**BODEMEISTER TO MISS HASKELL**

GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. runner-up **Bodemeister** (Empire Maker) will miss an intended start in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth July 29 after spiking a fever Saturday.

Ahmed Zayat's Zayat Stables, which owns the GI Arkansas Derby winner, will instead point the Bob Baffert-trained colt to either the 1 1/4-mile GI Travers S. or seven-furlong GI King's Bishop S., both at Saratoga Aug. 25.

"My dad visited in California, and we weren't happy with his coat," Zayat's racing and stallion manager

Justin Zayat said of Bodemeister. "We treated him with some penicillin [for a high temperature] and he will be back on track in a couple days. It's just unfortunate timing for us. We will point for the Travers or King's Bishop."

The operation could have a more-than-capable deputy in the Haskell in the form of GI Belmont S. second **Paynter** (Awesome Again). "Paynter is a probable for the Haskell and is training super," said Zayat.

Second in the GIII Derby Trial S. at Churchill Apr. 28 before romping by 5 3/4 lengths in a Pimlico allowance on the Preakness undercard May 19, Paynter hasn't raced since just failing to stave off Union Rags (Dixie Union) in the Belmont June 9. He's posted a pair of bullets since for Baffert, nailing five furlongs in :58 3/5 (1/19) at Santa Anita July 4 and six panels in 1:12 3/5 (1/7) July 11. Baffert has dominated the Haskell in recent years. Since 2001, he's captured five of the last 11 renewals of the race, including the last two runnings with Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) in 2010 and Coil (Point Given) last year. He also won with Point Given (Thunder Gulch) ('01), War Emblem (Our Emblem) ('02) and Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus) ('05).

**DHAAMER DOMINANT IN SUNSET**

Edward Brown Jr. and Jay Manoogian's **Dhaamer (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) made it two in a row over the Betfair Hollywood Park turf with a dominant victory in Sunday's GIII Sunset H. Sent off the 2-5 favorite, the chestnut gelding settled at the back of a compact field of four as **Quaintly** (Giant's Causeway) set a measured pace up front. Tipped out three wide turning for home, Dhaamer inhaled the pacesetter and powered clear down the lane to win by 3 1/4 lengths.

"He's a nice horse and won easily today," jockey Julien Lejaroux, who was celebrating his 29th birthday Sunday, commented. "In a four-horse field, everything went pretty much as planned. We knew there was not going to be pace. We thought before the race [Juniper Pass (Lemon Drop Kid)] was the one to beat. I just followed that one and when I asked him, he came very nice for me. He was just much the best today."

As for what is next for Dhaamer, trainer Mike Mitchell said, "He might have one start at Del Mar, we'll just have to figure out which one. That's kind of in our focus, but we want to have a GII Breeders' Cup Marathon horse on the dirt. He just barely got beat in the [GIII] Tokyo City [over the main track at Santa Anita]."

Mitchell, who continues to recover from brain surgery, had plenty of praise for his rider and future son-in-law. "Julien has such a great set of hands. Way before he met my daughter, I was riding him on horses. I've always thought he was a great rider." **cont. p3**

Dhaamer, who raced in Europe for his breeder Shadwell Estate, was purchased by trainer Mike Mitchell's son-in law, bloodstock agent Craig "Boomer" Rounsefell, for 30,000gns out of last year's Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale. He began his stateside campaign with a runner-up effort in the Mar. 24 Gill Tokyo City S. over the main track at Santa Anita before running an even fourth in the Apr. 22 Gill San Juan Capistrano H. He bounded home a four-length winner of the May 13 Round Table S. over the Sunset's course and trip last time.

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### Sequence Could Be Leger-bound

Trainer David Lanigan yesterday suggested that **Main Sequence** (Aldebaran) could attempt Classic success in the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 15. Deemed unlucky to be only fourth in Saturday's G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp, the Niarchos Family's 3-year-old who was second in the G1 Epsom Derby could face a rematch with Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the extended 14-furlong Classic. "He's come out of the race fine and is on his way back home," Lanigan told *PA Sport*. "They probably didn't go a great enough pace early on, which can generate its own problems at that stage of the race. The important thing is that he has improved since the Derby and was unlucky in his run yesterday, but mentally he's grown up an awful lot since Epsom. We still know we've got a nice horse for the future. He's got one or two options. It'll just take a day or two to digest things and I'll talk to the owners. The only positive thing we learnt after last night was that he will stay the mile and six of the St Leger. The trip wouldn't be a problem to him. It gives us a lot more options. Anything from a mile and a half, I'd be reluctant to bring him back to a mile and a quarter."

### Mayson Pointed to Abbaye

Saturday's surprise G1 July Cup hero **Mayson (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) is being targeted at the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, trainer Richard Fahey announced yesterday. David Arsmtrong's homebred 4-year-old scored by five lengths in Newmarket's six-furlong highlight and will revert to five furlongs for the sprint on Arc day Oct. 7. "We'll definitely go to Longchamp at the end of the season," Fahey said. "That's where we want to go and whether he'll run in one or two races beforehand, we'll see."

### Improved Is Deauville-bound

Iraj Parvizi's **Most Improved (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) is set to run in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville, trainer Brian Meehan stated yesterday. Following his success in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 19, last season's G1 Dewhurst S. third will be spared a race against Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood at the start of next month and will instead head to France for the Aug. 12 contest. "The Deauville race fits perfectly for him," Meehan said on his website. "We look forward to testing Most Improved against his elders and the top European fillies."

### Soumillon Booked for Orfevre

Christophe Soumillon will ride Japan's Horse of the Year **Orfevre (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) during his European campaign, it was announced yesterday. Owner Shunsuke Yoshida has opted to choose a European jockey for the five-times Group 1 winner, leaving regular rider Kenichi Ikezoe on the sidelines as he is prepared for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7. According to the *Racing Post*, trainer Yatsutoshi Ikee made the following announcement, "We had been worried about various objections from various people, but changing jockey is the result of much discussion. I am sure it will be the best for Orfevre. I want to go to the Arc to be a winner."

# NEWS TODAY

## YEAR OF THE DRAGON

For the second consecutive year, **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) earned the title of Hong Kong Horse of the Year for the 2011/2012 racing season at the Hong Kong Jockey Club awards ceremony held during the final race meeting of the season at Sha Tin racecourse Sunday. The 5-year-old also defended his crown as Champion Middle-distance Horse in addition to earning the title as champion miler. Among his biggest wins this season, the Tony Millard-trained horse won this term's first and second legs of the Triple Crown series--the HK-G1 Stewards' Cup (1600M) and the HK-G1 Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000M).

International hero **Little Bridge (NZ)** (Faltaat), victorious in last month's G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot, was voted Most Popular Horse of the Year by members of the public. In addition, the five-year-old gelding--who is trained by Danny Shum--claimed the title of champion sprinter. The champion stayer pedant went to the David Ferraris-trained **Liberator (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}), who defeated Ambitious Dragon in the Standard Chartered Champions and Chater Cup (2400M), the final leg of the Triple Crown. The unbeaten **Amber Sky (Aus)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) from the Ricky Yiu string was chosen as Champion Griffin. The 2-year-old won all three starts on the Sha Tin straight course. The John Size-trained **Glorious Days (Aus)** (Hussonet), another rising 4-year-old star, became the Most Improved Horse with the greatest rating increase of 57 points in the season. The gelded son of Hussonet snatched four wins and three seconds in his seven starts in his first racing season in Hong Kong.

## INDUSTRY INFO

### Conference on Jockeys' Safety at Monmouth:

Monmouth Park will host an international conference on the welfare, health and safety of jockeys at Monmouth Park Sept. 15 and 16. The conference, organized by the European Racing Medical Officers Group and administered under the auspices of the International Federation of Horse Racing Authorities, will showcase the latest developments in medical and technological research.

"The impetus for this is that jockeys keep getting bigger and bigger and they often undertake well-documented and drastic measures to reduce," said Denis Egan, head of the Irish Turf Club. "The result is that these measures result in serious health issues for them later in life and we are trying to improve their lives. There are all kinds of conferences about the welfare of the horse that are held around the world, but this is the only one that is for the riders."

Egan said that the agenda for the conference, the fourth of its kind and first in America, includes research on nutrition, concussions, trauma protocol, race day falls, and safety equipment, plus updates from each of the countries represented on special issues relative to the individual jurisdiction.

"I think this is great and it is incredibly important that the riders and other professionals in the sport keep abreast of all of the latest information available on all of these subjects," said Terry Meyocks, the national manager of the Jockeys' Guild. "Joe Johnston [the regional manager representing the riders in Monmouth's jockey colony] went to the conference in Dubai and he thought it was outstanding. The information that will be presented, especially on getting safer equipment, whether that be helmets, vests or any of the rest, is vital, not only for jockeys, but for exercise riders as well."

The Saturday morning session is restricted to jockeys, but other sessions are open to all licensed professionals in the sport and there is no registration fee.
