**KEENELAND SEPTEMBER KICKS OFF TODAY**

With cooler weather ushering in a sun-splashed Sunday in Lexington, buyers got an ideal final day to peruse the wares in advance of today's kickoff of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale. A scaled-back, single-session Book 1 begins at 4:00 p.m., followed by three sessions of Book 2 that begin at 11:00 a.m. The remaining days of the 11-session sale--following Friday's dark day--start at 10 a.m. The September format has undergone several changes in recent years; last year, Book 1 was held over two evening sessions that began on a Sunday. Most consignors said they were taking a wait-and-see approach to how the new format would unfold, but generally applauded Keeneland for its effort to find the perfect working balance between buyers and sellers.

"I think having a late start [today] is a great idea," said Claiborne's Dell Hancock. "It gives trainers time to run their stakes horses on Saturday or Sunday and still get here on Monday to see these yearlings that are in the select group. It is not too many, so they should be able to get through them. I think making that Monday session special is great. Kudos to Keeneland for trying something new and setting a high standard."

Opined Eaton Sales's Reiley McDonald, "I think it was a good move, but whether it will work out, I don't know. But the action's been good."

Indeed, the sales grounds were packed Sunday as buyers made their way through Books 1 and 2 offerings. Darley's John Ferguson and Ollie Tate, bloodstock agents David Ingordo and Mike Ryan, trainers Ian Wilkes, John Shirreffs and Gary Contessa, and European conditioner Jeremy Nosedo were among those out hunting. **Cont. p4**

**HEADING SKYWARD**

Supplemented for Sunday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. despite two recent reversals on British soil, **Sky Lantern (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}) justified that decision with a decisive defeat of the home-trained brigade. Turned over at 10-11 in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood 15 days previously, the 11-2 shot left that form behind when swooping to the front approaching the furlong pole and drawing away for a 2 1/2-length success from **Scintillula (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). "She's won very well and, although we couldn't be confident beforehand, she was the best filly in the race," Richard Hannon Jr. commented. "She loved the ground and we might bring her back for the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas." **Cont. p3**

**LIGHT THE LANTERN**

Sky Lantern, switched off early by Richard Hughes as His Highness The Aga Khan's **Karamaya (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) set the pace for her stable companion and 3-1 favorite **Harasiya (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), traveled smoothly under cover and had dead aim on **Sendmylovetorose (GB)** (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) as that rival wrested the advantage from the long-time leader passing the quarter pole. Allowed a quick breather before being sent on running to the furlong marker, she opened up to dominate the closing stages as the regally bred maiden **Scintillula (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) ousted Harasiya for the silver medal.

"She had been beaten twice in Group 3s, but she ran into a very good one in Godolphin's on the first occasion and was beaten fair and square," Richard Hannon, Jr. said. "I didn't feel she ran the best race she could at Goodwood and this wasn't a vintage Moyglare, so we took the decision to supplement. She gets a free entry to the Breeders' Cup now and we could look at that, but we'd quite like to wrap her up now. We'll talk to the owner and see."

The Moyglare Stud S. is part of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge and guarantees the winner a berth in the GI BC Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 2.

Trainer John Oxx was not too disappointed with the performance of Harasiya. "She changed her legs a bit and the ground might have been a bit fast," he told *PA Sport*. "She runs well on soft ground, but hopefully she'll handle better ground with more experience. I'd say she's done enough for this year." Cont. p4

Sky Lantern followed a 3 1/2-length debut win over six furlongs at Goodwood May 24 with a half-length success in the Listed Coolmore Stud EBF Sprint S. over that trip at Naas June 4. No match for Godolphin's Certify (Elusive Quality) when surrendering her unbeaten tag in the G3 Sweet Solera S. upped to this trip at Newmarket Aug. 11, she then succumbed to the similarly unbeaten Ollie Olga (Stormy Atlantic) in

the Prestige a fortnight later, but connections remained unperturbed.

Sky Lantern is the first Group 1 winner for her late sire Red Clubs (Ire) (Red Ransom), who captured the 2007 G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. He entered stud the following spring at Tally-Ho, but sired just two crops before dying prematurely. Tally-Ho purchased her dam Shawanni in foal to Shamardal for €78,000 from Darley at Goffs November in 2007 and sold the subsequent colt for €70,000. Sky Lantern herself was €75,000 purchase by Sackville Donald 12 months ago at Goffs.



# Keeneland September Yearling Sale

Sept. 10-21

Last year's sale, topped by an A.P. Indy--Malka (Deputy Minister) colt that Hill 'n' Dale Sales sold to Amerman Racing, Evans and Co. for \$1.4 million, evidenced a market that had stabilized and was moving forward after the dramatic declines precipitated by the economic crisis of 2008. The average of \$76,511 was up 18.1%, while the median of \$30,000 was up 20%. As has been the trend in the last two or three years, there are many fewer horses on offer this September, a result of drastically reduced foal crops. The 3,603 catalogued horses at the 2012 renewal is down 16.6% from the 4,319 catalogued last year, and down 25.8% from the 4,857 catalogued in 2010. Consignors are hoping the laws of supply and demand will further boost prices this year. **Cont. p5**

"We used to be able to breed horses with two blank dams [no black-type in the first two generations] and be able to sell those horses. It's not like that anymore."

**A.P. Indy's Final Crop Set to Sell...**

When hip 249 strode into the ring at the Keeneland July Sale in 1990, he seemed to have it all. He was a son of Triple Crown winner Seattle Slew. His half-brother Summer Squall (Storm Bird) had become a Classic winner two months earlier. And his movie-star good looks foreshadowed a horse that would relish the spotlight. As such, he topped the auction on Tomonori Tsurumaki's \$2.9-million bid, and while sale toppers often fail to live up to expectations, A.P. Indy didn't disappoint. Put into training with Neil Drysdale, he won the GI Hollywood Futurity at two, added the GI Santa Anita Derby, GI Belmont S. and GI Breeders' Cup Classic at three, and was sent off to stud as the nation's Horse of the Year. He was retired to Lane's End, fitting given the fact that farm owner Will Farish co-bred him with W.S. Kilroy, raised him, and sold him as a yearling.

A.P. Indy kept being good to Lane's End, of course. To date, he has sired nine champions and 26 Grade/Group I winners, including Lane's End's homebred Horse of the Year Mineshaft. Of his at least 146 black-type winners, a whopping 80 have come in graded company. Twice he topped North America's leading sire list.

**A.P. Indy's Final Crop Selling cont.**

A.P. Indy kept being good to Keeneland, too, and now, with the pensioned 23-year-old's final yearlings set to go under the hammer in Lexington, figures to continue to be in the next few days. He has 16 yearlings catalogued at September, five colts and 11 fillies.

"From my point of view, he is Keeneland's horse," said Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "He topped the July Sale of his [yearling] year, became a champion, then went to Lane's End and became a champion sire. His tremendous success will have a lasting effect on the Thoroughbred industry. He had the topper the last two years, and the quality of his last crop is very strong."

In fact, yearlings by A.P. Indy have topped September at least three times. Last year's September auction was led by a colt out of Malka (Deputy Minister) who was purchased by Amerman, Evans and Co. for \$1.4 million. Two years ago, it was the \$4.2-million Mr. Besilu, a son of multiple Grade I winner Balance (Thunder Gulch), who went to Besilu Stable's Benjamin Leon. In 2008, Chimayo brought a sale-topping \$3.2 million.

Others to star at Keeneland include the brilliant champion filly Rags to Riches, purchased by Demi O'Byrne for \$1.9 million in 2005.

Commercial high points included the 2005 and 2007 September auctions, when seven yearlings by A.P. Indy made seven figures each year, including four who brought \$2 million or more in 2005, and three who reached or eclipsed that plateau in 2007.

The recipe for success at that level is simple if hardly simple to attain: sire top runners, and a lot of them. "On the sire statistics I do, he was eight times the leading sire by APEX 'A' Runner Index, and that requires a sire to have an exceptionally high number of good horses," said the *TDN's* Bill Oppenheim. "He did that in spite of the fact that he was an all-American sire; he never really worked in Europe, or in Japan or anywhere else. To be just an American sire, and to be that good, is really very impressive. He's the last of an era. He's the last of the great sires, from Northern Dancer through Storm Cat and Sadler's Wells, who were so much better than their contemporaries. As a sales sire, he was a great-looking horse, and he threw great-looking horses. He's an obvious sale-topping sire. He's really number one in all categories. As an influence in American racing, I hope he remains huge, because he is the Bold Ruler sire line."

Will Farish's son Bill Farish summed up his family's view of A.P. Indy succinctly: "From dad's perspective, he was the culmination of everything he was trying to do in the horse business, all wrapped up in one horse."

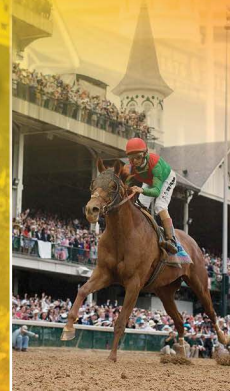

S. Aug. 18. Eight days later, she finally garnered a first pattern-race success in the Aug. 26 G3 Lanwades Stud Fillies S. back over nine furlongs at this venue, and built on that to enhance her burgeoning resume here. Settled towards the rear early, she worked her way down the outer to tackle Caponata inside the final furlong and showed grit to win the bobber. "She's as tough as nails and has learnt how to relax and race properly on her last couple of runs," jockey Joseph O'Brien said. "She had been running quite freely, and having plenty of races has calmed her down a little bit. She really puts her head down when you need her to and has a big heart. She was second in the French Guineas and lost her way a bit after, but she's really coming back to herself now."



After three runner-up finishes in his first three starts in hot maidens here and a game seventh in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 19, Leitir Mor looked guaranteed to lose his winless tag without much ceremony, but he failed to break through back here June 30 and at Tipperary July 24. Second again behind Pedro the Great (Henrythenavigator) in the G1 Phoenix S. over this course and distance Aug .12, the bay was third dropped to five furlongs on his sixth visit to this circuit in the Listed Curragh S. on heavy ground 13 days later. ### RETIREMENT LIKELY FOR BORN TO SEA

Christopher Tsui's **Born to Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}--Urban Sea, by Miswaki) may have run his last race after finishing lame in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Only fifth of six behind Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab), the G1 Irish Derby runner-up looks set to take up stud duties in the near future, according to trainer John Oxx. "He was climbing in the race and is a bit lame behind, which is a problem he has had before," Oxx commented. "We're in September and that puts us back from where we want to be. There has been a lot of interest in him as a stallion because of his breeding, and he may be going that way." The homebred bay is a son of G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine Urban Sea, making him a half-brother to leading sire Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and champion Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}).

### ORTENSIA TO RETURN HOME

**Ortensia (Aus)** (Testa Rossa {Aus}) will be shipped back to Australia after suffering an injury during Saturday's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. After beating only one rival in the six-furlong contest, the G1 Nunthorpe S. heroine was found to have over-reached and her European campaign is now at an end. "She's a bit tender," trainer Paul Messara told *PA Sport* yesterday. "She sustained a pretty good splicing at the back of her fetlock in the race. I'm not sure exactly at what stage of the race she did it, but she got a good one-inch cut right at the back of the fetlock right over the sesamoid, so it would have been quite painful for her to run on it. She did it early in the race and has done it a few times because she actually cut through the bandage. We had both fetlocks bandaged and still managed to put an inch splice in it. We're not sure if she did it jumping out of the stalls in the first few strides or at another stage. It certainly is sore enough and a big enough cut for her not to stretch out as we would have had expected her to over the final two furlongs. Luckily, I don't think it's going to be a long-term thing. Hopefully after a couple of weeks to heal up, the bruising will go away she will be okay. She's still in Newmarket at the moment, but she will probably go into quarantine this week and get home. It was just disappointing we couldn't put the icing on the cake on Saturday, but unfortunately that's racing. She certainly had a fair excuse after she pulled up and we got a chance to see what the full story was."

The Leger is the objective and the Classic over one mile and six furlongs is about staying. The horse is very well and [trainer] David [Lanigan] is pleased with him.”

**GOSDEN DELIGHTED WITH NATHANIEL** Trainer John Gosden yesterday expressed satisfaction with the effort of the Arc-bound **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in Saturday’s G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Lady Rothschild’s 4-year-old found only Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) too strong in the 10-furlong contest and is on course for a tilt at the G1 Prix de l’Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7. “He’s in good order,” Gosden told *PA Sport*. “He ate up last night, had a lead out this morning and he’s on the ferry coming home. I’m thrilled with him as he ran a superb race.”

Now, we’ve had her in our care and we’re getting to know her a little bit. She seems to be training well.” Samitar’s last win came in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27. Brown is also considering the GIII Noble Damsel S. at Belmont the same day for a pair of 4-year-old French-bred fillies: the Schwartz-owned **Whipsaw City (Fr)** (Elusive City), and **Kya One (Fr)** (One Cool Cat). A listed winner in her native country, Kya One will be making her North American debut, while Whipsaw City most recently finished sixth in the GIII Violet S. at Monmouth May 28.
