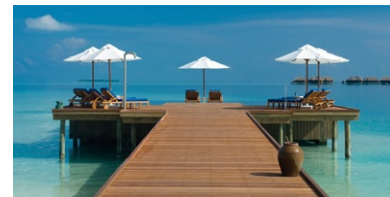

**SO YOU THINK RETIRED**

A 10-time Group 1-winner, dual hemisphere star **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}--Triassic {NZ}, by Tights) was retired yesterday after pulling muscles in his hind quarters ahead of his planned last outing in Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse. A champion 3-year-old and miler in Australia and highweighted older horse in Ireland last term, the dark bay will enter quarantine on Saturday as originally planned and will stand at Coolmore Australia at a fee of A\$66,000. "It's a big disappointment that he'll miss the Eclipse, but he's had a wonderful racing career and now it's time for him to shine at stud," the operation's Tom

Magnier said. "His book reads like a who's who of all the best mares and breeders, so he'll get the best possible start."

In line for a bid to record a repeat success in the Sandown highlight before the injury, the 6-year-old made his mark on the international scene with five wins apiece at the top level in Australia and Europe and had annexed the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot on his last start June 20. Purchased for \$NZ110,000 at the 2008 New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale, So You Think raced in the colors of Malaysian billionaire Dato Tan Chin Nam and Tunku Ahmad Yahaya and was initially trained by Bart Cummings. He became only the third 3-year-old since 1995 to win the G1 Cox Plate on only his fifth career start and also took the following year's edition of Moonee Valley's feature after also annexing the G1 Underwood S. and G1 Yalumba S. at Caulfield. Further glory at the highest level followed in the G1 Mackinnon S. at Flemington just a week after his second Cox Plate and that was followed by a third placing in the G1 Melbourne Cup. That proved to be his finale in Australia when it was announced that Coolmore had purchased a majority interest and he was transferred to Ballydoyle. He began his stint in Ireland by registering easy wins in the G3 Mooresbridge S. and G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh last May before his well-documented defeat by Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) in last year's G1 Prince of Wales's S. **Cont. p3**

**NATHANIEL ON FENCE FOR ECLIPSE**

The withdrawal of So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) means that 10 will go to post for the first major clash of the generations in Britain in Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse, although connections of last year's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. hero **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) could skip the race. Lady Rothschild's 4-year-old has yet to be seen this season and trainer John Gosden is biding his time. "Normally there are three weeks between the Eclipse and the King George, but this year there is only two and that is the big factor playing on my mind," he said. "If you have a hard race in the Eclipse on your first run of the year, it's a little tough to come back for the King George, so at this stage, I'd be mindful of that fact. We might decide not to run and have a racecourse gallop instead and go straight to the King George July 21."

Rebounding from his 2011 Prince of Wales's dip in fortunes to deny Workforce (GB) (King's Best) in the Eclipse and Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown, he then suffered four reversals in succession when fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, runner-up in the G1 Champion S. at Ascot, sixth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic and fourth in the Dubai World Cup. He had regained the winning thread in impressive style in the latest renewal of the Tattersalls Gold Cup before his return to Royal Ascot to settle scores. He retires as the winner of

14 of 23 starts and just over £5 million in prize money.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "So You Think is an extraordinary horse and it was a real privilege to have had him here at Ballydoyle on loan from Australia."

Salomina entered this late trial for the Aug. 5 G1 Preis der Diana unbeaten, and jumped to the head of ante-post betting markets for that Classic after escaping with a narrow victory to keep her perfect record intact. Opening up with a four-length score going just over nine furlongs at Cologne May 2, she increased her winning margin to 4 1/2 lengths in an 11-furlong Dusseldorf conditions heat last time June 3, and prevailed for a career high on pattern-race debut here. Salomina raced with the handbrake on in a close seventh for most of this trip. Let loose off the home turn, she stayed on strongly under a final-quarter drive to inhale Caitania in the shades of the post. "The pace was rather slow so the race turned into a sprint in the straight," explained winning rider Andrasch Starke. "Salomina was really great. She is a lovely and substantial filly, and has been my [German] Oaks filly since her Cologne [debut] victory. I am really looking forward to Dusseldorf next month."

### Trinniberg Spot Still Undecided...

Shivananda Parbhoo confirmed yesterday that his MGSW sophomore sprinter **Trinniberg** (Teuflesberg) would run Saturday at Calder, but said he had not yet determined whether it would be in the GII Smile Sprint H. against older foes or the GIII Carry Back S., which is restricted to 3-year-olds. "If the question is 'Will he run?', then the answer is 'Yes,'" Parbhoo said. "Which race will he run in? That's still up in the air." He added, "Right now, I would say we're leaning towards the Smile, but anything can change. We have until Saturday morning to decide, and we probably won't make a decision until then. The main goal is getting him to the Saratoga race (GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 25) in the best shape we can."

### HENNY HUGHES TO RANGEVIEW

**Henny Hughes** (Hennessy--Meadow Flyer, by Meadowlake), who previously stood at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Kentucky and Kelvinside in Australia, has been purchased by Robert and Jody Gray's Rangeview Stud in Western Australia. He will stand this breeding season there for \$A7,700. The 2006 GI King's Bishop S. and GI Vosburgh S. winner, who entered stud in 2007, is responsible for last year's GIII Sapling S. winner She Digs Me and G3 Falcon S. winner Henny Hound in Japan. "Rob and Jody are delighted to have been able to secure such a well credentialed stallion for their stud and this story is another one of those life stories that you just don't see coming!," said a release on Rangeview's website. "As part of that, we can say that negotiations always have their ebbs and flows before the ink truly dries on the paper, and this has been no different for them. But what really excites all who know quality and potential, is that Henny Hughes is actually already doing a great job at stud, getting winners all over the world and he's only nine years old! His reputation as a super type precedes him, and as said, he has already shown that he is passing that quality and presence on."

**DEL MAR ALSO SETS 2YO FIELD SIZE LIMIT**

The *North County Times* reports that the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club and the Thoroughbred Owners of California reached an agreement Wednesday to limit the field size for 2-year-old races at Del Mar to 10 runners, excluding stakes events. The New York Racing Association made a similar announcement one day earlier, but TOC President Lou Raffeto Jr. told the *Times* that plans for Del Mar had been in the works before NYRA's announcement. 

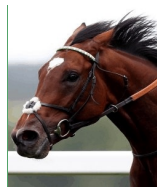

## AGA KHAN DRAFT TOPS AT ARQANA SUMMER

The second and final session of Arqana's Summer Sale brought The Aga Khan's Studs' draft to the fore and, by the close of trade at the Deauville venue Thursday, two such offerings were among a batch of five to break through the six-figure barrier. Leading the way was **Khalidabad (Fr)** (Nayef), Hip [187](#), initially led out unsold at €150,000, but who later fetched €175,000 in a private deal with local agent Abeth Mussat. The homebred bay is out of an unraced half-sister to the 2002 G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Khalkevi (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), and added value to his page with a Longchamp conditions score for Mikel Delzangles last month. Alain de Royer-Dupre trainee **Diakali (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}), Hip [281](#), joined him on the podium after fetching a €160,000 winning bid from Irish conditioner Willie Mullins. The once-placed grey, who is from the family of MG1SP Diamond Green (Fr) (Green Desert), is now bound for a career over obstacles. Bronze medal position on the day was earned by this semester's Listed Prix Sigy and Listed Prix du Pont-Neuf placegetter **Carnoustie (Fr)** (Acclamation {GB}), who was knocked down to Guillaume Gorse for €150,000. Tomas Schweizer's homebred 3-year-old, offered out of Nicolas Clement's stable as wildcard entry Hip [270](#), hails from the family of the 2009 G1 Preis von Europa and last term's G1 Irish St Leger hero Jukebox Jury (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}). She will remain in the care of Clement.

Despite the headline lots and a vastly improved clearance rate, parity with 2011's returns was not achieved although an enlarged book ensured the sale aggregate, including private sales, just shaded last season's yield by 2%.

"In terms of organization, the outcome is very positive," commented Arqana President Eric Hoyeau. "The breezes went very smoothly and attracted many potential buyers, who all seemed particularly delighted to be back in Deauville. The sales ring, equipped with new screens showing the breezes and key reference races, was a real plus and was appreciated by everyone. Overall, results are similar to last year, with a slight increase in turnover and the percentage of horses sold. This sale thus ensures the continued rotation of horses in training between racing establishments. Added to this, six horses sold for more than €100,000, a number almost identical to 2011."
