yesterday's forfeit stage, a select crew had assembled to take on the ultimate test in racing and the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe was under no illusions as to the difficulty of the unbeaten star's racecourse finale on ground which will ride on the soft side. "It's building up to be a really true test for him and I think it's exciting," said

Grimthorpe. "I've always come into this with the attitude that we have to enjoy him. The horse has done everything that we could possibly have dreamt about and I hope he'll run a huge race on Saturday." Of the likely ground conditions, Grimthorpe added, "I would think that soft wouldn't be too much of a problem. It was quite soft when he worked on the racecourse [on Wednesday], but [work rider] Shane [Fetherstonhaugh] got off him and said he handled it very nicely. Henry [Cecil] is very pleased with him and it's all systems go." Rod Street, Chief Executive of British Champions Series Ltd, offered, "To have four of the world's top six turf horses confirmed for Saturday promises something very special indeed for Britain's richest raceday, especially in the QIPCO Champion S., where Frankel looks like facing the toughest assignment of his career as he attempts to retain his unbeaten record. It's expected to be the world number one's final race and a capacity crowd will be ready to bid him farewell on a day that's likely to build to an unparalleled and highly charged crescendo shortly after 4 p.m. Four out of the five winners from last year, Frankel, Cirrus des Aigles, Fame And Glory and Dancing Rain, as well as three of the runners-up, Excelebration, Wizz Kid and Opinion Poll, have been confirmed today, which is amazing. The eyes of the racing world, and indeed the sporting world, will be on Ascot like never before." **Cont. p3**

In contrast to last week's bumper Book 1 at Tattersalls, figures dropped slightly in all sectors for the first day of the extended Book 2, but a number of pinhookers will have gone home happy after some of the most expensive yearlings sold on Monday returned handsome profits on their foal prices, including the joint-top lots.

A Kyllachy (GB) full-brother to the Group 2-placed juvenile Bould Mover (GB) ([lot 765](#)) shared top billing with an Exceed and Excel (Aus) colt out of the Selkirk mare Merle (GB) ([lot 776](#)), each fetching 150,000gns. The Kyllachy colt, out of Maugwenna (GB) (Danehill), was one of six purchases by Charlie Gordon-Watson on the day and provided a fantastic result for his consignor James Egan of Corduff Stud, who bought him for 20,000gns in the same ring last December. **Cont. p4**

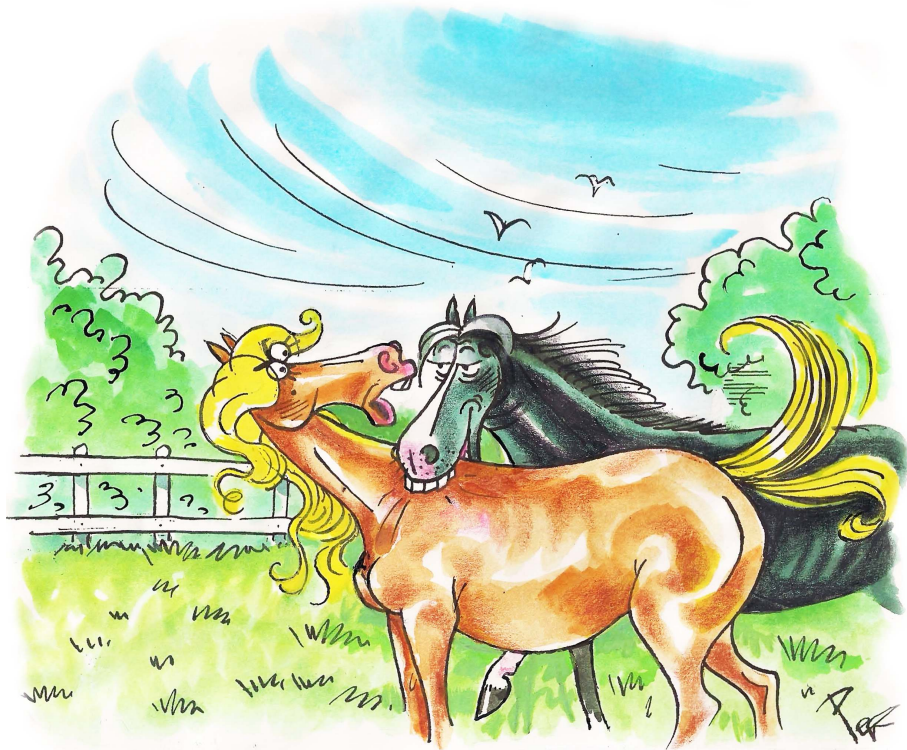

Among those looking to deny the Warren Place colossus Frankel a perfect send-off are Jean-Claude Alain Dupouy's **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}), Lady Rothschild's **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), Stall Antanando's **Pastorius (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) and His Highness The Aga Khan's **Ridasiyna (Fr)** (Motivator {GB}), who have won a total of eight Group 1 races between them. "Pastorius is coming over for the Champion S.," trainer Mario Hofer said of the G1 Deutsches Derby and G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis winner. "He is in very good condition and everything is fine with him. I have seen that the weather forecast is for a little bit of rain and he loves soft ground. Frankel is in another world compared to our horse and I would be delighted if we made the first three. I am very happy with Pastorius and, without risk, there is no reward." Also in the mix are Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Joseph Allen's progressive and still-unexposed **Declaration of War** (War Front) and Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum's **Master of Hounds** (Kingmambo), with Frankel's three-parts brother and established lead horse **Bullet Train (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) making up the field.

### EXCELEBRATION TOPS QEII LIST

Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) yesterday headed the 10 runners still engaged in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, with Aidan O'Brien issuing a positive bulletin on the dual Group 1 winner. Last seen winning the Aug. 12 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois from two of Saturday's chief rivals **Cityscape (GB)** (Selkirk) and **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality), the 4-year-old will bid to go one better than 12 months ago in the mile contest in which he chased home Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}). "So far, everything is good and we've been happy with him since the last day," O'Brien said. "He had a busy enough campaign early meeting Frankel twice, but we were delighted with him in France last time." Khalid Abdullah's 6-year-old Cityscape, who was third behind Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the Sept. 16 GI Woodbine Mile since that Deauville contest, looks set to have his favored easy ground which may not favor Teruya Yoshida's Elusive Kate, who has also been beaten since the Jacques le Marois when runner-up in Newmarket's G1 Sun Chariot S. Sept. 29. The Queen's **Carlton House** (Street Cry {Ire}), Iraj Parvizi's June 19 G1 St James's Palace S. winner **Most Improved (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) and the aforementioned Oct. 5 G3 Diamond S. winner **Declaration of War** (War Front) are others who could take their chances in the Champions' Day highlight. Regarding Carlton House, racing manager to The Queen John Warren offered, "The plan is for Carlton House to run at Ascot. All is very well with him and he is on target for the weekend. I wouldn't think any of the horses would like the ground to be bottomless, but I don't think that we are too concerned about the going. If it really tipped down, then we would discuss it, but we are happy with everything at the moment."

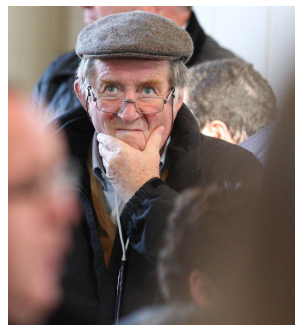

Gordon-Watson's record of buying for Saeed Suhail includes the 2003 Derby winner Kris Kin (Kris S.) and the Kyllachy colt will race in Suhail's blue and yellow silks, which have also been carried by Arabian Gleam (GB) and Awinnersgame (Ire), two colts who are bred on the same Kyllachy-Danehill cross.

"This horse has been bought for Saeed," confirmed Gordon-Watson. "I'm not sure where the horse will be trained, but he is a lovely 2-year-old type."

The Kildare-based Corduff Stud celebrated another good pinhooking result with a son of Dalakhani (lot 638), whom they bought in December for 42,000gns and sold yesterday for 90,000gns, and finished the day as leading vendor with three lots sold for a total of 315,000gns.

Peter Doyle selected Horse Park Stud's fellow top lot by Exceed and Excel--who doubled in price from when he was sold at Tattersalls last year--for the trainer/owner team of Amanda Perrett and John Connolly. The pair celebrated a win at Goodwood on Sunday with Empiricist (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), who was also bought by Doyle at last year's sale for 67,000gns.

"He's a lovely horse with a great action and I love the sire," said Peter Doyle. "We've bought four so far for Richard Hannon, and Amanda and I have been trying hard all day."

**In Search of the Next Mayson**

First-season sire Myboycharlie (Ire), who started his stallion career at the National Stud, but has since relocated to Haras du Mezeray in Normandy, had three yearlings sell on Monday for an average of 80,667gns, including [lot 710](#), a half-brother to the G2 Gimcrack S. winner Blaine (GB) (Avonbridge {GB}).

The Broughton Bloodstock-consigned colt was the subject of some spirited bidding from the likes of trainer Roger Teal and agent Stephen Hillen, but was ultimately knocked down to Richard Fahey for 135,000gns. Fahey's assistant trainer Robin O'Ryan signed the docket, confirming that the colt had been bought for David Armstrong, the owner of G1 July Cup winner Mayson (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), who was retired at the weekend to Cheveley Park Stud.

"He's a lovely-looking horse and we bid on his half-brother at the breeze-up sales," said O'Ryan. "We're taking a bit of a chance with a first-season sire, but we've seen quite a few of his yearlings and they look racy."

The fourth foal out of the Tagula mare Lauren Louise (GB), the colt was bred by Toby Barker. Lauren Louise sold for just 800gns to John Barnard at the 2005 Tattersalls July sale and failed to attract a bid at the 2007 Tattersalls February sale. In addition to Blaine, her first three foals, all bred by Barker, include stakes winner Bogart (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}).

Gordon-Watson's busy session included signing for a colt by Danehill Dancer (Ire) ([lot 691](#)) out of the unraced Lace (Sadler's Wells) who will go into training with David Lanigan. Referring to the premium on the heads of offspring by freshman sires, he said: "I was very happy to get this horse. You can spend that sort of money on a yearling by a first-season sire, but he's by a proven sire out of a Sadler's Wells mare, so it made sense."

**Bounty for Hong Kong**

Bahamian Bounty (GB)'s Group 3 winner Cay Verde (GB) was sold to race in Hong Kong at Arqana's Arc Sale Oct. 6 and another by the sire is heading the same way following the Hong Kong Jockey Club's purchase of [lot 596](#), out of the listed winner Hoh Chi Min (GB) (Efisio {GB}) for 120,000gns.

"I was pleased with the horses we managed to buy last week and I have eight or nine on a short list from Book 2," said Mark Richards of the Hong Kong Jockey Club.

**Bounty for HK cont.**

Stephen Hillen bought two of the 10 six-figure lots on Monday, striking early for [lot 633](#), a colt by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) who was another pinhooking success, this time for Flash Conroy's Glenvale Stud. Conroy bought the son of the King's Best mare Iwunder (Ire) for 29,000gns and sold him on for 120,000gns. The colt will be trained by David Wachman for a partnership which includes Dr. Jim Hay.

Also on Hillen's shopping list was the sole offering by Three Chimneys' stallion Exchange Rate, whose 2-year-old son Reckless Abandon (GB) provided yet another advertisement for his sire when extending his unbeaten record with victory in the G1 Middle Park S. Saturday. The half-brother to listed winner Langston (Pine Bluff) was bought as a foal at Keeneland by Corrib Bloodstock for \$87,000 and sold on for 100,000gns.

The final lot through the ring on Monday ([lot 838](#)) is also Hong Kong-bound after being bought by Sarah Lakin and Geoffrey Howson who "waited all day for the pick of the sale" and secured him for 100,000gns. The first foal of multiple winner Neve Lieve (Ire) (Dubai Destination) by the dependable Royal Applause (GB) was consigned by Rathbarry Stud.

**Boys on Top**

With the top 10 being dominated by colts, the most expensive of the first-day fillies was a strong bay daughter of New Approach (Ire) ([lot 829](#)), who sold for 90,000gns from the Mercer family's Usk Valley Stud draft. The March-foaled filly out of listed winner Nantyglo (GB) {Mark of Esteem {Ire}} was bought by Neil Gilchrist, who will race her in partnership with Andrew Cohen.

"She'll go back to Andrew's Wood Hall Stud first while we decide on a trainer," said Gilchrist, who added that he was hoping to buy six fillies during the week. Rabbah Bloodstock, the umbrella title for Sheikh Mohammed's racing associates, played a significant part at Book 1 when signing for 38 yearlings to the tune of 2,414,000gns and the team hasn't run out of steam just yet. Manager Jono Mills will need to ice his bidding arm overnight after selecting another 17 yearlings on Monday for 614,000gns to finish the day as leading buyer.

While only 13 fewer lots were offered than on the equivalent day in 2011, the session's aggregate fell by 20% to 6,965,500gns. The average was down 8.3% to 38,063gns, while the median fell 3.2% to 30,000gns.

We have thrown a few darts in the past without success, but there is no Lasix for 2-year-olds this year, which makes it a level playing field for all of us, so we will be heading across the Atlantic with our tails up. Sky Lantern is three from five so has plenty of experience, but judged on her work at home she has improved through the summer."

## CREATIVE CAUSE TO AIRDRIE

Grade I winner **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway--Dream of Summer, by Siberian Summer) has been retired to stud duty at Brereton and Elizabeth Jones's Airdrie Stud. The sophomore, who will stand his first season for a fee of \$15,000, retires with earnings of more than \$1,030,000. Campaigned by Heinz Steinmann, the grey was trained by Mike Harrington throughout his career. During his juvenile season, the \$135,000 KESEEP purchase won his five-furlong debut at Hollywood Park by 4 3/4 lengths before going on to win both the GI Norfolk S. at Santa Anita as well as Del Mar's GI Best Pal S., in which he defeated eventual GI Kentucky Derby hero I'll Have Another (Flower Alley). He concluded the 2011 season with a close-up third in the GI Breeder's Cup Juvenile and was one of three nominees--including Hansen (Tapit) and Union Rags (Dixie Union)--for the 2011 Eclipse Award for champion juvenile. This season, Creative Cause bested Bodemeister (Empire Maker) in the GI San Felipe S. before finishing second to I'll Have Another in the GI Santa Anita Derby.

Beaten three lengths in fifth the First Saturday in May, he concluded his career with a third in the GI Preakness S. "I couldn't believe more strongly that Creative Cause is as good a stallion prospect as we've put in the Airdrie stallion barn," said Airdrie Stud owner Brereton Jones. "He is the absolute total package. He's a Grade I-winning millionaire, by a Grade I-winning millionaire that's a perennial leading sire, and out of Grade I-winning millionaire [Dream of Summer] that beat Ashado in the [GI] Apple Blossom [H.]. People may not realize this, but he literally beat every horse he ever ran against at least once, and he ran against every top horse in his generation, including [Grade I winners] I'll Have Another, Bodemeister, Union Rags, Paynter [Awesome Again], Hansen, Gemologist [Tiznow], Alpha [Bernardini] and Dullahan [Even the Score]. He had that great precocious speed, but also trained on to be a top-class 3-year-old. He's a gorgeous, 16.2 hands and correct individual that was purchased by Becky Thomas as a yearling. We will be supporting him with the best mares we've ever sent an Airdrie stallion, including our [GI] Kentucky Oaks winner Proud Spell [Proud Spell], her dam Pacific Spell [Storm Bird], the dam of this year's Kentucky Oaks winner Believe You Can [Proud Citizen], Grade I winner No Such Word [Canadian Frontier] and our 11-year-old mare Don't Trick Her [Mazel Trick], who has already produced two U.S. Grade I winners [Check the Label and Include Me Out], just to name a few. We're all in on a horse that we believe has a limitless future."

Among the early favorites for this year's Kentucky Derby, he sustained a fracture to his right front splint and was subsequently scratched from the Feb 26 GII Fasig-Tipton

Fountain of Youth S. the morning of the race. After receiving the green light from veterinarians after a seven-month rehab, the colt rejoined trainer Todd Pletcher's Belmont string Sept. 11. The decision to retire him came after it was discovered the previous injury had been aggravated during routine training.

"It's very disappointing," said Starlight Racing's managing partner Jack Wolf. "Unfortunately, it's part of the game. He's a wonderful colt and, being a son of Bernardini, he should move on to a promising stud career. Due to his top and bottom side and his physical attributes, we've received a significant level of interest, but no decision has been made yet as to where he will stand."

The colt broke his maiden first time out by 5 1/4 lengths going five furlongs at Belmont Park in June 2011. He made his second start Dec. 16, winning a 6 1/2-furlong allowance at Gulfstream and romped in the one-mile Holy Bull over 2011 2-year-old champion Hansen (Tapit). The Holy Bull field included multiple graded stakes winner Silver Max (Badge of Silver), subsequent GII Carry Back S. winner Fort Loudon (Awesome of Course) and Long Branch S. winner My Adonis (Pleasantly Perfect).

"We were optimistic about his future and return to the track," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He was one of the best 3-year-olds I have worked with. We had such great expectations of him last winter. It's a disappointment, but he should have a great career ahead of him as a stallion."

Algorithms, bred in Kentucky by Oakbrook Farm, retires with \$301,500 in earnings. His 8-year-old dam Ava Knowsthecode has also produced graded stakes winners Justin Phillip (First Samurai), Keyed Entry (Honour and Glory) and Successful Mission (Successful Appeal).

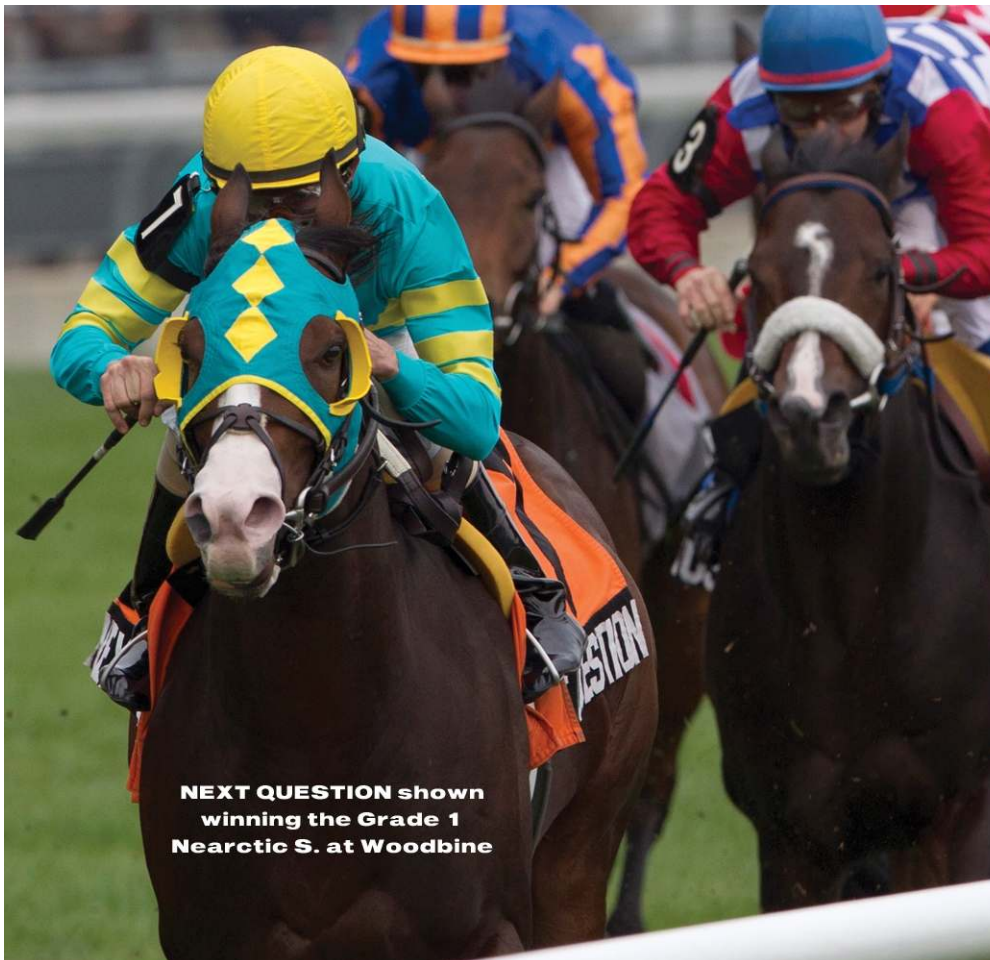

## SEVEN-UP FOR HUGHES AT WINDSOR

Britain's Champion Jockey elect Richard Hughes became just the second to register seven winners in a day with a record-equaling sequence at Windsor yesterday. After partnering the first five scorers on the card, the 39-year-old had his run interrupted briefly when only third in the sixth race before resuming the streak and rounding off the unforgettable afternoon on **Mama Quilla** (Smart Strike), whom he had stepped in to ride at the last minute. In doing so, he was able to join Frankie Dettori in the history books after the Italian's "magnificent seven" at Ascot in 1996. "I'm over the moon--it's great to do it," Hughes said. "I always said I might do it one day at Windsor, my lucky track. Without [trainer] Richard Hannon, I wouldn't be doing any of it. It's been one thing after another this year and I owe a lot of thanks to a lot of people, especially my agent, Tony Hind."

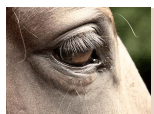

Just about every year at the yearling sales there is an unexpected buzz about an unproven stallion or two, as bloodstock agents and trainers convince themselves that this surprise package could be the next big thing. Now Lawman could hardly be described as a surprise package. After all, he had started his stallion career at Ballylinch Stud at a fee of €25,000 on the strength of his all-the-way victories in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club and G1 Prix Jean Prat. However, he hadn't been snapped up by one of the superpowers of European breeding and his fee had fallen to its current level of €15,000 by 2010, the year his first yearlings reached the sales ring. Having sold for up to €130,000 as weanlings, the Lawman yearlings created quite a stir in France, Ireland and England, with as many as 12 achieving six-figure prices. His top price of 300,000gns came from Shadwell, who signed for three of the top 12 Lawmans.

This type of excitement about a young sire doesn't always translate into equally impressive results on the racecourse, but this time it has. Five of Lawman's first 2-year-olds earned black type, including Most Improved, who was beaten only half a length in the G1 Dewhurst S., and Loi, a Group 3 winner in France. Loi has proved largely disappointing this year but the same couldn't be said of Most Improved.

He lined up against the winners of the Irish and French 2,000 Guineas in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot and won a rough race by 3/4 of a length from the 2000 Guineas third Hermival. One of Lawman's daughters, Forces of Darkness, was a close third in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary. Since then, she has won the G3 Prix Minerve over 1 9/16 miles. Another daughter, Lady Wingshot, has done well around seven furlongs, notably taking the G3 Fairy Bridge S. Then there's Mustacheel, a Shadwell purchase who won a Listed race over nine furlongs in France, and Fort Bastion, who easily defeated the future group winner Starboard in a Newmarket conditions race. **cont. p12**

This adds up to a very solid start, I'm sure you'll agree. However, these good winners come from a crop of 89 foals. The big question was whether Lawman would be able to add to his reputation with a second crop which numbers only 68. Last week answered that question in no uncertain terms. In rapid succession, Lawman's 2-year-olds gained a trio of group victories, starting with the French colt Us Law, who followed up a short-head defeat in the G3 Prix des Chenes by taking the Prix Thomas Bryon. Two days later Lawman struck again, with his imposing daughter Just The Judge keeping her unbeaten record intact with a victory over another Lawman filly, Nargys, in the G2 Rockfel S.

At about the same time, over in Italy, Lawman came out on top again in the G1 Gran Criterium, this time thanks to the English-trained colt Law Enforcement. A graduate from handicap company, Law Enforcement was winning for the fourth consecutive time in five starts. While the Gran Criterium often represents a "soft" Group 1, the next three places were filled by foreign raiders with at least one stakes victory to their credit, including the French Group 3 winner Pearl Flute. In addition to these three group winners, Lawman's second crop also contains Orgilgo Bay, runner-up to Battle of Marengo in the G2 Beresford S., and the group-placed Roseraie. Then there's Move To Strike, who won so well at The Curragh in May that he next started favorite for the Chesham S. at Royal Ascot.

Lawman wasn't exactly precocious. His only juvenile start came as late as November, when he comfortably landed a newcomers' race at Saint-Cloud. He has every right to sire smart 2-year-olds, though, as he is a son of Invincible Spirit. Indeed, in making a successful debut, Lawman became one of 35 first-crop juvenile winners by the Irish National Stud stallion. If I remember rightly, that total of 35 winners was initially claimed as a world record, but--record or not--it still highlighted that Invincible Spirit had inherited his sire Green Desert's ability to sire excellent 2-year-olds, and plenty of them. Because of the scale of Invincible Spirit's achievements, it is easy to forget that his first four crops were all sired at only €10,000.

His excellent first-season results led to his fee rising to €35,000 in 2007 and then along came Lawman's Group 1 victories to help boost Invincible Spirit's fee to a career high of €75,000 in 2008. With several of his higher-priced crops now of racing age, Invincible Spirit has been having another banner year. The 3-year-olds from his €75,000 crop include the group winners Lockwood, Speaking of Which and Swiss Spirit, but these have been outshone so far by their older siblings, headed by the Group 1 winners Mayson (July Cup) and Moonlight Cloud (Prix Maurice de Gheest and Prix du Moulin).

His other representatives include the smart but luckless sprinter Spirit Quartz and the French Group 3 winners Allied Powers and Beyond Desire. Invincible Spirit has also been represented by his second winner of the G1 Cheveley Park S., with the unbeaten Rosdhu Queen following in the footsteps of Hooray.

This lengthy list acts as a reminder that speed is the principal asset of the majority of Invincible Spirit's progeny. This reflects the stallion's own racing record, which peaked with his victory in the G1 Sprint Cup at Haydock, and with his powerful, muscular physique. The fact that he is out of a Prix de Diane winner from a family with endless stamina led me to expect a proportion of middle- distance performers by him. Inevitably there are some, such as Allied Powers, Speaking of Which and the Irish Derby second Born To Run, but these three all have dams or second dams which shone over a mile and a half. With a second dam by Shirley Heights and a third dam by Nijinsky, Lawman also had stamina elements in his pedigree, to help him last the 1 5/16 miles of the Prix du Jockey-Club. However, I suspect it might be wiser to think of him as a miler, judging by the record of his first two crops. Interestingly, two broodmare sires are responsible for four of Lawman's group winners. Us Law shares the same broodmare sire, Linamix, as Most Improved, while Rainbow Quest sired the dams of both Just The Judge and Law Enforcement.

Linamix mares haven't previously made much impact with the Green Desert branch, even though they have done well with other sections of the Danzig male line. It is a different story with Rainbow Quest mares. One of them is the dam of Invincible Spirit's fast son Spirit Quartz and they also have group or listed winners by five other sons of Green Desert. One of these sons, Oasis Dream, has the distinction of having a Group 1 winner, the high-class miler Aqlaam, with a dam by Rainbow Quest and another Group 1 winner, the Irish 2,000 Guineas winner Power, with a Rainbow Quest second dam.

Just The Judge has yet to tackle more than seven furlongs, but she settles well and is sure to be suited by a mile next year, possibly even a mile and a quarter. Her dam Faraday Light had the undesirable record of finishing tailed off in both her starts, but there is nothing wrong with her pedigree. Faraday Light's half-sister High Heeled was sold for 600,000gns after winning the G3 St Simon S. and finishing third in the Oaks. Just The Judge's second dam, Uncharted Haven, was a Grade II turf winner at up to a mile and an eighth, while a half-sister to Uncharted Haven produced Ferneley, a leading turf miler in North America. Just The Judge's fifth dam is the famous Mesopotamia, whose long list of distinguished descendants features such outstanding performers as Rip Van Winkle and Halling.

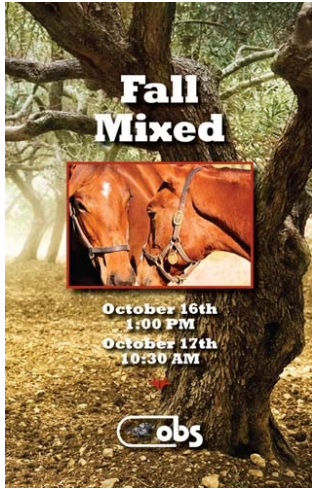
