fourth on his belated seasonal return. "He came out of it fine and was in good shape this morning," he added. "He just blew up--he got as far as the two pole and that was it. It is an unusual thing to give a horse a prep race in a Derby, but we had to get him out and the owner was game to run him. On heavy ground like that, it was asking a lot."

Derby Re-Jig Hailed a Success...

The Curragh's General Manager Paul Hensey was taking a positive stance on the repositioned Dubai Duty Free-sponsored Irish Derby on a Saturday evening, suggesting it could become a regular feature. Switched from Sunday afternoon, the race helped draw an increased crowd on 12 months ago, despite the rain. "I think the crowd figure was 23,211, which is about 500 up on last year's Derby meeting," Hensey said. "I think, considering the inclement weather and everything, that has to go down as a success as there is no doubt the weather had an effect on the number of walk-ups we got on the day. There were people seven or eight-deep around the parade ring before the race and I stood on the track watching the grandstands just before the off and you could sense the tension, as nobody wanted to see [Camelot] get beat. Everyone had heard Aidan's reservations about the ground, but thankfully he won and it was obviously a great result. It is something we'll obviously have to review further down the line with our team and later on the board, but my recommendation would be that we stick to the same plan for next year."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Turbulent Descent Sold...

Multiple Grade I winner **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), who had raced for Blinkers On Racing partnership, has been sold to Coolmore and will be transferred to the East Coast stable of trainer Todd Pletcher. "Over the years we have had a number of offers and we've never taken one of them--the number just wasn't right and we wanted to enjoy the ride," explained Blinkers On founder Scott Sherwood. "And sort of out of the blue just last week an offer was presented that was a number that was impossible to refuse."

Blinkers On purchased Turbulent Descent for \$160,000 out of the 2010 OBS April sale. The bay filly went on to capture the 2010 GI Hollywood Starlet, as well as last year's GI Test S. and GI Santa Anita Oaks. She was the 7-5 favorite in last year's GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, where she finished fifth. In her lone start so far in 2012, she captured the June 17 Desert Stormer H. On the board in nine of 11 starts to date, Turbulent Descent has won seven times and earned \$901,640.

Sherwood admitted he and the eight partners on the filly had been hoping for one more crack at the Breeders' Cup, but the group had already planned to sell Turbulent Descent as a broodmare prospect in the fall.

"We were planning all along to make one more run at the Breeders' Cup, with the [July 14 GII] A Gleam next month, so we were basically really only planning on running her three more times before we sold her," Sherwood said. "And the number was a substantial premium, in our mind, to what we would be able to sell her for as a broodmare."

The sale was bittersweet, Sherwood admitted, but he and his partners have enjoyed the experience.

"We campaigned and won races with her at two and three and four and we've traveled all over the country and we've won Grade Is and won big races," he said. "We were a favorite in the Breeders' Cup, even though we didn't win. So it's not like we really feel cheated on the experience. We sort of had the ride. So it is bittersweet, because we love the horse and we're all very attached to the horse, and it has been a great, great ride. But we knew that the day was going to come."

Suburban Hopefuls Tune Up...

A trio of contenders for next Saturday's GII Suburban H. tuned up at Belmont Park Sunday. Mike Repole's **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), working in company with MGSW Rule (Roman Ruler), went five furlongs in 1:00.05 with jockey Javier Castellano in the irons. Winner of last year's GI Travers S., Stay Thirsty has made only one start this term, a runner-up effort in the May 17 Vanlandingham S. "I thought he worked really well," trainer Todd Pletcher commented after the drill. "Both this work and the one before (5f, 1:00.05, June 25) were like what we saw before the Travers. He's in good form."

Live Oak homebred **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini), looking to improve on a third-place effort in the May 28 GI Metropolitan H., worked four furlongs over the training track in :47.56--third fastest of 62 at the distance. "If all goes well and he comes out of the work happy and is feeling good, then we'll run him in the Suburban," trainer Bill Mott reported. "Hopefully he'll run well and come back in good enough shape to run in the [Aug. 4 GI] Whitney."

GI Donn H. winner **Hymn Book** (Arch) worked four furlongs over the main track in :47.05--second fastest of 71 at the distance. "He's coming into the race great," said Buzz Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey. "He's an honest, hard-trying horse, and he'll give a good account of himself."

I'll Have Another, who broke his maiden and has been stabled at Hollywood Park, was recently sold to stand at stud at Shigeyuki Okada's Big Red Farm in Japan. The day's festivities will also include a fedora giveaway.



Mareina Was Worth the Wait:

Trainer Mike Mareina first worked at Belmont Park in 1980 when he was assistant to trainer Loren Rettele. Over three decades later, Mareina finally made his return to the Elmont oval and he is more than making up for lost time. With a string of 15 horses for owners Ernie Kuehne, Chris Baccari and Charles Arlington, the trainer has five victories from 14 starts, along with a second and two thirds. Mareina has been represented by recent Belmont winners Onthekisser (Pleasant Tap), Won Kool Kid (Lemon Drop Kid), Heir to Dare (Wildcat Heir), Alternative (Limehouse) and Divine Music (Songandaprayer).

"I love it here," Mareina, who has competed up and down the coast of California, as well as in the Midwest, Washington, Louisiana, Florida and Canada, told NYRA's press office. "Every horse I work is working well. I can't say enough about how well the tracks are maintained, and with the nice one-mile training track, it affords you all the opportunities to get a horse in a good atmosphere and a good training situation."

Mareina has served stints as assistant to trainers Bobby Frankel and Phil Hauswald. He also trained Game on Dude (Awesome Again) before the MGISW was sold and transferred to trainer Bob Baffert.

He currently has eight juveniles stabled at Belmont and plans to add another four or five to the Elmont base when racing shifts upstate to Saratoga.
