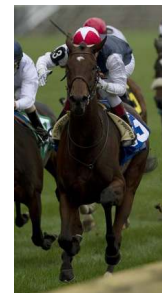

## SIYOUMA STORMS TO E.P. TAYLOR WIN

Robert Jeffcock's **Siyouma (Ire)** (Medicean {GB}) produced a powerful stretch run to take Sunday's GI E. P. Taylor S. at Woodbine by an authoritative 1 3/4 lengths. It was the second straight top-level victory for the 4-year-old filly, who was coming off a win in the Sept. 29 G1 Sun Chariot S., and earned her an automatic berth into the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. "She's so good and she's so calm," said winning trainer Francois Doumen. "She has got such a wonderful temperament that it allows her to travel beautifully well and takes all the effort away." **cont. p3**

## GENTILDONNA SWEEPS TRIPLE CROWN

It took a furious late rally--and a photo to separate her from rival **Verxina (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn})--but Sunday Racing's **Gentildonna (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) got the job done and completed the sweep of Japan's Filly Triple Crown Sunday in Kyoto in a thrilling renewal of the G1 Shuka Sho. She becomes the country's fourth female Triple Crown winner, following in the hoofsteps of Mejiro Ramonu (Jpn) (Mogami {Fr}) in 1986, Still in Love (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) in 2003, and Apapane (Jpn) (King Kamehameha) in 2010. The win comes a year after Sunday Racing took the male equivalent with Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}), and maybe helps lessen the sting of that colt's brutal last-gasp loss in the G1 Arc de Triomphe. **Cont. p6**

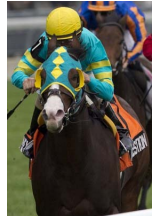

Away alertly, the 5-year-old took the lead into the first turn under Frankie Dettori. Unhurried through fractions of :51.59, 1:17.17 and 1:43.05, Joshua Tree was joined by a host of challengers at the top of the lane, but kicked clear in upper stretch and had enough left late to hold off **Dandino (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and **Forte dei Marmi (GB)** (Selkirk).

"That was always the plan, try to get to the front," Dettori commented. "I'm very happy after half a mile. I was able to dictate my own tempo. When I kicked for home at the quarter pole, I knew I had plenty of horse left."

Joshua Tree, third in the G3 Dubai Gold Cup in March, earned his first win of 2012 with a one-length victory in the Aug. 19 G2 Prix Kergorlay. He was coming off a third-place effort behind Japanese champion Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) in the Sept. 16 G2 Prix Foy.

Jockey Gerald Mosse had a tight hold of Siyouma as she pulled her way into a stalking position as longshot **Kapitale (Ger)** (**Dubawi {Ire}**) took the field through fractions of :25.83, :50.53 and 1:14.93. Finally given her head by Mosse at the top of the lane, the bay filly decisively picked off the leaders and surged clear.

"To be honest, I was not worried about the track, the ground and the filly," said Mosse. "I was just a bit worried two weeks ago...she was in the UK and we won a Group 1 already. It was a bit short in timing, but I told the trainer that if he chose to come, it means we are coming for something solid." *Cont. p4*

Next Question broke his maiden over the Woodbine Polytrack in May 2011, but then went to the sidelines for over a year. He resurfaced with three straight efforts over the lawn against New York-bred company this summer before making it back to the winner's circle with a front-running five-length optional claimer victory against open company at Belmont Sept. 12. A 16-1 outsider in his stakes debut, the bay gelding was up to press Bear Tough Tiger. He took a slim lead at the 3/8ths pold and kept on gamely in the stretch drive to hold off the closing Night Carnation. "He is a horse with a lot of natural speed, and when we left the gate and I saw the one [Bear Tough Tiger] trying to make the lead, I was excited about that," explained winning rider Ramon Dominguez. "I kind of wanted to rate and stalk, but my horse was really pulling me and taking me forward, so I decided to just keep him together. I was very happy with how he relaxed, turning for home he gave me a pretty good kick."

Next Question, who overcame a heart attack as a juvenile and a hairline fracture in a leg as a sophomore, is owned by Kirk Wycoff's Three Diamonds Farm. The gelding was not only Three Diamonds' first Grade I winner, but also its very first Grade I starter. "It was absolutely unbelievable," admitted Jordan Wycoff, racing manager for his father's operation. "It is such a long stretch at Woodbine, you just have to hold your breathe. But it almost brought me to tears. My father was sitting at home and I knew he was crying.

"Sure enough, I talked to him a little while later and he was crying," he laughed.

Kirk Wycoff's passion for horseracing goes back to when he would train horses at Penn National while attending college at Franklin and Marshall College. He settled for a career in banking and only got back into the racing game six years ago. "He absolutely lives for racing," his son said.

Three Diamonds currently has about 20 horses in training and has campaigned two other graded stakes winners, Jimanator and Now a Victor.

Jordan Wycoff said a decision on a Breeders' Cup start would be left up to trainer Mike Trombetta, but admitted a starter in racing's championship event would be special. Gentildonna entered her 3-year-old season with only a maiden win to her credit, but she quickly secured a first black-type badge in Kyoto's G3 Nikkan Sports Sho Shinzan Kinen in January. A step backward in the form of a fourth in the 1600-meter G3 Tulip Sho S. at Hanshin in March was quickly rectified in the first leg of the Triple Crown, the 1600-meter G1 Oko Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas), a victory that came by a half-length over Verxina. The margin over Verxina was a more comprehensive five lengths when Gentildonna swooped from mid-pack to win the second leg, the 2400-meter G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) at Tokyo May 20, and she was given a summer break. Gentildonna returned to Kyoto for the 1800-meter G2 Rose S. Sept. 16, and with new pace-pressing tactics, she once again had Verxina back in second, winning by a comfortable 1 1/2-length margin.

The prohibitive 1-5 choice under regular pilot Yasunari Iwata, Gentildonna reverted to her stalking ways and sat a mid-pack trip while racing in the clear on the outside. Verxina, meanwhile, gunned from the inside draw and led early before relinquishing the lead to Cherry Medusa (Jpn) (Six Sense {Jpn}), who made an aggressive move to charge past and open up eight lengths on the field. Cherry Medusa still maintained a huge advantage as they turned into the stretch, but Verxina and Gentildonna were just getting revved up.

Verxina shifted off the rail and began to cut into her advantage, while Gentildonna was flying down the outside. That pair finally joined together 50 meters out, sweeping past a leg-weary Cherry Medusa and finishing just inches apart. Aromatico and Bridge Climb rallied to complete the super.

Playing Alydar to Gentildonna's Affirmed, Verxina became the first filly to finish second in all three legs of the Filly Triple Crown. In another first, Gentildonna and her sire Deep Impact are the first father/daughter pair in JRA history to both win Triple Crowns. Verxina is also by Deep Impact.

### FLYING SPUR WITHDRAWN FROM STUD DUTY

Three-time Australian champion sire **Flying Spur (Aus)** (Danehill--Rolls, by Mr. Prospector) has been withdrawn from stud duty at Arrowfield Stud in New South Wales, Australia due to a "sudden and irreversible" decline in fertility, according to a press release from the farm. The 20-year-old stallion was Australia's champion first-season sire in the 1999-2000 season. He experienced a banner year in 2007, when his progeny earned A\$10.4 million, good enough to clinch the general and leading 2-year-old sire titles. Himself the victor of three Group 1 races including the G1 Golden Slipper, Flying Spur is the sire of 12 winners at the highest level, including Golden Slipper winner Forensics, G1 Blue Diamond S. winner Sleek Chassis, and G1 Galaxy H. winner Magnus. "Flying Spur is a very special horse for us, as we bred him, raced him in partnership and have been proud to stand him since 1997," said John Messara, Chairman of Arrowfield. "However, with more than 250 current 2-year-olds, yearlings and foals, Flying Spur's story is far from over, and his sought-after broodmare daughters and emerging sire sons will ensure he appears in top-class pedigrees for years to come."

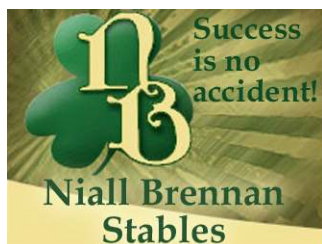

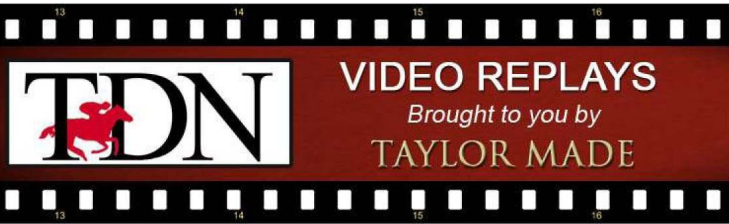
