



## GAME TIME, DUDE

Red-hot Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert sends the top two contenders in the G1 Hollywood Gold Cup, headed by Diamond Pride LLC, Lanni Family Trust, Mercedes Stable LLC and Bernie Schiappa's **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again). Beaten a nostril by First Dude (Stephen Got Even) in this race last year, the 2011 G1 Breeders' Cup Classic runner-up made up for a disappointing 12th in the G1 Dubai World Cup with a tour-de-force over **Kettle Corn** (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GII Californian S.

June 2, good for a gaudy 115 Beyer ([video](#)). "You never know how they'll react to a big performance, but he looks great," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. Baffert will also be represented by 7-year-old **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) in this Breeders' Cup Classic 'Win and You're In' event. A three-time Grade I winner on these shores before heading to Dubai for two winless seasons, the dark bay returned to Southern California in style with a 7 1/4-length tally in Betfair Hollywood's \$71,000 Prove It S. June 8. "He loves synthetics," Baffert continued to *DRF*. "He's going to move forward off that. He loves this track and he'll be tough. Him and Game On Dude are good horses." **Cont. p4**

## DEFENDING HIS 'HONOR'

Live Oak Plantation's **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini), hero of the last November's G1 Cigar Mile H. at the Big A Nov. 26, seeks to make amends for a disappointing third-place finish as the 8-5 favorite in the prestigious G1 Metropolitan H. May 28 ([video](#)) in today's loaded GII Suburban H. at Belmont Park. Racing in tight quarters for most of the way after drawing the dreaded one hole, the GIII Westchester S. winner failed to fire once clear in the stretch, and reported home third, three lengths

behind Shackelford (Forestry) and Caleb's Posse (Posse). To Honor and Serve has enjoyed his share of success at today's nine-furlong distance, though, annexing the GII Remsen S. at two and GII Pennsylvania Derby last September. "He's extremely good at a mile, but he's classy enough to get 1 1/8 miles," Hall of Famer Bill Mott commented. "In the Met Mile, I think he was extremely compromised by his post position and--not to take anything away from the first two finishers--didn't have the smoothest of trips." **Cont. p4**

## HOW FARHH CAN HE GO?

In the absence of So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}), today's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown has a wide-open feel to it and could provide the perfect opportunity for **Farhh (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) to launch himself in the big time. Prior to his latest third in the G1 Prince of Wales's S., Godolphin's 4-year-old had raced only twice since his debut in July 2010 and his eye-catching effort in that June 20 Royal Ascot feature suggests he is fast becoming a major force. Godolphin, who have won this four times and enjoyed a one-two-three in 1998, have a potent second string to their bow in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup hero **Monterosso (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and Racing Manager Simon Crisford is hoping for a bold showing from the representatives here. "Farhh is a very interesting horse, but he lacks a bit of match-practice," he commented. "He looked unlucky at Royal Ascot, as he missed the break and met trouble in running, but may have been a bit flattered and I can't help but feel that he was passing tired horses. Whether he can reproduce that running and be as good as he looked is a question, but health-wise he is where we want him. Saeed has been very happy with him in the build-up to the race, so we're expecting a good run and hope he can give a good account of himself." **Cont. p3**

Crisford continued, "Monterosso is going to be a bit rusty going into this race and we've got an eye on the second half of the season, but he's ready to run and he's been going very well. If he can translate his Dubai form to a different track and surface then he's got a fantastic chance. It is worth remembering that he won the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot as a three-year-old, so we know turf suits him and he stays well. He's had a good break since Dubai, is not short on experience and he's going to run a really solid race and be there or thereabouts, before building on that for the rest of the year."



Italian racing was boosted by the exploits of Falbrav (Ire), who started his winning spree in Britain in this race nine years ago and **Crackerjack King (Ire)** (Shamardal) makes his British debut after establishing himself as his country's leading middle-distance performer. Last year's G2 Derby Italiano hero has suffered only one defeat in his career so far and that came in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club. In his native land, Scuderia Effevis colt--who is now part-owned by Australian Thoroughbred Bloodstock--enjoyed a considerable reputation and signed off there with an authoritative win in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica over this trip at the Capannelle May 13. Marco Botti has charge of him now and he is happy with the way he has shaped in the short time he has been in Britain. "We think we have got him in very good form, but we do need to get to know him a bit better," he said. "He has shown he has a lot of class--in Italy he is unbeaten and his only bad run was in France for a couple of reasons. It's always difficult to compare the Italian form with English, but I was impressed with the manner in which he won last time. He traveled really well and picked up and won in good style and Italian horses in the past like Electrocutationist, Ramonti, Falbrav and Rakti have all done well here, so I'm hoping he will do exactly the same. A stiff mile and a quarter will suit him and I'd like to see decent ground."

Five 3-year-olds have bettered their elders since 1999 and Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's **Bonfire (Ger)** (Manduro {Ger}) warrants respect on his success in the G2 Dante S. at York May 17.

Only sixth in the G1 Epsom Derby June 2, he bids to emulate the fellow Dante winner Environment Friend (GB) and also Oratorio (Ire), who rebounded from unplaced efforts in that Classic to win this in 1991 and 2005. "He just didn't fancy the track at Epsom and didn't handle it at all," jockey Jimmy Fortune said. "I knew from a long way out he wasn't going to run his race. If they don't handle Epsom, they normally have a harder race if they did handle it. It took a hell of a lot out of him and he lost a lot of weight. He seems to be back in good form now and we are looking forward to the Eclipse."

Khalid Abdullah has a duo in the race in the 2010 hero **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) and **Cityscape (GB)** (Selkirk), who tries this trip for the first time. While Twice Over has looked to backtrack following his fourth Group 1 win in the Juddmonte International in August, Cityscape made a leap forward when registering a 4 1/4-length success in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Duty Free at Meydan. He missed the break and then suffered traffic issues as a result when down the field in the May 6 G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin and any rain will be in his favor. "He produced a stunning performance at Meydan and found a turbo-booster that produced a course record and had them off the bridle before destroying them," trainer Roger Charlton said."

#### HOMETOWN HERO HEADLINES SUMMIT

Reigning champion female sprinter **Musical Romance** (Concorde's Tune), second, beaten only a neck by Sassy Image (Broken Vow) in the 2011 GI Princess Rooney H., has been tabbed as the 5-2 morning-line favorite in this year's renewal.

The Pinnacle Racing Stable & Bill Kaplan colorbearer has faced the starter four times since posting a 20-1 upset in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint, kicking off the campaign with a fourth-place finish in the Sunshine Millions Filly & Mare Sprint at Gulfstream Jan. 28. She quickly got back on track with a win

in the GI Inside Information S. Mar. 17, then was a disappointing fourth as the 9-5 favorite in Keeneland's GI Vinery Madison S. Apr. 12. A well-beaten second to the in-form Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) in the GI Humana Distaff S. May 5 ([video](#)), Musical Romance fired a bullet four-furlong warning shot for this in :46 1/5 at Calder June 29. "She's coming into the race as good as I could possibly hope for," Kaplan told *Daily Racing Form*. "The last breeze was a little faster than I wanted, but it didn't take anything out of her. She did it all on her own. I'm very confident but you know anything can happen, just like it did when she hit the gate at the start of the Sunshine Millions and injured herself." Gem Inc's **Nicole H** (Mr. Greeley), previously campaigned in New York by Mike Hushion, makes her first start for David Fawkes. The hard-knocking dark bay has finished first or second in four out of six trips to the post this term, including a close second in Belmont's GI Vagrancy H. most recently June 2.

### TRINNIBERG CROSS-ENTERED

It will be a game-time decision whether sophomore **Trinniberg** (Teuflesberg) lines up against older horses in the Breeders' Cup 'Win And Your'e In' GII Smile Sprint H. or stays in his own division for the GIII Carry Back S. Brilliant in front-running victories in the GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Mar. 10 and the GIII Bay Shore S. at the Big A Apr. 7, the \$21,000 OBSAPR graduate quickly erased the memory of an ill-advised attempt at the GI Kentucky Derby with a career-best performance in the GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont June 9 ([video](#)), good for a 106 Beyer. **Gantry** (Pulpit), a three-time stakes winner at the Fair Grounds meeting, had a four-race winning streak snapped when third behind Shackleford (Forestry) and Amazombie (Northern Afleet) in the GII Churchill Downs S. May 5. The Brittlyn Stables colorbearer worked a bullet four-furlongs in :47 3/5 at Calder July 1. "To be honest, I wouldn't have any problem at all with him being in the race," trainer Ron Faucheux said of Trinniberg. "Provided there is another horse in there that will go with him." ## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### CARRIED INTEREST LIKELY STAKES BOUND

Klaravich Stables and William H. Lawrence's **Carried Interest** (Henny Hughes) has likely booked his ticket for a Saratoga stakes race after his half-length debut victory at Belmont Park Thursday ([video](#)). Both the Aug. 12 GII Saratoga Special and Sept. 3 GII Three Chimneys Hopeful S. are under consideration, according to trainer Rick Violette. "We'll see how he comes out of this race and follow his lead," said Violette.

Pressed on the early lead, Carried Interest held off **Palace Malice** (Curlin) by a half-length while completing the five furlongs in :56.62. "He was a very fast colt, very smart," said Violette. "We knew he'd be quick, but we think he can stretch out a little bit. I don't think he'll be a stone-cold sprinter. He has a good mind and has been a pro throughout. [Palace Malice] is a nice horse, also. He came to us twice, and we said 'no.' Hopefully we're not just the head of the class and his talent will carry him forward to next year as well."

Trainer Todd Pletcher was also pleased with the effort of Palace Malice. "We just ran into a quicker horse," said Pletcher, who trains the colt for Dogwood Stable. "We think our horse will improve when he stretches out, and we hope that will be the case. He got behind horses, and had to make some room for himself at the top of the stretch. We were very encouraged."

**JOCKEY HERRERA KILLED AT PLEASANTON**

Jockey Jorge Herrera was killed in a race at the Alameda County Fair Thursday evening when his horse clipped heels and he was thrown to the track. Herrera was said to have suffered traumatic head injuries when he was stepped on, either by his own mount, Morita (Illinois Storm), or a trailing horse in Pleasanton's eighth race, a \$5,000 maiden claiming event. Paramedics treated him at the scene before transporting him to Eden Medical Center in Pleasanton, where he was pronounced dead. Herrera was 33 years old and was a native of Jalisco, Mexico. He had won 55 Thoroughbred races in his career, which began in 2004, and rode mostly in California, Oregon and Washington. He also rode other breeds and worked as an exercise rider. A statement from the Fair said, "We are deeply saddened by this loss, and our thoughts and prayers are with his family." Herrera is the first rider to be fatally injured at Pleasanton since Juan Gonzalez in 1975. The Juan Gonzalez Memorial S. will be run there today.

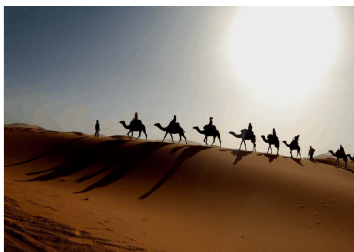

## HKJC Announces Purse Increases, New Jockey Rules:

### *Edited Press Release*

The Hong Kong Jockey Club has announced that the upcoming 2012-13 season will see a total prize money increase of HK\$40.29 million, with significant increases in the standard prize money for Class 1 to Class 5 races. The increase follows a similar injection of funds for the 2011-12 campaign, when prize money rose by HK\$40 million on the previous season, and affirms the Club's proactive strategy in combating the negative effects of market forces.

Speaking at a press briefing Friday, the Club's Executive Director of Racing William A. Nader highlighted the Club's ongoing commitment to maintaining attractive prize money levels in Hong Kong as a means of ensuring that it continues to offer a high-quality product.

"The Club has noted that Hong Kong owners are finding it increasingly difficult to secure the right quality horses at reasonable prices due to the twin issue of a continuing upward trend in the cost of good class horses globally and a weakening Hong Kong Dollar," said Nader. "Since the 2006-07 season, when we began to experience an upswing in turnover, the Club has ensured that prize money levels have kept pace with the needs and demands of the industry. Today, with this latest purse increase, we can see percentage gains in relation to that starting point of between 20% and 40% across Class 1 to 5 races. These increases for the 2012-13 season mark the second successive year that we have raised the season's prize money pool by approximately HK\$40 million."

The increases augment last week's announcement that December's Longines Hong Kong International races have received a notable prize money boost, with all four Group 1 contests now worth a combined total of HK\$72 million.

The Club also revealed yesterday that the Hong Kong International Sale Bonus will double in value to HK\$2 million. Furthermore, the 2013 running of the Hong Kong Macau Trophy will be a HK\$2 million race (from HK\$2.4 million), but will benefit from a new initiative that offers a HK\$500,000 bonus to any horse that can win both "interport races" (the reciprocal contest being the Macau Hong Kong Trophy).

In a move that will further enhance the already competitive nature of Hong Kong racing, the Club has announced changes to the distribution of race rides ahead of the 2012-13 season. A 50% ceiling will come into effect with respect to the number of race rides a trainer is allowed to offer any individual Club Jockey or Freelance Jockey during the entirety of a racing season.

The Club has also revised downwards, from 50% to 40%, the maximum percentage of race rides that a Club Jockey can take for an individual trainer during the course of a season. Allied to this is the introduction of a 60% ceiling for the quantity of race rides that a Freelance Jockey can take for an individual trainer during an entire season. In line with these changes, the Club has also decided to implement an upper limit of 250 Hong Kong race wins as the point at which a Freelance Jockey is no longer eligible to receive a weight allowance.

All changes take effect from the opening race meeting of the 2012-13 season Sept. 8.
