SHANGHAI BOBBY TAKES FLIGHT IN HOPEFUL

Starlight Racing's **Shanghai Bobby** (Harlan's Holiday) produced a powerful stretch run to record an authoritative 3 3/4-length victory in the GII Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Monday's closing-day card at Saratoga. "That was a very professional effort from him," commented winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "It seemed like he won with a little something left today; he was pricking his ears when he came to the wire."

Breaking from the outside in a field of nine, Shanghai Bobby broke a half-step slowly and was unhurried in the early strides, but he rushed up into a stalking fourth from the outside down the backstretch as **Majestic Hussar** (Majestic Warrior) took the field through an opening quarter in :22.55. The 2-1 shot moved to challenge for the lead leaving the turn after a half in :45.28. He took command at the top of the lane and powered clear, leaving favored **Fortify** (Distorted Humor) and **Bern Identity** (Bernstein) to battle it out for second. **Cont. p3**

HALO DOLLY GETS THE YELLOW RIBBON

Halo Dolly (Popular), making her second start against graded stakes company, came flying home late to win the GII Yellow Ribbon S. at Del Mar Monday by 1 1/4 lengths. The dark bay filly, sent off at 5-1, settled off the pace as **Broken Dreams** (Broken Vow) tugged her way through fractions of :23.63, :46.75 and 1:10.27. Halo Dolly began making forward progress leaving the backstretch and came widest of all into the lane, uncorking a powerful stretch run that put her on top at midstretch.

"This filly used to want to bust out of the gate and go, but now she's gotten smarter," rider Joe Talamo said of the winner. "She's gotten older and she'll settle and run. And that turn of foot she has makes her an especially good grass horse. She turns it on at the end. I was able to get over and in on that first turn and save some ground. That's the key to riding this turf course and most any turf course. You've got to save ground."

Talamo was winning his 11th stakes of the Del Mar meeting and his seventh on the turf course. "I've been really lucky at this meet," he added. "I'm riding some really good horses. That's what it's all about." **Cont. p4**

Shanghai Bobby Wins Hopeful (cont. from p1)

Shanghai Bobby debuted with a four-length victory over 4 1/2 furlongs at Aqueduct Apr. 19. He was a front-running victor of the Track Barron S. over 5 1/2 furlongs at Belmont June 27. "He was actually quite a handful today," jockey Rosie Napravnik, who took off GII Sanford S. winner Bern Identity to ride Shanghai Bobby, said of the winner. "Usually, he's a little more relaxed. Today, he was keyed up. It was all positive energy. He was ready to go. He did rate properly and finished really strong. He's a very talented horse. I really liked this horse since day one. He's very sensible, and he's been moving forward every race and really maturing. I thought he was going to excel off his last race. It's great to have him back and in good shape. I'm sure he'll move forward off of this as well."

With his win in the Hopeful, Shanghai Bobby has earned an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Because he broke his maiden at Aqueduct, the colt also earned a \$100,000 juvenile bonus from NYRA. The bonus, begun this year, is awarded to any 2-year-old maiden winner at Aqueduct or Belmont Park who goes on to win a graded stakes at a NYRA track. "The purse is \$300,000, you get a \$100,000 [NYRA] bonus, and I still have shares in [Shanghai Bobby's sire] Harlan's Holiday," said Starlight Racing's Jack Wolf. "I said to my wife, 'This is a pretty big race.' It's nice that NYRA came up with the bonus. It seems to have helped the 2-year-old program." Up next for Shanghai Bobby is the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S., according to Pletcher.

Pletcher Power

Shanghai Bobby's Hopeful victory completed an impressive meeting with 2-year-olds for leading trainer Todd Pletcher, who had 22 juvenile winners. "We love Saratoga and we try to emphasize the meet," Pletcher said. "We've been blessed with a lot of nice 2-year-olds this year. It's nice to win the Hopeful to close it out. It would have been kind of disappointing not to close it out with a 2-year-old win. We felt like this summer the 2-year-olds were training very well and we were coming in holding a strong hand. Until you get a bunch of them running, you don't know. When some of them start to win and their workmates come up to run, you kind of get a good feel for it. We're not surprised, but we're happy."

Shanghai Bobby is named after Bob Burton, a pilot for Delta who introduced Starlight partners Jack Wolf and Don Lucarelli at a party in 2004. He is the first foal of stakes winner Steelin' (Orientate). Steelin' was purchased, carrying Shanghai Bobby, by Jeff and Chiquita Reddoch's Stonehaven Steadings for \$155,000 out of the 2009 Keeneland November sale. The Reddoch's, originally from Louisiana and in the oil and gas pipeline construction business, have owned the Versailles-based farm since 2004. Steelin' had a Broken Vow filly last year and produced a full-sister to the Hopeful winner this spring.

Favored **City to City** (City Zip), who won this race a year ago, was forced to wait for racing room in upper stretch, broke loose at midstretch and closed for second, a nose ahead of longshot **Vivo Per Lei** (Empire Maker).

Jerry Hollendorfer, who trains and co-owns the race's top two finishers, said, "Both my fillies ran really well. Mike [Smith] on City to City had some trouble getting out until late, but then she came running. Joe [Talamo], it seems like he rides Halo Dolly perfectly, whether she's off the pace or up on the pace. Right now, I'd just have to say the key to the horse is that she's just a happy horse. Every day is a good day for her. She does her work willingly and rests willingly and everything is good for her right now."

Halo Dolly, a well-beaten sixth in last year's GII Cotillion S. in her only other try against graded company, was already a three-time stakes winner in 2012. She captured the Fran's Valentine S. over the lawn at Hollywood Park May 20 and moved to the main track to win the June 30 Alameda County S. at Pleasanton, both in front-running fashion. Third over the Yellow Ribbon's course and trip in the July 21 Osunitas S., Halo Dolly closed late to earn a half-length repeat victory in the Aug. 19 Solano Beach S. last time.

The consistent Hit It Rich, winner of last year's GIII Long Island H., had already hit the board in four graded stakes this term, including a victory in the Mar. 31 GIII Orchid S. Making her first start since running third in the June 30 GII New York S., the gray mare was sent off the heavy 4-5 favorite. She broke on top and was unhurried on the lead, setting a measured pace with Bizzy Caroline in close attendance throughout with the rest of the field far back. Asked for more turning into the lane, Hit It Rich scampered clear and was never seriously challenged. "The game plan was, if she could have the lead it's perfect, if we have a target that's fine, too," explained winning trainer Shug McGaughey. "[Jockey Javier Castellano] said she broke good, was relaxed, and they kind of gave him the lead even though [Bizzy Caroline] was sitting on her. He said going into the first turn she sort of just pricked her ears, and when she came by me the first time, she was just galloping along, and that was fine with me."

Del Mar notes: Fed Biz sets sights on late-season derbies

DEL MAR, Calif. - Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert's record-setting 100th career stakes win at Del Mar was accomplished Friday with a 3-year-old colt who may have a major role in lucrative late-season derbies.

Fed Biz won a thrilling running of the \$100,000 El Cajon Stakes for 3-year-olds over a mile, fighting back through the stretch to catch Jimmy Creed in the final strides.

Saturday, Baffert said he would consider Fed Biz for the \$1 million Pennsylvania Derby at Parx Racing on Sept. 22 or the \$500,000 Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park on Oct. 6.

Off the board in his next two, the dark bay gelding returned to Parx to annex the June 17 Parx Dash H. and was coming off a fourth-place effort, beaten just 3/4 lengths, in the July 28 Pennsylvania Governor Cup H. at Penn National. Well-supported here Ben's Cat chased the pace from fourth and angled out four wide into the lane. Moving in tandem with Chamberlain Bridge, Ben's Cat began reeling in pacesetting Great Mills in the final furlong to just get the better of those two rivals over the soft turf course.

Murtagh, who is fighting for fitness after a recent fall at The Curragh, looks set to be ready to partner Christopher Tsui's G1 Irish Derby runner-up in Leopardstown's 10-furlong contest. "All being well, he'll be riding Born To Sea on Saturday and he will ride our horses for other owners for the remainder of the year, where appropriate," Oxx told *PA Sport*. "He was not retained by anybody other than the Aga Khan, so he is effectively a freelance now. He can choose what he wants to ride, but hopefully, he'll be on a good few of ours for the rest of this season. He's been riding work and I think he's due to see the doctor Tuesday or Wednesday, so he can get clearance to ride again. I think he'd quite like to ride on Wednesday, so he is nice and sharp for the weekend." There were no surprises among the entries yesterday, with Lady Rothschild's **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) set to take on Cristina Patino's **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) and a team of six from Ballydoyle headed by three-times Group 1 winner **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}).

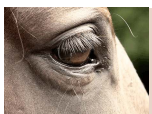

Is history about to repeat itself for Nathan Fox? Fox first made a name for himself in the late 1980s, when he gambled \$700,000 to bring Dynaformer to Wafare Farm at Nicholasville. Despite the colt's failure to win a Grade I race during a 30-race career and despite his considerable size and plainness, Dynaformer became one of the mainstays of Kentucky's breeding industry.

Now Fox is back in the news again thanks to So Many Ways, who followed up her GIII Schuylerville S. success with victory in the GI Spinaway S. This unbeaten filly overpowered the much-vaunted Teen Pauline at Saratoga to turn the spotlight onto her first-crop sire Sightseeing, a son of Pulpit standing at Fox's current base, Richland Hills near Midway.

Dynaformer began his career at \$5,000 in 1990 and Sightseeing set out at a similarly inexpensive fee--\$7,500--19 years later. The reasonableness of Sightseeing's fee again reflected a failure to score at Grade I level, and there are other similarities between the two stallions. Sightseeing stands 16.3 hands, so is a similar height to Dynaformer, and both possess outstanding bloodlines developed by top breeders. Whereas Dynaformer--bred by Joseph Allen--had a true Darby Dan pedigree, Sightseeing is a Dinny Phipps homebred who raced for Phipps Stable.

Fox has said that he was motivated to buy Dynaformer because he came from a sire-producing family. Sightseeing's female line has also produced numerous stallions. I would be lying if I claimed that all of them proved as effective in the breeding shed as they were on the track. However, they include the top European milers Polish Precedent (sire of the top colts Pilsudski and Rakti), Posse, Zilzal and Intikhab (sire of the star filly Snow Fairy). Then there's the Derby-winning Motivator, Mining and Wavering Monarch (sire of Maria's Mon). Of course, this Phipps family has also produced a succession of top fillies, none better than Goodbye Halo, whose second dam, the Grade I-winning Squander, is the third dam of Sightseeing.

Siring So Many Ways in a first crop of 51 named foals represents an eye-catching achievement. Dynaformer made his name with an average of only 42 foals in his first four crops (and a third crop of 27) and it looks as though Sightseeing also has his work cut out to build on his bright start. No doubt thanks partly to the difficult economic climate, he has 26 reported foals in his second crop and he covered 45 mares in his third season in 2011. He will surely find support much easier to come by next year, just as Dynaformer did in his fifth season. **Cont. p10**

At the time that the deal to stand Sightseeing was announced in August 2008, not a lot was known about Pulpit's ability as a sire of sires. However, the picture became much clearer during the remaining months of 2008. Sky Mesa recovered from a slow start by siring the Grade I winner Sky Diva and by adding Beethoven, Skylihter and Terrain to his team of graded winners.

The deal was also done just before an avalanche of impressive first-crop juvenile winners by Tapit, another of Pulpit's sons. By the end of 2008, he had enjoyed Grade I success with Laragh and Stardom Bound. Sightseeing is the fourth son of Pulpit to become a Grade I sire, the third being Essence of Dubai, sire of the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint winner Dubai Majesty.

Nathan Fox was understandably excited to acquire Sightseeing:

"Sightseeing went toe-to-toe with top 3-year-olds belonging to one of the best crops in recent memory," he said at the time. "He is a very impressive individual who has great stamina and soundness, and together with his great pedigree is one of the most exciting stallion prospects for 2009."

Inevitably, there was a touch of hyperbole attached to this statement. After all, Sightseeing had won only two of his 18 starts, but he had accounted for Any Given Saturday when a half-length second to Nobiz Like Shobiz in the GI Wood Memorial and he then landed the GI Peter Pan S. over a mile and an eighth. He was also beaten little more than two lengths when third to Street Sense in the GI Jim Dandy S.

Sightseeing raced at up to a mile and a half, which is understandable for a colt whose dam, Resort, was a respectable second to Jostle in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks over that trip. Don't forget either that his grandsires are A.P. Indy and Pleasant Colony, or that his great-grandsires include Seattle Slew and Alydar. As might be expected of a Phipps homebred, he has two lines to Buckpasser, so, by American standards, Sightseeing isn't short of staying blood.

No wonder So Many Ways was running on strongly at the end of the Spinaway S., and there is every reason to expect her to be even better suited by distances around a mile. Her pedigree includes 4x4 inbreeding to Seattle Slew and she also has two lines of Secretariat and two of Northern Dancer.

Although she was bred by John R. and John C. Penn, So Many Ways has a pedigree which pays tribute to the Mabees, as her first three dams were all bred by Mr. and Mrs. John C. Mabee. They also bred Avenue of Flags, the stallion responsible for So Many Ways' talented second dam, Really Happy.

After winning three of her four starts as a juvenile, Really Happy went on to win the GIII Bay Meadows Oaks and to be graded placed on both dirt and turf. She was sold to Japan for \$375,000 in 2002.

So Many Ways' third dam Dear Laura was a half-sister, by the stamina-packed Youth, to several good winners out of the Northern Dancer mare Six Months Long. Best of them was Half A Year, winner of the G1 St James's Palace S. Two of Six Months Long's daughters produced smart sons to Seattle Slew, Classic Event being the dam of Event of the Year and Zoe Montana, the dam of the fast and precocious English colt Council Member.

No wonder, then, that So Many Ways' breeders were tempted to try inbreeding to Seattle Slew. Turbulent Descent, Well Armed and Morning Line are other Grade I winners with two lines of Seattle Slew, as is the Mabee-bred Grade II winner Yearly Report, who was inbred 2x4. Coincidentally, Yearly Report's broodmare sire was Half A Year, so there are links to So Many Ways' pedigree.

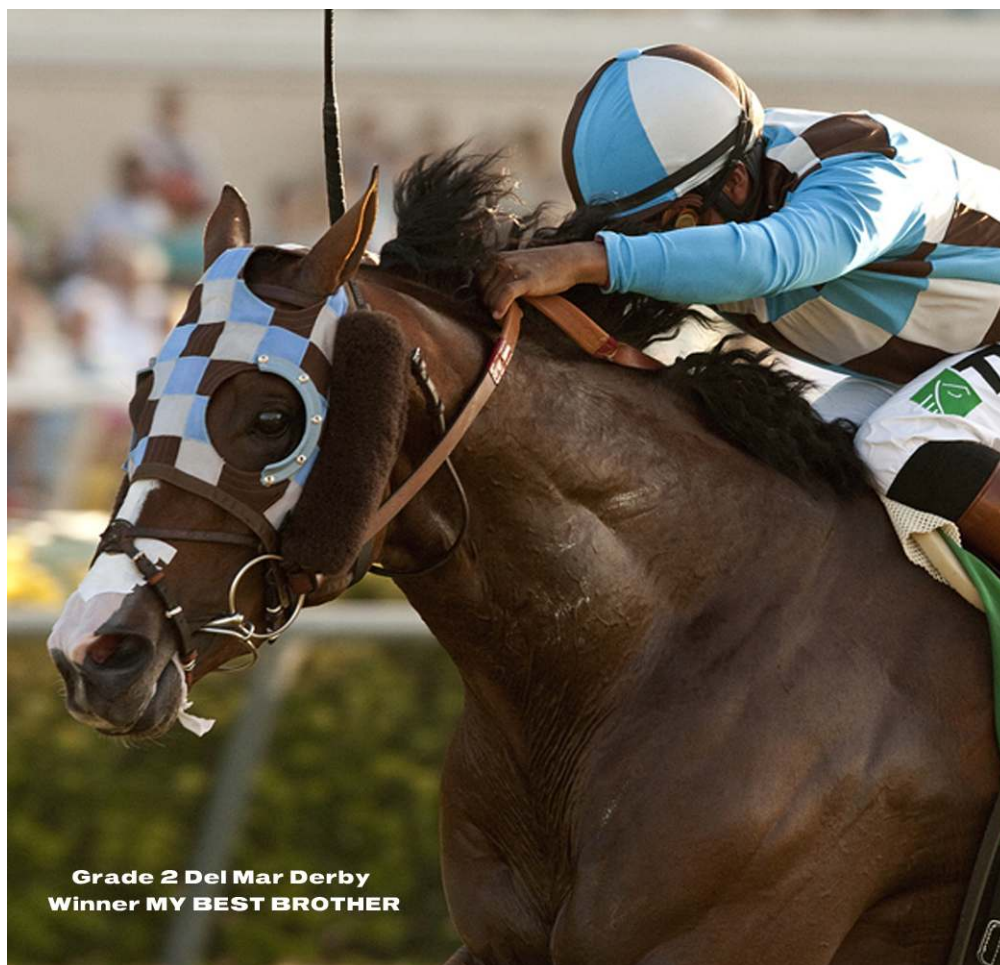
So Many Ways isn't the only recent winner whose first three dams were all bred by the same people. Golden Ticket, who shared the spoils in the GI Travers S., represents a female line which has done excellent work for Peter Blum since he bought Golden Ticket's fourth dam, the King Ranch-bred Mono, in 1974. Golden Ticket's first three dams--Business Plan, Good Mood and Mine Only--were all bred by Blum. Not bad going for a man whose family wasn't involved in racing and whose first job in racing was as a hotwalker at Belmont and Aqueduct!

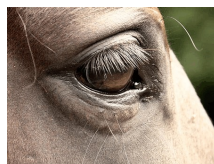

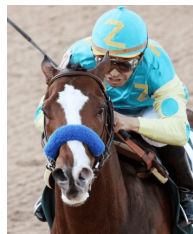
