Teruya Yoshida's decision to purchase a 50% interest in **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) yielded an instant dividend in last term's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe

and, despite reverses in the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, the Longchamp heroine bounced back to win a thrilling renewal of yesterday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot. Settled in mid-division until edging into contention under Andrasch Starke on the home turn, the 9-1 chance was sent in pursuit of defending champion **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) inside the final quarter mile and kept on relentlessly to nail that rival by a nose on the line to become Germany's first winner of Britain's

midsummer championship. **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) ran on strongly from the rear to claim third for a second straight year, 1 1/2 lengths further back. "It is a great feeling, it is very important for Germany and great for German racing," enthused trainer Peter Schiergen. "If she's well and in form, we will go to Baden-Baden [for the Sept. 2 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden] next, and after that we will go back for the [Oct. 7 G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp]." *Cont. p3*

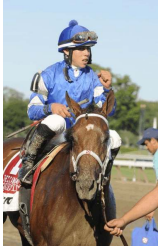

Danedream's rapid rise through the ranks began with a third in last term's G2 Derby Italiano at Rome's Capanelle, and gained momentum with victory in the G2 Oaks d'Italia at Milan next time. The bay slipped to fifth in Saint-Cloud's G2 Prix de Malleret, but went on a thrashing spree in her next three starts. Triumphs by five lengths in Hoppegarten's G1 Grosser Preis von Berlin, and by six lengths in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, persuaded Teruya Yoshida to purchase a half-interest, and he reaped immediate reward with Danedream's five-length promenade in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. **Cont. p4**

Danedream closed 2011 with a sixth in the Nov. 27 G1 Japan Cup, and annexed the May 20 G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmer back at Baden-Baden before running last-of-four in the June 24 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud last time. The eventual winner settled in mid-pack through the early stages here as St Nicholas Abbey's rabbit, Robin Hood (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) took time to gain pole position. Inching ever closer alongside Nathaniel rounding the final turn, she was sent in pursuit of that temporary chaperone as K 'Ua '6i JW kicked for home on last year's hero inside the two pole. Danedream was one length down on that rival entering the final eighth, but Andrasch Starke provided full force from the saddle in the latter stages of a pulsating renewal, and she was driven out to put her nose in front right on the line. Her win was the first by a distaffer since Time Charter (Ire) (Saritamer) in 1983. "It was lose, it was only a nose, but I hoped the photo-finish went my way and it did," said Starke. "It was very tight, but I had a good feeling. I don't know what happened [at Saint-Cloud] last time, but she was in good shape leading up to this race. She is unbelievably tough, she fought hard and this is definitely the biggest moment of my life." Schiergen added, "When she crossed the line I thought she might have been second, and I was delighted to hear her number announced first. Her form from race to race is as good as last year, but there was no pace and she didn't travel well through the race last time. There was a good pace today, and she traveled much better."

Gosden Thrilled With Nathaniel Run...

Lady Rothschild and Newsells Park Stud's **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) failed, by the width of a flared nostril, to make it back-to-back victories in the contest, but trainer John Gosden was nonetheless delighted with the G1 Eclipse S. hero. "I was stood on the line and couldn't tell who had won, but Nathaniel ran a great race and I'm really thrilled with him," said the Newmarket

conditioner. "He has run his race quite brilliantly, and just look at the horses who have finished behind him."

Gosden continued, "I can't believe that, in two weeks, he has come back [from the Eclipse] and put two races like that back to back. It is quite impressive, so full marks to him. We'll put him away for a break--I'd love to come back here for the [Oct. 21 G1] Champion S., and there is also the Arc as an option." Of the winner Gosden added, "Danedream destroyed the colts in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last year, she has come back to her best and is simply marvelous. She didn't seem happy on the loose ground at Saint-Cloud last time, but has come here today and run a blinder."

Abbey Third Again...

Derrick Smith colorbearer **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was unable to better last year's third-place finish, but ran on strongly in the straight to claim a podium position once again. "St Nicholas Abbey ran a great race," trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He has to be held up like that, and we were just worried about the dead ground, as he can't quicken like he normally does. There'll be other races for him."

Moon Eclipsed...

Khalid Abdullah's **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}), who went off as the crowd's 2-1 pick, was unable to match his winning performance in last month's G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot and finished fifth. "There's nothing to report; Sea Moon just didn't quite fire as we hoped he might," racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "He didn't quite travel through the race as we hoped, and he didn't pick up when he needed to. We'll have to have a think about what we do next."

Riders in Hot Water...

William Buick and Joseph O'Brien received suspensions for whip violations aboard Nathaniel and St Nicholas Abbey, respectively. Buick was banned for two days, Aug. 5 and 6, while O'Brien will miss the final day of the Glorious Goodwood meet, having incurred a seven-day ban which runs Aug. 4 to 10. The latter was also fined £900.

Questing shaped with a great deal of promise while trained by John Gosden for HRH Princess Haya in 2011, getting straight off the mark in a Newbury maiden June 21 before being beaten a nose and a head in third in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood Aug. 27. She suffered another heart-breaking defeat when a neck runner-up in Newmarket's G3 Oh So Sharp S. Sept. 23, and connections opted to roll the dice in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She did not disgrace herself against the likes of My Miss Aurelia (Smart Strike) and Grace Hall (Empire Maker) in a fifth-place effort and took up permanent residence on this side of the Atlantic with the Kiaran McLaughlin stable.

Given that her juvenile success came on the grass, Questing returned to that surface, but the results were disappointing, as she could manage only a fourth-place finish at odds-on in a Gulfstream allowance going a grassy mile Mar. 14 and cut back to seven-eighths of a mile when a midfield fifth in Belmont allowance company May 11. Connections decided to shake things up a bit and entered the homebred bay for a one-mile allowance on the dirt, and the results were nothing short of spectacular. With Irad Ortiz Jr. in the irons for the first time, Questing set a strong pace along the inside and cruised under the wire 3 3/4 lengths to the good of Book Review (Giant's Causeway), who in turn was 13 lengths clear of the third. The form of that event was franked on Saratoga's opening day when Book Review proved the handy winner of a seven-furlong allowance, and Questing was bet down into 7-2 here (from 9-2) while stretching back out to two turns.

Dressed in Godolphin blue--her previous starts this term came in Darley maroon-and-white--Questing was neatly away from the inside stall and landed in second, as GI Davona Dale S. upsetter Yara (Put It Back) set an unreasonably fast opening quarter-mile :23.21. Ortiz gave his mount a bit of rein, and horse and jockey edged to the front with fully five furlongs to race, as heavily backed In Lingerie and Zo Impressive were launching their rallies from the rear. Questing scooted two or three lengths clear turning for home, drifted out noticeably in the final eighth of a mile, but was always comfortably in front. Zo Impressive, the GI Acorn S. victress, stayed on to complete the exacta for her sire. "Irad did a great job," said McLaughlin. "He rode an excellent race for a 19-year-old kid. We thought we were faster than [Yara], but he said, and we talked about it, 'If she goes, let her go.' And he rode a great race. He used good judgment."

Reigning champion older male Acclamation made it seven straight with a hassle-free and successful defense of his title in this first Grade I of the Del Mar meeting. The bay commenced his winning streak with a seven-length score in the Gil Jim Murray H. before taking the 2011 GI Charles Whittingham H. ahead of a 3 1/4-length defeat of Jeranimo (Congaree) in this event. Patrick Valenzuela was at the controls for a pillar-to-post score from Twirling Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GI Pacific Classic on the local Poly Aug. 28, and he bagged a fifth straight win in the GI Clement L. Hirsch S. at Santa Anita Oct. 2. A horse without a Breeders' Cup home, Acclamation was put away for the year with a sore foot, but celebrated an Eclipse Award in January. His return to action this season was delayed just a bit, but he finally resumed with a one-length win over Silm Shadey (GB) (Val Royal {Fr}) in defense of his Whittingham title June 9. One of the least complicated horses in training, Acclamation was pointed towards the front by Valenzuela, and they clicked off easy fractions of :24.94, :49.00 and 1:12.57 for the opening three-quarters of a mile. Slim Shadey and later Interaction tried to make a race of it, but Acclamation put four on them with a furlong to race and coasted in the easiest of winners. "I'm going to say this now and I mean it: he's a great horse," the winning jockey commented. "I've been lucky enough to ride some very good horses, champions, like Sunday Silence and Arazi and Best Pal. And this horse is right there with them. This horse does it all. On turf. On dirt. On Polytrack. He can do it all. He is just amazing."

Much to the delight of the other horses and connections signed on for last Saturday's GIII American Derby at Arlington Park, Silver Max was withdrawn in favor of this spot, which carried a pot three times as great. Much to the chagrin of those who lined up against him here, the bay employed his usual punishing front-running tactics and held a late lunge from Lucky Chappy to run his turf winning streak to seven straight. Offered for \$50,000 in his career debut over the Saratoga main track last summer, Silver Max wired a field of starter/optional claimers at Gulfstream Mar. 9 prior to a 5 1/2-length victory in the GIII Transylvania S. at Keeneland Apr. 6. He overcame the 12 hole for a 2 3/4-length tally in Churchill's GII American Turf S. May 4, took the first leg of the Mid-American Triple--the May 26 Arlington Classic--and was coming into this off a 6 3/4-length success in the Oliver S. at Indiana Downs June 13. Sent immediately to the front here by Robby Albarado, Silver Max doled out a measured early pace and raced by six furlongs in 1:14.09. He cut the corner into the stretch still well in front, turned back a bid from stablemate Finnegan's Wake and dug in late to hold off Lucky Chappy for the win. The winner goes next in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Park Aug. 18.

For the second consecutive year, the reigning champion 3-year-old filly has raided Delaware Park and has departed with the lion's share of the purse money in the "Win and You're In" event for the Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. And while the distance separating heavily favored Royal Delta and the locally based Tiz Miz Sue was slightly greater than the nose of Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) that got down just ahead of eventual Horse of the Year Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) 12 months ago, the Del 'Cap was full of drama all the same.

Victorious in the 2011 GII Black-Eyed Susan S., Royal Delta was a rusty third to Godolphin's It's Tricky (Mineshaft) in last year's GI CCA Oaks July 23, but atoned for that defeat with a solid score in the GI TVG Alabama S. going this distance Aug. 20. She wasn't able to match the brilliance of Havre de Grace when a distant runner-up to that one in the GI Beldame S. Oct. 1, but, with her older nemesis opting for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, dominated the market and ultimately the race itself to clinch a divisional title in the Ladies' Classic.

Purchased by Ben Leon's operation for \$8.5 million at Keeneland November just a few days later, Royal Delta was pointed for the G1 Dubai World Cup, and resumed with a decent, if unspectacular, second-place effort to Awesome Maria in the GII Sabin S. at Gulfstream Feb. 25. She was the buzz of the Meydan backstretch in the lead-up to the World Cup, but she could not live up to the hype on race night, weakening in the stretch to finish a distant ninth. Trainer Bill Mott was content to let the filly tell him when she was ready to get back to business, and Royal Delta was sent back to Churchill for that track's GII Fleur de Lis H. June 16. Handy to the pace that evening, she dragged new rider Mike Smith to the front with a surprisingly quick move and left her rivals eight lengths behind at the finish.

Love and Pride (A.P. Indy) flashed speed from the outside stall and showed the way under the wire the first time, as Royal Delta stayed down at the fence and Awesome Maria raced four wide past the judge and into the first turn. The pacesetter took them down the backstretch in 1:09.80--faster than most six-furlong races at the track--and began to come back to the field. The composition of the race had changed a bit in the meantime, as Royal Delta was shifted out to about the three path and Awesome Maria had been guided down to the fence, and the two market leaders made simultaneous runs towards the front on the final bend. Royal Delta was clearly doing the better of those two and swept to the lead in upper stretch, but Tiz Miz Sue, who raced on a long rein and with cover for the opening mile, loomed the biggest danger and switched outside to launch her bid. It appeared for a few strides inside the final furlong that she had the favorite's measure, but Royal Delta stuck her neck out and class told in the finish.

All eyes were on The Queen's Carlton House (Street Cry {Ire}), including his owner's, but the race produced a shock result as Fanunalter took advantage of the favorite's tendency to over-race. Now with Michael Wigham after he was purchased out of Marco Botti's yard, the winner has shown glimpses of ability at big prices such as when defying odds of 16-1 in last year's G3 Diomed S. at Epsom. Beaten only 3/4 of a length by Dick Turpin (Ire) (Arakan) when runner-up in this race 12 months ago, he was also fourth behind that rival in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at the San Siro in September. After three unplaced efforts at Meydan this winter, he was sold and his new connections were expecting no fireworks on this belated debut for the stable. Restrained towards the rear under cover early as Cai Shen (Ire) (Iffraaj {GB}) and the free-running Royal runner created a fast tempo to run at, the bay was still full of run but locked in a pocket with a furlong remaining. Switched around Carlton House soon after, he swooped to the front with 100 yards remaining and held on as Pastoral Player delivered a strong challenge up the inner. "We have just brought him along quietly and he's done a lot of swimming--we don't gallop him a lot," Wigham said. "We thought he would improve for today, but obviously I was wrong. I thought he'd run well here and then go to a Group 3 in Norway, but we'll probably be shelving that plan now. We'll work out what we'll do at a later stage. He obviously still retains a lot of his ability."

Plans for Carlton House, who eventually dead-headed for fourth with Cai Shen after tugging at the reins to take on that pace-setter for much of the contest, are on hold according to Sir Michael Stoute. "He looked as though he didn't settle," he told *PA Sport*. "Ryan [Moore] said he regretted not dropping him in. I don't know what we'll do now. We'll have to have a think."

The homebred made three mostly nondescript starts over the Hawthorne main track last season while under the care of Moises Yanez, finishing a debut fourth Oct. 29, improving to third Nov. 12 and closing the season with

a disappointing sixth at odds-on Nov. 26.

HIGHWAY TO GLORY?

The Late Walter Haefner believed that the best fillies and mares should be tested on the track, so it is fitting that just over a month on from his parting, the Moyglare silks are carried postward to today's G1 Darley Irish Oaks by a leading contender in **Princess Highway** (Street Cry {Ire}). Rapidly



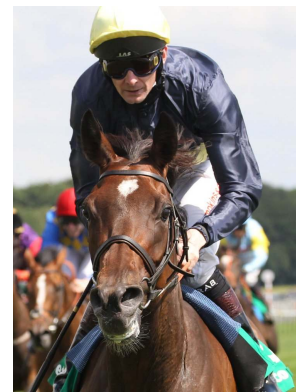

progressive, the homebred beat the solid yardstick Betterbetterbetter (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in a 10-furlong maiden at Leopardstown Mar. 28 before accounting for a host of Classic pretenders, including **Was (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), in the G3 Blue Wind S. over that trip at Naas May 16. Like her dam Irresistible Jewel (Ire) (Danehill), she annexed Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale S. June 21, and it will be a surprise if she is unable to make a much bigger impact in this race than her dam--and also her half-sister Mad About You (Ire) (Indian Ridge {GB})--who were both unplaced. She has reportedly suffered a late setback and connections are wary of the testing ground, but jockey Pat Smullen is finding it hard to contain his enthusiasm. "She's done everything right leading up to the race and was very impressive in Ascot," he said. "She appears to be in the same sort of form she was then, but the big concern for me is the ground. In the formbook it says it was soft at Ascot, but it was nothing compared to what she will encounter here--she is going to encounter heavy winter ground, and that is an unknown."

Smullen continued, "Was has probably improved since Naas, but Princess Highway's form is the strongest at the moment, in my opinion." Supplemented this week, Lady Rothschild's **Great Heavens (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) will love the conditions as she did when trouncing the smart older mares Shimmering Surf (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and Set To Music (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock

July 7. She was in receipt of nearly a stone on weight-for-age terms on that occasion and probably has to step up again to feature here, but trainer John Gosden has his stable firing on all cylinders at present.

"Obviously, it is very tight between races after such a huge effort in the Lancashire Oaks," he told *PA Sport*. "She seems fine and has shown she can handle really soft ground." Also added to the field on Tuesday was Thistle Bloodstock's **Colliding Worlds (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), who would be providing trainer Edward Lynam with a first Classic success if she can bridge the sizeable gap. She at least has had a boost to her maiden form, as the filly that was 6 1/2 lengths behind her at Leopardstown July 12, Wonderful (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), has since won a small race.

RECKLESS ENDEAVOR

Maisons-Laffitte play host to the G2 Prix Robert Papin today, and to a notable British challenger in the unbeaten **Reckless Abandon (GB)** (Exchange Rate). After a taking debut performance at Doncaster May 19, the Clive Cox-trained colt managed to win the June 21 G2 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot despite drifting left in the run to the line. "I've been very pleased with him since Ascot, very pleased indeed," his trainer told *PA Sport*. "This looks a nice, healthy step forward for him. He's stepping up half a furlong, but that shouldn't be a problem, and he gets into the race without a penalty. We're all very excited about him, and we hope he can produce another exciting performance. He's quite straightforward at home, but he is still a baby. Hopefully what happened at Ascot won't become a regular occurrence." Another from that country who took part in the Royal Ascot meeting was Andrew Tinkler's **Sir Prancealot (Ire)** (Tamayuz {GB}), who was fourth when favorite for the June 19 G2 Coventry S.

He had previously won Sandown's Listed National S. in the style of a potential class act May 31 and is another major threat to the home team headed by the unbeaten **Penny's Picnic (Ire)** (Kheleyf). After two successes by a cumulative margin of 18 lengths, he was brought down to earth in the June 8 Listed Prix la Fleche here, when he had to battle for the first time to keep his perfect sequence.

STAR-BOUND?

Some recent luminaries have used the G2 Prix Eugene Adam, or the Grand Prix de Maisons-Laffitte as it is also known, as a springboard to the major league and a select quintet attempt to emulate the likes of Arcangues (Sagace {Fr}), Carnegie (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), Dr Fong (Kris S.), Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold), Valixir (Ire) (Tremolino) and Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) today. Four of the last five editions have gone to British raiders, and there are a pair of highly regarded colts from that country in this line-up in Khalid Abdullah's **Starboard (GB)** (Zamindar) and Reddam Racing's **Cogito** (Giant's Causeway). The former hails from a John Gosden stable that has abundant reserves of classy types this year, and he has been a work in progress so far, earning a step up to pattern company with a cozy win in a 10-furlong conditions event at Doncaster last time June 9. Cogito has black-type to his name already, having won the Listed Heron S. over a mile at Sandown May 31 before an unplaced effort in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot last time June 19. "A strong finish characterised both his Newmarket debut and Sandown listed race and after some bad interference at the start of the G1 St James's Palace S., he was allowed to coast home eighth," trainer Brian Meehan explained. "He deserves this shot both at Group 2 level and an extra two furlongs, which he promises to stay and he has a great chance." Two defending the domestic honors are His Highness The Aga Khan's **Bayrir (Fr)** (Medicean {GB}), who took the Listed Prix Ridgway over 1 5/16 miles at Saint-Cloud last time June 24 and Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's unbeaten **Fractional (Ire)** (Manduro {Ger}). He bids to extend Andre Fabre's record of 13 wins in this prize and has been prepared meticulously by the master of Chantilly, taking a debutantes and conditions race at this circuit June 6 and June 27.

SPEED APLENTY IN THE SANFORD

Today's featured GII Sanford S. at the Spa brings together a very well-matched field of nine juvenile colts and geldings, five of which have remarkably already recorded a Beyer Speed Figure north of 80. Starlight Racing's **Rose Junction** (Dixie Union) showed battling qualities in his five-furlong debut downstate, outslugging Lignite (Run Away and Hide) en route to a three-length victory after dueling heads apart in the middle portion of the race. The form of that heat was flattered Friday when the runner-up returned to graduate in front-running fashion. The Todd Pletcher barn is also represented by **Onetwentyeight** (Discreet Cat), a five-length Belmont maiden winner at first asking June 28. Both horses are eligible for the \$100,000 bonus being offered by the New York Racing Association for any 2-year-old graded winner at the Spa who graduated at Aqueduct or Belmont. "They're both in the same position as they broke their maidens in their first start at Belmont," said Pletcher, a five-time winner of the Sanford including last year's edition with **Overdriven** (Tale of the Cat). "We'll see where they fit. We would like to collect the bonus." The field's biggest figure belongs to **Handsome Jack** (Bring the Heat), who broke his maiden for a \$20,000 tag at Churchill in May before running the promising Shanghai Bobby (Harlan's Holiday) to a length when second in the June 27 Track Barron S. at Belmont.

When she came out of that race and trained for the Schuylerville, she moved forward by leaps and bounds, and I knew I had something way better than average on my hands."

Romans Duo Work Towards Saratoga Starts...

A pair of Grade I winners from the Dale Romans barn were out for Saturday works as they continue on the road to appearances during the Saratoga meeting. **Tapitsfly** (Tapit), who is scheduled to make her next appearance in the GI Diana S. July 28, went five-eighths of a mile over the Saratoga main track in 1:01.41, the second-fastest of 22 moves at the distance. "She looked good doing it," said trainer Dale Romans said of the Frank L. Jones, Jr. homebred. "It made me think about running her back on the dirt, but we'll wait." Tapitsfly is coming off a front-running victory in the GI Just a Game S. at Belmont Park June 9. "Our plan for her this year was to get her to really relax and come from a little off the pace, and then we got to the Just a Game, a Grade I, and there was no speed, so we threw that out the window," Romans explained. "And I doubt there will be enough speed to run with her here, so she'll probably do the same thing." Meanwhile, **Shackleford** (Forestry), last-out winner of the GI Metropolitan H. May 28, worked five furlongs in 1:01.40 at Churchill Downs. The 4-year-old is being pointed to the GI Forego S. Sept. 1, where he is expected to meet Friday's GIII James Marvin S. hero Pacific Ocean (Ghostzapper) and Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil), fourth in Friday's race.

Casse Has Haskell Decision to Make...

Trainer Mark Casse and owner John Oxley will be represented in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park July 29, but a decision as to whether it will be GIII Ohio Derby hero **Prospective** (Malibu Moon) or **Stealcas** (Lawyer Ron), the GIII Matt Winn S. runner-up, has yet to be made. "We still haven't decided," Casse said Saturday from Saratoga. "Mr. Oxley is here and we will talk it over later this afternoon to decide which one will run." Prospective breezed five furlongs in 1:02.80 Friday at Woodbine. In other Haskell news, **Dullahan** (Even the Score), who figures to vie for Haskell favoritism with **Paynter** (Awesome Again), got the bullet for a five-furlong breeze in :59.80 Saturday morning at Churchill Downs.

AUSTRALIAN'S GUN SHY OF KENTUCKY DERBY WINNERS

Kentucky Derby-winning stallions cut little ice with Australian breeders, suspicious of their prepotency and doubting they transmit superior genes to our broodmare band. And given their record here, Fusaichi Pegasus and Thunder Gulch included, they are probably right.

But is this a harsh judgment built on our love affair with speed horses? Probably. Is it also a suspicion that dirt horses don't cut it in the turf dominated Antipodes? Again, probably.

I thought of these prejudices Saturday watching 4-year-old gelding Hour of Peril (Fusaichi Pegasus) win the \$80,000 Tattersall's Mile, his fourth win and first stakes success in one of the last black-type races of the Australian season.

Ridden beautifully in an energy-saving, rail-hugging ride around Eagle Farm, Brisbane, by international veteran Jeff Lloyd, Hour of Peril will not reinstate Fu Peg's sinking reputation here, but his son's win in a listed race serves as a reminder that surely we are at least fortunate to have the blood of Churchill Down's Derby winners flow into our stock.

Certainly mining billionaire Nathan Tinkler, who has tipped a fair chunk of the money that makes him our richest person under 40 into horseflesh, will not shrink from the ignominy that accompanied his buy of the Fu Peg colt for A\$47,500 at Sydney's secondary Inglis Classic Summer Sale in 2009.

Apart from being a cheapie for Tinkler, at the time regularly spending 20 times that amount on yearlings, he was bucking the consensus of bloodstock aficionados that Fu Peg was on the nose, and Saturday's win will be a lovely rejoinder for the big man who loves to one-up the establishment.

Fu Peg, shuttled to the Hunter Valley in 2001 by Coolmore, never guilty of underestimating their stallions, was given every chance to make it. He was sent one of the best, Oaks heroine Circles of Gold (Marscaj) and left us Haradasun, who rose to be champion 3-year-old colt in Australia and the best older miler in the UK due to his win at Royal Ascot in the G1 Queen Anne S.

However, this was not enough for the cognoscenti, who condemned the son of Mr. Prospector, discounting the getting of Haradasun because Circles of Gold already had champion \$5.6 million-earner Elvstroem (Danehill), and it was her superior genes which drove the champion miler.

Haradasun has rising 3-year-olds, and it would be fair to say the jury is out as to his effectiveness as a sire. It is not helping that he is without a standout winner among his 2-year-olds, although son Kabayan promises to be a durable runner for Gai Waterhouse in the coming year.

Earlier Saturday, another Run for the Roses victor whose worth is under the critical microscope, Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}), had son Clever Boy contest his third start in an A\$85,000 2-year-old 1300-meter event at Rosehill. The result was he ran third for the third time, leaving the jury yet to make up its mind, again.

Because of his brilliance as a 2-year-old, Street Sense was imagined here as a sire of babies. It hasn't turned out that way for the Sheikh Mohammed-owned Eclipse winner, and Darley's trainer Peter Snowden, who would have a swag of Street Sense progeny, has obviously chosen to be patient with their size and strength and left them to be tested in their third year.

While the patient await Street Sense, another Kentucky Derby winner with the same initials--Super Saver (Maria's Mon)--hasn't been granted the same courtesy. He has been sent packing after just one season standing last year at Victoria's Eliza Park at a modest fee of A\$16,500.

As breeders stayed away in their droves, questioning the credentials of the unknown Maria's Mon as a sire of sires, the Australian prejudice against Derby winners was there for all to see. How Big Brown (Boundary), with all his hype, will get over this will be interesting to see when his oldest turn into 2-year-old racehorses in 2013.

We won't have to wait that long for Stout Hearted (Dynaformer), who was imported from John Gosden's stables in England to run in our Cups later this year. Ultra impressive last time, he moved out a further 100 meters, to 1500 Saturday, and apart from being supported by punters this time, let no one down running third.

While he may not be the headliner, we thought, when winning like a Cups chance a fortnight ago, he is very much still in the calculations, particularly when racetrack diehards learned he was out of a Danzig mare.

Danzig does not suffer from prejudice here. Firstly, he wasn't a Kentucky Derby winner, and secondly, he was the sire of a horse called Danehill, who changed our landscape and began the climb up the mountain here.

As the conqueror, Danehill has another plus in Australian eyes--he has never sired a winner of the Kentucky Derby!

He bested Joha, who returned to graduate convincingly over the Belmont turf before taking Woodbine's Colin S. in a photo that day. Good Tickled subsequently earned his diploma on the Churchill dirt May 18, defeating Sanford foe John Gordon and well-regarded Positively, who finished second in the GIII Bashford Manor S. The fourth-place finisher in that heat, Show Some Magic, returned to run second to Bashford Manor winner Circle Unbroken before filling the same slot in yesterday's second race. You can toss out Good Tickled's fifth-place run in the Bashford, as he was left at the break and forced to rush up. 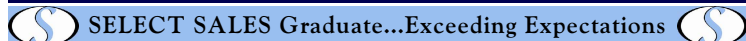
