### BOISTEROUS LOOKING TO MAKE SOME NOISE

Phipps Stable's **Boisterous** (Distorted Humor) was installed the lukewarm morning-line 4-1 favorite and faces an internationally flavored group in Saturday's GI Arlington Million, a "Win and You're In" event for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The dark bay should have no trouble working out a trip from the two hole and will have Jose Lezcano in the irons for the first time.

Boisterous, scheduled to arrive in Chicago today, tuned up for the Million with a strong half-mile breeze over the Oklahoma turf course at Saratoga in :47 3/5 this past Monday. **Crackerjack King (Ire)** (Shamardal) was the toast of Italy

at two and three, with four consecutive wins to kick off his career, including the G2 Derby Italiano last May. The grey decisioned **Afsare (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) by a clear-cut 2 1/2 lengths when they squared off in the G1 Gran Premio Presidente d'Repubblica May 13, but he was no better than a midpack fifth behind Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown July 7. Crackerjack King races prominently and can get first 'crack' at the expected pacesetters **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) and **Rahystrada** (Rahy). Field p3

### BODEMEISTER SENT TO ROOD AND RIDDLE

Zayat Stable and Michel and Tiffany Moreno's **"TDN Rising Star" Bodemeister** (Empire Maker) has been sent from the California stable of Bob Baffert for observation and testing at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital near Lexington, Kentucky. When asked what might be ailing the colt, Justin Zayat, racing manager, said via email, "We have no clue. That is why we sent him to Rood [and] Riddle to get a full physical. No one can figure out what is wrong with him. He just has not been traveling well. We are hoping by the end of the week we will have an answer."

Winner of the GI Arkansas Derby in spectacular fashion, Bodemeister led deep into the final furlong of the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. before being run down each time by I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). Connections decided to pass on the GI Belmont S. and targeted the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park July 29. However, Bodemeister spiked a fever and was withdrawn from that event, ultimately won by stablemate Paynter (Awesome Again). Bodemeister has not had a recorded work since breezing five furlongs in 1:01 at Santa Anita July 8.

Dropping back in trip here after a latest third in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris over 12 furlongs at Longchamp July 14, Saint Baudolino duly swamped his rivals with a smart spell of acceleration and lad home a one-two for his owner and trainer in the process. After his prior pattern-race success in the G3 Prix de Guiche over nine furlongs at Chantilly May 11, the bay was runner-up in the blanket finish to the G1 Prix du Jockey Club over 1 5/16 miles at Chantilly June 3 before his Bastille Day outing. Restrained in fifth early by Maxime Guyon as the British raider Rewarded (GB) (Motivator {GB}) took the field along, he was full of run in early stretch with his jockey confidently poised as another Brit Starboard (GB) (Zamindar) dueled with the long-time leader up front. Swooping on that duo approaching the furlong marker, the homebred rolled clear for an emphatic score from his Prix Jean Prat-winning stable companion G1 Aesop's Fables. "This is a nice result, but the form going into the race meant that any other result would have been disappointing," Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "We will have to talk to Sheikh Mohammed and Andre Fabre, but he has lots of options."

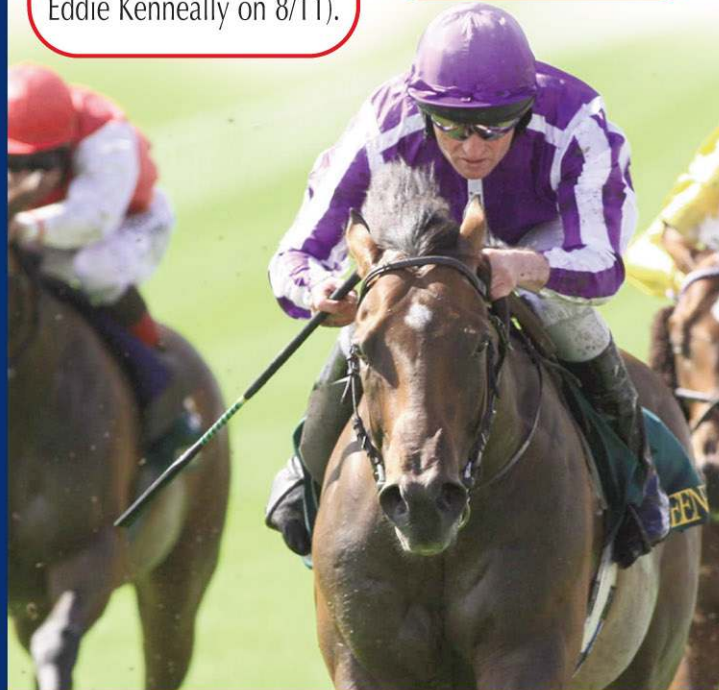

Reigning Eclipse Award-winning older male **Acclamation** (Unusual Heat) will likely not defend his title in the GI TVG Pacific Classic after emerging from a Monday gallop with slight swelling in the area of the

left front ankle. "Three days ago we were thrilled with the way he was looking and acting, then he came out of a gallop with a slight swelling," co-owner E. W. 'Bud' Johnston said. "It might just be a lousy little strain, but it could develop into something serious and it's probably going to keep us out of the Pacific Classic. We're only concerned about what's right for the horse." Added trainer Donald Warren, "He had some heat in a pastern. It could be a minor infection, but we're having it checked out. We'll just have to wait and see until we get a report from the vets later [Wednesday] morning or afternoon." Acclamation currently rides a seven-race

winning streak, including two starts this season, both on turf, in the GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. June 9 and a successful defense of his title in the GI Eddie Read S. July 21.

## Sutherland Cleared For Classic Ride...

Chantal Sutherland, who incurred a four-day suspension for a whip infraction while participating in the Shergar Cup in Britain last weekend, will be allowed to push back the start date from Aug. 26 to Aug. 29, therefore allowing her to partner Game On Dude (Awesome Again) in the Pacific Classic. The four days were set to begin Aug. 25, but Sutherland's agent Tommy Ball filed a request with the British Horseracing Authority earlier this week, asking permission to defer the start date. Del Mar stewards received a fax Wednesday from the BHA granting the stay.

## Atlantic Jewel Sidelined...

Unbeaten **Atlantic Jewel** (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) has sustained an injury that will keep her out of action for the next few months. The newly turned 4-year-old came back from a gallop Tuesday showing signs of lameness, and a scan revealed an injury to a lateral branch of super flexor tendon extending to the end region of the pastern. She had been the ante-post favorite for the A\$3-million G1 Cox Plate Oct. 27. "We will continue to assess the injury and it would be my opinion at this stage that she will be unable to resume full training for eight weeks," trainer Mark Kavanagh told *racingsvictoria.com.au*. "It may be the end of the spring, but it's not the end of the horse." The bay filly is perfect in seven career outings, including the 2011 G1 Thousand Guineas and 2012 G1 All-Aged S.

## Rain Set for the Knavesmire...

Last year's G1 Epsom Oaks heroine **Dancing Rain** (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) is set to make her belated reappearance in Thursday's G1 Darley Yorkshire Oaks at York, trainer William Haggas announced yesterday. Not seen since finishing unplaced in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto in November, the 4-year-old had been forced to miss a scheduled comeback in Ascot's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. July 21. "No final decision has been made yet, but we're planning to run Dancing Rain at York," Haggas told the *Racing Post*. "York is the next natural step and hopefully she will be a fresh filly for the autumn."

Her son Kayf Tara has established himself as a leading National Hunt sire and Opera House has also been a success at stud. She will be sorely missed."

The dark bay was a \$4,500 FTKOCT yearling RNA, but brought \$35,000 after breezing a decent-looking :10 3/5 at Fasig-Tipton Midlantic. It seems likely that there's more talent there than he showed on debut, and the drop in class can't hurt--considering No Nukes's purchase price and these purses, it definitely isn't a white flag type move. **Play:** \$20 Win. **Alternate:** Race 3 - \$20 Win on #7 Gombey Dancer.

**DiDonato Bankroll: \$890 - Record: 20-2-2-4**

**Sherack: Wednesday** - Much to my liking, **She Be Bunny** was ridden aggressively by Rosario and enjoyed a clear lead through fractions of :23.50 and :47.80, but had nothing left in the stretch and folded to finish a disappointing seventh.

**Thursday - Race 11 - Msw, (S), 3yo/up, f/m, 1mT - #7 Jennys Creek (20-1)**

Taking a swing on a horse that I added to my rapidly growing stable mail watch (149 horses strong at the moment) following her turf bow at the Spa July 28. Completely ignored at 67-1 going 5 1/2 furlongs versus a similar bunch that day, **Jennys Creek** stumbled at the start and quickly lost valuable positioning over a course playing extremely kind to front runners. She began to make a decent middle move from ninth into a sharp :22 1/5 opening quarter while riding the rails on the turn for home, but couldn't keep the momentum rolling once angled out for her run. While she failed to gain any ground on the top three--including the very sharp wire-to-wire winner Subtle--she did have 3 1/2 lengths on the fifth-place finisher to her credit. Jennys Creek has every right to move forward with that one under her belt, and the stretch to a mile should help the cause as well. It's been an unusually quiet season for the very capable Carlos Martin barn, but his horses have been performing pretty decent at this meeting so far (13-1-5-0). Wouldn't be surprised at all if Jennys Creek steps up and sneaks into the mix at a huge price over a course playing a lot more even now following last weekend's heavy rain. **Play:** \$14 Win (Turf Only). **Alternate:** Race 8: \$25 Win on #2 Dan and Sheila.

**DINAPOLI ISSUES VLT AUDIT** The office of New York State Comptroller Thomas DiNapoli has released an audit of the administration of the state's video lottery terminal revenues. The purpose of the audit, which covered the period Apr. 1, 2008 to Mar. 31, 2012, was to determine whether VLT revenues were "adequately controlled, accurately reported, used only for their intended purposes, and have improved racetrack attendance and handle." While those first three points were found to be in compliance, the audit noted, "we are unable to determine whether the VLT revenues used to enhance racetrack purses have aided racetrack attendance and handle." The New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association's President Rick Violette Jr. and New York Thoroughbred Breeders' Executive Director Jeffrey Cannizzo issued a joint statement in response. "State Comptroller Thomas DiNapoli's recent audit paints a false and misleading picture of Thoroughbred racing in New York," the statement read. "The fact is, despite a national economy still immersed in a significant downturn and a national trend that saw handle drop 7% last month, business is booming for New York Thoroughbred racing, and to paint any other picture is disingenuous. In 2012, all three of the New York Racing Association meets have seen significant increases in wagering. At Aqueduct, total handle was up 22.6% from the previous year. Belmont's handle increased 13.4% on-track, with total handle up 9.1%. Saratoga's total handle is up 6.5% midway through the meet. That only tells a fraction of the story. After a four-year decline, there was a 39.4% increase in Thoroughbred foals reported in New York through May 2012, and every one of those foals creates jobs."
