

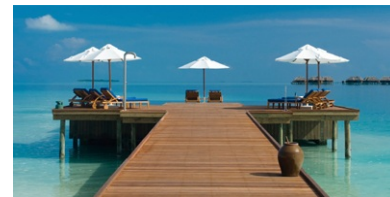

CENTRE COURT HOLDS SERVE

Sent off the slight second favorite behind reigning GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' Turf winner **Stephanie's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), G. Watts Humphrey's **Centre Court** (Smart Strike) settled in centerfield

beneath Julien Leparoux, split rivals inside the final eighth of a mile and held on in a wild finish in Wednesday's featured GII Lake George S. at Saratoga.

"She's easy to ride," commented winning trainer Rusty Arnold. "It got a little

rough in the stretch, but she got through. She's smart, she's brave, she always fights her way through."

Well-beaten in a single dirt try at two, Centre Court earned a field-best 94 Beyer Speed Figure when a head second in her seasonal and turf debuts at Gulfstream Mar. 3 and filled the same spot in a Polytrack maiden at Keeneland Apr. 15 before recording an impressive score over Churchill's Matt Winn turf course May 19. That effort earned the homebred a quote of 3-2 for the GIII Regret S. in Louisville June 16, and the favorite obliged with a one-length tally.

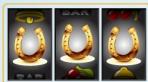
Settled on the rails as **Elusive Rumour** (Elusive Quality) set a searching pace, Centre Court advanced to be just off the leaders' heels approaching the lane. Angled out three wide in upper stretch, she found running room between **Medolina** (Aragorn {Ire}) and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine **Samitar (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) and dug in late for the victory. **Better Lucky** (Ghostzapper), exiting a modestly rated win in the GII Sands Point S. downstate May 28, was checked under the line the first time, covered ground while making a middle move down the backside and was getting to the winner late. **Cont. p3**

AUDIBLE HAS GEMOLOGIST IN HASKELL

The prospective field for Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth grew by one yesterday when trainer Todd Pletcher announced that WinStar Farm's GI Resorts World Wood Memorial S. hero **Gemologist** (Tiznow) would run in the \$1-million centerpiece instead of Saturday's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga. "He is going to run. He's definite," said trainer Todd Pletcher, who saddled Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) to win the Haskell for WinStar in 2006. The following summer he sent out Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor) to victory for WinStar and Padua Stables. "He has been training extremely well and we are very pleased with how he is coming into the race," Pletcher added. Perfect in three starts at two, including the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S., Gemologist drilled a one-mile Gulfstream allowance field by seven lengths Mar. 16 before besting Jim Dandy hopeful Alpha (Bernardini) by a neck in the Wood. Sent off an 8-1 chance in the GI Kentucky Derby, he was forwardly placed for a half-mile before drifting back through the field to finish 16th. Off the track since that time, Gemologist signaled his readiness for his return with a bullet five-furlong work over the Saratoga main track in :58 2/5 (1/43) July 22. In other Haskell developments, J. Paul Reddam's **Handsome Mike** (Scat Daddy) arrived on a flight from California Tuesday evening and got his first feel of the Monmouth main track in a one-mile gallop Wednesday morning. Post positions for the Haskell will be assigned today at noon.

Stephanie's Kitten was shuffled back to last nearing the second turn, but John Velazquez didn't panic. He gambled on an inside passage in the stretch, but was stopped cold behind Mendolina. They dove back down to the fence, but the wire came too soon. "I thought we had a good trip all the way to the eighth pole," said Velazquez, riding for the first time since suffering a broken collarbone in a spill at Churchill Downs. I made the decision to try to split horses, and the horse in front came out. I ended up behind heels and had to steady and go back inside, and we lost the race right there." Centre Court is a candidate for this track's GII Lake Placid S. Aug. 19, with October's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland the long-range objective.

HARD GRAF-TER

Jim Bolger trains his juveniles to be tough and resilient and **Grafelli (Ire)** (Hannouma {Ire}) is a prime example of the success of the Coolcullen method as he steps out again in today's G3 Tyros S. at

Leopardstown. Having his third run this month when registering an impressive six-length success in last Sunday's G3 Anglesey S. over an extended six furlongs at The Curragh, Sylvain Benillouche's hard-knocking colt bids to defy a three-pound penalty for that effort and provide his

stable with a fourth renewal since 2005. As is customary, Aidan O'Brien puts up the sternest opposition to Bolger's ambitions with a pair of lightly raced colts headed by Joseph Allen and Coolmore's **Lines of Battle (War Front)**. Having earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status on his winning debut over six furlongs in a Curragh maiden that has worked out well, he was sixth in the best juvenile race run so far in 2012, the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 19. He is joined by Derrick Smith's **Kingston Jamaica (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who followed a debut second behind the subsequent G2 Railway S. winner **Probably (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) over an extended seven furlongs at Limerick June 16 with a maiden win over the same track and trip six day later. This is a race that has played host to some of Coolcullen and Ballydoyle's best in recent years, with the former stable's **Teofilo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) being followed by **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in a rich spell of talent between 2006 and 2009.

Team Valor Introduces Ladies'-Only Partnership...

Valor Ladies LLC, a new Team Valor partnership restricted to female owners and spearheaded by the operation's Megan Jones, has been launched with the acquisition of the talented Italian-based filly **Tuttipaesi (Ire)** (Clodovil {Ire}).

"Megan came to me with a concept to form a new type of partnership that would be for women only," Team Valor CEO Barry Irwin explained. "Her idea was to start off with a horse that would be guaranteed to race mostly in stakes, in various locales of the country, in order to give the participants a reason to go out of town and have fun like their husbands do with Team Valor." He continued, "To give a special purpose to the new group, Megan thought that it would be a wonderful idea if a charity was designated that could receive a meaningful portion of the horse's earnings. Megan has settled on the Susan G. Komen For the Cure charity."

"It was decided that 25% of any net operating profits--defined as the difference between earnings and expenses--be donated to the breast cancer cause."

Pronounced two-tee-pie-AZEE, the dark bay, whose name translated from Italian means "all countries" was her country's leading juvenile of either sex at the time of her purchase. A debut second at Rome May 1 over heavy turf, Tuttipaesi stepped into a conditions event on the all-weather track at the Capanelle and drilled the field by five lengths ([video](#)). Since returned to the turf, Tuttipaesi further enhanced her reputation with victories in the Listed Premio Alessandro Perrone at Rome June 2 ([video](#)) and in the Listed Premio Mantovani at Milan's San Siro July 1 ([video](#)).

Tuttipaesi will be transferred immediately from her Rome base to the Newmarket yard of trainer Marco Botti, who prepared Gitano Hernando (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) in England before shipping Stateside to win the GI Goodwood S. as a 3-year-old at Santa Anita in 2009. Botti is well-versed in Italian racing, having grown up in a successful international stable before becoming a top jockey and later a successful conditioner.

While it is possible that Tuttipaesi could make one start under Botti's care while in Europe, she is currently tentatively scheduled to make her first American start for Valor Ladies in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. over the Keeneland Polytrack Oct. 5.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Chippendale to Take On Camelot...

Sir Robert Ogden's **Thomas Chippendale (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) is set to tackle **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the Sept. 15 G1 Ladbrokes St Leger, which attracted 36 entries at yesterday's forfeit stage. Successful in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot June 22, the Sir Henry Cecil-trained colt could bid to provide his stable with a fifth renewal of the Doncaster Classic. Barry Simpson, racing manager to the owner, commented, "It's quite possible that Thomas Chippendale will head to Doncaster. We have two races in mind for him--the [July 31] G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood and the [Aug. 22] G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York--and at the moment he will probably run at York. He would have to win or be a very unlucky loser in either of those races to warrant going for the Ladbrokes St Leger. He's an uncomplicated horse who is very straightforward, and I don't think that we would have any concern about his stamina for the Ladbrokes St Leger. Our view is that he is pretty good over a mile and a half and that he has a good turn of foot over that distance. Sir Henry started him off with a good education last season and we were a little late in starting him this season, due to the ground conditions and the fact that he had an eating problem, so he couldn't take his work in the early part of the season."

"A lot of horses are much keener on the rail," Bush added. "They see it, they know it, and they're likely to do more. That's what he did, but he handles turns so well that it's easy for him to work like that."

Get Stormy is looking for his second win in the one mile Fourstardave; he won the race in 2010 when it was contested over 1 1/16 miles. The bay colt is looking for his first victory since February, when he won the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H.

"Hopefully we can keep him happy," said Bush. "He's doing plenty well enough. He'll need to, I'm sure [the Fourstardave] is going to come up plenty deep."

Get Stormy was last seen finishing second in the June 10 GII Monmouth S.

She's out of a full-sister to European GSW and sire Ishiguru (Danzig), making her second dam the GI Spinaway S. and GI Matron S. winner Strategic Manuever (Cryptoclearance). Geisha Girl appears to have worked six furlongs on the turf here alongside Grade II-winning turf horse Newsdad (Arch) recently, which is certainly another positive. Other stat: After Da Mi Basia Mille scored at 8-1 Monday, trainer Christophe Clement is hitting at a 28% strike rate with a \$4.12 ROI over the past year with his firsters going long on the turf.
