I went into the Stephen Foster with a pretty horse--I didn't have a racehorse. So, he didn't run much that day. **TAKE ME HOME, COUNTRY ROADS**

The marquee name in today's \$750,000 GII West Virginia Derby is **Hansen** (Tapit), last year's champion juvenile who shrugged off a ninth-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby to dominate the GIII Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows

June 30. As the lone Grade I winner in the field, the nearly white colt is eligible for a \$150,000 bonus if he makes it to the winner's circle. Lord Lloyd-Webber's The Fugue, impressive when annexing the G3 Musidora S. at York May 16, was deemed unlucky not to have won the June 1 G1 Epsom Oaks, in which she was third to **Was (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), before finishing a game second on unsuitably easy ground in the G2 Ribblesdale S. over 12 furlongs at Royal Ascot June 21. "The season comes fast for those 3-year-old fillies, but The Fugue's been freshened and is in great order now," Gosden said. "I think a mile and a quarter is absolutely fine for her, but she does want to see proper summer ground. Izzi Top wouldn't want real fast ground, as she is hugely powerful and is bigger than most colts and, because of her sheer weight, likes a little give." William Buick has opted to stay faithful to Izzi Top and outlined what a hard call it was to side with her. "It was very tough to get off The Fugue," Buick said. "I am very aware that I might have made the wrong decision, but I will have to wait and see, and I hope I am right on the day. In terms of pure ability, I don't see there is anything between them. I think right now, Izzi Top is a better filly. In time, The Fugue will be every bit as good as Izzi Top, and she might be better. I think whatever order they finish in, they'll be one and two." Sheikh Ahmed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Nahrain (GB)** (Selkirk) returns to the trip over which she won the G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp in October, having disappointed on her comeback over a mile in the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 20. She was runner-up in the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf in between and is not short on stamina. "She was a bit rusty at Ascot, but seems to have come on a lot for the run," trainer Roger Varian commented. "She has really come to herself and looks in great condition. Her work has been very good, and we are hoping for a good run from her." Last year's G1 Falmouth S. winner **Timepiece (GB)** (Zamindar) has big questions to answer following two lackluster efforts when fourth and eighth, respectively, behind Izzi Top in the Dahlia and Middleton, but has been given a break to help and hails from the in-form Sir Henry Cecil stable. "She has turned a corner after looking pretty disappointing earlier in the season and everyone seems much more pleased with her--she is working better and moving much better," Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said.

and Pimlico's Miss Preakness S. May 18. "Your guess is as good as mine [as to why she ran poorly in the Victory Ride]," trainer Rudy Rodriguez commented. "I'm still looking for it. I'm going to [draw a line through the race]. Hopefully, she'll do it, too. That's what we're trying to do. We'll pretend it was a bad dream. It was kind of disappointing, but thankfully she came back good, and we'll keep our fingers crossed. Hopefully, she'll show up when we run her." Emma's Encore will be much lower than the 39-1 odds she delivered at in the Victory Ride. "[Emma's Encore will] have to do even better if she's going to get this one," Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens admitted. "You never know how the track is going to play, if it's going to be playing speed. That's why they don't win them all, but you got to take a chance. If she could do it, it'd be some feather in her cap, a Grade I." Tu Endie Wei, a multiple stakes winner over Woodbine's Polytrack, stumbled at the start, and looked loaded for bear while making her first start on dirt in the Victory Ride, but flattened out in the stretch to finish third, beaten three lengths. "I think that she'll end up running her best races on dirt, not Polytrack," trainer Reade Baker said of the Brereton Jones homebred. "Given that she had some mucus that day and got shuffled at the start [in the Victory Ride], that might have been the best race of her life."

Jay Em Ess Stable's **Include Me Out** (Include) will bid to start a new winning streak this afternoon in the \$300,000 GI Clement L. Hirsch S. at Del Mar. A maiden winner over this surface 12 months ago, the dark bay posted consecutive victories in the GII La Canada S. and GI Santa Margarita at Santa Anita before adding the GII Marjorie Everett H. at Betfair Hollywood Park, but her skein came to an end when caught near the wire of the GI Vanity at the Inglewood oval June 16.

"She pulled herself up," trainer Ron Ellis told *Daily Racing Form*. "You can't judge her off her last race." Joe Talamo, who booted home five winners on Thursday's card, retains the mount aboard the 4-year-old. The admirable **Switch** (Quiet American), twice a Grade I winner at seven panels, was a close third in last year's renewal of this event. She recently returned to form with a rallying score in the GII A Gleam H. July 14, but must demonstrate that she is as effective around two turns. Trainer Neil Drysdale fields Chilean invader **Amani (Chi)** (Morning Raider {Ire}). The Haras Sumaya homebred has been virtually unstoppable in her native land--the phrase "much the best" is the form comment in eight of her 10 career wins--but she has not faced the starter since Dec. 17. The August-born bay trounced colts by 5 3/4 lengths in the G1 St Leger Cristal S. that day, and will be piloted by Garrett Gomez, who rode Switch last out.

At the close of this recently upgraded contest, which proved to be a typically dramatic Goodwood encounter, Trumpet Major and Archbishop proved inseparable in the photo. Whether either would have prevailed had the desperately unlucky third-placed Aljamaaheer (Ire) (Dubawi (Ire) enjoyed a clear run in the closing stages is debatable, but Trumpet Major was carrying a four-pound penalty, while Archbishop is an unexposed colt who is on a steep upward curve. The former was impressive when winning last year's G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster and the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket on his 3-year-old bow Apr. 19. After a highly creditable fourth in the May 5 G1 2000 Guineas back at the latter venue, he returned under the weather when beating no rivals in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later. Archbishop jumped straight from handicap to pattern company last time and was 1 1/4-lengths second to Xanadou (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) in the G3 Prix Paul de Moussac over this trip at Chantilly June 9. Richard Hughes kept Trumpet Major under wraps against the fence in mid-division before creeping closer on the final turn. As Frankie Dettori asked Archbishop to stretch approaching the final furlong, he soon took the lead but that was short-lived as Trumpet Major cruised alongside and headed him with 100 yards remaining only to be joined again on the line. Aljamaaheer met serious traffic on the inside just in behind and finished full of run on his first try at this trip. "I had to burn some petrol to get a good spot, and coming round the turn I was able to re-group, but when I saw Richard [Hughes] was going twice as well, I had to try everything to get him off the bridle," Dettori explained. "Once I did, the game was on and both horses really tried. It's the first time I've ridden him, and he had every chance to throw the towel in but didn't." Hughes said of Trumpet Major, "They went very hard up front and it's the four-pound penalty more than lack of stamina which made the difference," Hughes said. "I just sat for five strides when I got to Frankie, as that last furlong here feels like an eternity. He is up to Group 1 standard--I went a strong, even pace making all in the Guineas and he just weakened in the last 100 meters, so he's better being ridden more patiently and you can put a line through his Curragh run, as he was sick."

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### Sights of the Spa...

Shivananda Parbhoo's **Trinniberg** (Teufflesberg) tuned up for the GI Foxwoods King's Bishop S. Aug. 25 by breezing a half-mile in :49.41 under jockey Willie Martinez over the Oklahoma training track Friday morning. Winner of the GII Woody Stephens S., GIII Bay Shore S. and GIII Swale S. earlier this year, the bay colt shipped up from his Florida base shortly after finishing second by a neck in the GII Carry Back S. at Calder July 7. "His regular rider was aboard him, and we told him we didn't want anything faster than :49," said Parbhoo, whose father Bisnath conditions the speedy colt. "He went in 49.41, which is perfect. [Martinez] didn't move a muscle. He came back happy and went straight to his feed. They'll have to try to catch him [in the King's Bishop]." A debut winner at Calder last summer, Trinniberg was sent off at 5-1 in the GII Saratoga Special S., but backed up and wound up a distant fifth to Union Rags (Dixie Union). He was subsequently dismissed at 68-1 in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Saratoga's closing day and was a grudging second to Currency Swap (High Cotton) in that premier event for juveniles, where the also-rans included I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). "[Trinniberg] ran a big race in the Hopeful, and half of the field has come back to do big things," Parbhoo added.

This year's renewal of the Saratoga Special Aug. 12 is shaping up as a competitive affair. **Carried Interest** (Henny Hughes), a game winner at first asking for Klaravich Stables and William H. Lawrence at Belmont July 5, looks to be tough to beat. He earned a 90 Beyer Speed Figure in his career opener. "He's doing great," said trainer Rick Violette Jr. "He ran very fast, it looks like he beat some very nice horses in the race, and all systems are go. He's shown quite a bit of talent, he's gotten dirt in his face, he's done everything well. He's got a great brain." Also eyeing the Saratoga Special is **In Harm's Way** (Hook and Ladder), who thumped New York-breds by 4 3/4 lengths in his second downstate start July 15. "Becky Thomas had this horse in Ocala, and she told me this horse can do good things," said Mike Hushion, who trains the homebred colt for Mary and Chester Broman. In Harm's Way is out of an A.P. Indy mare, and Hushion is looking forward to stretching his charge out. "His gallop-out was big the day he won," Hushion added. "I think 6 1/2 [furlongs] is an edge for us."

**CHURCHILL FALL STAKES SCHEDULE WORTH \$1.825 MILLION** Churchill Downs announced that the \$400,000 GI Clark H. will top its stakes schedule for the fall meet, which will take place Oct. 28-Nov. 25. The Clark's purse dipped from \$500,000 in 2011. The stakes schedule, consisting of 12 races, will be worth \$1.825 million. The meeting will kick off with the "Stars of Tomorrow I" card filled with juvenile events, including the \$150,000 GII Pocahontas S. and \$100,000 GIII Iroquois S. The famed oval will have night racing Nov. 17, a day that will feature the \$175,000 GII Mrs. Revere S. and \$100,000 GIII Commonwealth Turf S. On the penultimate day of the autumn meeting Nov. 24, Churchill will host the "Stars of Tomorrow II" card, topped by the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and GII Golden Rod S., each worth \$150,000. The Kentucky Jockey Club winner will receive automatic nominations to the 2013 GI Kentucky Derby and GIII Derby Trial S., while the Golden Rod heroine will automatically be nominated to the GI Kentucky Oaks and GIII Eight Belles S.

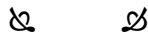

**NATIONAL HBPA SUPPORTING LASIX**

The National Horsemen’s Benevolent and Protective Association announced that 24 of its state-affiliates--representing approximately 29,000 owners and trainers--have passed formal Board of Directors Resolutions supporting the continued regulated use of race-day furosemide for racehorses. The 24 affiliates are Arizona, Arkansas, British Columbia, Charles Town, Finger Lakes, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mountaineer Park, Nebraska, New England, Ohio, Oklahoma, Ontario, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Tampa, Virginia, and Washington. “These Affiliate Board Resolutions demonstrate to one and all that the vast majority of owners and trainers in the United States and Canada support the use of race-day Lasix,” stated Robin Richards, the Chair and President of the National HBPA. “Owners and trainers who are at the barn every day, dealing directly with their horses know that Lasix is a safe, effective and beneficial medication for the prevention and treatment of EIPH.”

Phil Hanrahan, the organization’s CEO, added, “The scientific research incontestably establishes that Lasix allows a horse to only run to its God-given potential; not faster than its potential. The NHBPA challenges any organization or individual that supports a ban on race-day Lasix to provide us, and the Thoroughbred racing industry as a whole, with scientific support for their position that race-day Lasix should be banned because Lasix is detrimental to the horse.”

**SARATOGA DEBUT FOR COTEAU GROVE**

Keith and Ginger Myers’ Coteau Grove Farms will be represented by its first Saratoga sales yearling Monday when **Lundi Gras** (Empire Maker--Lady of Peace, by Lord at War {Arg}), a filly bred by the Louisiana-based operation, goes through the Fasig-Tipton ring as [hip 15](#) through the Four Star Sales consignment.

Founded in 2008, Coteau Grove is the fulfillment of a lifelong dream for Keith Myers.

“We skipped a generation,” Myers explains when asked how he got into the racing game. “My grandfather was involved in horse racing in Louisiana and, as a child, I grew up in the middle of that. Every chance I had, I would be at his farm with he and my grandmother or at the racetrack.

“My dad was a farmer and he didn’t have the wherewithal to get in the horse business, but I would stay at the track every chance I got--I just loved the horses,” Myers continued. “In my mind, ever since I was a little kid, the dream was to one day be in the horse business like my grandpa was, even at that level.”

In 1994, the husband and wife team founded the LHC Group “around the kitchen table.” The health care company grew from a start-up company to a publicly traded company in 2005, providing Myers the opportunity to fulfill that dream.

“We had some good fortune in business, and my wife and I had the opportunity to buy a couple hundred acres of land and then build a farm and actually live on a farm just like my grandparents, so it’s like every day of my life, I am living the whole dream come true,” Myers said. “I never thought I would be able to do it at this level. It is definitely what makes me tick every day. It’s a shame, but it’s almost like now I do my day job to support my habit of horse racing. I am sure I am not alone in that.”

The Myerses were hooked from the start. “The first year we got into it, we bought a couple of mares, but we loved it so much we bought more property and expanded and now we are all-in, so to speak,” Myers explained. “We have a full-time staff at the farm and we have our own full-time staff trainer.

“Our objective is to have top-quality mares bred to top stallions that are capable at running in open company at every level, but we stick within the Louisiana program because it is just a great fall-back position if you get one that can’t make it to that level. The Louisiana-bred program is quite lucrative.”

Myers, who was recently elected to the board of the Louisiana Breeders’ Association, thinks Coteau Grove Farms has positioned itself in the middle of Louisiana’s burgeoning Thoroughbred breeding industry.

“I just see a whole new level of business thought and seriousness to the business that wasn’t there before,” Myers commented. “It seemed like, in the past, people in Louisiana were in the horse business more as a hobby than a real for-profit business entity, and now I see that shifting. We have a five-year business plan for the farm and a budget, just like we have for our public health care company, and that is something my grandfather never had.”

The revitalization of the Louisiana breeding industry has attracted higher profile stallions and has meant an increased presence by Louisiana buyers at Kentucky’s major sales, according to Myers.

“Louisiana used to be thought of as a market where the horses were all just cheap speed horses and so the stallions that would stand in Louisiana were stallions that just couldn’t make it anywhere else,” Myers commented. “Now I am seeing better stallions coming into the state and the bar will be raised again next year. We just had Closing Argument come to Louisiana, D’wildcat is coming in--five years ago, none of that was going on. I look around, I see everybody raising their game. I really believe in the very near future you are going to see Louisiana-breds represented in some of the biggest races in the country--I can see that happening. We are going to Kentucky and buying mares in Book 1 and Book 2, that is where you have to be. In Louisiana five years ago, no one would show up until Book 6 or 7.”

Instead of relying on free agents, Myers has set up a team of individuals dedicated solely to the success of Coteau Grove, and he thinks that has paid dividends.

“I moved to a permanent annual elite relationship with Sid Fernando at Werk Thoroughbreds, so we use them,” Myers said. “They exclusively do all of our analysis and our recommendations to help us decide what we want to buy and then I use an agent representative do the buying for me and I pay them a flat fee.”

Coteau Grove horses are all trained by Pat Devereux, Jr., who also serves as the organization’s racing manager.

“We started giving horses to trainers on a day rate in the beginning,” Myers explained. “But we wanted to have a lot of horses and try to groom horses for the long-term. So we changed our plans and hired Pat Devereux as our full-time in-house trainer who is on a salary--he doesn’t have any other clients, it’s just us. That has really changed the quality of our operation. Last year, we saw a real jump in average earnings per start. So that has worked well for us.”

Myers has plenty of praise for the Coteau Grove team.

“Pat spends his whole day looking at claiming races across the country,” he said. “He is nicking mares with stallions, he is doing all of that. And Annie Bourque, who has loved horses her whole life, she runs the farm, does all the record keeping and is hands on at the farm, six days a week--but we can't keep Annie out of there even on Sundays.”

Coteau Grove Farms, based in the town of Sunset, currently has a broodmare band of 15, but Myers envisions that number will grow to 20 in the next few years. It also has 21 horses in training.

Myers is prepared to race, sell or breed as the market dictates. Those market conditions led to Lundi Gras' entry into the Saratoga sale. The filly is out of Lady of Peace (Lord at War {Arg}), a mare the Myerses acquired for \$45,000 out of the 2008 Keeneland November sale.

“This is a for-profit business, so we will take profit wherever it presents itself,” Myers explained. “In this case, we have an Empire Maker, Clear Sailing, who is a broodmare on the farm. And Lundi Gras is an Empire Maker filly who would be extremely valuable to us if we didn't have Clear Sailing, so with the current market value of all the Empire Makers, it gives us an opportunity to turn a profit on that horse. When you see that opportunity, you have to take it, strictly from a business perspective. There are good investments that are made in the horse business, but some people fall into that trap of falling in love with them. You have that window of opportunity when you can make a buck on a horse, but if you don't, it's too late.”

To that end, Myers admits he does have another policy.

“I keep my wife from feeding peppermints to the ones that could be a profit center--we put them at the back of the farm and don't let her develop a relationship with them,” he laughed.

Myers admitted he is excited about having his first representative in the Saratoga sale.

“I don't think there have been many fillies of that quality coming out of Louisiana and going to Saratoga,” he said. “Louisiana wasn't thought of as having that quality of breeding. I have a lot of Louisiana pride, the whole being part of the Louisiana-bred program and now being on the board, it feeds all of that Louisiana pride. We're very proud of our heritage and where we are from. So if it makes Louisiana look good, it makes me feel really good.”

Coteau Grove Farms is active in every facet of the industry. After selling at Saratoga, Myers expects to be an active buyer at the OBS August and Keeneland September sale.

“We are buying and selling, we claim horses that we see that have good pedigrees that could be broodmares, so we're doing it at all levels,” Myers said. “The only thing we're not doing right now, we don't currently own a position in a stallion, but we're looking and by next season, we will have an ownership position in a stallion in Louisiana.”

While Coteau Grove Farms is all business, Myers admits it is still a labor of love for the couple.

“Ginger and I wouldn't be in the business if we didn't live on the farm,” he said. “Every morning and every afternoon, it is in our backyard. It's a 200-acre block of property, but our house in the middle of it. So we are out there with the mares and the babies and when it is foaling season, Ginger is out there helping deliver the babies in the middle of the night. If this were located even a few miles down the road from our house, we certainly wouldn't get as much enjoyment out of it. I don't know if we would have done it at this level.”

I simply don't see much separation between the runners in this field, and think **Disco On's** actual chances of winning will be significantly better than his odds will reflect--I'm expecting much higher than his 12-1 morning-line quote. He's extremely dirtied up on paper thanks to rough trips, and he returns to the one-mile distance he hasn't tried since breaking his maiden in his first turf try at 52-1 at Aqueduct last November. Disco On finished out his 2-year-old term with two somewhat surprisingly competitive efforts on the dirt in New York-bred stakes company, but ultimately made his way back to what figures to be his preferred surface. He went seven panels at Belmont June 3 in the NYSS Spectacular Bid S. and had made a ridiculous wide, premature move before finishing ninth, beaten 21. Subsequently stretched out to nine furlongs on soft turf June 23, the bay failed to settle as they crawled up front, and pulled himself up to press three-wide without cover before again dropping far out of it late. Back to seven furlongs July 14, Disco On enjoyed a nice pocket journey--but he wasn't "empty" as the short-form comment states--he was totally shut off at the top of the stretch and just couldn't quite get back into the game in time after losing momentum, settling for fourth. He did gallop out very well, however. The two runners that finished directly ahead of Disco On return here as do a number of similar-looking horses from higher-profile connections, but to dismiss him as less than on par with this field off his recent trips would be a big mistake--he just might pull off something like his graduation shocker. **Play:** \$20 Win (Turf Only). **Alternate 1:** Race 5 - \$20 Win on #10 Fredericksburg (Turf Only). **Alternate 2:** Race 2 - \$20 Win on #10 Speight Ofitall.

Expecting a top-shelf performance from GI Donn H. hero **Hymn Book** in today's main event. The Stuart Janney III homebred will have more than enough pace to run at, and should thrive on the return to two turns following a razor sharp second to Mucho Macho Man after an unkind break in the GII Suburban H. at Belmont July 7. He was given plenty of time to refocus following mediocre performances in the GII Oaklawn H. and GIII Pimlico Special S., and the strategy appears to have done the trick. Shug certainly knows what it takes to win this contest, and the price should be generous enough with plenty of others figuring to take a good deal of action at the windows. 

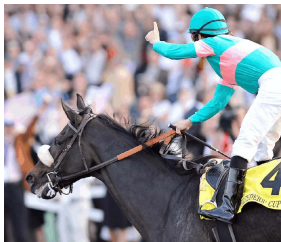

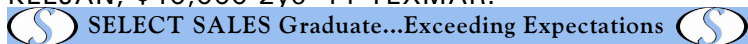
