TWO WINNING TICKETS IN THE TRAVERS

Quick, anybody have a spare canoe? Godolphin's **Alpha** (Bernardini), favored at 2-1 off the heels of a decisive victory in the GII Jim Dandy S., and Magic City's 33-1 longshot **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown), still

eligible for a first-level allowance, put on a show before a packed house of 46,528 at the Spa Saturday, finishing in a heart-stopping dead-heat in the 143rd running of the GI Travers S.

"At the wire, it was too close

to call," Alpha's trainer Kieran McLaughlin commented. "I said, 'We'll take a dead-heat.' It was a great race. We thought he would run great, and he did." Alpha, a decisive winner of Aqueduct's GIII Withers S. in February and a close second-place finisher in the GI Wood Memorial in April, has quickly made up for a 12th-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby in two subsequent starts in upstate New York. McLaughlin added, "I'm wondering who gets the canoe and how they're going to paint it." Golden Ticket earned a trip to the GII Tampa Bay Derby after graduating in a Gulfstream off-the-turfer at sixth asking Feb. 11. He ran his heart out in that one to finish second, beaten only 3/4 of a length to Prospective (Malibu Moon), then finished a close fifth in Keeneland's GIII Coolmore Lexington S. Apr. 21. He made only one start since, placing second, beaten a neck to Skyring (English Channel) in a \$75,000 optional claimer at Churchill Downs May 5. The dark bay had a trio of bullets in the holster for the Mid-Summer Derby. Magic City Thoroughbred Partners is a Billings, Montana-based outfit whose partners include co-owners Carter Stewart, Ken Schlenker and managing partner and former Montana legislator Dan Fuchs. "I thought we were beat at first, then I thought we won," trainer Kenny McPeck revealed. "I couldn't tell. I'm thrilled we finished in a dead heat. It would have been a heartbreaker for either one of us to lose. [Our horse] had been training unbelievable." **Cont. p3**

NOTHING DULL AT DEL MAR

Today's \$1-million GI TVG Pacific Classic at Del Mar features a well-matched group of 10, including Donegal Racing's **Dullahan** (Even the Score), who takes on older runners for the first time. The big chestnut's two lifetime wins have come in Grade I events on Keeneland's Polytrack--the Dixiana Breeders' Futurity last fall and the Toyota Blue Grass S. this spring--and he will be seeking to be the first 3-year-old to triumph in this marquee event since Came Home (Gone West) did so a decade ago. "He's running on his preferred surface and that should help," said exercise rider Tammy Fox. "He's running against older horses for the first time, but it's later on in the year where he should be able to handle it." Other sophomores to win the Pacific Classic are Best Pal in 1992 and General Challenge in 1999. **Cont. p13**

Alpha hit the gas with a three-wide sweep on the turn for home while Golden Ticket rode the rails. Golden Ticket looked like he had it wrapped up while enjoying a clear lead in midstretch, but Alpha showed his class, rallying to get a piece of the prize right on the wire. **Fast Falcon** (Awesome Again) turned it on nicely in deep stretch as well, rallying on the outside to add to the blanket finish.

Contested, tabbed as a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ following a 6 1/2-length tour-de-force in her second career try at Santa Anita last October, justified that tag in spades in her next three starts. A sharp allowance winner in her sophomore debut at Santa Anita Apr. 15, the Natalie Baffert colorbearer shipped to Churchill for a stylish win in the GIII Eight Belles S. May 4, then added a five-length tally in the GI TVG Acorn S. May 28. Stretched to 1 1/16 miles in the GI Mother Goose S. June 23, the 1-2 favorite led the fractions of :23 and :46 2/5 and tired badly to finish a well-beaten last of five. Cutting back to her preferred distance here, Contested was forced to show a new dimension after breaking slowly. Chasing in third through hot fractions of :21.49 and :44.09, Contested charged up three deep into the stretch and showed her class down the lane to kick clear. "I think she runs better off the pace," assistant trainer Jim Barnes commented. "They were going very fast. I wouldn't have wanted to have been up with them. I said [to Rafael Bejarano], 'You got to play the break. If you catch a flyer, you can actually go. If you get away slowly, just put her in a comfortable, clean spot.' And he did." Talk about a claim to fame. Willy Beamin has been quite literally unstoppable since being haltered for \$25,000 from MeB Racing Stables and trainer Dominic Schettino at Aqueduct Mar. 23. The New York-bred was a 5 3/4-length winner that day, and cleared his state-bred conditions in his next two starts May 10 and June 20. In a harbinger of things to come, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. brought him back on four days' rest to annex the Mike Lee S. at Belmont, and the sophomore returned to air by 6 1/4 lengths in the nine-furlong Albany S. this past Wednesday. The original plan had been to wheel him back in the Travers, but owner James Riccio called an audible and opted for this spot instead. Let go at 11-1, Willy Beamin came away cleanly from his rail post, but was content to settle well off the pace set as expected by Trinniberg (Teufflesberg). Chased by Doctor Chit (War Front) through splits of :22.28 and :45.13, the Calder shipper drifted out a bit turning for home, and for a split second it looked as though 9-5 Currency Swap (High Cotton) would motor through on the rail. However, those runners began to tread water, and Willy Beamin, sent four wide by jockey Alan Garcia, came with a sharp late run to prevail in a blanket finish. "Unbelievable," said Riccio, who resides in Bayonne, New Jersey. "He started getting good, good, good. The other day he had a lot left in the tank, and he didn't even really ask him to run. [Rick] Dutrow is great at that. They run better the second time. This is the best [race] I've ever won, and to be at Saratoga in a Grade I with a claimer, I never dreamed of this."

Zagora, heroine of the prestigious GI Diana S. over this course in 2011, kicked off her 5-year-old campaign with a pair of graded wins at Tampa, including the GIII Hillsborough S. Mar. 10. A disappointing fifth as the 7-5 chalk in the GI Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland Apr. 14, the Martin Schwartz colorbearer got back on track with a 1 3/4-length decision in GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico May 19, then received a break. A flat third behind Winter Memories (El Prado {Ire}) while attempting to defend her title in the Diana, the hard-knocking chestnut lined up as the chalk here. With Ramon Dominguez aboard, Zagora was settled in fifth as the comebacking Summer Soiree led through an opening quarter in :23.70.

Ballston Spa cont.

Zagora began to make her move entering the far turn, was guided out four wide at the top of the stretch, took over from Summer Soiree in the stretch, and outkicked Hungry Island home while crushing Leroidesanimaux's course record of 1:39.92 set in 2005. "In hindsight, she probably needed the race," trainer Chad Brown said of Zagora's Diana. "She loves Saratoga, especially when it's firm. She just exploded today. Ramon rode her beautifully. Down the backside, I was feeling pretty good. She had a horse directly in front of her, but those fractions were pretty demanding. I knew she was ready to run. When he tipped her out, it was pretty much over." Dominguez added, "I had an absolutely beautiful trip. The filly with speed [Summer Soiree] went at it, and I was able to sit back. When it was time, I went around and she finished up very nicely for me."

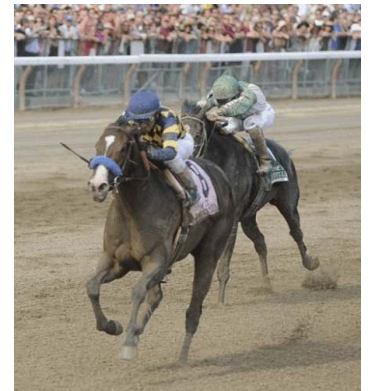

could go for the G2 May Hill S. [at Doncaster Sept. 14],
but will probably go straight for the G1 Fillies' Mile [at
Newmarket Sept. 28]," said winning trainer Mick
Channon.

Two of the top older fillies in the country renew their rivalry in today's GI Personal Ensign Invitational H. at the Spa. Besilu Stables' defending GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker), a dazzling 5 1/2-length victress over **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft) in Saratoga's GI Alabama S. last summer, has returned from a disappointing ninth in the G1 Dubai World Cup with a pair of victories, including a hard-fought neck decision over **Tiz Miz Sue** (Tiznow) in the GII Delaware H. July 21. Royal Delta fired a four-furlong warning shot for this in a bullet :48 2/5 over the Oklahoma training track Aug. 20. "She had to work at it [in the Delaware H.], without a doubt," Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott commented. "She had to work early and hang on late. With the difference in weight [nine pounds] she gave to the second horse, she ran quite well. She's doing well and she's proven in the past she can run well over this racetrack. She's highweight, and I suppose she deserves to be." It's Tricky, a valiant second to Royal Delta in the big one beneath the Twin Spires last November, has been perfect in three subsequent attempts at four, including a 3/4-length tally in the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont most recently May 28. The Godolphin racing colorbearer, off the board only once in 12 career attempts, defeated Royal Delta in the 2011 GI TVG Coaching Club American Oaks over this course. It's Tricky was scratched from Friday's seven-furlong GI Ballerina S. in favor of this spot. She's been working smartly at the nearby Greentree Training Center since, posting a sharp four-furlong move in :46 3/5 Aug. 18. "We have her coming back at 1 1/8 miles, and she hasn't raced in three months," trainer Kieran McLaughlin offered. "Hopefully we'll have her tight enough. She's training well and is coming into the race in great shape. We're ready to go."

"[Jeranimo's] races are being spread apart now," trainer Mike Pender told *Daily Racing Form*. "As he gets older, we've adjusted, reacting to him and letting him train us. He calls the shots at this stage." The 6-year-old earned an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in the Shoemaker. **Mr. Commons** (Artie Schiller), beaten only a nose in this contest last year, seeks his first victory since registering back-to-back wins in the GII Sir Beaufort S. Dec. 26 and the GII Arcadia S. Feb. 4. He was fourth, beaten two lengths, in the Shoemaker last time. **Obviously** (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}), second in the six-furlong Robert K. IN THE MASTER'S REALM

Not surprisingly, the leading trainer in the lists of the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville is Andre Fabre with eight renewals under his belt, and he saddles an intriguing pair of sophomores today headed by the aptly named **Masterstroke (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}). Runner-up to the re-opposing **Top Trip (GB)** (Dubai Destination) in Longchamp's G2 Prix Hocquart over 11 furlongs May 13, Godolphin's homebred filled the same spot in the G3 Prix du Lys over a furlong further at Chantilly June 17 before enjoying a confidence-boosting win in the Listed Prix Frederic de Lagrange over that distance at Vichy last time July 19. Also in the Godolphin livery is the progressive **Tenenbaum (GB)** (Authorized {Ire}), who stepped up from provincial efforts to beat subsequent G2 Prix Kergorlay runner-up Brigantin (Cozzene) by a neck in the Listed Prix de Reux over this course and distance last time Aug. 2. Of the older brigade, respect is due to Ecurie Wildenstein's 2011 G2 Prix Hocquart winner **Prairie Star (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre), who was a latest third under a penalty in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier over nearly two miles at Longchamp May 27; and also the British raider **Gatewood (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}). George Strawbridge's progressive 4-year-old took Royal Ascot's Listed Wolferton H. over 10 furlongs June 22 before finishing third in a slowly run G3 Glorious S. over a mile and a half at Goodwood last time Aug. 3. "There's only one logical pacemaker, so this will be tactical, but Gatewood is an easy horse to ride, quite versatile, and I'm pretty sure that you didn't see him at his best at Goodwood last time," jockey William Buick commented. "This track could play to his strengths, and if it were to come up soft, it certainly wouldn't be a concern."

SCALING THE HEIGHTS

In the absence of **"TDN Rising Stars"** Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) and Mars (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), today's G2 Futurity S. at The Curragh has lost some interest, but it still boasts a trio of unexposed colts from Ballydoyle headed by **Nevis (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}). He was fourth behind stable companion The United States (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) on debut over this track and trip July 1, a maiden is one of the best of its kind to have been run in this country so far this year, as it contained the smart Dibayani (Ire) (Shamardal) and subsequent dual group scorer Grafelli (Ire) (Hannouma {Ire}). Off the mark by three lengths in a mile maiden at Leopardstown in the interim July 19, the son of the Irish Oaks heroine Moonstone (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) has no stamina queries here, and it is significant that Joseph O'Brien has chosen him over the July 26 G3 Tyros S. third **Kingston Jamaica (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and the seven-furlong Leopardstown maiden winner **Flying the Flag (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). "Nevis is a nice horse and he won his maiden in Leopardstown nicely," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "We're hoping he'll have come on for that, and it will be interesting to see where he fits in with our other two-year-olds. The ground won't be ideal, but he did handle slow ground at Leopardstown the last day." Past evidence shows that none of the trio can be dismissed on jockey arrangements alone, and all are open to huge progression from the world's finest improver of a horse Aidan O'Brien, who is currently on seven wins in this race and creeping ever closer to the record of 16 renewals for his predecessor Dr. Vincent O'Brien. On form lines through the aforementioned Dibayani, Team Valor's recent acquisition **First Cornerstone (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) has strong claims, as he had that rival 5 1/2 lengths back in third in Tipperary's Listed Canford Cliffs S. over nearly 7 1/2 furlongs last time Aug. 10. Trainer Andrew Oliver told *PA Sport*, "I thought with the way the weather has gone, Dawn Approach would be an unlikely runner and I didn't think Mars would go either, so it's cut up pretty much as I thought it would. Our horse is in good form, and we'll have to see what happens with the ground. It's soft now and there is more rain on the way. He's a nice-moving horse, but he showed at Tipperary he can handle softer ground. Depending on how much rain we get, he could be going into the unknown on Sunday, so we'll see what happens. I don't think anyone wants it very soft. This is another step up for him. He was bought by Team Valor, who are based in America, earlier this week so they will make future plans after Sunday." **Cont. p16**

NEWFANGLED EUTHANIZED

Princess Haya of Jordan's impressive G3 Albany S. victress **Newfangled** (New Approach {Ire}--Scarlet Ibis, by Machiavellian), who sustained a pelvic fracture during Thursday's G2 Lowther S. at York, was euthanized Friday as a result of her injuries. Inserted at the head of ante-post betting lists for next year's G1 1000 Guineas in the wake of her blistering Royal Ascot success, she was pulled up early during her latest test. "It is a tragic accident and we have lost a hugely talented filly," trainer John Gosden told *Racing Post*. "She has received constant attention every minute from the vets, both at York and Newmarket, as well as my staff. The effort everyone put in to saving her was massive, but by Friday evening things were looking very grim and she was beginning to suffer much too much. In the end there was little option; her injuries were too severe. Everyone did everything they could, it was a remarkable team effort and everyone here at the yard is going through this loss together, but we had to do right by the horse. She was a very sound filly and it goes without saying that she was phenomenal. I've never trained a 2-year-old that was as fast as her--she was a fantastic talent."



FORMER JOCKEY PETER ALAFI DIES

One of Germany's all-time leading jockeys Peter Alafi died Tuesday. He was 76. Born in Hungary, Alafi was already a top jockey in his homeland when riots there forced him to flee the country. He went to Germany, via Vienna in Austria, and started out at Gestut Rottgen before moving on to Herbert Cohn at Krefeld, and then to Bruno Schutz and Sven von Mitzlaff at Cologne. He rode his three greatest winners for the latter, the German Triple Crown winner **Konigsstuhl (Ger)** (Dschingis Khan {Ger}) and the G1 Deutsches Derby winners **Orofino (Ger)** (Dschingis Khan {Ger}) and **Ordos (Ger)** (Frontal {Fr}). The last trainer he worked for was Harro Remmert who took over from Sven von Mitzlaff. One of the best horses at that time was Acatenango (Ger)'s contemporary **Kamiros (Ire)** (Star Appeal {Ire}), who won the G2 Deutsches St Leger and the G1 Preis von Europa. With 2,307 wins to his credit, Alafi remains Germany's winningest jockey, and Andrasch Starke is the only current rider remotely near this record. Alafi is survived by his two children, Peter Jr. and Eva.
