Undefeated GSW at two

A FAMILIAR APPROACH

It was a case of business as usual in yesterday's G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. at Newmarket as **"TDN Rising Star" Dawn Approach (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}) took his perfect record to six and led home a one-two for Jim Bolger, who was annexing a fifth renewal in seven years. Racing in third early off the strong tempo forced by his pacesetting stable companion **Leitir Mor (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), the Sept. 15 G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. winner took a few strides to reach top gear with a quarter mile remaining, but after passing his barnmate just inside the final furlong, stretched away for a

comfortable 2 3/4-length score. In a break from tradition, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum announced afterwards that the winning 3-10 favorite would stay with his current trainer despite carrying the royal blue. "Sometimes, we change," Dubai's ruler said of the unprecedented shift in policy. "It is a great day and we are very happy. We hope he will be back here for the 2000 Guineas, but the trainer will see if he's a Derby horse." **Cont. p3**

JOYFUL ABANDON

Off since extending his perfect tally to four in the G1 Prix Morny over this trip at Deauville Aug. 19, **Reckless Abandon (GB)** (Exchange Rate) demonstrated the same raw speed which had already cemented a substantial reputation to bring up a notable top-level double in yesterday's G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket. In front after the first furlong and on the stand's rail soon after as Gerald Mosse brought him across from his wide stall, the diminutive bay waited for the fellow 9-4 joint-favorite **Moohaajim (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}). After a final-furlong tussle with that rival, he held on to score by a neck. "We got the chance to get to the lead without too much pressure, and I tried to save him and get him to relax then," Mosse explained. "When they started to come, he picked up well and kept fighting. Aside from the obvious promise of his debut win in the opening juvenile turf maiden to be staged in Ireland this year, Dawn Approach was also providing his sire with a first winner in that five-furlong contest at The Curragh Mar. 25. Proving that was far from a novelty, the flashy chestnut stepped up to six furlongs for a

conditions event and overcame a penalty to win by 5 1/2 lengths May 16. Back over that track and trip for the June 4 Listed Rochestown S., he turned back a challenge from the British raider Mister Marc (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) there before taking on that country's finest precocious stars in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 19. Leitir Mor provided a near-perfect tow in that race, but his ability saw him in front too far from home, and he was still green out in the open as the subsequent Group 1 and dual Group 2 winner Olympic Glory (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}) chased. Granted a break due to the wet summer, he only strengthened his case as the juvenile category's champion elect when romping to a 4 3/4-length success in the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. on his first try at this trip at The Curragh last time Sept. 15, and his trainer had warned that he expected improvement from that race to here.

In the event, the only moment of brief concern came when he failed to pick up as instantly as many expected running to the quarter pole, but when sent about his business by Kevin Manning he soon had matters under control. Ballydoyle's George Vancouver had emerged from last on the wide outside to offer a threat, but that was quickly brushed aside, and at the line the chestnut had ears pricked as he clocked a time faster than the older horses had managed in the G2 Challenge S. earlier on the card. "We've been fortunate over the last few years to have such good 2-year-olds, and he's just another one of those," Manning said. "We went a proper pace and it never dropped, and two-down he hit that flat spot he always does, but I knew there was plenty there, and when he hit the rising ground he went away. He's very straightforward to ride--he has a great cruising gear and you can do anything you like on him. He ticks all the boxes, and he's much easier to deal with than his father, who had a bit of temperament about him and had to be ponied to the start. It's been a long year for him, but he's kept progressing and strengthening up all the time. He had a busy time up to Ascot, but afterwards it was a nice break for him, and he did very well at The Curragh last time. It is very hard to say at this stage, but I have no doubt that he will get further than a mile next year." Bolger simply stated, "He's capable of ruling the roost."

Despite showing a tendency to hang left when in front on his first two starts in a Doncaster maiden May 19 and in the June 21 G2 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot, Reckless Abandon also served notice of his above-average ability by winning with something in hand on both occasions. Taken to France to tackle their speediest in the G2 Prix Robert Papin over 5 1/2 furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte next time July 22, he again jinked left when firmly in control before staying straight and true in the Prix Morny Aug. 19. Making this a test of pillar-to-post pace, he had all rivals off the bridle at halfway, and his tempo was best measured by the sight of Ballydoyle's number one Cristoforo Colombo (Henrythenavigator) being taken out of his comfort zone in a detached last. As Reckless Abandon's former jockey Adam Kirby worked his way into contention on Moohaajim at the furlong marker, with the Norfolk runner-up Gale Force Ten hanging tough for Rosegreen out wide, he looked set to be swamped. Gerald Mosse pulled out his whip there, and his mount responded in determined fashion to outgame that duo and keep his admirable sequence intact. "There is nothing wrong with him, but he is just full of energy and young in his mind, so wants to play," Mosse said of the winner, who had acted up in the preliminaries and got warm before the start. "He has plenty of ability, and they have prepared him very well for this race. He pricked his ears in front and was carrying on after the line. He is very athletic and stays close to the ground--he has a big stride, and you don't feel the ground on him." Trainer Clive Cox added, "This is a fantastic day for all the team, and he's very talented. I thought he showed a great attitude to carry on to the line. He won't run again this season, and although he has a lot of speed, we have a few months to decide on what to do with him next year."

Appropriately enough, Dayatthespa made her racetrack debut at the Saratoga, taking a 5 1/2-furlong turf maiden restricted to state-breds by a resounding four lengths, then shipped north of the border to be second to Northern Passion (First Samurai) in the GII Natalma S., with Stephanie's Kitten a couple lengths further back in third. Though she was an excuse-free ninth to that rival when they rematched in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf last November, she has not tasted defeat since.

Dayatthespa overcame a 12-length deficit to win the Jan. 22 Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream, but was ridden more positively when a neck winner of the GIII Herecomesthebride S. in Hallandale Mar. 12. She

made a successful first visit to Lexington, besting Somali Lemonade (Lemon Drop Kid) by 2 3/4 front-running lengths in the GIII Appalachian S. Apr. 19, was given the rest of

the spring and part of the summer off and resumed with a handy 1 1/4-length tally in the Aug. 31 Riskaverse S. back at Saratoga.

Drawn widest in this field of eight, Dayatthespa was asked for a bit of speed and had some early company to her inside in the form of GII Lake George S. winner Centre Court and GII Sands Point S. victress Better Lucky, but, without having to work too hard, led into the first turn after an opening quarter-mile in :24.52. Making the running from the two path, Dayatthespa raced by the opening half in a hassle-free :49.11 and dared the others to catch her with a six-furlong split of 1:13.96. It was all over but the shouting from there, as the athletic filly threw in a final three-eighths of a mile in :35.03 to win convincingly. Centre Court was a game runner-up, while Better Lucky outnoddodded GI Garden City S. heroine Samitar (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) for third.

"I handicapped the race, and I didn't see a lot of speed in the race," confirmed winning rider Javier Castellano, taking his second QE II after Bit of Whimsy (Distorted Humor) in 2007. "Only one horse had speed. I thought the pace was going to be moderate today, and I took advantage. My filly, she's really quick out of the gate. On the turn for home at the quarter pole, I asked her a little bit and she responded. When she took off, I just let her go--hand ride."

Victorious trainer Chad Brown said there was no decision on a next spot for Dayatthespa, though he stated that the GI Breeders' Cup Filly/Mare Turf was likely not under consideration.

The well-bred La Cloche, a half-sister to the recently retired millionaire Winter Memories (El Prado {Ire}), added a valuable graded stakes win to her resume here. She secured her first career stakes victory in Belmont's Voodoo Dancer S. July 8, then finished a close fifth in Saratoga's De La Rose S. Aug. 4. La Cloche was as far back as 18 lengths in the Sept. 15 GIII Noble Damsel S., and improved her position to report home sixth, beaten 4 1/4 lengths. Settled in a good spot along the rail in sixth through fractions of :25.16 and :50.27, La Cloche was guided out by Junior Alvarado at the top of the stretch and came charging down the center of the course to finish with a rush and realize a career high. "[Owner] John [Phillips] will be thrilled about [the graded stakes win]," trainer Jimmy Toner revealed. "That's all we've heard, 'Gotta get a graded stakes, gotta get a graded stakes, gotta get a graded stakes!' Thank God, maybe she can get out of her sister's shadow for a change. We're really happy for her." Toner continued, "Junior [Alvarado] rode a great race. He really did. He just waited and waited and tipped her outside. She's got to get outside, and she exploded at the end. This filly is difficult to ride; you have to know her. If everything goes right for her, she can get the job done." It was Alvarado's first time aboard La Cloche since the Voodoo Dancer. "I just was waiting for my chance to move outside because she never runs one step on the inside," Alvarado commented. "That was pretty much what I was trying to work out first. She was able to swing outside by the quarter pole, and after that I won't say it was really easy, but she took off. She really helped me and gave me a nice kick at the end."

Coming under pressure with three furlongs remaining, he hooked up with Montiridge, who loomed large on the bridle, approaching the final eighth and battled gamely to deny that market rival in a pulsating duel for a career high. "I have been liking him for a long time, but he is very much a ground-dependent horse who wants good ground and we haven't had it all year," Bolger said. "The first chance I had to run him was at Leopardstown, so we were happy to let him start. The next chance for him was in his maiden. We will see how he comes out of this, but he is in the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 27], and we will have to see what the ground is like there."

Pierro proved just how hard it is to stay perfect, and it was Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus})'s little brother who would swoop in and steal the spotlight. After topping last year's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale with a bid of A\$1.025 million from Patinack Farm owner Nathan Tinkler, All Too Hard appeared to be the second coming of his champion elder sister when winning his first three starts, including a pair of Group 2s. All Too Hard suffered his first loss to Pierro when stepping up to Group 1 company in the G1 Sires' Produce S. at Randwick Apr. 14, and had disappointed in three starts this season, including a fourth against elders last out in the G1 George Main S. Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Imperial Monarch (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) spots his foes plenty of seasoning in today's G1 Pattison Canadian International, but he has been installed as the 3-1 morning-line favorite for this potential springboard to the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 3. The sophomore lost his unbeaten record when a fairly close eighth third out in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club June 3, then bounced right back to take the G1 Grand Prix de Paris five weeks later at Longchamp. The bay has been off since, but may get loose on an uncontested lead and figures to have plenty of upside in just his fifth lifetime start. *Cont. p15*

"I think he's had so little racing that he's still learning," T.J. Comerford, assistant to trainer Aidan O'Brien, said of the horse's running style. "The last time, he made [the pace]. It didn't bother him. He's got a great temperament. I just hope we see him at his best on Sunday. He's been off, but at the same time, we're getting him here thinking we've got him spot on. He's got loads of ability. It depends on how competitive a race it is." O'Brien sent **Joshua Tree (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) to victory here in 2010 when he was owned by the same connections as Imperial Monarch, and the 5-year-old, now trained by Marco Botti for Qatari interests, looks to improve on a runner-up finish a year ago. The bay was third last time to G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe runner-up Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) in Longchamp's G2 Prix Foy Sept. 16. "He seems to be coming into his best [form] recently," Botti told *Daily Racing Form*. "I haven't trained many horses as tough as he is. Every time he comes back after a race, he's full of life. He loves traveling." Mark Hawtin's **Wigmore Hall (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) boasts a two-for-two record over course and distance thanks to back-to-back scores in the GI Northern Dancer S. He bested **Al Khali** (Medaglia d'Oro) by a neck with **Forte dei Marmi (GB)** another length back in third and **Scalo (GB)** (Lando {Ger}) rounding out the superfecta in this year's renewal Sept. 16. The third-place finisher might prove dangerous late this time, as he was forced to weave for running room in the stretch and probably would have had a say in the outcome with a cleaner journey. "We thought he was the best horse in the Northern Dancer," Forte dei Marmi's trainer, Roger Attfield, told *DRF*.

The accompanying table was omitted from yesterday's Bill Oppenheim column "New Number One." Please see below.

Look at the little table with the heading '3 Elite Sales' this year: Saratoga (107 yearlings averaged \$299,065); Keeneland September Week 1 (Books 1-2, 655 yearlings averaged \$202,829); and Tattersalls' October Book 1 (418 yearlings averaged \$273,713). I've been speculating, ever since I saw that Keeneland Week 1 average, about that "\$200,000 yearling"--how many are there, and where are they selling?

In that respect--the \$200,000 yearling--yes, there is a measurable shift from North America to Europe. In 2011, just at 70% (856) of the 1,220 yearlings sold in those three sales combined, sold at the two North American sales; this year, the number was 65%, so there was a 5% shift in the number sold toward Europe. In 2011, October 1 constituted exactly 33% of the three-sale gross (\$86.7 million of a total \$264.8-million gross); in 2012, the October 1 percentage is 41% (\$114.4 million of a total \$279.2-million gross)--an 8% shift in money to Europe.
