## ALPHA, GOLDEN TICKET SEEK TO SEPARATE

There was nothing separating **Alpha** (Bernardini) and **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) after 10 furlongs around the Saratoga main track in the GI Travers S. Aug. 25, and the pair of sophomores will look to settle that score in Parx's \$1-million GI Pennsylvania Derby. The former, beaten a neck in the GI Wood Memorial S. in April and winner of the GI Jim Dandy S. at the Spa July 28, entered the "Midsummer Derby" with a much more decorated resume than his fellow winner, and

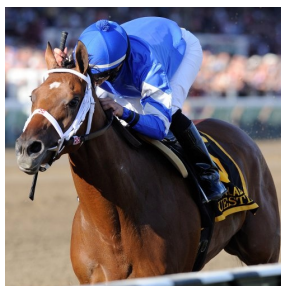

he gets the 9-5 morning-line nod as he seeks to complete the first leg of what could be a very nice double with **Questing** (GB) for Godolphin. Alpha has been a decidedly better horse so far when racing in New York, however, and that could be his biggest knock here. "Alpha hasn't won outside New York, but the only two races were at Churchill, so hopefully he just hates Churchill," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's flying. ## COTILLION LOOKING LIKE A MATCH RACE

Parx's **Cotillion** S. may not have drawn much in the quantity department in its first year as a Grade I with a \$1-million purse, but it attracted a pair of heavy hitters among its quartet of entrants. Godolphin's **Questing** (GB) (Hard Spun) sits squarely atop the sophomore fillies division on the strength of her runaway scores in Saratoga's GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 21 and GI Alabama S. Aug. 18, and it appears last year's champion 2-year-old filly **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike) is the only runner who could challenge the favorite. The Stonestreet Stables and George Bolton colorbearer culminated a four-race undefeated campaign last year with a decisive three-length tally in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, as **Questing**, who was based in Britain with John Gosden at the time, checked in fifth. Sidelined with shin problems for most of this year, the bay overcame a poor start and some greenness to annex the 6 1/2-furlong **Mandy's Gold** S. at Saratoga last time Aug. 8. **Cont. p9**

## KEESEP CELEBRATES STRONG GAINS

Despite the absence of some of the world's most powerful buyers, the 2012 renewal of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale concluded Friday with significant increases in average and median. Sales officials altered the format of this year's auction, trimming Book 1 from two days two one while shortening the sale by over 700 horses and two full sessions. The hope amongst sales officials and consignors alike was that reduced supply would have a material and positive affect on demand, and so it proved. For the 11 sessions of this year's September sale (compared with business through session 12 of the 2011 event), the cumulative average rested at \$87,354, an improvement of 7.6%. The middle market, bolstered by healthy participation from a strong domestic bench as well as from the so-called 'emerging markets,' also saw gains. The median improved dramatically, ending at \$45,000, a gain of 28.6%. When compared to the full 13 sessions of the 2011 sale, the average represented a 14.2% increase, while the median was 33% better than last fall. Seven horses sold in excess of \$1-million, while 42 made \$500,000 or more, compared to just 16 in 2011. Yesterday's concluding session was topped by a Taylor Made Sales-consigned Giacomo colt ([hip 3432](#)) who went for \$50,000 to Travis-Morgeson VI /Garry Simms, agent. **Cont. p3**

**Keeneland September Wrap-Up cont.**

“This was an extraordinary sale that was driven by the sheer number of people who attended and the high volume of trade they generated,” said Walt Robertson, Keeneland’s Vice President of Sales. “There were a number of new faces as well as longtime clients, and we welcomed many returning buyers, such as Juddmonte Farm, who have been out of the sales scene lately. The interest level was unlike anything we’ve experienced in recent memory.”

The daily sales sheets read like a who’s who from the Thoroughbred world, names such as Shadwell, O’Byrne, Pletcher and Live Oak Plantation figuring prominently. Conspicuously absent from the results were the likes of John Ferguson, who signs the vast majority of his tickets for Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum. After ending the 2011 September sale as the leading buyer, accounting for nearly \$8.9 million in turnover, Ferguson’s name appeared on but four tickets this year, for gross receipts just under \$900,000. Benjamin Leon’s Besilu Stables went nearly toe-to-toe with Ferguson last season, taking home almost \$8.2 million in bloodstock. Between them, they were responsible for a full 7.5% of the total gross. Many would have justifiably assumed that the September market would have a difficult time sustaining the momentum seen at Fasig-Tipton in July and to a somewhat lesser extent at the boutique Saratoga sale in the absence of those two powerhouse purchasers, but sales officials were basking in the afterglow following the close of business Friday.

“We always miss those kinds of people when they don’t show up, there’s no mistake about that,” Russell commented. “The September sale has the capability to attract other buyers and absorb some of that and fill in those spots. We would very much like to see everybody back, but it’s great that we were able to have a sale that could absorb their absence. I am just pleased that this sale was able to be successful even without their support.”

Added Taylor Made’s Mark Taylor, “What is amazing to me is to look at how few horses Darley bought. A while ago I would have thought [Darley’s diminished participation] would have led to a catastrophic downturn. But that void was able to be filled. It shows that the horse business, and Keeneland September in particular, is resilient. It’s the global marketplace, and when there’s opportunity, people are going to take advantage of it.”

For the eighth time in 10 years, Taylor Made was the September sale’s leading consignor by gross.

Reiley McDonald and his Eaton Sales has enjoyed a long and prosperous relationship with Betty Moran and her Brushwood Stable, buying and selling on her behalf for several years. The two veteran horsepeople teamed to offer this year's September sale, a regally bred son of Distorted Humor from Mushka (Empire Maker), who carried the Brushwood silks to victory in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. Moran had acquired the services of Mushka, herself a \$1.6-million yearling acquisition by Zayat Stables, for \$2.4 million at this auction house's November Breeding Stock sale in 2008. McDonald, who was the fourth-leading consignor by gross with over \$10 million in sales, paid tribute to Keeneland for their far-reaching efforts.

'It's been a really solid sale because the clearance rate was higher than it's been in a long time, and there seemed to be good depth in the middle and lower ends,' said Eaton Sales' Reiley McDonald. "A lot of that is due to Keeneland's efforts to develop these emerging markets. All those people coming here, buying horses that are really, for the most part, lower end in our market. It has created a really solid feel. Several years ago you couldn't find anyone to look at your horses [in the final days of the sale]. That's not the case anymore."

**Another Year, Another Leading Consignor Title...**

The six-figure offerings flew like hotcakes from the Taylor Made consignment, which sold nearly \$24 million in horses to lead the consignor's table for the eighth time in the last 10 years. With the 11-day marathon behind them, Taylor Made's Mark Taylor felt the sale lived up to his expectations.

"It was kind of like I predicted it was going to be--sometimes you get lucky in your pre-sale prognostications," he offered. "My sense the whole year was that the shortage of the foal crop would end up boosting the market, especially from Book 3 on. Starting with Book 3, you just had a huge influx of people in here and they were getting pushed back in the market to later than where they were used to being. They were saying, 'Well, I didn't get anything bought in Book 4, now I'm in Book 5.' I've never seen a crowd like this for Book 6, but horses a few years ago that were bringing \$2,500 are now bringing 10 or 15 [thousand]. It was an outstanding market."

The boon years of the mid 2000s have given way to a more steady and realistic market, something Taylor feels augurs well for the future.

"Every aspect of the business is connected to every other aspect," he offered. "Many people complain that stud fees are too high and I agree--it's hard to make money when stud fees creep up. But what that does, when you have more modest stud fees, it puts a limit on what people are going to pay for a good colt. When a horse could stand for 75 or 100 [thousand], that could encourage you to pay three, four or five million for a colt and think, 'Hey, if I win the right race, I can get paid back and maybe hit the long ball.' But when the stud fees adjust down, what you can pay for that top colt kind of slides down with it. It's a give and take. In general, I think this is healthier and more sustainable for the long haul and I think it gives buyers a shot to win

Classics and Grade 1s. In other words, if you buy 10 colts for \$250,000 apiece, that gives you 10 chances to win these races and maybe develop a stallion prospect down the road."

Taylor is pleased that some of the marquee racing outfits are having a fair amount of success and that it is having an impact on the sales.

"It's really good to see some of the people having success at the racetrack come back and be active buyers," he stated. "WinStar supports the market in a big way, Live Oak and Stonestreet as well. Those are the kind of people breeders like to see win big races because they know they come back in and support the market."

Taylor Made accounted for one of the seven million-dollar offerings at the September sale, selling a son of Street Cry (Ire)--Tizso (Cee's Tizzy) to Chuck and Maribel Sandford for an even \$1 million during the Monday opener.

**Forever Young...**

Bloodstock agent Steve Young had a busy few weeks in Lexington, signing tickets on no fewer than 15 horses for gross receipts of \$3,085,000. "I thought it was a hell of a sale. I think there was something for everyone, which is an understatement," said Young, whose most expensive purchase was hip 307, a Claiborne Farm-consigned son of Arch--Sidle (Seeking the Gold), a colt bred on the same cross as GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Blame. That pedigree combination is certainly not foreign to Young, who also signed the ticket on ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ Archwarrior (Arch) at OBS this past March. Young was impressed with what he saw on the grounds, adding that it was often tough sledding. "I think a lot of horses went up there with a lot of people thinking they were going to buy them and there were some horses that brought a lot less than I thought they were going to be," he explained. "When you have this many horses sell, I guess you can sort of predict that's going to happen. I thought there were a lot of nice horses. Everyone looks through a different set of eyes, but anyone looking with an open eye saw there were plenty of really nice horses there."

**Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell:**

"The great thing about the RNA rate at this sale is that as the RNA rate has gone down, the average and median have increased, and usually that doesn't happen. The fact that the prices are going up while the RNAs are going down is very good news for our farmers and our breeders."

**Keeneland Vice President of Sales Walt Robertson:**

"It continues to be a highly competitive, highly selective market," Robertson said. "In many cases, horses far exceeded their reserves, which meant there were several underbidders who then bought other horses to fill their orders. And while there were fewer horses who failed to meet their reserve, there was active trade in the RNA market as those horses were sold privately."

Drafting in second early, the bay took over with 300 meters remaining and, after seeing off the threat of Reliable Man soon after, asserted to score with authority.

Golden Ticket's prior career highlight was a runner-up finish in the GII Tampa Bay Derby in March, but he belied his 33-1 odds in the Travers while coming off a 3 1/2-month layoff since finishing second in a Churchill allowance on the GI Kentucky Derby undercard May 5. "He's done extremely well since the last race," trainer Ken McPeek said of the Magic City Thoroughbred Partners colorbearer to DRF. "He drank a bucket of water coming out of the Travers, and we think he can improve a notch off that race." Jerry Durant's **Macho Macho** (Macho Uno) could present the Travers winners with their toughest challenge. Never off the board since being transferred from Neil Howard to Steve Asmussen in the spring, the grey annexed the GII West Virginia Derby last time Aug. 4. That effort was flattered by runner-up Bourbon Courage (Lion Heart), who returned to annex Louisiana Downs's GII Super Derby by five lengths.

Kieran McLaughlin, who trains Questing, expects to be knocking heads with last year's champ from the get-go. "We're going to break running and probably Corey Nakatani [on My Miss Aurelia] is going to be close to us and we're going to see how it goes," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "She continues to train very well, looks fabulous." My Miss Aurelia's connections have confidence in their charge, despite the recency edge they're conceding to Questing. "We're not in the business of ducking horses, we're in the business of running our horses where we think they belong, and Steve thinks she's coming into the race in good shape," Bolton told DRF. John Oxley's **Dixie Strike** (Dixie Union)'s lone dirt try was a score in Fort Erie's Prince of Wales S. July 15. She was last seen finishing sixth in the Breeders S. over the Woodbine lawn Aug. 5.

**'ROMANCE' BLOOMS FOR KAPLAN**

A strong field of 11 will set out today in Belmont's GII Gallant Bloom H. in hopes of earning a spot in the Nov. 2 GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint. Both the winner and favorite of last year's championship will make a start today in **Musical Romance** (Concorde's Tune) and **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), respectively. Installed as the 9-5 morning-line favorite after a win in Saratoga's GI Ballerina H. Aug. 24, Turbulent Descent will make her second start since being acquired by Coolmore earlier this summer. "We felt like she came out of the Ballerina well and we still have six weekends from now until the Breeders' Cup," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "I think she may need another race to be really spot-on for the Breeders' Cup. She's in good form and doing well. It was nice winning the Ballerina with her, and it's pretty rare seeing a horse who can win Grade 1s at two, three and four. It's a special accomplishment." After tiring to fourth in the GI Vinery Madison S. at Keeneland Apr. 12 and finishing a well-beaten second behind Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) in the GI Humana Distaff on Derby Day, highweight Musical Romance came back with an all-out effort to take Calder's GI Princess Rooney H. July 7. "We're ready to go," said trainer and co-owner Bill Kaplan. "This year, we wanted to build towards running her again the Breeders' Cup. Now that she's a champion, we didn't need to run in the smaller stakes." Eric Fein colorbearer **C C's Pal** (Alex's Pal) has already recorded a win over this track and trip earlier in the season in the GII Vagrancy H. where she scored a career-high 98 Beyer Speed Figure, and enters off a win in the Spa's GII Honorable Miss H. Aug. 3. Sophomore **Emma's Encore** (Congrats) looks to add to her GIII Victory Ride S. win at this track July 7 and her rallying tally in the GI Prioress at Saratoga Aug. 4. "We're going to have to [try older fillies and mares] pretty soon, anyway," said Hall of Fame conditioner Allen Jerkens. "What are we going to do? You're not going to win all of them, so you try hard and do the best you can do." Although the Jerkens trainee might not get the pace set-up she needs in order to hit the board, the Wesley Ward-owned-and-trained **Judy the Beauty** (Ghostzapper), who was out-nosed by Emma's Encore in the Prioress, could find herself in contention given a decent trip.

## HEAVY DUTY

Like last year's winner Caspar Netscher (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}), Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's **Heavy Metal (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) has a three-pound penalty to overcome in today's G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury, which is the price to pay for having already conquered at this level. That success came in the G2 Richmond S. over this trip at Goodwood Aug. 2, when the re-opposing **Master of War (GB)** (Compton Place {GB}) and **Cay Verde (GB)** (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) were back in second and third, respectively. The Darley homebred again had Cay Verde behind when subsequently runner-up to Blaine (GB) (Avonbridge {GB}) in York's G2 Gimcrack S. 22 days later, and his experience of battle will help in this scenario. "He had to carry a penalty on his last start and this start, which is not ideal, but he takes his racing very well," trainer Mark Johnston told *PA Sport*. "The target is the Middle Park, but who knows what the ground will do between now and then, and we thought we might as well get him out while the ground is on the fast side." Since his two reversals at the hands of Heavy Metal, Qatar Racing's Cay Verde has put in a resounding performance on soft ground at Chantilly when taking the five-furlong G3 Prix d'Arenberg last time Sept. 11. Two of the unexposed types who could improve past the standard-bearers are Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Cougar Ridge** (Johannesburg), who was running for the first time in four months when a short-head second to subsequent G1 Vincent O'Brien S. third Leitir Mor (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) in The Curragh's G3 Round Tower S. over this trip Sept. 9; and Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum's **Moohaajim (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}). Fifth in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville on only his second start Aug. 19, he carries stable confidence. "We're looking forward to the race and it looks a very good opportunity for him," said trainer Marco Botti told *PA Sport*. "He ran very well in France and he has probably come on for the experience as well, as he was going for a Group 1 after just one run. He was still a bit green and he got trapped behind the other horses and had to switch wide, so I think he will have learnt quite a lot from that. He's by Cape Cross, so we know that he will get a mile eventually, but we're not in a hurry to step him up, as he has shown plenty of pace."

## TEAM VALOR LOOKING FOR 'LUCK' IN KENT

Given the morning-line nod at 3-1, **Lucky Chappy (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) looks to be primed for today's GIII Kent S. at Delaware. Despite not having won since relocating from Italy last summer, the Team Valor colorbearer has fared well against stiff competition, most recently with a runner-up effort in the GII Virginia Derby over a yielding Colonial Downs sod July 21, and rounding out the trifecta in the Spa's GIII Saranac S. Sept. 2. With plenty of speed signed on, his late-running style will be beneficial. **Cozzetti** (Cozzene) will turn back here off a sixth in the 1 1/4-mile GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 18. Successful on debut over this track and trip Sept. 2, the close relative of the owner/breeder's 2009 G1 Prix de la Foret hero Varenar (Fr) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) has a long way to go before drawing comparison with Dalakhani, but it is interesting that former luminary's trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre pitches him into a pattern-race test so early. While Pearl Bloodstock's July 29 G3 Prix de Cabourg and Sept. 9 G3 Prix La Rochette third **Pearl Flute (Ire)** (Piccolo {GB}) and the Aug. 27 Listed Ripon Champion 2-year-old Trophy scorer **Deauville Prince (Fr)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) offer the best form at present, it may be that the unproven types such as Gerard Augustin-Normand's Aug. 27 Deauville conditions winner **Saint Agnan (Fr)** (Verglas {Ire}) from the Jean-Claude Rouget stable have more to offer here.

🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 **Mandaeen (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}) starts back after a lengthy layoff in today's G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at Longchamp in a bid to provide Godolphin with a third consecutive renewal and fourth overall. Last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner was racing for the first time for the boys in blue when beating only one rival home in the G2 Dante S. over an extended 10-furlong trip at York May 17 and trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni is more than willing to forgive that effort. "We squeezed Mandaeen at the start of the season to get him ready and then gave him a break," he explained. "He has been back in work for a few weeks and is taking his training better. He did two good pieces of work recently and proved that he has improved from the start of the year. He has won a Group 1, and I see that he has a certain amount of class from his work. I think this looks a nice race for him to return in and he heads to France in good form." Another top-level scorer in the line-up is Ahmed Mouknass's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero **Lucayan (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}), but that was a weak renewal of that May 13 Classic for the second year in succession, and he has since had his limitations exposed when ninth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot last time June 19.

## SGA SELECT YEARLINGS Milan, 21 September

### SEA THE STARS COLT TOPS SGA SALE

by Emma Berry

Four yearlings achieved six-figure returns at the Societa Gestiona Aste (SGA) Select Yearling Sale in Milan on Friday, all of which were offered by Isabella Asti Bezzera's Razza del Sole, which was responsible for the top seven lots sold overall. Those highlights boosted the average to €21,385, only fractionally past last year's figure of €21,059, but the median decreased to €10,000 from €13,000 in 2011 when the sale offered 245 yearlings. A streamlined catalogue this time around included just 174 lots, 16 of which were withdrawn.

As has been seen at other yearling auctions across Europe this autumn, however, the clearance rate was the most worrying factor, with only 55% of those offered marked down as sold.

Just as he did in France, first-season sire Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) stole the show when his son Nabateo (lot 8) out of Group 3 winner Rosa Del Dubai (Ire) (Dubai Destination) sold for €250,000 (US\$324,601) to Marco Botti.

Despite being bought by an Italian, the colt can be considered an international purchase as Botti, the son of Italy's champion trainer Alduino Botti, trains successfully in his own right

in Newmarket, which is where his purchase is bound.

"He's a really nice horse and I thought it was a fair price," said Botti, one of six members of the training dynasty present in Milan along with his father, uncle Giuseppe, brother Stefano and cousins Endo and Alessandro. "For me he was the pick of the colts in the sale, and it's lovely to have a Sea the Stars. He will be going to England for one of my existing owners."

Botti has held a training license for just six years, but has already landed a number of big races around the world, including the GI Goodwood S. at Santa Anita with Gitano Hernando (GB) (Hernando {Fr}), and the G1 Prix du Moulin and G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2,000 Guineas) with Excelebration (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}).

Botti also recently won the inaugural running of the American St Leger S. at Arlington Park with Jakkalberry (Ire) (Storming Home {GB}), who is currently in quarantine ahead of a raid on the G1 Melbourne Cup.

New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), winner of the G1 Epsom Derby the year before Sea The Stars, currently tops the European table for freshman sires with runners, and his sole representative in the catalogue, a strong bay colt named L'Importante (lot 120) out of the Desert Prince (Ire) mare L'Indiscreta (GB), achieved the second-highest price of the day when selling for €200,000. He was one of two purchases for Luciano Salice of Scuderia Rencati, a successful owner in both Italy and the UK, whose colours have been borne by eight-time Group 1 winner Falbrav (Ire) (Fairy King). Salice also bought a Dubawi filly (Ire) (lot 93) named Fair Dubawi for €190,000 after seeing off underbidder Jehan Malherbe of Form Bloodstock.

"I'm delighted and, of course I'm biased, but I have to say I was selling nice horses from good families," said Isabella Asti Bezzera, who finished the day as leading vendor, her turnover of €1,049,000 accounting for just over half the sale's aggregate of €2,053,000. "I've also had some good luck, but I was expecting the Sea the Stars colt to sell well. He was very strong and macho, and by a very exciting young stallion."

Bezzera, who is also a key member of the SGA board, added: "The sale is taking place in a difficult market. The situation in Italy is very worrying and the Minister of Agriculture is a very difficult man to see. But Italian breeders are becoming a bigger force and improving their horses. I'm happy because there are many buyers here from different countries, and they have come because Italian horses are impressing people all over the world, and that's important to us." **Cont. p14**

Bruno Grizzetti was the most active of the domestic trainers and, acting on behalf of long-standing patron Allevamento dei Sette, bought a High Chaparral (Ire) colt ([lot 102](#)) out of a half-sister to listed winner Fiulin (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) for €100,000. Late in the day, he also went to €75,000 for a Danehill Dancer (Ire) filly ([lot 154](#)) out of Mujadil Shadow (Ire) (Mujdail) who has already produced a trio of stakes scorers among her six winning offspring.

Boosting the international contingent were South Africans Jehan Malherbe and Mike de Kock, who paid €30,000 for a Cape Cross (Ire) filly out of G3 Prestige S. winner Sesmen (GB) (Inchinor {GB}) through Armando Duarte for Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum.

"She'll either go to be trained in the UK or we'll take her home," said Malherbe. "I need to discuss that with Sheikh

Khalifa, we haven't decided yet."

Malherbe confirmed that this was his first time at the sales in Milan, following on from a debut visit to Arqana's August Sale in Deauville.

"I've been going to Goffs and Tattersalls for many years," he said, "but we thought we'd have a wider look around Europe and try to source a bit of value. This was a lovely filly, and Cape Cross is a really good sire who is constantly undervalued at the sales."

Trainer Mike de Kock has a satellite stable in the historic Abington Place in Newmarket, the base until 2009 of Geoff Wragg until his retirement and its purchase by Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum. The yard has recently changed hands again and has been bought by another client of de Kock and Malherbe, Mary Slack of Wilgerbosdrift Stud in South Africa.

Diego Romeo of Scuderia Incolinx, who has enjoyed big-race success via the likes of Worthadd (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) and Voila Ici (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}), added a son of Cape Cross to his string with Raffaele Biondi for next year when going to €75,000 for [lot 139](#), once again from Razza del Sole. The January-foaled colt is a half-brother to listed-winning trio of Zenone (Ire) (Orpen), Lui E La Luna (GB) (Nayef) and Luna Nel Pozzo (GB) (Choisir {Aus}) and hails from the family of the New Approach colt sold earlier in the day.

Con Marnane, who bought Wokingham S. winner Dandy Boy (Ity) (Danetime {Ire}) at the SGA sale in 2007, returned for his half-sister by Red Rocks (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), Folegandros Island ([lot 97](#)).

"I thought she was great value at €25,000," said Marnane, whose brother David trains Dandy Boy. The filly was one of two first-crop yearlings by Red Rocks to be selected by the Irish pinhooker, the other being a colt named Pinerolo and out of American Beauty (Ger) (Goofalik), who is a full-sister to Group 2 winner and Deutsches Derby runner-up Acambaro. Both yearlings were offered by Centro Equino Aracadia, the stud at which Red Rocks stands.

"He was very tough and he's by Galileo, so he could be a good prospect," said Marnane of Red Rocks. "The colt is going into training, but the filly will go to the breeze-ups."

Another filly bought by Marnane to breeze was Exceed and Excel's daughter of Maschera d'Oro (GB) (Mtoto {GB}), who was knocked down for €52,000.

"For me she was the best filly in the sale and I was really pleased to be able to buy her," Marnane added. "As well as Dandy Boy, I also bought [GI Middle Park S. winner] Amadeus Wolf (GB) (Mozart {Ire}) at this sale--I don't buy many here, but it's always been lucky for me."

Newmarket-based agent Johnny McKeever also signed for three yearlings and felt there was value to be found in Milan.

"I bought an Invincible Spirit (Ire) filly for €42,000--she's by an excellent sire from a good family and an A1 physical," McKeever offered. "I couldn't believe she was going that cheaply. For the horses I bought, I thought they were reasonable value in comparison to what we might have to pay at Tattersalls and Goffs next month." **Cont. p15**

"They're selling around 23 an hour here when we're used to 35 an hour, maybe more," said Biederman, who was enjoying a short break in the country with his wife Lisa. "But people bid much more slowly here."

Praising the SGA team, who invited him to take to the rostrum following the Palm Meadows Sale in Florida in March, he added: "They've done a great job selecting the horses and attracting a good range of buyers. When they asked me to sell some horses they said they sold in English, but when I got here, I discovered it was all done in Italian. However, there are plenty of English and Irish buyers here, and perhaps they appreciated hearing me."

## AWESOME GEM RETIRED

West Point Thoroughbreds' multi-millionaire **Awesome Gem** (Awesome Again--Piano, by Pentelicus) has been retired from racing. The 9-year-old gelding, most recently third in the GIII Longacres Mile at Emerald Downs Aug. 19, was slated to run Sunday in the Ralph M. Hinds H. at Fairplex.

"[Trainer] Craig [Dollase] called me this morning and said Awesome Gem had some filling in a front leg," said Terry Finley, president of West Point. "The decision to retire was easy. He deserves it. He's been a horse of a lifetime for his partners, West Point Thoroughbreds, and team Dollase. After a seven-year career, he owes us nothing. This horse took us across the globe, to four Breeders' Cups, and won or placed in 22 graded stakes.

We'll find him a very good home to live out his days. I sincerely appreciate the support of his partners over the years."

A \$150,000 purchase by West Point at Barretts March in 2005, the chestnut notched his first graded win in the 2007 GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. Later that season, he notched runner-up efforts in the GI Pacific Classic and GI Goodwood Breeders' Cup S. and was third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The classy campaigner captured the 2009 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup and earned an elusive top-level success the following year in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup. He added the GIII Lone Star Park H. and GIII Longacres Mile in 2011, and was victorious in the GIII Berkeley H. earlier this season.

"Awesome Gem is truly a gem," Dollase added. "Today marks the end of a wonderful career. He's been amazingly sound the past seven years, and I'm very proud of his long list of accomplishments. My team sure will miss him around the barn, but we know he'll go to a great home."

Awesome Gem gallops off into the sunset with earnings of \$2,881,370 and a career record of 51-11-15-7.

Ahmed Zayat offered a very upbeat bulletin on twitter yesterday regarding the condition of his GI Haskell winner **Paynter** (Awesome Again), who continues to battle colitis while fending off the subsequently developing laminitis. "Dr. Brian Fraley has flown in to [the Upstate Equine Medical Center in Schuylerville, NY] from Kentucky to visit him and wow, yes, he has beaten laminitis," Zayat revealed, saying that Paynter could eventually race again. He explained, "[Paynter] is showing uniform wall growth in all four feet. Radiographs taken barefoot showed significant sole growth." Zayat added that doctors have said that Paynter could return to performing at his best if he can "beat his colitis and get his gastro-intestinal track back to normal. Healing will take some time, but we are heading in the right direction."

## CHRB Approves Exchange Wagering:

The California Horse Racing Board approved a set of 22 rules related to exchange wagering at their monthly meeting Thursday, but several other steps must be taken before exchange wagering can actually be implemented in the state. A 15-day comment period has begun on the board's decision, and further discussion is expected at CHRB's next meeting Oct. 18. If the CHRB were to go ahead with exchange wagering at that time, rules would have to be reviewed and approved by California's office of administrative law. Approval is also required from the Thoroughbred Owners of California before an exchange can be implemented at a Thoroughbred track. The TOC, which has voiced opposition to exchange wagering for concerns regarding integrity and distribution of profits, is not expected to reach a decision on the matter until next summer.
