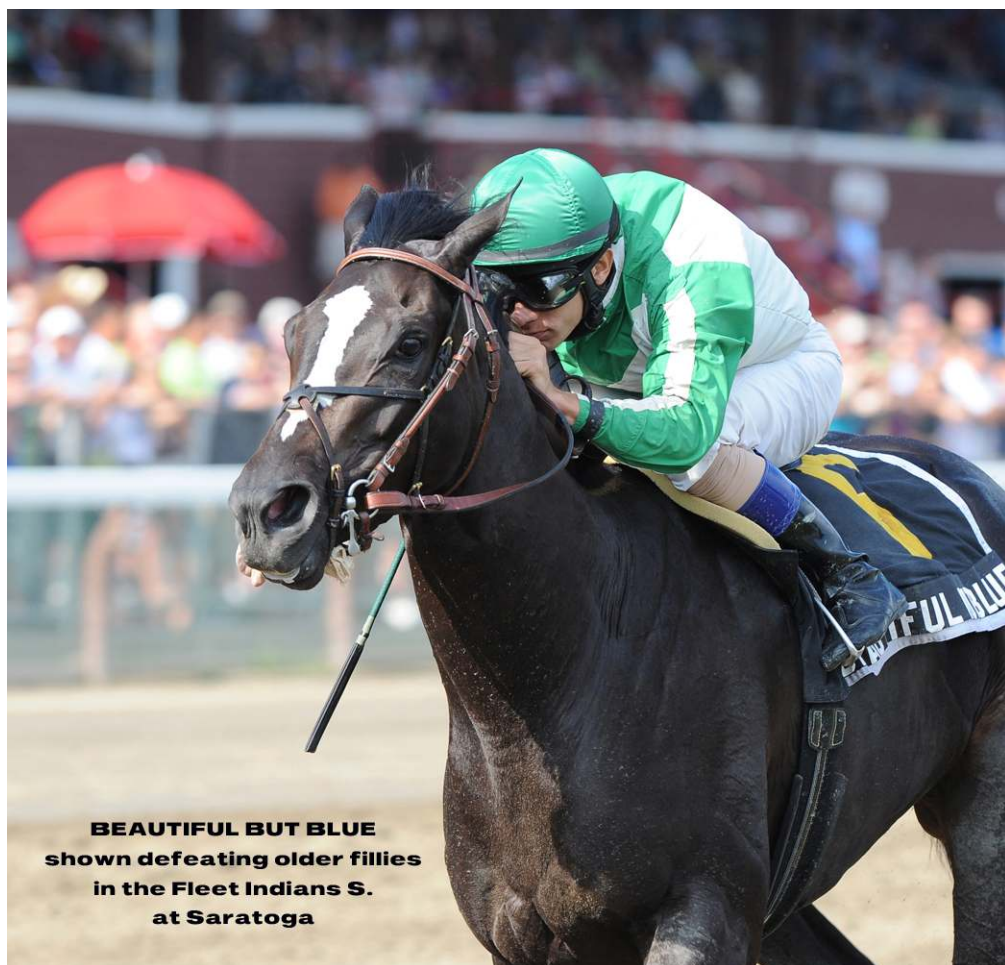


Steady Progress...

Victorious in the GIII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. at two, **To Honor and Serve** was a fringe player and missed the Triple Crown, but came to hand later in the season, with wins in the Cigar and the GII Pennsylvania Derby sandwiched around a better-than-it-looks seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. He cruised in his 2012 debut in the Apr. 28 GIII Westchester H., but was third to Shackleford (Forestry) in the GI Met Mile May 28 and a flat fourth to **Mucho Macho Man** in the GII Suburban H. July 7. "I told my story the last time about how I thought the heat had him agitated, and he didn't do very well in the 97 degrees that day," said Mott. The Woodward would be the ultimate shot at redemption and so it proved.

Down to the Wire in the Rematch...

Rule (Roman Ruler) and **Trickmeister** (Proud Citizen) were the longshot leaders in the Woodward, as **To Honor** and **Serve** took up a tracking spot in third. **Mucho Macho Man** was a touch slow into stride, but slipped up the inside to be just behind the pacesetters on what might have been the worst part of the track on the day, with **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) lapped to his outside. **Gourmet Dinner** (Trippi) and **Cease** (War Chant) were the back markers. **Rule** and **Trickmeister** were still at it as they left the half-mile pole in the rear view, but **To Honor** and **Serve** was creeping ever closer while still three wide on the turn and came to tackle **Rule** at the head of the stretch. **Mucho Macho Man** was able to find room underneath a tiring **Trickmeister** and the two market leaders had the race between them entering the final furlong. **Mucho Macho Man** ranged up going well and looked to have all the momentum, but **To Honor** and **Serve** dug in, despite drifting out noticeably, and held gamely to the wire. "He got to the quarter-pole in hand without me asking him to do anything," said Velazquez. "When he got to the lead, he started waiting. I thought he was going to gallop, but when he got by himself, he started waiting. When the other horse came to him, he started fighting. It was a great effort." A maiden winner in a single start at three, Emcee
dusted an in-form Associate (Wando) by a six lengths in
a first-level Gulfstream allowance Feb. 3 before
finishing a length third behind Calibrachoa (Southern
Image) and Caleb's Posse (Posse) when favored in the
GIII Tom Fool H. Mar. 3. He was seriously compromised
when losing his footing at the break of the GI Carter H.
at Aqueduct Apr. 7 and could do no better than fourth
of five behind Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil), but
received just the confidence booster he needed when
storming home at 1-2 in a May 5 Belmont optional-
claimer. Pointed for this meeting thereafter, Emcee
resumed in the Vanderbilt, but drew inside, was forced
to duel through fast splits from that position and stayed
on very gamely for third, beaten two necks. Emcee
broke alertly, but Alan Garcia was happy to concede
the lead to Pacific Ocean, who got away with a slow
pace to win the GIII James Marvin S. on opening day.
The Dutrow runner got the opening quarter in a
relatively comfortable :22.64 and the half in an easy
:45:38 while tracked by Emcee. With Pacific Ocean
making the running well off the inside, Edgar Prado
rolled the dice up the fence and sent Jersey Town to
the front turning for home, but that lead was short-
lived, as Emcee kept to his work under a patient Garcia
and came home fastest of all. It was the fourth Grade I
win of the meet for Godolphin.

The \$650,000 topper from this year's OBS April Sale, Executiveprivilege was the easiest kind of winner in her June 28 debut over the Hollywood Cushion Track and made it look equally academic when adding the July 14 Landaluce S. by 3 1/4 lengths. Sent off the prohibitive 2-5 chalk for the GIII Sorrento S. at this track Aug. 8, the attractive bay filly was three wide for most of the trip, but drove to the front approaching the final furlong and held sway by 1 1/4 lengths. Drawn one from the outside in stall eight, Executiveprivilege was smooth into stride, but drifted back into midfield, further than she has been in any of her previous appearances. Meanwhile, Beholder was able to clear the field from the widest gate and set a good pace up front and was still going great guns as they raced around the turn. Executiveprivilege was now beginning her advance, but was still trapped out wide and seemed to want to drift to her right in upper stretch. That nearly proved her undoing, but she kept her mind on business and was just able to tag a luckless Beholder at the wire.

Dominus followed a Santa Anita maiden score with a near-miss second in the GIII Derby Trial S. last April before wiring the field in the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont in July. The dark bay had no alibi when third to Stay Thirsty (Bernardini) in the GII Jim Dandy S. four weeks later, and went missing after a decent fourth in the GI King's Bishop S. in late August. He made a successful debut for this barn, taking an Aug. 4 allowance for fun over this main track and was trying the infield for the first time here. The controlling speed of the Baruch on paper, Dominus made an easy lead while getting only token pressure from Guys Reward with favored Data Link hostage to the pace back on the rail in third. Julien Leparoux asked Dominus to kick for home leaving the far turn and the result was never in any doubt, as Dominus cut the corner and covered his final 2 1/2 furlongs in a swift :28.05 for the victory. Sky Blazer dwelt a bit at the start and ran on nicely to round out the triple. "He was the only speed in the race, he just galloped easy, broke easy, and it was pretty easy for him," Leparoux commented. "He's a big horse. He's got this long stride, but when you ask him he's pretty light on himself, so hopefully we'll keep going like this and win more big ones."

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Tu Endie Wei, honored as Canada's champion juvenile filly last year, came up short in two tries in New York against her own generation, but got back on track here while facing her elders for the first time. Returned to sprints but again trying something new--the grass--in the Alywow S. June 3, she faltered badly in the stretch and came home sixth. It was another new test when trying conventional dirt for the first time in the GIII Victory Ride S. at Belmont July 7, and she ran with credit after a stumbling start, finishing third to Emma's Encore (Congrats). She had less luck against that foe when returned to the Empire State for the GI Prioress S. at Saratoga Aug. 4, trailing home last, and was in need of a wake-up call in this homecoming. Up from the rail draw to press to the inside of the odds-on pacesetter Roxy Gap, she put her nose in front after a modest quarter in :23 3/5 and continued to duel around the turn as Jenny's So Great made it three in a line in the quarter-mile sprint to the wire. Tu Endie Wei began to assert in mid-stretch and came home strongest.

He pinched a winning break and was never seriously menaced as Mister Marti Gras gained mildly from the backfield.

ANYONE'S RACE IN DEL MAR DERBY

How wide open is today's GII Del Mar Derby going nine furlongs over Del Mar's turf? Eastern invader **Howe Great** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) has been tabbed as the tepid 7-2 morning-line pick, but it's conceivable he'll be no better than the third or fourth choice by the time the gates opens. Still, the Team Valor International colorbearer has the credentials. He was a close-up second to Summer Front (War Front) in the GIII Hill Prince S. at Belmont June 16, then lived up to 1-5 favoritism in the grassy Jersey Derby at Monmouth July 12. "The stable looks pretty far in advance for races, so I think this race has been under consideration for awhile," Heather Craig, assistant to trainer H. Graham Motion, explained of why they made the trip west. "They were thinking about taking him to Saratoga, which would have meant taking on Summer Front again, but opted to go to Monmouth for the Jersey Derby, which worked out when he won. So it was to wait for something at Belmont or come here, and the decision was to come here." **Old Time Hockey** (Smarty Jones) gamely defeated **My Best Brother** (Stormy Atlantic) by a nose in the GII La Jolla H. here Aug. 11, a start after My Best Brother had **Tones (Ire)** (Strategic Prince {GB}) and Old Time Hockey behind him in a division of the Oceanside July 18. Trainer Tom Proctor won the Del Mar Derby last year with the ill-fated Banned (Kitten's Joy), but is a bit less bullish this time around. "Last year when I ran Banned in there I thought I could get a bad trip and still win, and did," Proctor said. "That's not going to be the case this year. I better have a good trip." **Brother Francis** (Lion Heart) hit the board in several graded stakes before breaking his maiden in impressive fashion over the main track Aug. 5.

READY TO 'ROLL' IN SAPLING

Trainer Todd Pletcher has three entered in today's GIII Sapling S. at Monmouth Park, but, with **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union) and **Lawn Man** (Flatter) also entered in Saratoga's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Monday, it seems a good chance that **Drum Roll** (Majestic Warrior) will be his lone representative in the gate. A \$300,000 OBSMAR acquisition by the Coolmore partners, Drum Roll opened his account with a 2 3/4-length score in a local five-furlong test July 8, then shipped to the Spa to be a tired fourth to Spurious Precision (High Cotton) after attending blistering splits. Jockey Chris DeCarlo, who didn't make the trip to Saratoga that day, gets the mount again, and believes Drum Roll will be competitive if he runs back to his maiden win. "In his race here, he broke a little slow and then got bumped," said DeCarlo. "Once he got rolling, he took me there [to the front] on his own. He hit his gear and there was no stopping him." A horse with similar past performance lines is **Brave Dave** (Put It Back), who broke his maiden at Calder at first asking June 30 before himself finishing fourth in a Spa juvenile stakes--the GII Sanford S. July 22--after pressing a sub-:45 half. He drifted out badly in the Sanford, but trainer Eddie Plesa, Jr. thinks he show more maturity today. "He had a little bit of trouble around the turn," Plesa explained. "Now he's coming out of that race with more knowledge and more experience, and we'll move forward off that effort." In his most recent work, Brave Dave posted a best-of-81, four-furlong drill in :47 flat. "He is coming up to it as good as any horse can come up to a race," Plesa said. "His last two works have been exceptional, and this is a race we've been pointing to all summer long with him. He's got a ton of speed, and I'm very anxious for [the race]."

Bred by Bert Firestone in Ireland, Theatrical was a member of Nureyev's lone European crop and captured his only start at two. Following a win in the G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial, the bay faltered as the favorite in the 1985 G1 Epsom Derby before finishing second in the G1 Irish Derby, and concluded his 3-year-old season with an unplaced effort in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf. Though Theatrical failed to visit the winner's circle in 1986, he distinguished himself with a second to champion Estrapade in the G1 Oak Tree Invitational prior to a neck loss to champion Manila in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, and finished up the year with a third in the blanket finish of the G1 Hollywood Turf Cup. Kept in training at age five by Allen Paulson, Theatrical put forth a sterling season, capturing the G1 Hialeah Turf Cup, the G1 Red Smith H., the G1 Bowling Green H. and the G1 Sword Dancer Invitational in succession before finishing third to Manila in the G1 Arlington Million. But he concluded his championship season in style, reeling off victories in the G1 Turf Classic, the G1 Man o' War and the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, defeating Arc hero Trempolino in his career finale. He retired with earnings of \$2,924,115 and a record of 21-10-3-2.

At stud, Theatrical established himself as consistent source of high quality turf performers. Japanese champion Hishi Amazon, from his third crop, remains his highest earner with a bankroll of over \$6.9 million, but the bay was represented by a series of international top-class performers, including European Classic winners Madeleine's Dream and Zagreb, as well as G1 Melbourne Cup hero Media Puzzle. On these shores, Theatrical boasted standouts such as Astra, Auntie Mame, Geri and Royal Anthem. In recent years, he was responsible by the brilliant Shakespeare and four-time Grade I winner Winchester. From 22 crops, brisnet.com credits him with 80 black-type winners (8% of foals) and progeny earnings of \$51,024,108.

His daughters have produced the likes of champion and successful young sire English Channel (Smart Strike), as well as G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero Rail Link (GB) (Dansili {GB}).

Shackleford Derailed By Cough...

The complexion of the G1 Forego S. changed dramatically when the 2-1 morning-line pick **Shackleford** (Forestry) was scratched yesterday morning. "He had a little cough last week and a little cough [Saturday] morning, so we're going to play it safe," said Dale Romans, who trains the 4-year-old for Michael Lauffer, W.D. Cubbedge, and Phillips Racing Partnership. Last year's G1 Preakness S. hero won the G1 Met Mile two starts back, and was looking to bounce back after a last-of-eight performance in the G1 Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. Aug. 5, contested over a muddy Spa track. Shackleford will reportedly return to Romans's base at Churchill to prepare for the G1 Kelso S. at Belmont Sept. 29.

Cirrus Awaits Frankel Faceoff...

Connections of **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) have opted to sidestep Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown and build up gradually to a repeat bid in the G1 Champion S. at Ascot. Off since suffering from an infected cut to his fetlock after his second in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 27, the triple Group 1 winner is being targeted at the Oct. 20 Champions' Day feature. "He will not run in Ireland," trainer Corine Barande-Barbe told *PA Sport*. "The Irish Champion looks like it will be a very good race and it might be too much for him--he has been off for a long time. He is very well and we are very happy with him, but we will prepare for Ascot in France. He could run in the [Sept. 21] G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte, or there is also the G2 Prix Dollar [at Longchamp Oct. 6]. He finished second in that race last year, and it could fit well. The English Champion is the big plan." The Ascot event was recently announced as the next start for unbeaten Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}).

There's some serious quality under the third dam as well, including GI Futurity S. winner Traitor, and GSW/GISPs Sun King and Ocean Drive. Trainer Jim Bond has a \$4.19 ROI with 2-year-old firsters over the past five years according to *DRF Formulator* thanks to two bombs, but I'm more interested in his numbers when partnering with Ramon Dominguez. I rarely am even aware of who's on my horse most of the time, as I think generally riders can only get horses beat with poor rides and it's hard to predict when that will occur, but I can't ignore the success of the Bond/Dominguez combo. They've hit at a 30% rate with a \$3.42 ROI together since 2010, and an even more incredible 41% clip with a \$5.18 ROI at the Spa. Field Size, Number of Races Up in 2012 at Del Mar:

The curtain will come down on the 2012 meet at Del Mar next Wednesday, and the meet will have conducted more races and attracted more runners per event than in 2011. "If someone would have told me before we started that we'd run more races than the previous year and field size would be up as well, I don't think I'd have believed them," Del Mar Racing Secretary Tom Robbins admitted. "It has exceeded expectations," he continued. "I was thrilled to be able to add more races [all three days of the Labor Day weekend] and provide more opportunities for owners and trainers at these higher purse levels. We added maiden special weight races, not lower level claimers, because we had a call for them."

Robbins continued, "There's usually an uptick towards the end of the meeting, but in all the years I've been here, I've never seen anything like this." With 11 races carded Sunday and Monday and 10 on Wednesday, the track will have conducted 328 races in 2012, up from 324 last summer. Average number of runners in 2012 will be impacted by scratches, but is expected to come in around 8.5 or 8.6 per race. That number was 8.4 in 2011.


