Saturday's GII Gallant Bloom H.--a "Win and You're In" race for the Nov. 2 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Santa Anita--has drawn a strong, 10-horse field including **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), who was

installed the 9-5 morning-line favorite. Victorious in her first start for team Coolmore in Saratoga's GI Ballerina S. Aug. 24, her connections considered training her up to the Breeders' Cup, but opted to give her one more go before her sojourn west. "We felt like she came out of the Ballerina well and we still have six weekends from now

until the Breeders' Cup," said Pletcher. "I think she may need another race to be really spot-on for the Breeders' Cup. She's in good form and doing well. It was nice winning the Ballerina with her, and it's pretty rare seeing a horse who can win Grade I's at two, three, and four. It's a special accomplishment." **Cont. p4**

NUMBERS UP AGAIN ON DAY 9 AT KEESEP

With gross, average and median continuing their ascent during the ninth session of the Keeneland September sale, California trainer James Kasparoff walked away with the top prize Wednesday's when going to \$220,000 for a son of Yes It's True. A member of agent Bill Reightler's consignment, [hip 2809](#) is out of the Wadena (Saint Ballado), a daughter of Grade III winner Ammy Hills (Bounding Basque). Although declining to identify the colt's new owner, Kasparoff indicated the bay was secured on behalf of one of his current West Coast patrons. "We went a little higher than we intended, but with these types of horses, you have to," revealed Kasparoff. "I was really impressed by his size and he had really strong bone. He's a very impressive looking horse and he looks like he will be an early type." Kasparoff, who conditioned 2008 GI Malibu S. hero Bob Black Jack (Stormy Jack), indicated that yesterday's purchase was exceptionally appealing. "He definitely was the standout of the day," stated Kasparoff. "All week, he had been showing himself very well and he simply stood out today. I had bid on a few earlier, but this is the one we really wanted." According to Kasparoff, the Feb. 23-foaled colt is expected to be sent to California within the upcoming week and will eventually join his Santa Anita string. The conclusion of Day 9 brought an 18% increase in gross, a 23% rise in average and a 33% jump in median. **Complete statistics cont. p3**

SPURIOUS PRECISION EUTHANIZED

Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence's **Spurious Precision** (High Cotton--Scarlet Combo, by Scarlet Ibis), winner of the GII Saratoga Special S. Aug. 12, was euthanized Tuesday after suffering a fractured left knee during a workout at

Aqueduct Monday. The 2-year-old had been sent to the Hogan Equine Clinic in Cream Ridge, New Jersey for surgery, but additional X-rays showed the damage was more extensive than initially thought. "He went a mile Monday and he looked super," trainer Rick Violette Jr. said. "But [exercise rider Rodney Payne] felt his stride change as they finished the work, and he pulled him up right away. The horse ambulance brought him back to the barn, and after looking at the initial X-rays, there was some hope that surgery was an option. We sent him down to Dr. Patricia Hogan, but the comprehensive set of X-rays taken at the clinic showed that, in addition to a slab fracture, he had significant damage that could not be repaired." Hogan added, "Spurious Precision sustained a severely comminuted fracture of his left knee. Unfortunately, he shattered the two major weight-bearing bones of his knee, as well as incurring several other smaller fractures of the lesser-supporting bones, thus rendering the knee unstable and unable to support his frame. Heroic surgical measures were considered, but humane euthanasia was ultimately the only appropriate option for this type of injury." Spurious Precision, a \$105,000 OBS April purchase by Klaravich Stables, graduated first-time out at Saratoga July 21 before his five-length victory in the Saratoga Special. He was being aimed at the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S.

KeeSep Continues Ascent in Session 9

Competitive bidding on Day 9 drove double-digit increases in gross, average and median for the third consecutive session at Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. On Wednesday, 302 horses sold for \$8,228,000 an increase of 18.05 percent over 2011 when 315 horses brought \$6,969,900. Average price for the day of \$27,245 rose 23.13 percent from last year's session average of \$22,127. The median price of \$20,000 was up 33.33 percent from the \$15,000 posted in 2011. **Statistics on page 3**

Jay Em Ess Runners Retired

A pair of Jay Em Ess Stable; Boys at Tosconova (Officer--Little Bonnet, by Coronado's Quest) and Redeemed (Include--Early Mass, by Pleasant Tap), have been retired, Samantha Siegel confirmed Wednesday. Winner of the 2010 GI Hopeful S., Boys at Tosconova was second behind champion Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) in that year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Boys at Tosconova won five of nine starts and earned \$688,960. Redeemed, winner of last year's GIII Discovery H., concludes his career with a three-race win streak. The 4-year-old won the May 3 Milesius S., before adding the June 8 GII Brooklyn H.

OBITUARIES

CHIEF BEARHART

Canadian Horse of the Year **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown--Amelia Bearhart, by Bold Hour) died of acute heart failure at the Shinzunai Stallion Station in Japan Tuesday. He was 19. A member of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, he was reportedly being treated for various infirmities since earlier this spring, at which time he was taken out of stud duty. Campaigned by Ernie Samuel's Sam-Son Farms and trained by Mark Frostad, the chestnut won 12 of 26 career starts, including three at the Grade I level--the Canadian International and Breeders' Cup Turf in 1997 and the Manhattan H. the following season. Following a fourth in the 1998 G1 Japan Cup, Chief Bearhart was retired with earnings of \$3,381,557 and rounded out his racing career with a total of seven championships, including the 1997 Eclipse Award as the leading turf horse; Canadian champion older male and turf horse in addition to his second consecutive Canadian Horse of the Year title. He was subsequently sold to the Japanese Racing Association and entered stud in that country in 1999.

Impact on horse racing industry: The Commerce Committee oversees the Interstate Horseracing Act (IHA) which is important legislation for our industry because the IHA was amended in 2000 to legalize pari-mutuel wagering on horse racing via the Internet. The NTRA's federal legislative team is working with members of the Commerce Committee to protect horse racing's interests in connection with recent efforts at the federal level to expand Internet poker.

Rolling Fog to Miss Rest of Season; Breeders' Cup

Rolling Fog (Posse), winner of the GI Del Mar Futurity Sept. 5, will miss the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita because of bucked shins, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Campaigned by Arnold Zetcher and trained by Bob Baffert, the bay was expected to make his next start in the Sept. 29 Frontrunner S. at Santa Anita. "I'm going to stop on him," Baffert told *DRF*. "He has shins. He needs 60 days off." A debut winner at Del Mar Aug. 4, Rolling Fog is likely to return for Santa Anita's winter meeting, which begins Dec. 26.

Sidelined nearly a year after the Breeders' Cup, he returned to win two of three starts in 2011. This term, the 4-year-old won an optional claimer at Gulfstream in January and has been off since running second in the Apr. 28 GIII Westchester S. Boys at Tosconova won five of nine starts and earned \$688,960.

"He is fine, he just doesn't want to be a racehorse anymore," Siegel said. "So we decided it was time to retire him. He is a nicely made Grade I winner who almost won a Breeders' Cup. He was a very good 2-year-old, and we were lucky enough to catch an injury early when he was a 3-year-old and we were able to bring him back and get a few more wins with him."

Redeemed, winner of last year's GIII Discovery H., concludes his career with a three-race win streak. The 4-year-old won the May 3 Milesius S., before adding the June 8 GII Brooklyn H. He suffered a tendon injury while winning the July 14 GIII Greenwood Cup S. "We were nursing him along, but [trainer] Rick [Dutrow] likes him too much to send him out there and have something happen, so we decided to stop on him."

On the board in 12 of 13 starts, Redeemed retires with eight wins and earnings of \$832,140.

MAD FLATTER RETIRED

Multiple graded stakes winner **Mad Flatter** (Flatter--Miss Pangea, by Honor Grades) has been retired from racing. The 7-year-old won the 2010 and 2011 renewals of the GIII Spend a Buck H. Trained by Jeff Thornbury, Mad Flatter began his racing career for his breeder Bonnie Heath Farm and then raced for a partnership that included Bright Brook Farm, Holiday Stable and Hinkle Farms. "We had great fun with the 'Madman' and formed lasting friendships because of him," said Heath. "He seemed to prefer two turns and dirt, but was good enough to place in the GIII Washington Park at Arlington Park on an artificial surface at 1 3/16 miles, beaten only 3/4 of a length, and to win consecutive GIII Spend a Bucks without taking a deep breath. While he didn't have to be on the lead, he knew what to do with it. He moves on now to the next level, a new career as a stallion. With his outstanding bone, size, conformation, and class, Mad Flatter offers breeders the speed, stamina, and versatility needed for tomorrow's racing." Even by giant-slaying Clive Brittain's standards, the 125-1 return represents one of his finest recent achievements as the winner went into the contest officially rated 34 pounds below Timepiece. Semayyel had been second in the Listed Radley S. over seven furlongs at Newbury in October, but, in six starts this term, had been off the board in five of them, including a latest sixth in a seven-furlong handicap for fillies rated 0-85 on Kempton's Polytrack Aug. 20. Rejuvenated by blinkers here, the bay raced in the slipstream of the leaders and was full of run in the straight as Tom Queally failed to get a rail run on the odds-on favorite. Cutting loose approaching the furlong marker, she stretched clear in a matter of yards and crossed the line the authoritative winner. "She'd lost a little bit of her form, but she's a Green Desert who loved this fast surface," jockey Freddie Tylicki explained. "She came home really strong and was very genuine today--the blinkers help her to keep concentrating, and she proved she was able to beat some very good fillies here."
