## SHORT, BUT SWEET FIELD IN DIANA

It only drew a field of six, but the historic GI Diana S. at Saratoga today is packed with class and both local talent and international appeal. Darby Dan's Phillips

of her 11 previous tries, the late-running grey looks to add another Grade I tally to keep last year's Garden City S. trophy company.

"You have to give [Tapitsfly] a lot of credit [for her Just a Game win]," Winter Memories's trainer Jimmy Toner said. "She was on the lead, nice and comfortable, and we just couldn't catch her. When they asked her, she had plenty enough to kick in. We just couldn't catch her. No excuses. I don't know if Tapitsfly will go [1 1/8 miles in the Diana], but if you have the same scenario as last time, she will go that far. And I don't see any pace in the race, truthfully. Unfortunately for us and fortunately for them, it could be the same scenario all over again."

Martin Schwartz's **Zagora (Fr)** (Green Tune) took last year's renewal of the Diana, and enters off a break following a successful run in Pimlico's GIII Galorette H. She's three-for-four this year, but was fifth in a pacesetter running of Keeneland's GI Jenny Wiley S. two back Apr. 14. "She came out of the Galorette with a popped splint, and we freshened her for a couple of weeks to fix that," explained conditioner Chad Brown of Zagora's recent respite. Of her lone disappointing effort as a 5-year-old, the conditioner added, "She caught a slow pace [in the Jenny Wiley], and she's 0-for-3 at Keeneland. It's not her course. Otherwise, she's been perfect this year." **Cont. p4**

## ANYONE'S RACE IN JIM DANDY

The strength of the 3-year-old male division has been dealt some serious blows with the recent retirements of I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) and Union Rags (Dixie Union) and the minor setback for Bodemeister (Empire Maker), but the competitiveness and strength of today's GII Jim Dandy S. at the Spa should offer a glimmer of hope that a new group of sophomores will step up for the second half of the season. Another son of Flower Alley, **Neck 'n Neck**, could be poised to carry the torch for the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. winner off of two smashing efforts at Churchill Downs. The A. Stevens Miles Jr. homebred earned a 101 Beyer Speed Figure for a 6 1/2-length rout of allowance foes May 10, and followed up with a 7 1/4-length romp in the GIII Matt Winn S. June 16, good for a 102 Beyer. "Just the way he did it and how he executed, and you know, to win by seven and beat those horses with authority, you have to go to the next level," said trainer Ian Wilkes of Neck 'n Neck. "You've got to give them a shot to get against the big boys." One of the 'big boys' is Godolphin's GI Wood Memorial S. runner-up **Alpha** (Bernardini). Forced to miss the GI Belmont S. due to a fever after running 12th in the GI Kentucky Derby, the bay has been firing bullets here in preparation for his return. "Alpha's doing great," trainer Kieran McLaughlin said. "We're all set." **Cont. p4**

The Baffert barn is loaded with talent in every main-track division this year, and it flexed its muscles again with a runner who could only possibly be considered a second stringer in a stable such as this one. Richard's Kid took back-to-back runnings of the GI Pacific Classic S. here in 2009 and 2010, first for Arnold Zetcher and then for Zabeel Racing International. He also annexed the 2010 GI Goodwood S. before being transferred to Satish Seemar for five fruitless starts in Dubai in 2011 and 2012. The dark bay has appreciated the return home and reunion with Baffert, and immediately rediscovered his best form with a 7 1/2-length romp in Betfair Hollywood Park's Prove It S. June 8. He was second to superstar stablemate Game On Dude (Awesome Again) last time in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. July 7, but with that runner absent, he loomed an imposing presence. Unhurried early as keen Peruvian import Fly Lexis Fly (Badge of Silver) ensured a solid pace, Richard's Kid began to take closer order as the field bunched up on the home turn. He still had plenty left to do as Worth Repeating hit the stretch with the lead, but a powerful sweeping move from Richard's Kid proved far too much for that runner to handle and the veteran drew off to an impressive if somewhat expected victory while breaking the track record. "It was almost like a bonus for me after I had my heart attack [while in Dubai in late March] when they told me I was getting Richard's Kid back," recalled Baffert, who will point the winner towards a record third victory in the TVG Pacific Classic Aug. 26. "I got saved and I got Richard's Kid, so something good came out of it."

# BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

## Short, but Sweet Diana cont...

Rounding out the Diana field are a pair of European invaders in France-based **Dream Peace (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) and Britain-based **Law of The Range (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}). The former, who took the G2 Prix de la Nonette last August, was beaten just a nose and a head as the favorite in Woodbine's GI E. P. Taylor S. over yielding ground last October. Fourth in the G3 Prix Allez France at Chantilly in April, the Robert Collet trainee was last seen finishing eighth in the competitive G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup May 20. While Law of The Range's accomplishments aren't quite on par with other runners in the field, trainer Marco Botti has had success when shipping to North America. Gitano Hernando (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) annexed the 2009 GI Goodwood S. at 18-1, while Joshua Tree (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) was second in last year's GI Canadian International at 11-1 after Botti took over training duties of that race's defending champ from Aidan O'Brien. Law of The Range comes off a sixth in the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 20, but she has speed and could fall into a nice trip tracking behind Tapitsfly.

## Anyone's Race in Jim Dandy cont...

J W Singer LLC's **Teeth of the Dog** (Bluegrass Cat) and Richard Pell's **Fast Falcon** (Awesome Again) have run one-two in both the June 9 Easy Goer S. and June 30 GII Dwyer S. downstate, and re-oppose here. The former, third in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7 and fifth in the Preakness May 19, will look to fill the void in the Michael Matz barn left by Belmont hero Union Rags. "His last two races were good, more so being that in one of them he was on the pace and in the other he came from behind," offered Matz. "We've asked a lot of him this year, and he's handled himself pretty well. One of the great things about this horse is that he's got a big heart and will give us his all." Shortleaf Stable's **Atigun** (Istan) made an ominous wide move in the Belmont last time, threatening to blow up the tote at 20-1, but settled for a solid third. With a bullet five-furlong work in 1:00 4/5 here July 21, he's another sophomore who could be peaking. Arnold Zetcher's Grade I-winning juvenile **Liaison** (Indian Charlie) appeared as if he hadn't trained on at three, but has appeared to wake up a bit recently. He's the only other runner besides Neck 'n Neck to have broken the 100 Beyer Speed Figure mark, having earned a 102 for a close third in the GII Swaps S. at Betfair Hollywood Park July 4. **Field p5**

**BC BID UP FOR GRABS IN SAN DIEGO**

As the morning line might suggest, today's GII San Diego H. at Del Mar is anyone's ball game. Five horses hover between 3-1 and 4-1 in this "Win and You're In" qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. Lightly raced **John Scott** (Bertrando) took a 2 1/2-year hiatus after annexing a Cal-bred stakes race here and finishing fourth in the GI Norfolk S. as a juvenile in 2009, and the Harris Farms homebred looks to make up for lost time in this first black-type test since his return. Fourth when sprinting on the Santa Anita dirt Apr. 21, the 5-year-old took a key seven-furlong heat at Betfair Hollywood Park May 26 before besting **Rail Trip** (Jump Start) on the stretch-out back at that venue June 28. But Rail Trip's trainer Ron Ellis is confident that his charge, who took the 2009 GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. and finished second in the GI Pacific Classic S. here that year, can turn the tables on that foe. "You'd like to win, but he was three or four wide the whole way," Ellis, who took training back over for the Jay Em Ess colorbearer at the beginning of the year after a stint with Rick Dutrow on the East Coast, told *Daily Racing Form* of the horse's last start. "The other horse was on the rail. That can't help." Ellis said that if Rail Trip runs as he expects, he could return in the Pacific Classic Aug. 26. Omnipresent Bob Baffert has two runners--

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Take Control** (A.P. Indy) and **Prayer for Relief** (Jump Start). The former, a son of champion Azeri, looks to build on an impressive late-running score in Inglewood June 30 coming off a 2 1/2-year break of his own. Prayer for Relief owns the field's best last-out Beyer Speed Figure--a 102--for a third-place run behind stablemate Game on Dude (Awesome Again) in the June 2 GII Californian S.

## OUT FOR REDEMPTION

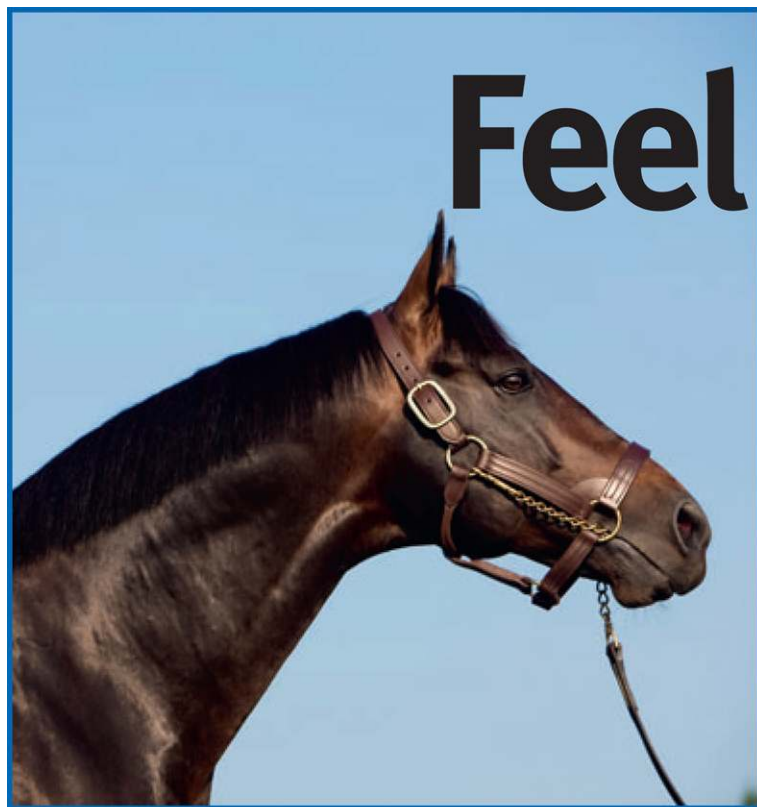
Previously one of France's great hopes, **Planteur (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) has become one of racing's biggest underachievers, and his new trainer Marco Botti attempts to unlock that talent with a class drop in today's G2 York S. On the days when he was winning the G2 Prix Noailles as a 3-year-old and the G1 Prix Ganay and G2 Prix d'Harcourt last year for Elie Lellouche, the ex-Wildenstein representative looked ready to tackle any company, but has been found wanting on the last six occasions he has raced at the top level. Despite promising thirds in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan Mar. 31 and in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan back at his favored Longchamp May 27, Mohamed Albousi Alghafli's acquisition once again flopped when seventh in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 20. "I was a little bit disappointed with his run at Ascot but, for some reason or another, he did the same thing the year before, and maybe the three weeks between the Prix d'Ispahan and the Prince of Wales's S. was not enough time for him," Botti told *Racing Post*. "Unfortunately, it was the only day at Royal Ascot when the ground was on the quick side of good and that didn't help. It's also a possibility that he

doesn't like Ascot, so his performance could have been down to a number of things. I think he is a horse who likes to be a little bit fresh, but he looks well and I have been happy with him." If Planteur has plateaued, one who could be on the ascent up the rankings is Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum's **Afsare (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}). He followed a second to another Botti trainee in Crackerjack King (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica over this trip at the Capannelle May 13 with a convincing win on good-to-soft ground in Sandown's Listed Gala S. last time July 6. Trainer Luca Cumani is using this as a stepping-stone to the Aug. 18 G1 Arlington Million and was keeping his enthusiasm under wraps yesterday. "This looks a very tight race with little between six or seven runners and, as such, we can't be confident," he said. "It still remains to be seen whether the listed race Afsare won at Sandown last time is worth much, but so long as there is a good gallop on, Afsare should go very well, as he looks an improved performer this year, and this much quicker ground is very much in his favour." **Field p7**

### EBF Increases Eligibility Payments...

The co-ordinating Committee of the European Breeders' Fund has agreed to increase the EBF Eligibility Payment for yearlings of 2012 from \$500 to \$600. Payment at this level will be payable May 1, 2013. Yearlings of 2013 by any stallion which stood in 2011 outside the EBF area, and which had not been entered in the EBF's International Stallion Scheme, will be eligible to compete in the extensive EBF programme when reaching racing age, provided the \$600 payment is made. The \$500 payment had been in place since the early 1990s, and the Committee took the view that the timing was right to introduce this increase. If the May 1, 2013 deadline is missed, later payments can be made at \$3,000 by Feb. 15 2014; or \$6,000 by June 30, 2014. The scheme was introduced to replace the Cross-Registration and Common Fund Agreements with Breeders' Cup, which were terminated Dec. 31, 2010. The EBF programme adds €4.5-million to the value of races in Britain, Ireland, France and Germany. "It is quite a problem getting across seemingly complicated arrangements which had to be introduced following the termination of the Cross-Registration and Common Fund Agreements," said Committee chairman Charles Henri de Moussac. "My Committee discussed the arrangements at great length. I think we have arrived at a fair and flexible result, which should appeal to breeders hoping to sell their stock to European interests, and owners racing in Europe."

The GI Belmont S. runner-up arrived in New Jersey Thursday evening on a flight from Southern California with fellow Haskell entrant **Nonios** (Pleasantly Perfect). His preparation is being overseen by Jimmy Barnes, assistant to five-time Haskell winning trainer Bob Baffert. ## Shackleford May Go To Vanderbilt...

Trainer Dale Romans announced yesterday that multiple Grade I winner **Shackleford** (Forestry) may contest the GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. over six furlongs at Saratoga on Aug. 5. That race would serve as a prep for the Sept. 1 seven-furlong GI Forego S., which Romans had previously identified as the 4-year-olds next target. "There is a slim chance that Shackleford might show up in the Vanderbilt," said Romans. "A lot depends on how he breezes at Churchill [today]. It has been in the back of my mind for a while." Shackleford, winner of last year's GI Preakness S., is riding a two-race win streak. His latest outing was a victory in the 28 May GI Met Mile at Belmont Park. Romans indicated earlier this week that the colt had emerged from that win tired, and would not make Saratoga's Aug. 4 GI Whitney H. "He's starting to come out of his shell, and I don't think [the Vanderbilt] will be as taxing on him as the 1 1/8 miles of the Whitney," said Romans. "He's a horse that likes to run, and if nothing else, it would be a good prep for the Forego. He only has three or four more races left in his career, so we might as well get them." Shackleford, who has won five races between seven furlongs and 1 1/8 miles, will try six furlongs for the first time if he runs in the Vanderbilt. He would require a supplementary entry of \$8,000.

## Baker Sets Saratoga Targets...

Trainer Reade Baker, who is targeting Saratoga's GI Whitney H. Aug. 4 with **Hunters Bay** (Ghostzapper), and the same day's GI Prioress S. with ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Tu Endie Wei** (Johar), said he will work both horses this morning at Woodbine and ship to Saratoga Monday. "Everything's a go," Baker said from Toronto. "We'll have to find out what the weights are for the Whitney before we know for sure." Hunters Bay, a 5-year-old out of multiple graded stakes winner Smok'n Frolic (Smoke Glacken), has won three straight races at Woodbine. He took the May 26 GIII Eclipse S. over 1 1/16 miles on the Polytrack, and most recently was victorious in the July 1 GIII Dominion Day S. over 1 1/4 miles. Long-term goals for Hunters Bay include the Sept. 3 GI Woodward H. at Saratoga, the Oct. 6 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont, and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 3. Tu Endie Wei, a half-sister to 2010 Canadian Horse of the Year Biofuel (Stormin Fever), earned Rising Star status off a debut win last June in the My Dear S. at Woodbine, and went on to garner champion 2-year-old filly honors north of the border. She most recently finished third in the GIII Victory Ride S. July 7 at Belmont. "I think that she'll end up running her best races on dirt, not Polytrack," revealed Baker. "Given that she had some mucus [on Victory Ride day] and got shuffled at the start, that might have been the best race of her life." Baker said the filly would likely make one more start after the Prioress as a prep for the Nov. 2 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint.

## Successful Dan to Miss Whitney...

*Daily Racing Form* reports that Morton Fink's **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal) will miss an intended appearance in the GI Whitney H. next Saturday after trainer Charlie Lopresti noticed that the gelding had some filling in the pastern of his left front foreleg. The 6-year-old will van to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington today for further evaluation by Dr. Larry Bramlage. "He said he thinks he strained it, but without seeing the horse, he doesn't want me to breeze him or run him," Lopresti told the *Form*. "We don't see any tears. [Bramlage] is a little bit concerned that with the problems that [Successful Dan] has had, it'd be good for him to see him to make an honest evaluation." A winner of seven of his 11 career starts, Successful Dan defeated Whitney hopeful Fort Larned (E Dubai) in the GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill Downs May 4 and was most recently beaten three lengths into second as the 1-2 favorite in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. June 30.

"I've never seen a horse do the first three furlongs in :32, let alone the last three." The Green Flash will be run over five furlongs on the turf. Abrams noted the long term goal for Lakerville is the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint down the hill at Santa Anita Nov. 3. "I think he'll win it," he said.

We have given our two TDN crack handicappers, Brian DiDonato and Steve Sherack, a mythical \$1000 bankroll and told them they can bet no more than 5% of that on any given day at Saratoga on a straight win bet. The winner, at the end of the meet, gets \$100 in a TVG betting account, along with bragging rights until next July.

**DiDonato: Friday** - Scratched all the way through my alternates, leaving me at the mercy of the Sherack Express. A rough start and a promising Pletcher firster kept me safe from further abuse, however, and I'm thinking the momentum's about to shift.

**Today - Race 11 - CLM (\$20K), N2x, 3yo/up, 5 1/2f - #12 Towner (12-1)**

The reasons to like **Towner** fall so perfectly into place that it almost seems too good to be true. He debuted for trainer Darrin Miller for \$50,000 over the Keeneland Polytrack going 6 1/2 furlongs Apr. 20, and scored by a nose against a group that has flattered that performance in subsequent efforts. The then-Silverton Hill colorbearer tried to stretch out against a tough group of allowance foes on the turf at Churchill May 18, but faded after pressing the pace. Miller dropped the chestnut back in for \$30,000 sprinting on the dirt in Kentucky June 24 and, after some bad behavior in the gate and a rough trip proved too much to overcome (he was a distant fourth of six), Towner was haltered by Brad Cox for claiming powerhouse Midwest Thoroughbreds. Cox, who boasts a 31% win rate and a \$2.39 ROI off the claim according to *DRF Formulator*, clearly claimed a number of horses for this meet, presumably because of the inflated purses. From three previous runners at the stand--all off the claim for Midwest--Cox has a second and two thirds. Those considerations might be enough to entice a play at 12-1, but Towner's pedigree puts his appeal over the top. Out of the all-turf mare Piconeach (NZ), he's a half to Silverton's Havelock (Great Notion), a MGSW turf sprinter who ran poorly in his one try over a conventional main track. Towner should get plenty of pace to run at here, and he won't have to be half as good as his big brother to mow them all down late on a surface that he is very likely to prefer. **Play:** \$36 Win on #12 Towner (Turf Only). **Alternate 1:** Race 9 - \$20 Win on #2 Law of The Range (Turf Only) . **Alternate 2:** Race 8 - \$10 Win on #6 Dancing Winner (Turf Only).

**DiDonato Bankroll: \$850 - Record: 6-0-1-1**

**Sherack: Friday - Stage Street** was hammered down to even-money (what else is new; he was the 7-2 third-choice on the morning-line!) once the rains arrived, and ran a big one to finish a solid second after nearly tossing Leparoux courtesy of a very hard bump shortly after they sprung the latch... First "profitable" afternoon for DiDonato, who broke even on the day after ducking me at the windows.

**Today - Race 10 - GII Jim Dandy S., 3yo, 1 1/8m - #3 Atigun (8-1)**

Landed on **Atigun** after watching him train with authority all week in preparation of the GI Belmont S., and the son of Istan gave me quite a run for my money at 20-1. Love that McPeek decided to freshen him a bit since that solid third-place finish behind Union Rags and Paynter, and the Shortleaf Stable colorbearer seems to have come out of the effort in top form, posting four solid drills including a five-furlong bullet in 1:00 4/5 at the Spa July 21. Hard to make excuses for his performances at Oaklawn in the GII Rebel S. and GI Arkansas Derby earlier this term, but he just has the look of a late-developing 3-year-old, who is clearly on the improve in his last two starts. Expecting a very big performance if he doesn't fall too far back early. **Play:** \$35 Win. **Alternate 1:** Race 5 - \$30 Win on #5 Associate. **Alternate 2:** Race 6: \$10 Win on #6 Adriatic Spirit.

### BRITAIN FACES TRACK CLOSURES

Arena Leisure and Northern Racing yesterday announced that two of Britain's racecourses at Hereford and Folkestone are set to close at the end of the current season. While Hereford's termination is permanent, the company is looking at the possibility of re-instating Flat racing at Folkestone in the future. "Folkestone suffers from out-dated facilities and has been the subject of detailed discussion between the previous management, Arena Leisure, and Shepway District Council for several years now," the Group's Managing Director Tony Kelly explained. "Discussions will continue with Shepway District Council in the hope that there will be approval of development plans which would secure the future of the racecourse. If they succeed, work to reconfigure the racecourse could commence in 2013."

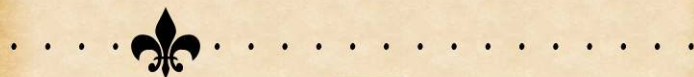
