

DULLAHAN SHIPS IN FOR PACIFIC SCORE

Heading into yesterday's GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, Donegal Racing's **Dullahan** (Even the Score) hadn't visited the winner's circle since a solid score in the

Apr. 14 GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. Facing off in a competitive affair which included West Coast stand outs **Game On Dude**

(Awesome Again), **Rail Trip** (Jump Start) and **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid), the striking chestnut needed to produce his best effort and he did just that

with a record-setting performance, earning an automatic berth in to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 3. "How about that," said Tammy Fox, assistant to trainer Dale Romans. "Oh my God; he ran great. I'm so glad we can come to California and take the west coast money. They always take our money, now we're taking theirs." Off at odds of 5-1, he was well-rated under Joel Rosario as rank outsider **Riveting Reason** (Fusaichi Pegasus) made the early running. **Game On Dude**, the expected pacesetter, was unhurried in third, and while he put his head in front as

they moved into the far turn, it was Dullahan who caught the eye as he began mowing down rivals with a five-wide move. Once into the stretch, Dullahan cut into **Game On Dude's** lead with every stride and was along in plenty of time to get up and win by a length. **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) finished third and **Rail Trip** (Jump Start) completed the super.

"[Dullahan's connections] didn't give me any special instructions," said Rosario. "Just said the obvious: he's a closer, save ground if you can, then make a late run. It

worked out perfect. He's a one-paced horse. He just goes and goes. When we went for home and I saw [Game On Dude] in front of me, I knew I had a big chance. My horse was coming and coming. He doesn't stop. He's a nice horse; a very nice horse." **Cont. p3**

LOVE AND A LITTLE BIT OF LUCK

Overlooked at odds of 10-1 in a field loaded with quality, **Love and Pride** (A.P. Indy) took advantage of a messy start by Grade I winner **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft) and repelled the late run of reigning champion 3-year-old filly **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) to punch her ticket to Santa Anita when taking Sunday's Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" designated GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga. The tone for the race was set as soon as the gate flew open as favored **It's Tricky** went to her knees, spotting the field several lengths. Meanwhile, **Love and Pride**--with blinkers off--enjoyed a better break and settled in second behind **Brushed by a Star** (Eddington), who set an opening half in :47 3/5. Keeping that rival in her sights down the backstretch, the Green Hills Farm runner inherited the lead as the pacesetter began to wilt following three quarters in 1:11 1/5. Turning for home, **Love and Pride** drifted out enough to allow **It's Tricky**, who was hustled into position after her troubled start, slip through along the inside as **Royal Delta**--with Mike Smith at the helm--took the overland route. For a brief moment, it appeared the champion would not have the necessary kick to challenge the new leader but, while she found extra to reel in **Love and Pride** nearing the wire, she didn't have enough to seal the deal and had to play the bridesmaid. Despite trying her best along the inner, **It's Tricky's** early exertions appeared to have taken their toll in the stretch and the Godolphin runner had to settle for third. **Cont. p4**

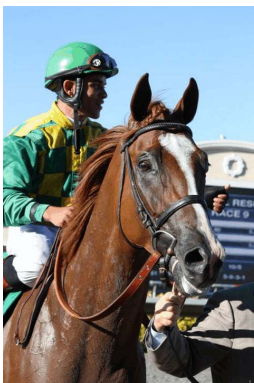

Trying to capture his fourth victory from five starts so far in 2012, Game on Dude entered this year's Pacific Classic off wins in the June 2 GII Californian and the July 7 GI Hollywood Gold Cup. The bay finished

fourth in last year's renewal of the 1 1/4-mile race. "That was him making that move on the backstretch. I didn't send him," explained Chantal Sutherland, aboard the runner up. "He just got strong at the five [furlong pole]. He wanted to go. When he put his head in front of David [Flores on longshot Riveting Reason], he was fine. Then around the sixteenth pole, as I was switching my stick to the left hand, I pushed my rein loose. It was dangling at the end; it looked awful sloppy. I haven't done something like that in 13 years. But

I don't think it affected anything. He was still doing what he could do. Just unfortunate." Dullahan launched his juvenile campaign with little fanfare sprinting at Churchill Downs last summer, but was only a nose removed from getting off the duck going past a mile at Saratoga in August. Third in the grassy with GII With Anticipation S. in September, he came back to score in the GI Breeders' Futurity over Keeneland's Polytrack Oct. 8. Sent off at 17-1 for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the half to GI Kentucky Derby hero Mine That Bird (Birdstone) closed well to be fourth. Second in his seasonal bow in the GIII Palm Beach S. over the Gulfstream turf course Mar. 11, he overcame a tardy start to score in the GI Blue Grass S. A fast-closing third in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby, he was well-beaten in both the June 9 GI Belmont S. and the July 29 GI Haskell Invitational S., and was sent west in hopes of recapturing his best form.

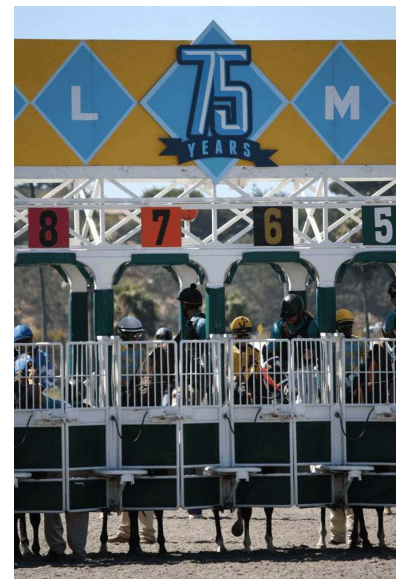

Dullahan is only the third horse in Pacific Classic history to win without being having run his last race at either Del Mar or Hollywood Park, joining Bertrando ('93, Monmouth Park) and Student Council '07, Churchill Downs) ... The victory makes Dullahan only the fourth 3-year-old to defeat older rivals in the Classic, joining Best Pal '91, General Challenge '99 and Came Home '02.

Recently inducted into the Racing Hall of Fame, John Velazquez was reunited with the filly after a two-race absence. "We broke well, and I wanted to give her the best chance the first part of the race as I could without letting her run off with me," explained Velazquez. "She broke on top and I saw [jockey] Corey Nakatani [aboard Brushed by a Star] wanted to go to the lead, so I got off them a little bit. I had her in a pretty decent spot and the other horse kept pushing me to the outside and she got a little more aggressive. I just waited there until we got to the three-eighths pole, and when I saw [It's Tricky] get through on the inside, it was time to go and she responded right away." Commenting on her switching leads in the stretch, Velazquez added, "She does not like the whip. I was in front and I thought maybe I'll just show it to her and keep her mind to running, and it was a mistake. I showed it to her and she went back to the left lead and she started waiting instead of completely going. I learned something new; don't show it to her."

Love and Pride, an impressive winner in her Spa debut in last August's Proud Spell S., failed to find the winner's circle her four final starts of the season, including a third in the Nov. 26 GI Gazelle S. at Belmont. Back on top following the Jan. 28 Affectionately H. at the Big A, the Green Hills Farm representative was second in a muddy renewal of the GI Top Flight H. Mar. 3 before finishing fourth in the Apr. 21 GI Sixty Sails H. at Hawthorne. A narrow second after showing speed in the May 19 GI Allaire DuPont Distaff at Pimlico, the dark bay went wire-to-wire in Delaware's GI Obeah S. June 16. Most recently, the well-bred filly tired to fourth in the 10-furlong GI Delaware H. July 21.

"Being an A.P. Indy, she probably gets a mile and a quarter; she just doesn't want to go as fast as she did the last time [in the Grade 2 Delaware H.], so we made a couple of adjustments," explained winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "The team at Delaware did a great job with her, had her ready to go, and training over that deeper surface, I think, may have paid off today. Michael Dilger, my Delaware assistant and I had about a 10-second conversation, and we figured we had nothing to lose [by taking off the blinkers]. We were just trying to get her to turn off a little bit. When Johnny [Velazquez] showed her the stick the first time, she jumped to her left lead, and that's kind of always been her, so he just kind of had to pick her up and hand ride her aggressively from there."

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Capital Account was far from disgraced when third, beaten just 1 1/4 lengths by sprint champion Amazombie (Northern Afleet), while making his stakes debut in the July 29 GI Bing Crosby S. last time out. The bay sat a stalking trip in a tightly bunched field down the backstretch as Don Tito (Trippi) and Coil set an opening quarter in :23.78. Camp Victory began to challenge for the lead in earnest after a pedestrian half in :46.81. Coil turned back that rival's attack in upper stretch, while Capital Account, widest into the stretch, surged into contention in the final furlong and outbattled his stablemate to the wire, with a final quarter mile completed in :22.68. "He broke just a shade slow, but there was no rush," explained winning rider David Flores.

"I had a feeling there wasn't going to be a lot of pace and I just wanted to stay close. You can put him where you want him and he's easy to work with. When it came time, I asked him and he gave me a big response. A very good race for him." Trainer Bob Baffert, who saddled the first two finishers, added, "[Camp Victory] was the horse to beat; he's a really good horse. But there wasn't a lot of pace, they were sort of walking around there and then turned it into a sprint for home. Advantage to Capital Account, he's a really fast horse and he's run some really big races. Coil really ran well, but Rafael [Bejarano] had to use him a little when it looked like [Camp Victory] was making a move. One-two, we'll take it either way."



Trakus Fact: Capital Account covered his final eighth in :11.31, his final quarter in :22.68, and his final three-eighths in :34.43. He ran 11 feet farther than runner-up Coil.

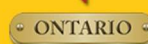

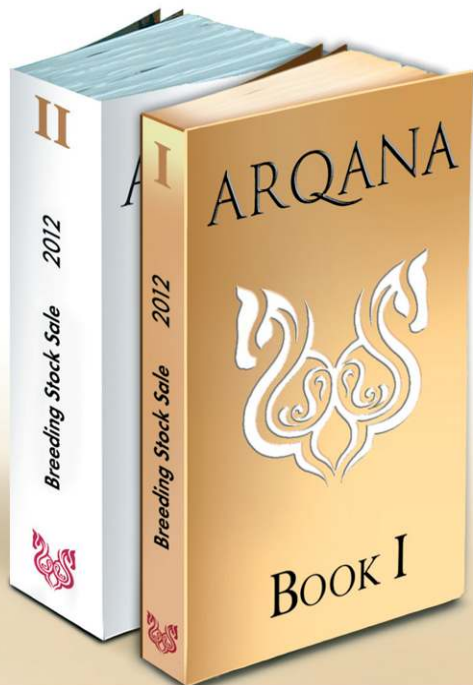

This race was initially the target of the **TDN Rising Star** ☆ Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) and Mars (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), but with an unfavorable weather forecast casting uncertainty over their participation, trainer Andrew Oliver took the shrewd step of supplementing First Cornerstone earlier this week. With no relenting in the rain in Ireland, the two star turns were absent from the final declarations and the race was opened up further as Ballydoyle also scratched the likely favorite Nevis (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) due to the change in ground conditions. First Cornerstone had the form to figure here regardless, having followed an encouraging debut dead-heat for third in a seven-furlong Down Royal maiden July 27 with a win in Tipperary's Listed Canford Cliffs S. over nearly 7 1/2 furlongs last time Aug. 10. In that contest, he left a host of smart yardsticks and highly regarded types trailing, including Dibayani (Ire) (Shamardal), Einsteins Folly (Ire) (Whipper) and the O'Brien-trained favorite King George River (Ire) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), and formlines suggested he had a class edge here. Racing in third early as Kingston Jamaica (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) set a strong pace for stable companion Flying the Flag, who Joseph O'Brien had switched to after the withdrawal of Nevis, the blaze-faced chestnut received an early slap with Chris Hayes's whip with a quarter mile remaining. Responding to take over from the tiring front-runner with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, he was always holding Flying the Flag in the run to the line, with the British challenger and other joint-favorite Birdman never able to land a serious blow in third.

"He's a lovely horse and I fancied him all week," Hayes said. "Going into the Tipperary race, you wouldn't be thinking he was good enough, but he's a real nice horse and I liked him from one previous piece of work before his debut. When Nevis was taken out this morning, I went through the race with Andy and we thought we'd ride our own race and let him get into his own rhythm. When we did, it was smooth sailing from halfway and I just didn't want to hit the front too soon as he was green at Tipperary. He'd have no problem stepping up to a mile and the ground suited him. He's a lovely big horse and he deserves his chance in a Group 1 now."

Quick Return for Team Valor...

Team Valor International Chief Executive Officer Barry Irwin had made plans to visit Germany for this week's Baden Baden yearling sale, and he ended up doing some shopping early when stopping over in Ireland to seal the deal on a listed stakes winner by Hurricane Run (Ire) last week. That move ended up paying dividends when the 2-year-old colt, named First Cornerstone, won yesterday's G2 Galileo EBF Futurity S. at the Curragh. A narrowly beaten third after a troubled trip in his career debut in a Down Royal maiden July 27, the colt who RNA'd for €12,000 as a GOFSEPT yearling, showed grit when winning the Listed Coolmore Canford Cliffs S. at 33-1 over heavy ground at Tipperary Aug. 10.

Sent off at much shorter odds yesterday, the chestnut found cover early behind Flying the Flag, quickened under urging inside the final 200 metres, and bested that rival comfortably.

Irwin noted that he had been trying to buy First Cornerstone for a few weeks, but was initially not keen on the idea of running the colt in the Futurity, which had once been expected to attract leading 2-year-old Dawn Approach (Ire).

“The price didn’t bother me too much, but the trainer and the owner wanted to run here in the Futurity, and I really didn’t want to because I thought the race was going to be too tough,” Irwin explained. “[Trainer Andy Oliver] told me he thought the ground was going to be very soft and heavy, and that a couple of the horses that were expected to run, he didn’t think they would. I wanted the horse, so I just bit the bullet and we bought him in the middle of the week, which didn’t give us a whole lot of time to syndicate him or promote him.”

Team Valor was able to sell half the shares in the horse right away, and will now look to sell the other half.

Irwin said that prior to purchasing First Cornerstone, he was impressed with the colt’s races, and the fact that he seemed to be defying his pedigree.

“He’s by a horse that was a mile-and-a-half horse, yet this horse, I wouldn’t call him precocious, but he’s certainly doing a lot more as a 2-year-old than what you would expect from a Hurricane Run,” Irwin said. “Every time you see a horse that does something different than his breeding suggests, that either means he took after his dam or that means that he’s out of the ordinary. And I think this horse might be out of the ordinary.”

Irwin noted that he purchased the horse with the intention of bringing him to America, but he will likely stay with his current yard in Ireland for one more race before traveling across the Atlantic for the Breeders’ Cup.



“After this race I think my guys would make him eligible for the Breeders’ Cup,” Irwin said. “So just off the top of my head without making a decision or analyzing it too much, I would think we’d run this horse back in a Grade 1, either the National S. [Sept. 15 at the Curragh] or the Racing Post Trophy S. [Oct. 27 at Doncaster], something like that, then we’ll probably bring him over for the Breeders’ Cup. I’d like to run him once more over here just to see what direction we really want to go in. He was in a pretty good battle [in the Futurity] for a furlong with a horse I know Aidan O’Brien likes, and he put that horse away, so it’s got to make you feel good.”--*Kelsey Riley*



This term, he had been runner-up to the main G1 July Cup protagonists The Cheka (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) and Mayson (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in both the Listed Cammidge Trophy at Doncaster Mar. 31 and Listed Abernant S. at Newmarket Apr. 19, respectively, before filling the same spot in the G3 Greenlands S. at The Curragh May 26. Off the board in the June 19 G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and in a six-furlong conditions event at Doncaster Aug. 4, he was roused into early action here and, after tracking the pace in a close-up second, was committed on the front passing halfway for a gutsy score. "Going into the race, [trainer] Clive Cox told me he was doing well and I got a perfect trip," jockey Gerald Mosse commented. "These English horses are tough and know how to hold on to the end."

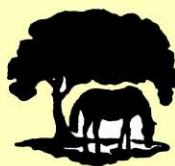

Pletcher Duo Prepare for Woodward

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out Saturday's GI Woodward S. candidates **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) and **Rule** (Roman Ruler) to work five furlongs Sunday morning. Working in tandem, the pair negotiated the distance in 1:00.03 over the main track. The move was the fastest of 23 at the distance for the duo, both coming off disappointing efforts in their most recent starts. WinStar Farm's Rule was ninth behind Fort Larned in the GI Whitney Invitational H. Aug. 4, while Repole Stable's Stay Thirsty was fifth in the GII Suburban H. July 7 at Belmont. "They both worked well; I'm happy with both of them," said Pletcher. "It seemed Rule worked more along the lines of how he worked prior to [winning the GII Monmouth Cup July 7] and the way he worked before he was third in the Woodward last year. It seems like he's ready to go." The trainer added that Stay Thirsty, who won last year's GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S. over the track, worked "as well as he's ever worked." Saratoga's leading rider, Ramon Dominguez, will ride Rule in the Woodward, said Pletcher, with Javier Castellano aboard Stay Thirsty.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Alpha & Golden Ticket Likely for Pennsylvania

One day after **Alpha** (Bernardini)'s shared victory with **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) in the GI Travers S., trainer Kieran McLaughlin was still basking in the glow of his first Mid-Summer Derby win. "A win's a win," McLaughlin said. "We're happy, very happy. It's a great win, and it's a win, that's the most important thing." During a less-than-ideal lead up into the Kentucky Derby, the Godolphin representative was runner-up behind Gemologist in the Apr. 7 GI Wood Memorial. In that Derby prep, the handsome bay sustained a laceration on his left foreleg which later became infected, thus delaying his departure for Kentucky. Only 12th in the May 5 Run for the Roses, he was pointed toward the June 9 GI Belmont S., but was scratched 10 days before that engagement after developing a temperature.

"He's just done this in the last 90 days," McLaughlin said pointing upward. "It's been amazing. It worked out perfectly what we planned after [his] being sick. We shipped him up [to Saratoga] on June 2, and this is what we wanted to do. It doesn't always work that way, so it was great that it did. The plan came together. In the paddock [Saturday], he never turned a hair, and that's what we were worried a little bit about. At the gate he was great. So, he has matured and has done extremely well up here. He just didn't do well in Kentucky. Getting sick before the Belmont is a blessing, looking back."

According to McLaughlin, the GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 22 at Parx Racing and the GI TVG Jockey Club Gold Cup Invitational Sept. 29 at Belmont are both possibilities for Alpha's next start. The sophomore will remain in Saratoga at the Greentree Training Center until his next start.

"I spoke to Simon [Crisford, Godolphin Racing Manager] Saturday evening," McLaughlin said. "He asked me, 'What would be the most logical spot?' And I said, 'Well, the Pennsylvania Derby is in one month, and it's straight 3-year-olds for \$1 million, the same day as [stablemate] Questing [GB, Hard Spun] going there [for the GI Cotillion S.].' It's a likely choice. Then you have Jockey Club Gold Cup the next week. It's older [horses], but that's the other spot to talk about, with the Breeders' Cup then the next stop."

Also possible for the Pennsylvania Derby is Golden Ticket, owned by Magic City Thoroughbred Partners. According to trainer Ken McPeek, the colt wasn't originally slated to run in the Travers. Runner-up in an allowance in May at Churchill Downs, McPeek initially planned to run the colt in a Saratoga allowance followed by an overnight stakes, but both failed to fill.

"We had been watching this horse train, and Danny Ramsey, who has a really good talent galloping for me, was telling me how good he was doing," McPeek said. "He went :59 [3/5, Aug. 13] over the Oklahoma track and that was faster than I've had any horse work there. He went :59 there and that's like :57 anywhere else."

While Golden Ticket, who was supplemented into the field as a separate entry from **Atigun** (Istan), enjoyed a clean trip en route to victory, his stablemate was forced to check when Street Life (Street Sense) abruptly slowed down because of a minor injury. The latter was drawn out five wide on the far turn and closed well to be fourth.

"Atigun, he got stopped," explained McPeek. "He could have won that race. He had to go outside, but he ran a great race in his own right. Atigun cleaned up his feed tub and Golden Ticket didn't. He's a little tired." McPeek added that Atigun might make his next start in the Jockey Club Gold Cup.

Street Life "Comfortable" Following Travers

Street Life (Street Sense), who ran last of 11 and was vanned off the track following Saturday's GI Travers S., was "happy and comfortable" Sunday morning after suffering a soft tissue injury to his left front pastern during the race. Trainer Chad Brown said he will wait a few days for the swelling to go down before having an ultrasound test to further evaluate the damage.

"All the bony structures in his leg X-rayed perfect," Brown relayed. "Hopefully, it's not a career-ending injury. At this point it's kind of up in the air. The pastern is somewhat of a complex structure with tendons and ligaments all in that area. We really want to zero in on where the damage is, if there is any, which we suspect there is. We just don't know the extent of it, but we're happy to report that the horse is happy, and it's in no way a life-threatening situation. All the bones in his leg are in place and look good."

Victorious in the July 27 Curlin S. at Saratoga, Street Life was the fourth betting choice in the Travers. Second to last in the early going, Street Life, under jockey Jose Lezcano, was pulled up soon after the wire.

"I loved where he was down the backside, because he was in his normal position near the rear of the field, but he was in good contact to run them down," explained Brown. "The way the race was unfolding, I was OK with it. When he entered the turn and Fast Falcon ended up going around him, that's when I was worried. That's about the time Jose said when he went to his left lead, he just didn't feel quite right."

Brown praised Lezcano for his handling of Street Life, who he has ridden in five of his eight career starts. "As soon as Jose came off the horse, he came over to me before I could get to the horse and said, 'Something just wasn't quite right, boss,'" Brown said. "That's how he put it to me. I'm happy he took care of the horse. He did the right thing. He knows the horse, and he wasn't hitting the ground quite right. I feel bad for everyone involved with the horse, because I thought he had a really good chance. But, it could have been a lot worse."

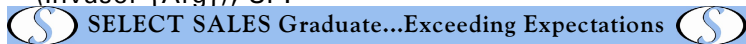
