## PERIOD OF PRIVATIZATION POSSIBLE FOR NY RACING *by Mike Kane*

It was revealed Monday that a for-profit company could manage the operations of the not-for-profit New York Racing Association during the time it is under the stewardship of the State of New York. The state is preparing to issue a Request For Proposals to conduct business at the NYRA tracks--Aqueduct, Belmont Park and Saratoga Race Course--for the three years that New York controls the huge racing franchise. The RFPs are likely to generate a response from racing and management companies interested in a piece of the billions in handle and other business generated by NYRA. With revenue from the racino at Aqueduct, NYRA may end a decade of losses with a profit in 2012.

Three weeks after the 144th season of racing in Saratoga ended, speculation was replaced by news Monday when state officials said that the bill authorizing the state takeover of NYRA will be signed by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo this week. The signing will be followed by the naming of the members of the temporary reorganization board of NYRA and the newest incarnation of NYRA. Trustees of the beleaguered association agreed in May to allow the state--which will appoint 12 of the 17 members of the new board--to control the association, which has a 25-year franchise agreement.

The state moved to take over NYRA in the wake of a report in April alleging that NYRA president Charles Hayward was aware that it had overcharged bettors by 1% (totaling \$8.5 million) on certain exotic wagers for more than a year.

Howard Glaser, the director of state operations and the point man in the Cuomo administration on the NYRA restructuring, said a third party will be selected.

"The State of New York does not want to be in the business of managing horse racing in New York," Glaser said in a radio interview on WGDJ in Albany. "What we're in the business of doing is fixing the management of horse racing and then leaving it to those that are competent to do it."

Cuomo is also expected to participate in the release of a report by the committee that investigated an unusually high number of equine breakdowns and deaths last winter at Aqueduct. The release date is tentatively scheduled for Friday. **Cont. p3**

Mott issued a similarly upbeat bulletin for Besilu Stables' **"TDN Rising Star"** **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker), who covered the same trip as To Honor and Serve in :47.56 as she looks to bounce back from a runner-up effort in the GI Personal Ensign H. 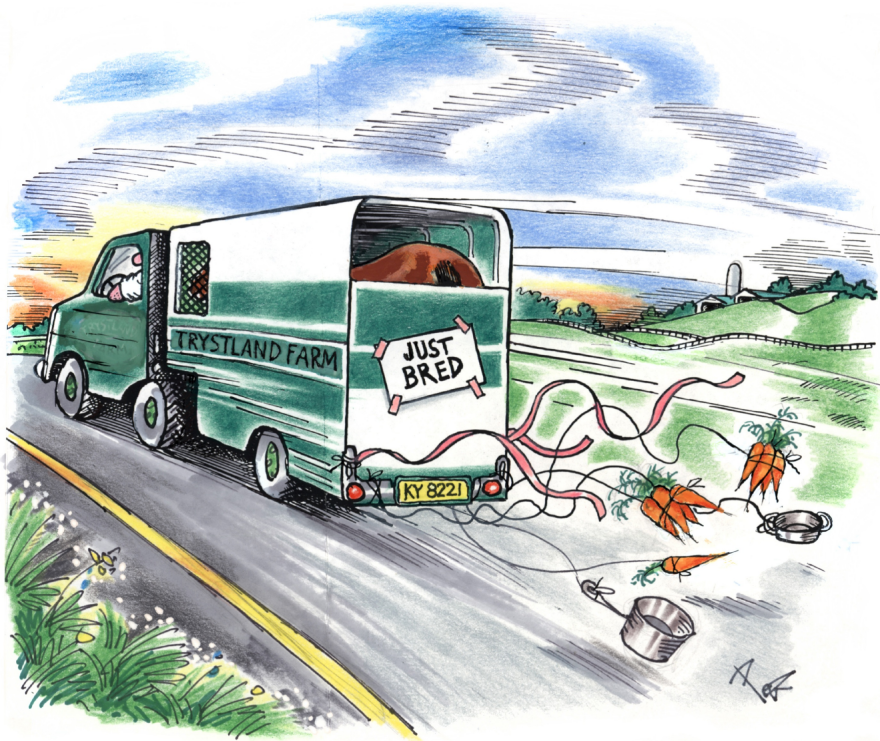

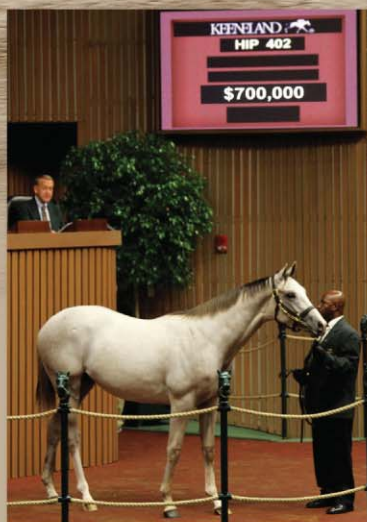

**New York racing cont.**

The *New York Post* reported Monday that the state was moving toward privatization of racing in New York, a dramatic departure from the model that has been in place since NYRA was formed in 1955. However, later in the day state officials said that RFPs are for the term of the reorganization period.

The change in racing law to allow the state takeover of NYRA was approved by the Legislature in June. Cuomo must sign it this week because a provision of the law pushes the formation of New York's new gaming commission from Oct. 1 to Feb. 1 of next year. Cuomo's signature will keep the New York State Racing and Wagering Board in place until the gaming commission is established.

Cuomo took questions from reporters about the NYRA developments Monday following a press announcement on the Capitol on an unrelated matter. He spoke in general terms about what is ahead for NYRA.

"We're going to be putting a new board in place to basically take control," Cuomo said. "How you do the business of putting forth horse racing and what is racing in the future and how do you incorporate all the knowledge and potential of the entertainment industry, which is a big component of this, is something we're working through."

Speaking at the governor's press briefing, Howard Glaser noted that the legislation says control must be returned to the not-for-profit NYRA. While NYRA will not be dissolved, Glaser said that the reorganization board is charged with recommending how the association will be shaped for life after state control.

"The franchise is NYRA's--they have a long-term franchise," Glaser said. "The operations of NYRA, which is what's at issue here, because that is what has been flawed, could be done in a variety of ways. No one option has been selected, but there are many ideas on the table and we'll look at that. It's two different things, the operations versus the legal franchise."

## MOTT RUNNERS GET IN FINAL WORKS cont.

Fellow Live Oak runner **Seasoned Warrior** (Majestic Warrior) went in :48.89, and the 2-year-old filly will go in Sunday's six-furlong GII Matron S., rather than next weekend's GI Frizette S. at a mile. She found herself surprisingly far back last time in the Sept. 2 GI Spinaway S., but came on a bit late to be fourth. "I don't think the whole thing [in the Spinaway] was her race," said Mott, who was pleased with Seasoned Warrior's final morning prep. "I'd say at one point I'd be willing to stretch her out--I won't say we won't--but I'm going to enter her in [the Matron]. I think she's a fast enough filly that she can compete at that trip." Seasoned Warrior earned her diploma second out at Saratoga going six furlongs Aug. 12.

A bevy of juvenile workers from Todd Pletcher's powerhouse stable were out and about at Belmont Park yesterday morning as they prepare for upcoming local engagements.

Starlight Racing's **Shanghai Bobby** (Harlan's Holiday) breezed four furlongs on the training track in :49.47--the 16th-fastest of 33 spins at the distance. "I thought he worked very well," Pletcher said of the

Alto Racing LLC's highly regarded ⚡ **"TDN Rising Star" ⚡ Archwarrior** (Arch) also prepped Monday for the Champagne, drilling five panels in 1:00.33 (3/22) on the training track alongside fellow Saratoga debut winner **Micromanage** (Medaglia d'Oro). "I don't really want to run Archwarrior on the synthetic surface at this time, so it sort of limits your graded stakes options on the dirt," explained Pletcher. "He has trained very well on the dirt and I think the one-turn mile will suit him very well." Micromanage's next start remains undecided.

On the filly front, Stonestreet Stables LLC's **Dreaming of Julia** (A.P. Indy) worked a maintenance half mile in :49.62. "It was a very standard maintenance half [mile] for her. She was very professional as always," Pletcher said of the ⚡ **"TDN Rising Star" ⚡**. "She is hopefully on the same schedule [as Shanghai Bobby] running in the [Oct. 6 GI] Frizette S." The homebred daughter of MGISW Dream Rush (Wild Rush) was last seen annexing the Sept. 9 Meadow Star S. by 16 1/4 lengths over the Frizette track and trip. Fellow Stonestreet colorbearer and ⚡ **"TDN Rising Star" ⚡ Kauai Katie** (Malibu Moon), winner of the GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga Aug. 12, worked five furlongs in 1:00.27. She'll run in Sunday's GII Matron S.

Among Pletcher's juveniles still waiting in the wings is **Darwin** (Big Brown), a \$1.3-million FTFEB purchase by the Coolmore contingent. He worked four panels from the gate in :48.34 over the main track yesterday, good for the 14th-fastest of 42 spins at that trip. "He's been training very well," Pletcher said. "He's a very professional-acting colt and he has been doing everything properly in the morning, so he is close to being ready." Pletcher continued, "I would say he'll be ready to start in the next couple of weeks at Belmont. He's had a nice, steady series of breezes, including two consecutive gate works in which he has been away from the gate alertly and he seems to be a pretty professional sort that things have come pretty easily to so far."

### WINNING EXPRESS ADDED TO PARK FIELD

Milton Express Limited's unbeaten **Winning Express (Ire)** (Camacho {GB}) was yesterday supplemented by trainer Ed McMahan for Saturday's G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket, for which 15 fillies remained at the six-day stage. Having taken the Sept. 6 Listed Dick Poole Fillies' S. over six furlongs at Salisbury, the bay was added to the feature at a cost of £15,000. "Winning Express has been fine since she won at Salisbury," McMahan commented. "I don't think she would want extremes of ground and she would probably go on going a fraction slower than good, but ideally she would want it quicker than good to be at her best." Among the list is Clipper Logistics' unbeaten Aug. 23 G2 Lowther S. winner **Rosdhu Queen (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), Ahmad Alkhalafi's July 28 G3 Princess Margaret S. scorer **Maureen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) and Arashan Ali's **The Gold Cheongsam (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}). Successful in the Weatherbys Insurance £300,000 2-Y-O S. at Doncaster last time Sept. 13, she needs the ground to stay on the fast side and the current wet spell is unwelcome for connections. "I was delighted with her performance at Doncaster, because she won a competitive race on ground which was far from ideal for her," trainer Jeremy Nosedá said. "When horses do that, you know they are in good nick and to me the ideal ground for her would be firm ground. We don't get that very often nowadays, but that would be what she really wants. She did a piece of work the other day and I feel she is at the top of her game. I'm just keeping my fingers crossed for faster ground come Saturday and, hopefully, we'll get a big piece of the pie. She's a tough genuine filly and she gets better, but the ground is going to be crucial to our chance."

Having been aimed at the Longchamp showpiece since her seventh Group 1 success in the Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 8, Cristina Patino's homebred will head elsewhere if the wet spell takes its toll. "It's a weather-watch," Dunlop said. "I believe we've got rain coming in and if it's going on in Paris, we won't be going."

### EAMON CLEARY, 52

Eamon Cleary, owner of Clearsky Farms, died Saturday in Kentucky after a battle with cancer. He was 52. Born in County Monaghan, Cleary reportedly left school at the age of 11 to work on his father's farm. By 15, he had taken up a masonry apprenticeship, and by 20 had started his concrete and reinforcing steel company. He later moved into agriculture, and in the early 1990s moved to New Zealand. There, he amassed his fortune developing dairy and sheep farms, and later expanded to cattle and cropping farms in Argentina and Australia. Cleary, who first became involved with racing in 1987, established Clearsky Farms in 2009. The farm, which has a broodmare band of 40, sold a \$1 million son of Tapit at this year's Fasig-Tipton Florida sale and a \$675,000 son of Sea the Stars (Ire) during last week's Keeneland September sale. Cleary raced steeplechase horses in New Zealand and campaigned champions Rand (NZ) and Real Tonic (NZ), as well as Group 1 winner Rags to Riches (NZ).

## F-T OCTOBER SALE DRAWS RECORD ENTRIES

Fasig-Tipton has catalogued a record 1,254 yearlings for its three-day October Sale, which will take place Oct. 22-24 at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky. ### NY Times Piece Nominated for Bergstein Award: *Edited Press Release*

Team Valor International has issued an automatic nomination to the team of *New York Times* writers for the inaugural Stanley Bergstein Writing Award, recognizing their Sept. 22 piece on the role of veterinarians in the widespread use of drugs in horse racing. In the front-page story "At The Track, Racing Economics Collide With Veterinarians Oath," writers Walt Bogdanich, Joe Drape and Rebecca Ruiz lay out how racetrack vets participate in and benefit from an emphasis on drugs that can be seen as conflicting with their oath to protect "animal health and welfare."
