"Wow, I didn't see that coming," he commented as the field of seven galloped out. **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) ran much better of the GI Travers S. dead-heaters grabbing the third spot. **Alpha** (Bernardini), favored at 3-5, faded

THE FACTOR RETIRED TO LANE'S END

George Bolton and Fog City Stable's **The Factor** (War Front--Greyciousness, by Miswaki) has been retired from racing and will stand the 2013 season at William S. Farish's Lane's End Farm in Kentucky. A recipient of the "TDN Rising Star" distinction for an 8 1/2-length maiden-breaking romp late in 2010, the speedy grey returned to annex the GI San Vicente S. and run away with GI Rebel S. early in his 3-year-old year. He went on to best his elders in Del Mar's GI Pat O'Brien S. that August, and finished off 2011 with a decisive success in the prestigious GI Malibu S.

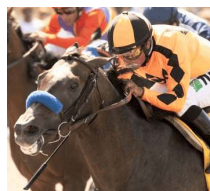

Topping the 2010 Barretts May Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale at \$250,000, The Factor retires with an overall record of 13-6-2-0 and earnings of \$922,180.

“The Factor showed brilliant speed and exceptional scope and quality in his three seasons on the racetrack and Lane’s End is very pleased to stand this stunning horse whose pedigree

will be of great interest to breeders,” said Will Farish. The Factor will stand with an initial stud fee of \$15,000. “We’re really doing a deal--[Fog City’s] David Shimmon and I with Lane’s End--to have a five- to 10-year plan,” Bolton explained on *HRTV*. “Instead of trying to have a high stud fee and a lot of mares the first year, we’re trying to get really good mares and, we think, because he’s fast and he’s got that great Danzig line, that people will like him at that level.” Bolton, who was roommates with Bill Farish at the University of Virginia, added, “It’s very exciting for me because Bill Farish and his father were the ones who got me into the sport, so it’s fun for me to have a colt who’s good enough to go down there [to Lane’s End].” [Click here for The Factor’s brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#) or [brisnet.com lifetime past performances](#).

VETS, MEDS FOCUS OF NY TIMES STORY

The *New York Times* has published its latest installment in a series of articles on the darker side of the horse racing industry, focusing this time on the abuse of prescription medications and the veterinarians prescribing them ([click here for complete feature](#)).

“Only veterinarians can legally prescribe medicine, yet they often let trainers, who are paid to win races, make medical decisions, including which drugs to use,” the article reads. “These veterinarians also have a powerful financial incentive to prescribe drugs: they are both doctor and drugstore, and so the more drugs they prescribe, the more money they make. Selling and administering drugs, in fact, accounts for most of their income.”

One of the medications discussed is clenbuterol, a bronchodilator that reportedly has steroidal qualities. California recently eliminated threshold levels for clenbuterol and recommended a 21-day withdrawal period for the medication. The Racing Medication and Testing Consortium (RMTTC) is awaiting the results of an ongoing study by the University of California, Davis before ruling on a possible clenbuterol ban.

Another medication addressed in the article is oxymetazoline, an ingredient in the over-the-counter cold remedy Afrin. According to the *Times*, over a 12-day period in 2011, Standardbreds at tracks in Pennsylvania and New York were treated with oxymetazoline and that “36 of 38 horses using the drug finished first or second, with 31 winning their races,” the article states.

In December, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board revealed that fines and suspensions had been levied to 16 individuals for oxymetazoline violations at the harness racing venues Yonkers, Monticello and Saratoga. Dr. Louis A. Grasso, who is believed to have treated several of the harness horses in question, lost his license to practice at New York racetracks, but is one of the few veterinarians to have been thusly sanctioned, the *Times* reports.

“Losing a racing license is not a big enough deterrent,” Edward J. Martin, president of the Association of Racing Commissioners International, told the *Times*. “We believe losing a veterinarian’s license is. This is a hole in the regulatory scheme and needs to be plugged.”

When the gates opened for the Cotillion--the first Grade I event in Pennsylvania racing history--both Questing and My Miss Aurelia came away alertly, before jockey Corey Nakatani ceded the early lead to Questing and Irad Ortiz Jr. The Godolphin filly raced well away from the quicksand inside paths through dawdling splits of :25.19 and :50.04, with My Miss Aurelia just behind to her outside. Nakatani gave the Eclipse Award winner her cue on the far turn and she responded immediately. The two stars went at it shoulder to shoulder, brushing several times in the stretch, but the taller My Miss Aurelia would not be denied in the end. "We decided we'd let Questing do her thing early and save our best for later," said Nakatani. "With such a slow pace, I had to move a little sooner than I would have wanted. It was a horse race." My Miss Aurelia, a professional winner of her Saratoga debut last July, went into the GI Breeders Cup Juvenile Fillies as the favorite following victories in the GII Adirondack S. and GI Frizette S. A three-length victory in the marquee event under the Twin Spires sealed her championship claims, but she was sidelined with shin problems subsequently. In her only outing this campaign, the bay was successful in the restricted Mandy's Gold S. at Saratoga Aug. 8. Her yearling half-brother by Distorted Humor sold for \$850,000 to Shadwell during Keeneland September's Book 1.

With assistant trainer Leandro Mora deputizing for the suspended Doug O'Neill, Handsome Mike stayed well off the rail while leading through a half mile in :49.37. Headed briefly by Alpha on the turn for home, Handsome Mike came right back at him at the head of affairs and kept on finding more in the stretch to pull off the upset. "We tend in our stable to try to hit the ball over the fence," owner J. Paul Reddam told *Daily Racing Form*. "We strike out a lot, but every once in a while the ball does go over the fence."

Dust and Diamonds, a sparkling 8 3/4-length allowance winner while returning from a 12-month hiatus at Saratoga last September, rolled triple 3s in optional-claiming efforts at Belmont, Churchill and Santa Anita before receiving another freshening. The Padua homebred

got back on track with a sharp \$35,000 optional-claiming win at Oaklawn Mar. 24, then, following another break, rolled to an impressive 5 3/4-length tally in Delaware's Dashing Beauty S. last time July 21. Overlooked a bit at the windows here, Dust and Diamonds chased in second through a hot opening quarter in :21.82. She challenged for command at the top of stretch, drew clear down the lane and was never seriously threatened by the late rally of Judy the Beauty while securing an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. Champion Musical Romance was along in time to outfinish favored Turbulent Descent (Congrats) for third. "She broke very sharp, as usual, and she was very relaxed the first quarter," jockey Julien Leparoux commented. "Then she just took me into the race and finished up strong." Turbulent Descent, a sharp winner of Saratoga's GI Ballerina S. Aug. 24 in her first attempt for trainer Todd Pletcher, failed to land a blow while reporting home a mediocre fourth. "Our biggest concern was the track seems to have been super fast since we've come back," Pletcher said. "I wouldn't know if she likes the track this firm. It seems to be kind of speed-favoring and she got further back than we had hoped. She kind of flattened out the last part. We'll regroup."

After a smooth introduction to racing action in Ascot's Crocker Bulteel Maiden S. over six furlongs July 22, Moohaajim was far from disgraced when pitched into the deep end in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville and belied his inexperience to be fifth in that Aug. 19 highlight. Justifying market confidence here, the bay demonstrated all the ability he had been flaunting on the Newmarket gallops to open his black-type account in style. Restrained from the gates as Richard Hughes set the early pace on Master of War, he was full of run, but trapped in a pocket approaching the final furlong with jockey Adam Kirby seeking an out. After muscling his way into the clear, which caused concertina interference to the eventual third Taayel, he swooped on the long-time leader with 100 yards remaining en route to a decisive success as the Shadwell representative found his feet. "He's special and, as long as he keeps his head, he is going to be a really top-class horse," Kirby commented. "We were going very slow, and I didn't want to set him alight and get him racing early, but when he got out he picked up very fast. He'll stay farther, but he's got a high cruising speed and can really pick up off that."

Optimizer showed his affinity for grass in his first two career starts at Saratoga as a juvenile last summer, including a heart-breaking nose defeat in the GII With Anticipation S., but didn't make it back to the infield until placing a solid fourth in the GII Virginia Derby July 21, 10 starts later. A close second to Secret Circle (Eddington) in the GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn Mar. 17, the Bluegrass Hall homebred was defeated by double digits in all three Triple Crown events, including a 10th-place finish in the GI Belmont S. June 9. He rallied to round out the superfecta in his aforementioned effort at Colonial, then was fifth in a washed off edition of the GII Hall of Fame S. at the Spa Aug. 10. Optimizer received some much needed class relief to clear his first allowance condition, wiring a group of optional \$35,000 taggers over the Saratoga lawn Aug. 25, and was well-supported by the Delaware faithful to make it two straight here. Drawn wide in post nine, he exchanged blows with Excaper while racing on the inside through testing early fractions of :22.71 and :46.99. With Jon Court aboard, Optimizer gained a narrow lead at the top of the stretch and impressively kicked clear late to win for fun.

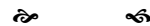

Trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni reported the Aug. 11 G3 Sweet Solera S. and Sept. 14 G2 May Hill S. winner to have pleased in her recent work. "Certify did a nice, easy piece of work this morning and we are hopefully aiming her towards Newmarket," he said. "We have the option of staying close to home or going to France for the G1 Prix Marcel Bousac the following week. The decision is based mainly on how she came out of her run at Doncaster. She is in good form at the moment. Certify showed that she is a good filly in the May Hill S., because she kicked off a slow pace. It's usually not very easy to win from behind if there is no pace, and she still showed a little bit of greenness. She is learning with her racing, and I hope that she will be better on her next outing. She is improving all of the time and seems to go on any ground." Among her opponents is likely to be Nick and Olga Dhandsa and John and Zoe Webster's unbeaten Aug. 25 G3 Prestige S. scorer **Ollie Olga** (Stormy Atlantic) from the Mick Channon stable; Mary-Anne Parker's July 26 Listed Star S. winner **Roz (GB)** (Teofilo {Ire}) from Harry Dunlop's barn; and Khalid Abdullah's **Winsili (GB)** (Dansili {GB}). John Gosden yesterday supplemented that homebred, who was a latest second to Godolphin's Lovely Pass (Ire) (Raven's Pass) in a mile conditions event at Ascot Sept. 8, at a cost of £15,000.

French Fifteen Out for the Season...

Trainer Nicolas Clement has ruled **French Fifteen (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) out of the remainder of the 2012 campaign. Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani's G1 Criterium international winner and G1 2000 Guineas runner-up has not been seen since beating only one home in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly July 1. "French Fifteen sustained a tiny hairline fracture to a hind leg and the vets are now very happy with him, but he won't run again this season," his conditioner told the *Racing Post*. "We will try and win another Group 1 race in 2013."

A TALE OF TWO SALES

The second week of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale (seven sessions in Books 3-6 from Saturday, Sept. 15–Friday, Sept. 21) established at least three things. Most significantly, Books 4 and 5 (Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday), with a combined 76.7% clearance rate from those catalogued and a combined \$36,988 average for 913 horses sold, demonstrated that the contracted foal crop and re-calibrated market ‘third tier’ can operate in a vibrant trading (if not profitable; that’s another issue) manner. In other words, between domestic and newly developed international markets, there is big demand for \$40,000 American-bred yearlings.

Second, the re-calibration of the bottom tier of the commercial yearling market in Kentucky is increasingly moving from Keeneland’s second week to Fasig-Tipton’s October Yearling Sale, scheduled this year for Oct. 22-24. This might have once been interpreted as a slur on Fasig-Tipton, but not as of last year, when they catalogued 1,007 yearlings, and sold 710 of them (70.5% of the catalogue) for a gross of \$17 million (near enough double the sale’s gross in 2010), and a very respectable average of \$24,010. This year, Fasig’s three-day sale has 1,254 catalogued--an increase of another 25%--many of them refugees from Keeneland Book 6. We may have to wait another four weeks to confirm the suspicion that the market for \$25,000 yearlings is just as strong as it’s been this week for \$40,000 yearlings at Keeneland.

The third thing we learn from the Week 2 results is more sobering, and it has to do with the comparison with the four-day Week 1, Books 1 and 2. Monday night’s Book 1 got off to a slow start with only 57% of the catalogue selling, but the market started to perceptibly pick up midway through Book 2’s opening Tuesday session, and Wednesday and Thursday felt very strong. Yet, in all of Book 2, 72.2% of the yearlings sent through the ring were sold. For Books 1-2 combined (Week 1), the figure was 71.4%. In week 2, the comparative figure was 84.7%. If you want to look at it from the point of view of percentage sold from the catalogue (which in America especially takes into account increased day-of-sale withdrawals due to lack of vets, scopes, second looks, etc.), in Books 1 and 2 combined, 62.5% of the catalogues were listed as sold--five out of eight. In Week 2, the comparative figure was 72.8%--over a 10% higher clearance rate from the catalogue.

This statistic can highlight only one thing: a lack of buyers for \$200,000 yearlings--\$202,829 was the combined average for Books 1 and 2. At Keeneland September 2008--literally the last sale before The Crash hit the Thoroughbred market--Books 1 and 2 grossed \$206.7 million; this year, Week 1--Books 1 and 2--grossed \$132.8 million. The Week 1 gross has declined by 36%. The number catalogued has declined by 19%, the number sold by 22%, and the average by 18%. Yes, the Week 1 market (like the whole of the Thoroughbred market) then was bloated; yes, there needed to be declines, world market collapse or no world market collapse. But the recovery in Week 1--the most important sector of the North American yearling market--is happening much more slowly. The market for \$40,000 yearlings is stabilizing; the market for \$200,000 yearlings is not.

TDN Publisher Barry Weisbord made a typically astute observation to me a couple of months ago when we were talking about the 'flattening' of the APEX A Runner indices for the top sires: keep in mind, he said, with the big crops all these sires are running against a lot more horses by other good sires, rather than a lot of horses by mediocre sires.

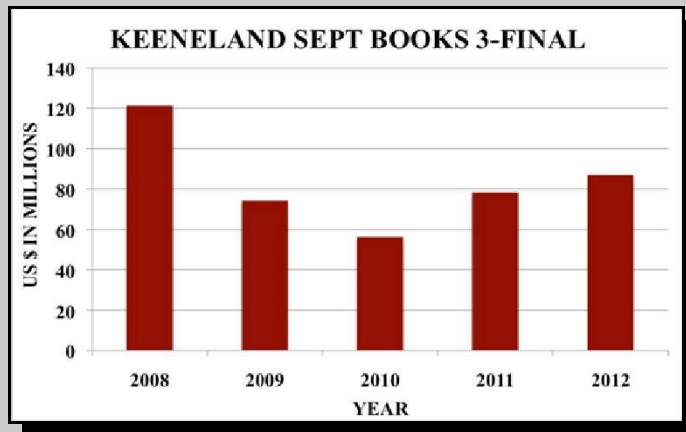
Good point, and it applies to the yearling sales, too. Sure, Books 4 and 5 were super-strong, but are the sires in those books a lot stronger than they used to be, too? And this whole line of thinking also applies, even more so, to commercial breeders who must now consider what they can afford to sign up for in the way of 2013 stud fees. Take a look at the table of 115 sires which had six or more yearlings sell at Keeneland September, ranked by their Keeneland September average only ([click here](#) to see averages for all 239 sires represented at Keeneland, alphabetically; [click here](#) to go to the Instatistics table ranking all yearling sires for all sales covered in 2012). Seven sires who are currently scheduled to be standing in North America in 2013 had September averages between \$218,000-\$319,000. Can commercial breeders, as I asked last week, really afford to be paying \$100,000 stud fees when the top sires, at the top sale on the continent, average between \$218,000 -\$319,000? It's a tough ask.

Keeneland's first week grossed \$132.8 million, and it will still be the highest-grossing sale in the North American and European yearling market at the end of 2012. But it may not be the most important. Tattersalls' October 1 Sale in Newmarket (Oct 9-11 this year), grossed the equivalent of \$87.7 million (at today's rates), and averaged over \$240,000, with 364 sold (71.6% of 508 catalogued) in 2011. That is a 9% higher clearance rate from the catalogue than Keeneland Week 1 achieved this year. This year's three-day October 1 sees 577 catalogued, an increase of 13%. With 42 yearlings by Galileo catalogued, and over 175 by consensus World Top 15 sires, that's the sale where the big guns will unload their arsenals.

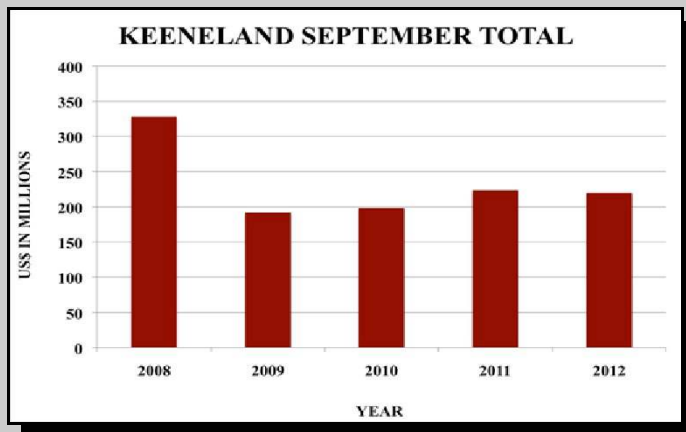

"Week 2, starting with Book 3 last Saturday, was a different sale: though 19% fewer were catalogued and 14% fewer sold than in 2011, the Week 2 gross was up by 11%, and the average by an impressive 29%, with an amazing 72.8% clearance rate from the catalogues. Shrinking the foal crop has worked, at least to some extent: the Week 2 average is now higher than even in 2008, from when the number of Week 2 horses catalogued at Keeneland has plunged by 40%."

Not all the buyers of \$200,000-plus yearlings disappeared in The Crash; some are concentrating their attentions more on Newmarket than on Lexington, which I have no doubt will be confirmed in about another 16 days. Kentucky desperately needs more of the kind of sire power which will attract back European buyers--that, to me, is one of the principal messages of this year's Keeneland September sale, and particularly of Week 1 results. And there's only one way to do that: go buy them. That, and no race-day medication. Buyers of \$40,000 yearlings don't mind; some potential buyers of \$200,000 yearlings clearly do.

Having taken the G2 Derby Italiano over 11 furlongs at the Capannelle May 20, Stall Eivissa was no match for **Pastorius (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) when unplaced behind that rival in the 12-furlong G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 1 and G1 Grosser Dallmyar-Preis over 10 furlongs at Munich four weeks later. Runner-up in the G1 Grosser Preis von Bayern back over this trip at the latter venue last time Aug. 12, he had **Earl of Tinsdal (Ger)** (Black Sam Bellamy {Ire}) back in third on that occasion. **Ovambo Queen (Ger)** (Kalatos {Ger}) may offer the sternest opposition from the older brigade, having beaten **Waldpark (Ger)** (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg July 3 and twice finished within a length of her esteemed compatriot **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {Ger}) in the May 20 G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmer and Sept. 2 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden.

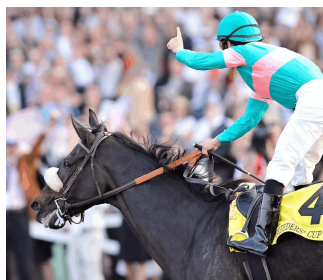

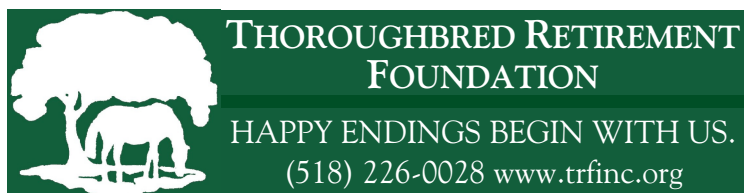
