### ALL BLUESKIESNRAINBOWS IN SWAPS

**Blueskiesnrainbows** (English Channel) missed out on a trip to the GI Kentucky Derby when he tired to third behind I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) after setting the pace in the Apr. 7 GI Santa Anita Derby, but he got the second half of the sophomore season off in style with a wire-to-wire victory in the GII Swaps S. at Betfair Hollywood Park Wednesday. The chestnut colt broke sharply and took charge into the first turn. Under Joe Talamo, the 7-2 shot was relaxed through measured fractions of :24.15 and :48.18. He scampered clear on the turn through three-quarters in 1:12.88 with **Nonios** (Pleasantly Perfect) his closest pursuer. After opening a three-length advantage in upper stretch, Blueskiesnrainbows looked home free, but Nonios and the late-charging **Liaison** (Indian Charlie) made a good run at him in the final strides, only to come up short of the determined winner. "It took him a while to get back in the swing of things and now he's finally getting back into his groove," trainer Bob Baffert, winning a record fifth Swaps, said of the victor. **Cont. p3**

Baffert will also saddle **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid), back-to-back winner of the GI Pacific Classic in 2009 and 2010.

**All Blueskiesnrainbows in the Swaps (cont. from p1)**

Blueskiesnrainbows, who debuted over the lawn at Santa Anita last October, graduated for \$30,000 over Hollywood's Cushion track in December. He romped by 7 1/4 lengths in a Jan. 20 starter allowance to begin 2012 and entered the Santa Anita Derby off a third-place finish in a Feb. 9 optional claimer. Connections opted to try their charge on the turf again, but came away with a lackluster ninth-place effort in the May 4 GII American Turf S. "The owners wanted to take a chance in the turf race at Churchill Downs, so we gave it a roll," explained trainer Bob Baffert. "It didn't work out. He didn't ship well and got really hot. I'm not ruling out turf for this horse yet because it didn't count that day."

Blueskiesnrainbows, who was a \$33,000 Keeneland September Yearling, is owned by Kelly and Dana Mitchell's Bad Boy Racing and the Whizway Farm of Texas anesthesiologist Stan Whisenant.

Clear Attempt, who broke his maiden over the Belmont lawn last June, was making his third start of the year off a pair of runner-up efforts in allowance company, first at Gulfstream Jan. 22 and last time when just nosed out over nine furlongs of this course May 18. The well-bred colt, making his stakes debut, raced in hand while closest to the sensible pace of Yield Bogey. The pacesetter, who saw a clear lead evaporate quickly after an opening quarter in :24.78, reasserted some measure of control through a half in :48.12, but couldn't hold off the upper-stretch challenge of Clear Attempt. Clear Attempt had plenty in reserve to draw clear as favored Compliance Officer got up for second. "My horse broke very good," commented winning jockey Jose Lezcano. "He was very comfortable, he didn't pull me. When the favorite moved outside, I moved with him and I kept waiting until the quarter-pole to really ask him. When I asked him, he gave me a good kick and finished good." Leanna Willaford, assistant to trainer Bill Mott, added, "This race wasn't setting up to be terribly, terribly tough, and cutting him back a little bit seemed like the thing to do." Of Clear Attempt's late entry into stakes company, Willaford explained, "Bill just takes his time. He's marinating them. We've always liked this horse. He's been one we aspired to win a stakes with."

Get Serious had not visited the winner's circle since taking this race back in 2010. The hard-knocking millionaire, who also won the Red Bank in 2009, was off the board in four starts last term and began 2012 with a close-up sixth-place finish in the May 19 Elkwood S. May 19. He was coming off a third-place effort in the June 10 GII Monmouth S. Hustled out of the gate to take the early lead, Get Serious was in hand through an opening quarter in :23.23. Headed by El Commodore down the backstretch, he shrugged off that rival to reassert control after a half in :46.76. Asked for more turning for home, he opened up briefly in upper stretch before a pesky El Commodore resumed his challenge, but the determined chestnut found more late and was safely in front at the wire. "We thought he was going to be back to himself this year and he's proved it," said winning trainer John Forbes. "We were concerned when he was getting pushed a little for most of the way, but he's as game as they get. As he's gotten older, he's learned to relax more when there's a horse on his flank. We've had him for his whole career and we've had a terrific time with him. We're very proud of him. I hope that he'll be back in other stakes here this year."

## BHA & BETFAIR AGREE ON FUNDING DEAL

Betting exchange Betfair has come to a five-year commercial arrangement with the British Horseracing Authority, which will be worth a guaranteed minimum of £40 million to British racing. The deal, achieved in conjunction with Britain's Horsemen's Group and Racecourse Association, will see Betfair pay 10.75% of all horseracing revenues from their British users. For its part, the BHA commits to setting a minimum level of annual fixtures in order to optimise betting opportunities. The announcement was made to London's stock exchange and coincided with the BHA's decision to withdraw from a high court judicial review that betting exchange customers should not pay a levy on betting activities.

"We are delighted that we have been able to reach an agreement with Betfair, one which represents a landmark for both the racing and betting industries," said BHA Chief Executive Paul Bittar. "It brings many benefits, including substantial and increased guaranteed funding, as well as importantly providing certainty for the sport in relation to Betfair's contribution. We hope that similar arrangements with other betting operators will follow. This agreement has required a high degree of co-operation both within racing, with all the major organizations closely involved in negotiations, and of course with Betfair, who have shown great commitment in their intent to be a constructive commercial partner with our sport. In particular, I would like to recognize the BHA chairman [Paul Roy] and the board for their vision and unwavering commitment in pursuing improved and more stable financial outcomes for the sport, as without it the deal would not have been possible."

Betfair's Martin Cruddace added, "This deal is a genuinely historic moment. For the first time, British Racing and Betfair have proved it is possible for us to work together on a truly commercial basis."

## HELMET RETIRED TO DARLEY AUSTRALIA

Sheikh Mohammed's homebred multiple Group 1 winner **Helmet (Aus)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}--Accessories {GB}, by Singspiel {Ire}) has been retired and will take up stud duties at Darley in Australia in the upcoming breeding season. As a 2-year-old, the speedy chestnut won the G1 A.J.C. Champagne S. and G1 A.J.C. Sires Produce S. He returned as a sophomore to earn a record-breaking win in the G1 Caulfield Guineas. Oliver Tait, Darley's Chief Operating Officer said, "Helmet was among the very best colts in an elite generation. Few horses can win three Group 1s across two consecutive seasons and Helmet did it the hard way, out in front. He was a remarkable talent, rated superior to his sire Exceed And Excel who is such a successful and popular horse on our roster." Helmet will stand at Darley's Northwood Park for A\$33,000.

Gestut Etzean's **Monami (Ger)** (Sholokhov {Ire}) bids to make the right headlines in today's G3 Hamburger Stuten-Preis after getting disqualified in a winning effort in the G2 Diana-Trial due to a technicality.

Supplemented for that May 27 Hoppegarten Classic prep after the official date due to wrong data being published on the German Jockey Club's website, last year's G3 Preis der Winterkonigin heroine was nevertheless clearly the best in that race and holds the aces on that form. From Britain is Kirsten Rausing's **Albamara (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who was a latest third in Newbury's Listed Lord Weinstock Memorial S. over 10 furlongs June 14. Her dam Albanova (GB) (Alzao) registered a Group 1 win in Cologne's G1 Preis von Europa in 2004 with Saldentigerin (Ger) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) back in second. ## KING'S THEATRE STORE TOPS ARQANA

**SUMMER** Arqana marked the permanent move of its Summer Sale--from Saint-Cloud to Deauville's newly refurbished Elie de Brignac complex--with a six-figure transaction when Haras du Mesnil's King's Theatre (Ire) colt was knocked down to Highflyer Bloodstock for €100,000 during yesterday's first session. The jumps bred 2-year-old store was sold as hip [96](#). Highflyer's name was to the fore earlier when €75,000, the day's third-highest price, secured a non-Thoroughbred gelding presented by Haras de Saint Voir.

Second place on the day's sheets was achieved by Hawthorn Villa Stud's hip [45](#), an Acclamation (GB) filly, who went the way of Broadhurst Agency for €82,000. The bay 2-year-old is a half to the 2009 Listed Lady Wulfruna S. victor Ceremonial Jade (UAE) (Jade Robbery) and is closely related to the 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up Firth of Lorne (Ire) (Danehill), herself the dam of this term's G3 UAE Oaks heroine Falls of Lora (Ire) (Street Cry {Ire}).

Hawthorn Villa Stud enjoyed further success with another breezer one hour later when Chris Richner went on the €72,000 docket for an Excellent Art (GB) colt. The 2-year-old bay, offered as hip [68](#), is out of a daughter of the 1994 G1 Yorkshire Oaks and G1 Prix Vermeille third State Crystal (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}), and is from the family of the G1 Fillies' Mile victress and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas runner-up Crystal Music (Nureyev). He is bound for the Czech Republic where he will go into training with Helena Blazkova.

An expanded first-day book ensured last year's gross was comfortably outstripped, but an inferior clearance rate induced a contraction in the average and median markers. They were down almost 14% and 19%, respectively. "Overall, and using comparable parameters, the first day of the sale has achieved a 9% increase in turnover," explained Arqana President Eric Hoyer. "For the flat bred 2-year-olds, it is a second sale which plays the role of second chance or catch up sale. The percentage of horses sold under the hammer of [just over] 70% is satisfactory, as is the [flat] median price which showed an increase. Regarding the store horses, the figures are similar to last year. They lack consistency, but in spite of this, they show a real demand for the horses with the more attractive profiles."
