WISE DAN PROVES HE'S THE MAN

Morton's Fink's versatile performer **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry), already a Grade I winner on dirt, added a Grade I victory on turf Sunday at Woodbine with a professional 3 1/4-length score in the GI Ricoh Woodbine Mile. "Yes, he is an unbelievable horse," said Fink. "After 40 years of trying, it's an incredible feeling." The Woodbine Mile earned Wise Dan an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, but Fink wouldn't rule out a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic instead. "I think he is good on anything, as he's proved, but I think he is a little better on the grass," he said. "But you can't turn down a Classic. There are no superstars, I don't think, around this year." **Cont. p3**

Wise Dan On Top in Woodbine Mile (cont. from p1)

Wise Dan, the 1-2 favorite, settled into a ground-saving third as longshots Artic Fern (Langfuhr) and Worthadd (Ire) (Dubawi) took the field through fractions of :23.78 and :46.90. He made his move turning for home, splitting foes to emerge at the top of the lane with the lead and strode home unchallenged.

“What a nice horse,” jockey John Velazquez said of the winner. “For a horse to do this race after race and come back the way he does things is incredible. It’s nice to be on him. I think he’s learned the more he’s races. He’s learning. He’s allowing me to get him back a little bit and get him relaxed behind the horses. When he does that he is a much better horse.”

Trainer Charles Lopresti, who won this race a year ago with Turrature (Wando), is keeping all Breeders’ Cup options open. “Mr. Fink and I will talk about it and we’ll talk to Johnny about it,” Lopresti said. “I said something to Johnny about the Classic and he said, ‘The grass is good, but we won’t rule the other one out as well.’”

“We will see how he comes out and take it from there. I think he is better on synthetic and turf. I honestly do,” Lopresti concluded.

Wise Dan came into the Woodbine Mile just a head short of a five-race win streak. The 5-year-old gelding began the streak with a win in the Gill Fayette S. over Keeneland’s Polytrack last October before ending the year with a victory in the Nov. 25 GI Clark H. He returned a dominant 10 1/2-length winner of his 2012 debut in the Gill Ben Ali S. He lost by just a head when second to Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) in the June 16 GI Stephen Foster H., but was back in the winner’s circle with a five-length victory in the Aug. 11 GI Fourstardave S. over the Saratoga lawn last time out.

Mark Hawtin's Wigmore Hall outbattled Simnard (Dixieland Band) to win this race by a neck a year ago following a fourth in the GI Arlington Million. After making stops in Dubai, France and England, the handsome bay returned to Arlington to run seventh in this year's Million and was still looking for his first win of the year with this title defense. Wigmore Hall trailed the field after a tardy beginning as longshot Celtic Conviction (Strut the Stage) rushed up to set the pace with the filly Irish Mission (Giant's Causeway) a pressing second. Mission assumed command nearing the stretch after a mile in 1:39.80, but the filly was soon swallowed up by a host of challengers, with Wigmore Hall and Al Khali asserting themselves at midstretch. Those two battled it out to the wire, with Wigmore Hall always keeping a neck in front. "He's one of my favorites," admitted winning rider Jamie Spencer. "He tries really hard." Gillian Dolman, assistant to trainer Michael Bell, added, "He loves Canada, especially. He's not so great on the soft turf, but he loved the conditions here today."

Moonlight Cloud opened the year with a win in this track's G3 Prix du Palais-Royal June 2 before tackling Black Caviar (Aus) at Royal Ascot. Whatever is made of Luke Nolen's *faux pas* in the closing stages of the June 23 G1 Diamond Jubilee S., Moonlight Cloud would have gained the distinction of lowering the Australian superstar's colors in another stride.

She returned to Deauville with her reputation enhanced further. Taking a second G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest Aug. 5, she was stopped at a crucial stage before displaying previously untapped stamina reserves in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois a week later. Frankie Dettori was keen to stretch his rival's staying power to the limit on Farhh and quickly established a comfortable lead after a quick break on the stalls-wary Godolphin challenger. In doing so, he inadvertently set the fractions necessary for Moonlight Cloud to relax into an ideal rhythm and, after she had shook off the attentions of Caspar Netscher on her outside in the false straight, loomed alongside the long-time leader with a quarter mile to race. Despite Farhh's game efforts against the rail, she was always holding a slight advantage. "She proved that she stays a mile, so I think we will pass on the [Oct. 7] G1 Prix de la Foret and keep her fresh for the [Nov. 3 G1] Breeders' Cup Mile," trainer Freddy Head said of the winner.

Of the runner-up, trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "He ran well over a trip which is probably short of his best, as I think a mile and a quarter suits him better. The ground was against him, too, and we will see how he comes out of this race." Racing Manager Simon Crisford added, "He was always going to be vulnerable at a mile, but ran his heart out. He will be aimed at either the [Oct. 20] G1 QIPCO Champion S. or the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot."

Shareta had taken time to regain her form, but was reinvigorated by winning a war of attrition in the Aug. 23 G1 Yorkshire Oaks. One of last season's most progressive fillies, the bay took the Listed Prix de Thiberville over 12 furlongs in July and the G3 Prix Minerve over a half-furlong further at Deauville the following month before filling the third spot in this race. After holding off all bar **Danedream (Ger)** (**Lomitas {GB}**) in the October showcase, she was seventh in the G1 Japan Cup at Kyoto in November and returned to be third under a penalty in the 10-furlong G3 Prix Allez France Apr. 30. Nosed out by **Solemia** in the G2 Prix Corrida May 28, Shareta was the bridesmaid again in the June 24 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud before outgaming **The Fugue (GB)** (**Dansili {GB}**) in the driving rain at York last time. Allowed to coast into second place by **Christophe Lemaire** after the first half mile, she enjoyed a perfect tow from the Wertheimer pacemaker **Sydarra (Fr)** (**Sinndar {Ire}**) to the top of the straight before shaking loose at the quarter pole. Soon in the clear, she was in a different league to the eye-catching closers **Pirika** and **Yellow and Green (GB)** (**Monsun {Ger}**), with old rival **Solemia** holding on for third between the pair. "When you look at the times of the Prix Niel and this race, the difference is clear," trainer **Alain de Royer-Dupre**, who was winning a record seventh renewal of this race, said. "This is what she can do in a truly run race and that was exactly what we needed for her. She had done so well between York and now and does well here, so she will be back in three weeks' time." His Highness **The Aga Khan** was also present and added, "She is a lovely filly who has certainly improved from three to four and although York is a demanding course, she had done well between the races and won this in good style."

Most winners of the G1 Prix du Jockey Club returning after the traditional mid-summer break in this Arc prep start as favorite with all eyes on them, but **Saonois** was allowed to go off at nearly 4-1 as the French struggle to come to terms with his true merit. Rated an outsider for the June 3 Chantilly Classic, the diminutive rags-to-riches performer turned that logic on its head with his explosive burst and was again behind the major operations' representatives in the betting here. Anchored early with only the G1 Secretariat S. scorer **Bayrir** behind, the bay was full of run, but had nowhere to go in mid-stretch as all six runners provided a blanket across the track. **Cont. p7**

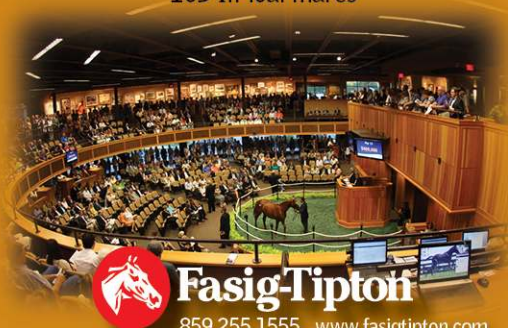

If she's sound and in good order, we'll plan on running her." Awesome Feather has been installed the 4-5 morning-line favorite for the one-mile Nasty Storm, which is the third race on the card.

Phipps Mares Boost KatieRich Farms...

In an effort to improve his broodmare band and position himself better after the recession, Larry Doyle of KatieRich Farms in Lexington privately purchased six mares from Ogden Phipps. One of those mares--6-year-old stakes-placed Distinctively (Awesome Again)--provided a payday on Sunday when hip 1707, her yearling colt by Elusive Quality, sold to Winchell Thoroughbreds for \$370,000.

"I feel with the economy it's tough in the middle market, so you have to be on the high end of the market," said Doyle, a New York native who established KatieRich about six years ago.

The farm is named after Doyle's daughter and son. "[Distinctively] is a young beautiful mare," Doyle said. "This colt was a May 25 foal, and he still managed to tick all the boxes, so that tells you how good he was."

Last Thursday, during the fourth session of the September sale, KatieRich sold [hip 779](#), a Pulpit colt out of another Phipps mare--Grade I winner Furlough (Easy Goer)--for \$330,000 to Ben Glass, agent. Doyle said his broodmare band numbers 25 and that he has bought six Phipps mares since 2010.

"I think [Mr. Phipps] knows we're starting out and sees us as honest guys," Doyle said. "They gave us a break and sold us some nice mares. It jumpstarted my broodmare band. I think [Phipps] wanted to incubate some honest guys." -Pete Denk

Baffert Buys Half to Executiveprivilege

Bloodstock agent Donato Lanni, representing trainer Bob Baffert, bid \$300,000 to buy a half-brother to GI Del Mar Debutante winner and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Executiveprivilege** (First Samurai). Catalogued as [hip 1504](#), the colt by Any Given Saturday was consigned by Betz Thoroughbreds, agent.

Baffert trains Executiveprivilege for the partnership of Mike Pegram, Karl Watson, and Paul Weitman. Undefeated in four starts, Executiveprivilege is the top rated 2-year-old filly in California. Baffert, as agent, bought her for \$650,000 at the OBS April 2-year-old sale.

"Obviously there was a big update to the pedigree, but he's a pretty cool horse in his own right," Lanni said. "He reminds me a lot of Executiveprivilege in the way he carries himself. I hope we get lucky again."

Lanni said Pegram, Watson, and Weitman will be the new owners of the Any Given Saturday colt.

Needham & Betz bought Executiveprivilege's dam, Grade II-placed Refugee (Unaccounted For), for \$65,000 at the 2006 Keeneland January sale. Bill Betz said he owns the 14-year-old mare in partnership with his brother Jim, Dr. Chuck Kidder and D.J. Stable.

"She had a nice race record and she was from a wonderful Calumet family," said Betz. "She's an outstanding looking mare, and those are the kind of mares we try to accumulate."

Betz said he sees a lot of similarity between the Any Given Saturday colt and his famous half-sister.

"Both horses have outstanding balance. They're lovely movers, and they have tremendous temperaments," Betz said. "I'm not surprised how Executiveprivilege has turned out. She was never intimidated. She doesn't worry about the job at hand. I think this colt will be much the same. He handled everything at the sale great. Because of who is half-sister is, he was shown a lot, and he came out and showed himself well every time. He has strength, balance, and movement, which are the three things we look for in a racehorse."

Refugee is in foal to Cowboy Cal. The partnership gave her a year off after delivering the Any Given Saturday colt on May 7 last year. -Pete Denk

Baffert Buys Sky Mesa Colt for \$350,000...

Later on Sunday, Lanni was at it again, outbidding bloodstock agent Bob Feld at \$350,000 to land [hip 1853](#), a Sky Mesa colt out of Mettle (Silver Deputy). The colt is a full sibling to Grade II placed stakes winner Arch Traveler (Sky Mesa). Lanni said the Sky Mesa colt was purchased for an undisclosed client of Baffert's. "He looks like a strong, two-turn, athletic horse," Lanni said. "He's a big, good looking, sound horse. I liked him a lot." The Sky Mesa colt was bred and consigned by Monticule. Minutes later, Monticule sold [hip 1857](#), a half-sister to 2008 champion 3-year-old colt Big Brown (Boundary) for \$190,000. Out of Mien (Nureyev), the bay filly was by Japanese champion miler Hat Trick (Jpn). J.J. Crupi, agent for St. Elias, purchased the Hat Trick filly. -Pete Denk

McPeek Wants Another Travers...

Ken McPeek, who saddled Golden Ticket (Speightstown) to a dead-heat victory in the GI Travers S. last month, went to \$310,000 to land [hip 1817](#), which he hopes will be another Classic dirt horse. The Mineshaft colt out of Lady Lyra (Storm Creek) is a half-brother to stakes-placed winner Enduring Star (Sir Shackleton). He is from the family of GI Wood Memorial S. winner Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) and English Group 1 winner Balmont (Stravinsky). McPeek said he was waiting for the colt all day.

"I thought he was the best colt in today's book," McPeek said. "He looked like he could get two turns without any trouble. He looked like he'll have some speed too. And he vetted well. I want another Travers."

McPeek said the colt was for a partnership that will include Harold Lerner, a New York-based owner.

"Mr. Lerner is going to take a majority share, and we are going to put some other people in on him," McPeek said. "We're really happy to have this colt."

Warrendale Sales, agent for David and Ann Hanley's Whitechurch Bloodstock, consigned the colt. The Hanleys bought the Kentucky-bred colt off the farm from breeder Sanford R. Robertson last winter.

"David has a great eye for detail," said Warrendale's Kitty Taylor. "He and his wife are hands-on. They look at the horses every day. They are totally involved with getting the horses ready for sale, and are very good at what they do."

Taylor said she was not surprised a trainer bought the rugged Mineshaft colt.

"He's a nice big strong colt, the kind of horse end-users really like," Taylor said. "It isn't like he was extraordinarily pretty, but he just was a big, good-walking horse that vetted well."

Taylor described the market as healthy. Warrendale was second leading consignor on the day by total sales, with 20 sold for \$2,035,000. Taylor Made Sales Agency led all consignors with 38 sold for \$2,496,000.

"It was a very good day," said Taylor, who sold 20 of the 21 yearlings her consignment sent through the ring on Sunday. -Pete Denk

Re-Occurring Derby Dreams

Donegal Racing's green and yellow silks have been carried to third-place finishes by Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}) and Dullahan (Even the Score) in the GI Kentucky Derby in two out of the last three years, and Jerry Crawford's partnership is locked and loaded for more.

Through the conclusion of Keeneland September's Book 3, Donegal has acquired seven yearlings, all colts, spending a total of \$1,400,000. An Unbridled's Song-Stormy Welcome colt from the Denali Stud draft led the way of the septet at \$410,000. [Hip 356](#), a March foal, counts bluehen mare Weekend Surprise as his third dam. Earlier this buying

season, Donegal purchased an Unbridled's Song half-brother to MGSW Cowtown Cat (Distorted Humor) for \$375,000 at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga.

"[Hip 356] is very athletic-looking and very scopey, and both are bred to get the Classic distances, which is our goal," Crawford said of the duo by Unbridled's Song. "We're very excited about [hip 356]. The Bandoroffs always bring nice horses to the ring, and this one graded out high across our spectrum."

Donegal's other KEESEP purchases include: [hip 177](#), a More Than Ready--Pleasant N Low colt for \$100,000; [hip 833](#), a Mr. Greeley--Honest Cause colt for \$270,000; [hip 872](#), a Dixie Union--Joyful colt for \$310,000; [hip 1086](#), a Broken Vow--Pun colt for \$170,000; [hip 1263](#), a Street Sense--Caught in the Act colt for \$70,000; and [hip 1747](#), an Afleet Alex--Flirting Glances colt for \$70,000.

"We had one real surprise," said Crawford, who launched Donegal in 2008. "We were prepared to go to \$400,000 on the Street Sense. He graded as highly as the Unbridled's Song on our criteria. The bidding stopped at \$70,000 and I was ecstatic. Actually, I was terrified at first because I thought I must've been bidding on the wrong hip."

Following disappointing efforts in the GI Belmont S. and GI Haskell Invitational, Dullahan got back on track in a big way by defeating older horses in the GI TVG Pacific Classic Aug. 26. The handsome chestnut will line up next in either the GI Jamaica S. Oct. 6 or the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic against older horses Sept. 29. Both races are contested over the Belmont turf. The half-brother to Derby hero Mine That Bird (Birdstone) will be considered for either the GI Breeders' Cup Classic or GI Breeders' Cup Turf in November.

"I'm so happy for the horse-- we just believed in him so much," Crawford said of his charge's big win at Del Mar. "To see him come back and smash a track record and beat the quality of the horses that he did was amazing."

Crawford concluded, "We call our partnership Derby Dreams and our goal is to get horses in the Classic races. Obviously if you do that and if they run well, you're making stallion prospects, which is the key to financial success in this business."

So far, so good.


