G1 Irish Champion S. 12 months ago, would not be denied this time as she continued on her remarkable comeback from injury. Having served notice that she was at least as good as ever when winning Deauville's G1 Prix Jean Romanet over this trip on her belated return last time Aug. 19, the 15-8 second favorite notched her seventh Group 1 in style to allay any concerns about her well-being. Waited with in fourth off the fast early pace, the bay cruised into contention in early stretch and, after Frankie Dettori pressed the button, quickly subdued **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) approaching the furlong pole en route to a 1 1/4-length success in track-record time. "The race went exactly to plan and I didn't realise how popular she is," Dettori said after steering a fifth winner of this race. "The reception I got was unbelievable and the credit goes to Ed [Dunlop] and the team for bringing her back. She retains her will-to-win and class and she's up there with the champions who have won this in the past. It's an honour to be on her again and it was a great race--she made it look easy for me." **Cont. p3**

SEND HER MY LOVE

Sendmylovetorose (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) came out of the bottom of the barrel at just £5,000 at the sales and was lucky to escape serious injury in the stalls at Royal Ascot, but she has proven herself worthy of pole position at the top table by hard graft, and today's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh could be her crowning glory. Just days after her traumatic experience in the gates ahead of the G3 Albany S. at the Royal meeting, John Gildea's bay was at The Curragh winning the July 1 G3 Grangecon Stud S. and built on that experience to add the G2 Cherry Hinton S. to her tally at Newmarket July 13. Now up to seven furlongs and encountering ground better than soft for the first time, she has questions to answer, but trainer Andrew Oliver is not expecting either to be a problem. "She is a light-moving filly and, although she has won on soft ground, we think she will appreciate the likely better ground at the weekend," he said. "Hopefully, after all the experience she has now gained, she will be more battle-hardened. With the year we have had up to now, the ground has been testing and all her runs have been on that. We know she handles that, so going on better ground will be a new experience for her. I suppose the other thing is it is 2 1/2 months since she last ran, so she might be a bit fresh. The Moyglare Stud is part of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge for the GI BC Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 2." **Cont. p12**

Snow Fairy's rise to prominence has been well-documented, but few expected she would ever be able to surpass her great predecessor Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in Ed Dunlop's estimations. While her victories in the G1 English and Irish Oaks and G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup and G1 Hong Kong Cup at three marked her as a class apart from her contemporaries, she still had a margin to close on Lord Derby's stellar performer at that stage. She failed to fire instantly last term, but after roughing up the supposed certainty So You Think in this contest, she was third in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp and the G1 Champion S. at Ascot in October. Back to winning ways when emulating her prior victory in the Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 13, she sustained a tendon injury before the Hong Kong Cup and had to chart the awkward path back to full fitness.

Despite her trainer's understandable doubts ahead of her return in the Prix Jean Romanet, the manner of her dispatch of some top-class distaffers headed by the G1 Pretty Polly S. heroine Izzi Top (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) answered all questions. Left alone early by Dettori as Daddy Long Legs (Scat Daddy) set out to stretch the field in favor of his stable companion St Nicholas Abbey, Snow Fairy always had dead aim on Nathaniel as that rival was committed on the front end by William Buick at the top of the straight. Body language told the story soon after, with the Italian sitting pretty as Nathaniel and St Nicholas Abbey's riders got to work and, after brushing aside the eventual runner-up with just over a furlong remaining, Snow Fairy ran hard to the line to set a new track record.

"This is the best of her achievements, and it doesn't get better," Dunlop commented. "I thought we were plenty far enough out of our ground, but she showed an amazing turn of foot again. Ouija Board was second and she was beaten by So You Think here last year, so it's great to have it on my CV. We've always said this year that we would take it one race at a time. She's in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 7] and the G1 Champion S. [at Ascot Oct. 20], but Frankel is in that and that is a different level entirely. I'd like to take her to the Breeders' Cup, as she hasn't done that, and winning a Group 1 in a sixth country may be a record."

Courtesy of this win, the peripatetic runner secured a berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 3.

There was a surprise in store at the end of yesterday's Matron S., as the Niarchos family's Duntle was disqualified and placed behind Tony Evans' Chachamaidee. Denied a win at this level for so long, the ultra-consistent Chachamaidee went down by a short head in the photo, but was judged to have been the victim of interference caused by the eventual first-place finisher as she started to deliver her rally out wide approaching the furlong pole.

Chachamaidee, who was only fourth in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood last time Aug. 25, was anchored in rear early in customary style by Tom Queally, and was beginning to unwind as Duntle forced Alanza (Ire) (Dubai Destination) on to her as Wayne Lordan angled out the winner before the furlong pole. While the bump was minor, she was finishing strongly enough for the officials to ascertain that it had cost her the prize.

"She deserved it, as she's been knocking on the door a lot, and I did feel the interference cost her," said winning jockey Tom Queally. "I took my time on her and intentionally took her to the outside to avoid the barging matches, and it happened anyway. I felt it did affect me, and it was something I felt strongly about. It's not the way you want to win these races, but Chachamaidee deserves it."

Chachamaidee had not won over this trip since her early 3-year-old career and had developed a reputation as a specialist over seven furlongs, having garnered the G3 Oak Tree S. at Goodwood last July and this term's G3 Chartwell Fillies' S. on Lingfield's Polytrack May 12 and July 31 G2 Lennox S. back at Goodwood all over that trip. She finished runner-up in the G1 Sun Chariot S. over this distance at Newmarket in September and the most recent renewal of the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 20, but her ability to last to the end of the eighth furlong was still open to question after her latest flop in the Celebration Mile.

Her late rattle from rear looked to be perfectly timed, but, after Duntle had swooped on last year's winner Emulous 25 yards from the post, she appeared to hold Chachamaidee's rally before the stewards intervened.

Society Rock, successful in the £250,000 Tattersalls Timeform Millions Sprint at Newmarket in September of his juvenile campaign, returned to win the Listed Pavilion S. at Ascot the following April and leapt to the top level shortly after for the Royal meeting's G1 Golden Jubilee S. After finishing a highly creditable second to Starspangledbanner (Aus) (Choisir {Aus}) there, he was off the board in two other starts that term before emerging the following season to go one better in the 2011 Golden Jubilee. Despite a tendency to break poorly, he still managed to be third in the G2 Duke of York S. on his seasonal bow May 16 and a close-up fifth behind Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) in the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. back at Royal Ascot June 23 before his third in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 14. Breaking on terms here, he was buried in mid-pack tracking Bated Breath as Strong Suit (Rahy) found himself on the front end. Threaded through the gap on the rail to take the lead from the latter just before the eighth pole, he was driven out to ward off the threat of the Irish raider Gordon Lord Byron. "I just felt he was a really underestimated horse, but he got in a real muddle with the stalls," Fanshawe said. "The staff back at home have done a lot of work with the stalls and he's been like a lamb, so I was just hoping he would be like that today and he jumped properly. When things go right, he's a really good horse and he's still got a good appetite for it. I was worried about the ground and, if he comes out of this in one piece, he'll go back to Ascot for the [Oct. 20] G2 British Champions Sprint S." The 5-2 favorite Ortensia apparently suffered an overreach and never factored. Trainer Paul Messara tweeted, "The cut was right on the point of the sesamoid and certainly would have been painful enough to restrict her action."

Bourbon Courage began his career with the impression that he might develop into a first-rate sprinter, but it appears now that routing might be his game after all. After scoring by 4 1/4 lengths first out at Fair Grounds Feb. 3, the bay aired by 6 3/4 lengths at the Big Easy oval Mar. 24, earning his second straight triple digit Beyer Speed Figure and being tabbed as a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆. He could only manage fourth in a stormy renewal of the GIII Derby Trial S. under the Churchill lights Apr. 28, and followed that with a fifth in the GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont June 9. Following a brief freshening, trainer Kellyn Gorder opted to send him two turns in the GII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Aug. 4, and Bourbon Courage came running late to finish second, beaten just a half-length. After two additional graded placings, he got up to take the GII Virginia Derby last July, but was sidelined thereafter. He was unplaced in his first two tries this season before taking second to Turbo Compressor (Halo's Image) in the Colonial Turf Cup June 16, and they mirrored that finish next out in the GI United Nations S. at Monmouth July 7. Trainer Shug McGaughey attempted to give Air Support a confidence booster in a Saratoga optional claimer Aug. 6, but the bay could only manage third at 3-5. He was favored once more here and finally came through. Tucked alongside the hedge as Bombagua got away with splits of :50.55 and 1:14.90, Air Support was guided by jockey John Velazquez to the outside entering the stretch. He needed nearly every inch of ground to get by the stubborn grey, but finally poked his head in front in the shadow of the wire. "I knew it would be a walking race," McGaughey confirmed. 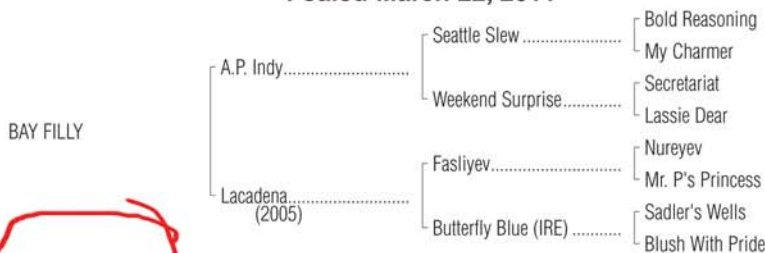

"Aidan O'Brien has won the race six times, including the last two years, but it does not look as either of his two runners this time around are the same caliber as Misty For Me and Maybe [the last two winners], so we thought this was the perfect opportunity to give Sky Lantern a shot at a Group 1," Hannon explained. "She worked well on Tuesday morning and is a hardy filly who has benefitted from missing the speed merchants at Royal Ascot, and she must have solid claims of grabbing some black-type." The aforementioned Ollie Olga's stable companion **Orpha (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) could be anything, and it is noteworthy that Mick Channon is willing to test her against these experienced rivals. Prince Faisal's homebred looked smart when winning on debut over six furlongs at ffos Las Aug. 13 and, being a half-sister to Olden Times (GB) (Darshaan {GB}), should appreciate this extra furlong.

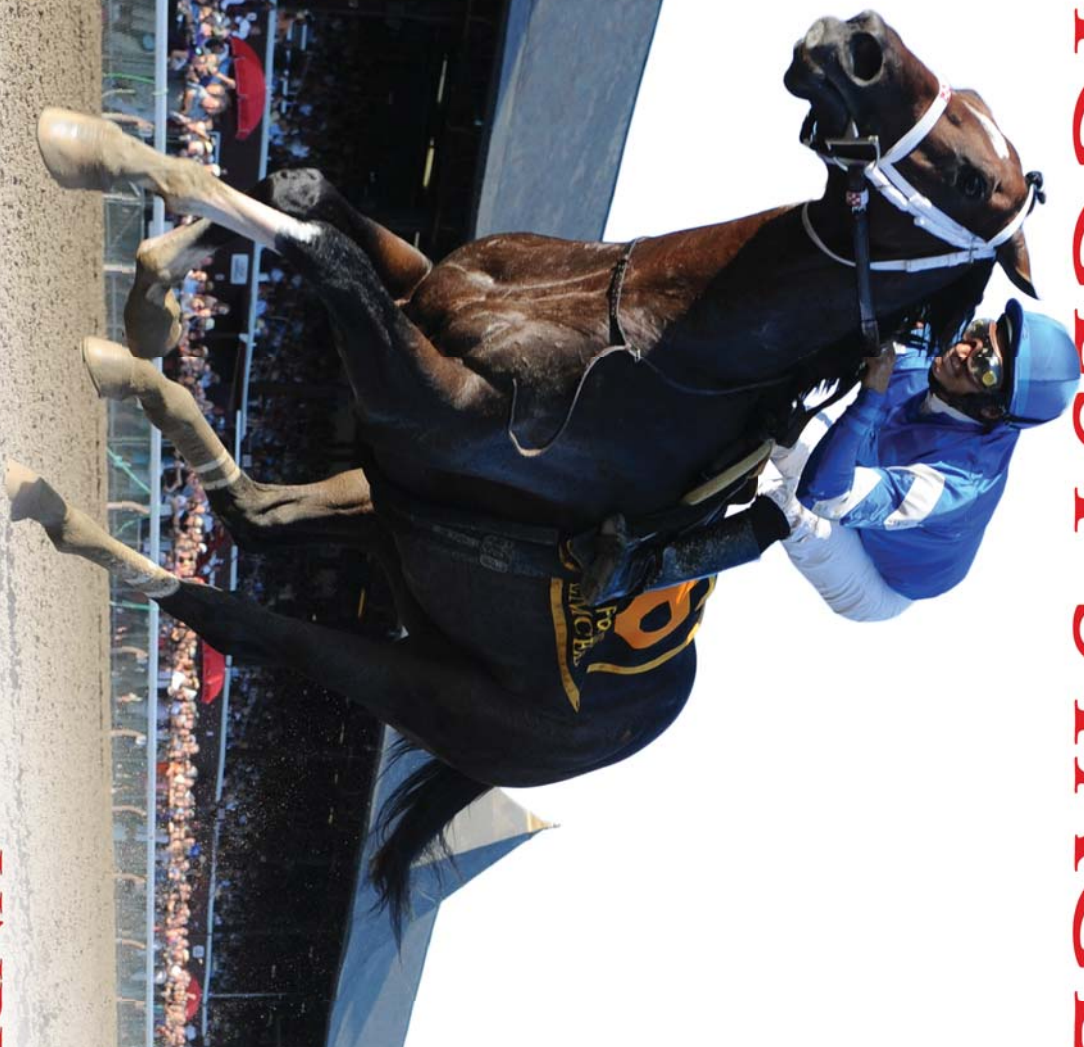

Winter Memories (El Prado {Ire}--Memories of Silver, by Silver Hawk) provided the perfect final clip to an already loaded highlight reel by following in her millionaire dam's footsteps in the prestigious GI Diana S. at Saratoga this summer ([video](#)).

While the popular gray was subsequently retired due to a bruised cannon bone that would've kept her on the sidelines throughout the remainder of the season, the Phillips family will be well-represented at the Keeneland September Sale by her yearling half-brother by Tiznow during Monday's select session.

The bay, an Apr. 9 foal, has been consigned by Darby Dan Farm, Agent I, as [hip 123](#). He was bred in Kentucky by the Phillips Racing Partnership.

"He's very athletic-looking and is an individual that I'm really excited about," Darby Dan principal John Phillips revealed. "Yeah, you've got [his half-sister] Winter Memories there, but there have been a lot of athletes, not just Winter Memories, in the family."

Some of those other athletes in Winter Memories' immediate family that Phillips was referring to include her stakes winning half-siblings by Storm Cat--British Blue and War Trace--and the GIII Pucker Up S. runner-up La Cloche (Ghostzapper), who recently provided a timely update by annexing Belmont's Voodoo Dancer S. in July prior to the printing of the catalog. British Blue proved quite popular in the ring too, realizing \$2.4 million from John Ferguson Bloodstock at the 2001 Keeneland July sale. The page goes all the way back to Darby Dan foundation mare Golden Trail.

"The pedigree certainly has been strengthened, not that it wasn't strong already," Phillips said. "The irony of Winter Memories is that she was an incredibly sound horse throughout her entire career and her retirement was a real surprise to us because there was never any indication of any issues ever in her career. That family tends to be very sound--Memories of Silver herself had a long career, too."

Phillips was not yet ready to announce who Winter Memories would be bred to in 2013.

"Winter Memories had *incredible* talent and was a 'wow!' horse," he continued. "She did things that you don't see even in some of the best Grade I horses.

"Her ability to recover from unfortunate circumstances, like in last year's Garden City, was amazing. She was the best horse that I think I've ever been around--I didn't have a chance to see Roberto. There's no doubt that she was every bit as talented and as special as her mother was, who still holds a course record at Keeneland."

After foaling Winter Memories in 2008, Memories of Silver was given a season off, then produced an unraced Bluegrass Cat colt in 2010. The 19-year-old had her first date with Tiznow the following year. Unfortunately, Memories of Silver's 2012 foal by Medaglia d'Oro died, and she was left open this season. Memories of Silver will be bred back to Medaglia d'Oro in 2013, according to Phillips.

"Tiznow has strength of In Reality, which has always done well when breeding over Roberto, breeding back to the strength of the dam," Phillips explained of the mating to the leading Taylor Made/WinStar stallion. "From a phenotype, having bred Memories of Silver and knowing the family, you need to get some size and scope with her."

He continued, "Tiznow is very good looking, is a very good athlete and could get a route of ground. There is no shortage of quickness and speed with Memories of Silver; she could get a route of ground herself, but she was *very* quick. Not just fast, but quick."

Darby Dan, well-represented throughout the entire KEESSEP sale, has eight head consigned through the first two books, including, [hip 101](#), a Speightstown-Honor Bestowed filly; [hip 156](#), a Corinthian-Parchisi colt; [hip 301](#), a Flower Alley-Shimmering Tale filly; [hip 445](#), an English Channel-Venatrix colt; [hip 604](#), a Grand Slam-Cat and the Hat colt; [hip 681](#), a Street Sense-Day Lily colt; and [hip 933](#), a Discreet Cat-Lethal Temper filly.

"I'm excited and looking forward to the sale at large," Phillips concluded. "The consignment is one of quality and if the market is there, we certainly have the horses for it." -SS

BIG NIGHT FOR RAMSEYS AT TOBA AWARDS

As he was wrapping up the 27th annual Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association's National Awards dinner Friday night at Keeneland, emcee Tom Leach quipped, "And thanks to my co-host, Ken Ramsey." Leach was referencing the fact that Ramsey, who operates Ramsey Farm with his wife Sarah, spent the majority of the evening on stage with him after collecting no fewer than four trophies during the evening, including the hardware for National Owner of the Year and the National Breeder of the Year.

"Congratulations to the other owners of the year-- they're just great competitors," Ken Ramsey said from the podium after accepting the award in that category. The loquacious Kentuckian was in fine form all night, sharing stories about how he suspects a photo of him nearly being trampled in Saratoga's winner's circle might win an Eclipse Award, his appreciation for the team around him, including son Jeff and farm manager Mark Patridge, and some lessons he's learned from years of pouring money through the betting windows: "The less you bet, the more you lose when you win." The Ramseys also won in the categories for Midwestern Region Owner of the Year and Kentucky Breeder of the Year.

What's next for Ramsey? He said he's hoping for a Kentucky Derby win, and tipped his hat to Team Valor's Barry Irwin for winning the race in 2011 with Animal Kingdom. "It's on my bucket list," he said. "I'd like to win it before I go, because I'd like to engrave it on my tombstone. Or have someone else engrave on my tombstone!"

Irwin himself was on hand to accept the award for Southern Region Owner of the Year. "We had great year last year," he said. "We won the Kentucky Derby with a homebred, which doesn't happen all the time. I'd like thank my right-hand man, [Team Valor CFO] Brad Weisbord, and my staff of 10, eight of whom drove all the way from Versailles this evening to be here."

Arnold Zetcher, who was named Western Region Owner of the Year, observed that, "This is the only city in the country that the bellman at your hotel says, Congratulations for your win on Wednesday."

Zetcher's Rolling Fog (Posse) took the GI Del Mar Futurity on closing day last week. Zetcher said the win was particularly special because it came on he and his wife Ellen's 30th wedding anniversary. He said he was considering asking his wife if he could return the earrings he got her as a gift, but reckoned the female members of the crowd would advise against that.

Pedigree expert Edward Rosen joined with some other members Mike Repole's Repole Stable team to accept the award for Eastern Region Owner of the Year. With Jim Crupi and stable manager Jim Martin alongside him, Rosen said Repole believes his success has been a group effort, and said the owner of horses like Uncle Mo and Stay Thirsty wanted to express his thanks to trainer Todd Pletcher and jockeys John Velazquez and Javier Castellano, among others.

The Indiana-based partnership of Robert Gorham and Mast Thoroughbreds LLC were honored as the National Small Breeder of the Year. In addition, the Rood & Riddle Thoroughbred Sport Horse of the Year award was presented to the owner of the ex-Thoroughbred racehorse that has accumulated the most points in competition, as tracked by the United States Equestrian Federation. Nicole Oliynyk's Sea Walker, received the award. -LM

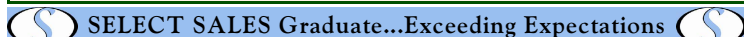
