



SOPH SURVIVORS SQUARE OFF IN TRAVERS

While the 143rd running of Saratoga's GI Travers S. has lost many of its would-be major players due to injury and/or early retirement, a well-matched group of 11 will square off in today's "Midsummer Derby."

Godolphin's **Alpha** (Bernardini), winner of the sloppy GI Jim Dandy S. here July 28, gets the morning-line nod at 5-2 off his two-length front-running success over four of his return rivals. **Neck 'n Neck** (Flower Alley) was second, with **Liaison** (Indian Charlie) third, **Atigun** (Istan) a patiently ridden sixth and

Fast Falcon (Awesome Again) seventh in that traditional Travers prep. Alpha's trainer Kiaran McLaughlin acknowledged that end-of-the-year honors may be out of the reach of his charge after the Triple Crown exploits of I'll Have Another (Flower Alley), but hopes to give that retiree a run for his money if Alpha can win here and go on to beat his elders. "People always say the 3-year-old crop is weak and then you look up and it's November and they're winning the Breeders' Cup," McLaughlin said. "It's tough to overtake I'll Have Another, but if you happened to win the Travers and the [GI] Breeders' Cup Classic, you would have a good chance. It's a \$1-million Grade I and a very important race Saturday." He added, "We couldn't be any happier with Alpha going into the race. He's put on weight and developed a lot since he arrived here June 2. He's really blossomed and is doing fabulous." **Cont. p5**

A LATE BLOOMER

Having arrived in Britain in the shadow of her compatriot Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}), **Ortensia** (Aus) (Testa Rossa {Aus}) made sure the limelight was all hers on York's Knavesmire yesterday as she found the front in the nick of time for a thrilling success in the G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. Held up far off the frenetic early pace by William Buick, the 7-2 joint-favorite was still well adrift inside the final quarter but the mighty stride of the Aug. 3 G2 King George S. winner took her past **Spirit Quartz** (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the final yards for a neck success. "She's unbelievable and I can't remember riding a horse who can go through so many gears in only five furlongs," Buick commented. "She gets outpaced early but is always stepping up through the gears and it's like she knows where the winning line is." **Cont. p5**

'DESCENT' EN POINTE FOR PLETCHER

Turbulent Descent (Congrats) proved worthy of her leading role in yesterday's GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga, earning an automatic berth into the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint Nov. 2 with a convincing 1 1/4-length success from **Derwin's Star** (Wildcat Heir) for new connections. Purchased by the Coolmore contingent from Blinkers On Racing Stable, et al in June, last year's GI Test S. heroine justified her 2-5 favoritism in this first go for leading trainer Todd Pletcher with a stalk-and-pounce trip from off a slow pace set by eventual third-place finisher **All Due Respect** (Value Plus). Perched three wide while racing in the second flight early, the bay put a head in front at the top of the lane while ridden confidently by John Velazquez and was never seriously threatened by the late-charging runner-up while becoming a millionaire in the process. "I thought she ran well," said Pletcher. "Sometimes the hardest races to win are the ones you're expected to. We were just hoping to stay out of trouble... Johnny said she got a bit of a bump in the middle of the turn over there and she kind of grabbed him and took off a little sooner than he wanted to. She seems like the kind of filly that, once she makes the lead, tends to wait a little bit, which we anticipated, but we're happy she got it done." **Cont. p3**

Trained by Mike Puype for the first part of her career, Turbulent Descent completed a perfect 2-year-old season with a win in the 2010 GI Hollywood Starlet S. She added the GI Santa Anita Oaks at a route of ground the following March, but her connections opted to cut her back to one-turn events, and she flourished with convincing scores in the GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland and the Test here last August with a runner-up effort to It's Tricky (Mineshaft) in the one-mile GI Acorn S. sandwiched in between. She resurfaced to finish a troubled-trip fifth as the favorite in the Breeders' Cup last November and finished off her sophomore campaign with a disappointing sixth in Santa Anita's GI La Brea S. on New Year's Eve. The bay resurfaced back in her best form, however, to take a very salty renewal of the Desert Stormer H. at Betfair Hollywood Park with a 104 Beyer Speed Figure June 17, and was subsequently scooped up after her new owners put in an offer that was said to be too good to pass up.

"It's sort of rare you have an opportunity to buy a multiple Grade I-winning filly with some races left and some opportunities," explained Pletcher of the reasoning behind Turbulent Descent's acquisition. "While it was certainly a fair price, it was still a lot of money. We felt based on her record there wasn't much downside. We talked about a couple of races, and this was one of them. So now, you're talking about a filly that's a Grade I winner at two, three and four, and it's pretty rare. Those are the kinds of mares you'd love to have in your broodmare band when their racing career is over." Pletcher said that Turbulent Descent would be pointed to the Filly & Mare sprint, but was not sure if she would make a start in between.

After winning four times at group level, Ortensia was stripped of an initial top-level success when a prohibited substance was discovered in a post-race test following the G1 Galaxy at Randwick in April 2010. It took 19 months for the bay to finally register that all-important victory on just her second start for the Paul Messara stable after leaving Tony Noonan with the plan of retiring her halfway through last year. Taking off after her belated first Group 1 in the Nov. 19

Winterbottom S. at Perth's Ascot track, she went straight to Meydan and added the Mar. 31 G1 Al Quoz Sprint to her tally on World Cup night Mar. 31. Only ninth on rain-softened ground on her British debut in Royal Ascot's G1 King's Stand S. June 19, she was fourth on an even more-testing surface in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 14 before coming good again in the King George last time. Left behind in the early dash for prominence here, she was allowed time to find her stride by a patient William Buick, as Hamish McGonagall streaked ahead on the far side. In no-man's land for a spell, she had that distant target to aim at away from the main action which was taking place down the center and near the stand's side. Motoring as Frankie Dettori edged past the eventual third on Spirit Quartz with 150 yards remaining, she forged ahead of that rival in the shade of the post to provide Australia with a first victory in this race. *Cont. p5*

"I think today she struggled to find her feet because of the loose ground," Buick said. "Once she does and passes a couple of horses, her confidence builds, and she did the same at Goodwood. She is the boss and you have to go along with what she wants and ride her the way she has to be ridden. All credit to Paul Messara and the team behind her, as it was a brave decision to keep her here."

Messara added, "It's the biggest thrill of my training career so far. The owner lives 10 minutes down the

road and, fortunately, he asked me to tinker around with her before retirement with a view to winning another race before she went to stud. We brought her along slowly and took a natural approach with her, and she started to really bloom and come on. We've had an amazing run with her, and she's five from seven with me including three Group 1s. She has a devastating finish and on fast ground she can run some unbelievable sectionals to get out of trouble. She's been very good to us and it's a case of one race at a time, so we'll see how she pulls up tomorrow and the next couple of days. If she's had enough, she'll be back to Australia. Otherwise, she'll be at Haydock [for the Sept. 8 G1 Sprint Cup] and the six furlongs will be no problem to her."

Spirit Quartz's trainer Robert Cowell told *PA Sport* that his charge could go next in France. "The [Oct. 7] G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp might be our next port of call and I might give him a break and not take him to Dubai, so we save him for next season," Cowell stated.

Stepping into the Spotlight..

Magnolia Racing Stable and Hidden Brook Farm's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Street Life** (Street Sense) found himself too far back when sixth in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7; third in the GII Peter Pan S. May 12; and fourth in the GI Belmont S. June 9, but parlayed a positive pace set-up into a 1 3/4-length victory over **Five Sixteen** (Invasor {Arg}) in the Curlin S. a day before the Jim Dandy. He earned a career-best 99 Beyer Speed Figure for that effort--three points faster than Alpha earned--but may not get the pace he needs here after the defection of Hansen (Tapit). "Hopefully, we'll get some pace to run at," trainer Chad Brown said. "At the end of the day, it will all be up to [jockey] Jose [Lezcano]."

Green B. Smith Jr.'s **Nonios** (Pleasantly Perfect) could take action from the Beyer boys, as he enters off back-to-back triple digit figures. A winner of the GIII Affirmed H. over Liaison at Betfair Hollywood Park June 3, the Jerry Hollendorfer pupil bested that same rival by one slot again when second in the GII Swaps S. July 4. He benefits from the absence of Paynter (Awesome Again), who handed Nonios a 3 3/4-length defeat in Monmouth's GI Haskell Invitational S. July 29. "We have a colt who is doing well," said Nonios's Hall of Fame trainer. "We try not to bring our horses anywhere we don't think they have a good chance, and I don't think we're being foolish or frivolous with him."

WILL CONTESTED BE TESTED?

The nation's best 3-year-old filly sprinters will have the chance to establish themselves in today's GI Test S. at Saratoga. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Contested** (Ghostzapper) is favored at 2-1 to bounce back from a poor effort last out in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont June 23, when she faltered to finish last as the 1-2 favorite. Trained by Bob Baffert for his wife Jill, Contested shipped to Churchill Downs to take the GIII Eight Belles S. by 4 3/4 lengths May 4, and broke into Grade I company in style next out, winning the Acorn S. May 28 at Belmont by five lengths. Assistant trainer Jim Barnes said the track condition may have contributed to Contested's poor showing in the Mother Goose. "It had rained heavily the night before," Barnes explained. "It was a different track the day we ran in the Acorn. It was very fast that day. The day we ran in the Mother Goose it was deep, and I don't think you wanted to be on the inside." Barnes said he expects a better effort today. "She's training well and the weather should be good throughout the weekend, so I expect her to [rebound in the Test]." Next in the betting at 5-2 is Gary and Mary West's **Book Review** (Giant's Causeway), who makes a huge class jump into stakes company. The Chad Brown trainee has yet to finish off the board in five lifetime starts, and she was second to leading 3-year-old filly Questing (GB) (Hard Spun) in a one-mile optional-claiming event at Belmont June 24. Prior to that effort, she bested Dance Card (Tapit) in a May 20 maiden special weight at Belmont, and that rival has since come back to win twice, including a victory at Saratoga. Mary and Chester Broman's **Beautiful But Blue** (El Corredor) also makes her first foray into the graded ranks. The dark bay has won two straight stakes events, most recently the restricted Fleet Indian S. over this track and trip Aug. 1. Her only loss this year came in the June 24 Bouwerie S. at Belmont, when she met a yielding course in her first try on turf and finished fifth. **Aubby K** (Street Sense) earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆** status after breaking her maiden by 15 3/4 lengths at Belmont last September, and she has been knocking on the door in graded-stakes company since. She was third behind Contested in the Acorn, and fourth in the GII Delaware Oaks behind Grace Hall (Empire Maker) July 20.

SHOWDOWN FOR KING'S BISHOP CROWN

Currency Swap (High Cotton) and **Trinniberg** (Teufflesburg) have met twice on the racetrack, and with each one owning a victory, today's GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga sets up as a rubber match of sorts between the 3-year-old sprinters. Klaravich Stables and William H. Lawrence's **Currency Swap** has been pegged the 5-2 morning line favorite on the merit of a win in the GII Amsterdam S. over this track July 29. Hero of the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga last year over **Trinniberg**, **Currency Swap** went head-to-head with that front-running rival in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 9 at Belmont, and checked in 1 3/4 lengths back in second. Trainer Terri Pompay has reason to believe **Currency Swap** can turn the tables today. "In the Woody Stephens, my plan wasn't to go after [Trinniberg], but no one else did, so we had to," Pompay explained. "There will be more speed in here. I'm hoping **Trinniberg** can go out in front and someone can prompt him." After recording a 106 Beyer Speed Figure in the Woody Stephens, **Trinniberg**, 7-2 here, was cut down by **Fort Loudon** (Awesome of Course) in the GIII Carry Back S. at Calder July 7. Owner Shivananda Parbhoo was pleased with that effort, claiming his horse was not fit for the race. "For him to not be ready and run a race like that, it was amazing," Parbhoo said. "We were totally not prepared for the Carry Back, but now there is no excuse. He is 100% ready." Fred Brei's **Fort Loudon**, fifth behind **Currency Swap** in the Amsterdam, will oppose the two favorites again today. **Ever So Lucky** (Indian Charlie) kicked off his summer campaign with a smart 7 1/2-length allowance win at Delaware, and he was third to **Street Life** (**Street Sense**) last out in the Curlin S. over this track July 27 after traveling five wide. John Velazquez stays with him as he returns to a sprint for the first time since finishing third behind **Trinniberg** in Gulfstream's GIII Swale S. in March.

GRADE I TRIO FACES OFF IN BALLSTON SPA

Today's GII Ballston Spa S. at Saratoga has drawn a well-matched field of filly and mare turf specialists, including three from last month's GI Diana S. over this course. Favored on the morning line is Martin Schwartz's Grade I winner **Zagora (Fr)** (Green Tune), who took last year's Diana. The Chad Brown charge has won a trio of Grade IIIs this year, two at this distance, and she was most recently third in the July 28 Diana off a two-month layoff. "After watching [the Diana] again, I didn't feel like she was going to finish better than third," said Brown. "She really got the trip I was looking for. In hindsight, she probably needed the race. Especially on softer turf, it was a little more demanding of a race off the layoff. She got a lot out of it, and she's put a couple of really nice works in since." Also returning from the Diana is **Tapitsfly** (Tapit). Winner of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf in 2009, the now 5-year-old has hit top gear in 2012. She won the GI Just a Game S. at Belmont June 9, recording a 100 Beyer Speed Figure. The Frank Jones Jr.-owned filly most recently finished fourth over turf rated 'good' in the Diana. "Firmer ground is definitely what she wants," said trainer Dale Romans. "She came out of the Diana really well. I wasn't thinking about running her back that quick, but she's just doing so well up here. There's plenty of speed in there with **Summer Soiree** (War Front), so we'll see what happens." Team Valor International's Summer Soiree makes her first start in nine months here. The front runner hit her best stride last summer, winning the GI Del Mar Oaks, and her last effort was a narrow nose loss in the GI Matriarch S. Nov. 25 at Hollywood Park. Emory A. Hamilton's **Hungry Island** (More Than Ready) finished fifth, a half-length off Tapitsfly in the Diana, and third, four lengths behind that foe, in the Just a Game. The Shug McGaughey charge has been consistent in graded stakes company since last summer, and bested Tapitsfly in Churchill's GII Distaff Turf Mile S. May 5.

Edward Brown Jr. and Jay Manoogian's **Dhaamer (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) has established himself as a consistent turf performer on the California circuit since arriving from England late last year, and now seeks an automatic berth into the Nov. 3 GI Breeders' Cup Turf in today's GII Del Mar H. The Mike Mitchell trainee, not yet nominated to the Breeders' Cup, has won two straight, including the GIII Sunset H. going 1 1/2 miles at Betfair Hollywood Park July 15. He has proven he can handle the distance and is favored at 5-2 on the morning line. **Worth Repeating** (Giant's Causeway) owns the highest Beyer Speed Figure in the field. He earned a 97 for a runner-up effort in the GII Cougar II H. behind multiple GI Pacific Classic hopeful Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) on the main track here July 27, and prepped for this race with a bullet five-furlong work in :59 flat over the Del Mar strip Aug. 20. Gary and Mary West's **Casino Host** (Dynaformer) appeared to have too much to do after sitting well off the pace in the GI Eddie Read S. July 21, and finished third behind Acclamation (Unusual Heat) and **Interaction (Arg)** (Easing Along). That was his first start for trainer Ron Ellis, and while there is no guarantee of a strong pace here, he could enjoy the added distance. Ron McAnally sends out 6-year-old veteran Interaction, a South American import who has also competed in France and Dubai. Interaction made little impact in two starts last year for Christophe Clement, but has shown improvement in two races this year. He won an optional claiming event at Betfair Hollywood Park June 16 before his second place finish in the Eddie Read last out.

Off the mark in a course-and-distance maiden July 14, Blaine belied his inexperience to outbattle Heavy Metal in a pulsating finish to this prestigious affair. Sent off with plenty of supporters despite being the true unknown quantity in the line-up, the bay raced in second early with Phillip Makin content to take a lead from the freewheeling Euxton Hall (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}). Rolling to the front before halfway, the bay was headed briefly by G2 Richmond S. winner Heavy Metal with a furlong to race, but dug in gamely to hold off that penalised rival. For only his second start, he

"[Trainer] Kevin [Ryan] was keen to have him in a rhythm and he was. As soon as I got to Richard Fahey's horse's girth, he came good at halfway and it was very straightforward from there. We've always liked him, and he still feels like he'll be much better next year. He's always shown a lot of ability and although he's been put in the deep end today, that has shone through." Makin continued, "The rain taking the jar out has helped him and we didn't go that hard up front." Ryan added, "He's quite a weak horse, which is why we haven't put a lot of runs into him, but he's very sensible and really wants to win. You have to be careful, but he eats and sleeps and his work has been great over the last 10 days. He's quite a raw horse still and will develop an awful lot." Trainer Mark Johnston was satisfied with the effort of the runner-up, who was saddled with a three-pound penalty. "Joe [Fanning] said he came there to win it, but he just couldn't get past the winner," he told *PA Sport*. "Our horse likes top of the ground and it maybe just wasn't quite fast enough for him today. It certainly wasn't as fast as it was at Goodwood. It was still a good performance. He's in the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 13], but the ground might be against him by then, so we'll see."

Dubai Prince came from Dermot Weld with the highest recommendations following his win in the G3 Killavullan S. at Leopardstown in October 2010, but his Classic season proved a wash-out after injury struck and he was out of his depth in the G1 Champion S. when finally nursed to the big time by Godolphin. Also misfiring at Meydan, the bay was beginning to look a lost cause until he revived his fortunes with a smooth 4 1/2-length defeat of Fury (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in a course-and-distance conditions event July 13. Only sixth in the G3 Glorious S. over 12 furlongs at Goodwood last time Aug. 3, he was able to use his acceleration to potent effect while dropped back to a more suitable trip here. Settled in last early as Fury was sent into a clear lead, he was produced with a telling surge down the outer by Frankie Dettori to lead with a quarter mile remaining and idled in front when the contest was settled.

"This horse is a beautiful, long-striding galloper who is suited to York and nine furlongs is his ideal trip," Frankie Dettori said. "The race set up quite well for me, as they went off fast and it was a good effort." Racing Manager Simon Crisford added, "It is a good race to win and a nice stepping-stone to all the autumn feature races over a mile and a quarter, but this particular horse needs things to go his way. He doesn't stay a mile and a half, but he needs a small field, a bit of daylight and to get into a rhythm where he doesn't panic. We've been guilty of over-facing him a little bit when going to the Champion S. last year, and he would choke when the heat of the race starts. We haven't really seen him at his best yet, and today's was a solid effort and he finished off really well. We'll look at the G2 Prix Dollar [at Longchamp Oct. 6], and there are only so many races you can target with him. If he was good enough to win that, we would look at the Champion again [at Ascot Oct. 20]. Today's ground is quick enough and so conditions are quite important to him, but even though he has the ability to perform very well in a big event, everything has to go right."

ROCK ON

Michael O'Flynn's **Saddler's Rock (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) is at York today as he bids to stake his claim as Europe's leading stayer in the G2 Weatherbys Insurance Lonsdale Cup. Last year's G2 Doncaster Cup winner had 2009 winner **Askar Tau (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}) a length back in second when scoring in comfortable fashion in the Aug. 2 G2 Goodwood Cup last time, and it will be a surprise if he is unable to confirm that form. Godolphin have won the last two renewals with **Opinion Poll (Ire)** (Halling), and in his absence send forward last year's G2 Goodwood Cup runner-up **Lost In the Moment (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and hardy veteran **Cavalryman (GB)** (Halling). The latter is the first string following successes in the Listed Grand Cup over 14 furlongs here May 26 and Listed Esher S. over an extended two-mile trip at Sandown July 7. "Cavalryman has won well on his two latest starts, and I was pleased with his work earlier this week," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He is in good form and two miles suits him. I am hopeful of another good run. Lost In the Moment has been disappointing so far this year, but he came out his race at Goodwood sound and healthy. He gets two miles well and I am looking for a better performance from him." One from leftfield could be **High Jinx (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), who was four lengths second to the subsequent G3 Geoffrey Freer S. scorer **Mount Athos (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the Listed Silver Cup over 14 furlongs here last time York July 14. From the James Fanshawe stable, the lightly raced 4-year-old is the type of work in progress with which his trainer seems to excel. "I think he'll appreciate the step up in trip, and an ease in the ground would suit him, so any rain is appreciated," Fanshawe told *PA Sport*. "He has a bit to find on the ratings and it's a tough race, but I'm looking forward to trying him over two miles."

So unlucky when third behind the dead-heaters **Archbishop (Arch)** and **Trumpet Major (Ire)** (Arakan) in the G3 Thoroughbred S. over this track and trip last time Aug. 3, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's sophomore proved his stamina for this trip on that occasion, having suggested that he needed further than seven furlongs when third in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 20. Trainer Roger Varian wants the ground to remain on the quick side. "He has been training really well since his luckless run in the Thoroughbred S.," he said. NEW YORK TIMES EDITORIAL: ENHANCED TRAVERS SECURITY PRAISEWORTHY

Earlier this month, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board announced a series of enhanced security protocols for horses participating in today's GI Travers S., including a full daily veterinarian's record of all medications and treatments available to the public on the homepage of its website ([click here](#)). Travers entrants, required to be on the grounds by Aug. 22, were subject to out-of-competition blood testing Wednesday. Unlike the GI Belmont S., Travers horses were allowed to stay in their current barns/stalls, which have been monitored at all times by additional security personnel. "The measures put forth by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board are common-sense protocols that will ensure that the Travers S. is run in a fair and safe manner," said John F. Wayne, executive director of the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission, who has more than 40 years experience in racing, including as a Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau agent and director of security for both Churchill Downs and Santa Anita. "I applaud the Racing and Wagering Board for employing these steps, which are in line with the best practices of protecting racehorses and the betting public." The added security measures were the focus of a *New York Times* editorial piece titled *Run to Death at Racetracks* in Friday's edition ([click here for complete New York Times editorial](#)). "Handicappers and bettors have had an unexpected new factor to work into their predictions for the elite Travers S. Saturday at the racetrack in Saratoga Springs: the disclosure, on the Web, of each medication dose given to the Thoroughbreds in the days before the race," the editorial read. "The extraordinary decision to tell the public what trainers are up to in the barns was ordered by New York racing authorities concerned about the rampant doping scandal that is threatening the American racing industry...These are praiseworthy but overdue steps." It was announced Friday afternoon that all of the samples from the Travers runners have come up clean. NYTHA Sounds off on Times Story...

New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association President Rick Violette Jr. issued a statement Friday in response to the *Times* piece. "The editorial on horse racing published in today's *New York Times* contains statements that are blatantly false and unimaginably inflammatory, and it would be irresponsible for the New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association to allow this unfounded attack on our sport and our industry to go unchallenged," he said. "If they would only take the time to do even the slightest research, the editorial board of the *New York Times* would know what it is our trainers and our crews are 'up to' in the barn area. We are working tirelessly, seven days a week, to ensure that our horses receive the highest quality care. You'd only need to spend a morning on the backstretch to witness the unflinching commitment we make to our horses. That commitment is not motivated by greed, but by a love of racing and a respect for the animals that provide us with our livelihoods. To say that racing is threatened by 'the rampant doping scandal' is to completely ignore the facts."

INTERIM REPORT SUPPORTS GOV'T STANCE

IN ONTARIO Ontario Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs Ted McMeekin released a statement yesterday commenting on a recently released interim report that supports a government decision to end the Slots at Racetracks program, which provides \$345 million in purse subsidies. "On June 7, I announced that three former cabinet ministers--Elmer Buchanan, John Snobelen and John Wilkinson--would lead consultations with the horse racing industry to help them transition from the Slots at Racetracks program to a more sustainable model," explained McMeekin. "I have received an interim report. The panel has concluded the government made the right decision to end the Slots at Racetracks program--a program that cost taxpayers \$345 million a year. The panel said it would be a mistake to reinstate the program--going so far as to call it 'poor public policy.'" The report does, however, support increased aid to the province's racetracks. "The panel also advises that a viable horse racing industry requires ongoing funding to maintain attractive purses, sustain tracks, support breeding and grow a robust betting system," explained McMeekin. "Our government committed \$50 million over the next three years to help transition the industry. The panel believes that a greater investment is required." In response to the interim report, the Ontario Horse Racing Industry Association issued a statement highlighting the positive elements of the panel's findings, including the sentiment that "the [Ontario] horse racing and breeding industry is worth saving." Sue Leslie, President of OHRIA, said, "OHRIA recognizes the effort and worthy contribution of the OMAFRA panel and looks forward to continuing our work with the panel to formulate the plan."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Craving Carats Works Towards Stakes Debut...

Donegal Racing's **Craving Carats** (Street Sense) tuned up for his upcoming start in next Thursday's GII With Anticipation S. by working five-eighths of a mile in 1:00.95 over the Saratoga main track yesterday morning. A \$320,000 Keeneland September purchase by Jerry Crawford's operation, Craving Carats was placed in a pair of starts on the main track, but has turned the corner since switching to the grass. Runner-up going seven furlongs at Belmont July 15, the bay colt most recently wired a field of maidens in his first try at two turns at the Spa Aug. 4. However, trainer Dale Romans doesn't necessarily believe he's a need-the-lead type. "I don't think so; he was just the fastest in that race," Romans said. "I won't be surprised if he sat off the pace [in the With Anticipation]. He's such an easy-moving horse."

Wise Dan Breezes Fast for Woodbine Mile...

Morton Fink's **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) returned to the worktab for the first time since his sensational victory in the GII Fourstardave H. Aug. 11, tearing through four furlongs on the Oklahoma turf training course in :45.89, the fastest of 45 workers by over a full second. Trainer Charlie Lopresti clocked the 5-year-old in :56 3/5 for five furlongs--that would have been the bullet for that distance as well--and 3/4 of a mile in 1:10 flat. The move didn't exactly unfold how Lopresti wanted it, but wasn't unduly concerned afterwards. "I was looking for a 48 [second work], in hand," said Lopresti, who is pointing Wise Dan to the Grade 1, \$1 million Woodbine Mile Sept. 23. "He's just a freak of nature. You never want a horse to go that fast for his first work [after a race], but if you don't have a watch on him, you don't know. He's just galloping." Wise Dan, winner of the GI Clark H. to close out 2011, set a track record in winning the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland by 10 1/2 lengths in his seasonal return Apr. 22. He was narrowly defeated in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 16 prior to his Fourstardave success.

According to the trade daily, the 4-year-old has left Michael Bell's stable and a final decision on her racing career will be made shortly. Previously owned by Peter Phillip and Tim Redman, the bargain €16,000 GOFOPN yearling and 10,000gns TATGNS 2yo purchase was enjoying her finest hour when securing the top-level success in York's five-furlong contest 12 months ago. She also won twice at Listed level and placed second in the G2 Lowther S., G3 Princess Margaret S. and G3 Albany S. at two. Bell told the *Post*, "She was owned by two incredibly lucky owners who have had horses with me for a long time and she's given us two wonderful years and a lot of fun. She was the original rags-to-riches story. She was catalogued very early in the Tattersalls Guineas Breeze-up Sale which I think is one of the reasons why Richard [Frisby] was able to get her for us for only 10,000gns--we would have paid more. She also didn't breeze great at the sale--she came up with her ears pricked and wasn't doing a tap--but she worked really well from the start for us and went to Newbury three weeks after the sale and bolted up. She was unlucky not to win a stakes race at two but we changed tactics with her last year and that turned her from a bridesmaid into a bride. She was a real pocket rocket and it's great that she's going to such a good place."

'Dangerous Time' for Newfangled...

Connections of Princess Haya of Jordan's **Newfangled** (New Approach {Ire}) yesterday gave an update on the injured filly following her early exit from Thursday's G2 Lowther S. The G3 Albany S. winner had been pulled up after just two furlongs of the York race and the owner's Racing Advisor John Ferguson told PA Sport, "The vets are still investigating at this stage. We know she has got a serious pelvis injury. She has made it through the night, but obviously it is a dangerous time at the moment. Fingers crossed, she'll be all right."

Options Open for Farhh...

Godolphin's **Farhh (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) could stay at 10 furlongs or revert to a mile for his next start, it was announced yesterday. Following his seven-lengths second to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in Wednesday's G1 Juddmonte International S., the 4-year-old who was also placed in the June 20 G1 Prince of Wales's S., July 7 G1 Eclipse S. and Aug. 1 G1 Sussex S. is set to make a quick reappearance. "He doesn't take his races that well compared to other horses and there is only so much training he can do in between them, so that's why we don't want to give him too much time to his next start," Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "Having said that, finding his next race is difficult but he's well-entered up and is in the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 8] and the [Sept. 16] G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. His big aim is [Oct. 20] Champions' Day at Ascot."

The Jockey Club Denies Privileges to Aguirre:

Trainer Paul Aguirre has been sanctioned by The Jockey Club for one year beginning Jan. 1, 2013, for altering the back of a foal certificate to affect a horse's eligibility for a race in 2011. The Jockey Club will deny Aguirre all privileges of *The American Stud Book*, including the privilege to register foals or submit any documents related to foal registration. Aguirre admitted to having altered the registration papers for his horse Doc Can Dance to make him eligible for a starter-allowance race at Hollywood Park in June 2011. Doc Can Dance ultimately won the race at odds of 27-1, but was subsequently disqualified and placed last. Aguirre was fined \$2,000 and suspended five days. The denial of privileges was made pursuant to Section V, Rule 19, of Principal Rules and Requirements of The American Stud Book, which covers "deceptive practices, cruelty to a horse and medication violations," and was based upon information received by The Jockey Club's Registrar.

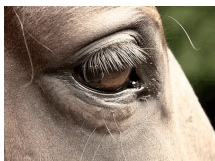
