



ALPHA PUNCHES TICKET TO TRAVERS

MR. HASKELL

Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert shoots for his record sixth win with GI Belmont S. runner-up and **"TDN Rising Star"** **Paynter** (Awesome Again) in today's GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. The Zayat Stables colorbearer has fired four straight bullets in Southern California since, including a six-furlong move in 1:11 4/5 over the Del Mar Polytrack July 23. Jockey Rafael Bejarano takes over the reins from Mike Smith on the 3-2 morning-line favorite. "Rafael has been on him numerous times for his works, and he knows him well," assistant trainer Jimmy Barnes commented. "He doesn't necessarily have to have the lead. In a small field like this, he'll play the breaks and see what happens. Once I give Rafael the leg up, it's up to him." Baffert has annexed the Jersey Shore's premier contest with Point Given (2001); War Emblem ('02); Roman Ruler ('05); Lookin At Lucky ('10); and Coil ('11).

Green B. Smith Jr's **Nonios** (Pleasantly Perfect), a strong second with a solid 102 Beyer Speed Figure in the GII Swaps S. at Betfair Hollywood Park July 4, has been very well-received since arriving to the Garden State. "He hasn't done a thing wrong since he got off the plane," Smith's racing manager/assistant trainer Christina Jelm said of the GIII Affirmed H. winner. "He's a classy horse." The dark bay makes his first start on traditional dirt here. "The exercise rider said he had good footing and was comfortable on [the Monmouth main track]," Jelm continued. "In the past, he worked bullets on the dirt at Pleasanton. Provided that everything sets up right in the race, I expect him to run very well."

WinStar Farm's **Gemologist** (Tiznow) began his career a perfect five-for-five, including the GI Wood Memorial at the Big A, but failed to land a blow when 16th in the GI Kentucky Derby last out. The bay has bullets for his return. "Gemologist is a very good horse and he is training extremely well," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "We are expecting a big effort from him."

With leading rider Ramon Dominguez aboard, Alpha jumped first from his rail draw and showed a new dimension by taking early control. Clear by a length through easy fractions of :24.40 and :49.30, Alpha put away **Teeth of the Dog** (Bluegrass Cat) at the top of the stretch and had plenty left in the tank to repel the bid of Churchill Downs shipper **Neck 'n Neck** (Flower Alley). "He was superb all the way around there," Dominguez offered. "Turning for home when I shook him up, he just took off for me. It's an indication he'll handle farther, and I love the way he was handling himself prior to and after the race." Alpha, a runaway debut winner at the Spa last summer, followed a second-place finish in the GI Champagne S. with a disappointing 11th after having a meltdown prior to the start in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. He dominated the New York scene this winter at the Big A after learning to keep his cool at the stalls, posting sharp victories in the Count Fleet S. Jan. 7 and the GIII Withers S. Feb. 4. Alpha ran his heart out to finish a close second in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7 prior to his effort on the First Saturday of May. He skipped the GI Belmont S. after spiking a temperature.

Fourth when trying to emulate her dam in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. at Keeneland in her sophomore finale Oct. 15, the homebred was back to her old self in the GIII Beaugay S. at Belmont May 5, and entered off a runner-up effort behind the loose-on-the-lead heroine Tapitsfly (Tapit) in the GI Just a Game S. June 9. Backed as the favorite here, Winter Memories sat in the clear in fourth as Tapitsfly and Law of the Range (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}) set relatively strong fractions of :23.31 and :47.56 over the rain-softened turf. As the latter began to tire on the turn, Winter Memories was forced to commence her rally a bit early while swinging three wide. But she quickly opened up a daylight advantage and, despite taking a few peeks at the grandstand during the stretch run, was always holding the game Dream Peace safe. "She is one very, very good horse, and we're proud to have her," winning owner John Phillips said. "I know one thing about her--she, like the rest of her family, will give her best. It's a wonderful quality, in people or horses. I almost didn't know how to handle [her having a clean trip]. She was four-wide and trouble-free, and I'm thinking, 'I'm not sure what's going to happen here!' It was quite a move that she made."

Sri Putra has long been in the shadow of some of the finest performers in the middle-distance category, but at times has had matters fall right below the top level and took advantage of that to win the 2008 G3 Solario S. at Sandown and the following year's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville. After a typically creditable fifth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot on his penultimate start June 20, the bay flopped on easy ground in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 7, and sported blinkers and a hood here. Also provided with a pacemaker in Pekan Star (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), he was held up early with only the slow-starting Jet Away (GB) (Dansili {GB}) behind as his stable companion set the necessary fractions. Short of room with three furlongs remaining, he was extricated soon after to chase Afsare and, after getting the better of that rival in the final 100 yards, was firmly in command at the line. "He's quite a classy animal who has had to mix it with the best," jockey Neil Callan said. "He's always run creditably, and the ground was too soft in the Eclipse--he really loves this ground and rattles off it. We are experimenting with the hood with a lot of horses, and it is really benefitting them." Afsare's jockey Kieren Fallon was downcast afterwards. "It is always disappointing when you get beaten like that--he drifted to the stand's rail because he was in front too soon and thought he'd done enough."

BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

DEAUVILLE'S DARLINGS

Previously known as the Prix d'Astarte, the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville offers the perfect mid-summer platform for Europe's top miling distaffers to strut their stuff and today's edition is a select affair to launch the month-long Normandy festival. Last year's top domestically trained fillies **Golden Lilac (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) have a trio of sophomores to hold at bay here, and the former needs to rebound from an uncharacteristically flat performance when beating only one rival in the G1 Falmouth S. Racing too keenly early on in that July 13 Newmarket contest, Gestut Ammerland's homebred--who has earned notable plaudits from trainer Andre Fabre--will have to settle better in what could prove another tactical affair here. Although she did win the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches over this trip at Longchamp last May, she has hinted that she needs further when adding the G1 Prix de Diane to her tally at Chantilly the following month and when outpointing Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan over an extended nine-furlong trip at Longchamp on her 4-year-old bow May 27. Richard Strauss's Immortal Verse was successful in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot last June and the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois over this track and trip in August before filling third spot in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. back at Ascot in October. Not seen since finishing seventh in Kyoto's G1 Mile Championship in November, the homebred may be a touch rusty on this belated comeback. Trainer Robert Collet told *PA Sport*, "It was not our intention to start her season so late, but she had a small problem at home. She is in good shape now, but it is her first race of the year and she is not quite in top form yet. She will improve for the run and hopefully after the Rothschild, she will have a good season." Of the 3-year-olds, Teruya Yoshida's **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality) stands out on her win in last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on Arc day and her return second on unsuitably soft ground in the Falmouth. She also has form at this track, having annexed the Listed Prix Six Perfections and G3 Prix du Calvados during last year's August festival and the drying conditions will boost her chances. "Although there are only five runners, they are all very good fillies," the owner's Racing Manager Patrick Barbe told *PA Sport*. "We were very happy with Elusive Kate's run at Newmarket and hopefully she will have improved. The ground will be no issue on Sunday, as I think it will be good ground and we know the mile is no issue either. It is going to be a tough race as all these fillies are at the top level."

PAST AND PRESENT

Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}), who caused an upset when beating the hot favorite Novellist (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) in the G1 Deutsches Derby July 1, bids to prove that was no fluke as he takes on his elders in today's G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich. Swooping wide away from the main action in that Hamburg Classic, Stall Antanando's colt, victorious in the G3 Herzog von Ratibor-Rennen at Krefeld in November will have to engage in battle here. Of the sophomores to have taken on their elders since 1990, only five have been successful, and it is also worth noting that no Derby winner has followed up here since it was opened up to older horses in 1985. Trainer Mario Hofer has other targets in mind. "The timing of this race is ideal, four weeks after the Derby and five weeks before the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, and I do not expect the drop back in distance to be a problem," he told the *Racing Post*. "The obvious danger is **Zazou (Ger)** (Shamardal), and I used to train him myself, so I know what a tough nut he is to crack, but there is very little between them." Zazou, who is now in the hands of Waldemar Hickst, was runner-up in the 2010 Deutsches Derby before plundering the following season's G1 Premio Roma. Ramzan Kadyrov's globe-trotter comes into this on the back of fifth and fourth placings in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup and May 20 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, respectively, and looks best of the older brigade ahead of last year's Derby hero **Waldpark (Ger)** (Dubawi {Ire}). He has been disappointing in the interim and has questions to answer after being nosed out by Ovambo Queen (Ger) (Kalatos {Ger}) in what looked an ideal opportunity to get back to winning ways in Hamburg's G2 Hansa-Preis over 12 furlongs last time July 3. Twelve months ago, Stall Tinsdal's **Durban Thunder (Ger)** (Samum {Ger}) was upsetting Famous Name (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in this race but has been well beaten in two subsequent starts and also has a seven-month lay-off to overcome after finishing last in Sha Tin's G1 Hong Kong Cup.

Canada's Filly Triple Crown concludes with today's restricted Wonder Where S., contested over 10 furlongs on Woodbine's turf course, and the winner of the second leg, Amerman Racing's Bison City S. heroine **Blue Heart** (Exchange Rate), figures to be favored by post time. Winner of the \$200,000 Mazarine S. facing open company last October, Blue Heart made a belated 2012 unveiling, running a closing second to **Dene Court** (City Zip) in the grassy Alywow S. going 6 1/2 furlongs at Woodbine June 3. Back on the main track for the July 1 Bison City, she rallied from just off the pace to defeat **Black Bird Rock** (Flower Alley) by 1 3/4 lengths. She renews rivalry with both that foe and with Dene Court, and as regards the latter, gets plenty more acreage to work with in the hopes of turning the tables. After the Alywow, Dene Court skipped the Bison City and instead stretched out for one-mile Ontario Damsel S. on the turf July 7, which she won in wire-to-wire fashion while earning a unique compliment from the chart caller: "toyed with them; easily." Still, the 10 furlongs remains a big question mark for the Eugene Melnyk colorbearer. **Part the Seas** (Stormy Atlantic) was a closing second in the Ontario Damsel; **Awesome Fire** (Strong Contender), a close-up third to Irish Mission (Giant's Causeway) and Northern Passion (Dixie Union) in the Woodbine Oaks June 3, was fourth in the Bison City and gets the services of the shipping-in Chantal Sutherland. **Cont. p12**

It's Tricky Breezes at Greentree...

Godolphin's MGISW **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft), a perfect three-for-three this term, including the GI Ogden Phipps H. last time May 28, worked :49 and change at Greentree Training Center Saturday, according to trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "She didn't go very fast, she didn't go in company, but she went great," McLaughlin reported. "The real neat thing is that she galloped out real strongly. She often does not, so that was a real good sign." It's Tricky is under consideration for either the GI Ballerina S. at seven furlongs Aug. 24 or the GI Personal Ensign going nine furlongs Aug. 26. "Most likely the [Personal Ensign], but you never know," McLaughlin added. "There's a chance if there's a four-horse field in the [Ballerina] we'll go in that direction, but we'll most likely go long. We'll talk with [Godolphin racing manager] Simon Crisford."

Jamaican Smoke Breezes for Prioress...

Glencrest Farm's **Jamaican Smoke** (Latent Heat), second in the July 7 GIII Victory Ride S. at Belmont, worked four furlongs over the Saratoga main track in :49.51 yesterday in preparation of an intended start in the GI Prioress S. at Saratoga Aug. 4. The 3-year-old filly pleased trainer Eddie Kenneally with her effort in the Victory Ride when beaten 2 3/4 lengths after attending fast fractions in her first try in stakes company. "She ran well [in the Victory Ride]," said Kenneally. "She got caught up in a speed duel but didn't quit in the lane. She was very gallant and kept running to the wire. She's an inexperienced filly, but that race should help her from an experience standpoint." Jamaican Smoke has hit the board in all four starts. After finishing third on debut Mar. 14 in maiden-special-weight company at Gulfstream Park, she broke her maiden over the Keeneland Polytrack Apr. 19. She stepped up successfully to allowance company May 25 at Churchill Downs, beating older fillies and mares by 4 1/4 lengths.

Sea Island to Alabama...

Phipps Stable's **Sea Island** (Pulpit), 15-1 winner of a competitive allowance event for fillies and mares Thursday at Saratoga, will have her next outing in the GI Alabama S. at the Spa Aug. 18. Among the horses finishing in the 3-year-old filly's wake were last year's GII Delaware Oaks winner St. John's River (Include), and 2010 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. winner Acting Happy (Empire Maker), both Grade I-placed. Sea Island showed marked improvement from her prior start, a fourth-place finish in the July 7 GIII Victory Ride S. "The one thing I do know about [Sea Island] is that she'll go that far," said trainer Shug McGaughey in reference to the 1 1/4 miles of the Alabama. "I'm not too sure some of the other ones want to run that far. The good thing about her is that if she breaks well, she can place herself where a horse like Questing [Hard Spun] is not going to get away from her. She wouldn't have so much ground to make up. I'm looking forward to it. She'll go back to the track tomorrow, and hopefully all systems will be go." Prior to the Victory Ride, Sea Island compiled back-to-back wins in an Apr. 13 maiden special weight at Aqueduct and in optional claiming company May 13 at Belmont.

THE INEXACT SCIENCE BLINDS US AGAIN

If the showcase of racing--black-type events--are meant to provide the key to the breeding of superior racehorses, then we all may well end up in the nut house. I know two and two often make five in racing; there comes a time when it doesn't add up at all.

Or am I a victim of fashion and believe that certain stallions are just so far out of vogue they cannot possibly get major winners? This is dangerous, especially if you like a wager, because the rule is there are no rules and any stallion can get one.

Take Saturday's superior racing in Sydney, where the 1600-meter, weight-for-age, A\$100,000 Listed Winter Challenge was won by 5-year-old Spinnawitch, a daughter of Country Reel. Yes, *that* Country Reel, whose last figures I saw record 10 winners out of 100 starters, or 10%, a figure that would send any stud master--let alone Sheikh Mohammed, who I believe still owns him--around the bend.

Therefore, it will come as no shock that Spinnawitch's Saturday win makes her the first stakes winner for Country Reel in Australia, where he got 93 live foals and stood for two seasons, shuttled by Darley with some initial fanfare for the royally bred son of Danzig.

Since then, things have improved marginally for the Gimcrack winner--whose mother was sired by the mighty Seattle Slew--getting five stakes horses in France without, might I say, setting the world on fire.

But Saturday, his daughter did him proud, and her owner/breeder Denise McGrath, a former trainer, couldn't care less that her mare's dad is less than popular. For Ms. McGrath, she is the apple of her eye, and in the first flush of joy after the mile win was talking Group 1 mare races over the Flemington carnival.

A leap of faith, yes, but that is what feeds this business; that is its oxygen. Ms. McGrath's cheers as Spinnawitch, out of a Zabeel mare, picked up the handy field at the 100-meter mark of the Warwick Farm track and ran away to win by two lengths will last much longer than the howl of despair of breeders who tried Country Reel with their mares for no result.

Earlier at the Farm, another imported stallion, Street Sense, followed up his stakes double in the U.S. with a nice 2-year-old winner Urquidez, who made light of the slow going, coming from second last to win going away in the 1100-meter race. **Cont. p15**

The oddly named colt was a boost for Street Sense, who hasn't figured here as a sire of 2-year-olds and has probably been misjudged as a getter of running youngsters because of his own record. The mistake we all made is that the Street Senses would be precocious, when in fact as a son of Street Cry, he is made of much sterner stuff.

Urquidez and Spinnawitch have a connection: they come out of the same stable, that of Jarrod Austin, who before Saturday I had heard little of. But now, if he can train a stakes winner by Country Reel, particularly second-up after a long spell, then we should all stand and salute the beginning of a major career.

Down south at Caulfield, the trainer of Ready To Rip, winner of the best race of the day, the A\$125,000 G3 Bletchingly S. over 1200 meters, Peter Moody needs no introduction. The big guy moved well past 200 winners for the season, and recorded his 599th lifetime winner in conjunction with 2012 Melbourne premiership jockey Luke Nolen with Ready To Rip.

The story of this horse encapsulates the vagaries of racing, and sometimes how easy it is to stay on top rather than the never ceasing battle to get there. Ready To Rip fell into Moody's lap not that long ago, sent to him by a Queensland owner who thought his horse was good enough for the champion trainer.

Even better than this good fortune, the relatively lightly raced 4-year old gelding is bred in the purple, by super-sire More Than Ready out of the Danehill mare Lady Langham, a cross-mating of our most proactive sprint influences and already the blood partnership in five of More Than Ready's best stakes winners here, including Golden Slipper hero Sebring.

Having already won a listed race at his first start for Moody, it was a surprise that punters went off Ready To Rip in the lead up to the Bletchingly letting him drift slightly pre-post from \$3 to \$4.60. Perhaps that was because a horse called Green Birdie (Catbird) was also in the field. Unlucky at his first start back from Hong Kong, the former star--after all he once beat Rocket Man--considered then the world's best, had drawn inside where he would get every chance.

He did, but ran fourth, the 8-year-old never had a chance to reel in the fast-finishing Moody gift horse. Perhaps that is a bit hard--Moody would say he got the horse because of his record, built on success that comes only from tireless toil.

To a degree he is right, and after all, Moody has won two stakes races from just two starts with the horse. But you just can't imagine the same thing happening to battlers like Jarrod Austin or Denise McGrath.

Maybe after Saturday's double, all that will change.

We have given our two TDN crack handicappers, Brian DiDonato and Steve Sherack, a mythical \$1000 bankroll and told them they can bet no more than 5% of that on any given day at Saratoga on a straight win bet. The winner, at the end of the meet, gets \$100 in a TVG betting account, along with bragging rights until next July.

DiDonato: Saturday - I think I scared my neighbors with an audible shriek after checking changes and seeing that my top pick was scratched again, but felt a bit better later after the nightcap came off the turf--**Towner** was a 'turf only' play, and I'll be keeping an eye out for his name in the entries as the meet wears on. Speculative alternate **Law of The Range** looked terrible at every point in the Diana, and I wonder if they brought her here in search of firmer going--they certainly didn't get it. Does anyone want to give me a price on getting shut out for the meet? That might be the only bet I could cash right now.

Today - Today - 10 - GII Amsterdam S. - #3 Unbridled's Note (8-1)

My first glance at this field made me think it would be a 'pass' race both here and in my personal wagering, but upon further review, I think the favorites might be vulnerable. Currency Swap could be the toughest to dismiss, as his recent runner-up effort behind Trinniberg in the GII Woody Stephens looks excellent on paper and comes up with a very fast pace on the Moss Pace Figure scale and a solid 102 Beyer. But that race was run as a total merry-go-round, with the 1-2-3 finishers traveling that way from start to finish. I didn't like Currency Swap's 3-year-old form coming into the Woody Stephens, so I'm going to take that last race as the exception rather than the rule. Doctor Chit has done little wrong this year, but he didn't face much resistance in the Western Larla S. last time against a very suspect field. Fort Loudon's defeat of Trinniberg in the GIII Carry Back at Calder last time was simply too much of an improvement for me to take it at face value--especially at a quirky venue like Calder. It doesn't help that trainer Nick Zito has been very cold so far at the Spa. Gun Boat looks good on paper, but his big-fig allowance win last time came on Betfair Hollywood Park's synthetic surface, and Bob Baffert's ROI in graded stakes here over the past five years is \$0.81 (courtesy of DRF Formulator). That leaves **Unbridled's Note** as the best alternative. He has done nothing wrong in two career sprints, and took a reasonably tough and paceless Churchill allowance last time while displaying some greenness. He should get the right set-up here, and offers by far the most upside at what should be an attractive price. **Play:** \$20 Win. **Alternate 1:** Race 2 - \$10 Win on #6 No Nukes. **Alternate 2:** Race 7 - \$10 Win on #7 Desert Storm (Turf Only).

DiDonato Bankroll: \$830 - Record: 7-0-1-1

Sherack: Saturday - Seriously, Leparoux? **Atigun** looked loaded throughout while getting completely strangled for the majority of the Jim Dandy, but came up empty in the stretch to finish a disappointing sixth. Bombs away in the Travers with a new rider.

Today - Race 9 - Nani Rose S., 3yo, f, 1mT - #2 Alaura Michele (12-1)

Concerned about the condition of the turf course after all of the rain Saturday, but hoping this one stays on the lawn. **Alaura Michele** looked like she could be any kind last year after transferring to the Bill Mott barn and switching to grass. The Siena Farms homebred was a bit headstrong when impressively wiring Belmont maidens going six furlongs in late June (shaded :12 in her final eighth), then showed the ability to settle and pounce when annexing the P. G. Johnson S. in style over the Saratoga lawn Aug. 31. Those two victories stamped Alaura Michele as a leading candidate for the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Churchill Downs, but the wheels came off at 3-5 over a soft going in Belmont's GIII Miss Grillo S. Oct. 2, and she hasn't faced the starter since. Love that Mott has the confidence to kick off her sophomore campaign in this aggressive spot, and the steady worktab, dating back to mid-April at Payson, should give her a nice foundation to fire in her first try off the bench. It won't be an easy task for Alaura Michele facing the likes of Grade 1 winner Karlovly Vary, but if she runs back to the promise that she flashed as a juvenile, Mr. Mott will be celebrating his 59th birthday in style. **Play:** \$20 Win (Turf Only). **Alternate 1:** Race 4 - \$20 Win (Turf Only) on #7 Why Not More. **Alternate 2:** Race 10 - \$20 Win on #6 Politicallycorrect.

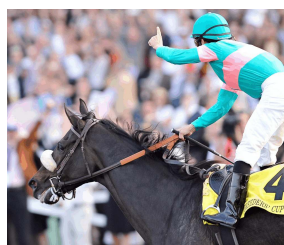



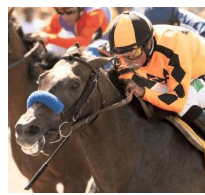
