



Red Mills Irish Champion Stakes WIN AND YOU'RE IN®

FAIRY DUST

Cristina Patino's Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) is one of the shining examples of how the new distaff program in Europe has benefitted racing as a whole, and she looks to put the boys in the shade in today's G1 Red Mills Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Despite being short of her absolute best on her return from a serious tendon injury in Deauville's G1 Prix Jean Romanet over this trip last time Aug. 19, the 5-year-old still managed to put a clutch of Group 1 winners in their place. On that evidence, there is a chance that she could be better than ever as she attempts to go one better than her second to So You Think (NZ)

(High Chaparral {Ire}) here 12 months ago. "She's come out of her last race incredibly well and didn't lose a huge amount of weight going to France and back," trainer Ed Dunlop commented. "She is fresh and well and Frankie [Dettori] was happy with her when he rode her in a piece of work the other day. Probably the best run of her life came here last year against So You Think, so the track suits and the ground is drying up dramatically. We're under no illusions, as it's as competitive a race as last year. She's not like normal horses, who would have been retired with the injury she had--she has a huge will to win and is very tough and she quickens well, but this is going to be a stiff stamina test." Snow Fairy's presence could mean that for the second run in succession, Lady Rothschild's Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) is denied a top-level victory by a member of the female brigade following his nose defeat by Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 21. He had previously beaten the solid yardstick Farhh (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in Sandown's G1 Eclipse S. July 7, but this is the first time that he has tackled this trip on fast ground. "He's in good order, but this is very much a prep for the Arc," trainer John Gosden explained. "He's in form, but he's not really fully wound up for a race like this."

FLY ME COURAGEOUS

Though Blueskiesnrainbows (English Channel) leads the red-hot Bob Baffert team into Shreveport, Bourbon Lane Stable and Wayne Lynn's Bourbon Courage (Lion Heart) looks primed for today's GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs in his return to the Pelican State. The bay debuted with a 103 Beyer Speed figure downstate at the Fair Grounds Feb. 3 and was accorded "TDN Rising Star" status off a 6 3/4-length allowance win in New Orleans Mar. 24, where he had recent GII West Virginia Derby hero Macho Macho (Macho Uno) back in second. He ran below expectations when fourth in a sloppy renewal of the GIII Derby Trial S. Apr. 28 and when fifth in the GII Woody Stephens S. June 9, but bridged nearly all of a 13-length deficit, falling a neck short to Macho Macho at Mountaineer Aug. 4. He should have plenty of pace to run at this time around as well. Blueskiesnrainbows has done his best work on the front end, having made the running before finishing a half-length third to I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) and Creative Cause (Giant's Causeway) in the GI Santa Anita Derby in April and accounted for Nonios (Pleasantly Perfect) in the GII Swaps S. last out July 4. The likely quicker surface will help **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who tries again at this distance following his third behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and Farhh in the Aug. 22 G1 Juddmonte International at York. Derrick Smith's dual G1 Coronation Cup and 2011 BC Turf hero needs to prove he is as effective at this intermediate trip, but he has never looked short of speed, and Aidan O'Brien's remarkable record of seven wins since the millennium year means that he is worthy of maximum respect. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ♣ **Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) demonstrated stamina when running Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) to two lengths in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 30, but his subsequent 6 1/2-length defeat by Famous Name (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the G2 Royal Whip over this trip at that Kildare venue leaves him with something to find here.

Like most of her Australian compatriots, **Ortensia (Aus)** (Testa Rossa {Aus}) has spent a long time away from the limelight dominated by the mighty Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}), but she is threatening to upstage that giant in one sphere as she limbers up for today's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. Whereas Nelly boasts a sole British Group 1, the 7-year-old, who bounced back from the doldrums, is on course for a second following her impressive rattle from rear to win York's G1 Nunthorpe S. 15 days ago. Having taken four seasons of racing to garner a top-level success, she has now registered a trio of them in the space of nine months, and trainer Paul Messara is hopeful she can extend the tally. "We've had a

great tour so far and one more would just finish off the trip," he said. "It's been fantastic and I love the sport over here. It was a massive run at York, as she had a few things against her, but managed to overcome. She's been perfect after York and, although she knew she had a run there, she bounced back really well. William [Buick] is part of the horse now and understands the mare now--she is a bit of a moody old woman and he's riding with a lot of confidence and gets on with her. She's a horse you have to work with and he's got a kind hand." **Cont. p4**

Intriguingly, Qatar Racing's **Strong Suit** (Rahy) boasts the highest official rating of these, having dominated the seven-furlong scene last term with emphatic wins in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot in June, G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood in July and G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket in October. His eighth in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 14 can be excused on account of the unfavorably soft ground, but he needs to show more dash than when a labored second in the G2 Hungerford S. back over seven at Newbury last time Aug. 18. "It seems I only had to enter Strong Suit for a Group 1 for it to rain, but we look like having good-to-firm ground at Haydock and the forecast is for it to stay dry and warm, so maybe this will be the day when he takes his place at the top table," trainer Richard Hannon commented. "He traveled well in the July Cup, but could not pick up in the soft ground, so now that we have got our conditions I hope he will enjoy his day in the sun. There will be plenty of pace on up front, which will allow us to find our rhythm." Khalid Abdullah's **Bated Breath (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) was nosed out of a win by Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) in this 12 months ago and bids to bag that elusive Group 1, but has ground to make up on Ortensia off his latest sixth in the Nunthorpe.

"The ground looks like it should be in his favour, which is helpful," trainer Roger Charlton told *PA Sport*, "He's run four times at Haydock, won three times, and was beaten a nose on the other start, so hopefully he has a big chance. He's on the other side of the track to Ortensia in stall one, but I actually think he's got a good draw." The little-known yard of Tom Hogan is responsible for one of the race's live outsiders **Gordon Lord Byron (Ire)** (Byron {GB}), who was impressive when winning the Listed Betfred City of York S. over seven furlongs at York last time Aug. 25.

CAN SHE EMULATE?

Last year's winner **Emulous (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) bids for back-to-back renewals of the G1 Coolmore Fusaichi Pegasus Matron S. at Leopardstown today with a question to answer following her latest flop at Royal Ascot. Only seventh when favorite in the June 20 G2 Windsor Forest S., Khalid Abdullah's 5-year-old had previously offered evidence that she was as good as last year when annexing The Curragh's G3 Ridgewood Pearl S. May 26, and a subsequent break may have freshened her. "She's a better filly in the autumn and the ground was maybe a little too fast for her at Royal Ascot," trainer Dermot Weld told *PA Sport*. "I'd always planned an autumn campaign for her, and this is the start of it. She was very good in this last year and let's hope she can be as good this year. She loves a bit of ease in ground, so I wouldn't want to see the Leopardstown ground drying out too much, but hopefully it will be beautiful ground." Of the 3-year-olds, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) tries again after a disappointing fifth in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 13. Lack of match practice and trip may have been the excuses for her previous flops in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6 and June 1 G1 Epsom Oaks, but she ran flat on her latest start and has been rested since. Another sophomore with claims is the Niarchos Family's **Duntle (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), who overcame testing ground to beat **Ballybacka Lady (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) in the Aug. 16 Desmond S. over this course and distance.

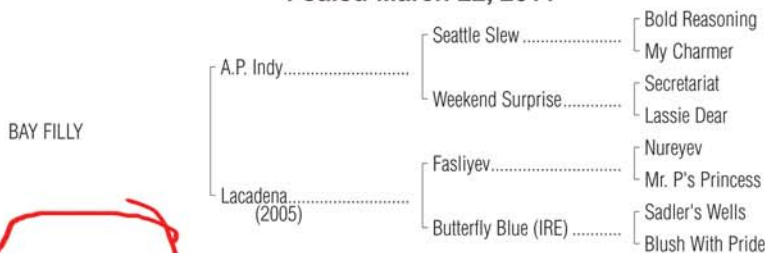

PACE THE QUESTION IN BOWLING GREEN

A short field of five turf specialists and main-track-only entrant **Redeemed** (Include) has been entered for today’s GII Bowling Green S. on opening day of the Belmont fall meeting. And the \$64,000 question is: where’s the pace? **Air Support** (Smart Strike) has been installed as the 8-5 morning-line favorite despite the fact that he has failed to win in five starts this season, despite some decent efforts. The homebred was runner-up to front-running Turbo Compressor (Halo’s Image) in both the June 16 Colonial Turf Cup and the GI United Nations S. July 7, but could do no better than third in an Aug. 6 allowance over a yielding Saratoga turf course. His better form is over quicker ground, and given the rains that have hit this week, that seems unlikely. Though he tends to come from the back, trainer Shug McGaughey expects his charge to be handier to whatever pace develops. “I think Johnny [Velazquez] will have him up in the race if there isn’t any pace,” the conditioner said. “With a short field, they’re going to be galloping around there. I think he’ll be laying close. If he’s on the lead, that wouldn’t bother me.” **Bombagua** (Borrego) lacks the class of his four rivals, but is two-for-four since being gelded, including a second-level allowance at Saratoga Aug. 26. “He might have speed to be dangerous on this racetrack,” trainer John Kimmel told *Daily Racing Form*. “We don’t have any other place to go; the horse is good ever since we cut him.”

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS FOR BETZ

Longtime Kentucky horseman Bill Betz, 61, has been involved with two of the more commercial mares of the last decade, whose offspring have generated over \$24

million in sales receipts. But the three graded stakes winners that have put Betz and his partners in the spotlight this year? They sold for a combined \$180,000 as Keeneland September yearlings, which includes the \$23,000 the undefeated GISW Executiveprivilege

(First Samurai) brought a year ago. So it goes in the Thoroughbred business.

"I'm a good advertiser for bargains at this sale," Betz laughed on Thursday.

Executiveprivilege's sale followed a year after Betz Thoroughbreds sold this season's dual Grade III winner **Daddy Nose Best** (Scat Daddy) to Bob and Cathy Zollars for \$35,000; and Gil Fantasy S. winner **Mamma Kimbo** (Discreet Cat) to Peachtree's John Fort for \$120,000.

Betz now returns to September with siblings to both Executiveprivilege and Mamma Kimbo. [Hip 1504](#), a colt by Any Given Saturday out of the GSP Refugee (Unaccounted For), goes through the ring next Sunday, Sept. 16, and sports the biggest kind of update, given the fact that

Executiveprivilege was just a maiden winner--albeit one with the **"TDN Rising Star"** designation--at the time of the catalogue printing.

"He's a beautiful, nice, correct, good-moving horse who vets very well," Betz said of the colt. "I think he'll be very well-received. I think he's one of my best yearlings, and that doesn't happen all the time when you get an update like that."

Also selling next Sunday is Mamma Kimbo's half-brother by Stormy Atlantic, who goes through the ring as [Hip 1636](#). The colt was produced by the stakes winner Bag Lady Jane.

"He's one who may need a little time--he's a little immature--but he's very attractive," said Betz. "He's not a big, rangy horse; he's got a Northern Dancer look to him. He looks fast."

Betz co-bred both yearlings, the Any Given Saturday colt with D.J. Stable, Chuck Kidder, his brother Jim Betz and Robenalt; the Stormy Atlantic with Kidder and Wayne Masterman.

From the Keystone to the Bluegrass...

If anyone has learned to not be surprised with what the horse business throws his way, it's Bill Betz. Born and raised in Pennsylvania, Betz grew up showing Quarter Horses around the nation. After earning a degree in philosophy and English from Notre Dame, he came to Kentucky in the 1970s to take some graduate classes in farm management at the University of Kentucky. "I figured I'd do that and go back to working with Quarter Horses," said Betz. But as he became immersed in Thoroughbred business, he began to love it. He worked for trainer John Ward, then was hired by consignor Lee Eaton as a pedigree analyst. When one of Eaton's clients, Edgar Lucas's Helmore Farm, needed a manager, Betz moved to Maryland.

"That was a great experience," he said. "We had four or five stallions there, including Northern Jove, who had just come up with a filly named Candy Eclair in his first crop. She was named champion juvenile filly [in 1978], and that set him up."

Edgar's son Dale Lucas eventually decided he wanted to switch the family's focus to commercial breeding, and Betz returned to the Bluegrass to help them establish a presence in Kentucky. He leased a farm from the family while boarding their mares, and began leasing a few other farms, too, while expanding his business to outside clients. At one point, Betz was operating out of four separate farms, none of which he owned.

By the late 1980s, Betz was ready to take the next step. He joined with Phil Needham to launch Needham/Betz Thoroughbreds, a commercial breeding and consigning operation, and over the next two decades became respected both as a breeder and as a consignor.

He and Needham had ties with, among others, the 1991 GI Breeders' Cup Turf upsetter Miss Alleged (Alleged), whom Betz co-bred with Carl Freeman, as well as the 1999 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up Chief Seattle, who they purchased as a weanling and wound up racing after failing to get unsatisfactory interest at the yearling sales.

A Silver (and Sassy) Lining...

If Betz's recent consignments have been advertising for the deals that can be had at Keeneland September, he has been on the other end of the selling spectrum too. With Needham and Rob Whiteley's Liberation Farm, and later with John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm, he co-bred a series of outstanding yearlings from Silvery Swan (Silver Deputy), a mare who they purchased as a yearling, but who never made the races. The partnership bred Silvery Swan when she was a 2-year-old, and emerged with the future GI Cigar Mile hero El Corredor (Gone West). The young mare's second foal was Grade III winner Silver Tornado (Maria's Mon), and two foals after that she came up with GI Haskell Invitational winner Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus).

The latter, a \$500,000 KEESEP yearling, is one of six yearlings from Silvery Swan to make a half-million or more. Her other produce includes the \$4.6 million Maimonides (Vindication), who ran third in the GI Hopeful S.; a \$2.7 million Mr. Greeley filly who sadly died before making the races; and the unraced 2-year-old Silvery Starlet (Unbridled's Song), acquired last year at KEESEP by Whisper Hill Farm for \$1 million.

"She was just a blue hen," said Betz. "Everything she produced was beautiful, and they all ran."

Taking into account broodmare sales and the like, Silvery Swan's offspring have grossed in excess of \$12.1 million at public auction.

It's been a similar story for Sassy Pants (Saratoga Six). Betz and his partners acquired the stakes-winning Illinois-bred off the track in 1996.

"We bought her off a guy from Chicago," explained Betz, who acted with Needham and partner James Blackburn. "She was very fast, but I don't think she was in the best physical shape when we got her, and I don't think was performing up to the level she could. So we retired her, and she became a great mare for us."

Sassy Pants's second foal to live was the ultra-talented race filly Madcap Escapade (Hennessy), a \$160,000 KEESEP yearling who went on to bank over \$1 million with her wins including the 2004 GI Ashland S. at Keeneland. **Cont. p13**

"After Madcap won the Ashland, we got an offer we couldn't refuse, and sold Sassy Pants for a big profit," said Betz, who sold the mare to Atlanta businessman Peter Blum. "I paid a lot of bills with her."

By that point, Betz, Needham and Blackburn had bred another future Grade I winner out of Sassy Pants, Dubai Escapade (Awesome Again), whom they sold for \$75,000 at the 2003 September Sale. (Darley purchased her from Jerry Bailey the following spring for \$2 million at Barretts March.)

Again taking into account transactions at bloodstock auctions, Sassy Pants's offspring have sold for over \$11.9 million.

Mine That Bird and Beyond...

In 2008, Needham and Betz dissolved their partnership, and now Betz simply breeds and sells under his own name. His farm, located on roughly 280 acres in Lexington, is home to about 60 or 70 mares, many of which he owns in partnership. The veterinarian Chuck Kidder, whom Betz has known since his Lee Eaton days, is a longtime co-conspirator, as is the aforementioned James Blackburn, who is based in Chicago. Other partners include Peter Lamantia, a Canadian who has retired from the

produce business, and Betz's accountant Larry Johnson, who was a partner in Chief Seattle.

Needham/Betz was still an entity, however, when, along with Lamantia and Blackburn, they bred Mine That Bird (Birdstone) from the Smart Strike mare Mining My Own, whom they also bred. Sold for just \$9,500 as a yearling, Mine That Bird won the 2009 GI Kentucky Derby. Needham and a few other partners later bought out Betz's share in Mining My Own for just \$8,000 at the 2008 KEEJAN sale, and bred this year's GI Pacific Classic and GI Blue Grass S. winner Dullahan (Even the Score).

It's another example of a few modestly priced horses that went on to stardom after Betz sold them, but he's been around long enough to know that door swings both ways.

"I've sold horses for multi-millions that didn't run, so it all balances itself out," he said. "That's part of the game. You take them over there and just hope they go to a good home, and hope they can run and increase the mare's value down the line."

That is certainly what happened with Executiveprivilege. Her dam, Refugee, was acquired by Betz and partners in foal to Not For Love for \$65,000 at the 2006 Keeneland January Sale, and though Executiveprivilege didn't set the sale ring on fire for them, it wasn't because she didn't look the part.

"Executiveprivilege was beautiful from the beginning," said Betz. "She had strength, balance, class--she had everything. But at the time, First Samurai was a little quiet, and it was a case of more horses than buyers. But people who work hard can always find good value at Keeneland. When [bloodstock agent] Hubert Guy came to me and said, 'Do you have anything you like that I might be able to afford?' I told him I wasn't sure he'd be able to afford her, but if he could he should buy her. And he did."

Guy later topped OBSAPR with Executiveprivilege, who sold for \$650,000 to Mike Pegram, et al.

Betz and partners, meanwhile, acquired Mamma Kimbo's dam Bag Lady Jane for \$50,000 at the 2007 KEENOV sale while in foal to Holy Bull. "I had actually tried to buy Bag Lady Jane as a weanling, and Frank Stronach outbid me," said Betz. "She went on to win a few stakes and was a good racemare. Frank bred her to a few of his Florida stallions, and then put her back in a sale. I remembered her as a baby, and figured I had a second chance to get her. So we bought her and bred her to Discreet Cat, who was standing his first year."

The resulting offspring was Mamma Kimbo, another standout as a yearling. "John Fort came to the sale and just fell in love with her," Betz said. "I think she was one of the higher-priced fillies by Discreet Cat that year. John told me, 'This filly is exceptional,' and he was right."

In addition to siblings to that pair, Betz says he has a number of attractive prospects at September. "We have a nice Empire Maker colt [[hip 683](#)], we have a nice Giant's Causeway colt [[hip 313](#)], we have a beautiful Malibu Moon colt [[hip 474](#)]," said Betz. "All of those are selling in Book 2. It's a select group. I've found over the years you really can't take mediocre horses over. Nobody wants to buy them. So the ones that don't qualify as sales yearlings we don't even fool with. We'll sell them somewhere else. But the ones we bring to Keeneland have the whole package--by nice stallions, nice physicals, out of good mares."

Whether or not it's reflected in sales prices, the performance of Betz's graduates on the track backs up that claim. And that, says Betz, is what matters most.

"We're just trying to raise good horses," he said. "So far, it's been an interesting career, to say the least. It's been a good ride."



Classic Corner

GUARANTEE GIVEN LEGER GO-AHEAD

Trainer William Haggas yesterday confirmed Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's **Guarantee (GB)** (Authorized {Ire}) an intended starter in next Saturday's G1 Ladbrokes St Leger. After pleasing in a home workout, the Aug. 25 Melrose H. winner was given the green light to tackle **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the Doncaster Classic. "He worked this morning, everything went nicely and we're planning to run in the St Leger," Haggas told *PA Sport*. "He's quite a lazy horse at home, and they are always difficult to read when they are like that, but he looks extremely well and in great form with himself. There are no prizes for going up the Al Bahathri in Newmarket, there never have been, so we didn't push too many buttons. I just wanted to see that he is still going the right way and I believe he is. Certainly what he did this morning, he couldn't have done two months ago. We're keen to have a go at the Leger now. We appreciate how tough it is going to be to beat Camelot, but you can't win these races if you're not in them."

BREEDERS' CUP WINNER MARAM DIES Maram (Sahm--American Dreamer, by Quest for Fame {GB}), winner of the 2008 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, passed away Thursday of "an acute illness," according to a statement from the mare's owner Karen N. Woods. Woods was the co-breeder of the mare along with Saud bin Khaled's Palides Investments NV Inc. Maram was undefeated in three races at two, including the GIII Miss Grillo S. prior to her nose victory in the Juvenile Fillies Turf. She made a successful return to the races in the John Hettinger S. the following August and added a fourth black-type success in the 2010 Miss Liberty S. at Monmouth Park. "Maram in Arabic means wish, dream, desire, and destiny," owner Woods said in the press release. "She definitely lived up to her name. She will be sadly missed." Retired to stud in 2011, Maram reportedly foaled a colt by Giant's Causeway colt this past April and was bred this season to Elusive Quality, but did not get in foal.

Jeff and Chiquita Reddoch's Stonehaven Steadings enjoyed its biggest success to date when Shanghai Bobby (Harlan's Holiday), bred by the couple's Kentucky-based operation, stormed home first in Sunday's GII Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga.

Jeff Reddoch admitted he didn't get to see the Hopeful until about an hour after the race, but he got the play-by-play over the phone from son-in-law Aidan O'Meara, who was watching the race live with Chiquita and daughter Leah O'Meara.

"It was obviously very exciting to see him win such an historically significant race as the Hopeful and even more so with the manner in which he did it," Reddoch said. "We are very excited to see what develops from here. We have experienced the notorious roller coaster ride that is the Thoroughbred business for our short time in it, but this is certainly one of the highs to date. It was very gratifying to see all of the hard work put in by ourselves and our farm crew, led by [farm manager] Colby Marks, paying off in such spectacular fashion."

The Reddochs have been involved in Thoroughbred racing since 2004 and lay the blame for their involvement squarely at the feet of daughter Leah.

"Our youngest daughter of five children, Leah had a strong interest in eventing and had moved to Kentucky to study at Midway College," Reddoch explained. "It was during multiple trips to visit her that we became acquainted with friends from Louisiana who were involved in the industry. We eventually decided to get involved ourselves and our initial foray involved the purchase of four mares under the Roasting Ear Creek banner, which is our farm in Arkansas."

Once Leah decided to make Kentucky her permanent home, eventually marrying Hill 'n' Dale Stallion Division Manager Aidan O'Meara, Jeff and Chiquita decided it was time to increase their involvement in racing with a base in the Bluegrass.

"As with all aspects of our life, we try to do things the best way we can and, if we were going to buy a farm, we wanted to get something special," Reddoch recalled. "Lexington is obviously the epicenter for Thoroughbreds in the U.S., and we wanted to have access to the best stallions as we developed our broodmare band, as well as a broader supporting base, such as veterinary, farriers, etc. We spent over a year looking for the right place and finally came upon a beautiful 120-acre farm in the heart of the Bluegrass country off of Old Frankfort Pike next door to Hopewell Farm and three minutes to WinStar and Three Chimneys."

The property's already impressive list of graduates, including champions Arazi, Fly So Free, Ajdal and Zilzal, sealed the deal, according to Reddoch, and the couple, originally from Lafayette, Louisiana, purchased the farm in 2007 and began operations in 2008.

With the goal of creating a commercial breeding operation, the Reddochs and Marks, who has been with Stonehaven Steadings since the beginning, purchased five broodmares during their first year of operation. One of the new additions was the stakes-winning mare Steelin'. In foal to Harlan's Holiday, the 5-year-old mare was purchased by Stonehaven Steadings for \$155,000 out of the 2009 Keeneland November sale.

"Steelin' fit the profile we have for prospective broodmares; she is a big beautiful mare and conformationally correct," Reddoch said. "She has a dominating presence about her and is the queen of the mares she currently resides with. She was a stakes winner and her dam was a full-sister to the classy Grade I winner City Band, so there was obvious class close up in the family. She was also in foal to a very good young stallion in Harlan's Holiday, who was just starting to take his career to the next level."

Steelin's Harlan's Holiday colt sold to Starlight Racing for \$105,000 at the 2011 Keeneland September sale. Now named Shanghai Bobby, he took his record to three-for-three with an authoritative victory in the Hopeful.

The mare's Broken Vow foal died shortly after birth last year, but she produced a full-sister to Shanghai Bobby this spring. **Cont. p16**

“Steelin’ foaled late this year, so we decided to give her the year off and she is open to a number of options as far as stallions next year,” Reddoch said. “We may retain his sister as a broodmare prospect or she may be sold as a yearling next year. Steelin’ will also be remaining as part of the broodmare band with the hopes of becoming a foundation mare for the farm.”

The Stonehaven Steadings broodmare band currently numbers 14 and, in addition to Steelin’, includes Love and Marry (Known Fact), the dam of multiple Grade I placed Riveting Reason (Fusaichi Pegasus); Suzanna Anna (Tale of the Cat), the dam of graded stakes winner Hour Glass (Petionville); and multiple graded stakes placed Long Approach (Broad Brush).

The farm is also home to some high-class boarders, including the hard-knocking multiple graded stakes winner Wasted Tears (Najran); Chasetheragingwind (Dayjur), dam of Grade I winner Here Comes Ben (Street Cry {Ire}); and Chasethewildwind (Forty Niner), dam of Grade I winner Albertus Maximus (Albert the Great).

In addition to Shanghai Bobby, the Reddochs have already been responsible for another three stakes winners during their short time in the game. They bred Hour Glass and stakes winners All About Anna (Maria’s Mon) and Trix in the City (Friend’s Lake) under their Roasting Ear Creek banner.

The Reddochs consign their own horses under their Stonehaven Steadings banner, including two during the upcoming Keeneland sale, [hip 2011](#), a daughter of Indygo Shiner--Trix City, and [hip 2152](#), a colt by Roman Ruler--Earlybird Road. Reddoch hopes to expand this arm of the operation in the future.

“We are planning on growing our consignment and increasing our presence at the major yearling sales, with both our own stock and those of our clients,” he commented. “We had our best year to date last year, selling over \$600,000 in bloodstock, topped by a Candy Ride (Arg)--Double Flyight (Flying Continental) colt for \$200,000 [at KEESEP] and a Stormy Atlantic--Love and Marry for \$170,000 [also at KEESEP], now named Asunder, who was a close third on his debut last month in a hot Saratoga maiden and runs back at Belmont soon.”

Stonehaven Steadings also has a small string of horses in training.

“Because we breed horses to race, if the appropriate financial compensation is not achieved at the sales ring, we have no problem bringing one home and putting it into training,” Reddoch said. “We currently have five of our own in training and shares in a couple of others in racing partnerships.

“We enjoyed some success with a filly of ours last year, Second Street City (Consolidator), who has won over \$100,000 to date and gave us a number of exciting days out. We have an El Corredor half-brother to Hour Glass [Luzianna Man] training at Keeneland currently who was a close third in his debut last month, too, and we hope to run back at the October meet.”

The Reddochs, who formerly owned an oil field drilling and production company in Louisiana, have now made the Thoroughbred breeding industry, not only their primary business, but also a lifestyle.

“It is one of Chiquita’s favorite things to enjoy her morning coffee on the balcony overlooking the paddocks with the mares and foals doing their thing, as well as traveling around the farm working on different projects,” Reddoch said. “I myself enjoy many aspects of the business, whether it is planning on next year’s matings, deciding on specific stallions, who may or may not be as significant three years later when we sell, and all that goes with that. Chiquita and I both particularly like attending the foalings and watching the next generation enter the world, as well as the sales.

“We love a day at the races, especially Keeneland, and that experience is made all the better if there is one running that we own or have bred ourselves,” he continued. “We have learned a tremendous amount since we have been involved and even learn something new on a daily basis.” -*Jessica Martini*

Del Mar Adjusts Figures After ADW Error:

Edited press release

Due to a reporting error on in-state Advanced Deposit Wagering bets during the final two weeks of the Del Mar meeting, the track has adjusted slightly downward its final figures on handle for its just-concluded meeting. The error, caused by a malfunction with the electronic reports submitted to CHRIMS -- the official data base and reporting agency for California racing -- by betting provider TVG's automated systems. TVG reported the error, noting that their system had overstated ADW handle wagered by California residents on out-of-state races of \$14,396,311 between Aug. 21-Sept. 3. Del Mar's portion of the error was \$9,681,116. TVG noted that the error had no impact on customer wagering or funds, but instead was limited to a report used by ADWs and racing associations for accounting and fee settlement purposes. The error was identified by TVG and CHRIMS in their month-end reconciliation process for August. As a result of the error and handle correction, all-sources handle for the 2012 Del Mar meeting was adjusted to a daily average of \$12,392,429 for the 37-day session, an increase of 6.6% over the 2011 figures. Average in-state ADW handle for the meet also was adjusted to \$1,551,180, an increase of 15.0% above 2011. All other information previously reported in the track's end-of-season release will not change as a result of the adjustment.

SCHLENDERHAN SPLITS WITH HIRSCHBERGER

The Ullmann family's Gestut Schlenderhan has dissolved its contract with private trainer Jens Hirschberger. He had been in charge of the Ullmanns' private training complex at Bergheim, near Cologne, since it opened in 2007 and enjoyed immediate success in the G2 German 2000 Guineas with Aviso (Ger) (Tertullian), and in the G1 Deutsches Derby with Adlerflug (Ger) (In the Wings {GB}). Hirschberger registered 176 victories during his five-year tenure, 30 of which were gained at pattern-race level, and he added a second Deutsches Derby triumph with Wiener Walzer (Ger) (Dynaformer) in 2009. Other notable victories were provided by Toylsome (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the 2007 G1 Prix de la Foret, Getaway (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) in the 2009 G1 Deutschland Preis and G1 Grosser Preis von Baden and Irian (Ger) (Tertullian) in the 2009 G2 German 2000 Guineas. Hirschberger also created history this term by saddling Energizer (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) to become Germany's first Royal Ascot winner in the G3 Tercentenary S. June 21. He has been replaced, with immediate effect, by acting racing manager Wilhelm Giedt, himself a former public trainer.
